## FEAR OF GOD

Then Abimilech called Abraham, and said unto him, What have you done unto us? What have I offended you, that you have brought on me and on my kingdom a great sin? You have done deeds unto me that ought not to be done.. Abraham said, Because I thought, Surely **the fear of God** is not in this place; and they will slay me for my wife's sake. Genesis 20:9,11

And the angel of the LORD called unto him out of heaven, and said, Abraham, Abraham: and he said, Here am I. And he said, Lay not your hand upon the lad, neither do any thing unto him: for now I know that you **fear God**, seeing you have not withheld your son, your only son from Me. Genesis 22:11-12

And Joseph said unto them the third day, This do, and live; for **I fear God**: If you be true men, let one of your brethren be bound in the house of your prison: go you, carry corn for the famine of your houses: But bring your youngest brother unto me; so shall your words be verified, and you shall not die. And they did so. Genesis 42:18-20

Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people **feared the LORD**, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses. Exodus 14:31

Then sang Moses and the children of Israel...I will sing unto the LORD, for He has triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider has He thrown into the sea...The people shall hear, and be afraid: sorrow shall take hold on the inhabitants of Palestina...**Fear and dread** shall fall upon them; by the greatness of Your arm they shall be as still as a stone; till Your people pass over, O LORD, till the people pass over, which You have purchased. Ex 15:1,14,16

You shall provide out of all the people able men, such as **fear God**, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them... Exodus 18:21

They said unto Moses, You speak with us, and we will hear: but let not God speak with us, lest we die...Moses said... Fear not: for God is come to prove you, and that **His fear** may be before your faces, and you sin not. And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God was. Ex 20:19-21

I will send **My fear** before you, and will destroy all the people to whom you shall come, and I will make all your enemies turn their backs unto you. Exodus 23:27

You shall not curse the deaf, nor put a stumblingblock before the blind, but shall **fear your God**: I am the LORD... You shall rise up before the hoary head, and honor the face of the old man, and **fear your God**: I am the LORD... You shall not therefore oppress one another; but you shall **fear your God**: for I am the LORD your God. Leviticus 19:14, 32; 25:17

If your brother become poor, and fallen in decay with you; then you shall relieve him: yes, though he be a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with you. Take no usury of him, or increase: but **fear your God**; that your brother may live with you. Lev 25:35-36

For they are My servants, which I brought forth out of the land of Egypt: they shall not be sold as bondmen. You shall not rule over him with rigor; but shall **fear your God**. Leviticus 25:42-43

What nation is there so great, that has statutes and judgments so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day? Only take heed to yourself and keep your soul diligently, lest you forget the things which your eyes have seen, and lest they depart from your heart all the days of your life: but teach them to your sons, and to your sons' sons; Specially the day that you stood before the LORD your God in Horeb, when the LORD said unto me, Gather Me the people together, and I will make them hear My words, that they may learn to **fear Me** all the days that they shall live upon the earth, and that they may teach their children. Deut 4:8-10

O that there were such an heart in them, that they would **fear Me**, and keep all My commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever! Deuteronomy 5:29

These are the commandments, the statutes, and the judgments, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that you might do them in the land whither you go to possess it: That you might **fear the LORD your God**, to keep all His statutes and His commandments...all the days of your life; and that your days may be prolonged...You shall **fear the LORD your God**, and serve Him, and shall swear by His name. Deuteronomy 6:1-2, 13

The LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to **fear the LORD our God**, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is at this day. And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as He has commanded us. Deuteronomy 6:24-25

You shall remember all the way which [YEHOVAH] the LORD your God led you these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you, and to prove you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or no...You shall also consider in your heart, that, as a man chastens his son, so the LORD your God chastens you. Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, and to **fear Him**. Deuteronomy 8:2, 5-6

Now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to **fear the LORD your God**, to walk in all His ways, and to love Him, and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, To keep the commandments of the LORD, and His statutes, which I command you this day for your good? ...You shall **fear the LORD your God**... Deut 10:12-13, 20

You shall walk after the LORD your God, and **fear Him**, and keep His commandments, and obey His voice, and you shall serve Him and cleave unto Him. Deuteronomy 13:4

You shall eat before the LORD your God, in the place which He shall choose to place His name there, the tithe of your corn, of your wine, and of your oil, and the firstlings of your herds and of your flocks; that you may learn to **fear the LORD your God** always. Deuteronomy 14:23

It shall be, when he sits upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests and Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to **fear the LORD his God**, to keep all the words of this law and these statutes, to do them: That his heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel. Deuteronomy 17:18-20

If you will not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may **fear this glorious and fearful name, [YEHōVAH] THE LORD YOUR GOD**; Then the LORD will make your plagues wonderful, and the plagues of your seed, even great plagues, and of long continuance, and sore sicknesses, and of long continuance. Deuteronomy 28:58-59

Gather the people together, men, and women, and children, and your stranger that is within your gates, that they may hear, and that they may learn, and **fear the LORD your God**, and observe to do all the words of this law: And that their children, which have not known any thing, may hear, and learn to **fear the LORD your God**, as long as you live in the land whither you go over Jordan to possess it. Deuteronomy 31:12-13

For the LORD your God dried up the waters of Jordan from before you, until you were passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red sea...That all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty: that you might **fear the LORD your God** for ever. Joshua 4:23-24

Now therefore **fear the LORD**, and serve Him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve you the LORD. And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom you will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD [YEHōVAH]. Joshua 24:14-15

He took a yoke of oxen, and hewed them in pieces, and sent them throughout all the coasts of Israel by the hands of messengers, saying, Whoever comes not forth after Saul and after Samuel, so shall it be done unto his oxen. And the **fear of the LORD** fell on the people, and they came out with one consent. 1 Samuel 11:7

Behold the king whom you have chosen, and whom you have desired! And, behold, the LORD has set a king over you. If you will **fear the LORD**, and serve Him, and obey His voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both you and also the king that reigns over you continue following the LORD your God... 1 Samuel 12:13-14

The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spoke to me, He that rules over men must be just, ruling in the **fear of God**. 2 Sam 23:3

Hear in Heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart you know; (for You, even You only, know the hearts of all the children of men;) That they may **fear You** all the days they live in the land which You gave to our fathers...Do according to all that the stranger calls to you for: that all the people of the earth may know Your name, to **fear You**, as do Your people Israel...1 Kings 8:39-40, 43

It shall come to pass, as soon as I am gone from you, that the Spirit of the LORD shall carry you whither I know not; and so when I come and tell Ahab, and he cannot find you, he shall slay me: but I your servant **fear the LORD** from my youth. 1 Kings 18:12

There cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and you know that your servant did **fear the LORD [YEHoVAH]**: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen. 2 Kings 4:1

Then the king of Assyria commanded, saying, Carry thither one of the priests whom you brought from thence; and let them go and dwell there, and let him teach them the manner of the God of the land. One of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and taught them how they should **fear the LORD**. 2 Kings 17:27-28

So they **feared the LORD**, and made unto themselves of the lowest of them priests of the high places, which sacrificed for them in the houses of the high places. They **feared the LORD**, and served their own gods, after the manner of the nations whom they carried away from thence. Unto this day they do after the former manners: they **fear not the LORD**, neither do they after their statutes, or after their ordinances, or after the law and commandment which the LORD commanded the children of Jacob, whom he named Israel; And the covenant that I have made with you shall not forget; neither shall you **fear** other gods. But **the LORD your God you shall fear**; and He shall deliver you out of the hand of all your enemies. 2 Kings 17:32-39

Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner. So these nations **feared the LORD**, and served their graven images, both their children, and their children's children: as did their fathers, so do they unto this day. 2 Kings 17:40-41

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto His name: bring an offering, and come before Him: worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness. **Fear before Him**, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved. 1 Chronicles 16:29-30

Hear from Heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart You know...that they may **fear You**, to walk in Your ways... 2 Chronicles 6:30-31

They smote all the cities round about Gerar; for the **fear of the LORD** came upon them: and they spoiled all the cities; for there was exceeding much spoil in them. 2 Chronicles 14:14

They taught in Judah, and had the book of the law of the LORD with them, and went about throughout all the cities of Judah, and taught the people. And the **fear of the LORD** fell upon all the kingdoms of the lands that were round about Judah, so that they made no war against Jehoshaphat. 2 Chronicles 17:9-10

Now let the **fear of the LORD** be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts...And he charged them, saying, Thus shall you do in the **fear of the LORD**, faithfully, and with a perfect heart...And the **fear of God** was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel. 2 Chronicles 19:7, 9; 20:29

Then...I rebuked the nobles, and the rulers, and said unto them, You exact usury, every one of his brother. And I set a great assembly against them... We after our ability have redeemed our brethren the Jews, which were sold unto the heathen; and will you even sell your brethren? Or shall they be sold unto us? Then held they their peace, and found nothing to answer. Also I said, It is not good that you do: ought you not to walk in the **fear of our God** because of the reproach of heathen our enemies? Nehemiah 5:7-9



The former governors that had been before me were chargeable to the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yes, even their servants bore rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the **fear of God**. Nehemiah 5:15

Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them. And the LORD said unto Satan, Whence come you? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Have you considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that **fears God**, and eschews evil? Then Satan answered the LORD, and said, Does Job **fear God** for nought? Job 1:6-9

The LORD said unto Satan, From whence come you? And Satan answered...From going to and fro in the earth, and from walking up and down in it. And the LORD said unto Satan, Have you considered my servant Job, that there is none like him in the earth, a perfect and an upright man, one that **fears God**, and eschews evil? And still he holds fast his integrity, although you moved Me against him, to destroy him without cause. Job 2:2-3

Is not my help in me? And is wisdom driven quite from me? To him that is afflicted pity should be shown from his friend; but he forsakes the **fear of the Almighty**...And unto man he said, Behold, the **fear of the Lord**, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is understanding. Job 6:13-14, 28:28

Serve the **LORD with fear**, and rejoice with trembling. Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and you perish from the way, when His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in Him. Psalm 2:11-12

But as for me, I will come into Your house in the multitude of Your mercy: and **in Your fear** will I worship toward Your holy temple. Lead me, O LORD, in Your righteousness because of my enemies; make Your way straight before my face. Psalm 5:7-8

Arise, O LORD; let not man prevail: let the heathen be judged in Your sight. Put them in **fear, O LORD**: that the nations may know themselves to be but men. Selah. Psalm 9:19-20



LORD, who shall abide in Your tabernacle? Who shall dwell in Your holy hill? He that walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in his heart. He that backbites not with his tongue, nor does evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a reproach against his neighbor. In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honors them that **fear the LORD**. He that swears to his own hurt, and changes not. He that puts not out his money to usury, nor takes reward against the innocent. He that does these things shall never be moved. Psalm 15:1-5

The **fear of the LORD** is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. Psalm 19:9

You that **fear the LORD**, praise Him; all you the seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and **fear Him**, all you the seed of Israel. For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; neither has He hid His face from him; but when he cried unto Him, He heard. My praise shall be of You in the great congregation: I will pay my vows before them that **fear Him**. Psalm 22:23-25

What man is he that **fears the LORD**? Him shall he teach in the way that He shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD is with them that **fear Him**; and He will show them His covenant. Psalm 25:12-14

Oh how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for them that **fear You**; which You have wrought for them that trust in You before the sons of men! Psalm 31:19

Let all the earth **fear the LORD**: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him...Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that **fear Him**, upon them that hope in His mercy; To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Psalm 33:8, 18-19

The angel of the LORD encamps round about them that **fear Him**, and delivers them. O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusts in Him. O **fear the LORD**, you His saints: for there is no want to them that **fear Him**. Psalm 34:7-9

Come, you children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the **fear of the LORD [YEHoVAH]**. Psalm 34:11

The transgression of the wicked says within my heart, that there is no **fear of God** before his eyes. For he flatters himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be hateful. The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he has left off to be wise, and to do good. Psalm 36:1-3

He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon a rock, and established my goings. He has put a new song in my mouth, even praise unto our God: many shall see it, and **fear**, and shall trust in the LORD. Psalm 40:2-3

Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and He shall hear my voice. He has delivered my soul in peace from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me. God shall hear, and afflict them, even He that abides of old. Selah. Because they have no changes, therefore they **fear not God**. Psalm 56:18-19

You have given a banner to them that **fear You**, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah. ...For You, O God, have heard my vows: you have given me the heritage of those that **fear Your name**. Psalm 60:4, 61:5

All men shall **fear**, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of His doing. Psalm 64:9

Come and hear, all you that **fear God**, and I will declare what He has done for my soul. Psalms 66:16

God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall **fear Him**... They shall **fear** you as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. Psalm 67:7, 72:5

Show us Your mercy, O LORD, and grant us your salvation. I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for He will speak peace unto His people, and to His saints: but let them not turn again to folly. Surely His salvation is nigh them that **fear Him**; that glory may dwell in our land. Psalm 85:7-9

Teach me Your way, O LORD; I will walk in Your truth: unite my heart to **fear Your name**. I will praise You, O Lord my God, with all my heart; and I will glorify Your name for evermore. Psalm 86:11-12

Who knows the power of Your anger? Even according to **Your fear**, so is Your wrath. So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom. Psalm 90:11-12

Give unto the LORD the glory due unto His name: bring an offering, and come into His courts. O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: **fear before Him**, all the earth. Psalm 96:8-9

For Your servants take pleasure in her stones, and favor the dust thereof. So the heathen shall **fear the name of the LORD**, and all the kings of the earth Your glory. Psalm 102:14-15

He has not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is His mercy toward them that **fear Him**. As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. Like as a father pities his children, so the LORD pities them that **fear Him**. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust. As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourishes. For the wind passes over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more. But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that **fear Him**, and His righteousness unto children's children; To such as keep His covenant, and to those that remember His commandments to do them. Psalm 103:10-18

He has given meat unto them that **fear Him**: He will ever be mindful of His covenant. He has shown His people the power of His works, that He may give them the heritage of the heathen. Psalm 111:5-6

The **fear of the LORD** is the beginning of wisdom: a good understanding have all they that do His commandments; His praise endures for ever...Praise you the LORD. Blessed is the man that **fears the LORD**, that delights greatly in His commandments. His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed. Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endures for ever. Psalm 111:10, 112:1-3

You that **fear the LORD**, trust in the LORD: He is their help and their shield. Psalm 115:11

The LORD has been mindful of us: He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. He will bless them that **fear the LORD**, both small and great. Psalm 115:12-13

Let them that **fear the LORD** say, that His mercy endures for ever. I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, and set me in a large place. The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me? Psalm 118:4-6

Stablish Your word unto Your servant, who is devoted to **Your fear**...Your hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn Your commandments. They that **fear You** will be glad when they see me; because I have hoped in Your word. Psalm 119:38, 73-74

Let those that **fear You** turn unto me, and those that have known Your testimonies...My flesh trembles for **fear of You**; and I am afraid of Your judgments. Psalm 119:79, 120

