DECEIT

Jacob said...Esau my brother is a hairy man, and I am a smooth man: My father peradventure will feel me, and I shall seem to him as a **deceiver**; and I shall bring a curse upon me, and not a blessing. Genesis 27:11-12

I have served your father. And your father has **deceived** me, and changed my wages ten times; but God suffered him not to hurt me. Genesis 31:6-7

The sons of Jacob answered Shechem and Hamor his father **deceitfully**, and said, because he had defiled Dinah their sister: And they said unto them, We cannot do this thing... Gen 34:13-14

And Moses said, Behold, I go out from you, and I will intreat the LORD that the swarms of flies may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, tomorrow: but let not Pharaoh deal **deceitfully** any more in not letting the people go to sacrifice to the LORD. Exodus 8:29

If she please not her master, who has betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he has dealt **deceitfully** with her. Exodus 21:8

If a soul sin, and commit a trespass against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbor in that which delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or has **deceived** his neighbor; Or have found that which was lost, and lies concerning it, and swears falsely; in any of all these that a man does, sinning therein: Then it shall be, because he has sinned, and is guilty, that he shall restore that which he took violently away, or the thing which he has **deceitfully** gotten, or that which was delivered him to keep, or the lost thing which he found... Leviticus 6:2-4

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not **deceived**, and you turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them... Deuteronomy 11:16

Saul said unto Michal, Why have you **deceived** me so, and sent away mine enemy, that he is escaped? 1 Samuel 19:17

Saul swore to her by the LORD, saying, As the LORD lives, there shall no punishment happen to you for this thing. Then said the woman, Whom shall I bring up unto you?...When the woman saw Samuel, she cried with a loud voice: and the woman spake to Saul, saying, Why have you **deceived** me? For you are Saul. 1 Samuel 28:10-12

You know Abner the son of Ner, that he came to **deceive** and to know your going out and your coming in, and to know all that you do. 2 Samuel 3:25

My lord, O king, my servant **deceived** me: for your servant said, I will saddle me an ass, that I may ride thereon, and go to the king; because your servant is lame. 2 Samuel 19:26

Then she said, Did I desire a son of my lord? Did I not say, Do not **deceive** me? 2 Kings 4:28

Thus says the king, Let not Hezekiah **deceive** you: for he shall not be able to deliver you out of his hand... 2 Kings 18:29

Thus shall you speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not your God in whom you trust **deceive** you, saying, Jerusalem shall not be delivered into the hand of the king of Assyria. 2 Kings 19:10

Now therefore let not Hezekiah **deceive** you, nor persuade you on this manner, neither yet believe him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver his people out of mine hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of mine hand? 2 Chronicles 32:15

My brethren have dealt **deceitfully** as a brook, and as the stream of brooks they pass away... Job 6:15

With Him is strength and wisdom: the **deceived** and the **deceiver** are His. Job 12:16

Will you speak wickedly for God? And talk **deceitfully** for Him? Job 13:7

Let not him that is **deceived** trust in vanity: for vanity shall be his recompense. Job 15:31

They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepares **deceit**. Job 15:35

My lips shall not speak wickedness, nor my tongue utter **decei**t. Job 27:4

If I have walked with vanity, or if my foot has hasted to **deceit**; Let me be weighed in an even balance, that God may know my integrity. Job 31:5-6

If my heart has been **deceived** by a woman, or if I have laid wait at my neighbor's door; Then let my wife grind unto another... Job 31:9-10

You shall destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and **deceitful** man. Psalm 5:6

His mouth is full of cursing and **deceit** and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and vanity. Psalm10:7

Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who shall stand in His holy place? He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn **deceitfully**. Psalm 24:3-4

For they speak not peace: but they devise **deceitful** matters against them that are quiet in the land. Psalm 35:20

The transgression of the wicked...The words of his mouth are iniquity and **deceit**; he has left off to be wise, and to do good...They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak mischievous things, and imagine **deceits** all the day long Psalm 38:1, 3, 12

Judge me, O God, and plead my cause against an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the **deceitful** and unjust man. Psalm 43:1

You give your mouth to evil, and your tongue frames **deceit**. Psalm 50:19

Why boast you yourself in mischief, O mighty man? The goodness of God endures continually. Your tongue devises mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working **deceitfully**. Psalm 52:1-2

You love evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah. You love all devouring words, O you **deceitful** tongue. God shall likewise destroy you for ever, He shall take you away, and pluck you out of your dwelling place, and root you out of the land of the living. Selah. Psalm 52:3-5

Wickedness is in the midst thereof: **deceit** and guile depart not from her streets. Psalm 55:11

But you, O God, shall bring them down into the pit of destruction: bloody and **deceitful** men shall not live out half their days; but I will trust in You. Psalm 55:23

He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy. He shall redeem their soul from **deceit** and violence: and precious shall their blood be in His sight. Psalm 72:13-14

Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not His testimonies: But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a **deceitful** bow. Psalm 78:56-57

He that works **deceit** shall not dwell within my house: he that tells lies shall not tarry in my sight. Psalm 101:7

For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the **deceitful** are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue. Psalm 109:2

You have trodden down all them that err from Your statutes: for their **deceit** is falsehood. Psalm 119:118

Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips, and from a **deceitful** tongue. Psalm 120:2

The wicked work a **deceitful** work: but to him that sows righteousness shall be a sure reward. Proverbs 11:18

The thoughts of the righteous are right: but the counsels of the wicked are **deceit**. Proverbs 12:5

He that speaks truth shows forth righteousness: but a false witness **deceit**. Proverbs 12:17

Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counselors of peace is joy. Proverbs 12:20

The wisdom of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is **deceit**. Proverbs 14:8

A true witness delivers souls: but a **deceitful** witness speaks lies. Proverbs 14:25

Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is **deceived** thereby is not wise. Proverbs 20:1

Bread of **deceit** is sweet to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel. Proverbs 20:17

Be not desirous of his dainties; for they are **deceitful** meat. Proverbs 23:3

Be not a witness against your neighbor without cause; and **deceive** not with your lips. Proverbs 24:28

He that hates dissembles with his lips, and lays up **deceit** within him... Proverbs 26:24

Whose hatred is covered by **deceit**, his wickedness shall be shown before the whole congregation. Proverbs 26:26

Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are **deceitful**. Proverbs 27:6

The poor and the **deceitful** man meet together: the LORD lightens both their eyes. Proverbs 29:13

Favor is **deceitful**, and beauty is vain: but a woman that fears the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

The princes of Zoan are become fools, the princes of Noph are **deceived**; they have also seduced Egypt, even they that are the stay of the tribes thereof. Isaiah 19:13

This is a rebellious people, lying children...which say to the seers, See not, and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy **deceits**... Isaiah 30:9-10

Thus said the king, Let not Hezekiah **deceive** you; for he shall not be able to deliver you. Isaiah 36:14

Thus shall you speak to Hezekiah king of Judah, saying, Let not your God, in whom you trust, **deceive** you, saying, Jerusalem shall not be given into the hand of the king of Assyria. Isaiah 37:10

He feeds on ashes: a **deceived** heart has turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand? Isaiah 44:20

He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any **deceit** in His mouth. Isaiah 53:9

Then said I, Ah, Lord GOD! Surely You have greatly **deceived** this people and Jerusalem, saying, You shall have peace; whereas the sword reaches unto the soul. Jeremiah 4:10

As a cage is full of birds, so are their houses full of **deceit**: therefore they are become great, and waxen rich. Jeremiah 5:27

Why then is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? They hold fast **deceit**, they refuse to return. Jeremiah 8:5

And they will **deceive** every one his neighbor, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity. Your habitation is in the midst of **deceit**; through **deceit** they refuse to know Me, says the LORD. Their tongue is as an arrow shot out; it speaks **deceit**: one speaks peaceably to his neighbor with his mouth, but in heart he lays his wait. Jeremiah 9:5-6, 8

Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in My name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the **deceit** of their heart. Jeremiah 14:14

The heart is **deceitful** above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? Jeremiah 17:9

O LORD, You **deceived** me, and I was **deceived**: You are stronger than I, and have prevailed: I am in derision daily, every one mocks me. Jeremiah 20:7

How long shall this be in the heart of the prophets that prophesy lies? Yes, they are prophets of the **deceit** of their own heart... Jeremiah 23:26

For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Let not your prophets and your diviners, that be in the midst of you, **deceive** you, neither hearken to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed. Jeremiah 29:8

Thus says the LORD; **Deceive** not yourselves, saying, The Chaldeans shall surely depart from us: for they shall not depart. Jeremiah 37:9

Cursed be he that does the work of the LORD **deceitfully**, and cursed be he that keeps back his sword from blood. Jeremiah 48:10

Your terribleness has **deceived** you, and the pride of your heart, O you that dwell in the clefts of the rock, that hold the height of the hill: though you should make your nest as high as the eagle, I will bring you down from there, says the LORD. Jeremiah 49:16

I called for my lovers, but they **deceived** me: my priests and my elders gave up the ghost in the city, while they sought their meat to relieve their souls. Lamentations 1:19

And if the prophet be **deceived** when he has spoken a thing, I the LORD have **deceived** that prophet, and I will stretch out My hand upon him, and will destroy him from the midst of My people Israel. Ezekiel 14:9

And after the league made with him he shall work **deceitfully**: for he shall come up, and shall become strong with a small people. Daniel 11:23

They return, but not to the Most High: they are like a **deceitful** bow: their princes shall fall by the sword for the rage of their tongue: this shall be their derision in the land of Egypt. Hosea 7:16

Ephraim compasses me about with lies, and the house of Israel with **deceit**: but Judah yet rules with God, and is faithful with the saints. Hosea 11:12

He is a merchant, the balances of **deceit** are in his hand: he loves to oppress. Hosea 12:7

Hear this O you that swallow up the needy, even to make the poor of the land to fail, Saying, When will the new moon be gone, that we may sell corn? And the sabbath, that we may set forth wheat, making the ephah small, and the shekel great, and falsifying the balances by **deceit**? Amos 8:4-5

The pride of your heart has **deceived** you, you that dwell in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that says in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground? Obadiah 1:3

All the men of your confederacy have brought you even to the border: the men that were at peace with you have **deceived** you, and prevailed against you; they that eat your bread have laid a wound under you: there is none understanding in him. Obadiah 1:7

Shall I count them pure with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights? For the rich men thereof are full of violence, and the inhabitants thereof have spoken lies, and their tongue is **deceitful** in their mouth. Micah 6:11-12

In the same day also will I punish all those that leap on the threshold, which fill their masters' houses with violence and **deceit**. Zephaniah 1:9

The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a **deceitful** tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:13

And it shall come to pass in that day, that the prophets shall be ashamed every one of his vision, when he has prophesied; neither shall they wear a rough garment to **deceive**. Zechariah 13:4

But cursed be the **deceiver**, which has in his flock a male, and vows, and sacrifices unto the Lord a corrupt thing: for I am a great King, says the LORD of hosts, and My name is dreadful among the heathen. Malachi 1:14

DECEIT IN THE NEW COVENANT

He also that received seed among the thorns is he that hears the word; and the care of this world, and the **deceitfulness** of riches, choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful. Mt 13:22

And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man **deceive** you. For many shall come in My name, saying, I am Christ; and shall **deceive** many. Matthew 24:4-5

Many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. Mt 24:11

For there shall arise false Christs [Messiahs], and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if it were possible, they shall **deceive** the very elect. Matthew 24:24

The chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate, Saying, Sir, we remember that that **deceiver** said, while He was yet alive, After three days I will rise again. Matthew 27:62-63

The cares of the world, and the **deceitfulness** of riches, and the lusts of other things entering in, choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful...From within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, **deceit**, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man. Mark 419, 7:22

And Jesus [Yeshua] answering them began to say, Take heed lest any man **deceive** you: For many shall come in My name, saying, I am Christ; and shall **deceive** many. Mark 13:5-6

And He said, Take heed that you be not **deceived**: for many shall come in My name, saying, I am Christ, and the time draws near: go you not therefore after them. Luke 21:8

Then answered them the Pharisees, Are you also **deceived**? John 7:47

Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, **deceit**, malignity; whisperers... Romans 1:29

Their throat is an open sepulcher; with their tongues they have used **deceit**; the poison of asps is under their lips... Romans 3:13

For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, **deceived** me, and by it slew me. Romans 7:11

Mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which you have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches **deceive** the hearts of the simple. Romans 16:17-18

Let no man **deceive** himself. If any man among you seems to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise. 1 Corinthians 3:18

Know you not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not **deceived**: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind... 1 Corinthians 6:9

Be not **deceived**: evil communications corrupt good manners. 1 Corinthians 15:33

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God **deceitfully**; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 2 Corinthians 4:1-2

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities...By honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report: as **deceivers**, and yet true... 2 Corinthians 6:8

For such are false apostles, **deceitful** workers, transforming themselves into the apostles of Christ. 2 Corinthians 11:13

Be not **deceived**; God is not mocked: for whatever a man sows, that shall he also reap. Galatians 6:7

That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to **deceive**... Ephesians 4:14

That you put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the **deceitful** lusts... Ephesians 4:22

Let no man **deceive** you with vain words: for because of these things comes the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Ephesians 5:6

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain **deceit**, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

For our exhortation was not of **deceit**, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile... 1 Thessalonians 2:3

Let no man **deceive** you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition... 2 Thessalonians 2:3

Then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of His mouth, and shall destroy by the brightness of His coming: Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, And with all **deceivableness** of unrighteousness in them that perish, because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 2 Thessalonians 2:8-10

And Adam was not **deceived**, but the woman being **deceived** was in the transgression. 1 Timothy 2:14

But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, **deceiving**, and being **deceived**. 2 Timothy 3:13

For there are many unruly and vain talkers and **deceivers**, specially they of the circumcision... Titus 1:10

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, **deceived**, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful and hating one another. Titus 3:3

But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today; lest any of you be hardened through the **deceitfulness** of sin. Hebrews 3:13

But be you doers of the word, and not hearers only, **deceiving** your own selves. James 1:22

But these, as natural brute beasts...shall receive the reward of unrighteousness, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time. Spots they are and blemishes, sporting themselves with their own **deceivings** while they feast with you... 2 Peter 2:13

If we say that we have no sin, we **deceive** ourselves, and the truth is not in us. 1 John 1:8

Little children, let no man **deceive** you: he that does righteousness is righteous, even as He is righteous. 1 John 3:7

For many **deceivers** are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a **deceiver** and an antichrist. 2 John 1:7

And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in you; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in you: for your merchants were the great men of the earth; for by your sorceries were all nations **deceived**. Revelation 18:23

The beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he **deceived** them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshiped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone...And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should **deceive** the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season...And shall go out to **deceive** the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea...And the devil that **deceived** them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. Revelations 19:20, 20:3, 8, 10

HAUGHTINESS

The afflicted people You will save: but Your eyes are upon the **haughty**, that You may bring them down. 2 Samuel 22:28

LORD, my heart is not **haughty**, nor mine eyes lofty: neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me. Psalm 131:1

Pride goes before destruction, and an **haughty** spirit before a fall. Proverbs 16:18

Before destruction the heart of man is **haughty**, and before honor is humility. Proverbs 18:12

Proud and **haughty** scorner is his name, who deals in proud wrath. Proverbs 21:24

The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the **haughtiness** of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day...The loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the **haughtiness** of men shall be made low: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. Isaiah 2:11, 17

Moreover the LORD said, Because the daughters of Zion are **haughty**, and walk with stretched forth necks and wanton eyes, walking and mincing as they go, and making a tinkling with their feet: Therefore the Lord will smite with a scab the crown of the head of the daughters of Zion, and the LORD will discover their secret parts. Isaiah 3:16-17

Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the **haughty** shall be humbled. Isaiah 10:33

The day of the LORD comes...For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine. I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay low the **haughtiness** of the terrible. Isaiah 13:9-11

We have heard of the pride of Moab; he is very proud: even of his **haughtiness**, and his pride, and his wrath: but his lies shall not be so. Isaiah 16:6

The earth mourns and fades away, the world languishes and fades away, the **haughty** people of the earth do languish. Isaiah 24:4

We have heard the pride of Moab, (he is exceeding proud) his loftiness, and his arrogancy, and his pride, and the **haughtiness** of his heart. Jeremiah 48:29

They were **haughty**, and committed abomination before Me: therefore I took them away as I saw good. Ezekiel 16:50

Therefore thus says the LORD; Behold, against this family do I devise an evil, from which you shall not remove your necks; neither shall you go **haughtily**: for this time is evil. Micah 2:3

In that day shall you not be ashamed for all your doings, wherein you have transgressed against Me: for then I will take away out of the midst of you them that rejoice in your pride, and you shall no more be **haughty** because of My holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

INIQUITY

But in the fourth generation they shall come hither again: for the **iniquity** of the Amorites is not yet full. Genesis 15:16

When morning arose, then the angels hastened Lot, saying, Arise, take your wife, and your two daughters, which are here; lest you be consumed in the **iniquity** of the city. Genesis 19:15

