GRACE

But Noah found **grace** in the eyes of the LORD. Genesis 6:8

Behold now, Your servant has found **grace** in Your sight, and You have magnified Your mercy, which You have shown me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die... Genesis 19:19

[Esau] I have oxen, and asses, flocks, and menservants, and women servants: and I have sent to tell my lord, that I may find **grace** in your sight...And he said, What do you mean by all this drove which I met? And he said, These are to find **grace** in the sight of my lord...And he lifted up his eyes, and saw the women and the children; and said, Who are those with you? And he said, The children which God has **graciously** given your servant... And Jacob said, Nay, I pray you, if now I have found **grace** in your sight, then receive my present at my hand: for therefore I have seen your face, as though I had seen the face of God, and you were pleased with me. Take, I pray you, my blessing that is brought to you; because God has dealt **graciously** with me, and because I have enough. And he urged him, and he took it. Genesis 32:5, 8; 33:5, 10-11

Shechem said unto her father... Let me find **grace** in your eyes, and what you shall say unto me I will give. Genesis 34:11

Joseph found **grace** in his sight, and he served him: and he made him overseer over his house...He lifted up his eyes, and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's son, and said, Is this your younger brother, of whom you spake unto me? And he said, God be **gracious** unto you, my son. ... You have saved our lives: let us find **grace** in the sight of my lord, and we will be Pharaoh's servants...As the time drew nigh that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found **grace** in your sight, I pray, put your hand under my thigh, and deal kindly and truly with me; bury me not, I pray, in Egypt....and when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found **grace** in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying...Let me go up, I pray you, and bury my father... Genesis 39:4, 43:29, 47:25, 29, 50:4-5

For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: wherein shall he sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he cries unto me, that I will hear; for I am **gracious**. Exodus 22:27

Moses said unto the LORD, See, You say unto me, Bring up this people: and You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, I know you by name, and you have also found **grace** in My sight. Now therefore, I pray you, if I have found **grace** in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You, that I may find **grace** in Your sight: and consider that this nation is Your people. Exodus 33:12-13

For wherein shall it be known here that I and Your people have found **grace** in Your sight? Is it not in that you go with us? So shall we be separated, I and Your people, from all the people that are upon the face of the earth. And the LORD said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that you have spoken: for you have found **grace** in My sight, and I know you by name... Exodus 33:16-17

And He said, I will make all My goodness pass before , and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and will be **gracious** to whom I will be **gracious**, and will show mercy on whom I will show mercy. Exodus 33:19

And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and **gracious**, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth...And he said, If now I have found **grace** in Your sight, Lord, let My Lord, I pray You, go among us; for it is a stiff necked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for Your inheritance. Ex 34:6, 9

The LORD bless you, and keep you: The LORD make His face shine upon you, and be **gracious** unto you: The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26

Wherefore, said they, if we have found **grace** in your sight, let this land be given unto your servants for a possession, and bring us not over Jordan. Numbers 32:5

He said unto Him, If now I have found **grace** in Your sight, then show me a sign that You talk with me. Judges 6:17

Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after him in whose sight I shall find **grace**. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter...Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said unto him, Why have I found **grace** in your eyes, that you should take knowledge of me, seeing I am a stranger? Ruth 2:2, 10

She said, Let your handmaid find **grace** in your sight. So the woman went her way, and did eat, and her countenance was no more sad. 1 Samuel 1:18

David swore moreover, and said, Your father certainly knows that I have found **grace** in your eyes; and he said, Let not Jonathan know this, lest he be grieved: but truly as the LORD lives, and as your soul lives, there is but a step between me and death... David said unto Achish, If I have now found **grace** in your eyes, let them give me a place in some town in the country, that I may dwell there... 1 Samuel 20:3, 27:5

And he said, While the child was yet alive, I fasted and wept: for I said, Who can tell whether GOD will be **gracious** to me, that the child may live? 2 Samuel 12:22

Joab fell to the ground on his face, and bowed himself, and thanked the king: and Joab said, To day your servant knows that I have found **grace** in your sight, my lord, O king, in that the king has fulfilled the request of his servant. 2 Samuel 14:22

Then said the king to Ziba, Behold, yours are all that pertained unto Mephibosheth. And Ziba said, I humbly beseech you that I may find **grace** in your sight, my lord, O king. 2 Samuel 16:4

The LORD was **gracious** unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast He them from His presence as yet. 2 Kings 13:23

For if you turn again unto the LORD, your brethren and your children shall find compassion before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the LORD your God is **gracious** and merciful, and will not turn away His face from you, if you return unto Him. 2 Chronicles 30:9

Now for a little space **grace** has been shown from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in His holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage. Ezra 9:8

They and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Your commandments, And refused to obey, neither were they mindful of Your wonders that You did among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but you are a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsook them not... Nevertheless for Your great mercies' sake You did not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for You are a **gracious** and merciful God. Nehemiah 9:16-17, 31

The king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained **grace** and favor in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2:17

Then He is **gracious** unto him, and says, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom. Job 33:24

You are fairer than the children of men; **grace** is poured into your lips: therefore God has blessed you for ever. Psalm 45:2

Has God forgotten to be **gracious**? Has He in anger shut up His tender mercies? Selah. Psalms 77:9

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give **grace** and glory: no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly. Psalm 84:11

But You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and **gracious**, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth...The LORD is merciful and **gracious**, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. Psalm 86:15, 103:8

He has made His wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is **gracious** and full of compassion...Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness: He is **gracious**, and full of compassion, and righteous. Psalm 111:4, 112:4

Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yes, our God is merciful.
Psalm 116:5

Remove from me the way of lying: and grant me Your law
graciously. Psalm 119:29

The LORD is **gracious**, and full of compassion; slow to anger,
and of great mercy. Psalm 145:8

For they shall be an ornament of **grace** unto your head,
and chains about your neck. Proverbs 1:9

Keep sound wisdom and discretion: So shall they be life unto
your soul, and **grace** to your neck. Then shall you walk in your
way safely, and your foot shall not stumble... Proverbs 3:21-23

The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked:
but He blesses the habitation of the just. Surely He scorns
the scornors: but He gives **grace** unto the lowly. Proverbs 3:33-34

Wisdom is the principle thing...she shall give to your head
an ornament of **grace**: a crown of glory shall she deliver to you.
Proverbs 4:7, 9

A **gracious** woman retains honor: and strong men retain riches.
Proverbs 11:16

He that loves pureness of heart, for the **grace** of his lips
the king shall be his friend. Proverbs 22:11

The words of a wise man's mouth are **gracious**; but the lips
of a fool will swallow up himself. Ecclesiastes 10:12

Therefore will the LORD wait that He may be **gracious** unto you,
and therefore will He be exalted, that He may have mercy
upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they
that wait for Him. For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem:
you shall weep no more: He will be very **gracious** unto you
at the voice of your cry; when He shall hear it, He will answer you.
Isaiah 30:18-19

O LORD, be **gracious** unto us; we have waited for you: be Thou
their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble.
Isaiah 33:2

O inhabitant of Lebanon, that makes your nest in the cedars, how **gracious** shall you be when pangs come upon you, the pain as of a woman in travail. Jeremiah 22:23

Thus says the LORD, The people which were left of the sword found **grace** in the wilderness; even Israel, when I went to cause him to rest. Jeremiah 31:2

Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto Him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us **graciously**: so will we render the calves of our lips. Hosea 14:2

Rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for He is **gracious** and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repents Him of the evil. Joel 2:13

Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be **gracious** unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:15

He prayed unto the LORD [YEHOVAH], and said, I pray You, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that You are a **gracious** God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repent You of the evil. Jonah 4:2

This is the word of the LORD unto Zerubbabel, saying, Not by might, nor by power, but by My spirit, says the LORD of hosts. Who are you, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel you shall become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shouts, crying, **Grace, grace** unto it. Zechariah 4:6-7

I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of **grace** and of supplications; and they shall look upon Me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for Him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:10

And now, I pray you, beseech God that He will be **gracious** unto us: this has been by your means: will He regard your persons? Says the LORD of hosts. Malachi 1:9

GRACE IN THE NEW COVENANT

The child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the **grace** of God was upon Him. Luke 2:40

And all bare Him witness, and wondered at the **gracious** words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son? Luke 4:22

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of **grace** and truth...And of His fulness have we all received, and **grace for grace**. For the law was given by Moses, but **grace** and truth came by Jesus Christ. John 1:14, 16-17

With great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great **grace** was upon them all. Acts 4:33

They sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch. Who, when he came, and had seen the **grace** of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord. Acts 11:22-23

Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in **the grace of God**. Acts 13:43

Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of His **grace**, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands..When they had preached the word in Perga, they went down into Attalia: And then sailed to Antioch, from where they had been recommended to **the grace of God** for the work which they fulfilled... Acts 14:3, 25-26

Now therefore why tempt you God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we believe that through **the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ** we shall be saved, even as they. Acts 15:10-11

Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto **the grace of God**. Acts 15:40

When he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through **grace**... Acts 18:27

But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the **grace** of God...Brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of His **grace**, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified. Acts 20:24, 32

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God. (Which He had promised afore by His prophets in the holy scriptures.) Concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh: And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: By whom we have received **grace** and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for His name. Among whom are you also the called of Jesus Christ: to all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: **Grace** to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 1:1-7

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; being justified freely by His **grace** through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God. Romans 3:23-25

Now to him that works is the reward not reckoned of **grace**, but of debt...Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by **grace**; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all... Romans 4:4, 16

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom also we have access by faith into this **grace** wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2

But not of the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more **the grace of God**, and the gift of **grace**, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, has abounded unto many. And not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offenses unto justification. For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of **grace** and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ...Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, **grace** did much more abound: that as sin has reigned unto death, even so might **grace** reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] our Lord. Romans 5:15-17, 20-21

What shall we say then? ...Shall we continue in sin, that **grace** may abound? ...For sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under the law, but under **grace**. What then? Shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under **grace**? God forbid. Romans 6:1, 14-15

Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of **grace**. And if by **grace**, then is it no more of works: otherwise **grace** is no more **grace**. But if it be of works, then is it no more **grace**: otherwise work is no more work. Romans 11:5-6

For I say, through the **grace** given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God has dealt to every man the measure of faith. For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another. Having then gifts differing according to the **grace** that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith... Romans 12:3-6

Nevertheless, brethren, I have written the more boldly unto you in some sort, as putting you in mind, because of **the grace** that is given to me of God... Romans 15:15

The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you...The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. Romans 16:20, 24

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God always on your behalf, for the **grace** of God which is given you by Jesus Christ... 1 Corinthians 1:3-4

According to the **grace** of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another builds thereon. But let every man take heed how he builds thereupon. 1 Corinthians 3:10

For if I by **grace** be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks? 1 Corinthians 10:30

But by the **grace** of God I am what I am: and His **grace** which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I labored more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me... The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. 1 Corinthians 15:10, 16:23

Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by **the grace of God**, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward. 2 Cor 1:2, 12

For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant **grace** might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 4:15

We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that you receive not the **grace** of God in vain...Brethren, we do want you to know of the **grace** of God bestowed on the churches in Macedonia...We desired Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also finish in you the same **grace** also. 2 Corinthians 6:1, 8:1, 6

Therefore, as you abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that you abound in this **grace** also. I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love. For you know the **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though He was rich, yet for your sakes He became poor, that you through His poverty might be rich. 2 Cor 8:7-9

Not that only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with this **grace**, which is administered by us to the glory of the same Lord, and declaration of your ready mind... 2 Corinthians 8:19

God is able to make **all grace** abound toward you; that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work...They glorify God...by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding **grace** of God in you. 2 Corinthians 9:8, 13-14

He said...My **grace** is sufficient for you: for My strength is made perfect in weakness...The **grace** of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. 2 Corinthians 12:9, 13:14

Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ...I marvel that you are so soon removed from Him that called you into the **grace** of Christ unto another gospel...But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by His **grace**, To reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood...Gal 1:3, 6, 15

When James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the **grace** that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision. Galatians 2:9

I do not frustrate the **grace** of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain...Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; you are fallen from **grace**. Galatians 2:21, 5:4

Brethren, the **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. Unto the Galatians written from Rome. Galatians 6:18

Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...To the praise of the glory of His **grace**, wherein He has made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His **grace**...Ephesians 1:2, 6-7

But God, who is rich in mercy, Even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by **grace** you are saved;) And has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His **grace** in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. For by **grace** are you saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God... Ephesians 2:4-8

If you have heard of the dispensation of the **grace** of God which is given me to you-ward...Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the **grace** of God given unto me by the effectual working of His power. Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this **grace** given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ... Eph 3:2, 7-8

Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister **grace** unto the hearers. Ephesians 4:29

Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. Written from Rome unto the Ephesians by Tychicus. Ephesians 6:24

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel, you all are partakers of my **grace**... Philippians 1:2, 7,

The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Philip 4:3

To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colossae: **Grace** be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ...We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which you have to all the saints, For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and brings forth fruit, as it does also in you, since the day you heard of it, and knew **the grace** of God in truth... Colossians 1:2-6

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with **grace** in your hearts to the Lord. Col 3:16

Let your speech be always with **grace**, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer every man...The salutation by the hand of me Paul. Remember my bonds. **Grace** be with you. Amen. Written from Rome to the Colossians by Tychicus and Onesimus. Colossians 4:6, 18

Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ; **Grace** be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ...The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen. The first epistle unto the Thessalonians was written from Athens. 1 Thessalonians 1:1; 5:28

Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ...That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the **grace** of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ...The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. 2 Thessalonians 1:2, 12; 3:18

Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through **grace**, comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: **Grace**, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord...The **grace** of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus...Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. **Grace** be with you. Amen. The first to Timothy was written from Laodicea, which is the chiefest city of Phrygia Pacatiana. 1 Timothy 1:2, 14, 6:21

Be you not ...ashamed...but be you a partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; who has saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and **grace**, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began... 2 Timothy 1:8-9

The Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. **Grace** be with you. Amen. The second epistle unto Timotheus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians, was written from Rome, when Paul was brought before Nero the second time. 2 Timothy 4:22

To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: **Grace**, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior...For the **grace** of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men...Through Jesus Christ our Savior; that being justified by His **grace**, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life...All that are with me salute you. Greet them that love us in the faith. **Grace** be with you all. Amen. It was written to Titus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Cretians, from Nicopolis of Macedonia. Titus 1:4, 2:11, 3:7, 15

Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. Written from Rome to Philemon, by Onesimus, a servant. Philemon 1:3, 25

We see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honor; that He by the **grace** of God should taste death for every man. Hebrews 2:9

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of **grace**, that we may obtain mercy, and find **grace** to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:15-16

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and has done despite unto the Spirit of **grace**? For we know Him that has said, Vengeance belongs unto Me, I will recompense, says the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge His people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Hebrews 10:28-31

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the **grace** of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled...Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have **grace**, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: for our God is a consuming fire. Hebrews 12:14-15, 28-29

Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with **grace**; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein...**Grace** be with you all. Hebrews 13:9, 25

For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withers the grass, and the flower thereof falls, and the **grace** of the fashion of it perishes: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways...But He gives more **grace**. Wherefore He says, God resists the proud, but gives **grace** unto the humble. James 1:11, 4:6

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: **Grace** unto you, and peace, be multiplied...Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the **grace** that should come unto you: Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us, they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the **grace** that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 1:2, 9-13

Wherefore, laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that you may grow thereby: If so be you have tasted that the Lord is **gracious**. 1 Peter 2:1-3

Likewise, you husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the **grace** of life; that your prayers be not hindered... 1 Peter 3:7

But the end of all things is at hand: be you therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man has received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold **grace** of God. 1 Peter 4:7-10

You younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yes, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resists the proud, and gives **grace** to the humble...The God of all **grace**, who has called us unto His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, [Messiah Yeshua] after that you have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. 1 Peter 5:5, 10

...By Silvanus, a faithful brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true **grace** of God wherein you stand. 1 Peter 5:12

Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord... But grow in **grace**, and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be glory both now and forever. Amen. 2 Peter 1:2, 3:18

Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. 2 John 1:3

For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the **grace** of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ. Jude 1:4

John to the seven churches which are in Asia: **Grace** be unto you, and peace, from Him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before His throne... Revelation 1:4

MERCY

Lot said...Behold now, your servant has found grace in your sight, and you have magnified your **mercy**, which you have shown unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die: Behold now, this city is near to flee unto... Genesis 19:18-20

He said, Blessed be the LORD God of my master Abraham, who has not left destitute my master of His **mercy** and His truth: I being in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren. Genesis 24:27

The LORD was with Joseph, and showed him **mercy**, and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison. Genesis 39:21

God Almighty give you **mercy** before the man, that he may send away your other brother, and Benjamin. Genesis 43:14

You in Your **mercy** have led forth the people which You have redeemed: You have guided them in Your strength unto Your holy habitation...Showing **mercy** unto thousands of them that love Me, and keep My commandments. Exodus 15:13, 20:6, (also found as Deuteronomy 5:10)