Blessed is every one that **fears the LORD**; that walks in His ways. For you shall eat the labor of your hands: happy shall you be, and it shall be well with you. Your wife shall be as a fruitful vine by the sides of your house: your children like olive plants round about your table. Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that **fears the LORD**. Psalm 128:1-4

Bless the LORD, O house of Levi: you that **fear the LORD**, bless the LORD [YEHoVAH]. Psalm 135:120

The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in truth. He will fulfil the desire of them that **fear Him**: He also will hear their cry, and will save them. The LORD preserves all them that love Him: but all the wicked will He destroy. Psalm 145:18-20

He delights not in the strength of the horse: He takes not pleasure in the legs of a man. The LORD takes pleasure in them that **fear Him**, in those that hope in His mercy. Psalm 147:10-11

The **fear of the LORD** is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise wisdom and instruction. Proverbs 1:7

My son, if you will receive my words, and hide my commandments with you; So that you incline your ear unto wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding; Yes, if you cry after knowledge, and lift up your voice for understanding; If you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hid treasures; Then shall you understand the **fear of the LORD**, and find the knowledge of God. Proverbs 2:1-5

Be not wise in your own eyes: **fear the LORD**, and depart from evil. It shall be health to your navel, and marrow to your bones. Proverbs 3:7-8

They call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me: For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the **fear of the LORD**...Proverbs 1:28-29

The **fear of the LORD** is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. Proverbs 8:13

The **fear of the LORD** is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding. Proverbs 9:10

**The fear of the LORD** prolongs days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened. Proverbs 10:27

He that walks in his uprightness **fears the LORD**: but he that is perverse in his ways despises him...A wise man **fears**, and departs from evil: but the fool rages, and is confident. Proverbs 14:1, 16

In the **fear of the LORD** is strong confidence: and his children shall have a place of refuge. The **fear of the LORD** is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 14:26-27

Better is little with the **fear of the LORD** than great treasure and trouble therewith. Proverbs 15:16

The **fear of the LORD** is the instruction of wisdom; and before honor is humility. Proverbs 15:33

By mercy and truth iniquity is purged: and by the **fear of the LORD** men depart from evil. Proverbs 16:6

The **fear of the LORD** tends to life: and he that has it shall abide satisfied; he shall not be visited with evil. Proverbs 19:23

By humility and the **fear of the LORD** are riches, and honor, and life. Proverbs 22:4

Let not your heart envy sinners: but you be in the **fear of the LORD** all the day long. Proverbs 23:17

My son, **fear you the LORD** [YEHoVAH] and the king: and meddle not with them that are given to change: For their calamity shall rise suddenly; and who knows the ruin of them both? Proverbs 24:21-22

Happy is the man that **fears** [the Lord] always: but he that hardens his heart shall fall into mischief. Proverbs 28:14

Favor is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that **fears the LORD**, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

I know that, whatever God does, it shall be for ever: nothing can be put to it: and God does it, that men should **fear before Him**. Ecclesiastes 3:14

Be not over much wicked, neither be you foolish: why should you die before your time? It is good that you should take hold of this; yes, also from this withdraw not your hand: for he that **fears God** shall come forth of them all. Ecclesiastes 7:17-18

Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that **fear God**, which **fear before Him**: But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong his days, which are as a shadow; because he **fears not before God**. Ecclesiastes 8:12-13

Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: **Fear God**, and keep His commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. Ecclesiastes 12:13

Enter into the rock, and hide in the dust, for **fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of His majesty. The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought low... Isaiah 2:10-12

They shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for **fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of His majesty, when He arises to shake terribly the earth. In that day a man shall cast his idols of silver, and his idols of gold, which they made each one for himself to worship, to the moles and to the bats; To go into the clefts of the rocks, and into the tops of the ragged rocks, for **fear of the LORD**, and for the glory of His majesty, when He arises to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:19-21

The spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the **fear of the LORD**: And shall make Him of quick understanding in the **fear of the LORD**: and he shall not judge after the sight of His eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears. Isaiah 11:2-3

Wherefore the Lord said, Forasmuch as this people draw near Me with their mouth, and with their lips do honor Me, but have removed their hearts far from Me, and their **fear toward Me** is taught by the precept of men; Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvelous work among this people, even a marvelous work and a wonder; for the wisdom of wise men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid. Isaiah 29:13-14

When he sees his children, the work of My hand, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify My name, and sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and shall **fear the God** of Israel. Isaiah 29:23

The LORD is exalted; for He dwells on high: He has filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. Wisdom and knowledge shall be the stability of your times, and strength of salvation: the **fear of the LORD** is his treasure. Isaiah 33:5-6

Who is among you that **fears the LORD**, that obeys the voice of His servant, that walks in darkness, and has no light? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Isaiah 50:10

And of whom have you been afraid or feared, that you have lied, and have not remembered Me, nor laid it to your heart? Have not I held My peace even of old, and you **fear Me** not? I will declare your righteousness, and your works; for they shall not profit you. Isaiah 57:11-12



According to their deeds, accordingly He will repay, fury to His adversaries, recompense to His enemies; to the islands He will repay recompense. So shall they **fear the name of the LORD** from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. Isaiah 59:18-19

Lift up your eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: your sons shall come from far, and your daughters shall be nursed at your side. Then you shall see, and flow together, and your heart shall **fear**, and be enlarged; because the abundance of the sea shall be converted unto you, the forces of the Gentiles shall come unto you. Isaiah 60:4-5

Your own wickedness shall correct you, and your backslidings shall reprove you: know therefore and see that it is an evil thing and bitter, that you have forsaken the LORD your God, and that **My fear** is not in you, says the Lord GOD of hosts. Jeremiah 2:19

**Fear you not Me?** says the LORD: **will you not tremble at My presence**, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it... Jeremiah 5:22

But this people have a revolting and a rebellious heart; they are revolted and gone. Neither say they in their heart, Let us now **fear the LORD** our God, that gives rain, both the former and the latter, in His season: he reserves unto us the appointed weeks of the harvest... There is none like unto You, O LORD; You are great, and Your name is great in might. Who would not **fear You**, O King of nations? Jeremiah 5:23-24, 10:6

Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? Did he not **fear the LORD**, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls. Jeremiah 26:19

I will give them one heart, and one way, that they may **fear Me** for ever, for the good of them, and of their children after them: and I will make an everlasting covenant with them, that I will not turn away from them, to do them good; but I will put **My fear** in their hearts, that they shall not depart from Me. Jeremiah 32:39-40

I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against Me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against Me. And it shall be to Me a name of joy, a praise and an honor before all the nations of the earth, which shall hear all the good that I do unto them: and they shall **fear and tremble** for all the goodness and for all the prosperity that I procure unto it. Jeremiah 33:8-9

I make a decree, That in every dominion of My kingdom men **tremble and fear before the God** of Daniel: for He is the living God, and steadfast for ever, and His Kingdom that which shall not be destroyed, and His dominion shall be even unto the end. He delivers and rescues, and He works signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who has delivered Daniel from the power of the lions. So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian. Daniel 6:26-28

The children of Israel shall abide many days without a king, and without a prince, and without a sacrifice, and without an image, and without an ephod, and without teraphim: Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall **fear the LORD** and His goodness in the latter days. Hosea 3:4-5

And he said unto them, I am an Hebrew; and I **fear the LORD**, the God of heaven, which has made the sea and the dry land. Then were the men exceedingly afraid, and said unto him, Why have you done this? For the men knew that he fled from the presence of the LORD, because he had told them. Jonah 1:9-10

The nations shall see and be confounded at all their might: they shall lay their hand upon their mouth, their ears shall be deaf. They shall lick the dust like a serpent, they shall move out of their holes like worms of the earth: they **shall be afraid of the LORD our God, and shall fear** because of You. Who is a God like unto You, that pardons iniquity, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He retains not His anger for ever, because He delights in mercy. He will turn again, He will have compassion upon us; He will subdue our iniquities; and You will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:16-19

Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did **fear before the LORD**. Haggai 1:12

A son honors his father, and a servant his master: if then I be a father, where is My honor? And if I be a master, where is My **fear**? says the LORD of hosts unto you, O priests, that despise My name. Malachi 1:6

And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, the widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and **fear not Me**, says the LORD of hosts. For I am the LORD, I change not... Malachi 3:5-6

They that **feared the LORD** spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before Him for them that **feared the LORD [YEHoVAH]**, and that thought upon His name. And they shall be Mine, says the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up My jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spares his own son that serves him. Malachi 3:16-17

## NEW COVENANT FEAR OF GOD

He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; Saying, There was in a city a judge, which **feared not God**, neither regarded man: And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of my adversary. And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I **fear not God**, nor regard man; Yet because this widow troubles me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. Luke 18:1-5

One of the malefactors which were hanged railed on Him, saying, If you are the Messiah, save yourself and us. But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Do you not **fear God**, seeing you are in the same condemnation? And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man has done nothing amiss. And he said unto Jesus, Lord, remember me when You come into Your Kingdom. And Jesus said unto him, Truly I say unto you today, you shall be with Me in paradise. Lk 23:39-43

And great **fear** came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things. And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. And the rest dared no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. And believers were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) Then had the churches rest...and were edified; and walking in the **fear of the Lord**, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied. Acts 5:11-14, 9:31

There was a certain man in Caesarea called Cornelius, a centurion of the band called the Italian band, a devout man, and one that **feared God** with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God always. Acts 10:1-2

Then Peter went down to the men which were sent unto him from Cornelius; and said, Behold, I am he whom you seek: what is the cause wherefore you are come? And they said, Cornelius the centurion, a just man, and one that **fears God**, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for you into his house, and to hear words of you. Acts 10:21-22

Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: but in every nation he that **fears Him**, and works righteousness, is accepted with Him. Acts 10:34-35

Paul stood up, and beckoning with his hand said, Men of Israel, and you that **fear God**, give audience...Men and brethren, children of the stock of Abraham, and whoever among you **fears God**, to you is the word of this salvation sent. Acts 13:16, 26

There is no **fear of God** before their eyes. Romans 3:18

Boast not against the branches. But if you boast, you bear not the root, but the root you. You will say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by faith. Be not high minded, but **fear**: For if God spared not the natural branches, take heed lest He also spare not you. Romans 11:19-21

Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the **fear of God**. 2 Corinthians 7:1

Be not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is ...Submitting yourselves one to another in the **fear of God**. Ephesians 5:17, 21

Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, **fearing God**: and whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; knowing that of the Lord you shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for you serve the Lord Christ. But he that does wrong shall receive for the wrong which he has done: and there is no respect of persons. Colossians 3:22-25

So also Christ [Messiah] glorified not Himself to be made an high priest; but He that said unto Him, You are My Son, today have I begotten You....Who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto Him that was able to save Him from death, and was heard in that He **feared**; Though He were a Son, yet learned He obedience by the things which He suffered; And being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation... Hebrews 5:5-9

Without faith it is impossible to please Him: for He that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. By faith, Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with **fear**, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. He 11:6-7

Honor all men. Love the brotherhood. **Fear God**. Honor the king.  
1 Peter 2:17

I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, **Fear God**, and give glory to Him; for the hour of His judgment is come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication. And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of His indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: and the smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receives the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus [Yeshua]. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them. And I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on His head a golden crown, and in His hand a sharp sickle. And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to Him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in your sickle, and reap: for the time is come for you to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. And He that sat on the cloud thrust in His sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. Rev 14:6-16

## HATEFUL, HATERS, HATE, HATRED, HATED

They blessed Rebekah, and said to her, You are our sister, be the mother of thousands of millions, and let your seed possess the gate of those which **hate** them. Genesis 24:60

And Isaac said to them, Why come you to me, seeing you **hate** me, and have sent me away from you? Genesis 26:27

And Esau **hated** Jacob because of the blessing with which his father blessed him: and Esau said in his heart, The days of mourning for my father are at hand; then will I slay my brother Jacob. Genesis 27:41

And when the LORD saw that Leah was **hated**, He opened her womb: but Rachel was barren. Genesis 29:31

And she conceived again, and bore a son; and said, Because the LORD has heard I was **hated**, He has therefore given me this son also: and she called his name Simeon. Genesis 29:33

And when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they **hated** him, and could not speak peaceably to him. And Joseph dreamed a dream, and he told it to his brothers: and they **hated** him yet the more. Genesis 37:4-5

And his brothers said to him, Shall you indeed reign over us? or shall you indeed have dominion over us? And they **hated** him yet the more for his dreams, and for his words. Genesis 37:8

The archers have sorely grieved him, and shot at him, and **hated** him...And when Joseph's brothers saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure **hate** us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did to him. Genesis 49:23, 50:15

You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of them that **hate** Me... Exodus 20:5

If you see the ass of him that **hates** you lying under his burden, and would forbear to help him, you shall surely help with him. Exodus 23:5



You shall not **hate** your brother in your heart: you shall in any wise rebuke your neighbor, and not suffer sin on him. Leviticus 19:17

And I will set My face against you, and you shall be slain before your enemies: they that **hate** you shall reign over you; and you shall flee when none pursues you. Leviticus 26:17

And it came to pass, when the ark set forward, that Moses said, Rise up, LORD, and let your enemies be scattered; and let them that **hate** you flee before you. Numbers 10:35

And you murmured in your tents, and said, Because the LORD **hated** us, He has brought us forth out of the land of Egypt, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us. Deuteronomy 1:27

That the slayer might flee thither, which should kill his neighbor unawares, and **hated** him not in times past; and that fleeing to one of these cities he might live... Deuteronomy 4:42

You shall not bow down yourself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation of them that **hate** Me... Deuteronomy 5:9

Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations; And repays them that **hate** Him to their face, to destroy them: He will not be slack to him that **hates** him, He will repay him to his face. Deuteronomy 7:10

And the LORD will take away from you all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which you know, on you; but will lay them on all them that **hate** you. Deuteronomy 7:15

Remember your servants, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob; look not unto the stubbornness of this people, nor to their wickedness, nor to their sin: Lest the land from where You brought us out say, Because the LORD was not able to bring them into the land which He promised them, and because He **hated** them, He has brought them out to slay them in the wilderness. Deuteronomy 9:27-28

You shall not do so to the LORD your God: for every abomination to the LORD, which He **hates**, have they done to their gods; for even their sons and their daughters they have burnt in the fire to their gods...Neither shall you set you up any image; which the LORD your God **hates**. Deuteronomy 12:31, 16:22

And this is the case of the slayer, which shall flee thither, that he may live: Whoever kills his neighbor ignorantly, whom he **hated** not in time past; As when a man goes into the wood with his neighbor to hew wood, and his hand fetches a stroke with the axe to cut down the tree, and the head slips from the helve, and lights upon his neighbor, that he die; he shall flee unto one of those cities, and live. Lest the avenger of the blood pursue the slayer, while his heart is hot, and overtake him, because the way is long, and slay him; whereas he was not worthy of death, inasmuch as he **hated** him not in time past. Deuteronomy 19:4-6