And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? What shall we speak? Or how shall we clear ourselves? God has found out the **iniquity** of your servants: behold, we are my lord's servants, both we, and he also with whom the cup is found. Genesis 44:16

You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me... Exodus 20:5

And it shall be upon Aaron's forehead, that Aaron may bear the **iniquity** of the holy things, which the children of Israel shall hallow in all their holy gifts; and it shall be always upon his forehead, that they may be accepted before the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Exodus 28:38

And they shall be upon Aaron, and upon his sons, when they come in unto the tabernacle of the congregation, or when they come near unto the altar to minister in the holy place; that they bear not **iniquity**, and die: it shall be a statute for ever unto him and his seed after him. Exodus 28:43

Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving **iniquity** and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. And he said, If now I have found grace in Your sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray You, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our **iniquity** and our sin, and take us for Your inheritance. Exodus 34:7, 9

And if a soul sin, and hear the voice of swearing, and is a witness, whether he has seen or known of it, if he does not utter it, then he shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 5:1

And if a soul sin, and commit any of these things which are forbidden to be done by the commandments of the LORD; though he knew it not, yet is he guilty, and shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 5:17

And if any of the flesh of the sacrifice of his peace offerings be eaten at all on the third day, it shall not be accepted, neither shall it be imputed unto him that offers it: it shall be an abomination, and the soul that eats of it shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 7:18

Wherefore have you not eaten the sin offering in the holy place, seeing it is most holy, and God has given it you to bear the **iniquity** of the congregation, to make atonement for them before the LORD [YeHoVaH]? Leviticus 10:17

Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the **iniquities** of the children of Israel, and all their transgressions in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness: And the goat shall bear upon him all their **iniquities** unto a land not inhabited: and he shall let go the goat in the wilderness. Leviticus 16:21-22

But if he wash them not, nor bathe his flesh; then he shall bear his **iniquity**. Leviticus 17:16

And the land is defiled: therefore I do visit the **iniquity** thereof upon it, and the land itself vomits out her inhabitants. Lev 18:25

Therefore every one that eats it shall bear his **iniquity**, because he has profaned the hallowed thing of the LORD: and that soul shall be cut off from among His people. Leviticus 19:8

And if a man shall take his sister, his father's daughter, or his mother's daughter, and see her nakedness, and she see his nakedness; it is a wicked thing; and they shall be cut off in the sight of their people: he has uncovered his sister's nakedness; he shall bear his **iniquity**... And you shall not uncover the nakedness of your mother's sister, nor of your father's sister: for he uncovers his near kin: they shall bear their **iniquity**. Leviticus 20:17, 19

...Or suffer them to bear the **iniquity** of trespass, when they eat their holy things: for I the LORD do sanctify them. Lev 22:16

They that are left of you shall pine away in their **iniquity** in your enemies' lands; and also in the **iniquities** of their fathers shall they pine away with them. Leviticus 26:39

If they shall confess their **iniquity**, and the **iniquity** of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against Me, and that also they have walked contrary unto Me; And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their **iniquity**: Then will I remember My covenant with Jacob, and also My covenant with Isaac, and also My covenant with Abraham will I remember: and I will remember the land. The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lies desolate without them: and they shall accept of the punishment of their **iniquity**: because, even because they despised My judgments, and...abhorred My statutes. Leviticus 26:40-43

Then shall the man bring his wife unto the priest, and he shall bring her offering for her, the tenth part of an ephah of barley meal; he shall pour no oil upon it, nor put frankincense thereon; for it is an offering of jealousy, an offering of memorial, bringing **iniquity** to remembrance...This is the law of jealousies, when a wife goes aside to another...when the spirit of jealousy comes upon him, and he be jealous over his wife, and shall set the woman before the LORD, and the priest shall execute upon her all this law. Then shall the man be guiltless from **iniquity**, and this woman shall bear her **iniquity**. Numbers 5:15, 29-31

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving **iniquity** and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech You, the **iniquity** of this people according unto the greatness of Your mercy, and as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now...After the number of the days in which you searched the land, even forty days, each day for a year, shall you bear your **iniquities**, even forty years...you shall know My breach of promise. Num 14:18-19, 34

Because he has despised the word of the LORD, and has broken His commandment, that soul shall utterly be cut off; his **iniquity** shall be upon him. Numbers 15:31

The LORD said unto Aaron, You and your sons and your father's house with you shall bear the **iniquity** of the sanctuary: and you and your sons with you shall bear the **iniquity** of your priesthood...But the Levites shall do the service of the tabernacle of the congregation, and they shall bear their **iniquity**: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations, that among the children of Israel they have no inheritance. Numbers 18:1,23

He has not beheld **iniquity** in Jacob, neither has he seen perverseness in Israel: the LORD his God is with him, and the shout of a king is among them. Numbers 23:21

...Because he held his peace at her in the day that he heard them. But if he shall any ways make them void after that he has heard them; then he shall bear her **iniquity**. Numbers 30:14-15

You shall not make you any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the waters beneath the earth: You shall not bow down yourself unto them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the **iniquity** of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me... Deuteronomy 5:9

One witness shall not rise up against a man for any **iniquity**, or for any sin, in any sin that he sins: at the mouth of two witnesses, or at the mouth of three witnesses, shall the matter be established. Deuteronomy 19:15

He is the Rock, His work is perfect: for all His ways are judgment: a God of truth and without **iniquity,** just and right is He. Deuteronomy 32:4

Is the **iniquity** of Peor too little for us, from which we are not cleansed until this day, although there was a plague in the congregation of the LORD...Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? And that man perished not alone in his **iniquity**. Joshua 22:17, 20

For I told him that I will judge his house for ever for the **iniquity** which he knows; because his sons made themselves vile, and he restrained them not. And therefore I have sworn unto the house of Eli, that the **iniquity** of Eli's house shall not be purged with sacrifice nor offering for ever. 1 Samuel 3:13-14

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as **iniquity** and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, He has also rejected you from being king. 1 Samuel 15:23

David fled from Naioth in Ramah, and came and said before Jonathan, What have I done? What is mine **iniquity**? And what is my sin before your father, that he seeks my life? 1 Sam 20:1

Therefore you shall deal kindly with your servant; for you have brought your servant into a covenant of the LORD with you: notwithstanding, if there be in me **iniquity**, slay me yourself; for why should you bring me to your father? 1 Samuel 20:8

Abigail...fell at his feet, and said, Upon me, my lord, upon me let this **iniquity** be: and let your handmaid, I pray you, speak in your audience, and hear the words of your handmaid. 1 Samuel 25:24

I will be his father, and he shall be my son. If he commit **iniquity**, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men... 2 Samuel 7:14

And the woman of Tekoah said unto the king, My lord, O king, the **iniquity** be on me, and on my father's house: and the king and his throne be guiltless. 2 Samuel 14:9

And Absalom answered Joab, Behold, I sent unto you, saying, Come hither, that I may send you to the king, to say, Wherefore am I come from Geshur? It had been good for me to have been there still: now therefore let me see the king's face; and if there be any **iniquity** in me, let him kill me. 2 Samuel 14:32

And said unto the king, Let not my lord impute **iniquity** unto me, neither remember that which your servant did perversely the day that my lord the king went out of Jerusalem, that the king should take it to his heart. 2 Samuel 19:19

I was also upright before Him, and have kept myself from my **iniquity**. 2 Samuel 22:24

And David's heart smote him after that he had numbered the people. And David said unto the LORD, I have sinned greatly in that I have done: and now, I beseech you, O LORD, take away the **iniquity** of Your servant; for I have done very foolishly. 2 Samuel 24:10

And David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech you, do away the **iniquity** of Your servant; for I have done very foolishly. 1 Chronicles 21:8

Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no **iniquity** with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts. 2 Chronicles 19:7

Even as I have seen, they that plow **iniquity**, and sow wickedness, reap the same. Job 4:8

So the poor has hope, and **iniquity** stops her mouth. Job 5:16

Return, I pray you, let it not be **iniquity**; yes, return again, my righteousness is in it. Is there **iniquity** in my tongue? Cannot my taste discern perverse things? Job 6:29-30

And why do you not pardon my transgression, and take away my **iniquity**? For now shall I sleep in the dust; and you shall seek me in the morning, but I shall not be. Job 7:21

Are your days as the days of man? Are your years as man's days, that you enquire after my **iniquity**, and search after my sin? You know that I am not wicked; and there is none that can deliver out of Your hand. Your hands have made me and fashioned me together round about; yet You do destroy me. Remember, I beseech You, that You have made me as the clay; and will you bring me into dust again? Job 10:5-9

If I sin, then You mark me, and You will not acquit me from my **iniquity**. Job 10:14

...And that He would show you the secrets of wisdom, that they are double to that which is! Know therefore that God exacts of you less than your **iniquity** deserves. Job 11:6

If **iniquity** be in your hand, put it far away, and let not wickedness dwell in your tabernacles. Job 11:14

How many are my **iniquities** and sins? Make me to know my transgression and my sin...For you write bitter things against me, and make me to possess the **iniquities** of my youth. Job 13:23, 26

My transgression is sealed up in a bag, and you sew up my **iniquity**. Job 14:17

For your mouth utters your **iniquity**, and you choose the tongue of the crafty. Job 15:5

How much more abominable and filthy is man, which drinks **iniquity** like water? Job 15:16

The heaven shall reveal his **iniquity**; and the earth shall rise up against him. Job 20:27

How oft is the candle of the wicked put out! and how often comes their destruction upon them!...God lays up his **iniquity** for his children: He rewards him, and he shall know it. Job 21:17, 19

Is not your wickedness great? And your **iniquities** infinite? Job 22:5

If you return to the Almighty, you shall be built up, you shall put away **iniquity** far from your tabernacles. Job 22:23

I made a covenant with my eyes; why then should I think upon a maid? For what portion of God is there from above? And what inheritance of the Almighty from on high? Is not destruction to the wicked? And a strange punishment to the workers of **iniquity**? Job 31:1-3

If my heart has been deceived by a woman...then let my wife grind for another, and let others bow down to her. For this is an heinous crime; yes, it is an **iniquity** to be punished by the judges. Job 31:9-11

This also were an **iniquity** to be punished by the judge: for I should have denied the God that is above. Job 31:28

If I covered my transgressions as Adam, by hiding my **iniquity** in my bosom: Did I fear a great multitude, or did the contempt of families terrify me, that I went not out of the door? Job 31:33-34

I am clean without transgression, I am innocent; neither is there **iniquity** in me. Job 33:9

What man is like Job, who drinks up scorning like water? Which goes in company with the workers of **iniquity**, and walks with wicked men. Job 34:7-8

Therefore hearken unto me, you men of understanding: far be it from God, that He should do wickedness; and from the Almighty, that He should commit **iniquity**. Job 34:10

There is no darkness, nor shadow of death, where the workers of **iniquity** may hide themselves. Job 34:22

That which I see not teach me: if I have done **iniquity**, I will do no more. Job 34:32

He opens also their ear to discipline, and commands that they return from **iniquity**. Job 36:10

Take heed, regard not **iniquity**: for this have you chosen rather than affliction...Who has enjoined him his way? Or who can say, You have wrought **iniquity**? Job 36:21, 23

And said, O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to You, my God: for our **iniquities** are increased over our head, and our trespass is grown up unto the heavens. Ezra 9:6

Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great trespass unto this day; and for our **iniquities** have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day. Ezra 9:7

After all that is come upon us for our evil deeds, and for our great trespass, seeing that You our God hast punished us less than our **iniquities** deserve, and has given us such deliverance as this; Should we again break Your commandments...? Ezra 9:13

And cover not their **iniquity**, and let not their sin be blotted out from before You: for they have provoked You to anger before the builders. Nehemiah 4:5

And the seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and confessed their sins, and the **iniquities** of their fathers. Nehemiah 9:2

The foolish shall not stand in Your sight: You hate all workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 5:5

Depart from me, all you workers of **iniquity**; for the LORD has heard the voice of my weeping. Psalm 6:8

O LORD my God, if I have done this; if there be **iniquity** in my hands ...Behold, he travails with **iniquity**, and has conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood. Psalm 7:3, 14

Have all the workers of **iniquity** no knowledge? Who eat up My people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD. Psalm 14:4

I was also upright before Him, and I kept myself from my **iniquity**. Psalm 18:23

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep His covenant and His testimonies. For Your name's sake, OLORD, pardon my **iniquity**; for it is great. Psalm 25:10-11

Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of **iniquity**, which speak peace to their neighbors, but mischief is in their hearts. Psalm 28:3

For my life is spent with grief, and my years with sighing: my strength fails because of my **iniquity**, and my bones are consumed. Psalm 31:10

Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputes not **iniquity**, and in whose spirit there is no guile...I acknowledged my sin unto you, and mine **iniquity** have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and You forgave the **iniquity** of my sin. Selah. Psalm 32:2, 5

For he flatters himself in his own eyes, until his **iniquity** be found to be hateful. The words of his mouth are **iniquity** and deceit: he has left off to be wise, and to do good. Psalm 36:2-3

There are the workers of **iniquity** fallen: they are cast down, and shall not be able to rise. Psalm 36:12

Fret not yourself because of evildoers, neither be you envious against the workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 37:1

For my **iniquities** are gone over mine head: as an heavy burden they are too heavy for me. Psalm 38:4

For I will declare mine **iniquity**; I will be sorry for my sin. Psalm 38:18

When you with rebukes do correct man for **iniquity**, you make his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man is vanity. Selah. Psalm 39:11

For innumerable evils have compassed me about: my **iniquities** have taken hold upon me, so that I am not able to look up; they are more than the hairs of my head: therefore my heart fails me. Psalm 40:12

And if he come to see me, he speaks vanity: his heart gathers **iniquity** to itself; when he goes abroad, he tells it. Psalm 41:6

Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, when the **iniquity** of my heels shall compass me about? Psalm 49:5

Wash me throughly from my **iniquity**, and cleanse me from my sin...Behold, I was shaped in **iniquity**; and in sin did my mother conceive me...Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my **iniquities**. Psalm 51:2, 5, 9

The fool has said in his heart, There is no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable **iniquity**: there is none that does good... Have the workers of **iniquity** no knowledge? Who eat up My people as they eat bread: they have not called upon God. Psalm 53:1,4

Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast **iniquity** upon me, and in wrath they hate me. Psalm 55:3

Shall they escape by **iniquity**? In Your anger cast down the people, O God. Psalm 56:7

Deliver me from my enemies, O my God; defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of **iniquity**, and save me from bloody men. Psalm 59:1-2

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of **iniquity**: who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words...They search out **iniquities**; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the heart, is deep. Psalm 64:1-3, 6

Iniquities prevail against me: as for our transgressions, You shall purge them away. Psalm 65:3

If I regard **iniquity** in my heart, the Lord will not hear me. Psalm 66:18

Add **iniquity** to their **iniquity**: and let them not come into Your righteousness. Let them be blotted out... Psalm 69:27-28

But He, being full of compassion, forgave their **iniquity**, and destroyed them not: yes, many a time turned He His anger away, and did not stir up all His wrath. Psalm 78:38

O remember not against us former **iniquities**: let your tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very low. Psalm 79:8

You have forgiven the **iniquity** of Your people, You have covered all their sin. Selah. Psalm 85:2

If they break My statutes, and keep not My commandments; Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their **iniquity** with stripes. Psalm 89:31-32

You have set our **iniquities** before You, our secret sins in the light of Your countenance. Psalm 90:8

When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of **iniquity** do flourish; it is that they shall be destroyed for ever... For, lo, Your enemies, O LORD, for lo, Your enemies shall perish; all the workers of **iniquity** shall be scattered. Psalm 92:7, 9

Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? Or who will stand up for me against the workers of **iniquity**? Psalm 94:16

Shall the throne of **iniquity** have fellowship with You, which frames mischief by a law? Psalm 94:20

And He shall bring upon them their own **iniquity**, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yes, the LORD our God shall cut them off. Psalm 94:23

Who forgives all your **iniquities**; who heals all your diseases... Psalm 103:3

He has not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our **iniquities**. Psalm 103:10

We have sinned with our fathers, we have committed **iniquity**, we have done wickedly. Psalm 106:6

Many times did He deliver them; but they provoked Him with their counsel, and were brought low for their **iniquity**. Psalm 106:43

Fools because of their transgression, and because of their **iniquities**, are afflicted. Psalm 107:17

He pours contempt upon princes, and causes them to wander in the wilderness, where there is no way. Yet sets He the poor on high from affliction, and makes him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all **iniquity** shall stop her mouth. Psalm 107:40-42

Let the **iniquity** of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out. Psalm 109:14

Blessed are they that keep His testimonies, and that seek Him with the whole heart. They also do no **iniquity**: they walk in His ways... Order my steps in Your word: and let not any **iniquity** have dominion over me. Psalm 119:3, 133

For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands to **iniquity**. Psalm 125:3

As for such as turn aside unto their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them forth with the workers of **iniquity**: but peace shall be upon Israel. Psalm 125:5

If You, LORD, should mark **iniquities**, O Lord, who shall stand? Psalm 130:3

And He shall redeem Israel from all his **iniquities**. Psalm 130:8

Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practice wicked works with men that work **iniquity**: and let me not eat of their dainties...Keep me from the snares which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 141:4,9