You shall make a **mercy** seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof. And you shall make two cherubim of gold, of beaten work shall you make them, in the two ends of the **mercy** seat...And you shall put the **mercy** seat above upon the ark; and in the ark you shall put the testimony that I shall give you. And there I will meet with you, and I will commune with you from above the **mercy** seat, from between the two cherubim which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give you in commandment unto the children of Israel...You shall put the **mercy** seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most holy place. Exodus 25:17-18, 21-22, 26:34

I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will show **mercy** on whom I will show **mercy**. Exodus 33:19

Keeping **mercy** for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation.
Exodus 34:7

The LORD said unto Moses, speak unto Aaron your brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the **mercy** seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the **mercy** seat...And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the **mercy** seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: and he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the **mercy** seat eastward; and before the **mercy** seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the **mercy** seat, and before the **mercy** seat...
Leviticus 16:2, 13-15

When Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with Him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the **mercy** seat that was upon the ark of testimony, from between the two cherubim: and he spake unto Him.
Numbers 7:8-9

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great **mercy**, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech You, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of Your **mercy**, and as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.
Numbers 14:18-19

When the LORD your God shall deliver them before you; you shall smite them, and utterly destroy them; you shall make no covenant with them, nor show **mercy** unto them...
Deuteronomy 7:2

There shall cleave nothing of the cursed thing to your hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger, and show you **mercy**, and have compassion upon you, and multiply you, as He has sworn unto your fathers... Deuteronomy 13:17

The spies saw a man come forth out of the city, and they said unto him, Show us, we pray you, the entrance into the city, and we will shew you **mercy**. Judges 1:24

Solomon said, You have showed unto your servant David my father great **mercy**, according as he walked before You in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with You; and You have kept for him this great kindness, that You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

He said, LORD God of Israel, there is no God like you, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keeps covenant and **mercy** with your servants that walk before You with all their heart... 1 Kings 8:23, 2 Chronicles 6:14

O give thanks unto the LORD; for He is good; for His **mercy** endures for ever...And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because His **mercy** endures for ever... 1 Chronicles 16:34, 41

Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlors thereof, and of the place of the **mercy** seat. 1 Chronicles 28:11

Solomon said unto God, You have shown great **mercy** unto David my father, and have made me to reign in his stead. 2 Chr 1:8

It came to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying, For He is good; for His **mercy** endures for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD... 2 Chronicles 5:13

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshiped, and praised the LORD, saying, For He is good; for His **mercy** endures for ever...And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of music of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because His **mercy** endures for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood. 2 Chronicles 7:3, 6

When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for His **mercy** endures for ever. 2 Chronicles 20:21

They sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because He is good, for His **mercy** endures for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. Ezra 3:11

Blessed be the LORD God of our fathers, which has put such a thing as this in the king's heart, to beautify the house of the LORD which is in Jerusalem: And has extended **mercy** unto me before the king, and his counselors, and before all the king's mighty princes. Ezra 7:27-28

We were bondmen; yet our God has not forsaken us in our bondage, but has extended **mercy** unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem. Ezra 9:9

By watering He wearies the thick cloud: He scatters His bright cloud: It is turned round about by His counsels: That they may do whatever He commands them upon the face of the world in the earth. He causes it to come, whether for correction, or for His land, or for **mercy**. Job 37:12-13

And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for His **mercy** endures for ever: But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea; for His **mercy** endures for ever. To Him which led His people through the wilderness: for His **mercy** endures for ever. To Him which smote great kings: for His **mercy** endures for ever: And slew famous kings: for His **mercy** endures for ever: Sihon king of the Amorites: for His **mercy** endures for ever: And Og the king of Bashan: for His **mercy** endures for ever: And gave their land for an heritage: for His **mercy** endures for ever: Even an heritage unto Israel His servant: for His **mercy** endures for ever. Who remembered us in our low estate: for His **mercy** endures for ever. And has redeemed us from our enemies: for His **mercy** endures for ever. Afterward, says the LORD, I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have **mercy**. Jeremiah 21:7

Thus says the LORD; Behold, I will bring again the captivity of Jacob's tents, and have **mercy** on his dwelling places; and the city shall be built upon her own heap, and the palace shall remain after the manner thereof...Is Ephraim my dear son? is he a pleasant child? for since I spake against him, I do earnestly remember him still: therefore My bowels are troubled for him; I will surely have **mercy** upon him, says the LORD. Jeremiah 30:18, 31:20

Again there shall be heard in this place...The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of Hosts: for the LORD is good; for His **mercy** endures for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, says the LORD. Jeremiah 33:11

Thus says the LORD; If My covenant be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have **mercy** on them. Jeremiah 33:25-26

I will shew **mercies** unto you, that he may have **mercy** upon you, and cause you to return to your own land. Jeremiah 42:12

They shall hold the bow and the land: they are cruel, and will not shew **mercy**: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, every one put in array, like a man to the battle, against you, O daughter of Babylon. Jeremiah 50:42

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have **mercy** upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for My holy name... Ezekiel 39:25

O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto you, and break off your sins by righteousness, and your iniquities by showing **mercy** to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of your tranquility. Daniel 4:27

I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and **mercy** to them that love Him, and to them that keep His commandments; We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and from Your judgments... To the Lord our God belong **mercies** and forgivenesses... Daniel 9:4-5, 8

She conceived again, and bare a daughter. And God said unto him, call her name Lo-ruhamah: for I will no more have **mercy** upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away. but I will have **mercy** upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen. So then it is not of him that wills, nor of him that runs, but of God that shows **mercy**...Therefore has He **mercy** on whom He will have **mercy**, and whom He will He hardens... That He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of **mercy**, which He had afore prepared unto glory, Even us, whom He has called... Romans 9:15-18, 23

For as you in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained **mercy** through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not believed, that through your **mercy** they also may obtain **mercy**. For God has concluded them all in unbelief, that He might have **mercy** upon all. Romans 11:30-32

Having then gifts differing according to the grace given to us... he that exhorts, on exhortation: he that gives, let him do it with simplicity; he that rules, with diligence; he that shows **mercy**, with cheerfulness. Let love be without dissimulation. Romans 12:6, 8

That the Gentiles might glorify God for His **mercy**; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to you among the Gentiles, and sing unto Your name. Romans 15:9

Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that has obtained **mercy** of the Lord to be faithful. 1 Corinthians 7:25

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received **mercy**, we faint not. 2 Corinthians 4:1

And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and **mercy**, and upon the Israel of God. Galatians 6:16

God, who is rich in **mercy**, for His great love wherewith He loved us, even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace you are saved;) and has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:4-7

For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had **mercy** on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. Philippians 2:27

Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, **mercy**, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. 1 Timothy 1:2

I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has enabled me, for that He counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained **mercy**, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief ...Howbeit for this cause I obtained **mercy**, that in me first Jesus Christ might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on Him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:12-13, 16

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His **mercy** He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior...being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:2-7

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain **mercy**, and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:16

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without **mercy** under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose you, shall he be thought worthy, who has trodden under foot the Son of God, and has counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and has done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:26-29

For he shall have judgment without **mercy**, that has shown no **mercy**; and **mercy** rejoices against judgment. James 2:13

The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of **mercy** and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:17

Behold, we count them happy which endure. You have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender **mercy**. James 5:11

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to His abundant **mercy** has begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for you. 1 Peter 1:3-4

The meek will He guide in judgment: and the meek will He teach His way. All the paths of the LORD are **mercy** and **truth** unto such as keep His covenant and His testimonies. For Your name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great. What man is he that fears the LORD? Him shall He teach in the way that He shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD is with them that fear Him; and He will show them His covenant. Psalm 25:9-14

I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation: I have not concealed Your loving kindness and Your **truth** from the great congregation. Withhold not Your tender **mercies** from me, O LORD: let Your loving kindness and Your **truth** continually preserve me. Psalm 40:10-11

Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusts in You: yes, in the shadow of Your wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast. Know you that the LORD He is God: it is He that has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people, and the sheep of His pasture. Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise: be thankful unto Him, and bless His name. For the LORD is good; His **mercy** is everlasting; and His **truth** endures to all generations. Psalm 100:1-5

O GOD, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory. Awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake early. For all His ways are judgment: a God of **truth** and without iniquity, just and right is He. Deuteronomy 32:3-4

In Your majesty ride prosperously because of **truth** and meekness and righteousness; and Your right hand shall teach You terrible things. Psalm 45:4

