THE BLOOD

Take to them every man a lamb...They shall take of the **blood**, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door posts of the houses, wherein they shall eat it...And the **blood** shall be to you for a token upon the houses where you are: and when I see the **blood**, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. Exodus 12:3, 7,13

You shall take a bunch of hyssop, and dip it in the **blood** that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two side posts with the **blood** that is in the basin; and none of you shall go out at the door of his house until the morning. For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when He sees the **blood** upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite you. Exodus 12:22-23

You shall not offer the **blood** of My sacrifice with leavened bread; neither shall the fat of My sacrifice remain until the morning. Exodus 23:18

Moses took half of the **blood**, and put it in basins; and half of the **blood** he sprinkled on the altar. And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD has said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the **blood**, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the **blood** of the covenant, which the LORD has made with you concerning all these words. Exodus 24:6, 8

You shall take of the **blood** of the bullock, and put it upon the horns of the altar with your finger, and pour all the **blood** beside the bottom of the altar...and you shall slay the ram, and you shall take his **blood**, and sprinkle it round about upon the altar...You shall kill the ram, and take of his **blood**, and put it upon the tip of the right ear of Aaron, and upon the tip of the right ear of his sons, and upon the thumb of their right hand, and upon the great toe of their right foot, and sprinkle the **blood** that is upon the altar, and of the anointing oil, and sprinkle it upon Aaron, and upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon the garments of his sons with him....Exodus 29:12, 16, 20-21

Aaron shall make an atonement upon the horns of it once in a year with the **bloo**d of the sin offering of atonements; once in the year shall he make atonement upon it throughout your generations: it is most holy unto the LORD. Exodus 30:10

You shall not offer the **blood** of My sacrifice with leaven; neither shall the sacrifice of the feast of the passover be left unto the morning. Exodus 34:25

The priest that is anointed shall bring of the bullock's **blood** to the tabernacle of the congregation: and the priest shall dip his finger in some of the **blood**, and sprinkle it seven times before the LORD, even before the vail. And he shall put some of the **blood** upon the horns of the altar which is before the LORD, that is in the tabernacle of the congregation, and shall pour out all the **blood** at the bottom of the altar of the burnt offering, which is at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. Leviticus 4:16-18

He shall sprinkle of the **blood** of the sin offering upon the side of the altar; and the rest of the **blood** shall be wrung out at the bottom of the altar; it is a sin offering. Leviticus 5:9

Whatever shall touch the flesh thereof shall be holy: and when there is sprinkled of the **blood** thereof upon any garment, you shall wash that whereon it was sprinkled in the holy place...And no sin offering, whereof any of the **blood** is brought into the tabernacle of the congregation to reconcile withal in the holy place, shall be eaten: it shall be burnt in the fire. Leviticus 6:27, 30

In the place where they kill the burnt offering shall they kill the trespass offering: and the **blood** thereof shall he sprinkle round about upon the altar...And of it he shall offer one out of the whole oblation for an heave offering unto the LORD, and it shall be the priest's that sprinkle the **blood** of the peace offerings. Leviticus 7:2, 14

Moreover you shall eat no manner of **blood**, whether it be of fowl or of beast, in any of your dwellings...Whatever soul it is that eats any manner of **blood**, even that soul shall be cut off from his people. Leviticus 7:26-27

Moses took of the anointing oil, and of the **blood** which was upon the altar, and sprinkled it upon Aaron, and upon his garments, and upon his sons, and upon his sons' garments with him; and sanctified Aaron... Leviticus 8:30

When the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering...Who shall offer it before the LORD, and make an atonement for her; and she shall be cleansed from the issue of her **blood**. This is the law for her that has born a male or a female. Leviticus 12:6-7

He shall **slay the lamb** in the place where he shall kill the sin offering and the burnt offering, in the holy place: for as the sin offering is the priest's, so is the trespass offering: it is most holy. Leviticus 14:12-13

He shall take of the **blood** of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the **blood** with his finger seven times. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his **blood** within the vail, and do with that **blood** as he did with the **blood** of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat...and he shall go out unto the altar that is before the LORD, and make an atonement for it; and shall take of the **blood** of the bullock, and of the blood of the goat, and put it upon the horns of the altar round about. And he shall sprinkle of the **blood** upon it with his finger seven times, and cleanse it, and hallow it from the uncleanness of the children of Israel. Leviticus 16:14-15, 18-19

The priest shall sprinkle the **blood** upon the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a sweet savor unto the LORD...Whatsoever man there is of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that sojourn among you, that eats any manner of **blood**; I will even set my face against that soul that eats **blood**, and will cut him off from among his people. For the life of the flesh is in the **blood**: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the **blood** that makes an atonement for the soul. Lev17:6, 10-11

I said unto the children of Israel, No soul of you shall eat **blood**, neither shall any stranger that sojourns among you eat **blood**...For it is the life of all flesh; the **blood** of it is for the life thereof: therefore I said unto the children of Israel, You shall eat the **blood** of no manner of flesh: for the life of all flesh is in the **blood** thereof: whosoever eats it shall be cut off. Lev 17:12, 14

If the slayer shall at any time come without the border of the city of his refuge, whither he was fled; and the revenger of **blood** find him without the borders of the city of his refuge, and the revenger of **blood** kill the slayer; he shall not be guilty of **blood**...So you shall not pollute the land wherein you are: for **blood** it defiles the land: and the land cannot be cleansed of the **blood** that is shed therein, but by the **blood** of him that shed it. Num 35:26-27, 33

If the place which the LORD your God has chosen to put His name there be too far from you, then you shall kill of your herd and of your flock, which the LORD has given you, as I have commanded you...Only be sure that you eat not the **blood**: for the **blood** is the life; and you may not eat the life with the flesh...And you shall offer your burnt offerings, the flesh and the **blood**, upon the altar of the LORD your God: and the **blood** of your sacrifices shall be poured out upon the altar of the LORD your God, and you shall eat the flesh. Deuteronomy 12:21, 23, 27

If you shall keep all these commandments to do them, which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to walk ever in His ways...That innocent **blood** be not shed in your land, which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance, and so **blood** be upon you...Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger of **blood**, that he may die. Your eye shall not pity him, but you shall put away the guilt of innocent **blood** from Israel, that it may go well with you. Deuteronomy 19:10, 12-13

Be merciful, O LORD, unto Your people Israel, whom You have redeemed, and lay not innocent **blood** unto Your people of Israel's charge. And the **blood** shall be forgiven them. So shall you put away the guilt of innocent **blood** from among you, when you shall do that which is right in the sight of the LORD. Deuteronomy 21:8-9

Blessed be your advice, and blessed be you, who have kept me this day from coming to shed **blood**, and from avenging myself with mine own hand. 1 Samuel 25:33

When David heard it, he said, I and my kingdom are guiltless before the LORD for ever from the **blood** of Abner the son of Ner...2 Samuel 3:28

The king said unto him, Do as he has said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that you may take away the innocent **blood**, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father. And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous...than he...1 Kings 2:31-32

They cried aloud, and cut themselves after their manner with knives and lancets, till the **blood** gushed out upon them. 1 Kings 18:28

Moreover Manasseh shed innocent **blood** very much, till he had filled Jerusalem from one end to another; beside his sin wherewith he made Judah to sin, in doing that which was evil in the sight of the LORD...also for the innocent **blood** that he shed: for he filled Jerusalem with innocent **blood**; which the LORD would not pardon. 2 Kings 21:16, 24:4

The word of the LORD came to me, saying, You have shed **blood** abundantly, and have made great wars: you shall not build an house unto My name, because you have shed much **blood** upon the earth in My sight. 1 Chronicles 22:8

They killed the passover, and the priests sprinkled the **blood** from their hands, and the Levites flayed them. 2 Chronicles 35:11

Their sorrows shall be multiplied that hasten after another god: their drink offerings of **blood** will I not offer, nor take up their names into my lips. Psalm 16:4

The righteous shall rejoice when he sees the vengeance: he shall wash his feet in the **blood** of the wicked. Psalm 58:10

He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their **blood** be in His sight. Psalm 72:14

Their **blood** have they shed like water round about Jerusalem; and there was none to bury them. We are become a reproach to our neighbors, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us. Psalm 79:3-4

These six things does the LORD hate: yes, seven are an abomination unto Him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent **blood**, An heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

A man that does violence to the **blood** of any person shall flee to the pit; let no man stay him. Proverbs 28:17

When you spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yes, when you make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of **blood**. Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before Mine eyes; cease to do evil; Learn to do well; seek judgment, relieve the oppressed, judge the fatherless, plead for the widow. Isaiah 1:15-17

...He that walks righteously, and speaks uprightly; he that despises the gain of oppressions, that shakes his hands from holding of bribes, that stops his ears from hearing of **blood**, and shuts his eyes from seeing evil; He shall dwell on high: his place of defense shall be the munitions of rocks: bread shall be given him; his waters shall be sure. Isaiah 33:15-16

When I say to the wicked, You shall surely die; and you give him not warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his **blood** will I require at your hand. Yet if you warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul. When a righteous man does turn from the righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die; because you have not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; but his **blood** will I require at your hand. Ezekiel 3:18-20

And say, If we had been in the days of our fathers, we would not have been partakers with them in the **blood** of the prophets... That upon you may come all the **blood** of righteous Abel unto the **blood** of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom you slew between the temple and the altar. Matthew 23:30, 35

For this is **My blood** of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. Matthew 26:28

Saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent **blood**. And they said, What is that to us? You see to that. Matthew 27:4

And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of **blood**. And they took counsel, and bought with them the potter's field, to bury strangers in. Wherefore that field was called, The field of **blood**, unto this day. Matthew 27:6-8

When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the **blood** of this just person: see you to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His **blood** be on us, and on our children. Matthew 27:24-25

And He said unto them, This is **My blood** of the new testament, which is shed for many. Mark 14:24

That the **blood** of all the prophets, which was shed from the foundation of the world, may be required of this generation; From the **blood** of Abel unto the **blood** of Zacharias, which perished between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation. Luke 11:50-51

He took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is My body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of Me. Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in My blood, which is shed for you...Being in an agony he prayed more earnestly: and his sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground. Luke 22:19-20, 44

As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name: Which were born, not of **blood**, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John 1:12-14

Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except you eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink **His blood**, you have no life in you. Whoso eats My flesh, and drinks **My blood**, has eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is meat indeed, and **My blood**, is drink indeed. He that eats My flesh, and drinks **My blood**, dwells in Me, and I in him. John 6:53-56

When they came to Jesus, and saw that He was dead already, they brake not His legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced His side, and forthwith came there out **blood** and water. John 19:33-34