His own **iniquities** shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins. Proverbs 5:22

The way of the LORD is strength to the upright: but destruction shall be to the workers of **iniquity**. Proverbs 10:29

By mercy and truth **iniquity** is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. Proverbs 16:6

An ungodly witness scorns judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devours **iniquity**. Proverbs 19:28

It is joy to the just to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of **iniquity**. Proverbs 21:15

He that sows **iniquity** shall reap vanity: and the rod of his anger shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

And moreover I saw under the sun the place of judgment, that wickedness was there; and the place of righteousness, that **iniquity** was there. Ecclesiastes 3:16

Ah sinful nation, a people laden with **iniquity**, a seed of evildoers, children that are corrupters: they have forsaken the LORD, they have provoked the Holy One of Israel unto anger, they are gone away backward. Isaiah 1:4

Bring no more vain oblations; incense is an abomination unto Me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot away with; it is **iniquity**, even the solemn meeting. Isaiah 1:13

Woe unto them that draw **iniquity** with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope... Isaiah 5:18

And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this has touched your lips; and your **iniquity** is taken away, and your sin is purged. Isaiah 6:7

And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their **iniquity**; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and lay low the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:11

Prepare slaughter for his children for the **iniquity** of their fathers; that they do not rise, nor possess the land, nor fill the face of the world with cities. Isaiah 14:21

And it was revealed in mine ears by the LORD of hosts, Surely this **iniquity** shall not be purged from you till you die, says the Lord GOD of hosts. Isaiah 22:14

For, behold, the LORD comes out of His place to punish the inhabitants of the earth for their **iniquity**: the earth also shall disclose her blood, and shall no more cover her slain. Isaiah 26:21

By this therefore shall the **iniquity** of Jacob be purged; and this is all the fruit to take away his sin; when he makes all the stones of the altar as chalkstones that are beaten in sunder, the groves and images shall not stand up. Isaiah 27:9

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for **iniquity** are cut off... Isaiah 29:20

Therefore this **iniquity** shall be to you as a breach ready to fall, swelling out in a high wall, whose breaking comes suddenly at an instant. Isaiah 30:13

Yet He also is wise, and will bring evil, and will not call back His words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work **iniquity**. Isaiah 31:2

For the vile person will speak villany, and his heart will work **iniquity**, to practice hypocrisy, and to utter error against the LORD, to make empty the soul of the hungry, and he will cause the drink of the thirsty to fail. Isaiah 32:6

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their **iniquity**. Isaiah 33:24

Speak you comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her **iniquity** is pardoned: for she has received of the LORD'S hand double for all her sins. Isaiah 40:2

You have bought Me no sweet cane with money, neither have you filled Me with the fat of your sacrifices: but you have made Me to serve with your sins, you have wearied Me with your **iniquities**. Isaiah 43:24

Thus says the LORD, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? Or which of My creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your **iniquities** have you sold yourselves, and for your transgressions is your mother put away. Isaiah 50:1

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our **iniquities**: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the **iniquity** of us all...He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their **iniquities**. Isaiah 53:5-6, 11

For the **iniquity** of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid Me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. Isaiah 57:17

But your **iniquities** have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid His face from you, that He will not hear. For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with **iniquity**; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue has muttered perverseness. None calls for justice, nor any pleads for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth **iniquity**. Isaiah 59:2-6a

Their works are works of **iniquity**, and the acts of violence is in their hands. Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of **iniquity**; wasting and destruction are in their paths...For our transgressions are multiplied before you, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our **iniquities**, we know them... Isaiah 59:6-7,12

But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our **iniquities**, like the wind, have taken us away. And there is none that calls upon Your name, that stirs up himself to take hold of you: for You have hid Your face from us, and have consumed us, because of our **iniquities**... Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember **iniquity** for ever: behold, see, we beseech You, we are all Your people. Isaiah 64:6-7, 9

Thus says the LORD, What **iniquity** have your fathers found in Me, that they are gone far from Me, and have walked after vanity, and are become vain?...For though you wash yourself with nitre, and take such soap, yet your **iniquity** is marked before Me... Jeremiah 2:5, 22

Only acknowledge your **iniquity**, that you have transgressed against the LORD your God, and have scattered your ways to the strangers under every green tree, and you have not obeyed My voice, says the LORD. Jeremiah 3:13

Your **iniquities** have turned away these things, and your sins have withholden good things from you. Jeremiah 5:25

And they will deceive every one his neighbor, and will not speak the truth: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit **iniquity**. Jeremiah 9:5

They are turned back to the **iniquities** of their forefathers, which refused to hear My words; and they went after other gods to serve them: the house of Israel and the house of Judah have broken My covenant which I made with their fathers. Jeremiah 11:10

...If you say in your heart, Wherefore come these things upon me? For the greatness of your **iniquity** are your skirts discovered, and your heels made bare. Jeremiah 13:22

O LORD, though our **iniquities** testify against us, do it for Your name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against you. Jeremiah 14:7

Thus says the LORD unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD does not accept them; He will now remember their **iniquity**, and visit their sins. Jeremiah 14:10

We acknowledge, O LORD, our wickedness, and the **iniquity** of our fathers: for we have sinned against you. Jeremiah 14:20

And it shall come to pass, when you shall show this people all these words, and they shall say unto you, Wherefore has the LORD pronounced all this great evil against us? Or what is our **iniquity**? Or what is our sin that we have committed against the LORD our God? Jeremiah 16:10

For My eyes are upon all their ways: they are not hid from My face, neither is their **iniquity** hid from My eyes. And first I will recompense their **iniquity** and their sin double; because they have defiled My land, they have filled My inheritance with the carcases of their detestable and abominable things. Jeremiah 16:17-18

Yet, LORD, You know all their counsel against me to slay me: forgive not their **iniquity**, neither blot out their sin from Your sight, but let them be overthrown before You; deal thus with them in the time of Your anger. Jeremiah 18:23

And it shall come to pass, when seventy years are accomplished, that I will punish the king of Babylon, and that nation, says the LORD, for their **iniquity**, and the land of the Chaldeans, and will make it perpetual desolations. Jeremiah 25:12

All your lovers have forgotten you; they seek you not; for I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of your **iniquity**; because your sins were increased. Why cry you for your affliction? Your sorrow is incurable for the multitude of your **iniquity**: because your sins were increased, I have done these things unto you. Jeremiah 30:14-15

But every one shall die for his own **iniquity**: every man that eats the sour grape, his teeth shall be set on edge...And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know Me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, says the LORD: for I will forgive their **iniquity**, and I will remember their sins no more. Jeremiah 31:30, 34

You show loving kindness unto thousands, and recompense the **iniquity** of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, is His name. Jeremiah 32:18

And I will cleanse them from all their **iniquity**, whereby they have sinned against Me; and I will pardon all their **iniquities**, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against Me. Jeremiah 33:8

It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the evil which I purpose to do unto them; that they may return every man from his evil way; that I may forgive their **iniquity** and their sin... I will punish him and his seed and his servants for their **iniquity**; and I will bring upon them, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and upon the men of Judah, all the evil that I have pronounced against them; but they hearkened not. Jer 36:3, 31

In those days, and in that time, says the LORD, the **iniquity** of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve. Jeremiah 50:20

Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her **iniquity**; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengeance; He will render unto her a recompense. Jeremiah 51:6

Your prophets have seen vain and foolish things for you: and they have not discovered your **iniquity**, to turn away your captivity; but have seen for you false burdens and causes of banishment... For the punishment of the **iniquity** of the daughter of My people is greater than the punishment of the sin of Sodom, that was overthrown as in a moment, and no hands stayed on her. Lamentations 2:14, 4:6

For the sins of her prophets, and the **iniquities** of her priests, that have shed the blood of the just in the midst of her, They have wandered as blind men in the streets, they have polluted themselves with blood, so that men could not touch their garments. Lamentations 4:13-14

The punishment of your **iniquity** is accomplished, O daughter of Zion; He will no more carry you away into captivity: He will visit your **iniquity**, O daughter of Edom; He will discover your sins. Our fathers have sinned, and are not; and we have borne their **iniquities**. Lamentations 4:22, 5:7

When I say unto the wicked, You shall surely die; and you give him not warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his **iniquity**; but his blood will I require at your hand. Yet if you warn the wicked, and he turn not from his wickedness, nor from his wicked way, he shall die in his **iniquity**; but you have delivered your soul. Again, When a righteous man does turn from his righteousness, and commit **iniquity**, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die; because you have not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at your hand. Ezekiel 3:18-20

Lie you also upon your left side, and lay the **iniquity** of the house of Israel upon it: according to the number of the days that you shall lie upon it you shall bear their **iniquity**. For I have laid upon you the years of their **iniquity**, according to the number of the days, three hundred and ninety days: so shall you bear the **iniquity** of the house of Israel. And when you have accomplished them, lie again on your right side, and you shall bear the **iniquity** of the house of Judah forty days: I have appointed you each day for a year...That they may want bread and water, and be astonied one with another, and consume away for their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 4:4-6, 17

For the seller shall not return to that which is sold, although they were yet alive: for the vision is touching the whole multitude thereof, which shall not return; neither shall any strengthen himself in the **iniquity** of his life. Ezekiel 7:13

They that escape of them shall escape, and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his **iniquity**...They shall cast their silver in the streets, and their gold shall be removed: their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels: because it is the stumblingblock of their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 7:16, 19

Then said He unto me, The **iniquity** of the house is Israel and Judah is exceeding great, and the land is full of blood, and the city full of perverseness: for they say, the LORD has forsaken the earth, and the LORD sees not. Ezekiel 9:9

Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the stumblingblock of their **iniquity** before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them? Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus says the Lord GOD; Every man of the house of Israel that sets up his idols in his heart, and puts the stumblingblock of his **iniquity** before his face, and comes to the prophet; I the LORD will answer him that comes according to the multitude of his idols. Ezekiel 14:3-4

For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourns in Israel, which separates himself from me, and sets up his idols in his heart, and puts the stumblingblock of his **iniquity** before his face, and comes to a prophet to enquire of him concerning Me; I the LORD will answer him by Myself... Ezekiel 14:7

They shall bear the punishment of their **iniquity**: the punishment of the prophet shall be even as the punishment of him that seeks unto him...Ezekiel 14:10

Behold, this was the **iniquity** of your sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. Ezekiel 16:49

He that has not given forth upon usury, neither has taken any increase, that has withdrawn his hand from **iniquity**, has executed true judgment between man and man. Ezekiel 18:8

That has taken his hand from the poor, that has not received usury nor increase, has executed My judgments, has walked in My statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live. As for his father, because he cruelly oppressed, spoiled his brother by violence, and did that which is not good among his people, lo, even he shall die in his **iniquity**. Yet say you, Why? Does not the son bear the **iniquity** of the father? When the son has done that which is lawful and right, and has kept all My statutes, and has done them, he shall surely live. Eze 18:17-19

The soul that sins, it shall die. The son shall not bear the **iniquity** of the father, neither shall the father bear the **iniquity** of the son: the righteousness of the righteous shall be upon him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon him. Ezekiel 18:20

But when the righteous turns away from his righteousness, and commits **iniquity**, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All his righteousness that he had done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he has trespassed, and in his sin that he has sinned, in them shall he die. Ezekiel 18:24

When a righteous man turns away from his righteousness, and commits **iniquity**, and dies in them; for his **iniquity** that he has done shall he die...Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, says the Lord God. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so **iniquity** shall not be your ruin. Ezekiel 18:26, 30

And it shall be unto them as a false divination in their sight, to them that have sworn oaths: but He will call to remembrance the **iniquity**, that they may be taken. Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Because you have made your **iniquity** to be remembered, in that your transgressions are discovered, so that in all your doings your sins do appear; because, I say, that you are come to remembrance, you shall be taken with the land. And you, profane wicked prince of Israel, whose day is come, when **iniquity** shall have an end...Whiles they see vanity unto you, whiles they divine a lie unto you, to bring you upon the necks of them that are slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their **iniquity** shall have an end. Ezekiel 21:23-25, 29

And your tires shall be upon your heads, and your shoes upon your feet: you shall not mourn nor weep; but you shall pine away for your **iniquities**, and mourn one toward another. Eze 24:23

You were perfect in your ways from the day that you were created, till **iniquity** was found in you...You have defiled your sanctuaries by the multitude of your **iniquities**, by the **iniquity** of your traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of you, it shall devour you, and I will bring you to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold you. Ezekiel 28:15, 18

It shall be no more the confidence of the house of Israel, which brings their **iniquity** to remembrance, when they shall look after them: but they shall know that I am the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 29:16

And they shall not lie with the mighty that are fallen of the uncircumcised, which are gone down to hell with their weapons of war: and they have laid their swords under their heads, but their **iniquities** shall be upon their bones, though they were the terror of the mighty in the land of the living. Ezekiel 32:27

But if the watchman see the sword come, and blow not the trumpet, and the people be not warned; if the sword come, and take any person from among them, he is taken away in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at the watchman's hand...When I say unto the wicked, O wicked man, you shall surely die; if you do not speak to warn the wicked from his way, that wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at you hand. Nevertheless, if you warn the wicked of his way to turn from it; if he does not turn from his way, he shall die in his **iniquity**; but you have delivered your soul...When I shall say to the righteous, that he shall surely live; if he trust to his own righteousness, and commit iniquity, all his righteousnesses shall not be remembered; but for his iniquity that he has committed, he shall die for it...If the wicked restore the pledge, give again that he had robbed, walk in the statues of life, without committing iniquity; he shall surely live, he shall not die... When the righteous turns from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, he shall even die thereby. Ezekiel 33:6, 8-9, 13, 15, 18

Because you have had a perpetual hatred, and have shed the blood of the children of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time that their **iniquity** had an end... Ezekiel 35:5

Then shall you remember your own evil ways, and your doings that were not good, and shall loathe yourselves in your own sight for your **iniquities** and for your abominations...Thus says the Lord GOD; In the day that I shall have cleansed you from all your **iniquities** I will also cause you to dwell in the cities, and the wastes shall be built. Ezekiel 36:31, 33

And the heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their **iniquity**: because they trespassed against Me, therefore hid I My face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. Ezekiel 39:23

You son of man, show the house to the house of Israel, that they may be ashamed of their **iniquities**: and let them measure the pattern. Ezekiel 43:10

And the Levites that are gone away far from Me, when Israel went astray, which went away from Me after their idols; they shall even bear their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 44:10

Because they ministered unto them before their idols, and caused the house of Israel to fall into **iniquity**; therefore have I lifted up My hand against them, says the Lord GOD, and they shall bear their **iniquity**. Ezekiel 44:12

Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto you, and break off your sins by righteousness, and your **iniquities** by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of your tranquillity. Daniel 4:27

We have sinned, and have committed **iniquity**, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and from Your judgments... Daniel 9:5

As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our **iniquities**, and understand Your truth. Daniel 9:13

According to all Your righteousness, I beseech You, let Your anger and Your fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, the holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the **iniquities** of our fathers, Jerusalem and Your people are become a reproach to all that are about us. Daniel 9:16

Seventy weeks are determined upon Your people and upon Your holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for **iniquity**, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:24

They eat up the sin of My people, and they set their heart on their **iniquity**. Hosea 4:8

And the pride of Israel does testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their **iniquity**; Judah also shall fall with them. Hosea 5:5

When I would have healed Israel, then the **iniquity** of Ephraim was discovered, and the wickedness of Samaria: for they commit falsehood; and the thief comes in, and the troop of robbers spoils without. Hosea 7:1

They sacrifice flesh for the sacrifices of mine offerings, and eat it; but the LORD accepts them not; now will He remember their **iniquity**, and visit their sins: they shall return to Egypt. Hosea 8:13

The days of visitation are come, the days of recompense are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a fool, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of your **iniquity**, and the great hatred... They have deeply corrupted themselves, as in the days of Gibeah: therefore He will remember their **iniquity**, He will visit their sins. Hosea 9:7, 9

O Israel, you have sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of **iniquity** did not overtake them...You have plowed wickedness, you have reaped **iniquity**; you have eaten the fruit of lies: because you did trust in your way, in the multitude of your mighty men. Hosea 10:9, 13

And Ephraim said, Yet I am become rich, I have found me out substance: in all my labors they shall find none **iniquity** in me that were sin...Is there **iniquity** in Gilead? Surely they are vanity: they sacrifice bullocks in Gilgal; yes their altars are as heaps in the furrows of the fields. Hosea 12:8, 11

O Israel, return unto the LORD your God; for you have fallen by your **iniquity**. Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto Him, Take away all **iniquity**, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves of our lips. Hosea 14:1-2

You only have I known of all the families of the earth: therefore I will punish you for all your **iniquities**. Amos 3:2

Woe to them that devise **iniquity**, and work evil upon their beds! When the morning is light, they practice it, because it is in the power of their hand. Micah 2:1

Who is a God like unto You, that pardons **iniquity**, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He retains not His anger for ever, because He delights in mercy. He will turn again, He will have compassion upon us; He will subdue our **iniquities**; and you will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:18-19