Behold, You desire **truth** in the inward parts: and in the hidden part You shall make me to know wisdom. Psalm 51:6

He shall reward evil unto mine enemies: cut them off in Your **truth**. Psalm 54:5

He shall send from heaven, and save me from the reproach of him that would swallow me up. Selah. God shall send forth His mercy and **truth**...For Your mercy is great unto the heavens, and Your **truth** unto the clouds. Psalm 57:3, 10

You have given a banner to them that fear You, that it may be displayed because of Your **truth**. Selah. Psalm 60:4

He shall abide before God for ever: O prepare mercy and **truth**, which may preserve him. Psalm 61:7

But as for me, my prayer is unto you, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of Your mercy hear me, in the **truth** of Your salvation. Psalm 69:13

I will also praise You with the psaltery, even your **truth**, O my God: unto You will I sing with the harp, O Holy One of Israel. Psalm 71:22

Mercy and **truth** are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. **Truth** shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Psalm 85:10-11

Teach me Your way, O LORD; I will walk in Your **truth**: unite my heart to fear Your name...but You, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plentiful in mercy and **truth**. Psalm 86:11, 15

Justice and judgment are the habitation of Your throne: mercy and **truth** shall go before Your face. Psalm 89:14

Lord, where are Your former loving kindnesses, which You swore unto David in your **truth**? Psalm 89:49

He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings shall you trust: His **truth** shall be your shield and buckler. Psalm 91:4

Then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice before the LORD: for He comes, for He comes to judge the earth: He shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with His **truth**. Psalm 96:12-13

He has remembered His mercy and His **truth** toward the house of Israel...For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting; and His **truth** endures to all generations. Psalm 98:3, 100:5

I will praise You, O LORD, among the people...For Your mercy is great above the heavens: and Your **truth** reaches unto the clouds. Psalm 108:3-4

The works of His hands are verity and judgment; all His commandments are sure. They stand fast for ever and ever, and are done in **truth** and uprightness. Psalm 111:7-8

Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto Your name give glory, for Your mercy, and for Your **truth's** sake. Ps 115:1

O praise the LORD, all you nations: praise Him, all you people. For His merciful kindness is great toward us: and the **truth** of the LORD endures for ever. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 117:1-2

I have chosen the way of **truth**: Your judgments have I laid before me...And take not Your **truth** utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in Your judgments...Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your law is the **truth**...You are near, O LORD; and all Your commandments are **truth**. Ps 119:30, 43, 142, 151

The LORD has sworn in **truth** unto David; He will not turn from it; Of the fruit of your body will I set upon your throne. Psalm 132:11

I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your loving kindness and for Your **truth**: for You have magnified Your word above all Your name. Psalm 138:2

The LORD is nigh unto all them that call upon Him, to all that call upon Him in **truth**. Psalm 145:18

Happy is he that has the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God: Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keeps **truth** for ever... Psalm 146:5-6

Let not mercy and **truth** forsake you: bind them about your neck; write them upon the table of your heart: So shall you find favor and good understanding in the sight of God and man. Pro 3:3-4

For my mouth shall speak **truth**; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. Proverbs 8:7

He that speaks **truth** shows forth righteousness: but a false witness deceit...The lip of **truth** shall be established for ever: but a lying tongue is but for a moment. Proverbs 12:17, 19

Do they not err that devise evil? But mercy and **truth** shall be to them that devise good. Proverbs 14:22

By mercy and **truth** iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. Proverbs 16:6

Mercy and **truth** preserve the king: and His throne is upholden by mercy. Proverbs 20:28

Have not I written to you excellent things in counsels and knowledge, that I might make you know the certainty of the words of **truth**; but you might answer the words of **truth** to them that send unto you? Proverbs 22:20-21

Buy the **truth**, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding. Proverbs 23:23

The preacher sought to find out acceptable words: and that which was written was upright, even words of **truth**. Ecclesiastes 12:10

In My ears said the LORD of hosts, Of a **truth** many houses shall be desolate, even great and fair, without inhabitant. Isaiah 5:9

The remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in **truth**. Isaiah 10:20

In mercy shall the throne be established: and He shall sit upon it in **truth** in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hastening righteousness. Isaiah 16:5

O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will praise Your name; for You have done wonderful things; Your counsels of old are faithfulness and **truth**. Isaiah 25:1

Open you the gates, that the righteous nation which keeps the **truth** may enter in. Isaiah 26:2

Remember now, O LORD, I beseech You, how I have walked before You in **truth** and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in Your sight. And Hezekiah wept sore...For the grave cannot praise You, death can not celebrate You: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for Your **truth**. The living, the living he shall praise You, as I do this day: the father to the children shall make known Your **truth**. Isaiah 38:3, 19

A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth judgment unto **truth**. Is 42:3

Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and show us former things? Let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is **truth**. Isaiah 43:9

Hear this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, but not in **truth**, nor in righteousness. Isaiah 48:1

None calls for justice, nor any pleads for **truth**: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity... Judgment is turned away backward, and justice stands afar off: for **truth** is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. Yes, **truth** fails; and he that departs from evil makes himself a prey... Isaiah 59:4, 14-15

For I the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in **truth**, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Isaiah 61:8

He who blesses himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of **truth**; and he that swears in the earth shall swear by the God of **truth**; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes. Isaiah 65:16

You shall swear, The LORD lives, in **truth**, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in Him, and in Him shall they glory. Jeremiah 4:2

Run you to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if you can find a man, if there be any that execute judgment, that seeks the **truth**; and I will pardon it. And though they say, The LORD lives; surely they swear falsely. O LORD, are not Your eyes upon the **truth**? You have stricken them, but they have not grieved; You have consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return... You shall say unto them, This is a nation that obeys not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receives correction: **truth** is perished, and is cut off from their mouth. Jeremiah 5:1-3, 7:28

They bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the **truth** upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not Me, says the LORD. Take you heed every one of his neighbor, and trust you not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbor will walk with slanders. And they will deceive every one his neighbor, and will not speak the **truth**: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity. Jeremiah 9:3-5

Know for certain, that if you put me to death, you shall surely bring innocent blood upon yourselves, and upon this city, and upon the inhabitants thereof: for of a **truth** the LORD has sent me unto you to speak all these words in your ears. Jeremiah 26:15

Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and **truth**... and I will cleanse them from all their iniquity... Jeremiah 33:6, 8

The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a **truth** it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing you could reveal this secret. Daniel 2:47

Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all whose works are **truth**, and His ways judgment: and those that walk in pride He is able to abase. Daniel 4:37

I came near unto one of them...and asked him the **truth** of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things...Then I would know the **truth** of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet...And I saw in a vision...An host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the **truth** to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered. Daniel 7:16, 19, 8:2, 12

As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us; yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand Your **truth**... I will show you that which is noted in the scripture of **truth**: and there is none that holds with me in these things, but Michael your prince. Daniel 9:13, 10:21

Now will I show you the **truth**. Behold, there shall stand up three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia. Daniel 11:2

Hear the word of the LORD, you children of Israel: for the LORD has a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no **truth**, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. Hosea 4:1

You will perform the **truth** to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which you have sworn unto our fathers from the days of old. Micah 7:20

Thus says the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of **truth**; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain. Zechariah 8:3

I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, in **truth** and in righteousness...These are the things that you shall do; Speak you every man the **truth** to his neighbor; execute the judgment of **truth** and peace in your gates...Thus says the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the **truth** and peace. Zechariah 8:8, 16, 19

The law of **truth** was in His mouth, and iniquity was not found in His lips: He walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. Malachi 2:6

TRUTH IN THE NEW COVENANT

They that were in the ship came and worshiped Him, saying, Of a **truth** You are the Son of God. Matthew 14:33

He answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs. She said, **Truth**, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table. Mt 15:26-27

They sent out unto Him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that You are **true**, and teach the way of God in **truth**, neither care You for any man: for You regard not the person of men. Matthew 22:16

The woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before Him, and told Him all the **truth**. Mark 5:33

The scribe said unto Him, Well, Master, You have said the **truth**: for there is one God; and there is none other but He... Mark 12:32

I tell you of a **truth**, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land... Luke 4:25

But I tell you of a **truth**, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the Kingdom of God. Luke 9:27

Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he comes shall find so doing. Of a **truth** I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he has. Luke 12:44

He said, Of a **truth** I say unto you, that this poor widow has cast in more than they all... Luke 21:3

After a little while another saw Him, and said, You are also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not. About the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a **truth** this fellow also was with Him: for he is a Galilean. Luke 22:58-59

