COUNTENANCE

But unto Cain and to his offering He had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his **countenance** fell. And the Lord said unto Cain, Why are you wroth? And why is your countenance fallen? Genesis 4:5-6

Jacob beheld the **countenance** of Laban, and, behold, it was not toward him as before...And said unto them, I see your father's **countenance**, that it is not toward me as before; but the God of my father has been with me. Genesis 31:2, 5

Thus says the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and **cheerful** feasts; therefore love the truth and peace. Zechariah 8:19

DELIGHT

The young man deferred not to do the thing, because he had **delight** in Jacob's daughter: and he was more honorable than all the house of his father. Genesis 34:19

If the LORD **delight** in us, then He will bring us into this land, and give it us; a land which flows with milk and honey. Num 14:8

Behold, the Heaven and the Heaven of Heavens is the LORD'S your God, the Earth also, with all that therein is. Only the LORD [YEHOVAH] had a **delight** in your fathers to love them, and He chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day. Deuteronomy 10:14-15

Samuel said, Has the LORD as great **delight** in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams. For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, He has also rejected you from being king. 1 Samuel 15:22-23

Saul commanded his servants, saying, Commune with David secretly, and say, Behold, the king has **delight** in you, and all his servants love you: now therefore be the king's son in law. 1 Samuel 18:22

Jonathan Saul's son **delighted** much in David: and Jonathan told David, saying, Saul my father seeks to kill you: now therefore, I pray you, take heed to yourself until the morning, and abide in a secret place, and hide yourself. 1 Samuel 19:2

You daughters of Israel, weep over Saul, who clothed you in scarlet, with other **delights**, who put on ornaments of gold upon your apparel. 2 Samuel 1:24

The king said unto Zadok, Carry back the Ark of God into the city: if I shall find favor in the eyes of the LORD, He will bring me again, and show me both it, and His habitation: But if He thus say, I have no **delight** in you; behold, here am I, let Him do to me as seems good unto Him. 2 Samuel 15:25-26

He brought me forth also into a large place: He delivered me, because He **delighted** in me. 2 Samuel 22:20

Joab said unto the king, Now the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God add unto the people, how many soever they be, an hundredfold, and that the eyes of my lord the king may see it: but why does my lord the king **delight** in this thing? 2 Samuel 24:3

Blessed be the LORD your God, which **delighted** in you, to set you on the throne of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore He made you king... 1 Kings 10:9

Blessed be the LORD your God, which **delighted** in you to set you on his throne, to be king for the LORD your God: because your God loved Israel, to establish them for ever, therefore He made you king over them, to do judgment and justice. 2 Chronicles 9:8

They took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so did they eat, and were filled, and became fat, and **delighted** themselves in Your great goodness. Nehemiah 9:25

So Haman came in. And the king said unto him, What shall be done unto the man whom the king **delights** to honor? Now Haman thought in his heart, To whom would the king delight to do honor more than to myself? And Haman answered the king, For the man whom the king **delights** to honor...Let this apparel and horse be delivered to the hand of one of the king's most noble princes, that they may array the man withal whom the king **delights** to honor, and bring him on horseback through the street of the city, and proclaim before him, Thus shall it be done to the man whom the king **delights** to honor...Esther 6:6-9

If you return to the Almighty, you shall be built up, you shall put away iniquity far from your tabernacles...Yes, the Almighty shall be your defense, and you shall have plenty of silver. For then shall you have your **delight** in the Almighty, and shall lift up your face unto God. Job 22:23, 25-26

Will God hear his cry when trouble comes upon him? Will he **delight** himself in the Almighty? Will he always call upon God? I will teach you by the hand of God: that which is with the Almighty will I not conceal. Job 27:9-11

What man is like Job...Which goes in company with the workers of iniquity, and walks with wicked men for he has said, It profits a man nothing that he should **delight** himself with God. [Lie] Job 34:8-9

Blessed is the man that walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful. But his **delight** is in the law of the LORD [YEHOVAH]; and in His law does he meditate day and night. Psalm 1:1-2

O my soul, you have said unto the LORD, You are my Lord: my goodness extends not to you; but to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all My **delight**. Ps 16:2-3

He brought me forth also into a large place; He delivered me, because He **delighted** in me. Psalm 18:19

He trusted on the LORD that He would deliver him: let Him deliver him, seeing He **delighted** in him. Psalm 22:8

Delight yourself also in the LORD [YEHOVAH]; and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Psalm 37:4

Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not yourself in any wise to do evil. For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth. For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be; yes, you shall diligently consider His place, and it shall not be. But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall **delight** themselves in the abundance of peace. Ps 37:8-11

The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD: and he **delights** in His way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the LORD upholds him with His hand. Psalm 37:23-24

For you desire not sacrifice; else would I give it: you **delight** not in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise. Psalm 51:16-17

They only consult to cast Him down from His excellency: they **delight** in lies: they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah. Psalm 62:4

Rebuke the company of spearmen, the multitude of the bulls, with the calves of the people, till every one submit himself with pieces of silver: scatter the people that **delight** in war. Psalm 68:30

In the multitude of my thoughts within me Your comforts **delight** my soul. Psalm 94:19

As he loved cursing, so let it come unto him: as he **delighted** not in blessing, so let it be far from him. Psalm 109:17

Praise you the LORD. Blessed is the man that fears the LORD, that **delights** greatly in His commandments. Psalm 112:1

I will **delight** myself in Your statutes: I will not forget Your word...Your testimonies also are my **delight** and my counselors. Psalm 119:16, 24

Make me to go in the path of Your commandments; for therein do I **delight**...Let Your tender mercies come unto me, that I may live: for Your law is my **delight**...Unless Your law had been my **delights**, I should then have perished in mine affliction. Psalm 119:35, 77, 92

How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? And the scorners **delight** in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge? Proverbs 1:22

My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD [YEHOVAH]; neither be weary of His correction. For whom the LORD loves He corrects; even as a father the son in whom he **delights**. Proverbs 3:11-12

Of wisdom...I was by him, as one brought up with him: and I was daily his **delight**, rejoicing always before him; rejoicing in the habitable part of his earth; and my **delights** were with the sons of men. Proverbs 8:30-31

A false balance is abomination to the LORD: but a just weight is His **delight**. Proverbs 11:1

They that are of a froward heart are abomination to the LORD: but such as are upright in their way are His **delight**. Proverbs 11:20

Lying lips are abomination to the LORD: but they that deal truly are His **delight**. Proverbs 12:22

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is His **delight**. Proverbs 15:8

Righteous lips are the **delight** of kings; and they love him that speaks right. Proverbs 16:13

A fool has no **delight** in understanding, but that his heart may discover itself...**Delight** is not seemly for a fool; much less for a servant to have rule over princes. Proverbs 18:2; 19:10

He that says unto the wicked, You are righteous; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him: But to them that rebuke him shall be **delight**, and a good blessing shall come upon them. Proverbs 24:24-25

I gathered me also silver and gold, and the peculiar treasure of kings and of the provinces: I gat me men singers and women singers, and the **delights** of the sons of men, as musical instruments, and that of all sort. Ecclesiastes 2:8

How fair and how pleasant are you, O love, for **delights**! Song of Solomon 7:6

To what purpose is the multitude of your sacrifices unto me? Says the LORD: I am full of the burnt offerings of rams, and the fat of fed beasts; and I **delight** not in the blood of bullocks, or of lambs, or of he goats... Isaiah 1:11

Behold, I will stir up the Medes against them, which shall not regard silver; and as for gold, they shall not **delight** in it. Isaiah 13:17

Behold My servant, whom I uphold; My elect, in whom My soul **delights**; I have put My spirit upon Him; He shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. Isaiah 42:1

Ho, every one that thirsts, come you to the waters, and he that has no money; come you, buy, and eat; yes, come, buy wine and milk without money and without price. Wherefore do you spend money for that which is not bread? And your labor for that which satisfies not? Hearken diligently unto Me, and eat that which is good, and let your soul **delight** itself in fatness. Isaiah 55:1-2

Yet they seek Me daily, and **delight** to know My ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of me the ordinances of justice; they take **delight** in approaching to God. Isaiah 58:2

If you turn away your foot from the sabbath, from doing your pleasure on My holy day; and call the sabbath a **delight**, the holy of the LORD, honorable; and shall honor Him, not doing your own ways, nor finding your own pleasure, nor speaking your own words: Then shall you **delight** yourself in the LORD; and I will cause you to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father: for the mouth of the LORD [YEHOVAH] has spoken it. Isaiah 58:13-14

You shall also be a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD [YEHOVAH], and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. You shall no more be termed Forsaken; neither shall your land any more be termed Desolate: but you shall be called Hephzibah, and your land Beulah: for the LORD **delights** in you, and your land shall be married. Isaiah 62:3-4

Therefore will I number you to the sword, and you shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, you did not answer; when I spake, you did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose that wherein I **delighted** not. Isaiah 65:12