Why do you show Me **iniquity**, and cause Me to behold grievance? For spoiling and violence are before Me: and there are that raise up strife and contention. Habakkuk 1:3

You are of purer eyes than to behold evil, and can not look on **iniquity**: wherefore look upon them that deal treacherously, and hold your tongue when the wicked devours the man that is more righteous than he? Habakkuk 1:13

Woe to him that builds a town with blood, and stablishes a city by **iniquity**! Habakkuk 2:12

The just LORD is in the midst thereof; He will not do **iniquity**: every morning does He bring His judgment to light, He fails not; but the unjust knows no shame. Zephaniah 3:5

The remnant of Israel shall not do **iniquity**, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:13

And He answered and spoke unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him He said, Behold, I have caused your **iniquity** to pass from you, and I will clothe you with change of raiment. Zechariah 3:4

For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua; upon one stone shall be seven eyes: behold, I will engrave the graving thereof, says the LORD of hosts, and I will remove the **iniquity** of that land in one day. Zechariah 3:9

The law of truth was in His mouth, and **iniquity** was not found in His lips: He walked with Me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from **iniquity**. Malachi 2:6

INIQUITY IN THE NEW COVENANT

Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name? and in Your name have cast out devils? and in Your name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from Me, you that work **iniquity**. Matthew 7:22-23

The Son of man shall send forth His angels, and they shall gather out of His kingdom all things that offend, and them which do **iniquity**; Matthew 13:41

Even so you also outwardly appear righteous unto men, but within you are full of hypocrisy and **iniquity**. Matthew 23:28

And because **iniquity** shall abound, the love of many shall wax [become] cold. Matthew 24:12

But He shall say, I tell you, I know you not whence you are; depart from Me, all you workers of **iniquity**. Luke 13:27

Now this man purchased a field with the reward of **iniquity**; and falling headlong, he burst asunder in the midst, and all his bowels gushed out. Acts 1:18

For I perceive that you are in the gall of bitterness, and in the bond of **iniquity**. Acts 8:23

Blessed are they whose **iniquities** are forgiven, and whose sins are covered...For as you have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to **iniquity** unto **iniquity**; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto holiness. Romans 4:7, 6:19

Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity vaunts not itself, is not puffed up, Does not behave itself unseemly, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil; Rejoices not in **iniquit**y, but rejoices in the truth; Bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Charity never fails... 1 Corinthians 13:5-8

For the mystery of **iniquity** does already work: only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way. 2 Thessalonians 2:7

Nevertheless the foundation of God stands sure, having this seal, The Lord knows them that are His. And, Let every one that names the name of Christ depart from **iniquity**. 2 Timothy 2:19

Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from all **iniquity**, and purify unto Himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works. Titus 2:14

You have loved righteousness, and hated **iniquity**; therefore God, even your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Hebrews 1:9

For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their **iniquities** will I remember no more. Hebrews 8:12

He had said before, This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord, I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and **iniquities** will I remember no more. Hebrews 10:15-17

And the tongue is a fire, a world of **iniquity**: so is the tongue among our members, that it defiles the whole body, and sets on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell. James 3:6

But was rebuked for his **iniquity**: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad the madness of the prophet. 2 Peter 2:16

For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God has remembered her **iniquities**. Revelations 18:5

MISCHIEF

But Benjamin, Joseph's brother, Jacob sent not with his brethren; for he said, Lest peradventure **mischief** befall him. Genesis 42:4

And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if **mischief** befall him by the way in the which you go, then shall you bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave. Genesis 42:38

And if you take this also from me, and **mischief** befall him, you shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave. Genesis 44:29

If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart from her, and yet no **mischief** follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges determine. And if any **mischief** follow, then you shall give life for life... Exodus 21:22-23

Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For **mischief** did He bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from your fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against your people. Exodus 32:12

And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: you know the people, that they are set on **mischief**. Exodus 32:22

I will heap **mischiefs** upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them. Deuteronomy 32:23

And David knew that Saul secretly practiced **mischief** against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod. 1 Samuel 23:9

The LORD has returned upon you all the blood of the house of Saul, in whose stead you have reigned; and the LORD has delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom your son: and behold, you are taken in your **mischief**, because you are a bloody man. 2 Samuel 16:8

And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the **mischief** that Hadad did: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria. 1 Kings 11:25

Then the king of Israel called all the elders of the land, and said, Mark, I pray you, and see how this man seeks **mischief**; for he sent unto me for my wives, and for my children, and for my silver, and for my gold; and I denied him not. 1 Kings 20:7

Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day is a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some **mischief** will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household. 2 Kings 7:9

That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in some one of the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me **mischief**. Nehemiah 6:2

Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and besought him with tears to put away the **mischief** of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews. Esther 8:3

They conceive **mischief**, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepares deceit. Job 15:35

Behold, he travails with iniquity, and has conceived **mischief**, and brought forth falsehood. He made a pit, and dug it, and has fallen into the ditch which he made. His **mischief** shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate. Psalm 7:14-16

His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is **mischief** and vanity... You have seen it; for you behold **mischief** and spite, to requite it with your hand: the poor commits himself unto you; you are the helper of the fatherless. Psalm 10:7, 15

For they intended evil against thee: they imagined a **mischievous** device, which they are not able to perform. Psalm 21:11

Gather not my soul with sinners, nor my life with bloody men. In whose hands is **mischief**, and their right hand is full of bribes. Psalm 26:9-10

Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak peace to their neighbors, but **mischief** is in their hearts. Psalm 28:3

He devises **mischief** upon his bed; he sets himself in a way that is not good; he abhors not evil. Psalm 36:4

They also that seek after my life lay snares for me: and they that seek my hurt speak **mischievous** things, and imagine deceits all the day long. Psalm 38:12

Why boast you yourself in **mischief**, O mighty man? The goodness of God endures continually. Your tongue devises **mischiefs**; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. Psalm 52:1-2

Day and night they go about it upon the walls thereof: **mischief** also and sorrow are in the midst of it. Psalm 55:10

How long will you imagine **mischief** against a man? You shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall shall you be, and as a tottering fence. Psalm 62:3

Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with You, which frames **mischief** by a law? Psalm 94:20

They draw nigh that follow after **mischief**: they are far from the law. Psalm 119:150

Deliver me, O Lord, from the evil man...Which imagine **mischiefs** in their heart; continually are they gathered together for war. Psalm 140:2

As for the head of those that compass me about, let the **mischief** of their own lips cover them. Psalm 140:9

For they sleep not, except they have done **mischief**; and their sleep is taken away, unless they cause some to fall. Proverbs 4:16

Frowardness is in his heart, he devises **mischief** continually; he sows discord. Proverbs 6:14

These six things does the LORD hate: yes, seven are an abomination unto him...An heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to **mischief**. Pro 6:18

It is as sport to a fool to do **mischief**; but a man of understanding has wisdom. Proverbs 10:23

He that diligently seeks good procures favor: but he that seeks **mischief**, it shall come unto him. Proverbs 11:27

There shall no evil happen to the just; but the wicked shall be filled with **mischief**. Proverbs 12:21

A wicked messenger falls into **mischief**: but a faithful ambassador is health. Proverbs 13:17

He that has a froward heart finds no good: and he that has a perverse tongue falls into **mischief**. Proverbs 17:20

For their heart studies destruction, and their lips talk of **mischief**. Proverbs 24:2

He that devises to do evil shall be called a **mischievous** person. Proverbs 24:8

For a just man falls seven times, and rises up again: but the wicked shall fall into **mischief**. Proverbs 24:16

Happy is the man that fears always: but he that hardens his heart shall fall into **mischief**. Proverbs 28:14

The beginning of the words of his mouth is foolishness: and the end of his talk is **mischievous** madness. Ecclesiastes 10:13

Therefore shall evil come upon you; you shall not know from whence it rises: and **mischief** shall fall upon you; you shall not be able to put it off: and desolation shall come upon you suddenly, which you shall not know. Isaiah 47:11

None calls for justice, nor any pleads for truth: for they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive **mischief**, and bring forth iniquity. Isaiah 59:4

Mischief shall come upon **mischief**, and rumor shall be upon rumor; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients. Ezekiel 7:26

Then said he unto me, Son of man, these are the men that devise **mischief**, and give wicked counsel in this city... Ezekiel 11:2

And both these kings' hearts shall be to do **mischief**, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not prosper: for yet the end shall be at the time appointed. Daniel 11:27

Though I have bound and strengthened their arms, yet do they imagine **mischief** against me. Hosea 7:15

That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asks, and the judge asks for a reward; and the great man, he utters his **mischievous** desire: so they wrap it up. Micah 7:3

And said, O full of all subtilty and all **mischief**, you child of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, will you not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? Acts 13:10

PRIDE

Now I know that the LORD is greater than all gods: for in the thing wherein they dealt **proudly** He was above them. Ex 18:11

I will break the **pride** of your power; and I will make your heaven as iron, and your earth as brass... Leviticus 26:19

Talk no more so exceeding **proudly**; let not **arrogancy** come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by Him actions are weighed. 1 Samuel 2:3

Eliab his eldest brother heard when he spake unto the men; and Eliab's anger was kindled against David, and he said, Why came you down hither? and with whom have you left those few sheep in the wilderness? I know your **pride**, and the naughtiness of your heart; for you are come down that you might see the battle. 1 Samuel 17:28

Notwithstanding Hezekiah humbled himself for the **pride** of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 32:26

And showed signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for you knew that they dealt **proudly** against them. So did you get you a name, as it is this day...They and our fathers dealt **proudly**, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Your commandments...and testified against them, that You might bring them again unto Your law: yet they dealt **proudly**, and hearkened not unto Your commandments, but sinned against Your judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear. Nehemiah 9:10, 16, 29

If God will not withdraw His anger, the **proud** helpers do stoop under Him. He divides the sea with His power, and by His understanding He smites through the **proud**. Job 9:13, 26:12

Then He opens the ears of men, and seals their instruction, That He withdraw man from his purpose, and hide **pride** from man. He keeps back his soul from the pit, and his life from perishing by the sword. Job 33:14-18

There they cry, but none gives answer, because of the **pride** of evil men. Surely God will not hear vanity... Job 35:12-13

Who shut up the sea with doors... And said, Hitherto shall you come, but no further: and here shall your **proud** waves be stayed? Job 38:8, 11

Cast abroad the rage of your wrath: and behold every one that is **proud**, and abase him. Look on every one that is **proud**, and bring him low; and tread down the wicked in their place. Job 40:11-12

His scales are his **pride**, shut up together as with a close seal... He beholds all high things: he is a king over all the children of **pride**. Job 41:15, 34

The wicked in his **pride** does persecute the poor: let them be taken in the devices that they have imagined...The wicked, through the **pride** of his countenance, will not seek after God; God is not in all his thoughts. Psalm 10:2, 4

The LORD shall cut off all flattering lips, and the tongue that speaks **proud** things... Psalm 12:3

They are inclosed in their own fat: with their mouth they speak **proudly**. Psalm 17:10

Let the lying lips be put to silence; which speak grievous things **proudly** and contemptuously against the righteous...You shall hide them in the secret of Your presence from the **pride** of man: you shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues...O love the LORD, all you His saints: for the LORD preserves the faithful, and plentifully rewards the **proud** doer. Psalm 31:18, 20, 23

Let not the foot of **pride** come against me, and let not the hand of the wicked remove me. Psalm 36:11

Blessed is that man that makes the LORD his trust, and respects not the **proud**, nor such as turn aside to lies. Psalm 40:4

For the sin of their mouth and the words of their lips let them even be taken in their **pride**: and for cursing and lying which they speak. Psalm 59:12

I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked. For there are no bands in their death: but their strength is firm. They are not in trouble as other men: neither are they plagued like other men. Therefore **pride** compasses them about as a chain; violence covers them as a garment. Ps 73:3-6

O God, the **proud** are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set You before them. Psalm 86:14

Lift up Yourself, You judge of the earth: render a reward to the **proud**. Psalm 94:2

Whoso privily slanders his neighbor, him will I cut off: him that has an high look and a **proud** heart will not I suffer. Psalm 101:5

You have rebuked the **proud** that are cursed, which do err from Your commandments...The **proud** have had me greatly in derision: yet have I not declined from Your law. Psalm 119:21,51

The **proud** have forged a lie against me: but I will keep your precepts with my whole heart...Let the **proud** be ashamed; for they dealt perversely with me without a cause: but I will meditate in Your precepts...The **proud** have dug pits for me, which are not after Your law. Psalm 119:69, 78, 85

Be surety for Your servant for good: let not the **proud** oppress me. Psalm 119:122

Our soul is exceedingly filled with the scorning of those that are at ease, and with the contempt of the **proud**. Psalm 123:4

Then they had swallowed us up quick, when their wrath was kindled against us: then the waters had overwhelmed us, the stream had gone over our soul: Then the **proud** waters had gone over our soul. Psalm 124:3-5

Though the LORD be high, yet has He respect unto the lowly: but the **proud** He knows afar off. Psalm 138:6

The **proud** have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. Psalm 140:5

These six things does the LORD hate: yes, seven are an abomination unto Him: A **proud** look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, an heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, a false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren. Proverbs 6:16-19

The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: **pride**, and **arrogancy**, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. Proverbs 8:13

When **pride** comes, then comes shame: but with the lowly is wisdom. Proverbs 11:2

Only by **pride** comes contention: but with the well advised is wisdom. Proverbs 13:10

In the mouth of the foolish is a rod of **pride**: but the lips of the wise shall preserve them. Proverbs 14:3

The LORD will destroy the house of the **proud**: but He will establish the border of the widow. Proverbs 15:25

Every one that is **proud** in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished... **Pride** goes before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the **proud**. Proverbs 16:5, 18-19

An high look, and a **proud** heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin...**Proud** and haughty scorner is his name, who deals in **proud** wrath. Proverbs 21:4, 24

He that is of a **proud** heart stirs up strife: but he that puts his trust in the LORD shall be made fat. Proverbs 28:25

A man's **pride** shall bring him low: but honor shall uphold the humble in spirit. Proverbs 29:23

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the patient in spirit is better than the **proud** in spirit. Ecclesiastes 7:8

For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is **proud** and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low... Isaiah 2:12

And the people shall be oppressed, every one by another, and every one by his neighbor: the child shall behave himself **proudly** against the ancient, and the base against the honorable. Isaiah 3:5

All the people shall know, even Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria, that say in the **pride** and stoutness of heart, The bricks are fallen down, but we will build with hewn stones... Is 9:9-10

And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the **arrogancy** of the **proud** to cease, and will lay low the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:11

We have heard of the **pride** of Moab; he is very **proud**: even of his haughtiness, and his **pride**, and his wrath: but his lies shall not be so. Isaiah 16:6

The Lord of hosts has purposed it, to stain the **pride** of all glory, and to bring into contempt all the honorable of the earth. Is 23:9

And he shall spread forth his hands in the midst of them, as he that swims spreads forth his hands to swim: and he shall bring down their **pride** together with the spoils of their hands. Isaiah 25:11

Woe to the crown of **pride**, to the drunkards of Ephraim, whose glorious beauty is a fading flower, which are on the head of the fat valleys of them that are overcome with wine! Behold, the Lord has a mighty and strong one, which as a tempest of hail and destroying storm, as a flood of mighty waters overflowing, shall cast down to the earth with the hand. The crown of **pride**, the drunkards of Ephraim, shall be trodden under feet. Is 28:1-3

Thus says the LORD, After this manner will I mar the **pride** of Judah, and the great **pride** of Jerusalem...Hear you, and give ear; be not proud: for the LORD has spoken...But if you will not hear it, my soul shall weep in secret places for your **pride**; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD'S flock is carried away captive. Jeremiah 13:9, 15

Then spake Azariah the son of Hoshaiah, and Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the **proud** men, saying unto Jeremiah, You speak falsely: the LORD our God has not sent you to say, Go not into Egypt to sojourn there... Jeremiah 43:2

We have heard the pride of Moab, (he is exceeding proud) his loftiness, and his **arrogancy**, and his **pride**, and the haughtiness of his heart. Jeremiah 48:29

Your terribleness has deceived you, and the **pride** of your heart, O you who dwells in the clefts of the rock, that holds the height of the hill: though you should make your nest as high as the eagle, I will bring you down from there, says the LORD. Jeremiah 49:16

Call together the archers against Babylon: all you that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she has done, do unto her: for she has been **proud** against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel. Jeremiah 50:29

Behold, I am against you, O you most **proud**, says the Lord GOD of hosts: for your day is come, the time that I will visit you. And the most **proud** shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him. Jeremiah 50:31-32

Behold, the day, behold, it is come: the morning is gone forth; the rod has blossomed, **pride** has budded. Ezekiel 7:10

Behold, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom, **pride**, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy...For your sister Sodom was not mentioned by your mouth in the day of your **pride**... Ezekiel 16:49, 56

Thus says the LORD; they also that uphold Egypt shall fall; and the **pride** of her power shall come down: from the tower of Syene shall they fall in it by the sword, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 30:6

Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all whose works are truth, and His ways judgment: and those that walk in **pride** He is able also to abase. Daniel 4:37

When his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in **pride**, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him...till he knew that the Most High God ruled in the kingdom of men. Daniel 5:20

The **pride** of Israel does testify to His face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them...and the **pride** of Israel testifies to His face: and they do not return to the LORD their God, nor seek Him... Hosea 5:5, 7:10

The **pride** of your heart has deceived you, you who dwell in the clefts of the rock, whose habitation is high; that says in his heart, Who shall bring me down to the ground?...But you should not have looked on the day of your brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither should you have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither should you have spoken **proudly** in the day of distress. Obadiah 1:3, 12

Yes, also, because he transgresses by wine, he is a **proud** man, neither keeps at home, who enlarges his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathers unto him all nations, and heaps unto him all people... Habakkuk 2:5

This shall they have for their **pride**, because they have reproached and magnified themselves against the people of the LORD of hosts. Zephaniah 2:10

In that day shall you be not ashamed for all your doings, wherein you have transgressed against Me: for then I will take away out of the midst of you them that rejoice in your **pride**, and you shall no more be haughty because of My holy mountain. Zephaniah 3:11

Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and he will smite her power in the sea...A bastard shall dwell in Ashdod, and I will cut off the **pride** of the Philistines. Zechariah 9:6

He shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves of the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall dry up: and the **pride** of Assyria shall be brought down, and the scepter of Egypt shall depart away. Zechariah 10:11

There is a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the **pride** of Jordan is spoiled. Zechariah 11:3

Now we call the **proud** happy; yes, they that work wickedness are set up; yes, they that tempt God are even delivered. Malachi 3:15

PRIDE IN THE NEW COVENANT

For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, **pride**, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile [corrupt] the man. Mark 7:21-23

He has shown strength with His arm; He has scattered the **proud** in the imagination of their hearts. Luke 1:51

...They did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, Backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, **proud**, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32

A bishop then must be...one that rules well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he then take care of the church of God?) Not a novice, lest being lifted up with **pride** he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 1 Timothy 3:4-6

If any man teach otherwise, and consent not to wholesome words, even the words of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness; He is **proud**, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof comes envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw yourself. But godliness with contentment is great gain. 1 Timothy 6:3-5

In the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, **proud**, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce, despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, high-minded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 2 Timothy 3:1-5

From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? You lust, and have not: you kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: you fight and war, yet you have not, because you ask not. You ask, and receive not, because you ask amiss, that you may consume it upon your lusts. You adulterers and adulteresses, know you not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? Whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. Do you think that the scripture says in vain, The spirit that dwells in us lusts to envy? But He gives more grace. Wherefore He says, God resists the proud, but gives grace unto the humble. Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble vourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up. James 4:1-10

You younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yes, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resists the **proud**, and gives grace to the humble. Humble yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time: Casting all your care upon Him; for He cares for you. 1 Peter 5:5-7

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the **pride** of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: but he that does the will of God abides for eyer. 1 John 2:15-17

SNARE AND SNARES

Pharoah's servants said unto him, How long shall this man be a **snare** unto us? Let the men go, that they may serve the LORD their God: know you not yet that Egypt is destroyed! Exodus 10:7

They shall not dwell in your land, lest they make you sin against Me: for if you serve other gods, it will surely be a **snare** unto you. Exodus 23:33

Take heed to yourself, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land whither you go, lest it be for a **snare** in the midst of you. Exodus 34:12

You shall consume all the people which the LORD your God shall deliver you; your eye shall have no pity upon them: neither shall you serve their gods; for that will be a **snare** unto you. Deuteronomy 7:16

Know for a certainty that the LORD your God will no more drive out any of these nations from before you; but they shall be **snares** and traps unto you, and scourges in your sides, and thorns in your eyes, until you perish from off this good land which the LORD your God has given you. Joshua 23:13

I also said, I will not drive them out from before you; but they shall be as thorns in your sides, and their gods shall be a **snare** unto you. Judges 2:3

Gideon made an ephod thereof, and put it in his city, even in Ophrah: and all Israel went thither a whoring after it: which thing became a **snare** unto Gideon, and to his house. Judges 8:27

Saul said, I will give him her, that she may be a **snare** to him, and that the hand of the Philistines may be against him. Wherefore Saul said to David, You shall this day be my son in law in the one of the twain. 1 Samuel 18:21

You know what Saul has done, how he has cut off those that have familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then lay you a **snare** for my life, to cause me to die? 1 Samuel 28:9

The sorrows of hell compassed me about; the **snares** of death prevented me. 2 Samuel 22:6

For he is cast into a net by his own feet, and he walks upon a **snare**. The gin shall take him by the heel, and the robber shall prevail against him. The **snare** is laid for him in the ground, and a trap for him in the way. Job 18:8-10

Therefore **snares** are round about you, and sudden fear troubles you... Job 22:10

He takes it with his eyes: his nose pierces through **snares**. Job 40:24

Upon the wicked he shall rain **snares**, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: this shall be the portion of their cup. Psalm 11:6

The sorrows of hell compassed me about: the **snares** of death prevented me. Psalm 18:5

They encourage themselves in an evil matter: they commune of laying **snares** privily; they say, Who shall see them? Psalm 64:5

Let their table become a **snare** before them: and that which should have been for their welfare, let it become a trap. Psalm 69:22

Surely He shall deliver you from the **snare** of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. Psalm 91:3

They served their idols: which were a **snare** unto them. Psalm 106:36

The wicked have laid a **snare** for me: yet I erred not from Your precepts. Psalm 119:110

Our soul is escaped as a bird out of the **snare** of the fowlers: the **snare** is broken, and we are escaped. Psalm 124:7

The proud have hid a **snare** for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. Psalm 140:5

Keep me from the **snares** which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity. Psalm 141:9

When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then You knew my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a **snare** for me. Psalm 142:3

With her much fair speech she caused him to yield, with the flattering of her lips she forced him. He goes after her straitway, as an ox goes to the slaughter, or as a fool to the correction of the stocks; Till a dart strike through his liver; as a bird hastes to the **snare**, and knows not that it is for his life. Proverbs 7:21-23

The law of the wise is a fountain of life, to depart from the **snares** of death. Proverbs 13:14

The fear of the LORD is a fountain of life, to depart from the **snares** of death. Proverbs 14:27

A fool's mouth is his destruction, and his lips are the **snare** of his soul. Proverbs 18:7

It is a **snare** to the man who devours that which is holy, and after vows to make enquiry. Proverbs 20:25

Thorns and **snares** are in the way of the froward: he that does keep his soul shall be far from them...Make no friendship with an angry man; and with a furious man you shall not go: lest you learn his ways, and get a **snare** to your soul. Proverbs 22:5, 24-25

In the transgression of an evil man there is a **snare**: but the righteous does sing and rejoice...Scornful men bring a city into a **snare**; but wise men turn away wrath. Proverbs 29:6, 8

The fear of man brings a **snare**: but whoso puts his trust in the LORD shall be safe. Proverbs 29:25

I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is **snares** and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleases God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Ecclesiastes 7:26

For man also knows not his time: as the fishes that are taken in an evil net, and as the birds that are caught in the **snare**; so are the sons of men **snared** in an evil time, when it falls suddenly upon them. Ecclesiastes 9:12

He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a **snare** to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Many among them shall stumble, and fall, and be broken, and be **snared**, and be taken. Isaiah 8:14-15

Fear, and the pit, and the **snare**, are upon you, O inhabitant of the earth. And it shall come to pass, that he who flees from the noise of the fear shall fall into the pit; and he that comes up out of the midst of the pit shall be taken in the **snare**: for the windows from on high are open, and the foundations of the earth do shake. Isaiah 24:17-18

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off: That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a **snare** for him that reproves in the gate, and turn aside the just for a thing of nought. Isaiah 29:20-21

For among My people are found wicked men: they lay wait, as he that sets **snares**; they set a trap, they catch men. Jeremiah 5:26

Let a cry be heard from their houses, when you shall bring a troop suddenly upon them: for they have dug a pit to take me, and hid **snares** for my feet. Jeremiah 18:22

Fear, and the pit, and the **snare**, shall be upon you, O inhabitant of Moab, says the LORD. He that flees from the fear shall fall into the pit; and he that gets up out of the pit shall be taken in the **snare**: for I will bring upon it, even upon Moab, the year of their visitation, says the LORD. Jeremiah 48:43-44

I have laid a **snare** for you, and you are also taken, O Babylon, and you were not aware: you are found, and also caught, because you have striven against the LORD. Jer 50:24

Fear and a **snare** is come upon us, desolation and destruction. Lamentations 3:45

My net also will I spread upon him, and he shall be taken in My **snare**: and I will bring him to Babylon to the land of the Chaldeans; yet shall he not see it, though he shall die there. Ezekiel 12:13

I will spread My net upon him, and he shall be taken in My **snare**, and I will bring him to Babylon, and will plead with him there for his trespass that he has trespassed against Me. Ezekiel 17:20

Hear you this, O priests; and hearken, you house of Israel; and give you ear, O house of the king; for judgment is toward you, because you have been a **snare** on Mizpah... Hosea 5:1

The watchman of Ephraim was with my God: but the prophet is a **snare** of a fowler in all his ways, and hatred in the house of his God. Hosea 9:8

Can a bird fall in a **snare** upon the earth, where no gin is for him? Shall one take up a **snare** from the earth, and have taken nothing at all? Amos 3:5

Take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. For as a **snare** shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. Watch you therefore, and pray always, that you may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. Luke 21:34-36

Let their table be made a **snare**, and a trap, and a stumblingblock, and a recompense unto them... Romans 11:9

The unmarried woman cares for the things of the Lord... but she that is married cares for the things of the world, how she may please her husband. This I speak for your own profit; not that I may cast a **snare** upon you, but for that which is comely, and that you may attend upon the Lord without distraction. 1 Corinthians 7:34-35

A bishop then must be blameless...Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach and the **snare** of the devil...Having food and raiment let us be therewith content. But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a **snare**, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. 1 Timothy 3: 2, 7, 6:8-9

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the **snare** of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:26

STUMBLE - STUMBLINGBLOCK

You shall not curse the deaf, nor put a **stumblingblock** before the blind, but shall fear your God: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:14

The bows of the mighty men are broken, and they that **stumbled** are girded with strength. 1 Samuel 2:4

When they came unto the threshingfloor of Chidon, Uzza put forth his hand to hold the ark; for the oxen **stumbled**. 1 Chronicles 13:9

When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they **stumbled** and fell. Psalm 27:2

My son, let not them depart from your eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion: So shall they be life unto your soul, and grace to your neck. Then shall you walk in your way safely, and your foot shall not **stumble**...I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in right paths. When you go, your steps shall not be straitened; and when you run, you shall not **stumble**... The way of the wicked is as darkness: they know not at what they **stumble**. Proverbs 3:21-23, 4:11-12, 19

Rejoice not when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he **stumbles**: Lest the LORD see it, and it displease Him, and He turn away His wrath from Him. Proverbs 24:17-18

None shall be weary nor **stumble** among them; none shall slumber nor sleep; neither shall the girdle of their loins be loosed, nor the latchet of their shoes be broken... Isaiah 5:27

He shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of **stumbling** and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. Many among them shall **stumble**, and fall, and be broken, and be snared, and be taken. Isaiah 8:14-15

They also have erred through wine, and through strong drink are out of the way; the priest and the prophet have erred through strong drink, they are swallowed up of wine, they are out of the way through strong drink; they err in vision, they **stumble** in judgment. Isaiah 28:7

Cast you up, cast you up, prepare the way, take up the **stumblingblock** out of the way of My people. Isaiah 57:14

We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we **stumble** at noonday as in the night... Isaiah 59:10

Where is He that brought them up out of the sea with the shepherd of His flock? Where is He that put His holy Spirit within Him? That led them by the right hand of Moses with His glorious arm, dividing the water before them, to make Himself an everlasting name? That led them through the deep, as an horse in the wilderness, that they should not **stumble**? Isaiah 63:11-13

Therefore thus says the LORD, Behold, I will lay **stumblingblocks** before this people, and the fathers and the sons together shall fall upon them; the neighbor and his friend shall perish. Jeremiah 6:21

Give glory to the LORD your God, before He cause darkness, and before your feet **stumble** upon the dark mountains, and, while you look for light, He turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness. Jeremiah 13:16

Because My people have forgotten Me, they have burned incense to vanity, and they have caused them to **stumble** in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up; To make their land desolate, and a perpetual hissing, every one that passes thereby shall be astonished, and wag his head. Jeremiah 18:15

The LORD is with me as a mighty terrible one: therefore my persecutors shall **stumble**, and they shall not prevail: they shall be greatly ashamed; for they shall not prosper: their everlasting confusion shall never be forgotten. Jer 20:11

They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not **stumble**: for I am a Father to Israel, and Ephraim is My firstborn. Jeremiah 31:9

Let not the swift flee away, nor the mighty man escape; they shall **stumble**, and fall toward the north by the river Euphrates. Jeremiah 46:6

The nations have heard of your shame, and your cry has filled the land: for the mighty man has **stumbled** against the mighty, and they are fallen both together. Jeremiah 46:12

The most proud shall **stumble** and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him. Jeremiah 50:32

Again, When a righteous man does turn from his righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a **stumblingblock** before him, he shall die: because you have not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he has done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at your hand. Ezekiel 3:20

Their silver and their gold shall not be able to deliver them in the day of the wrath of the LORD: they shall not satisfy their souls, neither fill their bowels; because it is the **stumblingblock** of their iniquity. Ezekiel 7:19

Son of man, these men have set up their idols in their heart, and put the **stumblingblock** of their iniquity before their face: should I be enquired of at all by them? Therefore speak unto them, and say unto them, Thus says the Lord GOD; Every man of the house of Israel that sets up his idols in his heart, and puts the **stumblingblock** of his iniquity before his face, and comes to the prophet; I the LORD will answer him that comes according to the multitude of his idols...For every one of the house of Israel, or of the stranger that sojourns in Israel, which separates himself from Me, and sets up his idols in his heart, and puts the **stumblingblock** of his iniquity before his face, and comes to a prophet to enquire of him concerning Me; I the LORD will answer him by Myself. Ezekiel 14:3-4, 7

Then he shall turn his face toward the fort of his own land: but he shall **stumble** and fall, and not be found. Daniel 11:19

He shall recount his worthies: they shall **stumble** in their walk; they shall make haste to the wall thereof, and the defense shall be prepared...The horseman lifts up both the bright sword and the glittering spear: and there is a multitude of slain, and a great number of carcases; and there is none end of their corpses; they **stumble** upon their corpses... Nahum 2:5, 3:3

I will consume man and beast; I will consume the fowls of the heaven, and the fishes of the sea, and the **stumblingblocks** with the wicked; and I will cut off man from off the land, says the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Zephaniah 1:3

But you are departed out of the way; you have caused many to **stumble** at the law; you have corrupted the covenant of Levi, and the LORD of hosts. Malachi 2:8

Are there not twelve hours in a day? If any man walk in the day, he **stumbles** not, because he sees the light of this world. But if a man walk in the night, he **stumbles**, because there is no light in him. John 1:9-10

Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they **stumbled** at that **stumblingstone**; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a **stumblingstone** and rock of offence: and whosoever believes on Him shall not be ashamed. Romans 9:32-33

David said, Let their table be make a snare, and a trap, and a **stumblingblock**, and a recompense unto them: Let their eyes be darkened, that they may not see, and bow down their back always. I say then, Have they **stumbled** that they should fall? God forbid: but rather through their fall salvation is come unto the Gentiles, for to provoke them to jealousy. Romans 11:9-11

Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a **stumblingblock** or an occasion to fall in his brother's way...It is good neither to eat flesh, nor to drink wine, nor any thing whereby your brother **stumbles**, or is offended, or is made weak. Romans 14:13, 21

We preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a **stumblingblock**, and unto the Greeks foolishness...Take heed lest by any means this liberty of yours become a **stumblingblock** to them that are weak. 1 Corinthians 1:23, 8:9

Unto them which be disobedient...the same is made... A stone of **stumbling**, and a rock of offence, even to them which **stumble** at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. 1 Peter 2:7-8

He that loves his brother abides in the light, and there is none occasion of **stumbling** in him. 1 John 2:10

I have a few things against you, because you have there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balac to cast a **stumblingblock** before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed unto idols, and to commit fornication. Revelation 2:14

TRUTH ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

The **transgressors** shall be destroyed together: the end of the wicked shall be cut off. Psalm 37:38

I beheld the **transgressors**, and was grieved; because they kept not Your word. Psalm 119:158

The wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the **transgressors** shall be rooted out of it. Proverbs 2:22

The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of **transgressors** shall destroy them...The righteousness of the upright shall deliver them: but **transgressors** shall be taken in their own naughtiness. Proverbs 11:3,6

A man shall eat good by the fruit of his mouth: but the soul of the **transgressors** shall eat violence. Proverbs 13:2

Good understanding gives favor: but the way of the **transgressors** is hard. Proverbs 13:15