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and **truth**...For the law was given by Moses, but grace and **truth** came by Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]. John 1:14, 17

Every one that does evil hates the light, neither comes to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. He that does **truth** comes to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. John 3:20-21

The hour comes, and now is, when the **true** worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in **truth**: for the Father seeks such to worship Him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in **truth**. John 4:23-24

You sent unto John, and he bare witness to the **truth**. John 5:33

You shall know the **truth**, and the **truth** shall make you free. John 8:32

Now you seek to kill Me, a man that has told you the **truth**, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham... You are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the **truth**, because there is no **truth** in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. And because I tell you the **truth**, you believe Me not. Which of you convinces me of sin? And if I say the **truth**, why do you not believe me? Jn 8:40, 44-46

Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the **truth**, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by Me. John 14:6

If you love Me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of **truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for He dwells with you, and shall be in you. John 14:15-17

When the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of **truth**, which proceeds from the Father, He shall testify of Me... I tell you the **truth**; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. When He, the Spirit of **truth**, is come, He will guide you into all **truth**: for He shall not speak of Himself; but whatever He shall hear, that shall He speak: and He will show you things to come. Jn 15:26, 16:7, 13

Sanctify them through Your **truth**: Your word is **truth**... for their sakes I sanctify Myself, that they also might be sanctified through the **truth**. John 17:17, 19

Pilate therefore said unto him, Are you a king then? Jesus answered, You say that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the **truth**. Every one that is of the **truth** hears My voice. Pilate said unto Him, What is **truth**? And when he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and said unto them, I find in Him no fault at all. John 18:37-38

For of a **truth** against Your holy child Jesus, whom you have anointed...Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together... Acts 4:27-28

Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a **truth** I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that fears Him, and works righteousness, is accepted with Him. Acts 10:34-35

He said, I am not mad, most noble Festus; but speak forth the words of **truth** and soberness. Acts 26:25

The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the **truth** in unrighteousness...who changed the **truth** of God into a lie, and worshiped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. Romans 1:18, 25

We are sure that the judgment of God is according to **truth** against them which commit such things...To them who by patient continuance in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the **truth**, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath... Romans 2:2, 7-8

You are...an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which have the form of knowledge and of the **truth** in the law. You therefore which teach another, teach you not yourself?... Romans 2:20-21

Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for the **truth** of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers...Ro 15:8

Let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and **truth**. 1 Corinthians 5:8

Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity vaunts not itself, is not puffed up, Does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil; Rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the **truth**... 1 Corinthians 13:4-6

But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believes not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he judged of all: And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a **truth**. 1 Corinthians 14:24-25

Therefore, seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the **truth** commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 2 Corinthians 4:1-2

But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God.. by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned. By the word of **truth**, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, By honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet **true**; As unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed; As sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:4-8

For if I have boasted any thing to him of you, I am not ashamed; but as we spake all things to you in truth, even so our boasting, which I made before Titus, is found a **truth**...As the **truth** of Christ [the Messiah] is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia. 2 Corinthians 7:14, 11:10

For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the **truth**: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he sees me to be, or that he hears of me. 2 Corinthians 12:6

Now I pray to God that you do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that you should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates. For we can do nothing against the **truth**, but for the **truth**. 2 Corinthians 13:7-8

But neither Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised: And that because of false brethren unawares brought in who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the **truth** of the gospel might continue with you. Galatians 2:3-5

The other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation. But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the **truth** of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If you, being a Jew, live after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compel you the Gentiles to live as do the Jews? Galatians 2:13-14

O foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, that you should not obey the **truth**, before whose eyes Jesus Christ has been evidently set forth, crucified among you? Galatians 3:1

Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the **truth**?... You did run well; who did hinder you that you should not obey the **truth**? Galatians 4:16, 5:7

...We should be to the praise of His glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom you also trusted, after that you heard the word of **truth**, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that you believed, you were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise... Ephesians 1:12-13

...That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the **truth** in love, may grow up into Him in all things, which is the head, even Christ... You have not so learned Christ; If so be that you have heard Him, and have been taught by Him, as the **truth** is in Jesus. Ephesians 4:14-15, 20-21

Put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that you put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. Wherefore putting away lying, Speak every man **truth** with his neighbor; for we are members one of another. Ephesians 4:22-25

The fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and **truth**... Ephesians 5:9

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplate of righteousness... Ephesians 6:14

The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds: But the other of love, knowing that I am set for the defense of the gospel. What then? Notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretense, or in **truth**, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yes, and will rejoice. Philippians 1:16-18

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you...For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof you heard before in the word of the **truth** of the gospel; which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and brings forth fruit, as it does also in you, since the day you heard of it, and knew the grace of God in **truth**... Colossians 1:3, 5-6

...When you received the word of God which you heard of us, you received it not as the word of men, but as it is in **truth**, the word of God, which effectually works also in you that believe. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

For the mystery of iniquity does already work...With all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the **truth**, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the **truth**, but had pleasure in unrighteousness...But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God has from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the **truth**: Whereunto He called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 2:7, 10-14

I exhort therefore, that, first of all supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men...For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the **truth**...Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the **truth** in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity. 1 Timothy 2:2:1, 3-4, 7

These things write I...that you may know how you ought to behave yourself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the **truth**. 1 Tim 3:14-15

Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, ...Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God has created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the **truth**... He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof comes envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the **truth**, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw yourself. But godliness with contentment is great gain. 1 Timothy 4: 1-3, 6:4-6

Study to show yourself approved unto God, a workman that needs not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of **truth**. But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. And their word will eat as does a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; Who concerning the **truth** have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already... 2 Timothy 2:15-18

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the **truth**; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:24-26

Of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of the **truth**. Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the **truth**.. 2 Timothy 3:6-8

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the **truth**, and shall be turned unto fables. 2 Timothy 4:3-4

Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of **the truth** which is after godliness; In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began... Titus 1:1-2

This witness is **true**. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith; not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from the **truth**. Titus 1:13-14

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of **the truth**, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. Hebrews 10:26-27

Of His own will begat He us with the word of **truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of His creatures. James 1:18

Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if you have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the **truth**. Jas 3:13-14

Brethren, if any of you do err from the **truth**, and one convert him; Let him know, that he which converts the sinner from the error of his way, shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins. James 5:19-20

Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though you know them, and be established in the present **truth**. 2 Peter 1:12

Seeing you have purified your souls in obeying the **truth** through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that you love one another with a pure heart fervently... 2 Peter 1:21-22

Many follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of **truth** shall be evil spoken of. 2 Peter 2:2

If we say that we have fellowship with Him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the **truth**: But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the **truth** is not in us... He that says, I know Him, and keeps not His commandments, is a liar, and the **truth** is not in him...I have not written unto you because you know not the **truth**, but because you know it, and that no lie is of the **truth**. Who is a liar but he that denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denies the Father and the Son... But the anointing which you have received of Him abides in you, and you need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teaches you of all things, and is **truth**, and is no lie, and even as it has taught you, you shall abide in Him. 1 John 1:6-8, 2:4, 21-22, 27

My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in **truth**. And hereby we know that we are of the **truth**, and shall assure our hearts before Him...We are of God: he that knows God hears us; he that is not of God hears not us. Hereby know we the spirit of **truth**, and the spirit of error... This is He that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that bears witness, because the Spirit is **truth**. 1 John 3:18-19, 4:6, 5:6

The elder unto the elect lady... whom I love in the **truth**; and not I only, but also all they that have known the **truth**; For the **truth's** sake, which dwells in us, and shall be with us for ever. Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in **truth** and love. I rejoiced greatly that I found of your children walking in **truth**, as we have received a commandment from the Father. 2 John 1:1-4

The elder unto the well beloved Gaius, whom I love in **the truth**. For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of **the truth** that is in you, even as you walk in the **truth**. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in **truth**. We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellow helpers to the **truth**. Demetrius has good report of all men, and of the **truth** itself; yes, and we also bear record; and you know that our record is **true**. 3 John 1:1, 3-4, 8, 12

FAVOR

My Lord, if now I have found **favor** in Your sight, pass not away, I pray You, from Your servant... Genesis 18:3

Leah was tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well **favored**. Genesis 29:17

Laban said unto him, I pray you, if I have found **favor** in your eyes, tarry: for I have learned by experience that the LORD has blessed me for your sake. Genesis 30:27

He left all that he had in Joseph's hand; and he knew not ought he had, save the bread which he did eat. And Joseph was a goodly person, and well **favored**. Genesis 39:6