But if any man **hate** his neighbor, and lie in wait for him, and rise up against him, and smite him mortally that he die, and flees into one of these cities: Then the elders of his city shall send and fetch him thence, and deliver him into the hand of the avenger of blood, that he may die. Your eye shall not pity him... Deut 19:11-13

If a man have two wives, one beloved, and another **hated**, and they have born him children, both the beloved and the **hated**; and if the firstborn son be hers that was **hated**: Then it shall be, when he makes his sons to inherit that which he has, that he may not make the son of the beloved firstborn before the son of the **hated**, which is indeed the firstborn: But he shall acknowledge the son of the **hated** for the firstborn, by giving him a double portion of all that he has: for he is the beginning of his strength; the right of the firstborn is his. Deuteronomy 21:15-17

If any man take a wife, and go in to her, and **hate** her...And the damsel's father shall say to the elders, I gave my daughter to this man to wife, and he **hates** her; And, lo, he has given occasions of speech against her, saying, I found not your daughter a maid; and yet these are the tokens of my daughter's virginity. And they shall spread the cloth before the elders of the city. And the elders of that city shall take that man and chastise him... Deut 22:13, 16-17

And if the latter husband **hate** her, and write her a bill of divorce, and gives it in her hand, and sends her out of his house; or if the latter husband die, which took her to be his wife; Her former husband, which sent her away, may not take her again to be his wife, after that she is defiled; for that is abomination before the LORD: and you shall not cause the land to sin, which the LORD your God gives you for an inheritance. Deut 24:3-4

The LORD your God will put all these curses on your enemies, and on them that **hate** you, which persecuted you. Deut 30:7

For I lift up My hand to heaven, and say, I live for ever. If I whet My glittering sword, and My hand take hold on judgment; I will render vengeance to My enemies, and will reward them that **hate** Me. Deuteronomy 32:41

Bless, LORD, his substance, and accept the work of his hands; smite through the loins of them that rise against him, and of them that **hate** him, that they rise not again. Deuteronomy 33:11

And if the avenger of blood pursue after him, then they shall not deliver the slayer up into his hand; because he smote his neighbor unwittingly, and **hated** him not beforetime. Joshua 20:5

Jephthah said to the elders of Gilead, Did you not **hate** me, and expel me out of my father's house? and why are you come to me now when you are in distress? Judges 11:7

And Samson's wife wept before him, and said, You do but **hate** me, and love me not: you have put forth a riddle to the children of my people, and have not told it me. And he said to her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it you? Judges 14:16

And her father said, I truly thought that you had utterly **hated** her; therefore I gave her to your companion: is not her younger sister fairer than she? take her, I pray you, instead of her. Judges 15:2

David said on that day, Whoever gets up to the gutter, and smites the Jebusites, and the lame and the blind that are **hated** of David's soul, he shall be chief and captain. Why they said, The blind and the lame shall not come into the house. 2 Sam 5:8

Then Amnon hated her exceedingly; so that the **hatred** with which he hated her was greater than the love with which he had loved her. And Amnon said to her, Arise, be gone...Absalom spoke to his brother Amnon neither good nor bad: for Absalom **hated** Amnon, because he had forced his sister Tamar. 2 Samuel 13:15, 22

Joab...said, You have shamed this day the faces of all your servants, which this day have saved your life...In that you love your enemies, and **hate** your friends. For you have declared this day, that you regard neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased you well. 2 Samuel 19:5-6

He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them that **hated** me: for they were too strong for me...You have also given me the necks of my enemies, that I might destroy them that **hate** me. 2 Samuel 22:18, 41

The king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may inquire of the LORD: but I **hate** him; for he does not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so. 1 Kings 22:8

The king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, There is yet one man, by whom we may inquire of the LORD: but I **hate** him; for he never prophesied good to me, but always evil: the same is Micaiah the son of Imla. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so. 2 Chronicles 18:7

And Jehu the son of Hanani the seer went out to meet him, and said to king Jehoshaphat, Should you help the ungodly, and love them that **hate** the LORD? therefore is wrath on you from before the LORD. 2 Chronicles 19:2

Now in the twelfth month, Adar, on the thirteenth day ... in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, (though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that **hated** them;)...Thus the Jews smote all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, and slaughter, and destruction, and did what they would to those that **hated** them. Esther 9:1, 5

They that **hate** you shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nothing. Job 8:22

He tears me in his wrath, who **hates** me: he gnashes on me with his teeth; my enemy sharpens his eyes on me. They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me. God has delivered me to the ungodly, and turned me over into the hands of the wicked. Job 16:9-11

...If I rejoiced at the destruction of him that **hated** me, or lifted up myself when evil found him: Neither have I suffered my mouth to sin by wishing a curse to his soul. Job 31:29-30

Shall even he that **hates** right govern? and will you condemn him that is most just? Job 34:17

The foolish shall not stand in Your sight: You **hate** all workers of iniquity. Psalms 5:5

Have mercy on me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that **hate** me, You that lift me up from the gates of death: Psalms 9:13

The LORD tries the righteous: but the wicked and him that loves violence His soul **hates**. Psalms 11:5

He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them which **hated** me: for they were too strong for me. Psalms 18:17

You have also given me the necks of my enemies; that I might destroy them that **hate** me. Psalms 18:40

Your hand shall find out all your enemies: your right hand shall find out those that **hate** you. Psalms 21:8

Consider my enemies; for they are many; and they **hate** me with cruel hatred. Psalms 25:19

I have **hated** the congregation of evil doers; and will not sit with the wicked. Psalms 26:5

I have **hated** them that regard lying vanities: but I trust in the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Psalms 31:6

Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that **hate** the righteous shall be desolate. Psalms 34:21

Let not them that are my enemies wrongfully rejoice over me: neither let them wink with the eye that **hate** me without a cause. Psalms 35:19

For he flatters himself in his own eyes, until his iniquity be found to be **hateful**. Psalms 36:2

But my enemies are lively, and they are strong: and they that **hate** me wrongfully are multiplied...All that **hate** me whisper together against me: against me do they devise my hurt. Ps 38:19, 41:7

Through You will we push down our enemies; though Your name will we tread them under that rise up against us... But You have saved us from our enemies, and have put them to shame that **hated** us...You make us to turn back from the enemy: and they which **hate** us spoil for themselves. Psalms 44:5-7, 10

You love righteousness, and **hate** wickedness: therefore God, Your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Psalms 45:7

But unto the wicked God says, What have you to do to declare My statutes, or that You should take My covenant in your mouth? Seeing you **hate** instruction, and cast My words behind you. Psalms 50:16-17

Attend unto me, and hear me: I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise; Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast iniquity on me, and in wrath they **hate** me. Psalms 55:2-3

For it was not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have borne it: neither was it he that **hated** me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him: But it was you, a man my equal, my guide, and my acquaintance. We took sweet counsel together, and walked unto the house of God in company. Psalms 55:12

Let God arise, let His enemies be scattered: let them also that **hate** Him flee before Him. Psalms 68:1

They that **hate** me without a cause are more than the hairs of my head: they that would destroy me, being my enemies wrongfully, are mighty... Psalms 69:4

Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that **hate** me, and out of the deep waters. Psalms 69:14

The **haters** of the LORD should have submitted themselves to Him: but their time should have endured for ever. Psalms 81:15

For, see, your enemies make a tumult: and they that **hate** you have lifted up the head. Psalms 83:2

Show me a token for good; that they which **hate** me may see it, and be ashamed: because You, LORD, have helped me, and comforted me. Psalms 86:17

And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that **hate** him. Psalms 89:23

You that love the LORD, **hate** evil: He preserves the souls of His saints; He delivers them out of the hand of the wicked. Psalms 97:10

I will set no wicked thing before my eyes: I **hate** the work of them that turn aside; it shall not stick to me. Psalms 101:3

He turned their heart to **hate** His people, to deal subtly with His servants. Psalms 105:25

And He saved them from the hand of him that **hated** them, and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. Psalms 106:10

And He gave them into the hand of the heathen; and they that **hated** them ruled over them. Psalms 106:41

The LORD takes my part with them that help me: therefore shall I see my desire on them that **hate** me. Psalms 118:7

Through your precepts I get understanding: therefore I **hate** every false way. Psalms 119:104

I **hate** vain thoughts: but Your law do I love... I esteem all Your precepts concerning all things to be right; and I **hate** every false way. Psalms 119:113, 128



I **hate** and abhor lying: but Your law do I love. Psalms 119:163

Psalms 129:5

Do not I **hate** them, O LORD, that **hate** You? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against you? I **hate** them with perfect **hatred**: I count them my enemies. Psalms 139:21-22

How long, you simple ones, will you love simplicity? and the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools **hate** knowledge?  
Proverbs 1:22

For that they **hated** knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD...And say, How have I **hated** instruction, and my heart despised reproof... Proverbs 1:29, 5:12

These six things does the LORD **hate**: yes, seven are an abomination to Him: A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, an heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief, A false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren.  
Proverbs 6:16-19

The fear of the LORD is to **hate** evil: pride, and arrogance, and the evil way, and the fraudulent mouth, do I hate. Proverbs 8:13

But he that sins against me wrongs his own soul: all they that **hate** me love death. Proverbs 8:36

Therefore I **hated** life; because the work that is worked under the sun is grievous to me: for all is vanity and vexation of spirit. Yes, I **hated** all my labor which I had taken under the sun: because I should leave it to the man that shall be after me. Eccl 2:17-18

A time to love, and a time to **hate**; a time of war, and a time of peace. Ecclesiastes 3:8

The king spake, and said, Belteshazzar, let not the dream, or the interpretation thereof trouble you. Belteshazzar [Daniel] answered and said, My lord, the dream be to them that **hate** you, and the interpretation thereof to your enemies. Daniel 4:19

All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I **hated** them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of Mine house, I will love them no more: all their princes are revolvers. Hosea 9:15

They **hate** him that rebukes in the gate, and they abhor him that speaks uprightly. Amos 5:10

**Hate** the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:15

I **hate**, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. Amos 5:21

The Lord GOD has sworn by Himself, says the LORD the God of hosts, I abhor the excellency of Jacob, and **hate** his palaces: therefore will I deliver up the city with all that is therein. Amos 6:8

I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and you princes of the house of Israel; Is it not for you to know judgment? Who **hate** the good, and love the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones; Who also eat the flesh of My people, and flay their skin from off them; and they break their bones, and chop them in pieces, as for the pot, and as flesh within the caldron. Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but He will not hear them: He will even hide His face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings. Micah 3:1-4

These are the things that you shall do; speak you every man the truth to his neighbor; execute the judgment of truth and peace in your gates; And let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbor; and love no false oath: for all these are things that I **hate**, says the LORD. Yet I loved Jacob, and I **hated** Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness. Malachi 1:2b-3

You have heard that it has been said, You shall love your neighbor, and **hate** your enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that **hate** you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you... Matthew 5:43-44

You shall be **hated** of all men for My name's sake: but he that endures to the end shall be saved...Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and you shall be **hated** of all nations for My name's sake. And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall **hate** one another. Matthew 10:22, 24:9-10

And you shall be **hated** of all men for My name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. Mark 13:13

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel...As He spake by the mouth of His holy prophets, which have been since the world began: That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that **hate** us; to perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember His holy covenant; the oath which He swore to our father Abraham, that He would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear, in holiness and righteousness before Him, all the days of our life. And you, child, shall be called the prophet of the Highest; for you shall go before the face of the Lord to prepare His ways; to give knowledge of salvation unto His people by the remission of their sins...Luke 1:68-77

Blessed are you, when men shall **hate** you... and shall reproach you, and cast out your name as evil, for the Son of man's sake... But I say unto you which hear, Love your enemies, do good to them which **hate** you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you. Luke 6:22, 27

If any man come to me, and **hate** not his father, and mother, and wife, and children, and brethren, and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple...No servant can serve two masters: for either he will **hate** the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. The world cannot **hate** you; but Me it **hates**, because I testify of it, that the works thereof are evil. John 7:7

If the world **hate** you, you know that it **hated** Me before it **hated** you. If you were of the world, the world would love his own: but because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world **hates** you...He that **hates** Me **hates** My Father also. If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and **hated** both Me and My Father. But this comes to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They **hated** Me without a cause. John 15:18, 23-25

I have given them Your word; and the world has **hated** them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. John 17:14

...God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, **haters** of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without understanding, covenant-breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful... Romans 1:30

For that which I do I allow not: for what I would, that do I not; but what I **hate**, that do I. Romans 7:15

As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I **hated**. Romans 9:13

So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loves his wife loves himself. For no man ever yet **hated** his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as the Lord the church... Ephesians 5:28-29

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasure, living in malice and envy, **hateful**, and **hating** one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared... Titus 3:3-4

Unto the Son He said, Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom. You have loved righteousness, and **hated** iniquity; therefore God, even Your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above Your fellows. Hebrews 1:8-9

Marvel not, my brethren, if the world **hate** you. 1 John 3:13

This you have, that you **hate** the deeds of the Nicolaitans, which I also **hate**...So have you also them that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I **hate**. Revelation 2:6,15

The ten horns which you saw upon the beast, these shall **hate** the whore, and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire. Revelation 17:16

## WISDOM and WISE

When the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one **wise**, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her, and he did eat. Genesis 3:6

It came to pass in the morning that his spirit was troubled; and he sent and called for all the magicians of Egypt, and all the **wise** men thereof: and Pharaoh told them his dream; but there was none that could interpret them unto Pharaoh. Genesis 41:8

Now therefore let Pharaoh look out for a man discreet and **wise**, and set him over the land of Egypt...and Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God has shown you all this, there is none so discreet and **wise** as you are... Genesis 41:33, 39

Then Pharaoh also called the **wise** men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments. Exodus 7:11

You shall take no gift: for the gift blinds the **wise**, and perverts the words of the righteous. Exodus 23:8

And you shall speak unto all that are **wise** hearted, whom I have filled with the spirit of **wisdom**, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto Me in the priest's office. Exodus 28:3

And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in **wisdom**, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship...And I, behold, I have given with him Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan: and in the hearts of all that are **wise** hearted I have put **wisdom**, that they may make all that I have commanded you... Exodus 31:3, 6

Every **wise** hearted among you shall come, and make all that the LORD has commanded...All the women that were **wise** hearted did spin with their hands, and brought that which they had spun, both of blue, and of purple, and of scarlet, and of fine linen. And all the women whose heart stirred them up in **wisdom** spun goats' hair. Exodus 35:10, 25-26

He has filled him with the spirit of God, in **wisdom**, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship... Exodus 35:31

Them has He filled with **wisdom** of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, even to them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work. Exodus 35:35

Then wrought Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every **wise** hearted man, in whom the LORD put **wisdom** and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. And Moses called Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every **wise** hearted man, in whose heart the LORD had put **wisdom**, even every one whose heart stirred him up to come unto the work to do it...Ex 36:1-2

All the **wise** men, that wrought all the work of the sanctuary, came every man from his work which they made...and every **wise** hearted man among them that wrought the work of the tabernacle made ten curtains of fine twined linen, and blue, and purple, and scarlet: with cherubim of cunning work made he them. Ex 36:4, 8