A divine sentence is in the lips of the king: his mouth **transgresses** not in judgment. Proverbs 16:10

The wicked shall be a ransom for the righteous, and the **transgressor** for the upright. Proverbs 21:18

A whore is a deep ditch; and a strange woman is a narrow pit. She also lies in wait as for a prey, and increases the **transgressors** among men. Proverbs 23:27-28

To have respect of persons is not good: for for a piece of bread that man will **transgress**. Proverbs 28:21

Wherefore will you plead with Me? You all have **transgressed** against Me, says the LORD. Jeremiah 2:29

If you fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, You shall love your neighbor as yourself, you do well: But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as **transgressors**. James 2:9

Whoever commits sin **transgresses** also the law; for sin is the **transgression** of the law. 1 John 3:4

TEACHINGS ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Why do Your disciples **transgress** the tradition of the elders? For they wash not their hands when they eat bread. But He answered and said unto them, Why do you also **transgress** the commandment of God by your tradition? Matthew 15:2-3

He answering said to his father, Lo, these many years do I serve you, neither **transgressed** I at any time your commandment: and yet you never gave me a kid, that I might make merry with my friends: But as soon as this your son was come, who has devoured your living with harlots, you have killed for him the fatted calf. And he said unto him, Son, you are ever with me, and all that I have is yours. It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this your brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost, and is found. Luke 15:29-32

If the uncircumcision keep the righteousness of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision? and shall not uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, judge you, who by the letter and circumcision do **transgress** the law? For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. Romans 2:26-29

If I build again the things which I destroyed, I make myself a **transgressor**...Wherefore then serves the law? It was added because of **transgressions**, till the seed should come to whom the promise was made...Galatians 2:18, 3:19

He is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the **transgression**s that were under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance. Hebrews 9:15

For He that said, Do not commit adultery, said also, Do not kill. Now if you commit no adultery, yet if you kill, you have become a **transgressor** of the law. James 2:11

Whoever **transgresses**, and abides not in the doctrine of Christ, has not God. 2 John 1:9

PROPHECIES ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Yes, you heard not; yes, you knew not; yes, from that time that your ear was not opened: for I knew that you would deal very treacherously, and was called a **transgressor** from the womb. For My name's sake will I defer mine anger, and for My praise will I refrain for you, that I cut you not off. Isaiah 48:8-9

Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He has poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the **transgressors**; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the **transgressors**. Isaiah 53:12

They shall go forth, and look upon the carcases of the men that have **transgressed** against Me: for their worm shall not die, neither shall their fire be quenched; and they shall be an abhorring unto all flesh. Isaiah 66:24

In the latter time of their kingdom, when the **transgressors** are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up. And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people. Daniel 8:23-24

In that day shall you not be ashamed for all your doings, wherein you have **transgressed** against Me: for then I will take away out of the midst of you them that rejoice in your pride, and you shall no more be haughty because of My holy mountain. I will also leave in the midst of you an afflicted and poor people, and they shall trust in the name of the LORD. The remnant of Israel shall not do iniquity, nor speak lies; neither shall a deceitful tongue be found in their mouth: for they shall feed and lie down, and none shall make them afraid. Zephaniah 3:11-13

The scripture was fulfilled, which said, And he was numbered with the **transgressors**. Mark 15:28

This that is written must yet be accomplished in Me, And He was reckoned among the **transgressors**: for the things concerning Me have an end. Luke 22:37

CONSEQUENCES OF TRANSGRESSION

Behold, I send an Angel before you, to keep you in the way, and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your **transgressions**: for My name is in him. But if you shall indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto your enemies, and an adversary unto your adversaries. Exodus 23:20-22

And Aaron shall lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat, and confess over him all the iniquities of the children of Israel, and all their **transgressions** in all their sins, putting them upon the head of the goat, and shall send him away by the hand of a fit man into the wilderness... Leviticus 16:21

They rose up early in the morning, and they went up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we are here, and will go up unto the place which the LORD has promised: for we have sinned. And Moses said, Wherefore now do you **transgress** the commandment of the LORD? But it shall not prosper. Go not up, for the LORD is not among you; that you be not smitten before your enemies...But they presumed to go up unto the hill top: nevertheless the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and Moses, departed not out of the camp. Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanite which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, even unto Hormah. Numbers 14:41-45

He shall make an atonement for the holy place, because of the uncleanness of the children of Israel, and because of their **transgressions** in all their sins: and so shall he do for the tabernacle of the congregation, that remains among them in the midst of their uncleanness. Leviticus 16:16

If there be found among you, within any of your gates which the LORD your God gives you, man or woman, that has wrought wickedness in the sight of the LORD your God, in **transgressing** His covenant, and has gone and served other gods, and worshiped them, either the sun, or moon, or any of the host of heaven, which I have not commanded...Then shall you bring forth that man or that woman...and shall stone them with stones, till they die. Deuteronomy 17:2-5

Israel has sinned, and they have also **transgressed** My covenant which I commanded them: for they have even taken of the accursed thing, and have also stolen, and dissembled also, and they have put it even among their own stuff...And it shall be, that he that is taken with the accursed thing shall be burnt with fire, he and all that he has: because he has **transgressed** the covenant of the LORD, and because he has wrought folly in Israel. Joshua 7:11, 15

When you have **transgressed** the covenant of the LORD your God, which He commanded you, and have gone and served other gods, and bowed yourselves to them; then shall the anger of the LORD be kindled against you, and you shall perish quickly from off the good land which He has given unto you. Joshua 23:16

Therefore fear the LORD, and serve Him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve you the LORD. And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom you will serve...Joshua said unto the people, You cannot serve the LORD: for He is an holy God; He is a jealous God; He will not forgive your **transgressions** nor your sins. If you forsake the LORD, and serve strange gods, then He will turn and do you hurt, and consume you, after that He has done you good. And the people said unto Joshua, No; but we will serve the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Joshua 24:14-21

The anger of the LORD was hot against Israel; and He said, Because this people has **transgressed** My covenant which I commanded their fathers, and have not hearkened unto My voice; I also will not henceforth drive out any from before them of the nations which Joshua left when he died. Judges 2:20-21

Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation. And he said unto them, Why do you such things? For I hear of your evil dealings by all this people. No, my sons; for it is no good report that I hear: you make the LORD'S people to **transgress**. If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall entreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would...

slay them...And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him...This shall be a sign unto you, that shall come upon your two sons, on Hophni and Phinehas; in one day they shall die both of them. 1 Samuel 2:22-25, 27,36

The people flew upon the spoil, and took sheep, and oxen, and calves, and slew them on the ground: and the people did eat them with the blood. They told Saul, saying, Behold, the people sin against the LORD, in that they eat with the blood. And he said, You have **transgressed**: roll a great stone unto me this day. 1 Samuel 14:32-33

For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, He has also rejected you from being king. And Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have **transgressed** the commandment of the LORD, and your words: because I feared the people, and obeyed their voice. Now therefore, I pray, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD. And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with you: for you have rejected the word of the LORD, and the LORD has rejected you from being king over Israel. 1 Samuel 15:23-26

The king of Assyria did carry away Israel unto Assyria...Because they obeyed not the voice of the LORD their God, but **transgressed** His covenant, and all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded, and would not hear them, nor do them. 2 Kings 13:11-12

They **transgressed** against the God of their fathers, and went a whoring after the gods of the people of the land, whom God destroyed before them. And the God of Israel stirred up the spirit of Pul king of Assyria, and the spirit of Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria, and he carried them away... 1 Chronicles 5:25-26

It came to pass, when Rehoboam had established the kingdom, and had strengthened himself, he forsook the law of the LORD, and all Israel with him. And it came to pass that in the fifth year of king Rehoboam Shishak king of Egypt came up against Jerusalem, because they had **transgressed** against the LORD... 2 Chronicles 12 1-2

The Spirit of God came upon Zechariah the son of Jehoiada the priest, which stood above the people, and said unto them, Thus says God, Why **transgress** you the commandments of the LORD, that you cannot prosper? Because you have forsaken the LORD, He has also forsaken you. 2 Chronicles 24:20

When he was strong, his heart was lifted up to his destruction: for he **transgressed** against the LORD his God, and went into the temple of the LORD to burn incense upon the altar of incense. 2 Chronicles 26:16

For the LORD brought Judah low because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and **transgressed** sore against the LORD. 2 Chronicles 28:19

Moreover all the chief of the priests, and the people, **transgressed** very much after all the abominations of the heathen; and polluted the house of the LORD which he had hallowed in Jerusalem. 2 Chron 36:14

Ezra the priest stood up, and said unto them, You have **transgressed**, and have taken strange wives, to increase the trespass of Israel... But the people are many, and it is a time of much rain, and we are not able to stand without, neither is this a work of one day or two: for we are many that have **transgressed** in this thing. Ezra 10:10, 13

Remember, I beseech you, the word that you commanded your servant Moses, saying, If you **transgress**, I will scatter you abroad among the nations. Nehemiah 1:8

Shall we then hearken unto you to do all this great evil, to **transgress** against our God in marrying strange wives? Nehemiah 13:27

Behold, God is mighty, and despises not any: He is mighty in strength and wisdom. He preserves not the life of the wicked: but gives right to the poor. He withdraws not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings are they on the throne; yes, He does establish them for ever, and they are exalted. And if they be bound in fetters, and be holden in cords of affliction; Then He shows them their work, and their **transgressions** that they have exceeded. Job 36:5-9 [continued]

He opens also their ear to discipline, and commands that they return from iniquity. If they obey and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures. But if they obey not, they shall perish by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge. But the hypocrites in heart heap up wrath: they cry not when He binds them. Job 36:10-13

The eyes of the LORD preserve knowledge, and He overthrows the words of the **transgressor**. Proverbs 22:12

The great God that formed all things both rewards the fool, and rewards **transgressors**. Proverbs 26:10

The destruction of the **transgressors** and of the sinners shall be together, and they that forsake the LORD shall be consumed. Isaiah 1:28

The earth mourns and fades away, the world languishes and fades away, the haughty people of the earth do languish. The earth also is defiled under the inhabitants thereof; because they have **transgressed** the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting covenant. Therefore has the curse devoured the earth, and they that dwell therein are desolate: therefore the inhabitants of the earth are burned, and few men left. Isaiah 24:4-6

Your first father has sinned, and your teachers have **transgressed** against Me...Remember this, and show yourselves men: bring it again to mind, O you **transgressors**. Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like Me, declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying My counsel shall stand... Isaiah 43:27, 46:9-10

Thus says the LORD, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? Or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your iniquities have you sold yourselves, and for your **transgressions** is your mother put away. Isaiah 50:1

For our **transgressions** are multiplied before You, and our sins testify against us: for our **transgressions** are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them; In **transgressing** and lying against the LORD [YeHoVaH]... Isaiah 59:12-16

The priests said not, Where is the LORD? And they that handled the law knew Me not: the pastors also **transgressed** against Me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal, and walked after things that do not profit...For of old time I have broken your yoke, and burst your bands; and you said, I will not **transgress**; when upon every high hill and under every green tree you wandered, playing the harlot. Jeremiah 2:8, 20

Only acknowledge your iniquity, that you have **transgressed** against the LORD your God, and have scattered your ways to the strangers under every green tree, and you have not obeyed My voice, says the LORD. Jeremiah 3:13

Wherefore a lion out of the forest shall slay them, and a wolf of the evenings shall spoil them, a leopard shall watch over their cities: every one that goes out thence shall be torn in pieces: because their **transgressions** are many, and their backslidings are increased. Jeremiah 5:6

You have not hearkened unto Me, in proclaiming liberty, every one to his brother, and every man to his neighbor; behold, I proclaim a liberty for you, says the LORD, to the sword, to the pestilence, and to the famine; and I will make you to be removed into all the kingdoms of the earth. And I will give the men that have **transgressed** My covenant, which have not performed the words of the covenant which they had made before Me, when they cut the calf in twain, and passed between the parts thereof...I will even give them into the hand of their enemies... Jeremiah 34:17-20

For the LORD has afflicted her for the multitude of her **transgressions**: her children are gone into captivity before the enemy...The yoke of my **transgressions** is bound by His hand: they are wreathed, and come up upon my neck: He has made my strength to fail, the Lord has delivered me into their hands, from whom I am not able to rise up. Lamentations 1:5, 14

Son of man, I send you to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that has rebelled against Me: they and their fathers have **transgressed** against Me, even unto this very day. Ezekiel 2:3

They shall bear the punishment of their iniquity: the punishment of the prophet shall be even as the punishment of him that seeks unto him; That the house of Israel may go no more astray from Me, neither be polluted any more with all their **transgressions**; but that they may be My people, and I may be their God, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 14:10-11

Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, says the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your **transgressions**; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Cast away from you all your **transgressions**, whereby you have **transgressed**; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will you die, O house of Israel? Ezekiel 18:30-31

If the wicked will turn from all his sins that he has committed, and keep all My statutes, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall surely live, he shall not die. All his **transgressions** that he has committed, they shall not be mentioned unto him: in his righteousness that he has done he shall live. Have I any pleasure at all that the wicked should die? Says the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live?... When the wicked man turns away from his wickedness that he has committed, and does that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive. Because he considers, and turns away from all his **transgressions** that he has committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die. Ezekiel 18:21-23, 27-28

I will purge out from among you the rebels, and them that **transgress** against Me: I will bring them forth out of the country where they sojourn, and they shall not enter into the land of Israel: and you shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 20:38

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Because you have made your iniquity to be remembered, in that your **transgressions** are discovered, so that in all your doings your sins do appear; because, I say, that you are come to remembrance, you shall be taken with the hand. Ezekiel 21:24

Therefore, O son of man, speak unto the house of Israel; Thus you speak, saying, If our **transgressions** and our sins be upon us, and we pine away in them, how should we then live? Say unto them, As I live, says the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn you, turn you from your evil ways; for why will you die, O house of Israel? Therefore, son of man, say unto the children of your people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his **transgression**: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turns from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his righteousness in the day that he sins. Ezekiel 33:10-12

According to their uncleanness and according to their **transgressions** have I done unto them, and hid My face from them. Ezekiel 39:24

Yes, all Israel have **transgressed** Your law, even by departing, that they might not obey Your voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against Him. Daniel 9:11

O Ephraim, what shall I do unto you? O Judah, what shall I do unto you? For your goodness is as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goes away. Therefore have I hewed them by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of My mouth: and your judgments are as the light that goes forth. For I desired mercy, and not sacrifice; and the knowledge of God more than burnt offerings. But they like men have transgressed the covenant: there have they dealt treacherously against Me... Woe unto them! For they have fled from Me: destruction unto them! Because they have transgressed against Me: though I have redeemed them, yet they have spoken lies against Me. And they have not cried unto Me with their heart, when they howled upon their beds: they assemble themselves for corn and wine, and they rebel against Me...Set the trumpet to your mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed My covenant, and trespassed against My law. Hosea 6:4-7, 7:13-14, 8:1

Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the just shall walk in them; but the **transgressors** shall fall therein. Hosea 14:9

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Damascus, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have threshed Gilead with threshing instruments of iron... Amos 1:3

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Gaza, and for four, will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they carried away captive the whole captivity, to deliver them up to Edom... Amos 1:6

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Tyrus, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they delivered up the whole captivity to Edom, and remembered not the brotherly covenant... Amos 1:9

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever. Amos 1:11

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of the children of Ammon, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have ripped up the women with child of Gilead, that they might enlarge their border... Amos1:13

Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Moab, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because he burned the bones of the king of Edom into lime. Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Judah, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they have despised the law of the LORD, and have not kept His commandments, and their lies caused them to err, after the which their fathers have walked... Thus says the LORD; For three **transgressions** of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof, because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes...Amos 2:1, 4, 6

Come to Bethel, and **transgress**; at Gilgal multiply **transgression**; and bring your sacrifices every morning, and offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with leaven, and proclaim and publish the free offerings: for this you like, O you children of Israel, says the Lord GOD. And I also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities, and want of bread in all your places: yet have you not returned unto Me, says the LORD. Amos 4:4-6

For I know your manifold **transgressions**, and your mighty sins: they afflict the just, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate from their right. Amos 5:12

Yes, also because he **transgresses** by wine, he is a proud man, neither keeps at home, who enlarges his desire as hell, and is as death, and cannot be satisfied, but gathers unto him all nations, and heaps unto him all people; Habakkuk 2:5

PRAYERS ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

Forgive your people that have sinned against you, and all their **transgressions** wherein they have **transgressed** against you, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them... 1 Kings 8:50

If I covered my **transgressions** as Adam, by hiding my iniquity in my bosom...Behold, my desire is, that the Almighty would answer me, and that my adversary had written a book. Job 31:33, 35

Destroy you them, O God; let them fall by their own counsels; cast them out in the multitude of their **transgressions**; for they have rebelled against you. Psalm 5:10

Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goes not out of feigned lips. Let my sentence come forth from Your presence; let Your eyes behold the things that are equal. You have proved my heart; You have visited me in the night; You have tried me, and shall find nothing; I am purposed that my mouth shall not **transgress**. Psalm 17:1-3