He that kills an ox is as if he slew a man; he that sacrifices a lamb, as if he cut off a dog's neck; he that offers an oblation, as if he offered swine's blood; he that burns incense, as if he blessed an idol. Yes, they have chosen their own ways, and their soul delights in their abominations. I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spoke, they did not hear: but they did evil before My eyes, and chose that in which I **delight** not. Isaiah 66:3-4

Rejoice you with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you that love her: rejoice for joy with her, all you that mourn for her: that you may suck, and be satisfied with the breasts of her consolations; that you may milk out, and be **delighted** with the abundance of her glory. Isaiah 66:10-11

Behold, their ear is uncircumcised, and they cannot hearken: behold, the word of the LORD is unto them a reproach; they have no **delight** in it. Jeremiah 6:10

Thus says the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD [YEHOVAH] which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I **delight**, says the LORD. Jer 9:23-24

Who is a God like unto you, that pardons iniquity, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He retains not His anger for ever, because He **delights** in mercy. Micah 7:18 You have wearied the LORD [YEHOVAH] with your words. Yet you say, Wherein have we wearied Him? When you say, Every one that does evil is good in the sight of the LORD, and He **delights** in them; or Where is the God of judgment? Malachi 2:17

Behold, I will send My messenger, and he shall prepare the way before Me: and the Lord, whom you seek, shall suddenly come to His temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom you **delight** in: behold, He shall come, says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 3:1

And all nations shall call you blessed: for you shall be a **delightsome** land, says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 3:12

I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. For I **delight** in the law of God after the inward man: But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. O wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death? I thank God though Jesus Christ our Lord [Yeshua the Messiah]. So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God; but with the flesh the law of sin. Romans 7:21-25

GLADNESS

The anger of the LORD was kindled against Moses, and He said, Is not Aaron the Levite your brother? I know that he can speak well. And also, behold, he comes forth to meet you: and when he sees you, he will be **glad** in his heart. Exodus 4:14

Also in the day of your **gladness**, and in your solemn days, and in the beginnings of your months, you shall blow with the trumpets over your burnt offerings, and over the sacrifices of your peace offerings; that they may be to you for a memorial before your God: I am the LORD your God. Numbers 10:10

Because you served not the LORD your God with joyfulness, and with **gladness** of heart, for the abundance of things; Therefore shall you serve your enemies which the LORD shall send against you, in hunger, and in thirst, and in nakedness, and in want of all things... Deuteronomy 28:47-48

And the priest's heart was **glad**, and he took the ephod, and the teraphim, and the graven image, and went in the midst of the people. Judges 18:20

They said unto the messengers that came, Thus shall you say unto the men of Jabesh-gilead, To morrow, by that time the sun be hot, you shall have help. And the messengers came and showed it to the men of Jabesh; and they were **glad**. 1 Sam 11:9

It was told king David, saying, The LORD has blessed the house of Obed-edom, and all that pertains unto him, because of the Ark of God. So David went and brought up the Ark of God from the house of Obed-edom into the city of David with **gladness**. 2 Samuel 6:12

On the eighth day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents joyful and **glad** of heart for all the goodness that the LORD [YEHOVAH] had done for David His servant, and for Israel His people. 1 Kings 8:66

Glory and honor are in His presence; strength and **gladness** are in His place...Let the Heavens be **glad**, and let the Earth rejoice: and let men say among the nations, The LORD reigns. 1 Chr 16:27, 31

They sacrificed sacrifices unto the LORD...and did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great **gladness**. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed him unto the LORD to be the chief governor, and Zadok to be priest. 1 Chronicles 29:21-22

On the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, **glad** and merry in heart for the goodness that the LORD had shown unto David, and to Solomon, and to Israel His people. 2 Chronicles 7:10

Moreover Hezekiah the king and the princes commanded the Levites to sing praise unto the LORD...And they sang praises with **gladness**, and they bowed their heads and worshiped. 2 Chronicles 29:30

And the children of Israel that were present at Jerusalem kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with **great gladness**: and the Levites and the priests praised the LORD day by day, singing with loud instruments unto the LORD [YEHOVAH]...And the whole assembly took counsel to keep other seven days: and they kept other seven days with **gladness**. 2 Chronicles 30:21, 23

Then shall the land **enjoy** her sabbaths, as long as it lies desolate, and you be in your enemies' land; even then shall the land rest, and **enjoy** her sabbaths. The land also shall be left of them, and shall **enjoy** her sabbaths, while she lies desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because even because they despised My judgments, and because their soul abhorred My statutes. Leviticus 26:43

And every daughter, that possesses an inheritance in any tribe of the children of Israel, shall be wife unto one of the family of the tribe of her father, that the children of Israel may **enjoy** every man the inheritance of his fathers. Numbers 36:8

There you shall eat before the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God, and you shall **rejoice** in all that you put your hand unto, you and your households, wherein the LORD your God has blessed you. You shall not do after all the things that we do here this day, every man whatever is right in his own eyes. For you are not as yet come to the rest and to the inheritance, which the LORD your God gives you...And you shall **rejoice** before the LORD your God, you, and your sons, and your daughters, and your menservants, and your maidservants, and the Levite that is within your gates; forasmuch as he has no part nor inheritance with you... and you shall **rejoice** before the LORD your God in all that you put your hands unto Deuteronomy 12:7, 12,18

You shall bestow that money for whatsoever your soul lusts after, for oxen, or for sheep, or for wine, or for strong drink, or for whatsoever your soul desires: and you shall eat there before the LORD your God, and you shall **rejoice**, you, and your household... Deuteronomy 14:26

You shall **rejoice** before the LORD your God, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levite that is within your gates, and the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are among you, in the place which the LORD your God has chosen to place His name there. Deuteronomy 16:11

You shall **rejoice** in your feast, you, and your son, and your daughter, and your manservant, and your maidservant, and the Levites, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within your gates. Seven days shall you keep a solemn feast unto the LORD your God in the place which the LORD shall choose: because the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God shall bless you in all your increase, and in all the works of your hands, therefore you shall surely **rejoice**. Deuteronomy 16:14-15

And you shall **rejoice** in every good thing which the LORD your God has given unto you, and unto your house, you, and the Levites, and the stranger that is among you...You shall offer peace offerings, and shall eat there, and **rejoice** before the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 26:11, 27:7

You shall beget sons and daughters, but you shall not **enjoy** them; for they shall go into captivity...All these curses shall come upon you, and shall pursue you, and overtake you, till you be destroyed: because you hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD your God, to keep His commandments and His statutes which He commanded you...Because you served not the LORD your God with **joyfulness**, and with gladness of heart, for the abundance of all things... Deuteronomy 28:41, 45-47

The LORD your God will make you plenteous in every work of your hand, in the fruit of your body, and in the fruit of your cattle, and in the fruit of your land, for good: for the LORD will again **rejoice** over you for good, as He **rejoiced** over **your** fathers... **Rejoice**, O you nations, with His people: for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and will render vengeance to His adversaries, and will be merciful unto His land, and to His people. Deuteronomy 30:9, 32:43

Of Zebulun he said, **Rejoice**, Zebulun, in your going out; and, Issachar, in your tents. Deuteronomy 33:18

You shall pass before your brethren armed, all the mighty men of valor, and help them; Until the LORD have given your brethren rest, as He has given you, and they also have possessed the land which the LORD your God gives them: then you shall return unto the land of your possession, and **enjoy** it. Joshua 1:14-15

Hannah prayed, and said, My heart **rejoices** in the LORD, my horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I **rejoice** in Your salvation. 1 Samuel 2:1

They of Beth-shemesh were reaping their wheat harvest in the valley: and they lifted up their eyes, and saw the ark, and **rejoiced** to see it. 1 Samuel 6:13

It came to pass as they came, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women came out of all cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet king Saul, with tabrets, with **joy**, and with instruments of music. 1 Samuel 18:6

For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: you saw it, and did **rejoice**: wherefore then will you sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause? 1 Samuel 19:5

All the people came up after him, and the people piped with pipes, and **rejoiced** with great **joy**, so that the earth rent with the sound of them...And Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet have anointed him king in Gihon: and they are come up from thence **rejoicing**, so that the city rang again. This is the noise that you have heard. 1 Kings 1:40, 45

It came to pass, when Hiram heard the words of Solomon, that he **rejoiced** greatly, and said, Blessed be the LORD this day, which has given unto David a wise son over this great people. 1 Kings 5:7

He sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents **joyful** and glad of heart for all the goodness that the LORD [YEHOVAH] had done for David His servant, and for Israel His people. 1 Kings 8:66

All the people of the land **rejoiced**, and the city was in quiet: and they slew Athaliah with the sword... 2 Kings 11:20

Moreover they that were nigh them, even unto Issachar and Zebulun and Naphtali, brought bread on asses, and on camels, and on mules, and on oxen, and meat, meal, cakes of figs, and bunches of raisins, and wine, and oil, and oxen, and sheep abundantly: for there was joy in Israel. 1 Chronicles 12:40

David spake to the chief of the Levites to appoint their brethren to be the singers with instruments of music, psalteries and harps and cymbals, sounding, by lifting up the voice with **joy**. 1 Chr 15:16