For he was numbered with us, and had obtained part of this ministry. Now this man purchased a field with the reward of iniquity; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of **blood**. Acts 1:17-19

And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: and on My servants and on My handmaidens I will pour out in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy: and I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; **blood**, and fire, and vapor of smoke: The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into **blood**, before that great and notable day of the Lord come: Acts 2:19-20

The high priest asked them, Saying, Did not we straitly command you that you should not teach in this name? And, behold, you have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's **blood** upon us. Acts 5:27-28

My sentence is, that we trouble not them, which from among the Gentiles are turned to God: But that we write unto them, that they abstain from pollutions of idols, and from fornication, and from things strangled, and from **blood**. For Moses of old time has in every city them that preach him, being read in the synagogues every sabbath day...For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things; That you abstain from meats offered to idols, and from **blood**, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if you keep yourselves, you shall do well. Acts 15:19-21, 28-29

God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that He is Lord of heaven and earth, dwells not in temples made with hands; Neither is worshiped with men's hands, as though He needed any thing, seeing He gives to all life, and breath, and all things; And has made of one **blood** all nations of men for to dwell on all the face of the earth, and has determined the times before appointed, and the bounds of their habitation; That they should seek the Lord, if haply they might feel after Him, and find Him, though He be not far from every one of us: For in Him we live, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also His offspring. Acts 17:24-28

Wherefore I take you to record this day, that I am pure from the **blood** of all men...Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost has made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which He has purchased with **His own blood**. Acts 20:26, 28

As touching the Gentiles which believe, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from **blood**, and from strangled, and from fornication. Acts 21:25

And when the **blood** of the martyr Stephen was shed, I also was standing by, and consenting unto his death, and kept the raiment of them that slew him. Acts 22:20

Their feet are swift to shed **blood**: Destruction and misery are in their ways: and the way of peace they have not known. Romans 3:15-17

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in **His blood**, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God... Romans 3:25

But God commended His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ [Messiah] died for us. Much more then, being now justified by **His blood**, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. Romans 5:8-9

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of **the blood** of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we being many are one bread, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one bread. 1 Corinthians 10:16-17

After the same manner also He took the cup, when He had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in **My blood**: this do you, as oft as you drink it, in remembrance of Me. For as often as you eat this bread, and drink this cup, you do show the Lord's death till He come. Wherefore whoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and **blood of the Lord**. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eats and drinks unworthily, eats and drinks damnation to himself, For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. 1 Corinthians 11:25-30

Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and **blood** cannot inherit the Kingdom of God; neither does corruption inherit incorruption. 1 Corinthians 15:50

Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, To the praise of the glory of His grace, wherein He has made us accepted in the Beloved. In whom we have redemption through **His blood**, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace... Ephesians 1:5-7

But now in Christ Jesus you who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ. For He is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in His flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in Himself of twain one new man, so making peace; and that He might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby... Ephesians 2:13-16

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and **blood**, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Ephesians 6:10-12

Giving thanks unto the Father, who has made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who has delivered us from the power of darkness, and has translated us into the kingdom of His dear Son: In whom we have redemption through **His blood**, even the forgiveness of sins...And He is before all things, and by Him all things consist. And He is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence. For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell: And having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in your mind by wicked works, yet now has He reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight: if you continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which you have heard, and which was preached...Colossians 1:12-14, 17-23

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and **blood**, He also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death He might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. Hebrews 2:14-15

Now when these things were thus ordained, the priests went always into the first tabernacle, accomplishing the service of God. But into the second went the high priest alone once every year, not without **blood**, which he offered for himself, and for the errors of the people... Hebrews 9:6-7

But Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; Neither by the **blood** of goats and calves, but by **His own blood** He entered in once into the holy place, having obtained eternal redemption for us. For if the **blood** of bulls and goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall **the blood of Christ**, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:11-14

Whereupon neither the first testament was dedicated without **blood**. For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the **blood** of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, Saying, This is the **blood** of the testament which God has enjoined unto you. Moreover he sprinkled with **blood** both the tabernacle, and all the vessels of the ministry. And almost all things are by the law purged with **blood**; and without shedding of **blood** is no remission... Nor yet that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest entered into the holy place every year with **blood** of others... Hebrews 9:18-23, 25

For it is not possible that the **blood** of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Hebrews 10:4

This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the LORD, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus... Hebrews 10:16-19

Of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted **the blood of the covenant**, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and has done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:29

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice [blood] than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaks... Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of **blood**, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them. Hebrews 11:4, 28

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him that endured such contradiction of sinners against Himself, lest you be wearied and faint in your minds. You have not yet resisted unto **blood**, striving against sin. Hebrews 12:2-4

To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect. And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the **blood** of sprinkling, that speaks better things than that of Abel. See that you refuse not Him that speaks. For if they escaped not who refused Him that spoke on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from Him that speaks from heaven. Hebrews 12:23-25

For the bodies of those beasts, whose **blood** is brought into the sanctuary by the high priest for sin, are burned without the camp. Wherefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with **His own blood**, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto Him without the camp, bearing His reproach. Hebrews 13:11-13

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through **the blood** of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:11-13, 20-21

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of **the blood** of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace be multiplied. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for you... 1 Peter 1:2-4

Forasmuch as you know that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with **the precious blood of Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you, Who by Him do believe in God, that raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:18-21

This then is the message which we have heard of Him, and declare unto you, that God is light, and in Him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth. But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and **the blood of Jesus Christ** His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:5-9

This is He that came by water and **blood**, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and **blood**. And it is the Spirit that bears witness, because the Spirit is truth. For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one. And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and **the blood**: and these three agree in one. 1 John 5:6-8

...And from Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], who is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in **His own blood**. Revelation 1:5

They sung a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your **blood** out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation... Revelation 5:9

When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: They cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, do you not judge and avenge our **blood** on them that dwell on the earth? And white robes were given every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. Revelation 6:9-11

I said unto him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Revelation 7:14

They overcame him by **the blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11

The winepress was trodden without the city, and **blood** came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs. Revelation 14:20

The second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the **blood** of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea. And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and the fountains of waters; and they became **blood**...For they have shed the **blood** of saints and prophets, and you have given them **blood** to drink; for they are worthy. Revelation 16:3-4, 6

I saw the woman drunken with the **blood** of the saints, and with the **blood** of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration. Revelation 17:6

In her was found the **blood** of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the earth. Revelation 18:24

He was clothed with a vesture dipped in **blood**: and His name is called The Word of God. Revelation 19:13

COVENANT

Abraham took sheep and oxen, and gave them unto Abimelech; and both of them made a **covenant**. Genesis 21:27

God heard their groaning, and God remembered His **covenant** with Abraham, with Isaac, and with Jacob. Exodus 2:24

I have also established My **covenant** with them, to give them the land of Canaan, the land of their pilgrimage, wherein they were strangers. And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel, whom the Egyptians keep in bondage; and I have remembered My **covenant**. Exodus 6:4-5

Now therefore, if you will obey My voice indeed, and keep My **covenant**, then you shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the earth is Mine: and you shall be unto Me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which you shall speak unto the children of Israel. Exodus 19:5-6

You shall make no **covenant** with them, nor with their gods. Exodus 23:32

He took the book of the **covenant**, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD has said will we do, and be obedient. And Moses took the **blood**, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold **the blood of the covenant**, which the LORD has made with you concerning all these words. Ex 24:7-8

He said, Behold, I make a **covenant**: before all your people I will do marvels, such as have not been done in all the earth, nor in any nation: and all the people among which you are shall see the work of the LORD: for it is a terrible thing that I will do with you. Observe that which I command you this day...Take heed to yourself, lest you make a **covenant** with the inhabitants of the land whither you go, lest it be for a snare in the midst of you. But you shall destroy their altars, break their images, and cut down their groves: For you shall worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God: Lest you make a **covenant** with the inhabitants of the land, and they go a whoring after their gods, and do sacrifice unto their gods, and one call you, and you eat of his sacrifice. Exodus 34:10-15

And the LORD said unto Moses, Write you these words: for after the tenor of these words I have made a **covenant** with you and with Israel. And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the **covenant**, the ten commandments. Exodus 34:27-28

Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps **covenant** and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations... Deuteronomy 7:9

When your herds and your flocks multiply, and your silver and your gold is multiplied, and all that you have is multiplied... And you say in your heart, My power and the might of my hand has gotten me this wealth. But you shall remember the LORD your God: for it is He that gives you power to get wealth, that He may establish **His covenant** which He swore unto your fathers, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 8:13,17-18

When you have transgressed the **covenant** of the LORD your God, which He commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and you shall perish quickly from off the good land which He has given you. Joshua 23:16

Lo Zadok also, and all the Levites were with him, bearing the ark of the **covenant** of God: and they set down the ark of God; and Abiathar went up, until all the people had finished passing out of the city. 2 Samuel 15:24

David the son of Jesse said...Although my house is not so with God; yet He has made with me an everlasting **covenant**, ordered in all things, and sure: for this is all my salvation, and all my desire, although He make it not to grow. 2 Samuel 23:5

The king ... read in their ears all the words of the book of the **covenant** which was found in the house of the LORD. And the king stood by a pillar, and made a **covenant** before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep His commandments and His testimonies and His statutes with all their heart and with all their soul, to perform the words of this **covenant** that were written in this book... 2 Kings 23:1-3

And all the people stood to the **covenant**...and the king commanded all the people, saying, Keep the passover unto the LORD your God, as it is written in the book of this **covenant**. 2 Kings 23:3, 21

So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD out of the house of Obed-edom with joy. And it came to pass, when God helped the Levites that bare the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD, that they offered seven bullocks and seven rams. And David was clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also had upon him an ephod of linen. Thus all Israel brought up the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD with shouting, and with sound of the cornet, and with trumpets, and with cymbals, making a noise with psalteries and harps. 1 Chronicles 15:25-28

Be you mindful always of His **covenant**; the word which He commanded to a thousand generations; even of the **covenant** which He made with Abraham, and of His oath unto Isaac; and has confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting **covenant**. 1 Chronicles 16:15-17

So he left there before the ark of the **covenant** of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day's work required... 1 Chronicles 16:37

There was nothing in the ark save the two tables which Moses put therein at Horeb, when the LORD made a **covenant** with the children of Israel, when they came out of Egypt. 2 Chronicles 5:10

If you will walk before Me, as David your father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded you, and shall observe My statutes and My judgments; then will I stablish the throne of your kingdom, according as I have **covenanted** with David your father, saying, there shall not fail a man to be rule in Israel. But if you turn away, and forsake My statutes and My commandments ... then will I pluck them up by the roots out of My land which I have given them. 2 Chronicles 7:18-19