Yes, let none that wait on You be ashamed: let them be ashamed which **transgress** without cause. Show me Your ways, O LORD; teach me Your paths. Psalm 25:3-4

Lead me in Your truth, and teach me: for You are the God of my salvation; on You do I wait all the day. Remember, O LORD, Your tender mercies and Your loving kindness; for they have been ever of old. Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my **transgressions**: according to Your mercy remember Thou me for Your goodness' sake, O LORD. Good and upright is the LORD: therefore will He teach sinners in the way. The paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep His covenant and His testimonies. Psalm 25:5-10

I acknowledged my sin unto you, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my **transgression**s unto the LORD; and You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Selah. For this shall every one that is godly pray unto You in a time when You may be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him. You are my hiding place; You shall preserve me from trouble; You shall compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah. I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you shall go: I will guide you with My eye. Psalm 32:5-8

Deliver me from all my **transgressions**: make me not the reproach of the foolish...Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not Your peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with You, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more. Psalm 39:8, 12-13

Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God: defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men. For, lo, they lie in wait for my soul: the mighty are gathered against me; not for my **transgression**, not for my sin, O LORD. They run and prepare themselves without my fault: awake to help me, and behold. You therefore, O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, awake to visit all the heathen: be not merciful to any wicked **transgressors**. Selah. Psalm 59:1-5

O You that hears prayer, unto You shall all flesh come. Iniquities prevail against me: as for our **transgressions**, You shall purge them away. Psalm 65:2-3

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of Your tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight: that You might be justified when You speak, and be clear when You judge. Behold, I was shaped in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part You shall make me to know wisdom. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which You have broken may rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from Your presence; and take not Your holy spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of Your salvation; and uphold me with Your free spirit. Then will I teach transgressors Your ways; and sinners shall be converted unto You. Psalm 51:1-3, 10-13

Let all their wickedness come before You; and do unto them, as You have done unto me for all my **transgressions**: for my sighs are many, and my heart is faint...We have **transgressed** and have rebelled: You have not pardoned. Lamentations 1:22, 3:42

PROMISES ABOUT TRANSGRESSION

...Then you shall say before the LORD your God, I have brought away the hallowed things out of my house, and also have given them unto the Levite, and unto the stranger, to the fatherless, and to the widow, according to all Your commandments which You have commanded me: I have not **transgressed** Your commandments, neither have I forgotten them: I have not eaten thereof in my mourning, neither have I taken away aught thereof for any unclean use, nor given aught thereof for the dead: but I have hearkened to the voice of the LORD my God, and have done according to all that You have commanded me. Deuteronomy 26:13-14

As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our **transgressions** from us. Psalm 103:12

I, even I am He that blots out your **transgressions** for mine own sake, and will not remember your sins...I have blotted out, as a thick cloud, your **transgressions**, and, as a cloud, your sins: return unto Me; for I have redeemed you. Isaiah 43:25, 44:22

Who has believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form or comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not. Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our **transgressions**, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed... Isaiah 53:1-6, 10-12

Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief: when you shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities. Therefore will I divide Him a portion with the great, and He shall divide the spoil with the strong; because He has poured out His soul unto death: and He was numbered with the **transgressors**; and He bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the **transgressors**. Isaiah 53:10-12

I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against Me, and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have **transgressed** against Me. Jeremiah 33:8

Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their **transgressions**: but I will save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be My people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 37:23

TRESPASSES

Jacob was wroth, and argued with Laban: and Jacob answered and said to Laban, What is my **trespass**? What is my sin, that you have so hotly pursued after me? Genesis 31:36

So shall you say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray you now, the **trespass** of your brethren, and their sin; for they did unto you evil: and now, we pray you, forgive the **trespass** of the servants of the God of your father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him. Genesis 50:17

For all manner of **trespass**, whether it be for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, or for any manner of lost thing, which another challenges to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; and whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbor. Exodus 22:9

He shall bring his **trespass** offering unto the LORD for his sin which he has sinned, a female from the flock, a lamb or a kid of the goats, for a sin offering; and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his sin. And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he has committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering. Leviticus 5:6-7

If a soul commit a **trespass**, and sin through ignorance, in the holy things of the LORD; then he shall bring for his trespass unto the LORD a ram without blemish out of the flocks, with your estimation by shekels of silver, after the shekel of the sanctuary, for a **trespass** offering: And he shall make amends for the harm that he has done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the **trespass** offering and it shall be forgiven him. And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with your estimation, for a **trespass** offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and knew it not, and it shall be forgiven him. It is a **trespass** offering: he has certainly **trespassed** against the LORD. Leviticus 5: 15-16, 18-19

If a soul sin, and commit a **trespass** against the LORD, and lie unto his neighbor in that which was delivered him to keep, or in fellowship, or in a thing taken away by violence, or has deceived his neighbor...Or all that about which he hath sworn falsely; he shall restore it in the principal, and shall add the fifth part more thereto, and give it unto him to whom it appertains, in the day of his **trespass** offering. And he shall bring his trespass offering unto the LORD, a ram without blemish out of the flock, with your estimation, for a **trespass** offering, unto the priest...Leviticus 6:2-6

It shall not be baked with leaven. I have given it unto them for their portion of My offerings made by fire; it is most holy, as is the sin offering, and as the **trespass** offering. Leviticus 6:17

Likewise this is the law of the **trespass** offering: it is most holy. In the place where they kill the burnt offering shall they kill the **trespass** offering: and the blood thereof shall he sprinkle round about upon the altar. Leviticus 7:1-2

This is the law of the burnt offering, of the meat offering, and of the sin offering, and of the **trespass** offering, and of the consecrations, and of the sacrifice of the peace offerings... Leviticus 7:37

And the priest shall take the lamb of the **trespass** offering, and the log of oil, and the priest shall wave them for a wave offering before the LORD: And he shall kill the lamb of the **trespass** offering, and the priest shall take some of the blood of the **trespass** offering, and put it upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot...And the priest shall put of the oil that is in his hand upon the tip of the right ear of him that is to be cleansed, and upon the thumb of his right hand, and upon the great toe of his right foot, upon the place of the blood of the **trespass** offering: Leviticus 14:24-25, 28

The priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the **trespass** offering...and the sin which he has done shall be forgiven him...They shall not profane the holy things of the children of Israel, which they offer unto the LORD; or suffer them to bear the iniquity of **trespass**, when they eat their holy things: for I the LORD do sanctify them. Leviticus 19:22, 22:15-16

They that are left of you shall pine away in their iniquity in your enemies' lands; and also in the iniquities of their fathers shall they pine away with them. If they shall confess their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their **trespass** which they **trespassed** against me, and that also they have walked contrary unto Me: and that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies: if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember My covenant with Jacob, and also My covenant with Isaac, and also My covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land. Leviticus 26:26:40-42

But the children of Israel committed a **trespass** in the accursed thing: for Achan, the son of Carmi, the son of Zabdi, the son of Zerah, of the tribe of Judah, took of the accursed thing: and the anger of the LORD was kindled against the children of Israel. Joshua 7:1

Phinehas the son of Eleazar the priest said unto the children of Reuben, and to the children of Gad, and to the children of Manasseh, This day we perceive that the LORD is among us, because you have not committed this **trespass** against the LORD: now you have delivered the children of Israel out of the hand of the LORD. Joshua 22:31

I pray you, forgive the **trespass** of your handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fights the battles of the LORD, and evil has not been found in you all your days. 1 Samuel 25:28

If any man **trespass** against his neighbor, and an oath be laid upon him to cause him to swear, and the oath come before Your altar in this house: Then hear in heaven, and do, and judge Your servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness. 1 Kings 8:31-32

For they dealt faithfully. The **trespass** money and sin money was not brought into the house of the LORD: it was the priests'. 2 Kings 12:15-16

What cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and judgments, you shall even warn them that they **trespass** not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and you shall not **trespass**. 2 Chronicles 19:10

They left the house of the LORD God of their fathers, and served groves and idols: and wrath came upon Judah and Jerusalem for this their **trespass**. 2 Chronicles 24:18

They withstood Uzziah the king, and said unto him, It appertains not unto you, Uzziah, to burn incense unto the LORD, but to the priests the sons of Aaron, that are consecrated to burn incense: go out of the sanctuary; for you have **trespassed**; neither shall it be for your honor from the LORD God. 2 Chronicles 26:18

For our fathers have **trespassed**, and done that which was evil in the eyes of the LORD our God, and have forsaken Him, and have turned away their faces from the habitation of the LORD, and turned their backs. 2 Chronicles 29:6

Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his prayer unto his God, and the words of the seers that spake to him in the name of the LORD God of Israel, behold, they are written in the book of the kings of Israel. His prayer also, and how God was intreated of him, and all his sin, and his **trespass**, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they are written among the sayings of the seers...Amon sacrificed unto all the carved images which Manasseh his father had made, and served them; And humbled not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had humbled himself; but Amon **trespassed** more and more. 2 Chronicles 33:18-19, 22-23

O my God, I am ashamed and blush to lift up my face to Thee, my God: for our iniquities are increased over our head, and our **trespass** is grown up unto the heavens. Since the days of our fathers have we been in a great **trespass** unto this day; and for our iniquities have we, our kings, and our priests, been delivered into the hand of the kings of the lands, to the sword, to captivity, and to a spoil, and to confusion of face, as it is this day... Ezra 9:6-7

Shechaniah...answered and said unto Ezra, We have **trespassed** against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land; yet now there is hope in Israel concerning this thing...You have transgressed, and have taken strange wives, to increase the **trespass** of Israel...And they gave their hands that they would put away their wives; and being guilty, they offered a ram of the flock for their **trespass**. Ezra 10:2, 10, 16

Blessed be the Lord, who daily loads us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah. He that is our God is the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord belong the issues from death. But God shall wound the head of his enemies, and the hairy scalp of such an one as goes on still in his **trespasses**. Psalm 68:19-21

I will spread My net upon him, and he shall be taken in My snare, and I will bring him to Babylon, and will plead with him there for his **trespass** that he has **trespassed** against Me... When the righteous turns away from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All his righteousness that he has done shall not be mentioned: in his **trespass** that he has **trespassed**, and his sin that he has sinned, in them shall he die. Ezekiel 17:20, 18:24

The heathen shall know that the house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity: because they **trespassed** against Me, therefore hid I My face from them, and gave them into the hand of their enemies: so fell they all by the sword. According to their uncleanness and according to their transgressions have I done unto them, and hid My face from them... After that they have borne their shame, and all their **trespasses**... shall they know that I am the LORD their God... Ezekiel 39:23-27

O Lord, righteousness belongs unto You, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, that are near, and that are far off, through all the countries whither you have driven them, because of their **trespass** that they have **trespassed** against You. Dan 9:7

Set the trumpet to your mouth. He shall come as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed My covenant, and **trespassed** against My law. Hosea 8:1

TRESPASS IN NEW COVENANT

For if you forgive men their **trespasses**, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if you forgive not men their **trespasses**, neither will your Father forgive your **trespasses**. Matt 6:14-15

Moreover if your brother shall **trespass** against you, go and tell him his fault between you and him alone: if he shall hear you, you have gained your brother...So likewise shall My Heavenly Father do also unto you, if you from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their **trespasses**. Matthew 18:15, 35

When you stand praying, forgive, if you have aught against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your **trespasses**. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your **trespasses**. Mark 11:25-26

Take heed to yourselves: If your brother **trespass** against you, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. And if he **trespass** against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to you, saying, I repent; you shall forgive him. Luke 17:3-4

All things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself by Jesus Christ, and has given to us the ministry of reconciliation; To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their **trespasses** unto them; and has committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 2 Corinthians 5:18-19

You has He quickened, who were dead in **trespasses** and sins; wherein in time past you walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience... Ephesians 2:1-2

You are complete in Him, which is the head of all principality and power...And you, being dead in your sins and uncircumcision of your flesh, has He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all **trespasses**; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it. Colossians 2:10, 13-15

VANITY

Let there more work be laid upon the men, that they may labor therein; and let them not regard **vain** words. Exodus 5:9

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in **vain**; for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that takes His name in **vain**. Exodus 20:7

I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and you shall sow your seed in **vain**, for your enemies shall eat it. Leviticus 26:16

And your strength shall be spent in **vain**: for your land shall not yield her increase, neither shall be trees of the land yield their fruits. Leviticus 26:20

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in **vain**: for the LORD will not hold him guiltless that takes His name in **vain**. Deuteronomy 5:11

I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no faith. They have moved Me to jealousy with that which is not God; they have provoked Me to anger with their **vanities**: and I will move them to jealousy with those which are not a people; I will provoke them to anger with a foolish nation. Deut 32:20-21

For it is not a **vain** thing for you; because it is your life: and through this thing you shall prolong your days in the land, whither you go over Jordan to possess it. Deuteronomy 32:47

And they gave him threescore and ten pieces of silver out of the house of Baal-berieth, wherewith Abimelech hired **vain** and light persons, which followed him. Judges 9:4

Then Jephthah fled from his brethren, and dwelt in the land of Tob: and there were gathered **vain** men to Jephthah, and went out with him. Judges 11:3

And turn you not aside: for then should you go after **vain** things, which cannot profit nor deliver; for they are **vain**. 1 Samuel 12:21

Now David had said, Surely in **vain** have I kept all that this fellow has in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that pertained unto him: and he has requited me evil for good. 1 Samuel 25:21

Then David returned to bless his household. And Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, How glorious was the king of Israel today, who uncovered himself today in the eyes of the handmaids of her servants, as one of the **vain** fellows shamelessly uncovers himself! 2 Samuel 6:20

For the sins of Baasha, and the sins of Elah his son, by which they sinned, and by which they made Israel to sin, in provoking the LORD God of Israel to anger with their **vanities**. 1 Kings 16:13

For he walked in all the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin, to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger with their **vanities**. 1 Kings 16:26

And they rejected His statutes, and His covenant that He made with their fathers, and His testimonies which He testified against them; and they followed **vanity**, and became **vain**, and went after the heathen that were round about them, concerning whom the LORD had charged them, that they should not do like them. 2 Kings 17:15

You say, (but they are but **vain** words,) I have counsel and strength for the war. Now on whom do you trust, that you rebel against Me? 2 Kings 18:20

There are gathered unto him **vain** men, the children of Belial, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them. 2 Chronicles 13:7

So am I made to possess months of **vanity**, and wearisome nights are appointed to me...I loathe it; I would not live always: let me alone; for my days are **vanity**...If I be wicked, why then labor I in **vain**? For he knows **vain** men: he sees wickedness also; will he not then consider it? For **vain** man would be wise, though man be born like a wild ass's colt. Job 7:3, 16, 9:29, 11:11-12

Should a wise man utter **vain** knowledge, and fill his belly with the east wind? Job 15:2

Let not him that is deceived trust in **vanity**: for **vanity** shall be his recompense. Job 15:31

They conceive mischief, and bring forth **vanity**, and their belly prepares deceit. Job 15:35

Shall **vain** words have an end? Or what emboldens you that you answer? Job 16:3

How then you comfort me in **vain**, seeing in your answers there remains falsehood? Job 21:34

Behold, all you yourselves have seen it; why then are you thus altogether vain? Job 27:12

If I have walked with **vanity**, or if my foot has hastened to deceit; Let me be weighed in an even balance, that God may know my integrity. Job 31:5-6

Surely God will not hear **vanity**, neither will the Almighty regard it...Therefore does Job open his mouth in **vain**; he multiplies words without knowledge. Job 35:13, 16

She is hardened against her young ones, as though they were not hers: her labor is in **vain** without fear... Job 39:16

Behold, the hope of him is in **vain**: shall not one be cast down even at the sight of him? Job 41:9

Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a **vain** thing? Psalm 2:1

O you sons of men, how long will you turn My glory into shame? How long will you love **vanity**, and seek after leasing? Selah. Psalm 4:2

His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue is mischief and **vanity**. Psalm 10:7

They speak **vanity** every one with his neighbor: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak. Psalm 12:2

He that has clean hands, and a pure heart; who has not lifted up his soul unto **vanity**, nor sworn deceitfully. Psalm 24:4

I have not sat with **vain** persons, neither will I go in with dissemblers. Psalm 26:4

I have hated them that regard lying **vanities**: but I trust in the LORD. Psalm 31:6

An horse is a **vain** thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength. Psalm 33:17

Behold, you have made my days as an handbreadth; and mine age is as nothing before You: verily every man at his best state is altogether **vanity**. Selah. Surely every man walks in a **vain** show: surely they are disquieted in **vain**: he heaps up riches, and knows not who shall gather them. Psalms 39:5-6

When you with rebukes do correct man for iniquity, you make his beauty to consume away like a moth: surely every man is vanity. Selah. Psalm 39:11

And if he come to see me, he speaks **vanity**: his heart gathers iniquity to itself; when he goes abroad, he tells it. Psalm 41:6

Give us help from trouble: for **vain** is the help of man. Psalm 60:11

Surely men of low degree are **vanity**, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than **vanity**. Trust not in oppression, and become not **vain** in robbery: if riches increase, set not your heart upon them. Psalm 62:9-10