Take you **wise** men, and understanding, and known among your tribes, and I will make them rulers over you...So I took the chief of your tribes, **wise** men, and known, and made them heads over you, captains over thousands, and captains over hundreds, and captains over fifties, and captains over tens, and officers among your tribes. Deuteronomy 1:13, 15

Keep therefore and do them; for this is your **wisdom** and your understanding in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a **wise** and understanding people. Deuteronomy 4:6

You shall not wrest judgment; you shall not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift does blind the eyes of the **wise**, and pervert the words of the righteous. Deuteronomy 16:19

O that they were **wise**, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end! Deuteronomy 32:29

Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of **wisdom**; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him and did as the LORD commanded Moses. Deuteronomy 34:9

The mother of Sisera looked out at a window, and cried through the lattice, Why is his chariot so long in coming? Why tarry the wheels of his chariots? Her **wise** ladies answered her, yes, she returned answer to herself... Judges 5:28-29

Joab sent to Tekoah, and fetched thence a **wise** woman, and said unto her, I pray you, feign yourself to be a mourner, and put on now mourning apparel, and anoint not yourself with oil, but be as a woman that had a long time mourned for the dead... 2 Sam 14:2

To fetch about this form of speech has your servant Joab done this thing: and my lord is **wise**, according to the **wisdom** of an angel of God, to know all things that are in the earth. 2 Sam 14:20

The women went unto all the people in her **wisdom**. And they cut off the head of Sheba the son of Bichri, and cast it out to Joab. 2 Samuel 20:22

Do therefore according to your **wisdom**, and let not his hoar head go down to the grave in peace. 1 Kings 2:6

Behold, I have done according to your words: lo, I have given you a **wise** and understanding heart; so that there was none like you before you, neither after you shall any arise like unto you. 1 Kings 3:12

Then spake the woman whose the living child was unto the king, for her bowels yearned upon her son, and she said, O my lord, give her the living child, and in no **wise** slay it. But the other said, Let it be neither mine nor thine, but divide it. Then the king answered and said, Give her the living child, and in no **wise** slay it: she is the mother thereof. And all Israel heard of the judgment which the king had judged; and they feared the king: for they saw that the **wisdom** of God was in him, to do judgment... God gave Solomon **wisdom** and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 1 Kings 3:26-28, 4:29

Solomon's **wisdom** excelled the **wisdom** of all the children of the east country, and all the **wisdom** of Egypt...And there came of all people to hear the **wisdom** of Solomon, from all kings of the earth, which had heard of his **wisdom**. 1 Kings 4:30, 34

It came to pass, when Hiram heard the words of Solomon, that he rejoiced greatly, and said, Blessed be the LORD this day, which has given unto David a **wise** son over this great people. 1 Kings 5:7

And the LORD gave Solomon **wisdom**, as He promised him: and there was peace between Hiram and Solomon; and they two made a league together. 1 Kings 5:12

He was a widow's son of the tribe of Naphtali, and his father was a man of Tyre, a worker in brass: and he was filled with **wisdom**, and understanding, and cunning to work all works in brass. And he came to king Solomon, and wrought all his work. 1 Kings 7:14

When the queen of Sheba had seen all Solomon's **wisdom**... she said to the king, It was a true report that I heard in my own land of your acts and of your **wisdom**...Howbeit I believed not the words, until I came, and my eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: your **wisdom** and prosperity exceeds the fame which I heard. Happy are your men, happy are these your servants, which stand continually before you, and that hear your **wisdom**. 1 Kings 10:4, 6-8

So king Solomon exceeded all the kings of the earth for riches and for **wisdom**. And all the earth sought to Solomon, to hear his **wisdom**, which God had put in his heart...And the rest of the acts of Solomon, and all that he did, and his **wisdom**, are they not written in the book of the acts of Solomon? 1 Kings 10:24, 11:41

Only the LORD give you **wisdom** and understanding, and give you charge concerning Israel, that you may keep the law of the LORD your God. 1 Chronicles 22:12

The lot eastward fell to Shelemiah. Then for Zechariah his son, a **wise** counselor, they cast lots; and his lot came out northward. 1 Chronicles 26:14

Jonathan David's uncle was a counselor, a **wise** man, and a scribe... 1 Chronicles 27:32

Give me now **wisdom** and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can judge this your people, that is so great? And God said to Solomon, Because this was in your heart, and you have not asked riches, wealth, or honor, nor the life of your enemies, neither yet have asked long life; but have asked **wisdom** and knowledge for yourself, that you may judge my people, over whom I have made you king: **Wisdom** and knowledge is granted unto you; and I will give you riches, and wealth, and honor, such as none of the kings have had that have been before you, neither shall there any after you have the same. 2 Chronicles 1:10-12

And when the queen of Sheba had seen the **wisdom** of Solomon, and the house that he had built...And she said to the king, It was a true report which I heard in mine own land of your acts, and of your **wisdom**: Howbeit I believed not their words, until I came, and my eyes had seen it: and, behold, the one half of the greatness of thy **wisdom** was not told me: for you exceed the fame that I heard. Happy are your men, and happy are these your servants, which stand continually before you, and hear your **wisdom**... King Solomon passed all the kings of the earth in riches and **wisdom**. And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his **wisdom**, that God had put in his heart. 2 Chronicles 9:3, 5-7, 22-23

And you, Ezra, after the **wisdom** of your God, that is in your hand, set magistrates and judges, which may judge all the people that are beyond the river, all such as know the laws of your God; and you teach them to those that know them not. Ezra 7:25

The king said to the **wise** men, which knew the times, (for so was the king's manner toward all that knew law and judgment... Esther 1:13

Haman told Zeresh his wife and all his friends everything that had befallen him. Then said his **wise** men and Zeresh his wife unto him, If Mordecai be of the seed of the Jews, before whom you have begun to fall, you shall not prevail against him, but shall surely fall before him. Esther 6:13

Does not their excellency which is in them go away? They die, even without **wisdom**...He takes the **wise** in their own craftiness: and the counsel of the froward is carried headlong. Job 4:21, 5:1

Is not my help in me? And is **wisdom** driven quite from me? Job 6:13

He is **wise** in heart, and mighty in strength: who has hardened himself against him, and has prospered? Job 9:4

And that He would show you the secrets of **wisdom**, that they are double to that which is! Know therefore that God exacts of you less than your iniquity deserves. Job 11:6

For vain man would be **wise**, though man be born like a wild ass's colt. Job 11:12

No doubt but you are the people, and **wisdom** shall die with you...Job 12:2

With the ancient is **wisdom** and in length of days understanding. With Him is **wisdom** and strength, He has counsel and understanding...With Him is strength and **wisdom**: the deceived and the deceiver are His. Job 12:12-13, 16

O that you would altogether hold your peace! And it should be your **wisdom**. Job 13:5

Have you heard the secret of God? And do you restrain **wisdom** to yourself? Job 15:8

Can a man be profitable unto God, as he that is **wise** may be profitable unto himself? Job 22:2

How have you counseled him that has no **wisdom**? And how have you plentifully declared the thing as it is? Job 26:3

But where shall **wisdom** be found? And where is the place of understanding? ...No mention shall be made of coral, or of pearls: for the price of **wisdom** is above rubies. Job 28:12, 18

Whence then comes **wisdom**? And where is the place of understanding?...And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is **wisdom**; and to depart from evil is understanding. Job 28:20, 28

I said, Days should speak, and multitude of years should teach **wisdom**...Great men are not always **wise**: neither do the aged understand judgment. Job 32:7, 9

...Lest you should say, We have found out **wisdom**: God thrusts him down, not man. Job 32:13

If not, hearken unto me: hold your peace, and I shall teach you **wisdom**. Job 33:33

Hear my words, O you **wise** men; and give ear unto me, you that have knowledge. Job 34:2

Let men of understanding tell me, and let a **wise** man hearken unto me. Job 34:34

Behold, God is mighty, and despises not any: He is mighty in strength and **wisdom**. Job 36:5

Men do therefore fear Him: He respects not any that are **wise** of heart. Job 37:24

Who has put **wisdom** in the inward parts? Or who has given understanding to the heart? Who can number the clouds in **wisdom**? Or who can stay the bottles of heaven... Job 38:36-37

Because God has deprived her of **wisdom**, neither has He imparted to her understanding. Job 39:17

Does the hawk fly by your **wisdom**, and stretch her wings toward the south? Job 39:26

Be **wise** now therefore, O you kings: be instructed, you judges of the earth. Psalm 2:10

The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making **wise** the simple. Psalm 19:7

The words of his mouth are iniquity and deceit: he has left off to be **wise**, and to do good. Psalm 36:3

The mouth of the righteous speaks **wisdom**, and his tongue talks of judgment. Psalm 37:30



My mouth shall speak of **wisdom**; and the meditation of my heart shall be of understanding. Psalm 49:3

For he sees that **wise** men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others. Psalm 49:10

Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts: and in the hidden part You shall make me to know **wisdom**. Psalm 51:6

So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto **wisdom**. Psalm 90:12

Understand, you brutish among the people: and you fools, when will you be **wise**? Psalm 94:8

O LORD, how manifold are Your works! In **wisdom** have You made them all: the earth is full of Your riches. Psalm 104:24

He made him lord of his house, and rule of all his substance: To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators **wisdom**. Psalm 105:21, 22

Whoso is **wise**, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. Psalm 107:43

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of **wisdom**: a good understanding have all they that do His commandments: His praise endures for ever. Psalm 111:10

To know **wisdom** and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; To receive the instruction of **wisdom**, justice, and judgment, and equity... Proverbs 1:2-3

A **wise** man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto **wise** counsels: to understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the **wise**, and their dark sayings. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge: but fools despise **wisdom** and instruction. Pro 1:5-7

**Wisdom** cries without; she utters her voice in the streets... Proverbs 1:20

So that you incline your ear unto **wisdom**: out of his mouth comes knowledge and understanding. He lays up sound **wisdom** for the righteous: He is a buckler to them that walk uprightly. Proverbs 2:6-7

Be not **wise** in your own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil. Proverbs 3:7

When **wisdom** enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto your soul; Discretion shall preserve you, understanding shall keep you: To deliver you from the way of the evil man... Proverbs 2:10-11

Happy is the man that finds **wisdom**, and the man that gets understanding...The LORD by **wisdom** has founded the earth; by understanding has He established the heavens... My son, let not them depart from your eyes: keep sound **wisdom** and discretion..The **wise** shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Proverbs 3:13, 19, 21, 35

Get **wisdom**, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth...**Wisdom** is the principal thing; therefore get **wisdom**: and with all your getting get understanding. Proverbs 4:5, 7

I have taught you in the way of **wisdom**; I have led you in right paths...My son, attend unto my **wisdom**, and bow your ear to my understanding... Proverbs 4:11, 5:1

Go to the ant, you sluggard; consider her ways, and be **wise**... Proverbs 6:6

Say unto **wisdom**, You are my sister; and call understanding your kinswoman... Proverbs 7:4

Does not **wisdom** cry? And understanding put forth her voice? ...O you simple, understand **wisdom**: and, you fools, be you of an understanding heart...For **wisdom** is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it... I **wisdom** dwell with prudence, and find out knowledge of witty inventions...counsel is mine, and sound **wisdom**: I am understanding; I have strength. Proverbs 8:1, 5, 11-12, 14

Hear instruction, and be **wise**, and refuse it not. Proverbs 8:33

**Wisdom** has built her house, she has hewn out her seven pillars...  
Proverbs 9:1

Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate you: rebuke a **wise** man, and he will love you. Give instruction to a **wise** man, and he will be yet **wiser**: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of **wisdom**: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding. Proverbs 9:8-10

If you be **wise**, you shall be **wise** for yourself: but if you scorn, you alone shall bear it. Proverbs 9:12

The proverbs of Solomon. A **wise** son makes a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother...He that gathers in summer is a **wise** son: but he that sleeps in harvest is a son that causes shame. Proverbs 10:1, 5

The **wise** in heart will receive commandments: but a prating fool shall fall...In the lips of him that has understanding **wisdom** is found: but a rod is for the back of him that is void of understanding. **Wise** men lay up knowledge: but the mouth of the foolish is near destruction. Proverbs 10:8, 13-14

In the multitude of words there wants not sin: but he that refrains his lips is **wise**...The lips of the righteous feed many: but fools die for want of **wisdom**. Proverbs 10:19, 21

It is as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding has **wisdom**...The mouth of the just brings forth **wisdom**: but the froward tongue shall be cut out. Proverbs 10:23, 31

When pride comes, then comes shame: but with the lowly is **wisdom**. Proverbs 11:2

He that is void of **wisdom** despises his neighbor: but a man of understanding holds his peace. Proverbs 11:12

He that troubles his own house shall inherit the wind: and the fool shall be servant to the **wise** of heart. The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that wins souls is **wise**. Proverbs 11:29-30

A man shall be commended according to his **wisdom**: but he that is of a perverse heart shall be despised. Proverbs 12:8

The way of a fool is right in his own eyes: but he that hearkens unto counsel is **wise**. Proverbs 12:15

A **wise** son hears his father's instruction: but a scorner hears not rebuke. Proverbs 13:1

The law of the **wise** is a fountain of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 13:10

Only by pride comes contention: but with the well advised is **wisdom**. Proverbs 13:14

He that walks with **wise** men shall be **wise**: but a companion of fools shall be destroyed. Proverbs 13:20

Every **wise** woman builds her house: but the foolish plucks it down with her hands. Proverbs 14:1

In the mouth of the foolish is a rod of pride: but the lips of the **wise** shall preserve them. Proverbs 14:3

A scorner seeks **wisdom**, and finds it not: but knowledge is easy to him that understands. Proverbs 14:6

The **wisdom** of the prudent is to understand his way: but the folly of fools is deceit. Proverbs 14:8

The **wise** man fears, and departs from evil: but the fool rages, and is confident. Proverbs 14:16

The crown of the **wise** is their riches: but the foolishness of fools is folly. Proverbs 14:24

The king's favor is toward a **wise** servant; but his wrath is against him that causes shame. Proverbs 14:35

**Wisdom** rests in the heart of him that has understanding: but that which is in the midst of fools is made known. Proverbs 14:33

The tongue of the **wise** uses knowledge aright: but the mouth of fools pours out foolishness. Proverbs 15:2

The lips of the **wise** disperse knowledge: but the heart of the foolish does not so. Proverbs 15:7

A scorner loves not one that reproves him: neither will he go unto the **wise**. Proverbs 15:12

A **wise** son makes a glad father: but a foolish man despises his mother. Proverbs 15:20

Folly is joy to him that is destitute of **wisdom**: but a man of understanding walks uprightly. Proverbs 15:21

The way of life is above to the **wise**, that he may depart from hell beneath. Proverbs 15:24

The ear that hears the reproof of life abides among the **wise**. Proverbs 15:31

The fear of the LORD is the instruction of **wisdom**; and before honor is humility. Proverbs 15:33