So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD [out of the house of Obed-edom with **joy**. 1 Chronicles 15:25

Glory you in His holy name: let the heart of them **rejoice** that seek the LORD [YEHOVAH]. 1 Chronicles 16:10

Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth **rejoice** that seek the LORD. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields **rejoice**, and all that is therein. 1 Chronicles 16:31-32

I know also, my God, that You try the heart, and have pleasure in uprightness. As for me, in the uprightness of my heart I have willingly offered all these things: and now have I seen with **joy** Your people, which are present here, to offer willingly unto You...Then the people **rejoiced**, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also **rejoiced** with great **joy**. 1 Chronicles 29:7, 9

Arise, O LORD God, into Your resting place, You, and the ark of Your strength: let Your priests, O Lord, be clothed with salvation, and let Your saints **rejoice** in goodness. 2 Chronicles 6:41

All Judah **rejoiced** at the oath: for they had sworn with all their heart, and sought Him with their whole desire; and He was found of them: and the LORD gave them rest round about. 2 Chr 15:15

They returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with **joy**; for the LORD had made them to **rejoice** over their enemies. 2 Chronicles 20:27

Also Jehoiada appointed the offices of the house of the LORD by the hand of the priests the Levites, whom David had distributed in the house of the LORD, to offer the burnt offerings of the LORD, as it is written in the law of Moses, with **rejoicing** and with singing, as it was ordained by David. 2 Chronicles 23:18

All the princes and all the people **rejoiced**, and brought in, and cast into the chest, until they had made an end. 2 Chr 24:10

Hezekiah **rejoiced**, and all the people, that God had prepared the people: for the thing was done suddenly. 2 Chronicles 29:36

All the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, **rejoiced**. There was great **joy** in Jerusalem: for since the time of Solomon the son of David king of Israel there was not the like in Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 30:25-26

Many of the priests and Levites and chief of the fathers, who were ancient men, that had seen the first house, when the foundation of this house was laid before their eyes, wept with a loud voice; and many shouted aloud for **joy**: So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of **joy** from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off. Ezra 3:12-13

The children of Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the rest of the captivity, kept the dedication of this house of God with **joy**... The children of Israel...kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with **joy**: for the LORD had made them **joyful**, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to strengthen their hands in the work of the house of God... Ezra 6:16, 21-22

Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be you sorry; for the **joy** of the LORD is your strength...Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and **rejoiced**: for God had made them **rejoice** with great **joy**: the wives also and the children **rejoiced**: so that the **joy** of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 8:10, 12:43

And at that time were some appointed over the chambers for the treasures, for the offerings, for the firstfruits, and for the tithes, to gather into them out of the fields of the cities the portions of the law for the priests and Levites: for Judah **rejoiced** for the priests and for the Levites that waited. Nehemiah 12:44

Then went Haman forth that day **joyful** and with a glad heart: but when Haman saw Mordecai in the king's gate, that he stood not up, nor moved for him, he was full of indignation against Mordecai. Esther 5:9

And Mordecai went out from the presence of the king in royal apparel of blue and white, and with a great crown of gold, and with a garment of fine linen and purple: and the city of Shushan **rejoiced** and was glad. The Jews had light, and gladness, and **joy**, and honor. And in every province, and in every city, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, the Jews had **joy** and gladness, a feast and a good day. Esther 8:15-17

As the days wherein the Jews rested from their enemies, and the month which was turned unto them from sorrow to **joy**, and from mourning into a good day: that they should make them days of feasting and **joy**, and of sending portions one to another, and gifts to the poor. Esther 9:22

They take the timbrel and harp, and **rejoice** at the sound of the organ. Job 21:12

The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for **joy**. Job 29:13

He shall pray unto God, and He will be favorable unto him: and he shall see His face with **joy**: for He will render unto man his righteousness. Job 33:26

Where were you...when the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for **joy**? Job 38:4, 7

Have you given the horse strength?...He paws in the valley, and **rejoices** in his strength... Job 39:21

In his neck remains strength, and sorrow is turned into **joy** before him. Job 41:22

Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling. Ps 2:11

Let all those that put their trust in you **rejoice**: let them ever shout for **joy**, because you defend them: let them also that love Your name be **joyful** in you. Psalm 5:11

I will be glad and **rejoice** in You: I will sing praise to Your name, O most High. Psalm 9:2

Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that hate me, You that lift me up from the snares of death: That I may show forth all Your praise in the gates of the daughter of Zion: I will **rejoice** in Your salvation. Psalm 9:13-14

Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten my eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death; Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that trouble me **rejoice** when I am moved. But I have trusted in Your mercy; my heart shall **rejoice** in Your salvation. Psalm 13:3-5

Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory **rejoices**: my flesh also shall rest in hope. For You will not leave my soul in hell; neither will you suffer Your Holy One to see corruption. You will shew me the path of life: in Your presence is fulness of **joy**; at Your right hand there are pleasures for evermore. Psalm 16:9-11

Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD [YEHOVAH] brings back the captivity of His people, Jacob shall **rejoice**, and Israel shall be glad. Psalm 14:7

The Heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His handiwork...In them has He set a tabernacle for the sun, which is as a bridegroom coming out of His chamber, and **rejoices** as a strong man to run a race. Psalm 19:1, 4-5

The statutes of the LORD are right, **rejoicing** the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes... We will **rejoice** in Your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all your petitions. Psalm 19:8, 20:5

The king shall **joy** in Your strength, O LORD [YEHOVAH]; and in Your salvation how greatly shall he **rejoice!** Psalm 21:1

Now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in His tabernacles sacrifices of **joy**; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises unto the LORD. Psalm 27:6

I will extol You, O LORD [YEHOVAH]; for You have lifted me up, and have not made my foes to **rejoice** over me. Psalm 30:1

For His anger endures but a moment; in His favor is life: weeping may endure for a night, but **joy** comes in the morning. Psalm 30:5

I will be glad and **rejoice** in Your mercy: for You have considered my trouble; You have known my soul in adversities... Psalm 31:7

Be glad in the LORD, and **rejoice**, you righteous: and shout for **joy**, all you that are upright in heart. Psalm 32:11

Rejoice in the LORD, O you righteous: for praise is comely for the upright. Psalm 33:1

For our heart shall **rejoice** in Him, because we have trusted in His holy name. Psalm 33:21

My soul shall be **joyful** in the LORD: it shall **rejoice** in His salvation. Psalm 35:9

Let not them that are mine enemies wrongfully **rejoice** over me: neither let them wink with the eye that hate me without a cause. For I said, Hear me, lest otherwise they should **rejoice** over me: when my foot slips, they magnify themselves against me... Psalm 35:19, 38:16

Judge me, O LORD my God, according to Your righteousness; and let them not **rejoice** over me...Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that **rejoice** at my hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonor that magnify themselves against me. Let them shout for **joy**, and be glad, that favor my righteous cause: yes, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. And my tongue shall speak of Your righteousness and of Your praise all the day long...Let all those that seek You **rejoice** and be glad in You: let such as love Your salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified. Psalm 35:24, 26-28, 40:16

When I remember these things, I pour out my soul in me: for I had gone with the multitude, I went with them to the house of God, with the voice of **joy** and praise, with a multitude that kept holyday...Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding **joy**: yes, upon the harp will I praise Thee, O God my God. Psalm 42:4, 43:4

With gladness and **rejoicing** shall they be brought: they shall enter into the king's palace. Psalm 45:15

My soul shall be satisfied as with marrow and fatness; and my mouth shall praise you with **joyful** lips: When I remember You upon my bed, and meditate on You in the night watches. Because You have been my help, therefore in the shadow of Your wings will I **rejoice**. Psalm 63:5-7

The king shall **rejoice** in God; every one that swears by Him shall glory... Psalm 63:11

You make the outgoings of the morning and evening to **rejoice**. You visit the earth, and water it: you greatly enrich it with the river of God, which is full of water...The little hills **rejoice** on every side. The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for **joy**...Psalm 65:8-9, 12-13

Make a **joyful** noise unto God, all you lands... Psalm 66:1

He turned the sea into dry land: they went through the flood on foot: there did we **rejoice** in Him. Psalm 66:6

O let the nations be glad and sing for **joy**: for You shall judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon the earth. Selah. Psalm 67:4

Let the righteous be glad; let them **rejoice** before God: yes, let them exceedingly **rejoice**. Sing unto God, sing praises to His name: extol Him that rides upon the heavens by His name YAH, and **rejoice** before Him. Psalm 68:3-4

Let all those that seek You **rejoice** and be glad in You: and let such as love Your salvation say continually, Let God be magnified... My lips shall greatly **rejoice** when I sing unto You; and my soul, which You have redeemed. Psalm 70:4, 71:23

Sing aloud unto God our strength: make a **joyful noise** unto the God of Jacob. Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery. Psalm 81:1-2

Will you not revive us again: that Your people may **rejoice** in You? Psalm 85:6

Rejoice the soul of Your servant: for unto You, O Lord, do I lift up my soul. Psalm 86:4