Howbeit the LORD would not destroy the house of David, because of the **covenant** that He had made with David, and as He promised to give a light to him and to his sons for ever. 2 Chronicles 21:7

I beseech You, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keeps **covenant** and mercy for them that love Him and observe His commandments: Let Your ear now be attentive, and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant, which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against You: both I and my father's house have sinned. We have dealt very corruptly against You, and have not kept the commandments.... Nehemiah 1:5-7

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep His **covenant** and His testimonies...The secret of the LORD is with them that fear Him; and He will show them His **covenant**. Psalm 25:10, 14

Gather My saints together unto Me; those that have made a **covenant** with Me by sacrifice...But unto the wicked God says, What have you to do to declare My statutes, or that you should take My **covenant** in your mouth? Psalm 50:5,16

He has put forth his hands against such as be at peace with him: he has broken His **covenant**. Psalm 55:20

Have respect unto the **covenant:** for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty. Psalm 74:20

They kept not the **covenant** of God, and refused to walk in His law...For their heart was not right with Him, neither were they steadfast in His **covenant**. Psalm 78:10, 37

I have made a **covenant** with My chosen, I have sworn unto David My servant...My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and My **covenant** shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to endure for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven... My **covenant** will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of My lips. Once have I sworn by My holiness that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure for ever... Psalm 89:3, 28-29, 34-36

You have made void the **covenant** of Your servant: you have profaned his crown by casting it to the ground. You have broken down all his hedges; you have brought his strongholds to ruin. All that pass by the way spoil him: he is a reproach to his neighbors. Psalm 89:39-41

The mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear Him, and His righteousness unto children's children to such as keep His **covenant**, and to those that remember His commandments to do them. Psalm 103:17-18

He has remembered His **covenant** for ever, the word which He commanded to a thousand generations. Which **covenant** He has made with Abraham, and His oath unto Isaac; and confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an everlasting **covenant**. Psalm 105:8-10

Many times did He deliver them; but they provoked Him with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity. Nevertheless He regarded their affliction, when He heard their cry: and He remembered for them His **covenant**, and repented according to the multitude of His mercies. Ps 106:43-45

He has made His wonderful works to be remembered: the LORDis gracious and full of compassion. He has given meat unto them that fear Him: He will ever be mindful of His **covenant**...The works of His hands are verity and judgment; all His commandments are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in truth and uprightness. He sent redemption unto His people: He has commanded His **covenant** for ever: holy and reverend is His name. Psalm 111:4-5, 7-9

The LORD has sworn in truth unto David... If your children will keep My **covenant** and My testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon your throne for evermore. Ps 132:11-12

He keeps the paths of judgment, and preserves the way of His saints...to deliver you from the strange woman, even from the stranger which flatters with her words; which forsakes the guide of her youth, and forgets the **covenant** of her God. For her house inclines unto death, and her paths unto the dead. Pro 2:8, 16-18

The earth is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting **covenant**...Hear the word of the LORD, you scornful men, that rule this people which is in Jerusalem. Because you have said, We have made a **covenant** with death, and with hell are we at agreement; when the overflowing scourge shall pass through, it shall not come unto us: for we have made lies our refuge, and under falsehood have we hid ourselves. Is 24:5, 14-15

Judgment also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. And your **covenant** with death shall be disannulled, and your agreement with hell shall not stand... Isaiah 28:17-18

The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceases: he has broken the **covenant**, he has despised the cities, he regards no man. Isaiah 33:8

Thus says God the LORD, He that created the heavens, and stretched them out; He that spread forth the earth, and that which comes out of it; He that gives breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein: I the LORD have called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand, and will keep you, and give you for a **covenant** of the people, for a light to the Gentiles.... Isaiah 42:5-6

Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and His Holy One, to Him whom man despises, to Him whom the nation abhors, to a servant of rulers, kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is faithful, and the Holy One of Israel, and He shall choose you. Thus says the LORD, In an acceptable time have I heard you, and in a day of salvation have I helped you: and I will preserve you, and give you for a **covenant** of the people... Isaiah 49:7-8

For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but My kindness shall not depart from you, neither shall the **covenant** of My peace be removed, says the LORD that has mercy on you. O you afflicted, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay your stones with fair colors, and lay your foundations with sapphires. Isaiah 54:10-11

Incline your ear, and come unto Me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will made an everlasting **covenant** with you, even the sure mercies of David. Behold, I have given him for a witness to the people, a leader and commander to the people. Isaiah 55:3-4

For thus says the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep My sabbaths, and chose the things that please Me, and take hold of My **covenant**; Even unto them will I give in Mine house and within My walls a place and a name better than of sons and of daughters: I will give them an everlasting name, that shall not be cut off. Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve Him, and to love the name of the LORD, to be His servants, every one that keeps the sabbath from polluting it, and takes hold of My **covenant**. Even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer... Isaiah 56:4-7

Behind the doors also and the posts have you set up your remembrance: for you have discovered yourself to another than Me, and are gone up; you have enlarged your bed, and made you a **covenant** with them; you loved their bed where you saw it. And you went to the king with ointment, and did increase your perfumes, and did send your messengers far off, and did debase yourself even unto hell. Isaiah 57:8-9

The Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, says the LORD. As for Me, this is My **covenant** with them, says the LORD; My spirit that is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth, shall not depart out of your mouth, nor out of the mouth of your seed, nor out of the mouth of your seed, says the LORD, from henceforth and for ever. Isaiah 59:20-21

For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting **covenant** with them. Isaiah 61:8

It shall come to pass, when you be multiplied and increased in the land, in those days, says the LORD, they shall say no more, The ark of the **covenant** of the LORD: neither shall it come to mind: neither shall they remember it; neither shall they visit it; neither shall that be done any more. Jeremiah 3:16

Hear you the words of this **covenant**, and speak unto the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and say unto them, Thus says the LORD God of Israel; Cursed be the man that obeys not the words of His **covenant**... Jeremiah 11:2-3

The LORD said unto me, Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying, Hear you the words of this **covenant**, and do them... Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this **covenant**, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not... They are turned back to the iniquities of their forefathers, which refused to hear My words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken My **covenant** which I made with their fathers. Jer 11:6-10

Do not abhor us, for Your name's sake, do not disgrace the throne of Your glory: remember, break not Your **covenant** with us. Jeremiah 14:21

Many nations shall pass by this city, and they shall say every man to his neighbor, wherefore has the LORD done thus unto this great city? Then they shall answer, Because they have forsaken the **covenant** of the LORD their God, and worshiped other gods, and served them. Jeremiah 22:8-9

Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will make a new **covenant** with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah: Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which **covenant** they broke, although I was an husband unto them, says the LORD: but this shall be the **covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel; after those days, says the LORD, I will put My law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be My people. Jeremiah 31:31-33

I will make an everlasting **covenant** with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put My fear in their hearts, that they shall not depart from Me. Yes, I will rejoice over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with My whole heart and with My whole soul. Jeremiah 32:40-41

Thus says the LORD; If you can break My **covenant** of the day, and My **covenant** of the night, and that there should not be day and night in their season; then may also My **covenant** be broken with David, my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers. As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea measured: so will I multiply the seed of David My servant, and the Levites that minister unto Me. Jeremiah 33:21-22

If My **covenant** be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David My servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them. Jeremiah 33:25-26

They shall go, and seek the LORD their God. They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces toward this, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual **covenant** that shall not be forgotten. Jeremiah 50:5

When I passed by you, and looked upon you, behold, your time was the time of love; and I spread My skirt over you, and covered your nakedness: yes, I swore unto you, and entered into a **covenant** with you, says the Lord GOD, and you became Mine. Then washed I you with water; yes, I throughly washed away your blood from you, and I anointed you with oil...For thus says the Lord GOD; I will even deal with you as you have done, who have despised the oath in breaking the **covenant**. Nevertheless I will remember My **covenant** with you in the days of your youth, and I will establish unto you an **everlasting covenant**. Then you shall remember your ways, and be ashamed, when you shall receive your sisters, your elder and your younger: and I will give them unto you for daughters, but not by your **covenant**. And I will establish My **covenant** with you; and you shall know that I am the LORD... Ezekiel 16:8-9, 59-62

I will cause you to pass under the rod, and I will bring you into the bond of the **covenant**: and I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that transgress against Me: Ezekiel 20:37

I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it. I will make with them a **covenant** of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. Ezekiel 34: 24-25

David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe My statutes, and do them... and they shall dwell therein, even they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and My servant David shall be their prince for ever. Moreover I will make a **covenant** of peace with them; It shall be an **everlasting covenant** with them: and I will place them, and multiply them, and will set My sanctuary in the midst of them for ever. My tabernacle also shall be with them: yes, I will be their God, and they shall be My people. Ezekiel 37:24-27

You shall say to the rebellious, even to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD; O house of Israel, let it suffice you of all your abominations, In that you have brought into My sanctuary strangers, uncircumcised in flesh, to be in My sanctuary, to pollute it, even My house, when you offer My bread, the fat and the blood, and they have broken My **covenant** because of all your abominations. Ezekiel 44:6-7

O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the **covenant** and mercy to them that love Him, and to them that keep His commandments; we have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and from Your judgments... Daniel 9:3-5

After threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for Himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof shall be with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined. And he shall confirm the **covenant** with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make it desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate. Daniel 9:26-27

Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart shall be against the holy **covenant**; and he shall do exploits, and return to his own land...for the ships of Chittim shall come against him: therefore he shall be grieved, and return, and have indignation against the holy **covenant**: so shall he do; he shall even return, and have intelligence with them that forsake the holy **covenant**. Arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that makes desolate. And such as do wickedly against the **covenant** shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits. Daniel 11:28-32

In that day will I make a **covenant** for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and with the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely. And I will betroth you unto Me for ever; yes, I will betroth you unto Me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in loving kindness, and in mercies. Hosea 2:18-20

They like men have transgressed the **covenant**: there have they dealt treacherously against Me...Set the trumpet to your mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed My **covenant**, and trespassed against My law. Israel shall cry unto Me, My God, we know You. Israel has cast off the thing that is good: the enemy shall pursue him. Hosea6:7, 8:1-3

Their heart is divided; now shall they be found faulty: he shall break down their altars, he shall spoil their images. For now they shall say, We have no king, because we feared not the LORD; what then should a king do to us? They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a **covenant**: thus judgment springs up as hemlock in the furrows of the field. Hosea 10:2-4