The LORD was with Joseph, and showed him mercy, and gave him **favor** in the sight of the keeper of the prison. Genesis 39:21

Behold, there came up out of the river seven well **favored** kine [cows] and fatfleshed; and they fed in a meadow. And, behold, seven other kine came up after them out of the river, ill **favored** and leanfleshed; and stood by the other kine upon the brink of the river. And the ill **favored** and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well **favored** and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke...And Joseph said, And the seven thin and ill **favored** kine that came up after them are seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted with the east wine shall be seven years of famine. Genesis 41:2-4, 25, 27

I will give this people **favor** in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when you go, you shall not go empty... Exodus 3:21

The LORD gave the people **favor** in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people... The LORD gave the people **favor**...so that they lent unto them such things as they required. Exodus 11:3, 12:36

Moses said unto the LORD, Wherefore have You afflicted Your servant? and wherefore have I not found **favor** in Your sight, that You lay the burden of all this people upon me? Num 11:11

If you deal thus with me, kill me, I pray you, out of hand, if I have found **favor** in Your sight; and let me not see my wretchedness. Numbers 11:15

Of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with **favor**, and full with the blessing of the LORD: possess you the west and the south. Deuteronomy 33:23

For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that He might destroy them utterly, and that they might have no **favor**, but that He might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses. Joshua 11:20

It shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be **favorable** unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for you did not give unto them at this time, that you should be guilty. Judges 21:22

Let me find **favor** in your sight, my lord; for that you have comforted me, and for that you have spoken friendly unto your handmaid, though I be not like unto one of your handmaidens. Ruth 2:13

The child Samuel grew on, and was in **favor** both with the LORD [YEHOVAH], and also with men. 1 Samuel 2:26

Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray you, stand before me; for he has found **favor** in my sight. 1 Samuel 16:22

If I have found **favor** in your eyes, let me get away, I pray you, and see my brethren. 1 Samuel 20:29

Ask your young men, and they will show you. Wherefore let the young men find **favor** in your eyes: for we come in a good day: give, I pray you, whatever comes to your hand unto your servants, and to your son David. 1 Samuel 25:8

Then Achish called David, and said unto him, Surely, as the LORD lives, you have been upright, and your going out and your coming in with me in the hosts is good in my sight: for I have not found evil in you since the day of your coming unto me unto this day: nevertheless the lords **favor** you not. 1 Samuel 29:6

The king said unto Zadok, Carry back the ark of God into the city: if I shall find **favor** in the eyes of the LORD, He will bring me again, and show me both it, and His habitation... 2 Samuel 15:25

One of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that **favours** Joab, and he that is for David, let him go after Joab. 2 Samuel 20:11

Hadad found great **favor** in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife...1 Kings 11:19

I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if your servant has found **favor** in your sight, that you would send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it. Nehemiah 2:5

When the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, she required nothing but what Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, appointed. And Esther obtained **favor** in the sight of all them that looked upon her... The king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and **favor** in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2:15, 17

It was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, that she obtained **favor** in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden scepter that was in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the scepter...If I have found **favor** in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do tomorrow as the king has said. Esther 5:2, 8

Then Esther the queen answered, and said, If I have found **favor** in your sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request...If it please the king, and if I have found **favor** in his sight, and the thing seem right before the king, and I be pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which are in all the king's provinces... Esther 7:3, 8:5

You have granted me life and **favor**, and Your visitation has preserved my spirit. Job 10:12

He shall pray unto God, and He will be **favorable** unto him: and he shall see His face with joy: for He will render unto man his righteousness. Job 33:26

For you, LORD, will bless the righteous; with **favor** will You compass him as with a shield. Psalm 5:12

For His anger endures but a moment; in His **favor** is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning. And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved. LORD, by Your **favor** You have made my mountain to stand strong: You did hide your face, and I was troubled. Psalm 30:5-7

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that **favor** my righteous cause: yes, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. Psalm 35:27

By this I know that You **favor** me, because my enemy does not triumph over me. Psalm 41:11

For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but Your right hand, and Your arm, and the light of Your countenance, because You had a **favor** unto them. Psalm 44:3

The daughter of Tyre shall be there with a gift; even the rich among the people shall intreat your **favor**. Psalm 45:12

Will the Lord cast off for ever? And will He be **favorable** no more? Psalm 77:7

LORD, You have been **favorable** unto Your land: You have brought back the captivity of Jacob. Psalm 85:1

For You are the glory of their strength: and in Your **favor** our horn shall be exalted. Psalm 89:17

You shall arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to **favor** her, yes, the set time, is come. For Your servants take pleasure in her stones, and **favor** the dust thereof. Psalm 102:13-14

Remember me, O LORD, with the **favor** that You bear unto Your people: O visit me with Your salvation... Psalm 106:4

Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to **favor** his fatherless children. Psalm 109:12

A good man shows **favor**, and lends: he will guide his affairs with discretion. Psalm 112:5

I intreated Your **favor** with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to Your word. Psalm 119:58

My son, forget not my law; but let your heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to you. Let not mercy and truth forsake you: bind them about your neck; write them upon the table of your heart. So shall you find **favor** and good understanding in the sight of God and man. Proverbs 3:1-4

Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed is the man that hears me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. For whoso finds me finds life, and shall obtain **favor** of the LORD [YEHOVAH]. Proverbs 8:33-35

He that diligently seeks good procures **favor**: but he that seeks mischief, it shall come unto him. Proverbs 11:27

A good man obtains **favor** of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn. Proverbs 12:2

Good understanding gives **favor**: but the way of the transgressors is hard. Proverbs 13:15

Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is **favor**. Proverbs 14:9

The king's **favor** is toward a wise servant: but his wrath is against him that causes shame. Proverbs 14:35

In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his **favor** is as a cloud of the latter rain. Proverbs 16:15

Whoso finds a wife finds a good thing, and obtains **favor** of the LORD. Proverbs 18:22

Many will intreat the **favor** of the prince: and every man is a friend to him that gives gifts. Proverbs 19:6

The king's wrath is as the roaring of a lion; but his **favor** is as dew upon the grass. Proverbs 19:12

The soul of the wicked desires evil: his neighbor finds no **favor** in his eyes. Proverbs 21:10

A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving **favor** rather than silver and gold. Proverbs 22:1

He that rebukes a man afterwards shall find more **favor** than he that flatters with the tongue. Proverbs 28:23

Many seek the ruler's **favor**; but every man's judgment comes from the LORD. Proverbs 29:26

Favor is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that fears the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet **favor** to men of skill; but time and chance happens to them all. Ecclesiastes 9:11

Let **favor** be shown to the wicked, yet will he not learn righteousness: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD. Isaiah 26:10

When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, and set them on fire: for it is a people of no understanding: therefore He that made them will not have mercy on them, and He that formed them will shew them no **favor**. Isaiah 27:11

The sons of strangers shall build up your walls, and their kings shall minister unto you: for in My wrath I smote you, but in My **favor** have I had mercy on you. Isaiah 60:10

Therefore will I cast you out of this land into a land that you know not, neither you nor your fathers; and there shall you serve other gods day and night; where I will not shew you **favor**. Jeremiah 16:18

The anger of the LORD has divided them; He will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they **favored** not the elders. Lamentations 4:16

The king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; Children in whom was no blemish, but **well favored**, and skillful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace...Daniel 1:3-4

Now God had brought Daniel into **favor** and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs. Daniel 1:9

The angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, you who are highly **favored**, the Lord is with you: blessed are you among women. And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutation this should be. And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for you have found **favor** with God. Luke 1:28-30

Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in **favor** with God and man. Luke 2:52

They, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, praising God, and having **favor** with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. Acts 2:46-47

The patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him, and delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him **favor** and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. Acts 7:9-10

Then the high priest and the chief of the Jews informed him against Paul, and besought him. And desired **favor** against him, that he would send for him to Jerusalem, laying wait in the way to kill him. Acts 25:2-3

FORGIVENESS

So shall you say unto Joseph, **Forgive**, I pray you now, the trespass of your brethren, and their sins; for they did unto you evil: and now, we pray you, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of your father. And Joseph wept when they spoke unto him. Genesis 50:17

Now therefore **forgive**, I pray you, my sin only this once, and intreat the LORD your God, that He may take away from me this death only. Exodus 10:17

Yet now, if You will **forgive** their sin; and if not, blot me, I pray You, out of Your book which You have written. Exodus 32:32

The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, Keeping mercy for thousand, **forgiving** iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:6-7