The north and the south You have created them: Tabor and Hermon shall **rejoice** in Your name. Psalm 89:12

Blessed is the people that know **the joyful sound**: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of Your countenance. In Your name shall they **rejoice** all the day: and in Your righteousness shall they be exalted. Psalm 89:15-16

Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah **rejoiced** because of Your judgments, O LORD. Psalm 97:8

Rejoice in the LORD [YEHOVAH], you righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of His holiness. Psalm 97:12

Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise. Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm. With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King. Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be joyful together before the LORD; for He comes to judge the earth: with righteousness shall He judge the world, and the people with equity. Psalm 98:4-9

Make a joyful noise unto the LORD], all you lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before His presence with singing...Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His name. Psalm 100:1-2, 4

The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever: the LORD shall **rejoice** in His works. Psalm 104:31

Glory you in His holy name: let the heart of them **rejoice** that seek the LORD...He brought forth His people with **joy**, and His chosen with gladness... Psalm 105:3, 43

Remember me, O LORD, with the favor that you bear unto Your people: O visit me with Your salvation; that I may see the good of Your chosen, that I may **rejoice** in the gladness of Your nation, that I may glory with Your inheritance. Psalm106:4-5

Yet sets He the poor on high from affliction, and makes him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and **rejoice**: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Psalm 107:42

Let them curse, but bless you: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let Your servant **rejoice**. Psalm 109:28

He makes the barren woman to keep house, and to be a **joyful** mother of children. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 113:9

The voice of **rejoicing** and salvation is in the tabernacles of the righteous...This is the day which the LORD [YEHOVAH] has made; we will **rejoice** and be glad in it. Psalm 118:15, 24

I **rejoice** at Your word, as one that finds great spoil. Psalm 119:162

They that sow in tears shall reap in **joy**. He that goes forth and weeps, bearing precious seed, shall doubtless come again with **rejoicing**, bringing his sheaves with him. Psalm 126:5-6

Let your priests be clothed with righteousness; and let your saints shout for **joy**...I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for **joy**...If I do not remember You, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief **joy**. Psalm 132:9, 16, 137:6

Let Israel **rejoice** in Him that made him: let the children of Zion **be joyful** in their King. Let them praise His name in the dance: let them sing praises unto Him with timbrel and harp. For the LORD takes pleasure in His people: He will beautify the meek with salvation. Let the saints be **joyful** in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds. Psalm 149:2-5

Let your fountain be blessed: and **rejoice** with the wife of your youth. Proverbs 5:18

As one brought up with him: and I was daily his delight, **rejoicing** always before him; **Rejoicing** in the habitable part of His earth; and my delights were with the sons of men. Proverbs 8:30-31

Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counselors of peace is **joy**. Proverbs 12:20

When it goes well with the righteous, the city **rejoices**: and when the wicked perish, there is shouting. Proverbs 11:10

The light of the righteous **rejoices**: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out. Proverbs 13:9

The heart knows his own bitterness; and a stranger does not intermeddle with his **joy**. Proverbs 14:10

Folly is **joy** to him that is destitute of wisdom: but a man of understanding walks uprightly. Proverbs 15:21

A man has **joy** by the answer of his mouth: and a word spoken in due season, how good it is! Proverbs 15:23

The light of the eyes **rejoices** the heart: and a good report makes the bones fat. Proverbs 15:30

He that begets a fool does it to his sorrow: and the father of a fool has no **joy**. Proverbs 17:21

It is **joy** to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 21:15

My son, if your heart be wise, my heart shall **rejoice**, even mine. Yes, my reins shall **rejoice**, when your lips speak right things. Proverbs 23:15-16

The father of the righteous shall greatly **rejoice**: and he that begets a wise child shall have **joy** of him. Your father and your mother shall be glad, and she that bare you shall **rejoice**. Pro 23:24-25

Rejoice not when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he stumbles... Proverbs 24:17

Ointment and perfume **rejoice** the heart: so does the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel. Proverbs 27:9

When righteous men do **rejoice**, there is great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden. Proverbs 28:12

When the righteous are in authority, the people **rejoice**: but when the wicked bear rule, the people mourn. Whoso loves wisdom **rejoices** his father: but he that keeps company with harlots spends his substance. Proverbs 29:2-3

In the transgression of an evil man there is a snare: but the righteous does sing and **rejoice**. Proverbs 29:6

Strength and honor are her clothing; and she shall **rejoice** in time to come. Proverbs 31:25

I said in my heart, Go to now, I will prove you with mirth, therefore **enjoy** pleasure: and, behold, this also is vanity... Whatsoever my eyes desired I kept not from them, I withheld not my heart from any **joy**; for my heart **rejoiced** in all my labor: and this was my portion of all my labor. Ecclesiastes 2:1, 10

There is nothing better for a man, than that he should eat and drink, and that he should make his soul **enjoy** good in his labor. This also I saw, that it was from the hand of God. Eccl 2:24

For God gives to a man that is good in His sight wisdom, and knowledge, and **joy**: but to the sinner He gives travail, to gather and to heap up, that He may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 2:26

I know that there is no good in them, but for a man to **rejoice**, and to do good in his life. And also that every man should eat and drink, and **enjoy** the good of all his labor, it is the gift of God. Ecclesiastes 3:12-13

I perceive that there is nothing better, than that a man should **rejoice** in his own works; for that is his portion: for who shall bring him to see what shall be after him? Ecclesiastes 3:22

Behold that which I have seen: it is good and comely for one to eat and to drink, and to **enjoy** the good of all his labor that he takes under the sun all the days of his life, which God gives him: for it is his portion. Every man also to whom God has given riches and wealth, and has given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion, and to **rejoice** in his labor; this is the gift of God. For he shall not much remember the days of his life; because God answers him in the **joy** of his heart. Ecclesiastes 5:18-20

In the day of prosperity be **joyful**, but in the day of adversity consider: God also has set the one over against the other to the end that man should find nothing after Him. Ecclesiastes 7:14

Go your way, eat your bread with **joy**, and drink your wine with a merry heart; for God now accepts your works. Ecclesiastes 9:7

Live **joyfully** with the wife whom you love all the days of the life of your vanity, which He has given you under the sun, all the days of your vanity: for that is your portion in this life, and in your labor which you take under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:9

If a man live many years, and **rejoice** in them all; yet let him remember the days of darkness; for they shall be many. **Rejoice**, O young man, in your youth; and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth, and walk in the ways of your heart, and in the sight of your eyes: but know you, that for all these things God will bring you into judgment. Ecclesiastes 11:8-9

Draw me, we will run after you: the king has brought me into his chambers: we will be glad and **rejoice** in you, we will remember your love more than wine: the upright love you. Song of Solomon 1:4

You have multiplied the nation, and not increased the **joy**: they **joy** before You according to the **joy** in harvest, and as men **rejoice** when they divide the spoil. Isaiah 9:3

Therefore the Lord shall have no **joy** in their young men, neither shall have mercy on their fatherless and widows: for every one is an hypocrite and an evildoer, and every mouth speaks folly. Isaiah 9:17

Therefore with **joy** shall you draw water out of the wells of salvation...Cry out and shout, you inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of You. Isaiah 12:3,6

Therefore I will bewail with the weeping of Jazer the vine of Sibmah: I will water you with my tears, O Heshbon, and Elealeh: for the shouting for your summer fruits and for your harvest is fallen. Gladness is taken away, and **joy** out of the plentiful field; and in the vineyards there shall be no singing, neither shall there be shouting: the treaders shall tread out no wine in their presses; I have made their vintage shouting to cease. Wherefore my bowels shall sound like an harp for Moab, and my inward parts for Kir-haresh. Isaiah 16:9-11

In that day did the Lord GOD of hosts call to weeping, and to mourning, and to baldness, and to girding with sackcloth: and behold **joy** and gladness, slaying oxen, and killing sheep, eating flesh, and drinking wine: let us eat and drink; for tomorrow we shall die...The mirth of tabrets ceases, the noise of them that **rejoice** ends, the **joy** of the harp ceases...There is a crying for wine in the streets; all **joy** is darkened, the mirth of the land is gone. Isaiah 22:12-13, 24:8, 11

It shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will save us: this is the LORD; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and **rejoice** in His salvation. Isaiah 25:9

The meek also shall increase their **joy** in the LORD, and the poor among men shall **rejoice** in the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 29:19

The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall **rejoice**, and blossom as the rose. It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with **joy** and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it...they shall see the glory of the LORD, and the excellency of our God. Isaiah 35:1-2

The ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to Zion with songs and everlasting **joy** upon their heads: they shall obtain **joy** and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away. Isaiah 35:10

You shall fan them, and the wind shall carry them away, and the whirlwind shall scatter them: and you shall **rejoice** in the LORD, and shall glory in the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 41:16

Sing, O Heavens; and **be joyful**, O Earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD [YEHOVAH] has comforted His people, and will have mercy upon His afflicted. Isaiah 49:13

The LORD shall comfort Zion: He will comfort all her waste places; and He will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; **joy** and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody... Therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall return, and come with singing unto Zion; and everlasting **joy** shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and **joy**; and sorrow and mourning shall flee away. Isaiah 51:3, 11