Ephraim feeds on wind, and follows after the east wind: he daily increases lies and desolation; and they do make a **covenant** with the Assyrians, and oil is carried into Egypt. The LORD has also a controversy with Judah, and will punish Jacob according to his ways; according to his doing will he recompense him. Hos 12:1-2

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes unto you: He is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and He shall speak peace unto the heathen: and His dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth. As for you also, by the blood of your **covenant** I have sent forth your prisoners out of the pit where in is no water. Turn you to the strong hold, you prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto you. Zechariah 9:9-12

I took my staff, even Beauty, and cut it asunder, that I might break my **covenant** which I had made with all the people. And it was broken in that day: and so the poor of the flock that waited upon me knew that it was the word of the LORD. Zechariah 11:10-11

You shall know that I have sent this commandment unto you, that My **covenant** might be with Levi, says the LORD of hosts. My **covenant** was with him of life and peace; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared Me, and was afraid before My name. Malachi 2:4-5

For the priest's lips should keep knowledge, and they should seek the law at his mouth: for he is the messenger of the LORD of hosts. But you are departed out of the way; you have caused many to stumble at the law; you have corrupted the **covenant** of Levi, says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 2:7-8

Have we not all one father? Has not one God created us? Why do we deal treacherously every man against his brother, by profaning the **covenant** of our fathers? Judah has dealt treacherously, and an abomination is committed in Israel and in Jerusalem; for Judah has profaned the holiness of the LORD which he loved, and has married the daughter of a strange god. The LORD will cut off the man that does this, the master and the scholar, out of the tabernacles of Jacob, and him that offers an offering unto the LORD of hosts. This have you done again, covering the altar of the LORD with tears, with weeping, and with crying out, insomuch that he regards not the offering any more, or receives it with good will at your hand. Malachi 2:10-13

Yet you say, wherefore? Because the LORD has been witness between you and the wife of your youth, against whom you have dealt treacherously: yet is she your companion, and the wife of your covenant. And did not He make one? Yet had He the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That He might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth. For the LORD, the God of Israel, says that He hates putting away: for one covers violence with his garment, says the LORD of hosts: therefore take heed to your spirit, that you deal not treacherously. Malachi 2:13-16

Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom you seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom you delight in: behold, He shall come, says the LORD of hosts. But who may abide the day of His coming? And who shall stand when He appears? For He is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap: and He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and He shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer unto the LORD an offering in righteousness. Then shall the offering of Judah and Jerusalem be pleasant unto the LORD, as in the days of old, and as in former years. And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against the false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and fear Me not, says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 3:1-5

He spake by the mouth of His holy prophets, which have been since the world begun: That we should be saved from our enemies...To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember His holy **covenant**. The oath which he swore to our father Abraham. Luke 1:70-73

You are the children of the prophets, and of the **covenant** which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, and in your seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed...The nation to whom they shall be in bondage will I judge, said God: and after that shall they come forth, and serve Me in this place. And He gave him the **covenant** of circumcision: and so Abraham begat Isaac, and circumcised him the eighth day; and Isaac begat the twelve patriarchs. Acts 3:25, 7:7-8

God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, **covenant**-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32

...The Israelites; to whom pertain the adoption, and the glory, and the **covenants**, and the giving of the law, and the service of God, and the promises...Romans 9:4

There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob: For this is My **covenant** unto them, when I shall take away their sins. Romans 11:26-27

Though it be but a man's **covenant**, yet if it be confirmed, no man disannuls, or adds thereto. Now to Abraham and his seed were the promises made. He says not, And to seeds, as of many; but as of one, And to your seed, which is Christ. And this I say, that the **covenant**, that was confirmed before of God in Christ, the law, which was four hundred and thirty years after, cannot disannul, that it should make the promise of none effect...Galatians 3:15-17

For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. Which things are an allegory: for these are the two **covenants**; the one from the mount Sinai, which genders to bondage, which is Agar. For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answers to Jerusalem which now is, and is in bondage with her children. But Jerusalem which is above is free, which is the mother of us all. Galatians 4:22-26

That at that time you were without Christ [Messiah], being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the **covenants** of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: But now in Christ Jesus you who sometimes were far off are made nigh by **the blood of Christ**. Ephesians 2:12-13

Now has he obtained a more excellent ministry, by how much also he is the mediator of a better **covenant**, which was established upon better promises. For if that first **covenant** had been faultless, then should no place have been sought for the second. For finding fault with them, he said, Behold, the days come, says the Lord, when I will make a new **covenant** with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah: Not according to the **covenant** that I made with their fathers in the day when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt; because they continued not in My **covenant**, and I regarded them not, says the Lord. For this is the **covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the Lord I will put My laws into their mind, and I will be to them a God, and they shall be to Me a people...In that He says, A new **covenant**, He has made the first old. Now that which decays and waxes old is ready to vanish away. Hebrews 8:6-10, 13

The first **covenant** had also ordinances of divine service, and a worldly sanctuary. For there was a tabernacle made; the first, wherein was the candlestick, and the table, and the showbread; which is called the sanctuary. And after the second veil, the tabernacle which is called the Holiest of all. Which had the golden censer, and the ark of the **covenant** overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the **covenant**..He 9:1-5

But this man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; from henceforth expecting till His enemies be made His footstool. For by one offering He has perfected for ever them that are sanctified. Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that He had said before, This is the **covenant** that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin. Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by **the blood of Jesus**, by a new and living way, which He has consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, His flesh; and having a high priest over the house of God...He 10:12-22

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted the blood of the **covenant**, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and has done despite unto the Spirit of grace? For we know Him that has said, Vengeance belongs unto Me, I will recompense, says the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge His people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Hebrews 10:26-31

You are come unto mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of just men made perfect, and to Jesus the mediator of the new **covenant**, and to **the blood of sprinkling**, that speaks better things than that of Abel. Hebrews 12:22-24

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through **the blood of the everlasting covenant**, make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20-21

HIS CROSS AND CRUCIFIXION

He that takes not his **cross**, and follows after Me, is not worthy of Me...Then said Jesus unto His disciples, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross**, and follow Me. Matthew 10:38, 16:24

You know that after two days is the feast of the passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be **crucified**. Matthew 26:2

Pilate said unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let Him be **crucified**. And the governor said, Why, what evil has He done? But they cried out the more, saying, Let Him be **crucified**. When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this just person: see you to it. Then answered all the people, and said, His blood be on us, and on our children. Then released he Barabbas unto them: and when he had scourged Jesus, he delivered Him to be **crucified**. Mt 27:22-26

And they **crucified** Him, and parted His garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted My garments among them, and upon My vesture did they cast lots. And sitting down they watched Him there; And set up over His head His accusation written, THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS. Matthew 27:35-37

Then were there two thieves **crucified** with Him, one on the right hand, and another on the left. And they that passed by reviled Him, wagging their heads, And saying, You who destroys the temple, and builds it in three days, save Yourself. If You be the Son of God, come down from the **cross**. Likewise also the chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said, He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the **cross**, and we will believe Him. He trusted in God; let Him deliver Him now, if He will have Him: for He said, I am the Son of God. The thieves also, which were **crucified** with Him, cast the same in His teeth. Matthew 27:38-44

The angel answered...Fear you not: for I know that you seek Jesus, which was **crucified**. He is not here: for He is risen. Mt 28:5

When He had called the people unto Him with His disciples also, He said unto them, Whoever will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross**, and follow Me. Mark 8:34

Then Jesus beholding him loved him, and said unto him, One thing you lack: go your way, sell whatever you have, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in heaven: and come, take up the **cross**, and follow Me. Mark 10:21

The chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them. And Pilate answered and said again unto them, What will you then that I shall do unto Him whom you call the King of the Jews? And they cried out again, **Crucify Him.** Then Pilate said unto them, Why, what evil has He done? And they cried out the more exceedingly, **Crucify Him.** And so Pilate, willing to content the people, released Barabbas unto them, and delivered Jesus, when he had scourged Him, to be **crucified**. Mark 15:11-15

And when they had **crucified** Him, they parted His garments, casting lots upon them, what every man should take. And it was the third hour, and they **crucified** Him. And the superscription of His accusation was written over, THE KING OF THE JEWS. Mark 15:24-26

And with Him they **crucify** two thieves; the one on His right hand, and the other on His left. And the scripture was fulfilled, which said, And He was numbered with the transgressors. And they that passed by railed on Him, wagging their heads, and saying, Ah, You who destroys the temple, and builds it in three days, Save Yourself, and come down from the **cross**. Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others, Himself He cannot save. Let Christ the King of Israel descend now from the **cross**, that we may see and believe. And they that were **crucified** with Him reviled Him. Mark 15:27-32

Entering into the sepulcher, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were frightened. And he said unto them, Be not frightened: You seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was **crucified**: He is risen; He is not here: behold the place where they laid Him. Mark 16:5-6

He said to them all, If any man will come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his **cross** daily, and follow Me. Lk 9:23

Whosoever does not bear his **cross**, and come after Me, cannot be My disciple. Luke 14:27

They were instant with loud voices, requiring that He might be **crucified**. And the voices of them and of the chief priests' prevailed. And Pilate gave sentence that it should be as they required. And he released unto them him that for sedition and murder was cast into prison, whom they had desired; but he delivered Jesus to their will. And as they led Him away, they laid hold upon one Simon, a Cyrenian, coming out of the country, and on him they laid the **cross**, that he might bear it after Jesus. Luke 23:23-26

When they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they **crucified** Him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots. And the people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided Him... Luke 23:33-35

As they were afraid, and bowed down their faces to the earth, they said unto them, Why seek you the living among the dead? He is not here, but is risen: remember how He spoke unto you when He was yet in Galilee, Saying, The Son of man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be **crucified**, and the third day rise again. Luke 24:5-9

And He said unto them, What things? And they said unto Him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people: And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and have **crucified** Him. Lk 24:19-20

Then delivered he Him therefore unto them to be **crucified**. And they took Jesus, and led Him away. He bearing his **cross** went forth into a place called the place of a skull, which is called in the Hebrew Golgotha: where they **crucified** Him, and two other with Him, on either side one, and Jesus in the midst. And Pilate wrote a title, and put it on the **cross**. John 19:16-19

Then the soldiers, when they had **crucified** Jesus, took His garments, and made four parts, to every soldier a part; and also His coat: now the coat was without seam, woven from the top throughout. They said therefore among themselves, Let us not rend it, but cast lots for it, whose it shall be: that the scripture might be fulfilled, which says, They parted My raiment among them, and for My vesture they did cast lots. These things therefore the soldiers did. John 19:23-24