Verily I have cleansed my heart in **vain**, and washed my hands in innocency. Psalm 73:13

Therefore their days did He consume in **vanity**, and their years in trouble. Psalm79:33

Remember how short my time is: wherefore have You made all men in vain? Psalm 89:47

The LORD knows the thoughts of man, that they are **vanity**. Psalm 94:11

Give us help from trouble: for **vain** is the help of man. Psalms 108:12

Turn away mine eyes from beholding **vanity**; and quicken me in Your way...I hate **vain** thoughts: but Your law do I love. Psalm 119:37, 113

Except the LORD build the house, they labor in **vain** that build it: except the LORD keep the city, the watchman wakes but in **vain**. It is **vain** for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: for so He gives His beloved sleep. Psalm 127:1-2

For they speak against you wickedly, and your enemies take Your name in vain. Psalm 139:20

Blessed be the LORD my strength, which teaches my hands to war, and my fingers to fight: My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and He in whom I trust; who subdues my people under me. LORD, what is man, that you take knowledge of him? Or the son of man, that You make account of him? Man is like to vanity: his days are as a shadow that passes away...Whose mouth speaks vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood...Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaks vanity, and their right hand is a right hand of falsehood. Psalm 144:1-8, 11

Surely in **vain** the net is spread in the sight of any bird. Proverbs 1:17

He that tills his land shall be satisfied with bread: but he that follows **vain** persons is void of understanding. Proverbs 12:11

Wealth gotten by **vanity** shall be diminished: but he that gathers by labor shall increase. Proverbs 13:11

The getting of treasure by a lying tongue is a **vanity** tossed to and fro of them that seek death. Proverbs 21:6

He that sows iniquity shall reap **vanity**: and the rod of his anger shall fail. Proverbs 22:8

He that tills his land shall have plenty of bread: but he that follows after **vain** persons shall have poverty enough. Proverbs 28:19

Remove far from me **vanity** and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me: Lest I be full, and deny You, and say, Who is the LORD? Or lest I be poor, and steal, and take the name of my God in **vain**. Proverbs 30:8-9

Favor is deceitful, and beauty is **vain**: but a woman that fears the LORD [YeHoVaH], she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

Vanity of **vanities**, says the Preacher, **vanity** of **vanities**; all is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 1:2

I have seen all the works that are done under the sun; and behold, all is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 1:14

I said in my heart, Go to now, I will prove you with mirth, therefore enjoy pleasure: and, behold, this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:1

Then I looked on all the works that my hands had wrought, and on the labor that I had labored to do: and, behold, all was **vanity** and vexation of spirit, and there was no profit under the sun. Ecclesiastes 2:11

Then said I in my heart, As it happens to the fool, so it happens even to me; and why was I then more wise? Then I said in my heart, that this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:15

Therefore I hated life; because the work that is wrought under the sun is grievous unto me: for all is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 2:17

And who knows whether he shall be a wise man or a fool? Yet shall he have rule over all my labor wherein I have labored, and wherein I have shown myself wise under the sun. This is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:19

For there is a man whose labor is in wisdom, and in knowledge, and in equity; yet to a man that has not labored therein shall he leave it for his portion. This also is **vanity** and a great evil. Ecclesiastes 2:21

For all his days are sorrows, and his travail grief; yes, his heart takes not rest in the night. This is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 2:23

For God gives to a man that is good in His sight wisdom, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner He gives travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Eccl 2:26

For that which befalls the sons of men befalls beasts; even one thing befalls them: as the one dies, so dies the other; yes, they have all one breath; so that a man hath no preeminence above a beast: for all is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 3:19

Again, I considered all travail, and every right work, that for this man is envied of his neighbor. This is also **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 4:4

Then I returned, and I saw vanity under the sun. There is one alone, and there is not a second; yes, he has neither child nor brother: yet is there no end of all his labor; neither is his eye satisfied with riches; neither says he, For whom do I labor, and bereave my soul of good: This is also **vanity**, yes, it is a sore travail. Ecclesiastes 4:7-8

There is no end of all the people, even of all that have been before them: they also that come after shall not rejoice in him. Surely this also is **vanity** and vexation of spirit. Ecclesiastes 4:16

For in the multitude of dreams and many words there are also divers **vanities**: but you fear God...He that loves silver will not be satisfied with silver; nor he that loves abundance with increase: this is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 5:7, 10

A man to whom God has given riches, wealth, and honor, so that he wants nothing for his soul of all that he desires, yet God gives him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eats it: this is **vanity**, and it is an evil disease...For he comes in with **vanity**, and departs in darkness, and his name shall be covered with darkness... Better is the sight of the eyes than the wandering of the desire: this is also **vanity** and vexation of spirit...Seeing there be many things that increase **vanity**, what is man the better? For who knows what is good for man in this life, all the days of his **vain** life which he spends as a shadow? For who can tell a man what shall be after him under the sun? Ecclesiastes 6:2, 4, 9, 11-12

For as the crackling of thorns under a pot, so is the laughter of the fool: this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 7:6

All things have I seen in the days of my **vanity**: there is a just man that perishes in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that prolongs his life in his wickedness. Ecclesiastes 7:15

And so I saw the wicked buried, who had come and gone from the place of the holy, and they were forgotten in the city where they had so done: this is also **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 8:10

There is a **vanity** which is done upon the earth; that there be just men, unto whom it happens according to the work of the wicked; again, there be wicked men, to whom it happens according to the work of the righteous: I said that this also is **vanity**. Ecclesiastes 8:14

Live joyfully with the wife whom you love all the days of the life of your **vanity**, which He has given you under the sun, all the days of your **vanity**: for that is your portion in this life, and in your labor which you take under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:9

But if a man live many years, and rejoice in them all; yet let him remember the days of darkness; for they shall be many. All that comes is **vanity**...Rejoice, O young man, in your youth; and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth, and walk in the ways of your heart, and in the sight of your eyes: but know, that for all these things God will bring you into judgement. Therefore remove sorrow from your heart, and put away evil from your flesh: for childhood and youth are **vanity**. Eccl 11:8, 10

Vanity of vanities, says the preacher; all is vanity. Eccl 12:8

Bring no more **vain** oblations; incense is an abomination unto Me; the new moons and sabbaths, the calling of assemblies, I cannot endure; it is iniquity, even the solemn meeting. Isaiah 1:13

Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of **vanity**, and sin as it were with a cart rope... Isaiah 5:18

The Egyptians shall help in **vain**, and to no purpose: therefore have I cried concerning this, Their strength is to sit still. Isaiah 30:7

And his breath, as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of **vanity**: and there shall be a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing them to err. Isaiah 30:28

I say, you say, (but they are but **vain** words) I have counsel and strength for war: now on whom do you trust, that you rebel against Me? Isaiah 36:5

All nations before Him are as nothing; and they are counted to Him less than nothing, and **vanity**. Isaiah 40:17

That bring the princes to nothing; He makes the judges of the earth as **vanity**. Isaiah 40:23

Behold, they are all **vanity**; their works are nothing: their molten images are wind and confusion. Isaiah 41:29

They that make a graven image are all of them **vanity**; and their delectable things shall not profit; and they are their own witnesses; they see not, nor know; that they may be ashamed. Isaiah 44:9

For thus says the LORD that created the heavens; God Himself that formed the earth and made it; He has established it, He created it not in **vain**, He formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is none else. I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not unto the seed of Jacob, Seek you Me in **vain**: I the LORD speak righteousness, I declare things that are right. Isaiah 45:18-19

Then I said, I have labored in **vain**, I have spent my strength for nought, and in **vain**: yet surely my judgment is with the LORD [YeHoVaH], and my work with my God. Isaiah 49:4

When you cry, let your companies deliver you; but the wind shall carry them all away; **vanity** shall take them: but he that puts his trust in Me shall possess the land, and shall inherit My holy mountain... Isaiah 57:13

None calls for justice, nor any pleads for truth: they trust in **vanity**, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. Isaiah 59:4

Then shall you call, and the LORD shall answer; you shall cry, and He shall say, Here I am. If you take away from the midst of you the yoke, the putting forth of the finger, and speaking **vanity**... Isaiah 58:9

They shall not labor in **vain**, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. Isaiah 65:23

Thus says the LORD, What iniquity have your fathers found in Me, that they are gone far from Me, and have walked after **vanity**, and are become **vain**? Jeremiah 2:5

In **vain** have I smitten your children; they received no correction: your own sword has devoured your prophets, like a destroying lion. Jeremiah 2:30

Truly in **vain** is salvation hoped for from the hills, and from the multitude of mountains: truly in the LORD our God is the salvation of Israel. Jeremiah 3:23

O Jerusalem, wash your heart from wickedness, that you may be saved. How long shall your **vain** thoughts lodge within you? ...And when you are spoiled, what will you do? Though you clothe yourself with crimson, though you deck yourself with ornaments of gold, though you rent your face with painting, in **vain** shall you make yourself fair; your lovers will despise you, they will seek your life. Jeremiah 4:14, 30

The bellows are burned, the lead is consumed of the fire; the founder melts in **vain**: for the wicked are not plucked away. Jeremiah 6:29

How do you say, We are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us? Lo, certainly in **vain** made He it, the pen of the scribes is in **vain**. Jeremiah 8:8

Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of My people because of them that dwell in a far country: Is not the LORD in Zion? Is not her king in her? Why have they provoked Me to anger with their graven images, and with strange **vanities**? Jeremiah 8:19

Learn not the way of the heathen...The customs of the people are **vain**: for one cuts a tree out of the forest, the work of the hands of the workman, with the axe. They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not... But they are altogether brutish and foolish: the stock is a doctrine of **vanities**...They are **vanity**, and the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. Jeremiah 10:2-4, 8, 15

Are there any among the **vanities** of the Gentiles that can cause rain? Or can the heavens give showers? Are not you He, O LORD our God? Therefore we will wait upon You: for You have made all these things. Jeremiah 14:22

O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto you from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, **vanity**, and things wherein there is no profit. Jeremiah 16:19

Because My people have forgotten Me, they have burned incense to **vanity**, and they have caused them to stumble in their ways from the ancient paths, to walk in paths, in a way not cast up... Jer 18:15

Thus says the LORD of hosts, Hearken not unto the words of the prophets that prophesy unto you: they make you vain: they speak a vision of their own heart, and not out of the mouth of the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Jeremiah 23:16

Go up into Gilead, and take balm, O virgin, the daughter of Egypt: in **vain** shall you use many medicines; for you shall not be cured. Jeremiah 46:11

For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows shall be as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in **vain**. Jeremiah 50:9

Every man is brutish by his knowledge; every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them. They are **vanity**, the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. Jeremiah 51:17-18

Thus says the LORD of hosts; The broad walls of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labor in **vain**, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary. Jeremiah 51:58

Thy prophets have seen **vain** and foolish things for you: and they have not discovered your iniquity, to turn away your captivity; but have seen for you false burdens and causes of banishment. Lamentations 2:14

As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our **vain** help: in our watching we have watched for a nation that could not save us. Lamentations 4:17

And they shall know that I am the LORD, and that I have not said in **vain** that I would do this evil unto them. Ezekiel 6:10

For there shall be no more any **vain** vision nor flattering divination within the house of Israel. Ezekiel 12:24

They have seen **vanity** and lying divination, saying, The LORD says: and the LORD has not sent them: and they have made others to hope that they would confirm the word. Have you not seen a **vain** vision, and have you not spoken a lying divination, whereas you say, The LORD says it; albeit I have not spoken? Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Because you have spoken **vanity**, and seen lies, therefore, behold, I am against you, says the Lord GOD. And My hand shall be upon the prophets that see **vanity**, and that divine lies: they shall not be in the assembly of My people, neither shall they be written in the writing of the house of Israel, neither shall they enter into the land of Israel; and you shall know that I am the Lord GOD...Therefore you shall see no more **vanity**, nor divine divinations: for I will deliver My people out of your hand: and you shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 13:6-9, 23

While they see **vanity** unto you, while they divine a lie unto you, to bring you upon the necks of them that are slain, of the wicked, whose day is come, when their iniquity shall have an end... And her prophets have daubed them with untempered mortar, seeing **vanity**, and divining lies unto them, saying, Thus says the Lord GOD, when the LORD has not spoken. Eze 21:29, 22:28

Is there iniquity in Gilead? Surely they are **vanity**: they sacrifice bullocks in Gilgal; yes, their altars are as heaps in the furrows of the fields. Hosea 12:11

They that observe lying **vanities** forsake their own mercy. Jonah 2:8

Behold, is it not of the LORD of hosts that the people shall labor in the very fire, and the people shall weary themselves for very **vanity**? Habakkuk 2:13

For the idols have spoken **vanity**, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they comfort in **vain**: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd. Zechariah 10:2

You have said, It is **vain** to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept His ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts? Malachi 3:14

VANITY IN THE NEW COVENANT

But when you pray, use not **vain** repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. Matthew 6.7

In **vain** do they worship Me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men... Matthew 15:9, Mark 7:7

This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the **vanity** of their mind... Ephesians 4:17

Lord, you are God...Who by the mouth of Your servant David has said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? Acts 4:25

Sirs, why do you these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that you should turn from these **vanities** unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein... Acts 14:15

Because that, when they knew God, they glorified Him not as God, neither were thankful; but became **vain** in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Romans 1:21

For the creature was made subject to **vanity**, not willingly, but by reason of Him who has subjected the same in hope... Romans 8:20

For he is the minister of God to you for good. But if you do that which is evil, be afraid; for he bears not the sword in **vain**: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that does evil. Romans 13:4

The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are **vain**. 1 Corinthians 3:20

Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also you, which also you received, and wherein you stand. By which also you are saved, if you keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2

By the grace of God I am what I am: and His grace which was bestowed upon me was not in **vain**; but I labored more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me. 1 Corinthians 15:10

If Christ be not risen, then is our preaching **vain**, and your faith is also **vain**...If the dead rise not, then is not Christ raised. And if Christ be not raised, your faith is **vain**; you are yet in your sins. 1 Corinthians 15:14, 16-17

Therefore, my beloved brethren, be you steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, forasmuch as you know that your labor is not in **vain** in the Lord. 1 Cor 15:58

We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that you receive not the grace of God in vain. 2 Corinthians 6:1

Yet have I sent the brethren, lest our boasting of you should be in **vain** in this behalf; that, as I said, you may be ready... 2 Corinthians 9:3

And I went up by revelation, and communicated unto them that gospel which I preach among the Gentiles, but privately to them which were of reputation, lest by any means I should run, or had run, in **vain**. Galatians 2:2

I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in **vain**. Galatians 2:21

Have you suffered so many things in **vain**? If it be yet in **vain**. Galatians 3:4

I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labor in **vain**. Galatians 4:11

Let us not be desirous of **vain** glory, provoking one another, envying one another. Galatians 5:26

Let no man deceive you with **vain** words: for because of these things comes the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience. Ephesians 5:6

Let nothing be done through strife or **vainglory**; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Phil 2:3

Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in **vain**, neither labored in **vain**. Philippians 2:16

Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and **vain** deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. Colossians 2:8

Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshiping of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, **vainly** puffed up by his fleshly mind... Colossians 2:18

For yourselves, brethren, know our entrance in unto you, that it was not in **vain**... 1 Thessalonians 2:1

For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labor be in **vain**. 1 Thessalonians 3:5

Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned: From which some having swerved have turned aside unto **vain** jangling. 1 Timothy 1:5-6

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to your trust, avoiding profane and **vain** bablings, and oppositions of science falsely so called... 1 Timothy 6:20

But shun profane and **vain** babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. 2 Timothy 2:16

For there are many unruly and **vain** talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision...But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and **vain**. Titus 1:10, 3:9

If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridles not his tongue, but deceives his own heart, this man's religion is **vain**. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. James 1:26-27

But will you know, O **vain** man, that faith without works is dead? James 2:20

Do you think that the scripture says in **vain**, The spirit that dwells in us lusts to envy? James 4:5

...You know that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, as silver and gold, from your **vain** conversation received by tradition from your fathers; but with the precious blood of Christ...1 Peter 1:18-19

For when they speak great swelling words of **vanity**, they allure through the lusts of the flesh, through much wantonness, those that were clean escaped from them who live in error. 2 Peter 2:18

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and truth unto such as keep His covenant and His testimonies. For Your name's sake, O LORD, pardon my **iniquity**; for it is great. Psalm 25:10-11

Wash me throughly from mine **iniquity**, and cleanse me from my sin...Behold, I was shaped in **iniquity**; and in sin did my mother conceive me...Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all my **iniquities**. Psalm 51:2, 5, 9

Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God; defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of **iniquity**, and save me from bloody men. Psalm 59:1-2

Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of **iniquity**: who whet their tongue like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows, even bitter words. Psalm 64:1-3

Add **iniquity** unto their **iniquity**: and let them not come into Your righteousness. Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous. Psalm 69:27-28

Incline not my heart to any evil thing, to practice wicked works with men that work **iniquity**: and let me not eat of their dainties...Keep me from the snares which they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of **iniquity**. Psalm 141:4, 9