The wrath of a king is as messengers of death: but a **wise** man will pacify it. Proverbs 16:14

How much better is it to get **wisdom** than gold! And to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver! Proverbs 16:16

The **wise** in heart shall be called prudent: and the sweetness of the lips increases learning...The heart of the **wise** teaches his mouth, and adds learning to his lips. Proverbs 16:21, 23

A **wise** servant shall have rule over a son that causes shame, and shall have part of the inheritance among the brethren. Pro 17:2

A reproof enters more into a **wise** man than an hundred stripes into a fool. Proverbs 17:10

Even a fool, when he holds his peace, is counted **wise**: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of understanding. Proverbs 17:28

Through desire a man, having separated himself, seeks and intermeddles with all **wisdom**. Proverbs 18:1

The words of a man's mouth are as deep waters, and the wellspring of **wisdom** as a flowing brook. Proverbs 18:4

The heart of the prudent gets knowledge; and the ear of the **wise** seeks knowledge. Proverbs 18:15

My son, if your heart be **wise**, my heart shall rejoice, even mine. Proverbs 23:15

The father of the righteous shall greatly rejoice: and he that begets a **wise** child shall have joy of him. Proverbs 23:24

Through **wisdom** is an house built; and by understanding it is established: Proverbs 24:3

A **wise** man is strong; yes, a man of knowledge increases strength. Proverbs 24:5

For by **wise** counsel you shall make your war: and in multitude of counselors there is safety. Proverbs 24:6

**Wisdom** is too high for a fool: he opens not his mouth in the gate. Proverbs 24:7

My son, you eat honey, because it is good; and the honeycomb, which is sweet to your taste. So shall the knowledge of **wisdom** be unto your soul: when you have found it, then there shall be a reward, and your expectation shall not be cut off. Pro 24:13-14

These things also belong to the **wise**. It is not good to have respect of persons in judgment. Proverbs 24:23

As an earring of gold, and an ornament of fine gold, so is a **wise** reprove upon an obedient ear. Proverbs 25:12

Answer a fool according to his folly, lest he be **wise** in his own conceit... You see a man **wise** in his own conceit? There is more hope of a fool than of him. Proverbs 26:5, 12

My son, be **wise**, and make my heart glad, that I may answer him that reproaches me. Proverbs 27:11

Whoso keeps the law is a **wise** son: but he that is a companion of riotous men shames his father. Proverbs 28:7

The rich man is **wise** in his own conceit; but the poor has understanding that searches him out. Proverbs 28:11

Whoso loves **wisdom** rejoices his father: but he that keeps company with harlots spends his substance. Proverbs 29:3



Scornful men bring a city into a snare: but **wise** men turn away wrath...If a **wise** man contends with a foolish man, whether he rage or laugh, there is no rest...A fool utters all his mind: but a **wise** man keeps it in till afterwards. Proverbs 29:8-9, 11

The rod and reproof give **wisdom**: but a child left to himself brings his mother to shame. Proverbs 29:15

There be four things which are little upon the earth, but they are exceeding **wise**: The ants are a people not strong, yet they prepare their meat in the summer; The conies are but a feeble folk, yet make they their houses in the rocks; The locusts have no king, yet go they forth all of them by bands; The spider takes hold with her hands, and is in kings' palaces. Proverbs 30:24-28

Surely I am more brutish than any man, and have not the understanding of a man. I neither learned **wisdom**, nor have the knowledge of the holy. Who has ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name, and what is His son's name, if you can tell? Proverbs 30:2-4

She opens her mouth with **wisdom**; and in her tongue is the law of kindness. She looks well to the ways of her household, and eats not the bread of idleness. Her children rise up, and call her blessed; her husband also, and he praises her. Many daughters have done virtuously, but you excel them all. Favor is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that fears the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:26

I gave my heart to seek and search out by **wisdom** concerning all things that are done under heaven: this sore travail has God given to the sons of man to be exercised therewith... I communed with mine own heart, saying, Lo, I am come to great estate, and have gotten more **wisdom** than all they that have been before me in Jerusalem: yes, my heart had great experience of **wisdom** and knowledge. And I gave my heart to know **wisdom**, and to know madness and folly: I perceived that this also is vexation of spirit. For in much **wisdom** is much grief: and he that increases knowledge increases sorrow. Eccl 1:13, 16-18

I sought in my heart to give myself unto wine, yet acquainting my heart with **wisdom**; and to lay hold on folly, till I might see what was that good for the sons of men, which they should do under the heaven all the days of their life. So I was great, and increased more than all that were before me in Jerusalem: also my **wisdom** remained with me...and I turned myself to behold **wisdom**, and madness, and folly: for what can the man do that comes after the king? Even that which has been already done. Then I saw that **wisdom** excels folly, as far as light excels darkness. Eccl 2:3-13

The **wise** man's eyes are in his head; but the fool walks in darkness: and I myself perceived also that one event happens to them all. Then said I in my heart, As it happens to the fool, so it happens even to me; and why was I then more **wise**? Then I said in my heart, that this also is vanity. For there is no remembrance of the **wise** more than of the fool for ever; seeing that which now is in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dies the **wise** man? As the fool. Ecclesiastes 2:14-16

And who knows whether he shall be a **wise** man or a fool? Yet shall he have rule over all my labor wherein I have labored, and wherein I have shown myself **wise** under the sun. This is also vanity. Ecclesiastes 2:19

For there is a man whose labor is in **wisdom**, and in knowledge, and in equity; yet to a man that has not labored therein shall he leave it for his portion. This also is vanity and a great evil... For God gives to a man that is good in His sight **wisdom**, and knowledge, and joy: but to the sinner He gives travail, to gather and to heap up, that he may give to him that is good before God. This also is vanity and vexation of spirit. Eccl 2:21, 26

Better is a poor and a **wise** child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished. Ecclesiastes 4:13

For what has the **wise** more than the fool? What has the poor, that knows to walk before the living? Ecclesiastes 6:8

The heart of the **wise** is in the house of mourning; but the heart of fools is in the house of mirth...It is better to hear the rebuke of the **wise**, than for a man to hear the song of fools. Eccl 7:4-5

Surely oppression makes a **wise** man mad; and a gift destroys the heart. Ecclesiastes 7:7

**Wisdom** is good with an inheritance: and by it there is profit to them that see the sun. For wisdom is a defense, and money is a defense: but the excellency of knowledge is, that **wisdom** gives life to them that have it. Ecclesiastes 7:11-12

Be not righteous over much; neither make yourself over **wise**: why should you destroy yourself? Ecclesiastes 7:16

**Wisdom** strengthens the **wise** more than ten mighty men which are in the city. Ecclesiastes 7:19

All this have I proved by **wisdom**: I said, I will be **wise**; but it was far from me. That which is far off, and exceeding deep, who can find it out? I applied my heart to know, and to search, and to seek out **wisdom**, and the reason of things, and to know the wickedness of folly, even of foolishness and madness: And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso pleases God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Eccl7:23-26

Who is as the **wiseman**? And who knows the interpretation of a thing? A man's **wisdom** makes his face to shine, and the boldness of his face shall be changed. Ecclesiastes 8:1

Whoso keeps the commandment shall feel no evil thing: and a **wise** man's heart discerns both time and judgment. Eccl 8:5

When I applied my heart to know **wisdom**, and to see the business that is done upon the earth: (for also there is that neither day nor night sees sleep with his eyes:) Then I beheld all the work of God, that a man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun: because though a man labor to seek it out, yet he shall not find it; yes further; though a **wise** man think to know it, yet shall he not be able to find it. Ecclesiastes 8:16-17

For all this I considered in my heart even to declare all this, that the righteous, and the **wise**, and their works, are in the hand of God: no man knows either love or hatred by all that is before them. Ecclesiastes 9:1

Whatsoever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might; for there is no work, nor device, nor knowledge, nor **wisdom**, in the grave, whither you go. I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet favor to men of skill; but time and chance happens to them all. Ecclesiastes 9:10-11

This **wisdom** have I seen also under the sun, and it seemed great unto me: There was a little city, and few men within it; and there came a great king against it, and besieged it, and built great bulwarks against it: Now there was found in it a poor **wise** man, and he by his **wisdom** delivered the city; yet no man remembered that same man. Then said I, **Wisdom** is better than strength: nevertheless the poor man's **wisdom** is despised, and his words are not heard. The words of **wise** men are heard in quiet more than the cry of him that rules among fools. **Wisdom** is better than weapons of war; but one sinner destroys much good. Ecclesiastes 9:13-18

Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savor: so does a little folly him that is in reputation for **wisdom** and honor. A **wise** man's heart is at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left. Yes also, when he that is a fool walks by the way, his **wisdom** fails him, and he says to every one that he is a fool. Ecclesiastes 10:1-3

**Wisdom** is profitable to direct...The words of a **wise** man's mouth are gracious; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself. Ecclesiastes 10:10, 12

Woe unto them that are **wise** in their own eyes, and prudent in their own sight!...By the strength of my hand I have done it, and by my **wisdom**; for I am prudent: and I have removed the bounds of the people, and have robbed their treasures, and I have put down the inhabitants like a valiant man... Isaiah 5:21, 10:13

The spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of **wisdom** and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; and shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD... Isaiah 11:2-3a

The counsel of the **wise** counselors of Pharaoh is become brutish: how say you unto Pharaoh, I am the son of the **wise**, the son of ancient kings? Where are they? Where are your **wise** men? And let them tell you now, and let them know what the LORD of hosts has purposed upon Egypt. Isaiah 19:11-12

Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvelous work among this people, even a marvelous work and a wonder: for the **wisdom** of their **wise** men shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid. Isaiah 29:14

Yet he also is **wise**, and will bring evil, and will not call back his words: but will arise against the house of the evildoers, and against the help of them that work iniquity. Isaiah 31:2

O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have waited for You: You be their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble. The LORD is exalted; for He dwells on high: He has filled Zion with judgment and righteousness. And **wisdom** and knowledge shall be the stability of their times, and strength of salvation: the fear of the LORD is his treasure...Thus says the LORD [YEHOVAH], I am your Redeemer...That frustrates the tokens of the liars, and makes diviners mad; that turns **wise** men backward, and makes their knowledge foolish... Isaiah 33:2, 2, 5-6, 44:24-25

Your **wisdom** and your knowledge, it has perverted you; and you have said in your heart, I am, and none else beside me. Isaiah 47:10

For My people are foolish, they have not known Me; they are sottish children, and they have none understanding: they are **wise** to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge. Jeremiah 4:22

How do you say, We are **wise**, and the law of the LORD is with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he it; the pen of the scribes is in vain. The **wise** men are ashamed, they are dismayed and taken: lo, they have rejected the word of the LORD; and what **wisdom** is in them? Who is the **wise** man, that may understand this? And who is he to whom the mouth of the LORD has spoken, that he may declare it, for what the land perishes and is burned up like a wilderness, that none passes through? Jeremiah 8:8-9, 9:12

Thus says the LORD, Let not the **wise** man glory in his **wisdom**, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, says the LORD. Jer 9:23-24

Who would not fear you, O King of nations? For to You does it appertain: forasmuch as among all the **wise** men of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like unto You... He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His **wisdom**, and has stretched out the heavens by His discretion. Jeremiah 10:7, 12

Then said they, Come, and let us devise devices against Jeremiah; for the law shall not perish from the priest, nor counsel from the **wise**, nor the word from the prophet. Come, and let us smite him with the tongue, and let us not give heed to any of his words. Jeremiah 18:18

Concerning Edom, thus says the LORD of hosts; Is **wisdom** no more in Teman? is counsel perished from the prudent? Is their **wisdom** vanished? Jeremiah 49:7

A sword is upon the Chaldeans, says the LORD, and upon the inhabitants of Babylon, and upon her princes, and upon her **wise** men. Jeremiah 50:35

He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His **wisdom**, and has stretched out the heaven by His understanding. Jeremiah 51:15

I will make drunk her princes, and her **wise** men, her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, says the King, whose name is the LORD of hosts. Jeremiah 51:57

The inhabitants of Zidon and Arvad were your mariners: your **wise** men, O Tyrus, that were in you, were your pilots. The ancients of Gebal and the **wise** men thereof were in you your caulkers: all the ships of the sea with their mariners were in you to occupy your merchandise. Ezekiel 27:8-9



With your **wisdom** and with your understanding you have gotten yourself riches, and have gotten gold and silver into your treasures: by your great **wisdom** and by your traffic have you increased your riches, and your heart is lifted up because of your riches...Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon you, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of your **wisdom**, and they shall defile your brightness. ...Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus says the Lord GOD; You seal up the sum, full of **wisdom**, and perfect in beauty...Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty, you have corrupted your **wisdom** by reason of your brightness: I will cast you to the ground, I will lay you before kings, that they may behold you. Eze 28: 4-5, 7, 12, 17

The king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; Children in whom was no blemish, but well favored, and skillful in all **wisdom**, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans. Daniel 1:4

As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and **wisdom**: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams...And in all matters of **wisdom** and understanding, that the king enquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm. Daniel 1:17-20

For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the **wise** men of Babylon. And the decree went forth that the **wise** men should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain. Then Daniel answered with counsel and **wisdom** to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the **wise** men of Babylon... Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his companions. That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his fellows should not perish with the rest of the **wise** men of Babylon. Daniel 2:12-14, 18



Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for **wisdom** and might are His: And He changes the times and the seasons: He removes kings, and sets up kings: He gives **wisdom** unto the **wise**, and knowledge to them that know understanding... Daniel 2:20-21

I thank You, and praise You, O God of my fathers, who has given me **wisdom** and might, and has made known unto me now what we desired of You: for You have now made known unto us the king's matter. Therefore Daniel went in unto Arioch, whom the king had ordained to destroy the **wise** men of Babylon: he went and said thus unto him; Destroy not the **wise** men of Babylon: bring me in before the king, and I will shew unto the king the interpretation. Daniel 2:23-24

Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king has demanded cannot the **wise** men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, show unto the king... As for me, this secret is not revealed to me for any **wisdom** that I have more than any living, but for their sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and you might know the thoughts of your heart...Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the **wise** men of Babylon. Daniel 2:27, 30, 48

Bring in all the **wise** men of Babylon before me, that they might make known unto me the interpretation of the dream. Daniel 4:6

This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now you, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the **wise** men of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but you are able; for the spirit of the holy gods is in you. Daniel 4:18

The king spake, and said to the **wise** men of Babylon, Whoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and have a chain of gold about his neck, and be the third ruler in the kingdom. Then came in all the king's **wise** men: but they could not read the writing, nor make known to the king the interpretation thereof. Daniel 5:7-8

There is a man in your kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of your father light and understanding and **wisdom**, like the **wisdom** of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar your father, the king, I say, your father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers...I have even heard of you, that the spirit of the gods is in you, and that light and understanding and excellent **wisdom** is found in you...Now the **wise** men, the astrologers, have been brought in before me, that they should read this writing, and make known unto me the interpretation thereof: but they could not shew the interpretation of the thing... Daniel 5:11, 14-15