Then came the soldiers, and brake the legs of the first, and of the other which was **crucified** with Him. But when they came to Jesus, and saw that He was dead already, they brake not His legs: But one of the soldiers with a spear pierced His side, and forthwith came there out blood and water...These things were done, that the scripture should be fulfilled, A bone of Him shall not be broken. And again another scripture says, They shall look on Him whom they pierced. John 19:32-37

Then took they the body of Jesus, and wound it in linen clothes with the spices, as the manner of the Jews is to bury. Now in the place where He was **crucified** there was a garden; and in the garden a new sepulcher, wherein was never man yet laid. There laid they Jesus therefore because the Jews' preparation day; for the sepulcher was nigh at hand. John 19:40-42

You men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by Him in the midst of you, as you yourselves also know: Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, you have taken, and by wicked hands have **crucified** and slain: Whom God has raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that He should be holden of it...Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God has made that same Jesus, whom you have **crucified**, both Lord and Christ. Acts 2:22-24, 36-37

Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you **crucified**, whom God raised from the dead, even by Him does this man stand here before you whole. Acts 4:10

Therefore we are buried with Him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of His death, we shall be also in the likeness of His resurrection: Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin. For he that is dead is freed from sin. Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dies no more, death has no more dominion over Him. For in that He died, He died unto sin once: but in that He lives, He lives unto God. Likewise reckon you also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in the lusts thereof. Neither yield you your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God. Romans 6:4-13

For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the **cross** of Christ should be made of none effect. For the preaching of the **cross** is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. 1 Corinthians 1:17-18

But we preach Christ **crucified**, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. 1 Cor 1:23-25

I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God. For I determined not to know any thing among you, save Jesus Christ, and Him **crucified**. And I was with you in weakness, and in fear, and in much trembling. And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: That your faith should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 1 Corinthians 2:1-2

But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, even the hidden wisdom, which God ordained before the world unto our glory: Which none of the princes of this world knew: for had they known it, they would not have **crucified** the Lord of glory. 1 Corinthians 2:7-8

Since you seek a proof of Christ speaking in me, which to youward is not weak, but is mighty in you. For though He was **crucified** through weakness, yet He lives by the power of God. For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him by the power of God toward you. 2 Corinthians 13:3-4

I am **crucified** with Christ; nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me. Galatians 2:20

O foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ has been evidently set forth, **crucified** among you? Galatians 3:1

And I brethren, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? Then is the offence of the **cross** ceased. Galatians 5:11

They that are Christ's have **crucified** the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:24-26

As many as desire to make a fair show in the flesh, they constrain you to be circumcised; only lest they should suffer persecution for the **cross** of Christ...But God forbid that I should glory, save in the **cross** of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is **crucified** unto me, and I unto the world. Galatians 6:12, 14

But now in Christ Jesus you who sometimes were far off are made nigh by **the blood of Christ**. For He is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us...to make in Himself of twain one new man, so making peace; And that He might reconcile both unto God in one body by the **cross**, having slain the enmity thereby... Ephesians 2:16

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus; Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the **cross**. Philippians 2:5-8

Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as you have us for an example. (For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, that they are the enemies of the **cross** of Christ: Whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame, who mind earthly things.) Philippians 3:17-19

For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell; And, having made peace through the blood of His **cross**, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven... You, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, has He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His **cross**. Colossians 1:19-20, 2:14

It is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they **crucify** to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame. Hebrews 6:4-6

Let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which does so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the **cross**, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

Their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was **crucified**. Revelation 11:8

LAMBS AND SHEEP

She again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of **sheep**, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. Genesis 4:2

Abraham set seven ewe **lambs** of the flock by themselves. And Abimelech said unto Abraham, What mean these seven ewe **lambs** which you have set by themselves: And he said, For these seven ewe **lambs** shall you take of my hand, that they may be a witness unto me, that I have dug this well. Genesis 21:28-30

Isaac spoke unto Abraham his father, and said, My father: and he said, Here am I, my son. And he said, Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the **lamb** for a burnt offering? Abraham said, My son, God will provide Himself a **lamb** for a burnt offering: so they went both of them together. Genesis 22:7-8

In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a **lamb**, according to the house of their fathers, a **lamb** for an house: And if the household be too little for the **lamb**, let him and his neighbor next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make your count for the **lamb**. Your **lamb** shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: you shall take it out from the **sheep**, or from the goats... Exodus 12:3-5

Then Moses called for all the elders of Israel, and said unto them, Draw out and take out a **lamb** according to your families, and kill the passover. Exodus 12:21

Now this is that which you shall offer upon the altar; two **lambs** of the first year day by day continually. The one **lamb** you shall offer in the morning; and the other **lamb** you shall offer at even. Exodus 29:38-39

The firstling of an ass you shall redeem with a **lamb**: and if you redeem him not, then shall you break his neck. All the firstborn of your sons you shall redeem. And none shall appear before Me empty. Exodus 34:20

If he offer a **lamb** for his offering, then shall he offer it before the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Leviticus 3:7

Then you shall sacrifice one kid of the goats for a sin offering, and two **lambs** of the first year for a sacrifice of peace offerings. And the priest shall wave them with the bread of the firstfruits for a wave offering before the LORD, with the two **lambs**: they shall be holy unto the LORD for the priest. Lev 23:19-20

You shall not sacrifice unto the LORD your God any bullock, or **sheep**, wherein is blemish, or any evilfavouredness: for that is an abomination unto the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 17:1

Samuel took a sucking **lamb**, and offered it for a burnt offering wholly unto the LORD: and Samuel cried unto the LORD for Israel; and the LORD heard him. 1 Samuel 7:9

Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David your son, which is with the **sheep**. 1 Samuel 16:19

David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's **sheep** at Bethlehem...David said unto Saul, Your servant kept his father's **sheep**, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a **lamb** out of the flock... 1 Samuel 17:15, 34

They offered unto the LORD the same time, of the spoil which they had brought, seven hundred oxen and seven thousand **sheep**. 2 Chronicles 15:11

You have given us like **sheep** appointed for meat; and have scattered us among the heathen...Yes, for your sake are we killed all the day long; we are counted as sheep for the slaughter. Psalms 44:11,22

But made His own people to go forth like **sheep**, and guided them in the wilderness like a flock...For He is our God; and we are the people of His pasture, and the **sheep** of His hand... I have gone astray like a lost **sheep**; seek Your servant; for I do not forget Your commandments. Psalm 78:52, 95:7, 119:176

When Israel went out of Egypt...the sea saw it and fled: Jordan was driven back. The mountains skipped like **rams**, and the little hills like **lambs**. What ailed you, O you sea, that you fled? You Jordan, that you were driven back? You mountains, that you skipped like **rams**; and you little hills, like **lambs**? Psalms 144:1, 3-6

Be diligent to know the state of your flocks, and look well to your herds....The **lambs** are for your clothing, and the goats are the price of the field. Proverbs 27:23, 26

To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto Me? says the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I delight not in the blood of bullocks, or of **lambs**, or of he goats...Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto Me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot endure it; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting...and when you spread forth your hands, I will hide Mine eyes from you... Isaiah 1:11, 13, 15

The LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness. Then shall the **lambs** feed after their manner, and the waste places of the fat ones shall strangers eat. Isaiah 5:16-17

The wolf also shall dwell with the **lamb**, and the leopard shall lie down with the kid; and the calf and the young lion and the fatling together; and a little child shall lead them. And the cow and the bear shall feed; their young ones shall lie down together; and the lion shall eat straw like the ox...They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain: for the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the LORD, as the waters cover the sea. Isaiah 11:6-7, 9

The sword of the LORD is filled with blood, it is made fat with fatness, and with the blood of **lambs** and goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams: for the LORD has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughter in the land of Idumea...For it is the day of the LORD'S vengeance, and the year of recompenses for the controversy of Zion. Isaiah 34:6, 8

He shall feed His flock like a shepherd: He shall gather the **lambs** with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and shall gently lead those that are with young. Isaiah 40:11

He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a **lamb** to the slaughter, and as a **sheep** before her shearers is dumb, so He opened not His mouth. Isaiah 53:7

The wolf and the **lamb** shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all My holy mountain, says the LORD. Isaiah 65:25

Woe be unto the pastors that destroy and scatter the **sheep** of My pasture! says the LORD. Jeremiah 23:1

I will bring them down like **lambs** to the slaughter, like rams with he goats. How is Sheshach taken! And how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! How is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations! Jeremiah 51:40-41

Dedan was your merchant in precious clothes for chariots. Arabia, and all the princes of Kedar, they occupied with you in **lambs**, **and rams**, and goats: in these were they your merchants. Ezekiel 27:20-21

For thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, will both search My **sheep**, and seek them out. As a shepherd seeks out his flock in the day that he is among his **sheep** that are scattered; so will I seek out My **sheep**, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day. Ezekiel 34:11-12

You shall eat the flesh of the mighty, and drink the blood of the princes of the earth, of rams, of **lambs**, and of goats, of bullocks, all of them fatlings of Bashan. And you shall eat fat till you be full, and drink blood till you be drunken, of My sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you. Ezekiel 39:18-19

The people of the land shall worship at the door of this gate before the LORD in the sabbaths and in the new moons. And the burnt offering that the prince shall offer unto the LORD in the sabbath day shall be six **lambs** without blemish, and a **ram** without blemish. And the meat offering shall be an ephah for a **ram**, and the meat offering for the **lambs** as he shall be able to give, and an hin of oil to an ephah. And in the day of the new moon it shall be a young bullock without blemish, and six **lambs**, and a **ram**: they shall be without blemish. And he shall prepare a meat offering, an ephah for a bullock, and an ephah for a **ram**, and for the **lambs** according as his hand shall attain unto, and an hin of oil to an ephah. Ezekiel 46:3-7

Now when the prince shall prepare a voluntary burnt offering or peace offerings voluntarily unto the LORD, one shall then open him the gate that looks toward the east, and he shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, as he did on the sabbath day: then he shall go forth; and after his going forth one shall shut the gate. You shall daily prepare a burnt offering unto the LORD of a **lamb** of the first year without blemish: you shall prepare it every morning...Thus shall they prepare the **lamb**, and the meat offering, and the oil, every morning for a continual burnt offering. Ezekiel 46:12-13, 15

Though you, Israel, play the harlot, yet let not Judah offend; and come not you unto Gilgal, neither go you up to Bethaven, nor swear, The LORD lives. For Israel slides back as a backsliding heifer: now the LORD will feed them as a **lamb** in a large place. Hosea 4:15-16