And he shall do with the bullock as he did with the bullock for a sin offering, so shall he do with this: and the priest shall make an atonement for them, and it shall be **forgiven** them. And he shall burn all his fat upon the altar, as the fat of the sacrifice of peace offerings: and the priest shall make an atonement for him as concerning his sin, and it shall be **forgiven** him...He shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat is taken away from off the sacrifice of peace offerings; and the priest shall burn it upon the altar for a sweet savor unto the LORD; and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and it shall be **forgiven** him...He shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat of the lamb is taken away from the sacrifice of the peace offerings; and the priest shall burn them upon the altar, according to the offerings made by fire unto the LORD: and the priest shall make an atonement for his sin that he has committed, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Levi 4:20-35

And he shall offer the second for a burnt offering, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an atonement for him for his sin which he has sinned, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 5:10

And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he has sinned in one of these, and it shall be **forgiven** him: and the remnant shall be the priest's as a meat offering... And he shall make amends for the harm that he has done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest; and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be **forgiven** him...And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with your estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and knew it not, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 5:13, 16, 18

And the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD: and it shall be **forgiven** him for any thing of all that he has done in trespassing therein. Leviticus 6:7

The priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering before the LORD for his sin which he has done; and the sin which he has done shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 19:22

The LORD [YEHOVAH] is longsuffering, and of great mercy, **forgiving** iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech You, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of Your mercy, and as You have **forgiven** this people, from Egypt even until now. Numbers 14:18-19

The priest shall make an atonement for all the congregation of the children of Israel, and it shall be **forgiven** them; for it is ignorance: and they shall bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their ignorance. And it shall be **forgiven** all the congregation of the children of Israel, and the stranger that sojourns among them; seeing all the people were in ignorance...The priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sins ignorantly, when he sins by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be **forgiven** him. Numbers 15:26, 28

But if her father disallow her in the day that he hears; not any of her vows, or of her bonds wherewith she has bound her soul, shall stand: and the LORD shall **forgive** her, because her father disallowed her...But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he heard it; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul, of none effect; and the LORD shall **forgive** her. Numbers 30:5, 8

But if her husband has utterly made them void on the day he heard them; then whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband has made them void; and the LORD shall **forgive** her. Numbers 30:12

Be merciful, O LORD, unto Your people Israel, whom You have redeemed, and lay not innocent blood unto Your people of Israel's charge. And the blood shall be **forgiven** them. Deuteronomy 21:8

And Joshua said unto the people, You cannot serve the LORD: for He is an holy God; He is a jealous God; He will not **forgive** your transgressions nor your sins. Joshua 24:19

I pray you, **forgive** the trespass of your handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fights the battles of the LORD, and evil has not been found in you all your days. 1 Samuel 25:28

And hearken to the supplication of Your servant, and of Your people Israel, when they shall pray toward this place: and hear You in heaven Your dwelling place: and when You hear, **forgive**...Then hear You in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of Your people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which You gave unto their fathers...Then hear You in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of Your servants, and of Your people Israel, that You teach them the good way wherein they should walk, and give rain upon Your land, which You have given to Your people for an inheritance...Then hear You in heaven Your dwelling place, and **forgive**, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart you know; (for You, even You only, know the hearts of all the children of men;) 1 Kings 8:30, 34, 36, 39

And **forgive** Your people that have sinned against You, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against You, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them... 1 Kings 8:50

Hearken therefore unto the supplications of Your servant, and of Your people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear You from Your dwelling place, even from heaven; and when You hear, **forgive**. 2 Chronicles 6:21

Then hear from the heavens, and **forgive** the sin of Your people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which You gave to them and to their fathers. 2 Chronicles 6:25

Then hear from heaven, and **forgive** the sin of Your servants, and of Your people Israel, when You have taught them the good way, wherein they should walk; and send rain upon Your land, which You have given unto Your people for an inheritance. 2 Chronicles 6:27

Then hear from heaven Your dwelling place, and **forgive**, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart You know; (for You only know the hearts of the children of men:) 2 Chronicles 6:30

If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will **forgive** their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and **forgive** all my sins. Psalm 25:18

Blessed is he whose transgression is **forgiven**, whose sin is covered. Psalm 32:1

You have **forgiven** the iniquity of Your people, You have covered all their sin. Selah. Psalm 85:2

Be merciful unto me, O Lord: for I cry unto you daily. Rejoice the soul of Your servant: for unto You, O Lord, do I lift up my soul. For You, Lord, are good, and ready to **forgive**; and plentiful in mercy unto all them that call upon You. Psalm 86:3-5

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who **forgives** all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases; Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's. Psalm 103:1-5

If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? But there is **forgiveness** with You, that You may be feared. Psalm 130:4

And the mean man bows down [to idols], and the great man humbles himself; therefore **forgive** them not. Isaiah 2:9

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be **forgiven** their iniquity. Isaiah 33:24

Yet, LORD, You know all their counsel against me to slay me: **forgive** not their iniquity, neither blot out their sin from Your sight, but let them be overthrown before You Jer 18:23

And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know Me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, says the LORD: for I will **forgive** their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more. Jeremiah 31:34

It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the evil which I purpose to do unto them; that they may return every man from his evil way; that I may **forgive** their iniquity and their sin. Jeremiah 36:3

To the Lord our God belong mercies and **forgivenesses**, though we have rebelled against Him...O Lord, hear; O Lord, **forgive**; O Lord, hearken and do; defer not, for Your own sake, O my God: for Your city and Your people are called by Your name. Daniel 9:9, 19

And it came to pass, that when they had made an end of eating the grass of the land, then I said, O Lord GOD, **forgive**, I beseech You: by whom shall Jacob arise? For he is small. Amos 7:2

FORGIVENESS IN NEW COVENANT

After this manner therefore pray: Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And **forgive** us our debts, as we **forgive** our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For Yours is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen. For if you **forgive** men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also **forgive** you: But if you **forgive** not men their trespasses, neither will your Father **forgive** your trespasses. Matthew 6:9-15

And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus [Yeshua] seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; your sins be **forgiven** you. Matthew 9:2

For whether is easier, to say, Your sins be **forgiven** you; or to say, Arise, and walk? Matthew 9:5

But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to **forgive** sins, (then said He to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up your bed, and go unto your house. Matthew 9:6

Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be **forgiven** unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be **forgiven** unto men. And whoever speaks a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whoever speaks against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be **forgiven** him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. M 12:31-32

Peter...said, Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me, and I **forgive** him? Till seven times? Jesus said unto him, I say not unto you, Until seven times: but, Until seventy times seven... Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O you wicked servant, I **forgave** you all that debt, because you desired me to: Should not you also have had compassion on your fellow servant, even as I had pity on you? And his lord...delivered him to the tormentors...So likewise shall My heavenly Father do also unto you, if you from your hearts **forgive** not every one his brother their trespasses. Mt 18:21-22, 35

When Jesus saw their faith, He said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, your sins be **forgiven** you... Why does this man thus speak blasphemies? Who can **forgive** sins but God only? ... Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, Your sins be **forgiven** you; or to say, Arise, and take up your bed, and walk? But that you may know that the Son of man has power on earth to forgive sins, (He said to the sick of the palsy,)... Mark 2:5, 7, 9-10

Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be **forgiven** unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost never has **forgiveness**, but is in danger of eternal damnation... Mark 3:28-29

That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be **forgiven** them. Mark 4:12

And when you stand praying, **forgive**, if you have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not **forgive**, neither will your Father which is in heaven **forgive** your trespasses. Mark 11:25-26

And when He saw their faith, He said unto him, Man, your sins are **forgiven** you. And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaks blasphemies? Who can **forgive** sins, but God alone? Luke 5:20-21

Whether is easier, to say, Your sins be **forgiven** you; or to say, Rise up and walk? But that you may know that the Son of man has power upon earth to **forgive** sins, (He said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto you, Arise, and take up your couch, and go into your house. Luke 5:23-24

Judge not, and you shall not be judged: condemn not, and you shall not be condemned: **forgive**, and you shall be **forgiven**: Luke 6:37

Wherefore I say unto you, Her sins, which are many, are **forgiven**; for she loved much: but to whom little is **forgiven**, the same loves little. And He said unto her, Your sins are **forgiven**. And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that **forgives** sins also? Luke 7:47-49

It came to pass, that, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, one of His disciples said unto him, Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples. And He said unto them, When you pray, say, Our Father who is in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your Kingdom come. Your will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Give us day by day our daily bread. And **forgive** us our sins; for we also **forgive** every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Luke 11:1-4