Break forth into **joy**, sing together, you waste places of Jerusalem: for the LORD has comforted His people, He has redeemed Jerusalem. Isaiah 52:9

For you shall go out with **joy**, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. Isaiah 55:12

Even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them **joyful** in My house of prayer: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon Mine altar; for Mine house shall be called an house of prayer for all people. Isaiah 56:7

Whereas you have been forsaken and hated, so that no man went through you, I will make you an eternal excellency, a **joy** of many generations. Isaiah 60:15

To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of **joy** for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified...For your shame you shall have double; and for confusion they shall **rejoice** in their portion: therefore in their land they shall possess the double: everlasting **joy** shall be unto them. Isaiah 61:3, 7

I will greatly **rejoice** in the LORD [YEHOVAH], my soul shall be **joyful** in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels...For as a young man marries a virgin, so shall your sons marry you: and as the bridegroom **rejoices** over the bride, so shall your God **rejoice** over you. Isaiah 61:10,62:5

My servants shall sing for **joy** of heart, but you shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of spirit. Isaiah 65:14

But be you glad and **rejoice** for ever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a **rejoicing**, and her people a **joy**. And I will **rejoice** in Jerusalem, and **joy** in My people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying. Isaiah 65:18-19

They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of My people, and My elect shall long **enjoy** the work of their hands. Isaiah 65:22

Hear the word of the LORD [YEHOVAH], you that tremble at His word; Your brethren that hated you, that cast you out for My name's sake, said, Let the LORD be glorified: but He shall appear to your **joy**, and they shall be ashamed. Isaiah 66:5

Rejoice you with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you that love her: **rejoice for joy** with her, all you that mourn for her. When you see this, your heart shall **rejoice**, and your bones shall flourish like an herb: and the hand of the LORD shall be known toward His servants, and His indignation toward His enemies. Is 66:10, 14

Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and Your word was unto me the joy and **rejoicing** of mine heart: for I am called by Your name, O LORD God [YEHOVAH] of hosts...I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor **rejoiced**; I sat alone because of Your hand: for You have filled me with indignation. Jeremiah 15:16-17

For thus says the LORD; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and **shout** among the chief of the nations; publish you, praise you, and say, O LORD, save Your people, the remnant of Israel...Then shall the virgin **rejoice** in the dance, both young men and old together: for I will turn their mourning into **joy**, and will comfort them, and make them **rejoice** from their sorrow. Jeremiah 31:7, 13

Yes, I will **rejoice** over them to do them good, and I will plant them in this land assuredly with My whole heart and with My whole soul. Jeremiah 32:41

It shall be to me a name of **joy**, a praise and an honor before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall fear and tremble for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it. Thus says the LORD [YEHOVAH]; Again there shall be heard in this place, which you say shall be desolate without man and without beast, even in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, that are desolate, without man, and without inhabitant, and without beast. Jeremiah 33:9-10

The voice of **joy**, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of hosts: for the LORD is good; for His mercy endures for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first.. Jer 33:9-11

For was not Israel a derision unto you? was he found among thieves? for since you spoke of him, you skipped for **joy**... **Joy** and gladness is taken from the plentiful field, and from the land of Moab... Jeremiah 48:27

All that pass by clap their hands at you; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying, Is this the city that men call The perfection of beauty, The **joy** of the whole earth? ... The **joy** of our heart is ceased; our dance is turned into mourning. Lamentations 2:15, 5:15

Also, you son of man, shall it not be in the day when I take from them their strength, the **joy** of their glory, the desire of their eyes, and that whereupon they set their minds, their sons and their daughters, that he that escapes in that day shall come unto you, to cause you to hear it with your ears? In that day shall your mouth be opened...Ezekiel 24:25-27

Thus says the Lord GOD; when the whole earth **rejoices**, I will make you desolate...Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Surely in the fire of My jealousy have I spoken against the residue of the heathen, and against all Idumea, which have appointed My land into their possession with the **joy** of all their heart, with despiteful minds, to cast it out for a prey. Ezekiel 35:14, 36:5

Rejoice not, O Israel, for **joy**, as other people: for you have gone a whoring from your God, you have loved a reward upon every cornfloor. Hosea 9:1

The vine is dried up, and the fig tree languishes; the pomegranate tree, the palm tree also, and the apple tree, even all the trees of the field, are withered: because **joy** is withered away from the sons of men.. Is not the meat cut off before our eyes, yes, **joy** and gladness from the house of our God? Joel 1:12, 16

Fear not, O land; be glad and **rejoice**: for the LORD will do great things...Be glad then, you children of Zion, and **rejoice** in the LORD your God [YEHOVAH]: for He has given you the former rain moderately, and He will cause to come down for you the rain, the former rain, and the latter rain in the first month. Joel 2:21, 23

You should not have looked on the day of your brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither should you have **rejoiced** over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither should you have spoken proudly in the day of distress. Obadiah 1:12

Rejoice not against me, O my enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a light unto me. Micah 7:8

Though the fig tree shall not blossom, neither shall fruit be in the vines; the labor of the olive shall fail, and the fields shall yield no meat...Yet I will **rejoice** in the LORD, I will **joy** in the God of my salvation. Habakkuk 3:17-18

For then I will take away out of the midst of you them that **rejoice** in your pride, and you shall no more be haughty because of My holy mountain...Sing, O daughter of Zion; shout, O Israel; be glad and **rejoice** with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem...The LORD your God in the midst of you is mighty; He will save, He will **rejoice** over you with **joy**; he will rest in His love, He will **joy** over you with singing. Zeph 3:11, 14, 17

Sing and **rejoice**, O daughter of Zion: for, lo, I come, and I will dwell in the midst of you, says the LORD. And many nations shall be joined to the LORD in that day, and shall be My people; and I will dwell in the midst of you, and you shall know that the LORD of hosts has sent me unto you. And the LORD shall inherit Judah His portion in the holy land, and shall choose Jerusalem again. Zechariah 2:10-11

For who has despised the day of small things? for they shall **rejoice**, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth. Zechariah 4:10

Thus says the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah **joy** and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the truth and peace. Zechariah 8:19

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; **shout**, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes unto you: He is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. Zechariah 9:9

They of Ephraim shall be like a mighty man, and their heart shall **rejoice** as through wine: yes, their children shall see it, and be glad; their heart shall **rejoice** in the LORD. Zechariah 10:7

When they saw the star, they **rejoiced** with exceeding great **joy**. Matthew 2:10

Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great is your reward in Heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you. Matthew 5:12

He that received the seed into stony places, the same is he that hears the word, and anon with **joy** receives it... Matthew 13:20

Again, the Kingdom of Heaven is like unto treasure hid in a field; the which when a man has found, he hides, and for **joy** thereof goes and sells all that he has, and buys that field. Matthew 13:44

If so be that he find it, verily I say unto you, he **rejoices** more of that sheep, than of the ninety and nine which went not astray. Matthew 18:13

His lord said unto him, Well done, you good and faithful servant: you have been faithful over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things: enter you into the **joy** of your lord. Matthew 25:21

They departed quickly from the sepulcher with fear and great **joy**; and did run to bring His disciples word. Matthew 28:4

You shall have **joy** and gladness; and many shall **rejoice** at his birth...For, lo, as soon as the voice of your salutation sounded in mine ears, the babe leaped in my womb for **joy**. Luke 1:14, 44

My spirit has **rejoiced** in God my Savior. Luke 1:47

The angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great **joy**, which shall be to all people. Luke 2:10

Blessed are you, when men shall hate you, and when they shall separate you from their company, and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake. **Rejoice** you in that day, and leap for **joy**: for, behold, your reward is great in Heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets. Luke 6:22-23

They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with **joy**; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. Luke 8:13

The seventy returned again with **joy**, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Your name. Luke 10:17

Jesus **rejoiced** in spirit, and said, I thank you, O Father, Lord of Heaven and Earth, that you have hid these things from the wise and prudent, and have revealed them unto babes...Luke 10:21

When He had said these things, all His adversaries were ashamed: and all the people **rejoiced** for all the glorious things that were done by Him. Luke 13:17

What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose one of them, does not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness and go after that which is lost, until he find it? When he has found it, he lays it on his shoulders, **rejoicing.** And when he comes home, he calls together his friends and neighbors, saying unto them, **Rejoice** with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost. I say unto you, that likewise **joy** shall be in heaven over one sinner that repents, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance... When she has found it, she calls her friends and her neighbors together, saying, **Rejoice** with me; for I have found the piece which I lost. Likewise, I say unto you, there is **joy** in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repents. Luke 15:4-7, 9-10

He made haste, and came down, and received Him **joyfully**. Luke 19:6

When He was come nigh... the whole multitude of the disciples began to **rejoice** and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen... Luke 19:37

While they believed not for **joy**, and wondered, He said unto them, Have you here any meat?...They worshiped Him, and returned to Jerusalem with great **joy**... Luke 24:41, 52