Woe to them that are at ease in Zion, and trust in the mountain of Samaria, which are named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came!...that stretch upon beds of ivory, and stretch themselves upon their couches, and eat the **lambs** out of the flock, and the calves out of the midst of the stall; that chant to the sound of the viol, and invent to themselves instruments of music, like David; That drink wine in bowls, and anoint themselves with the chief ointments: but they are not grieved for the affliction of Jacob. Amos 6:1, 4-6

The Lord appointed other seventy also, and sent them two and two before His face into every city and place, whither He Himself would come. Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few: pray you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth laborers into His harvest. Go your ways; behold, I send you forth as **lambs** among wolves...heal the sick that are therein, and say unto them, The Kingdom of God is come nigh you. Luke 10:1-3, 9

Behold the **Lamb** of God, who takes away the sin of the world. This is He of whom I said, After me comes a man which is preferred before me: for He was before me...The next day after John stood, and two of his disciples; and looking upon Jesus as He walked, he said, Behold the **Lamb** of God! John 1:29-30, 35-36

So when they had dined, Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, Do you love Me more than these? He said unto Him, Yes, Lord; you know that I love You. He said unto him, Feed My lambs. He said to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, Do you love Me? He said unto Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I love You. He said unto him, Feed My sheep. He said unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, Do you love Me? Peter was grieved because He said unto him the third time, Do you love Me? And he said unto Him, Lord, You know all things; you know that I love You. Jesus said unto him, Feed My sheep. John 21:15-17

Do you understand what you are reading? And he said, How can I except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him. The place of the scripture which he read was this, He was led as a **sheep** to the slaughter; and like a **lamb** dumb before his shearer, so opened He not His mouth: In His humiliation His judgment was taken away: and who shall declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth. And the eunuch answered Philip, and said, I pray you, of whom speak the prophet this? Of himself, or of some other man? Then Philip opened his mouth and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus [Yeshua]. Acts 8:30-35

You were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your vain conversation received by tradition from your fathers; But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a **lamb** without blemish and without spot... 1 Peter 1:18-19

And I beheld, and lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a **Lamb** as it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth. And he came and took the book out of the right hand of Him that sat upon the throne. And when he had taken the book, the four beasts and four and twenty elders fell down before the **Lamb**, having every one of them harps, and golden vials full of odors, which are the prayers of the saints. Revelation 5:6-8

And they sung a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for you were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation; And have made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign upon the earth. And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands; Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing. And every creature which is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessings, and honor, and glory, and power, be unto Him that sits upon the throne, and unto the **Lamb** for ever and ever. And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives for ever and ever. Revelation 5:9-14

And I saw when the **Lamb** opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the noise of thunder, one of the four beasts saying, Come and see. And I saw, and behold a white horse: and he that sat on him had a bow... Revelation 6:1-2a

The kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; and said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the **Lamb**: For the great day of His wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? Revelation 6:15-17

Lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the **Lamb**, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands; And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sits upon the throne, and unto the **Lamb**. And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshiped God, Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honor, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Revelation 7:9-12

And one of the elders answered, saying unto me, What are these which are arrayed in white robes? And whence came they? And I said unto him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in **the blood of the Lamb**. Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and He that sits on the throne shall dwell among them. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst anymore; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. For the **Lamb** which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. Rev 7:13-17

I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the Kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by **the blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:10-11

...And it was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the **Lamb** slain from the foundation of the world. Rev 13:7-8

And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns <u>like</u> a **lamb**, and he spake as a dragon. Rev 13:11 [false]

I looked, and, lo, a **Lamb** stood on the mount Sion, and with Him an hundred forty and four thousand, having His Father's name written in their foreheads. And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: And they sung as it were a new song before the throne...These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the **Lamb** whithersoever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the **Lamb**. Revelation 14:1-2, 4

The third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of His indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the **Lamb**: And the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receives the mark of his name. Revelation 14:9-11

They sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the **Lamb**, saying, Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are Your ways, you King of saints. Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You only are holy: for all nations shall come and worship before You; for Your judgments are made manifest. Rev 15:3-4

The beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition. And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. These shall make war with the **Lamb**, and the **Lamb** shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him are called, and chosen, and faithful. Rev 17:11-14

The four and twenty elders and the four beasts fell down and worshiped God that sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia. And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all you His servants, and you that fear Him, both small and great. And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigns. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of the saints. And said unto me, Write, Blessed are they which are called unto the marriage supper of the Lamb...Revelation 19:4-9

There came unto me one of the seven angels which had the seven vials full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come hither, I will shew you the bride, the **Lamb's** wife. And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, Having the glory of God... Revelation 21:9-11a

The wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the **Lamb**. And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates thereof, and the wall thereof. Revelation 21:14-15

I saw no temple therein: for the Lord God Almighty and the **Lamb** are the temple of it. And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the **Lamb** is the light thereof. Revelation 21:22-23

And the gates of it shall not be shut at all by day: for there shall be no night there...And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defiles, neither whatever works abomination, or makes a lie: but they which are written in the **Lamb's** book of life. Revelation 21:25, 27

He showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the **Lamb**. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the **Lamb** shall be in it; and His servants shall serve Him: and they shall see His face; and His name shall be in their foreheads. And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God gives them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever. Revelation 22:1-5

SACRIFICE

When you will offer a **sacrifice** of thanksgiving unto the LORD, offer it at your own will. Leviticus 22:29

They shall call the people unto the mountain; there they shall offer **sacrifices** of righteousness: for they shall suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hid in the sand. Deuteronomy 33:19

Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. 1 Samuel 15:22

It came to pass at the time of the offering of the evening **sacrifice**, that Elijah the prophet came near, and said, LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and of Israel, let it be know this day that you are God in Israel, and that I am your servant, and that I have done all these things at Your word. 1 Kings 18:36

At that time when David saw that the LORD had answered him in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite, then he **sacrificed** there. 1 Chronicles 21:28

When Solomon had made an end of praying, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the **sacrifices**; and the glory of the LORD filled the house... The LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said unto him, I have heard your prayer, and have chosen this place to Myself for an house of **sacrifice**. 2 Chronicles 7:1, 12

He repaired the altar of the LORD, and **sacrificed** thereon peace offerings and thank offerings, and commanded Judah to serve the LORD God of Israel. 2 Chronicles 33:16

Then Darius the king made a decree...I make a decree what you shall do to the elders of these Jews for the building of this house of God...That they may offer **sacrifices** of sweet savors unto the God of heaven, and pray for the life of the king. Ezra 6:1, 8, 10

Then were assembled unto me every one that trembled at the words of the God of Israel, because of the transgression of those that had been carried away; and I sat astonied until the evening **sacrifice**. Ezra 9:4

At the evening **sacrifice** I arose up from my heaviness; and having rent my garment and my mantle, I fell upon my knees, and spread out my hands unto the LORD my God. Ezra 9:5

That day they offered great **sacrifices**, and rejoiced: for God had made them rejoice with great joy: the wives also and the children rejoiced: so that the joy of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 12:43

Offer the **sacrifices** of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Psalm 4:5

Now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in His tabernacle **sacrifices** of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises unto the LORD. Psalm 27:6

Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; my ears have You opened: burnt offering and sin offering have You not required. Psalm 40:6

Gather My saints together unto Me; those that have made a covenant with Me by **sacrifice**...O Lord, open My lips; and My mouth shall shew forth Your praise. For You desire not **sacrifice**; else would I give it: You delight not in burnt offering. The **sacrifices** of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise...Then shall You be pleased with the **sacrifices** of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering... Psalm 50:5, 51:15-19

I will freely **sacrifice** unto You: I will praise Your name, O LORD; for it is good. For He has delivered me out of all trouble: and my eye has seen His desire upon my enemies. Psalm 54:6-7

Oh that men would praise the LORD for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! Let them **sacrifice the sacrifices** of thanksgiving, and declare His works with rejoicing. Psalm 107:22-23

I will offer to You the **sacrifice** of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD...Psalm 116:17

God is the LORD, which has showed us light: bind the **sacrifice** with cords, even unto the horns of the altar. Psalm 118:27

Let my prayer be set forth before You as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening **sacrifice**... my eyes are unto You, O GOD the Lord: in You is my trust... Psalm 141:2,8

The **sacrifice** of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is His delight. Proverbs 15:8

To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the LORD than **sacrifice**. Proverbs 21:3

I will **sacrifice** unto You with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD. Jonah 2:9

Even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their **sacrifices** shall be accepted upon Mine altar; for Mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people. Isaiah 56:7

They shall come from the cities of Judah, and from the places about Jerusalem, and from the land of Benjamin, and from the plain, and from the mountains, and from the south, bringing burnt offerings, and sacrifices, and meat offerings, and incense, and bring sacrifices of praise, unto the house of the LORD... The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for His mercy endures for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, says the LORD. Jeremiah 17:26, 33:11

Go and learn what that means, I will have mercy, and not **sacrifice**: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance...If you had known what this means, I will have mercy, and not **sacrifice**, you would not have condemned the guiltless. Matthew 9:13, 12:7

Well, Master, You have said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but He: And to love Him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. Mark 12:33

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living **sacrifice**, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. Romans 12:1

Purge out therefore the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, as you are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is **sacrificed** for us... 1 Corinthians 5:7

Be you therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in love, as Christ also has loved us, and has given Himself for us an offering and a **sacrifice** to God for a sweet smelling savor. Ephesians 5:2

Do all things without murmurings and disputings: That you may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom you shine as lights in the world; Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ [Messiah], that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain. Yes, and if I be offered upon the **sacrifice** and service of your faith, I joy, and rejoice with you all. For the same cause also do you joy, and rejoice with me. Philippians 2:14-18

I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odor of a sweet smell, a **sacrifice** acceptable, well pleasing to God. Philippians 4:18

For every high priest taken from among men is ordained for men in things pertaining to God, that He may offer both gifts and **sacrifices** for sins...Who needs not daily, as those high priests, to offer up **sacrifice**, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this He did once, when He offered up Himself. Hebrews 5:1, 7:27

It was therefore necessary that the patterns of things in the heavens should be purified with these; but the heavenly things themselves with better **sacrifices** than these... For then must He often have suffered since the foundation of the world: but now once in the end of the world has He appeared to put away sin by the **sacrifice** of Himself. Hebrews 9:23, 26

For the law having a shadow of good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with those **sacrifices** which they offered year by year continually make the comers thereunto perfect. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? Because that the worshipers once purged should have had no more conscience of sins. Hebrews 10:1-2