They that be **wise** shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever...Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the **wise** shall understand. Daniel 12:3, 10

Who is **wise**, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the just shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein. Hosea 14:9

Shall I not in that day, says the LORD, even destroy the **wise** men out of Edom, and understanding out of the mount of Esau? Obadiah 1:8

He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to do justly and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God? The LORD'S voice cries unto the city, and the man of **wisdom** shall see your name: hear you the rod, and who has appointed it. Micah 6:8-9

The burden of the word of the LORD in the land of Hadrach, and Damascus shall be the rest thereof: when the eyes of man, as of all the tribes of Israel, shall be toward the LORD. And Hamath also shall border thereby; Tyrus, and Zidon, though it be very **wise**. And Tyrus did build herself a strong hold, and heaped up silver as the dust, and fine gold as the mire of the streets. Behold, the Lord will cast her out, and He will smite her power in the sea; and she shall be devoured with fire. Zechariah 9:1-4

## WISDOM in the NEW COVENANT

Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came **wise** men from the east to Jerusalem...Then Herod, when he had privily called the **wise** men, enquired of them diligently what time the star appeared. ...Then Herod, when he saw that he was mocked of the **wise** men, was exceeding wrathful, and sent forth, and slew all the children that were in Bethlehem, and in all the coasts thereof, from two years old and under, according to the time which he had diligently enquired of the **wise** men. Matthew 2:1, 7, 16

Therefore whoever hears these sayings of Mine, and does them, I will liken him unto a **wise** man, which built his house upon a rock...Matthew 7:24

Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be you therefore **wise** as serpents, and harmless as doves. Matthew 10:16

The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a winebibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But **wisdom** is justified of her children. Matthew 11:19

The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the **wisdom** of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here. Matthew 12:42

And when He was come into His own country, He taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said, Whence has this man this **wisdom**, and these mighty works? Matthew 13:54

Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and **wise** men, and scribes: and some of them you shall kill and crucify; and some of them shall you scourge in your synagogues, and persecute them from city to city: Matthew 23:34

Who then is a faithful and **wise** servant, whom his lord has made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season? Matthew 24:45

Five of them were **wise**, and five were foolish. They that were foolish took their lamps, and took no oil with them: but the **wise** took oil in their vessels with their lamps. While the bridegroom tarried, they all slumbered and slept. And at midnight there was a cry made, Behold, the bridegroom comes; you go out to meet him. Then all those virgins arose, and trimmed their lamps. And the foolish said unto the **wise**, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the **wise** answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but rather you go to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. Matthew 25:2-10

And when the sabbath day was come, He began to teach in the synagogue: and many hearing Him were astonished, saying, From whence has this man these things? And what **wisdom** is this which is given unto Him, that even such mighty works are wrought by His hands? Mark 6:2

He shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the **wisdom** of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17

And the child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with **wisdom**: and the grace of God was upon Him...And Jesus increased in **wisdom** and stature, and in favor with God and man. Luke 2:40, 52

But **wisdom** is justified of all her children. Luke 7:35

In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank you, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that you have hid these things from the **wise** and prudent, and have revealed them unto babes; even so, Father, for so it seemed good in Your sight. Luke 10:21

The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to heard the **wisdom** of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here. Luke 11:31

Therefore also said the **wisdom** of God, I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they shall slay and persecute...Luke 11:49

The Lord said, Who then is that faithful and **wise** steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? Luke 12:42

For I will give you a mouth and **wisdom**, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:15

Wherefore, brethren, look you out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and **wisdom**, whom we may appoint over this business. Acts 6:3

And they were not able to resist the **wisdom** and the spirit by which he spoke. Acts 6:10

And delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him favor and **wisdom** in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. Acts 7:10

And Moses was learned in all the **wisdom** of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and in deeds. Acts 7:22

I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the **wise**, and to the unwise. Romans 1:14

...Because that, when they knew God, they glorified him not as God, neither were thankful; but became vain in their imaginations, and their foolish heart was darkened. Professing themselves to be **wise**, they became fools, and changed the glory of the uncorruptible God into an image made like to corruptible man, and to birds, and fourfooted beasts, and creeping things. Romans 1:21-23

For I would not, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be **wise** in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in...O the depth of the riches both of the **wisdom** and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are His judgments, and His ways past finding out! Romans 11:25, 33

Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not **wise** in your own conceits. Romans 12:16

I would have you **wise** unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil...To God only **wise**, be glory through Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] for ever. Amen. Romans 16:19, 27

For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with **wisdom** of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect...For it is written, I will destroy the **wisdom** of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent. Where is the **wise**? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Has not God made foolish the **wisdom** of this world? For after that in the **wisdom** of God the world by **wisdom** knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. For the Jews require a sign, and the Greeks seek after **wisdom**. But we preach Christ crucified, unto the Jews a stumblingblock, and unto the Greeks foolishness; But unto them which are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God, and the **wisdom** of God. Because the foolishness of God is **wiser** than men; and the weakness of God is stronger than men. For you see your calling, brethren, how that not many **wise** men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many noble are called: but God has chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the **wise**; and God has chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty...But of Him are you in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us **wisdom**, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption. 1 Cor 1:17-30

When I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of **wisdom**, declaring unto you the testimony of God...And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's **wisdom**, but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power. That your faith should not stand in the **wisdom** of men, but in the power of God. Howbeit we speak **wisdom** among them that are perfect: yet not the **wisdom** of this world, nor of the princes of this world, that come to nought: But we speak the **wisdom** of God in a mystery, even the hidden **wisdom**, which God ordained before the world unto our glory...Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's **wisdom** teaches, but which the Holy Ghost teaches; comparing spiritual things with spiritual...For the **wisdom** of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He takes the **wise** in their own craftiness. 1 Cor 2:1, 4-7, 13, 19

According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a **wise** masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another builds thereon. But let every man take heed how he builds thereupon. 1 Corinthians 3:10

Let no man deceive himself. If any man among you seems to be **wise** in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be **wise**. For the **wisdom** of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, He takes the **wise** in their own craftiness. And again, the Lord knows the thoughts of the **wise**, that they are vain. 1 Corinthians 3:18-20

We are fools for Christ's sake, but you are **wise** in Christ; we are weak, but you are strong; you are honorable, but we are despised. 1 Corinthians 4:10

I speak to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a **wise** man among you? No, not one that shall be able to judge between his brethren? 1 Corinthians 6:5

I speak as to **wise** men; judge you what I say. 1 Corinthians 10:15

For to one is given by the Spirit the word of **wisdom**; to another the word of knowledge by the same Spirit... 1 Corinthians 12:8

For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly **wisdom**, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward. 2 Corinthians 1:12

For we dare not make ourselves of the number, or compare ourselves with some that commend themselves: but they measuring themselves by themselves, and comparing themselves among themselves, are not **wise**. 2 Corinthians 10:12

Wherein He has abounded toward us in all **wisdom** and prudence... That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of **wisdom** and revelation in the knowledge of Him... Ephesians 1:8, 17

To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold **wisdom** of God... Ephesians 3:10



See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as **wise**...  
Ephesians 5:15

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all **wisdom** and spiritual understanding... Colossians 1:9

Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all **wisdom**; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]...That our hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; In whom are hid all the treasures of **wisdom** and knowledge. Colossians 1:28, 2:3

Which things have indeed a show of **wisdom** in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honor to the satisfying of the flesh. Colossians 2:23

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all **wisdom**; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. Col 3:16

Walk in **wisdom** toward them that are without, redeeming the time. Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer every man. Colossians 4:5-6

Now unto the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only **wise** God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen. 1 Tim 1:17

From a child you have known the holy scriptures, which are able to make you **wise** unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works. 2 Timothy 3:15-17

If any of you lack **wisdom**, let him ask of God, that gives to all men liberally, and upbraids not; and it shall be given him. But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavers is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. James 1:5-6

Who is a **wise** man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with meekness of **wisdom**. But if you have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. This **wisdom** descends not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish. For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work. But the **wisdom** that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. James 3:13-17

Be diligent that you may be found of Him in peace, without spot, and blameless. .And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the **wisdom** given unto him has written unto you... 2 Peter 3:14-15

To the only **wise** God our Savior, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen. Jude 1:25

I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders... Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and **wisdom**, and strength, and honor, and glory and blessing. Rev 5:11-12

And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshiped God, Saying, Amen: blessing, and glory, and **wisdom**, and thanksgiving, and honor, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Rev 7:11-12

Here is **wisdom**, Let him that has understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore and six. Revelation 13:18

Here is the mind which has **wisdom**. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sits. And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he comes, he must continue a short space. And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition. And the ten horns which you saw are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as kings one hour with the beast. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength unto the beast. Revelation 17:9-13

## UNDERSTANDING

Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not **understand** one another's speech. Genesis 11:7

And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and there is none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of you, that you can **understand** a dream to interpret it. Genesis 41:15

And they knew not that Joseph **understood** them; for he spoke unto them by an interpreter. Genesis 42:23

And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in **understanding**, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship...And he has filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in **understanding**, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship...Then wrought Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and **understanding** to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded. Exodus 31:3, 35:31, 36:1

But if the LORD make a new thing, and the earth open her mouth, and swallow them up, with all that appertain unto them, and they go down quick into the pit; then you shall **understand** that these men have provoked the LORD. Numbers 16:30

Take you wise men, and **understanding**, and known among your tribes, and I will make them rulers over you. And you answered me, and said, The thing which you have spoken is good for us to do. Deuteronomy 1:13-14

Keep therefore and do them; for this is your wisdom and your **understanding** in the sight of the nations, which shall hear all these statutes, and say, Surely this great nation is a wise and **understanding** people. Deuteronomy 4:6

**Understand** therefore this day, that the LORD your God is He which goes over before you; as a consuming fire He shall destroy them, and He shall bring them down before your face...**Understand** therefore, that the LORD your God gives you not this good land to possess it for your righteousness; for you are a stiffnecked people. Deuteronomy 9:3, 6

The LORD shall bring a nation against you from far, from the end of the earth, as swift as the eagle flies; a nation whose tongue you shall not **understand**... Deuteronomy 28:49

For they are a nation void of counsel, neither is there any **understanding** in them. O that they were wise, that they **understood** this, that they would consider their latter end! Deuteronomy 32:28-29

And when the Philistines heard the noise of the shout, they said, What does the noise of this great shout mean in the camp of the Hebrews? And they **understood** that the ark of the LORD was come into the camp. 1 Samuel 4:6

Now the name of the man was Nabal; and the name of his wise Abigail: and she was a woman of good **understanding**, and of a beautiful countenance: but the man was churlish and evil in his doings; and he was of the house of Caleb. 1 Samuel 25:3

David therefore sent out spies, and **understood** that Saul was come in very deed. 1 Samuel 26:4

For all the people and all Israel **understood** that day that it was not of the king to slay Abner the son of Ner. 2 Samuel 3:37

Give therefore Your servant an **understanding** heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge so great a people? And the speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing. And God said unto him, Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked for yourself long life; neither have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies; but have asked for yourself **understanding** to discern judgment; behold I have done according to your words: lo, I have given you a wise and an **understanding** heart...And God gave Solomon wisdom and **understanding** exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. 1 Kings 3:9-12, 4:29

He was a widow's son of the tribe of Naphtali, and his father was a man of Tyre, a worker in brass: and he was filled with wisdom, and **understanding**, and cunning to work all works in brass. And he came to king Solomon... 1 Kings 7:14

Then said Eliakim... unto Rab-shakeh, Speak, I pray you, to your servants in the Syrian language; for we **understand** it: and talk not with us in the Jews' language in the ears of the people that are on the wall. 2 Kings 18:26

...And of the children of Issachar, which were men that had **understanding** of the times, to know what Israel ought to do... 1 Chronicles 12:32

Only the LORD give you wisdom and **understanding**, and give you charge concerning Israel, that you may keep the law of the LORD your God. 1 Chronicles 22:12

And you, Solomon my son, know you the God of your father, and serve him with a perfect heart and with a willing mind: for the LORD searches all hearts, and **understands** all the imaginations of the thoughts; if you seek Him, He will be found of you; but if you forsake Him, He will cast you off for ever. 1 Chronicles 28:9

All this, said David, the LORD made me **understand** in writing by His hand upon me, even all the works of this pattern. 1 Chronicles 28:19

Huram said, moreover, Blessed be the LORD God of Israel, that made heaven and earth, who has given to David the king a wise son, endued with prudence and understanding, that might build an house for the LORD, and an house for his kingdom. And now I have sent a cunning man, endued with **understanding**...skilful to work in gold, and in silver, in brass, in iron, in stone, and in timber, in purple, in blue, and in fine linen, and in crimson... 2 Chronicles 2:12-14

He sought God in the days of Zechariah, who had **understanding** in the visions of God: and as long as he sought the LORD, God made him to prosper. 2 Chronicles 26:5 (written about Uzziah)

Then sent I for Eliezer, for Ariel, for Shemaiah... men of **understanding**...that they should bring unto us ministers for the house of our God. And by the good hand of our God upon us they brought us a man of **understanding**, of the sons of Mahli, the son of Levi, the son of Israel; and Sherebiah, with his sons and his brethren, eighteen...Ezra 8:16-18

And Ezra the priest brought the law before the congregation both of men and women, and all that could hear with **understanding**, upon the first day of the seventh month. And he read therein before the street that was before the water gate from the morning until midday, before the men and the women, and those that could **understand**; and the ears of all the people were attentive unto the book of the law...and the Levites, caused the people to **understand** the law: and the people stood in their place. So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to **understand** the reading...And all the people went their way to eat, and to drink, and to send portions, and to make great mirth, because they had **understood** the words that were declared unto them...And on the second day were gathered together the chief of the fathers of all the people, the priests, and the Levites, unto Ezra the scribe, even to **understand** the words of the law. Nehemiah 8:2-3, 7-8, 12-13

And the rest of the people, the priests, the Levites, the porters, the singers, the Nethinims, and all they that had separated themselves from the people of the lands unto the law of God, their wives, their sons, and their daughters, every one having knowledge, and having **understanding**... Nehemiah 10:28

And I came to Jerusalem, and **understood** of the evil that Eliashib did for Tobiah, in preparing him a chamber in the courts of the house of God. Nehemiah 13:7

Teach me, and I will hold my tongue: and cause me to **understand** wherein I have erred. Job 6:24

With the ancient is wisdom; and in length of days **understanding**. With Him is wisdom and strength, He has counsel and **understanding**. ...He removes away the speech of the trusty, and takes away the **understanding** of the aged. Job 12:12-13, 20

Lo, my eye has seen all this, my ear has heard and **understood** it. ....What do you know, that we know not? What do you **understand**, which is not in us? Job 13:1, 15:9

For you have hid their heart from **understanding**: therefore shall you not exalt them. Job 17:4



I have heard the check of my reproach, and the spirit of my **understanding** causes me to answer. Job 20:3