The friend of the bridegroom, which stands and hears him, **rejoices** greatly because of the bridegroom's voice: this my **joy** therefore is fulfilled. John 3:29

Lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest. And he that reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit unto life eternal: that both he that sows and he that reaps may **rejoice** together. John 4:35-36

He was a burning and a shining light: and you were willing for a season to **rejoice** in his light. John 5:35

Your father Abraham **rejoiced** to see My day: and he saw it, and was glad. John 8:56

You have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If you loved Me, you would **rejoice**, because I said, I go unto the Father: for My Father is greater than I. John 14:28

These things have I spoken unto you, that My **joy** might remain in you, and that your **joy** might be full. This is My commandment, That you love one another, as I have loved you. John 15:11-12

Verily, verily, I say unto you, That you shall weep and lament, but the world shall **rejoice**: and you shall be sorrowful, but your sorrow shall be turned into **joy**. A woman when she is in travail has sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembers no more the anguish, for **joy** that a man is born into the world. And you now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall **rejoice**, and your **joy** no man takes from you. John 16:20-22

I say unto you, whatsoever you shall ask the Father in My name, He will give it you. Hitherto have you asked nothing in My name: ask, and you shall receive, that your **joy** may be full... Jn 16:23-24

Now come I to you; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my **joy** fulfilled in themselves. John 17:13

For David speaks concerning Him...Therefore did my heart **rejoice**, and my tongue was **glad**; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope: You have made known to me the ways of life; You shall make me full of **joy** with Your countenance. Acts 2:25, 28

There was great joy in that city. Acts 8:8

The disciples were filled with **joy**, and with the Holy Ghost. Acts 13:52

Being brought on their way by the church, they passed through Phenice and Samaria, declaring the conversion of the Gentiles: and they caused great **joy**...When they had gathered the multitude together, they delivered the epistle: which when they had read, they **rejoiced** for the consolation. Acts 15:3, 30-31

None of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with **joy**, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God. Acts 20:24

Tertullus began to accuse him, saying, Seeing that by you we **enjoy** great quietness... Acts 24:2

By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and **rejoice** in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:2

For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. And not only so, but we also **joy** in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom we have now received the atonement. Romans 5:10-11

Fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; **Rejoicing** in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer... Romans 12:12

For the Kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and **joy** in the Holy Ghost. Romans 14:17

Again he said, **Rejoice**, you Gentiles, with His people. Romans 15:10

Now the God of hope fill you with all **joy** and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost... Strive together with me in your prayers to God for me: That I may come unto you with **joy**... Romans 15:13, 31-32

Whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honored, all the members **rejoice** with it. 1 Corinthians 12:26

Both they that have wives be as though they had none; and they that weep, as though they wept not; and they that **rejoice**, as though they **rejoiced** not; and they that buy, as though they possessed not... 1 Corinthians 7:29-30

Charity...**Rejoices** not in iniquity, but **rejoices** in the truth... 1 Corinthians 13:6

I protest by your **rejoicing** which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord [Messiah Yeshua], I die daily. 1 Corinthians 15:31

Also you have acknowledged us in part, that we are your **rejoicing**, even as you also are ours in the day of the Lord Jesus ... Not for that we have dominion over your faith, but are helpers of your **joy**: for by faith you stand. 2 Corinthians 1:14, 24

I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to **rejoice**; having confidence in you all, that my **joy** is the **joy** of you all. 2 Corinthians 2:3

As sorrowful, yet always **rejoicing**; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:10

Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with comfort, I am exceeding **joyful** in all our tribulation...Not by His coming only, but by the consolation wherewith He was comforted in you, when He told us your earnest desire, your mourning, your fervent mind toward me; so that I **rejoiced** the more...Now I **rejoice**, not that you were made sorry, but that you sorrowed to repentance: for you were made sorry after a godly manner, that you might receive damage by us in nothing. 2 Corinthians 7:4, 7, 9

I **rejoice** therefore that I have confidence in you in all things. 2 Corinthians 7:16

Therefore we were comforted in your comfort: yes, and exceedingly the more **joyed** we for the **joy** of Titus, because his spirit was refreshed by you all. 2 Corinthians 7:13

How that in a great trial of affliction, the abundance of their **joy** and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality. 2 Corinthians 8:2

For it is written, **Rejoice**, you barren who bears not; break forth and cry, you who travails not: for the desolate has many more children than she which has an husband. Galatians 4:27

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, **joy**, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance... Galatians 5:22

Let every man prove his own work, and then shall he have **rejoicing** in himself alone, and not in another. Galatians 6:4

I thank my God upon remembrance of you, always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with **joy**... Philippians 1:3-4

Having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and **joy** of faith; That your **rejoicing** may be more abundant in Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] for me by my coming to you again. Philippians 1:25

Fulfil you my **joy**, that you be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 2:2

Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ [the Messiah], that I have not run in vain, neither labored in vain. Yes, and if I be offered upon the sacrifice and service of your faith, I **joy**, and **rejoice** with you all. For the same cause also do you **joy**, and **rejoice** with me. Philippians 2:16-18

I sent him therefore the more carefully, that, when you see him again, you may **rejoice**, and that I may be the less sorrowful. Philippians 2:28

Finally, my brethren, **rejoice** in the Lord...For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and **rejoice** in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh. Phil 3:1, 3

Therefore, my brethren dearly beloved and longed for, my **joy** and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved. Phil 4:1

We also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with **joyfulness**... Colossians 1:9-12

Who now **rejoice** in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ [Messiah] in my flesh for His body's sake, which is the church... Colossians 1:24

For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, **joying** and beholding your order, and the steadfastness of your faith in Christ [the Messiah]. Colossians 2:5

You became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with **joy** of the Holy Ghost... 1 Thessalonians 1:6

For what is our hope, or **joy**, or crown of **rejoicing**? Are not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming? For you are our glory and our **joy**. 1 Thessalonians 2:20

Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. 1 Thess 5:16-17

Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to **enjoy**... 1 Timothy 6:17

Greatly desiring to see you, being mindful of your tears, that I may be filled with **joy**... 2 Timothy 1:4

We have great **joy** and consolation in your love, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by you, brother. Philemon 1:7

Yes, brother, let me have **joy** of you in the Lord: refresh my bowels in the Lord. Philemon 1: 20

For you had compassion of me in my bonds, and took **joyfully** the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that you have in heaven a better and an enduring substance. Hebrews 10:34

By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter; Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God, than to **enjoy** the pleasure of sin for a season: Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasure in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompense of the reward. Hebrews 11:24-26

Looking unto Jesus [Yeshua] the author and finisher of our faith; who for the **joy** that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2

Now no chastening for the present seems to be **joyous**, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness unto them which are exercised thereby. Hebrews 12:11

Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with **joy**, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. Hebrews 13:17

My brethren, count it all **joy** when you fall into divers temptations; knowing this that the trying of your faith works patience...Let the brother of low degree **rejoice** in that he is exalted. James 1:2, 9

For he shall have judgment without mercy, that has shown no mercy; and mercy **rejoices** against judgment. James 2:13

Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your **joy** to heaviness...Now you **rejoice** in your boastings: all such **rejoicing** is evil. James 4:9, 16

But **rejoice**, inasmuch as you are partakers of Christ's [Messiah's] sufferings; that, when His glory shall be revealed, you may be glad also with exceeding **joy**. 1 Peter 4:13

Wherein you greatly **rejoice**, though now for a season, if need be, you are in heaviness through manifold temptations: That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]: whom having not seen, you love; in whom, though now you see Him not, yet believing, you **rejoice** with **joy** unspeakable and full of glory: receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:6-9

These things write we unto you, that your **joy** may be full. 1 John 1:4

I **rejoiced** greatly that I found of your children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father... Having many things to write unto you, I would not write with paper and ink: but I trust to come unto you, and speak face to face, that our **joy** may be full. 2 John 1:4, 12

For I **rejoiced** greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, even as you walk in the truth. For I have no greater **joy** than to hear that my children walk in truth. 3 Jn 1:3-4

Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding **joy**, to the only wise God our Savior, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen. Jude 1:24-25

They that dwell upon the Earth shall **rejoice** over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the Earth. Rev 11:10

Therefore **rejoice**, you Heavens, and you that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabiters of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath... Revelations 12:12

Rejoice over her, you heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets; for God has avenged you on her. Revelation 18:20

Let us be glad and **rejoice**, and give honor to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife has made herself ready. Revelation 19:7

LIGHT

In the beginning God created the Heaven and the Earth. And the Earth was without form, and void; and the darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be **light**: and there was **light**. And God saw the **light**, that it was good: and God divided the **light** from the darkness. And God called the **light** Day, and the darkness He called Night. And the evening and the morning were the first day. Genesis 1:1-5

God said, Let there be **lights** in the firmament of the Heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years: and let them be for **lights** in the firmament of the Heaven to give **light** upon the earth: and it was so. And God made two great **lights**; the greater **light** to rule the day, and the lesser **light** to rule the night: He made the stars also. And God set them in the firmament of the Heaven to give **light** upon the Earth, and to rule over the day and over the night, and to divide the **light** from the darkness: and God saw that it was good. ...the evening and the morning were the fourth day. Gen 1:14-19

The LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand toward heaven, that there may be darkness over the land of Egypt, even darkness which may be felt. And Moses stretched forth his hand toward Heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days: They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had **light** in their dwellings. Exodus 10:21-23

The LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto the children of Israel, that they bring me an offering...Oil for the **light**, spices for anointing oil...Thou shalt make the seven lamps thereof: and they shall **light** the lamps thereof, that they may give **light** over against it...and you shall command the children of Israel, that they may bring thee pure oil olive beaten for the **light**, to cause the lamp to burn always. In the tabernacle of the congregation without the vail, which is before the testimony, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel. Exodus 25:1, 26:37, 28:20

The LORD spake unto Moses, saying, Speak unto Aaron and unto his sons, saying, On this wise you shall bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, The LORD bless you, and keep you: The LORD make His face **shine** upon you, and be gracious unto you: The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them. Numbers 6:22-27

The LORD came from Sinai, and rose up from Seir unto them; He **shined** forth from mount Paran, and He came with ten thousands of saints: from His right hand went a fiery law for them. Yea, He loved the people; all His saints are in thy hand: and they sat down at thy feet; every one shall receive of thy words. De 33:2

The men of David sware unto him, saying, Thou shalt go no more out with us to battle, that thou quench not the **light** of Israel. 2 Samuel 21:17

Unto his son will I give one tribe, that David my servant may have a **light** always before me in Jerusalem... 1 Kings 11:36

The LORD would not destroy Judah for David his servant's sake, as He promised him to give him always a **light**, and to his children. 2 Kings 8:19

He walked in the way of the kings of Israel, like as did the house of Ahab...Howbeit the LORD would not destroy the house of David, because of the covenant that he had made with David, and as He promised to give **a light** to him and to his sons for ever. 2 Chronicles 21:7

The city of Shushan rejoiced and was glad. The Jews had **light**, and gladness, and joy, and honor. Esther 8:15-16

Why is **light** given to a man whose way is hid, and whom God has hedged in? ... Are not my days few? Cease them, and let me alone, that I may take comfort a little, Before I go whence I shall not return, even to the land of darkness and the shadow of death; A land of darkness, as darkness itself, and of the shadow of death, without any order, and where the **light** is as darkness. Job 3:23, 10:20-22

He takes away the heart of the chief of the people of the earth, and causes them to wander in a wilderness where there is no way. They grope in the dark without **light**, and He makes them to stagger like a drunken man. Job 12:24-25

Yes, the **light** of the wicked shall be put out, and the spark of his fire shall not shine. The **light** shall be dark in his tabernacle, and his **candle** shall be put out with him. Job 18:5-6

You shall also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto you: and the **light** shall shine upon your ways. Job 22:28

Men groan from out of the city, and the soul of the wounded cries out: yet God lays not folly to them. They are of those that rebel against the **light**; they know not the ways thereof, nor abide in the paths thereof. The murderer rising with **the light** kills the poor and needy, and in the night is as a thief. Job 24:12-14

In the dark they dig through houses, which they had marked for themselves in the daytime: they know not the **light**. Job 24:16

Moreover, Job continued his parable, and said, Oh that I were as in months past, as in the days when God preserved me; When His candle **shined** upon my head, and when by His **light** I walked through darkness; As I was in the days of my youth, when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle; When the Almighty was yet with me, when my children were about me; When I washed my steps with butter, and the rock poured me out rivers of oil; When I went out to the gate through the city, when I prepared my seat in the street! Job 29:1-7

He looks upon men, and if any say, I have sinned, and perverted that which was right, and it profits me not; He will deliver his soul from going into the pit, and his life shall see the **light**... to bring back his soul from the pit, to be **enlightened** with the **light** of the living. Job 33:27-28, 30

Stand still, and consider the wondrous works of God. Do you know when God disposed them, and caused **the light** of His cloud to shine? Do you know the balancing of the clouds, the wondrous works of Him which is perfect in knowledge? Job 37:14-16

From the wicked their **light** is withholden, and the high arm shall be broken. Job 38:15

Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own heart upon your bed, and be still. Selah. Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, and put your trust in the LORD. There be many that say, Who will show us any good? LORD, lift up the **light** of Your countenance upon us. You have put gladness in my heart, more than in the time that their corn and their wine increased. I will both lay me down in peace, and sleep: for You, LORD, only make me dwell in safety. Psalm 4:4-8

For You will **light** my candle: the LORD my God will **enlighten** my darkness. Psalm 18:28

The LORD is my **light** and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? Psalm 27:1

My times are in Your hand: deliver me from the hand of mine enemies, and from them that persecute me. Make Your face to **shine** upon Your servant: save me for Your mercies' sake. Psalm 31:15-16

How excellent is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings. They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of Your house; and You shall make them drink of the river of Your pleasures. For with You is the fountain of life: in Your **light** shall we see **light**. O continue Your lovingkindness unto them that know You; and Your righteousness to the upright in heart. Psalm 36:7-10

Delight yourself also in the LORD; and He shall give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass. And He shall bring forth your righteousness as the **light**, and your judgment as the noonday. Psalm 37:4-6

Lord, all my desire is before You; and my groaning is not hid from You. My heart pants, my strength fails me: as for **the light** of mine eyes, it also is gone from me...For I will declare mine iniquity; I will be sorry for my sin. Psalm 38:9-10, 18

O send out Your **light** and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto Your holy hill, and to Your tabernacles. Psalm 43:3

For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but Your right hand, and Your arm, and the **light** of Your countenance, because You had a favor unto them. Psalm 44:3

He shall go to the generation of his fathers; they shall never see **light**. Man that is in honor, and understands not, is like the beasts that perish. Psalm 49:19-20

The mighty God, even the LORD, has spoken, and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof. Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God has **shined**. Psalm 50:1-2

For You have delivered my soul from death: will not You deliver my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the **light** of the living? Psalm 56:13

God be merciful unto us, and bless us; and cause His face **to shine** upon us; Selah. That Your way may be known upon earth, Your saving health among all nations. Psalm 67:1-2

The day is Yours, the night also is Yours: You have prepared the **light** and the sun. Psalm 74:16

Turn us again, O God, and cause Your face to **shine**; and we shall be saved...Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause Your face to **shine**; and we shall be saved...Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause Your face to **shine**; and we shall be saved. Psalm 80:3, 7, 19

Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the **light** of Your countenance. Psalm 89:15

For we are consumed by Your anger, and by Your wrath are we troubled. You have set our iniquities before You, our secret sins in the **light** of Your countenance. Psalm 90:7-8

You that love the LORD, hate evil: He preserves the souls of His saints; He delivers them out of the hand of the wicked. **Light** is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart. Psalm 97:10-11

Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, You are very great; You are clothed with honor and majesty. Who covers Yourself with **light** as with a garment: who stretches out the Heavens like a curtain: Who lays the beams of His chambers in the waters: who makes the clouds His chariot: who walks upon the wings of the wind: who makes His angels spirits; His ministers a flaming ire: who laid the foundations of the Earth, that it should not be removed or ever. Psalm 104:1-5

He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give **light** in the night. Psalm 105:39

Unto the upright there arises **light** in the darkness: He is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. Psalm 112:4

God is the LORD, which has shown us **light**: bind the sacrifice with cords, even unto the horns of the altar. Psalm 118:27

Your word is a lamp unto my feet, and a **light** unto my path. Psalm 119:105

The entrance of Your words gives **light**; it gives understanding unto the simple. Psalm 119:130

Order my steps in Your word: and let not any iniquity have dominion over me. Deliver me from the oppression of man: so will I keep Your precepts. Make Your face to **shine** upon Your servant; and teach me Your statutes. Psalm 119:130, 133-135

O give thanks unto the LORD...To Him that by wisdom made the Heavens: for His mercy endures for ever. To Him that stretches out the Earth above the waters: for His mercy endures for ever. To Him that made **great lights**: for His mercy endures for ever: The sun to rule by day: for His mercy endures for ever: The moon and stars to rule by night: for His mercy endures for ever. Psalm 136:1-9

If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be **light** about me. Yes, the darkness hides not from You; but the night shines as the day: the darkness and the **light** are both alike to You. Psalm 139:11-12

The path of the just is as the shining **light**, that shines more and more unto the perfect day. Proverbs 4:18

For the commandment is a lamp; and the law is **light**; and reproofs of instruction are the way of life... Proverbs 6:23

The **light** of the righteous rejoices: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out. Proverbs 13:9

The LORD is far from the wicked: but He hears the prayer of the righteous. The **light** of the eyes rejoices the heart: and a good report makes the bones fat. The ear that hears the reproof of life abides among the wise. Proverbs 15:29-31

In the **light** of the king's countenance is life; and his favor is as the cloud of the latter rain. Proverbs 16:15

The spirit of man is the **candle** of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly. Proverbs 20:27

Who can find a virtuous woman?...she perceives that her merchandise is good: her **candle** goes not out by night. Proverbs 31:1, 18