But in those **sacrifices** there is a remembrance again made of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins. Wherefore when He comes into the world, He says, **Sacrifice** and offering you would not, but a body have You prepared me: In burnt offerings and **sacrifices** for sin you have had no pleasure. Then said I, Lo, I come (in the volume of the book it is written of Me,) to do Your will, O God...Every priest stands daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same **sacrifices**, which can never take away sins: but this man, after He had offered one **sacrifice** for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God... Hebrews 10:3-7, 11-12

If we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more **sacrifice** for sins. Hebrews 10:26

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent **sacrifice** than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous... Hebrews 11:4

Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with **His own blood**, suffered without the gate. Let us go forth therefore unto Him without the camp, bearing His reproach. For here we have no continuing city, but we seek one to come. By Him therefore let us offer **the sacrifice** of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such **sacrifices** God is well pleased. Hebrews 13:12-16

The Lord is...a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious. You also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, an holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual **sacrifices**, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 2:3-5

TESTAMENT

For this is **My blood** of the new **testament**, which is shed for many for the remission of sins. Matthew 26:28

Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in **My blood**, which is shed for you. Luke 22:20

After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new **testament** in **My blood**: this do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me. 1 Cor 11:25

Who also has made us able ministers of the new **testament**; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter kills, but the spirit gives life. 2 Corinthians 3:6

But their minds were blinded: for until this day remains the same vail untaken away in the reading of the old **testament**; which vail is done away in Christ [Messiah]. 2 Corinthians 3:14

The Lord swore and will not repent, You are a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec:) By so much was Jesus made a surety of a better **testament**. Hebrews 7:21-22

And for this cause He is the mediator of the new **testament**, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were under the first **testament**, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. For where a **testament** is, there must also of necessity be the death of the testator. For a **testament** is of force after men are dead: otherwise it is of no strength at all while the testator lives. Whereupon neither the first **testament** was dedicated without blood. For when Moses had spoken every precept to all the people according to the law, he took the blood of calves and of goats, with water, and scarlet wool, and hyssop, and sprinkled both the book, and all the people, saying, This is the blood of the **testament** which God has enjoined unto you. Hebrews 9:15-20

The temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in His temple the ark of His **testament**: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. Revelation 11:19

TESTIMONY & TESTIFY

As the LORD commanded Moses, so Aaron laid it up before the **testimony**, to be kept. Exodus 16:34

If the ox were wont to push with his horn in time past, and it has been **testified** to his owner, and he has not kept him in, but that he has killed a man or a woman; the ox shall be stoned, and his owner also shall be put to death. Exodus 21:29

You shall put into the ark the **testimony** which I shall give you... You shall put the mercy seat above upon the ark; and in the ark you shall put the **testimony** that I shall give you. And there I will meet with you, and I will commune with you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the **testimony**, of all things which I will give you in commandment unto the children of Israel. Exodus 25:16, 21-22

You shall hang up the vail under the taches, that you may bring in thither within the vail the ark of the **testimony**: and the vail shall divide unto you between the holy place and the most holy. You shall put the mercy seat upon the ark of the **testimony** in the most holy place. Exodus 26:34

In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is before the **testimony**, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel. Exodus 27:21

You shall put it before the vail that is by the ark of the **testimony**, before the mercy seat that is over the **testimony**, where I will meet with you...You shall anoint the tabernacle of the congregation therewith, and the ark of the **testimony**...You shall beat some of it very small, and put of it before the **testimony** in the tabernacle of the congregation, where I will meet with you: it shall be unto you most holy. Exodus 30:6, 26, 36

And in the hearts of all that are wise hearted I have put wisdom, that they may make all that I have commanded you. The tabernacle of the congregation, and the ark of the **testimony**, and the mercy seat that is thereupon, and all the furniture of the tabernacle... Exodus 31:6-7

He gave unto Moses, when He had made an end of communing with him upon mount Sinai, two tables of **testimony**, tables of stone, written with the finger of God. Exodus 31:18

Moses turned, and went down from the mount, and the two tables of the **testimony** were in his hand: the tables were written on both their sides; on the one side and on the other were they written. Exodus 32:15

It came to pass, when Moses came down from mount Sinai with the two tables of **testimony** in Moses' hand, when he came down from the mount, that Moses knew not that the skin of his face shone while he talked with Him. Exodus 34:29

This is the sum of the tabernacle, even of the tabernacle of the **testimony**, as it was counted, according to the commandment of Moses, for the service of the Levites, by the hand of Ithamar, son to Aaron the priest. Exodus 38:21

And they brought the tabernacle unto Moses, the tent, and all his furniture, his taches, his boards, his bars, and his pillars, and his sockets, and the covering of rams' skins dyed red, and the covering of badgers' skins, and the veil of the covering, the ark of the **testimony**, and the staves thereof, and the mercy seat. Ex 39:33-35

You shall put therein the ark of the **testimony**, and cover the ark with the vail...You shall set the altar of gold for the incense before the ark of the **testimony**, and put the hanging of the door to the tabernacle...He took and put the **testimony** into the ark, and set the staves on the ark, and put the mercy seat above upon the ark: and he brought the ark into the tabernacle, and set up the vail of the covering, and covered the ark of the **testimony**; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:3, 5, 20-21

He shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the **testimony**, that he die not... Leviticus 16:13

Without the vail of the **testimony**, in the tabernacle of the congregation, shall Aaron order it from the evening unto the morning before the LORD continually: it shall be a statute for ever... Leviticus 24:3

You shall appoint the Levites over the tabernacle of **testimony**, and over all the vessels thereof, and over all things that belong to it: they shall bear the tabernacle, and all the vessels thereof; and they shall minister unto it, and shall encamp round about the tabernacle. Numbers 1:50

The Levites shall pitch round about the tabernacle of **testimony**, that there be no wrath upon the congregation of the children of Israel: and the Levites shall keep the charge of the tabernacle of **testimony**. Numbers 1:53

When the camp sets forward, Aaron shall come, and his sons, and they shall take down the covering vail, and cover the ark of **testimony** with it... Numbers 4:5

Then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the ark of **testimony**, from between the two cherubim; and he spake unto Him. Numbers 7:89

On the day that the tabernacle was reared up the cloud covered the tabernacle, namely, the tent of the **testimony**: and at even there was upon the tabernacle as it were the appearance of fire, until the morning. Numbers 9:15

It came to pass on the twentieth day of the second month, in the second year, that the cloud was taken up from off the tabernacle of the **testimony**. Numbers 10:11

You shall lay them up in the tabernacle of the congregation before the **testimony**, where I will meet with you...The LORD said unto Moses, Bring Aaron's rod again before the **testimony**, to be kept for a token against the rebels; and you shall quite take away their murmurings from Me, that they die not. Numbers 17:4, 10

Whoso kills any person, the murderer shall be put to death by the mouth of witnesses: but one witness shall not **testify** against any person to cause him to die. Numbers 35:30

These are the **testimonies**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which Moses spake unto the children of Israel, after they came forth out of Egypt. Deuteronomy 4:45

You shall diligently keep the commandments of the LORD your God, and His testimonies, and His statutes, which He has commanded you... And when your son asks you in time to come, saying, What mean the **testimonies**, and the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD our God has commanded you? Deuteronomy 6:17, 20

It shall be, if you do at all forget the LORD your God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I **testify** against you this day that you shall surely perish. Deutonomy 8:19

If a false witness rise up against any man to **testify** against him that which is wrong...The judges shall make diligent inquiry: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and has **testified** falsely against his brother; Then shall you do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shall you put the evil away from among you. Deuteronomy 19:16, 18

It shall come to pass, when many evils and troubles are befallen them, that this song shall **testify** against them as a witness; for it shall not be forgotten out of the mouths of their seed: for I know their imagination which they go about... Deut 31:21

He said unto them, Set your hearts unto all the words which I **testify** among you this day, which you shall command your children to observe to do, all the words of this law. Deut 32:46

Command the priests that bear the ark of the **testimony**, that they come up out of Jordan. Joshua 4:16

I went out full, and the LORD has brought me home again empty: why then do you call me Naomi, seeing the LORD has **testified** against me, and the Almighty has afflicted me? Ruth 1:21

Now this was the manner in former time in Israel concerning redeeming and concerning changing, for to confirm all things; a man plucked off his shoe, and gave it to his neighbor: and this was a **testimony** in Israel. Ruth 4:7

David said unto him, Your blood be upon your head; for your mouth has **testified** against you, saying, I have slain the LORD'S anointed. 2 Samuel 1:16

Keep the charge of the LORD thy God, to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, and His commandments, and His judgments, and His **testimonies**, as it is written in the law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do, and whithersoever you turn yourself. 1 Kings 2:3

He brought forth the king's son, and put the crown upon him, and gave him the **testimony**; and they made him king, and anointed him; and they clapped their hands, and said, God save the king. 2 Kings 11:12

Yet the LORD **testified** against Israel, and against Judah, by all the prophets, and by all the seers, saying, Turn you from your evil ways, and keep My commandments and My statutes, according to all the law which I commanded your fathers, and which I sent to you by My servants the prophets...They rejected His statutes, and His covenant that He made with their fathers, and His **testimonies** which He **testified** against them; and they followed vanity, and became vain, and went after the heathen that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them. 2 Kings 17:13,15

The king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep His commandments and His **testimonies** and His statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant. 2 Kings 23:3

Give unto Solomon my son a perfect heart, to keep Your commandments, Your **testimonies**, and Your statutes, and to do all these things, and to build the palace, for the which I have made provision. 1 Chronicles 29:19

He sent prophets to them, to bring them again unto the LORD; and they **testified** against them: but they would not give ear. 2 Chronicles 24:19

The king stood in his place, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep His commandments, and His **testimonies**, and His statutes, with all His heart, and with all His soul, to perform the words of the covenant which are written in this book. 2 Chronicles 34:31

Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against You, and cast Your law behind their backs, and slew Your prophets which testified against them to turn them to You, and they wrought great provocations...After they had rest, they did evil again before you: therefore left you them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto You, You heard them from heaven; and many times did You deliver them according to Your mercies: and testified against them, that You might bring them again unto Your law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto Your commandments, but sinned against Your judgments, which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and hardened their neck, and would not hear...Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept Your law, nor hearkened unto Your commandments and Your testimonies, wherewith You did testify against them. Nehemiah 9:26, 28-29, 34

Many years did You forbear them, and **testified** against them by Your spirit in Your prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore You gave them into the hand of the people of the lands. Nehemiah 9:30

In those days saw I in Judah some treading wine presses on the sabbath, and bring in sheaves, and lading asses; as also wine, grapes, and figs, and all manner of burdens, which they brought into Jerusalem on the sabbath day: and I **testified** against them in the day wherein they sold victuals...Then I **testified** against them, and said unto them, Why lodge you about the wall? If you do so again, I will lay hands on you. From that time forth came they no more on the sabbath. Nehemiah 13:15, 21