I would know the words which He would answer me, and **understand** what He would say unto me. Job 23:5

He divides the sea with His power, and by His **understanding** He smites through the proud...Lo, these are parts of His ways: but how little a portion is heard of Him? But the thunder of His power who can **understand**? Job 26:12-14

But where shall wisdom be found? And where is the place of **understanding**?...Whence then comes wisdom? And where is the place of **understanding**? God **understands** the way thereof, and He knows the place thereof. Job 28:12, 20, 23

And unto man he said, Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom; and to depart from evil is **understanding**. Job 28:28

But there is a spirit in man: and the inspiration of the Almighty gives them **understanding**. Great men are not always wise: neither do the aged **understand** judgment. Job 32:8-9

Therefore hearken unto me, you men of **understanding**: far be it from God, that He should do wickedness; and from the Almighty, that He should commit iniquity...If now you have **understanding**, hear this: hearken to the voice of my words... Let men of **understanding** tell me, and let a wise man hearken unto me. Job 34:10, 16, 34

Can any **understand** the spreadings of the clouds, or the noise of His tabernacle?...Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Declare, if you have **understanding**...Who has put wisdom in the inward parts? Or who has given **understanding** to the heart? ...Gave you ...feathers unto the ostrich? Which leaves her eggs...her labor is in vain without fear; Because God has deprived her of wisdom, neither has He imparted to her **understanding**. Job 36:29, 38:4, 36, 39:13, 16-17

Who is he that hides counsel without knowledge? Therefore have I uttered that I **understood** not; things too wonderful for me, which I knew not. Job 42:3

The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did **understand**, and seek God... God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did **understand**, that did seek God. Psalm 14:2, 53:2

Who can **understand** his errors? Cleanse Thou me from secret faults. Psalm 19:12

Be not as the horse, or as the mule, which have no **understanding**: whose mouth must be held in with bit and bridle, lest they come near unto you. Psalm 32:9

For God is the King of all the earth: sing praises with **understanding**. Psalm 47:7

My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart shall be of **understanding**. Psalm 49:3

Man that is in honor, and **understands** not, is like the beasts that perish. Psalm 49:20

For I was envious at the foolish, when I saw the prosperity of the wicked...Until I went into the sanctuary of God; then **understood** I their end. Surely you did set them in slippery places; you cast them down into destruction. Psalm 73:3, 17-18

This he ordained in Joseph for a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt: where I heard a language that I **understood** not. Psalm 81:5

They know not, neither will they **understand**; they walk on in darkness: all the foundations of the earth are out of course. Psalm 82:5

O LORD, how great are Your works! And Your thoughts are very deep. A brutish man knows not; neither does a fool **understand** this...**Understand**, you brutish among the people: and you fools, when will you be wise? Psalm 92:6, 94:8

Our fathers **understood** not your wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of Your mercies; but provoked Him at the sea, even at the Red sea. Psalm 106:7



Yet sets He the poor on high from affliction, and makes him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall **understand** the lovingkindness of the LORD. Psalm 107:41-43

The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: a good **understanding** have all they that do His commandments: His praise endures for ever. Psalm 111:10

Make me to **understand** the way of Your precepts: so shall I talk of Your wondrous works. Psalm 119:27

Your hands have made me and fashioned me: give me **understanding**, that I may learn Your commandments. Psalm 119:73

I have more **understanding** than all my teachers: for Your testimonies are my meditation. I **understand** more than the ancients, because I keep Your precepts...The righteousness of Your testimonies is everlasting: give me **understanding**, and I shall live. Psalm 119:99-100, 144

You know my downsitting and my uprising, you **understand** my thought afar off. Psalm 139:2

Great is our Lord, and of great power: His **understanding** is infinite. Psalm 147:5

The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel; To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of **understanding**; To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity; To give subtilty to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. Proverbs 1:1-4

A wise man will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of **understanding** shall attain unto wise counsels: To **understand** a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings. Proverbs 1:5-6

My son, if you will receive my words, and hide my commandments with you; So that you incline your ear unto wisdom, and apply thine heart to **understanding**; Yes, if you cry after knowledge, and lift up your voice for **understanding**; If you seek her as silver, and search for her as for hid treasures; Then shall you **understand** the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. For the LORD gives wisdom: out of His mouth comes knowledge and **understanding**... He keeps the paths of judgment, and equity; yes, every good path. Then shall you **understand** righteousness, and judgment, and equity; yes, every good path... When wisdom enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto your soul; Discretion shall preserve you, **understanding** shall keep you: Proverbs 2:1-6, 9-11

Let not mercy and truth forsake you: bind them about your neck; write them upon the table of your heart: So shall you find favor and good **understanding** in the sight of God and man. Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own **understanding**. Proverbs 3:3-5

Happy is the man that finds wisdom, and the man that gets **understanding**. Proverbs 3:13

The LORD by wisdom has founded the earth; by **understanding** has He established the heavens. Proverbs 3:19

Hear, you children, the instruction of a father, and attend to know **understanding**... Get wisdom, get **understanding**: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth... Forsake her not, and she shall preserve you: love her, and she shall keep you. Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all your getting get **understanding**. Proverbs 4:1, 5-7

My son, attend unto my wisdom, and bow your ear to my **understanding**: That you may regard discretion, and that your lips may keep knowledge. Proverbs 5:1-2

They are all plain to him that **understands**, and right to them that find knowledge. Proverbs 8:5, 8-9 (Wisdom speaking)

Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am **understanding**; I have strength. Proverbs 8:14

Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: as for him that wants **understanding**, she says to him, Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled. Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of **understanding**. Proverbs 9:4-6

Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a just man, and he will increase in learning. The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is **understanding**. For by me your days shall be multiplied, and the years of your life shall be increased...A foolish woman is clamorous: she is simple, and knows nothing. For she sits at the door of her house, on a seat in the high places of the city, To call passengers who go right on their ways: Whoso is simple, let him turn in hither: and as for him that wants **understanding**, she says to him, Stolen waters are sweet, and bread eaten in secret is pleasant. But he knows not that the dead are there; and that her guests are in the depths of hell. Proverbs 9:9-11, 13-18

Good **understanding** gives favor: but the way of transgressors is hard. Proverbs 13:15

A scorner seeks wisdom, and finds it not: but knowledge is easy unto him that **understands**. Proverbs 14:6

The wisdom of the prudent is to **understand** his way: but the folly of fools is deceit. Proverbs 14:8

He that is slow to wrath is of great **understanding**: but he that is hasty of spirit exalts folly. Proverbs 14:29

Wisdom rests in the heart of him that has **understanding**: but that which is in the midst of fools is made known. Pro 14:33

The heart of him that has **understanding** seeks knowledge: but the mouth of fools feeds on foolishness. Proverbs 15:14

**Understanding** is a wellspring of life unto him that has it: but the instruction of fools is folly. Proverbs 16:22

A man void of **understanding** strikes hands, and becomes surety in the presence of his friend. Proverbs 17:18

Wisdom is before him that has **understanding**; but the eyes of a fool are in the ends of the earth. Proverbs 17:24

He that has knowledge spares his words: and a man of **understanding** is of an excellent spirit. Even a fool, when he holds his peace, is counted wise: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of **understanding**. Proverbs 17:27-28

A fool has no delight in **understanding**, but that his heart may discover itself. Proverbs 18:2

He that gets wisdom loves his own soul: he that keeps **understanding** shall find good. Proverbs 19:8

Smite a scorner, and the simple will beware: and reprove one that has **understanding**, and he will **understand** knowledge. Proverbs 19:25

Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of **understanding** will draw it out. Proverbs 20:5

Man's goings are of the LORD; how can a man then **understand** his own way? Proverbs 20:24

The man that wanders out of the way of **understanding** shall remain in the congregation of the dead... There is no wisdom nor **understanding** nor counsel against the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Proverbs 21:16, 30

Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and **understanding**. Proverbs 23:23

Through wisdom is an house built; and by **understanding** it is established... Proverbs 24:3

I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of **understanding**; And, lo, it was all grown over with thorns, and nettles had covered the face thereof, and the stone wall thereof was broken down. Proverbs 24:30-31

For the transgression of a land many are the princes thereof: but by a man of **understanding**, and knowledge the state thereof shall be prolonged... Evil men **understand** not judgment: but they that seek the LORD **understand** all things. Proverbs 28:2, 5

The rich man is wise in his own conceit; but the poor that has **understanding** searches him out...The prince that wants **understanding**, is also a great oppressor: but he that hates covetousness shall prolong his days. Proverbs 28:11,16

A servant will not be corrected by words: for though he **understand** he will not answer. Proverbs 29:19

Surely I am more brutish than any man, and have not the **understanding** of a man. I neither learned wisdom, nor have the knowledge of the holy. Proverbs 30:2-3

I...saw...that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of **understanding**, nor yet favor to men of skill; but time and chance happens to them all. For man also know not his time: as the fishes that are taken in an evil net, and as the birds that are caught in the snare; so are the sons of men snared in an evil time, when it falls suddenly upon them. Ecclesiastes 9:11-12

Go, and tell this people, Hear you indeed, but **understand** not; and see you indeed, but perceive not. Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and **understand** with their heart, and convert, and be healed. Isaiah 6:9-10

The spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and **understanding**, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; and shall make Him of quick **understanding** in the fear of the LORD: and He shall not judge after the sight of His eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears... Isaiah 11:2-3

For it is a people of no **understanding**: therefore He that made them will not have mercy on them, and He that formed them will show them no favor. Isaiah 27:11

Whom shall He teach knowledge? And whom shall He make to **understand** doctrine? Them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts. Isaiah 28:9

Therefore, behold, I will proceed to do a marvelous work among this people, even a marvelous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise men shall perish, and the **understanding** of their prudent men shall be hid... Surely your turning of things upside down shall be esteemed as the potter's clay: for shall the work say of him that made it, He made me not? Or shall the thing framed say of him that framed it, he had no **understanding**? Isaiah 29:14, 16

From the time that it goes forth it shall take you: for morning by morning shall it pass over, by day and by night; and it shall be a vexation only to **understand** the report. Isaiah 28:19

When he sees his children, the work of My hands, in the midst of him, they shall sanctify My name, and sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and shall fear the God of Israel. They also that erred in spirit shall come to **understanding**, and they that murmured shall learn doctrine... Isaiah 29:23-24

The heart of the rash shall **understand** knowledge, and the tongue of the stammerers shall be ready to speak plainly. Isaiah 32:4

You shall not see a fierce people, a people of a deeper speech than you can perceive; of a stammering tongue, that you can not **understand**. Isaiah 33:19

Then said Eliakim and Shebna and Joah unto Rabshakeh, Speak, I pray you, unto your servants in the Syrian language; for we **understand** it: and speak not to us in the Jews' language, in the ears of the people that are on the wall. Isaiah 36:11

With whom took He counsel, and who instructed Him, and taught Him in the path of judgment, and taught Him knowledge, and showed to Him the way of **understanding**? Behold, the nations are as a drop of a bucket, and are counted as the small dust of the balance: behold, He takes up the isles as a very little thing. ...Have you not known? Have you not heard? Has it not been told you from the beginning? Have you not **understood** from the foundations of the earth?...Have you not known? Have you not heard, that the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, faints not, neither is weary? There is no searching of His **understanding**. Isaiah 40:14-15-28



That they may see, and know, and consider, and **understand** together, that the hand of the LORD has done this, and the Holy One of Israel has created it. Isaiah 41:20

You are My witnesses, says the LORD, and My servant whom I have chosen: that you may know and believe Me, and **understand** that I am He: before Me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after Me. I, even I, am the LORD; and beside Me there is no savior. Isaiah 43:10-11

They have not known nor **understood**: for He has shut their eyes, that they cannot see; and their hearts, that they cannot **understand**. And none considers in his heart, neither is there knowledge nor **understanding** to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yes, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten it: and shall I make the residue thereof an abomination: shall I fall down to the stock of a tree? Isaiah 44:18-19

Yes, they are greedy dogs which can never have enough, and they are shepherds that cannot **understand**: they all look to their own way, every one for his gain, from his quarter. Isaiah 56:11

And I will give you pastors according to My heart, which shall feed you with knowledge and **understanding**. Jeremiah 3:15

My bowels, my bowels! I am pained at my very heart; my heart makes a noise in me; I cannot hold my peace, because you have heard, O my soul, the sound of the trumpet, the alarm of war. Destruction upon destruction is cried; for the whole land is spoiled: suddenly are my tents spoiled, and my curtains in a moment...For My people are foolish, they have not known Me; they are sottish children, and they have no **understanding**: they are wise to do evil, but to do good they have no knowledge. Jeremiah 4:19-20, 22

Lo, I will bring a nation upon you from far, O house of Israel... a nation whose language you know not, neither **understand** what they say...Hear now this, O foolish people, and without **understanding**; which have eyes, and see not; which have ears, and hear not: Fear you not Me? Says the LORD: will you not tremble at My presence...? Jeremiah 5:15, 21



Who is the wise man, that may **understand** this? And who is he to whom the mouth of the LORD has spoken, that he may declare it, for what the land perishes and is burned up like a wilderness, that none passes through? And the LORD said, Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, neither walked therein... Jeremiah 9:12-13

Thus says the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glories glory in this, that he **understands** and knows Me, that I am the LORD which exercise loving kindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, says the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23-24

He has made the earth by His power, He has established the world by His wisdom, and has stretched out the heaven by His **understanding**. Jeremiah 51:15

For you are not sent to a people of a strange speech and of an hard language, but to the house of Israel; Not to many people of a strange speech and of an hard language, whose words you can not **understand**. Surely, had I sent you to them, they would have hearkened unto you. Ezekiel 3:5-6

With your wisdom and with your **understanding** you have gotten your riches, and have gotten gold and silver into your treasures: By your great wisdom and by your traffic have you increased your riches, and your heart is lifted up because of your riches: Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; because you have set your heart as the heart of God; Behold, therefore I will bring strangers upon you, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of your wisdom, and they shall defile your brightness. Ezekiel 28:4-7

The king spake that...he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; Children in whom was no blemish, but well favored, and skillful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and **understanding** science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans. Daniel 1:3-4

As for these for four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had **understanding** in all visions and dreams. Daniel 1:17

And in all matters of wisdom and **understanding**, that the king inquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians and astrologers that were in all his realm. Daniel 1:20

...The secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven. Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever; for wisdom and might are His: And He changes the times and the seasons: He removes kings, and sets up kings: He gives wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know **understanding**... Daniel 2:19-21

At the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up my eyes unto heaven, and my **understanding** returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honored Him that lives for ever, whose dominion is an everlasting dominion, and His Kingdom is from generation to generation: Daniel 4:34

There is a man in your kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of your father light and **understanding** and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar your father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers; Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and **understanding**, interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel...let Daniel be called, and he will shew the interpretation. Daniel 5:11-12

I have even heard of you, that the spirit of the gods is in you, and that light and **understanding** and excellent wisdom is found in you... Because an excellent spirit was in him...the king thought to set him over the whole realm. Daniel 5:14, 6:3