Truly the **light** is sweet, and a pleasant thing it is for the eyes to behold the sun: Ecclesiastes 11:7

O house of Jacob, come you, and let us walk in the **light** of the LORD. Isaiah 2:5

The LORD will create upon every dwelling place of mount Zion, and upon her assemblies, a cloud and smoke by day, and the shining of **a flaming fire** by night; for upon all the glory shall be a defense. Isaiah 4:5

Woe unto them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for **light**, and **light** for darkness; that put bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Isaiah 5:20

To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no **light** in them. Isaiah 8:20

The people that walked in darkness have seen a great **light**: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them has the **light** shined. Isaiah 9:2

The **light** of Israel shall be for a fire, and His Holy One for a **flame**: and it shall burn and devour his thorns and briers in one day; Isaiah 10:17

Moreover the **light** of the moon shall be as the **light** of the sun, and the **light** of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the **light** of seven days, in the day that the LORD binds up the breach of His people, and heals the stroke of their wounds. Isaiah 30:26

Thus says God the LORD, He that created the Heavens, and stretched them out; He that spread forth the Earth, and that which comes out of it; He that gives breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein: I the LORD have called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand, and will keep you, and give you for a covenant of the people, for a **light** of the Gentiles; To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, and them that sit in darkness out of the prison house. I am the LORD: that is My name: and My glory will I not give to another, neither My praise to graven images. Isaiah 42:5-8

I form the **light**, and create darkness...I the LORD do all these things. Isaiah 45:7

And He said, It is a **light** thing that you should be My servant to raise up the tribes of Jacob, and to restore the preserved of Israel: I will also give you for a **light** to the Gentiles, that you may be My salvation unto the end of the earth. Isaiah 49:6

Who is among you that fears the LORD, that obeys the voice of his servant, that walks in darkness, and has no **light**? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Behold, all you that kindle a fire, that compass yourselves about with sparks: walk in the **light** of your fire, and in the sparks that you have kindled. This shall you have of My hand; you shall lie down in sorrow. Isaiah 50:10-11

Hearken unto Me, My people; and give ear unto Me, O My nation: for a law shall proceed from Me, and I will make My judgment to rest for a **light** of the people. My righteousness is near; My salvation is gone forth, and Mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon Me, and on Mine arm shall they trust. Isaiah 51:4-5

Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that you break every yoke? Is it not to deal your bread to the hungry, and that you bring the poor that are cast out to your house? When you see the naked, that you cover him; and that you hide not yourself from your own flesh? Then shall your **light** break forth as the morning, and your health shall spring forth speedily: and your righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be your rereward. Then shall you call, and the LORD shall answer; you shall cry, and He shall say, Here I am. If you take away from the midst of you the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking vanity; and if you draw out your soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall your **light** rise in obscurity, and your darkness be as the noonday. Isaiah 58:6-10

The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goes therein shall not know peace. Therefore is judgment far from us, neither does justice overtake us: we wait for **light**, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness. Isaiah 59:8-9

Arise, shine; for your **light** is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon you. For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall rise upon you, and His glory shall be seen upon you. And the Gentiles shall come to your **light**, and kings to the brightness of your rising. Isaiah 60:1-3

The sun shall be no more your **light** by day; neither for brightness shall the moon give **light** unto you: but the LORD shall be unto you an everlasting **light**, and your God your glory. The sun shall no more go down; neither shall your moon withdraw itself: for the LORD shall be your everlasting **light**, and the days of your mourning shall be ended. Isaiah 60: 19-20

Give glory to the LORD your God, before He cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while you look for **light**, He turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness. Jeremiah 13:16

Thus says the LORD, which gives the sun for **a light** by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for **a light** by night, which divides the sea when the waves thereof roar; The LORD [YEHOVAH] of hosts is His name: If those ordinances depart from before Me, says the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me for ever. Thus says the LORD; If Heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the Earth searched out beneath, I will also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, says the LORD. Jeremiah 31:35-37

When I shall put you out, I will cover the Heaven, and make the stars thereof dark; I will cover the sun with a cloud, and the moon shall not give her light. All the bright **lights** of Heaven will I make dark over you, and set darkness upon your land, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 32:7-8

Daniel blessed the God of Heaven...He reveals the deep and secret things: He knows what is in the darkness, and the **light** dwells with Him. Daniel 2:22

There is a man in your kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of your father **light** and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar your father, the king, I say, your father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers...I have even heard of you, that the spirit of the gods is in you, and that **light** and understanding and excellent wisdom is found in you. Daniel 5:11, 14

Rejoice not against me, O mine enemy: when I fall, I shall arise; when I sit in darkness, the LORD shall be a **light** unto me. I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against Him, until He plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: He will bring me forth to the **light**, and I shall behold His righteousness. Micah 7:8-9

The just LORD is in the midst thereof; He will not do iniquity: every morning does He bring His judgment to **light**, He fails not; but the unjust know no shame. Zephaniah 3:5

The people which sat in darkness saw great **light**; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death **light** is sprung up. Matthew 4:16

You are the **light** of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men **light** a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it gives **light** unto all that are in the house. Let your **light** so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven. Matthew 5:14-16

The **light** of the body is the eye: if therefore your eye be single, your whole body shall be full of **light**. But if your eye be evil, your whole body shall be full of darkness. If therefore the **light** that is in you be darkness, how great is that darkness! Matthew 6:22-23

What I tell you in darkness, that speak you in **light**: and what you hear in the ear, that preach you upon the housetops. Matthew 10:27

For My yoke is easy, and My burden is **light**. Matthew 11:30

Jesus...was transfigured before them: and His face did shine as the sun, and His raiment was white as the **light**. Mt 17:1-2

In those days shall be affliction, such as was not from the beginning of the creation which God created unto this time, neither shall be. And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom He has chosen, He has shortened the days...but in those days, after that tribulation, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her **light**, and the stars of Heaven shall fall, and the powers that are in Heaven shall be shaken. And then shall they see the Son of man coming in the clouds with great power and glory. And then shall He send His angels, and shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the Earth to the uttermost part of Heaven. Mark 13:19-20, 24-27

You child, shall be called the prophet of the Highest... To give **light** to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. Luke 1:79

A **light** to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel. Luke 2:32

No man, when he has **lighted** [lit] a candle, covers it with a vessel, or put it under a bed; but sets it on a candlestick, that they which enter in may see the **light**. For nothing is secret, that shall not be made manifest; neither any thing hid, that shall not be known and come abroad. Luke 8:16-17

No man, when he has **lighted** [lit] a candle, puts it in a secret place, neither under a bushel, but on a candlestick, that they which come in may see the **light**. The **light** of the body is the eye: therefore when your eye is single, your whole body also is full of **light**; but when your eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness. Take heed therefore that the **light** which is in you be not darkness. If your whole body therefore be full of **light**, having no part dark, the whole shall be full of **light**, as when the bright shining of a candle does give you **light**. Luke 11:33-36

Whatsoever you have spoken in darkness shall be heard in the **light**; and that which you have spoken in the ear in closets shall be proclaimed upon the housetops. Luke 12:3

The lord commended the unjust steward, because he had done wisely: for the children of this world are in their generation wiser than the children of **light**. Luke 16:8

For as the **lightning**, that **lightens** out of one part under Heaven, shines unto the other part under heaven; so shall also the Son of man be in His day...but the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all. Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed. In that day, he which shall be upon the housetop, and his stuff in the house, let him not come down to take it away: and he that is in the field, let him likewise not return back. Remember Lot's wife. Luke 17:24-32

In Him was life; and the life was **the light** of men. And **the light** shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. The same came for a witness, to bear witness of **the Light**, that all men through him might believe. He was not **that Light**, but was sent to bear witness of **that Light**. That was **the true Light**, which **lightens** every man that comes into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made by Him, and the world knew Him not...and the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. John 1:1-10, 14

This is the condemnation, that **light** is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than **light**, because their deeds were evil. For every one that does evil hates the **light**, neither comes to the **light**, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that does truth comes to the **light**, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. John 3:19-21

You sent unto John...He was a burning and shining **light**: and you were willing for a season to rejoice in his **light**. John 5:33, 35

Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the **light** of the world: he that follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the **light** of life. John 8:12

I must work the works of Him that sent Me, while it is day: the night comes, when no man can work. As long as I am in the world, I am the **light** of the world. John 9:4-5

Jesus answered, Are there not twelve hours in the day? If any man walk in the day, he stumbles not, because he sees the **light** of this world. But if a man walk in the night, he stumbles, because there is no **light** in him. John 11:9-10

Yet a little while is the **light** with you. Walk while you have the **light**, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walks in darkness knows not whither he goes. While you have **light**, believe in the **light**, that you may be the children of **light**. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them...I am come a **light** into the world, that whosoever believes on Me should not abide in darkness. John 12:35-36, 46

As he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there **shined** round about him a **light** from heaven: and he fell to the earth, and heard a voice saying unto him, Saul, Saul, why do you persecute Me?