Your own mouth condemns you, and not I: yes, your own lips **testify** against you. Job 15:6

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the **testimony** of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple... All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep His covenant and His **testimonies**. Ps 19:7, 25:10

Hear, O My people, and I will speak; O Israel, and I will **testify** against you: I am God, even your God. Psalm 50:7

For He established a **testimony** in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children...They tempted and provoked the Most High God, and kept not His **testimonies**... Psalm 78:5, 56

This He ordained in Joseph for a **testimony**, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I understood not...Hear, O My people, and I will **testify** unto you: O Israel, if you will hearken unto Me; There shall no strange god be in you; neither shall you worship any strange god. Ps 81:5, 8-9

Your **testimonies** are very sure: holiness becomes Your house, OLORD, for ever. Psalm 93:5

He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar: they kept His **testimonies**, and the ordinance that He gave them. Ps 99:7

Blessed are they that keep His **testimonies**, and that seek Him with the whole heart...I have rejoiced in the way of Your **testimonies**, as much as in all riches...Remove from me reproach and contempt; for I have kept Your **testimonies**... Your **testimonies** also are my delight and my counselors... I have stuck unto Your **testimonies**: O LORD, put me not to shame... Incline my heart unto Your **testimonies**, and not to covetousness. Psalm 119:2, 14, 22, 24, 31, 36

I will speak of Your **testimonies** also before kings, and will not be ashamed...I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto Your **testimonies**...Let those that fear You turn unto me, and those that have known Your **testimonies**...Quicken me after Your lovingkindness; so shall I keep the **testimony** of Your mouth...The wicked have waited for me to destroy me: but I will consider Your **testimonies**...I have more understanding than all my teachers: for Your **testimonies** are my meditation. Psalm 119:46, 59, 79, 88, 95, 99

Your **testimonies** have I taken as an heritage for ever: for they are the rejoicing of my heart...You put away all the wicked of the earth like dross: therefore I love your **testimonies**... I am Your servant; give me understanding, that I may know Your **testimonies**... Psalm 119:111, 119, 125

Your **testimonies** are wonderful: therefore does my soul keep them...Your **testimonies** that You have commanded are righteous and very faithful...The righteousness of Your **testimonies** is everlasting: give me understanding, and I shall live...I cried unto You; save me, and I shall keep Your **testimonies**...Concerning Your **testimonies**, I have known of old that You have founded them for ever...Many are my persecutors and my enemies; yet do I not decline from Your **testimonies**...My soul has kept Your **testimonies**; and I love them exceedingly. I have kept Your precepts and Your **testimonies**: for all my ways are before You. Psalm 119:129, 135, 144, 146, 152, 157, 167-168

Jerusalem is built as a city that is compact together: Whither the tribes go up, the tribes of the LORD, unto the **testimony** of Israel, to give thanks unto the name of the LORD. Psalm 122:3-4

If your children will keep My covenant and My **testimony** that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon your throne for evermore. Psalm 132:12

Bind up the **testimony**, seal the law among My disciples... Behold, I and the children whom the LORD has given me are for signs and wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwell in mount Zion. And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? For the living to the dead? To the law and to the **testimony**: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. Isaiah 8:16, 18-20

For our transgressions are multiplied before You, and our sins **testify** against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them... Isaiah 59:12

O LORD, though our iniquities **testify** against us, You do it for Your name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against You...Because you have burned incense, and because you have sinned against the LORD, and have not obeyed the voice of the LORD, nor walked in His law, nor in His statutes, nor in His **testimonies**; therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day. Jeremiah 14:7, 44:23

The pride of Israel does **testify** to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them. Hosea 5:5

Hear you, and **testify** in the house of Jacob, says the Lord GOD, the God of hosts. Amos 3:13

O My people, what have I done unto you? And wherein have I wearied you? **Testify** against Me. Micah 6:3

Jesus said unto him, See you tell no man; but go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer the gift that Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Matthew 8:4

You shall be brought before governors and kings for My sake, for a **testimony** against them and the Gentiles. Matthew 10:18

Go your way, show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing those things which Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Mark 1:44

Whoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet for a **testimony** against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment, than for that city... Take heed to yourselves: for they shall deliver you up to councils; and in the synagogues you shall be beaten: and you shall be brought before rulers and kings for My sake, for a **testimony** against them. Mark 6:11, 13:9

He charged him to tell no man: but go, and show yourself to the priest, and offer for your cleansing, according as Moses commanded, for a **testimony** unto them. Luke 5:14

Whosoever will not receive you, when you go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a **testimony** against them. Luke 9:5

I pray...that you would send him to my father's house: For I have five brethren; that he may **testify** unto them, lest they also come into this place of torment. Abraham said unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them...If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. Luke 16:26-31

They shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. And it shall turn to you for a **testimony**. Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what you shall answer: For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:12-15

Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because He knew all men, and needed not that any should **testify** of man: for He knew what was in man. John 2:24-25

Truly, truly, I say unto you, We speak that we do know, and **testify** that we have seen; and you receive not our witness. John 3:11

What He has seen and heard, that He **testifies**; and no man receives His **testimony**. He that has received His **testimony** has set to his seal that God is true. John 3:32-33

Many of the Samaritans of that city believed on Him for the saying of the woman, which **testified**, He told me all that ever I did. John 4:39

For Jesus himself **testified**, that a prophet has no honor in his own country. John 4:44

I receive not **testimony** from man: but these things I say, that you might be saved...Search the scriptures; for in them you think you have eternal life: and they are they which **testify** of Me. Jn 5:34, 39

The world cannot hate you; but Me it hates, because I **testify** of it, that the works thereof are evil. John 7:7

It is also written in your law, that the **testimony** of two men is true. John 8:17

When Jesus had thus said, He was troubled in spirit, and **testified**, and said, Truly, truly, I say unto you, that one of you shall betray Me. John 13:21

When the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceeds from the Father, He shall **testify** of Me... John 15:26

This is the disciple which **testifies** of these things, and wrote these things: and we know that his **testimony** is true. John 21:24

With many other words did he **testify** and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation. Acts 2:40

They, when they had **testified** and preached the word of the Lord, returned to Jerusalem, and preached the gospel in many villages of the Samaritans. Acts 8:25

He commanded us to preach unto the people, and to **testify** that it is He which was ordained of God to be the Judge of quick and dead. Acts 10:42

When He had removed him, He raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also He gave **testimony**, and said, I have found David the son of Jesse, a man after My own heart, which shall fulfil all My will. Acts 13:22

Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave **testimony** unto the word of His grace, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands. Acts 14:3

When Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and **testified** to the Jews that Jesus was Christ [Yeshua was Messiah]. Acts 18:5

I have kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have showed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house, **testifying** both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ...None of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to **testify** the gospel of the grace of God. Acts 20:20-21, 24

Make haste, and get yourself quickly out of Jerusalem: for they will not receive your **testimony** concerning Me. And I said, Lord... Acts 22:18-19

The night following the Lord stood by him, and said, Be of good cheer, Paul: for as you have **testified** of Me in Jerusalem, so must you bear witness also at Rome. Acts 23:11

My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews; which knew me from the beginning, if they would **testify**, that after the most strait sect of our religion I lived a Pharisee. Acts 26:4-5

When they had appointed him a day, there came many to him into his lodging; to whom he expounded and **testified** the Kingdom of God, persuading them concerning Jesus, both out of the law of Moses, and out of the prophets... Acts 28:23

I thank my God always on your behalf... That in every thing you are enriched by Him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge; Even as the **testimony** of Christ was confirmed in you: so that you come behind in no gift; waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ...I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the **testimony** of God. 1 Corinthians 1:4-8, 2:1

If Christ is not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your faith is also vain. Yes, and we are found false witnesses of God; because we have **testified** of God that He raised up Christ: whom He raised not up, if so be that the dead rise not. 1 Cor 15:14-15

For our rejoicing is this, the **testimony** of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward. 2 Corinthians 1:12

For I **testify** again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law. Galatians 5:3

This I say therefore, and **testify** in the Lord, that you henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But you have not so learned Christ [Messiah]; If so be that you have heard Him, and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: That you put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts... Ephesians 4:17-22

...That no man go beyond and defraud his brother in any matter: because that the Lord is the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and **testified**...Seeing it is a righteous things with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels...When He shall come to be glorified in His saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our **testimony** among you was believed) in that day. 1 Thessalonians 4:6, 2 Thes 1:6-7, 10

For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus; Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be **testified** in due time. 1 Timothy 2:5-6

Be not therefore ashamed of the **testimony** of our Lord, nor of me His prisoner: but be a partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God... 2 Timothy 1:8

One in a certain place **testified**, saying, What is man, that you are mindful of him? Or the son of man, that you visit him? Hebrews 2:6

Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a **testimony** of those things which were to be spoken after... Hebrews 3:5

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God **testifying** of his gifts: and by he being dead yet speaks. By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this **testimony**, that he pleased God. Hebrews 11:4-5

Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it **testified** beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. 1 Peter 1:11

By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and **testifying** that this is the true grace of God, wherein you stand. 1 Peter 5:12

We have seen and do **testify** that the Father sent the Son to be the Savior of the world...If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which He has **testified** of His Son. 1 John 4:14, 5:9

For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and **testified** of the truth that is in you, even as you walk in the truth. 3 John 1:3

The revelation of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], which God gave unto Him, to show unto His servants things which must shortly come to pass; and He sent and signified it by His angel unto His servant John: who bare record of the word of God, and of the **testimony** of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw. Revelation 1:1-2

I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the Kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the **testimony** of Jesus Christ. Revelation 1:9

When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the **testimony** which they held... Revelation 6:9

When they shall have finished their **testimony**, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit shall make war against them, and shall overcome them, and kill them. Revelation 11:7

They overcame him by **the blood of the Lamb**, and by the word of their **testimony**; and they loved not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:11

The dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the **testimony** of Jesus Christ. Revelation 12:17

After that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the **testimony** in heaven was opened... Revelation 15:5

I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, see you do it not: I am your fellowservant, and of your brethren that have the **testimony** of Jesus; worship God: for the **testimony** of Jesus [Yeshua] is the spirit of prophecy. Revelation 19:10

I Jesus [Yeshua] have sent mine angel to **testify** unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star...For I **testify** unto every man that hears the words of the prophecy of this book, If any man shall add unto these things, God shall add unto him the plagues that are written in this book... Revelation 22:16, 18