I heard a man's voice between the banks of Ulai, which called, and said, Gabriel, make this man to **understand** the vision. So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, **Understand**, O son of man: for at the time of the end shall be the vision. Daniel 8:16-17

And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and **understanding** dark sentences, shall stand up. And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and holy people...and he shall magnify himself in his heart...The vision of the evening and the morning which was told is true: wherefore you shut up the vision: for it shall be for many days. And I Daniel fainted, and was sick certain days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none **understood** it. Daniel 8:23-27

I Daniel **understood** by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem. And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: and I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God... As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and **understand** Your truth...And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now come forth to give you skill and **understanding**...Know therefore and **understand**, that from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince shall be seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times. Daniel 9:2-4, 13, 22, 25

In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing was true, but the time appointed was long: and he **understood** the thing, and had **understanding** of the vision. Daniel 10:1

He said unto me, O Daniel, a man greatly beloved, **understand** the words that I speak unto you, and stand upright: for unto you am I now sent. And when he had spoken this word unto me, I stood trembling. Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that you did set your heart to **understand**, and to chasten yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I am come for your words... Daniel 10:11-12

Now I am come to make you **understand** what shall befall your people in the latter days: for yet the vision is for many days. Daniel 10:14

And they that **understand** among the people shall instruct many: yet they shall fall by the sword, and by flame, by captivity, and by spoil, many days. Now when they shall fall, they shall be helped with a little help: but many shall cleave to them with flatteries. And some of them of **understanding** shall fall, to try them, and to purge, and to make them white, even to the time of the end: because it is yet for a time appointed. Daniel 11:33-35

And I heard, but I **understood** not: then said I, O my Lord, what shall be the end of these things? And he said, Go your way, Daniel: for the words are closed up and sealed till the time of the end. Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall **understand**; but the wise shall **understand**. Daniel 12:8-10

My people ask counsel at their stocks, and their staff declares unto them: for the spirit of whoredoms has caused them to err, and they have gone a whoring from under their God...I will not punish your daughters when they commit whoredom, nor your spouses when they commit adultery; for themselves are separated with whores, and they sacrifice with harlots: therefore the people that does not **understand** shall fall. Hosea 4:12, 14

Now they sin more and more, and have made them molten images of their silver, and idols according to their own **understanding**, all of it the work of the craftsmen: they say of them, Let the men that sacrifice kiss the calves. Hosea 13:2

I will heal their backsliding, I will love them freely: for Mine anger is turned away from him. I will be as the dew unto Israel: he shall grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon. His branches shall spread, and his beauty shall be as the olive tree, and his smell as Lebanon. They that dwell under his shadow shall return; they shall revive as the corn, and grow as the vine... Who is wise, and he shall **understand** these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the just shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein. Hosea 14:4-7, 9

All the men of your confederacy have brought you even to the border: the men that were at peace with you have deceived you, and prevailed against you; they that eat your bread have laid a wound under you: there is none **understanding** in him. Shall I not in that day, says the LORD, even destroy the wise men out of Edom, and **understanding** out of the mount of Esau? Obadiah 1:7-8

Now also many nations are gathered against you, that say, Let her be defiled, and let our eye look upon Zion. But they know not the thoughts of the LORD, neither **understand** they His counsel: for He shall gather them as the sheaves into the floor. Arise and thresh, O daughter of Zion: for I will make your horn iron, and I will make your hoofs brass: and you shalt beat in pieces many people: and I will consecrate their gain unto the LORD, and their substance unto the Lord of the whole earth. Micah 4:11-13

## UNDERSTANDING in the NEW COVENANT

Seeing see not; and hearing they hear not, neither do they **understand**. And in them is fulfilled the prophecy of Esaias, which says, By hearing you shall hear, and shall not **understand**; and seeing you shall see, and shall not perceive. For this people's heart is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and should **understand** with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. But blessed are your eyes, for they see: and your ears, for they hear. ...When any one hears the word of the Kingdom, and **understands** it not, then comes the wicked one, and catches away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side...But he that received seed into the good ground is he that hears the word, and **understands** it; which also bears fruit, and brings forth, some an hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. Matthew 13:13-16, 19, 23

Again, the Kingdom of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind: Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away. So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the just, and shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Jesus [Yeshua] said unto them, Have you **understood** all these things? They say unto him, Yes, Lord. Then said He unto them, Therefore every scribe which is instructed unto the Kingdom of heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which brings forth out of his treasure things new and old. Matthew 13:47-52

Hear, and **understand**: Not that which goes into the mouth defiles a man; but that which comes out of the mouth, this defiles a man...Jesus said, Are you also yet without **understanding**? Do not you yet **understand**, that whatever enters in at the mouth goes into the belly, and is cast out into the draught? But those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the heart; and they defile the man. Matthew 15:10-11, 16-18

How is it that you do not **understand** that I spake it not to you concerning bread, that you should beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees? Then **understood** they how that he bade them not beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and of the Sadducees. Matt 16:11-12

Elias truly shall first come, and restore all things. But I say unto you, That Elias is come already, and they knew him not, but have done unto him whatsoever they listed. Likewise shall also the Son of man suffer of them. Then the disciples **understood** that He spake unto them of John the Baptist. Matthew 17:11-13

When you therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso reads, let him **understand**;) Matthew 24:15

There came unto Him a woman having an alabaster box of very precious ointment, and poured it on His head, as He sat at meat. But when His disciples saw it, they had indignation...This ointment might have been sold for much...When Jesus **understood** it, He said unto them, Why trouble you the woman? For she has wrought a good work upon Me. Matthew 26:7-10

Unto you it is given to know the mystery of the Kingdom of God; but unto them that are without, all these things are done in parables: That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not **understand**; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be forgiven them. Mark 4:12

Hearken unto Me every one of you, and **understand**: There is nothing from without a man, that entering into him can defile him: but the things which come out of him, those are they that defile the man...Are you so without **understanding** also? Do you not perceive, that whatever thing from without enter into the man, it cannot defile him; Because it enters not into his heart, but into the belly, and goes out into the draught, purging all meats? For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within and defile the man. Mark 7:14-23



He charged them, saying, Take heed, beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, and of the leaven of Herod. And they reasoned among themselves, saying, It is because we have no bread. And when Jesus knew it, He said unto them, Why reason you, because you have no bread? Perceive you not yet, neither **understand**? Have you your heart yet hardened? Mark 8:15-17

When I brake the five loaves among five thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took you up? They say unto Him, Twelve. And when the seven among four thousand, how many baskets full of fragments took you up? And they said, Seven. And He said unto them, How is it that you do not **understand**? Mark 8:19-21

He taught His disciples, and said unto them, The Son of man is delivered into the hands of men, and they shall kill Him; and after that He is killed, He shall rise the third day. But they **understood** not that saying, and were afraid to ask Him. Mark 9:31-32

And the scribe said unto Him, Well, Master, You have said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but He: And to love Him with all the heart, and with all the **understanding**, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love his neighbor as himself, is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. And when Jesus saw that he answered discreetly, He said unto him, You are not far from the Kingdom of God. And no man after that dared ask Him any questions. Mark 12:32-34

When you shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing where it ought not, (let him that reads **understand**,) then let them that be in Judaea flee to the mountains: And let him that is on the housetop not go down into the house, neither enter therein, to take anything out of his house: And let him that is in the field not turn back again for to take up his garment. Mark 13:14-16

When she saw Peter warming himself, she looked upon him, and said, And you also were with Jesus of Nazareth. But he denied, saying, I know not, neither **understand** I what you say. And he went out into the porch; and the cock crew. Mk 14:67-68

It seemed good to me also, having had perfect **understanding** of all things from the very first, to write unto you most excellent Theophilus, that you might know the certainty of those things, wherein you have been instructed. Luke 1:3-4

After three days they found him in the temple, sitting in the midst of the doctors, both hearing them, and asking them questions. And all that heard Him were astonished at His **understanding** and answers. And when they saw Him, they were amazed: and His mother said unto Him, Son, why have you thus dealt with us? Behold, your father and I have sought you sorrowing. And He said unto them, How is it that you sought Me? Didn't you know that I must be about My Father's business? And they **understood** not the saying which He spoke unto them. Luke 2:46-50

And He said, Unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the Kingdom of God; but to others in parables; that seeing they might not see, and hearing they might not **understand**. Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God... Luke 8:10-11

But while they wondered every one at all things which Jesus did, He said unto His disciples, Let these sayings sink down into your ears: for the Son of man shall be delivered into the hands of men. But they **understood** not this saying, and it was hid from them, that they perceived it not: and they feared to ask Him of that saying. Luke 9:43-45

Behold, we go up to Jerusalem, and all things that are written by the prophets concerning the Son of man shall be accomplished. For He shall be delivered unto the Gentiles, and shall be mocked, and spitefully entreated, and spitted on: And they shall scourge Him, and put Him to death: and the third day He shall rise again. And they **understood** none of these things: and this saying was hid from them, neither knew they the things which were spoken. Luke 18:31-34

These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning Me. Then opened He their **understanding**, that they might **understand** the scriptures... Luke 24:44-45

They **understood** not that He spake to them of the Father. Then said Jesus [Yeshua] unto them, When you have lifted up the Son of man, then shall you know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father has taught Me, I speak these things...If God were your Father, you would love Me: for I proceed forth and came from God; neither came I of Myself, but He sent me. Why do you not **understand** My speech? Even because you cannot hear My word. You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. And because I tell you the truth, you believe Me not. John 8:27-28, 42-45

This parable spake Jesus unto them: but they **understood** not what things they were which He spake unto them. Then said Jesus unto them again, Truly, truly, I say unto you, I am the door of the sheep. All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them. I am the door: by Me if any man enter in, he shall be saved, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. The thief comes not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd gives his life for the sheep. But he that is an hireling, and not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, sees the wolf coming, and leaves the sheep, and flees: and the wolf catches them, and scatters the sheep. John 10:6-12

Blessed is the King of Israel that comes in the name of the Lord. And Jesus [Yeshua], when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written, Fear not, daughter of Zion: behold, your King comes, sitting on an ass's colt. These things **understood** not His disciples at the first: but when Jesus [Yeshua] was glorified, then remembered they that these things were written of Him, and that they had done these things unto Him. John 12:13-16

...They could not believe, because that Esaias said again, He has blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor **understand** with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. John 12:39-40

Seeing one of them suffer wrong, he defended him, and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian. For he supposed his brethren would have **understood** how that God by his hand would deliver them: but they **understood** not. Acts 7:24-25

Philip ran thither to him, and heard him read the prophet Esaias, and said, Do you **understand** what you are reading? And he said, How can I, except some man should guide me? And he desired Philip that he would come up and sit with him...Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture, and preached unto him Jesus [Yeshua]. Acts 8:30-31, 35

And he wrote a letter after this manner...This man was taken of the Jews, and should have been killed of them: then came I with an army, and rescued him, having **understood** that he was a Roman...When the governor had read the letter, he asked of what province he was. And when he **understood** that he was of Cilicia; I will hear you, said he, when your accusers are also come. Acts 23:25, 27, 34-35a

Because that you may **understand**, that there are yet but twelve days since I went up to Jerusalem for to worship. And they neither found me in the temple disputing with any man, neither raising up the people, neither in the synagogues, nor in the city. Acts 24:11-12

Saying, Go unto this people, and say, Hearing you shall hear, and not **understand**; and seeing you shall see, and not perceive. For the heart of this people is waxed gross, and their ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes have they closed; lest they should see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and **understand** with their heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them. Acts 28:26-27 (waxed gross - calloused)

For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being **understood** by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse. Romans 1:20

Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents, without **understanding**, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:29-32

There is none that **understands**, there is none that seeks after God. Romans 3:11

But as it is written, To whom He was not spoken of, they shall see: and they that have not heard shall **understand**. Romans 15:21

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God. For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the **understanding** of the prudent. 1 Corinthians 1:18-19

Wherefore I give you to **understand**, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God called Jesus [Yeshua] accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord [Yeshua is the Messiah], but by the Holy Ghost. 1 Corinthians 12:3-6

Though I have the gift of prophecy, and **understand** all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing... When I was a child, I spake as a child, I **understood** as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known. 1 Corinthians 13:2, 11-12

For if the trumpet give an uncertain sound, who shall prepare himself to the battle? So likewise you, except you utter by the tongue words easy to be **understood**, how shall it be known what is spoken? For you shall speak into the air. 1 Corinthians 14:8-9

For if I pray in an unknown tongue, my spirit prays, but my **understanding** is unfruitful. What is it then? I will pray with the spirit, and I will pray with the **understanding** also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the **understanding** also. Else when you shall bless with the spirit, how shall he that occupies the room of the unlearned say Amen at your giving of thanks, seeing he **understands** not what you say? 1 Corinthians 14:14-16

In the church I had rather speak five words with my **understanding**, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue. Brethren, be not children in **understanding**: howbeit in malice be you children, but in **understanding** be men. 1 Corinthians 14:19-20

The eyes of your **understanding** being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power to usward who believe, according to the working of His mighty power, which He wrought in Christ [Messiah], when He raised Him from the dead, and set Him at His own right hand in the heavenly places, Far above all principality, and power, and might... Ephesians 1:18-21

Whereby, when you read, you may **understand** my knowledge in the mystery of Christ [Messiah] which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto His holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit; That the Gentiles should be fellow-heirs, and of the same body and partakers of His promise in Christ by the gosel... Ephesians 3:4-6

This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind. Having the **understanding** darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart: Who being past feeling have given themselves over unto lasciviousness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But you have not so learned Christ [the Messiah]... Ephesians 4:17-20



Wherefore be you not unwise, but **understanding** what the will of the Lord is. Ephesians 5:17

But I would you should **understand**, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel... Philippians 1:12

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the peace of God, which passes all **understanding**, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus [Yeshua the Messiah]. Philippians 4:6-7

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual **understanding**... Colossians 1:9

That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of **understanding**, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ [the Messiah]; In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. Colossians 2:2-3

Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned: From which some having swerved have turned aside unto vain jangling; Desiring to be teachers of the law; **understanding** neither what they say, nor whereof they affirm. 1 Timothy 1:7

Consider what I say; and the Lord give you **understanding** in all things. Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel... 2 Timothy 2:7-8

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through faith we **understand** that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear. Hebrews 11:1-3



The Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of judgment to be punished: But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous are they, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities. Whereas angels, which are greater in power and might, bring not railing accusation against them before the Lord. But these, as natural brute beasts, made to be taken and destroyed, speak evil of the things that they **understand** not; and shall utterly perish in their own corruption... 2 Peter 2:9-12

Wherefore, beloved, seeing that you look for such things, be diligent that you may be found of Him in peace, without spot, and blameless. And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him has written unto you; As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be **understood**, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction. 2 Peter 3:14-16

And he causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: and that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him that has **understanding** count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man: and his number is Six hundred threescore and six. Revelation 13:16-18