And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be **forgiven** him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be **forgiven**. Luke 12:10

Take heed to yourselves: If your brother trespass against you, rebuke him; and if he repent, **forgive** him. And if he trespass against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to you, saying, I repent; you shall **forgive** him. Luke 17:3-4

When they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then said Jesus, Father, **forgive** them; for they know not what they do. And they parted His raiment, and cast lots. Luke 23:33-34

Men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the **forgiveness** of sins...Him has God exalted with His right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, for to give repentance to Israel, and **forgiveness** of sins. Acts 13:38, 5:31

Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of your heart may be **forgiven** you. Acts 8:22

I am Jesus...I have appeared unto you...to make you a minister and a witness both of these things which you have seen, and of those things in the which I will appear unto you; Delivering you from the people, and from the Gentiles, unto whom now I send you, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive **forgiveness** of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in Me. Acts 26:18

Blessed are they whose iniquities are **forgiven**, and whose sins are covered. Romans 4:7

...So that contrariwise you ought rather to **forgive** him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. 2 Corinthians 2:7

To whom you **forgive** any thing, I **forgive** also: for if I **forgave** any thing, to whom I **forgave** it, for your sakes **forgave** I it in the person of Christ... 2 Corinthians 2:10

For what is it wherein you were inferior to other churches, except it be that I myself was not burdensome to you? **Forgive** me this wrong. 2 Corinthians 12:13

In whom we have redemption through His blood, the **forgiveness** of sins, according to the riches of His grace... Ephesians 1:7

And be you kind one to another, tenderhearted, **forgiving** one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

In whom we have redemption through His blood, even the **forgiveness** of sins... Colossians 1:14

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, has He quickened together with Him, having **forgiven** you all trespasses; Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross; And having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it. Colossians 2:13-15

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be **forgiven** him. James 5:15

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to **forgive** us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

I write unto you, little children, because your sins are **forgiven** you for His name's sake. 1 John 2:12

REPENT

God is not a man, that He should lie; neither the son of man that He should **repent**: has He said, and shall He not do it? Or has He spoken, and shall He not make it good? Numbers 23:19

For the LORD shall judge His people, and **repent** Himself for His servants, when He sees that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left. Deuteronomy 32:36

The Strength of Israel will not lie nor **repent**: for He is not a man, that He should repent. 1 Samuel 15:29

If they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and **repent**, and make supplication unto You in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness; And so return unto you with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captives, and pray unto You toward their land, which You gave unto their fathers, the city which You have chosen, and the house which I have built for Your name: Then hear You their prayer and their supplication in heaven Your dwelling place, and maintain their cause, and forgive Your people that have sinned against You, and all their transgressions .. 1 Kings 8:47-50

I abhor myself, and **repent** in dust and ashes. Job 42:6

The LORD has sworn, and will not **repent**, You are a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. Psalm 110:4

For this shall the earth mourn, and the heavens above be black: because I have spoken it, I have purposed it, and will not **repent**, neither will I turn back from it. Jeremiah 4:28

No man **repented** him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? Every one turned to his course, as the horse rushes into the battle...If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will **repent** of the evil that I thought to do unto them. And at what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it; If it do evil in My sight, that it obey not My voice, then I will **repent** of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them. Jeremiah 8:6, 18:8-10

Let that man be as the cities which the LORD overthrew, and **repented** not: and let him hear the cry in the morning, and the shouting at noontide; Because he slew me not from the womb... Jeremiah 20:16-17

If so be they will hearken, and turn every man from his evil way, that I may **repent** Me of the evil, which I purpose to do unto them because of the evil of their doings...Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and obey the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will **repent** him of the evil that He has pronounced against you. Jeremiah 26:3, 13

Surely after that I was turned, I **repented**; and after that I was instructed, I smote upon my thigh... Jeremiah 31:19

If you will still abide in this land, then will I build you, and not pull you down, and I will plant you, and not pluck you up: for I **repent** Me of the evil that I have done unto you. Jeremiah 42:10

Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD; **Repent**, and turn yourselves from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations...I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, says the Lord GOD. **Repent**, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Ezekiel 14:6, 18:30

I the LORD have spoken it: it shall come to pass, and I will do it, I will not go back, neither will I spare, neither will I **repent**; according to your ways, and according to your doings, shall they judge you, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 24:14

I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be your plagues; O grave, I will be your destruction: **repentance** shall be hid from My eyes. Hosea 13:14

Who knows if He will return and **repent**, and leave a blessing behind Him; even a meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God? Joel 2:14

Who can tell if God will turn and **repent**, and turn away from His fierce anger, that we perish not? Jonah 3:9

REPENTANCE IN THE NEW COVENANT

John...**Repent** you: for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand... Bring forth therefore fruits meet for **repentance**...I indeed baptize you with water unto **repentance**: but He that comes after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: He shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire. Matthew 3:2, 8, 11

From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent**: for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. Matthew 4:17

Go you and learn what that means, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to **repentance**. Matthew 9:13

Then began He to upbraid the cities wherein most of His mighty works were done, because they **repented** not: Woe unto you, Chorazin! Woe unto you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have **repented** long ago in sackcloth and ashes. Mt 11:20-21

The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they **repented** at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here. Matthew 12:41

But what think you? A certain man had two sons; and he came to the first and said, Son, go work to-day in my vineyard. He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he **repented**, and went. And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not. Which of them did the will of his father? They said unto Him, the first. Jesus said unto them, Truly I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the Kingdom of God before you. For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and you believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and you, when you had seen it, repented not afterward, that you might believe him. Matthew 21:28-32

Then Judas, which had betrayed Him, when he saw that he was condemned, **repented** himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. Mt 26:3-4

John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of **repentance** for the remission of sins...After that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: **repent** you, and believe the gospel. Mark 1:4, 14-15

When Jesus heard it, He said unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick, I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to **repentance**. Mark 2:17

They went out, and preached that men should **repent**. Mark 6:12

He came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of **repentance** for the remission of sins... Luke 3:3

Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of **repentance**, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. Luke 3:8

I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to **repentance**. Luke 5:32

Woe unto you, Chorazin! Woe unto you, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago **repented**, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. Luke 10:13

There were present at that season some that told Him of the Galileans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose you that these Galileans were sinners above all the Galileans, because they suffered such things? I tell you, No; but, except you **repent**, you shall all likewise perish. Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think you that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem? I tell you, No: but, except you **repent**, you shall all likewise perish. Luke 13:1-5

I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that **repents**, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no **repentance**...I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that **repents**. Luke 15:7, 10

Take heed to yourselves: If your brother trespass against you, rebuke him; and if he **repent**, forgive him. And if he trespass against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to you, saying, I **repent**; you shall forgive him. Luke 17:3-4

Abraham said unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. And he said, No, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will **repent**. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. Luke 16:29-31

Jesus...said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ [the Messiah] to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: and that **repentance** and remission of sins should be preached in His name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And you are witnesses of these things. Luke 24:46-48

Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:38

Repent you therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord... Acts 3:19

The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you slew and hanged on a tree. Him has God exalted with His right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, for to give **repentance** to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. Acts 5:30-31

Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you. Acts 8:22

When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then has God also to the Gentiles granted **repentance** unto life. Acts 11:18

Of this man's seed has God according to His promise raised unto Israel a Savior, Jesus: When John had first preached before His coming the baptism of **repentance** to all the people of Israel. Acts 13:23-24

The times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commands all men every where to **repent**: because He has appointed a day, in the which He will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom He has ordained; whereof He has given assurance unto all men, in that He has raised Him from the dead. Acts 17:30-31

John verily baptized with the baptism of **repentance**, saying unto the people, that they should believe on Him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus [Yeshua the Messiah]. Acts 19:4

Paul...serving the Lord with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews...I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shown you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house, testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, **repentance** toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:19-21

O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should **repent** and turn to God, and do works meet for **repentance**. Acts 26:19-20

Despise you the riches of His goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to **repentance**? Romans 2:4

For the gifts and calling of God are without **repentance**. Romans 11:29

For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not **repent**, though I did **repent**: for I perceive that the same epistle has made you sorry, though it were but for a season. Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that you sorrowed to **repentance**: for you were made sorry after a godly manner, that you might receive damage by us in nothing. For godly sorrow works **repentance** to salvation not to be **repented** of: but the sorrow of the world works death. 2 Corinthians 7:8-10

Many which have sinned already, and have not **repented** of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness... 2 Cor 12:21

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God perhaps will give them **repentance** to the acknowledging of the truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:24-26

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of **repentance** from dead works, and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. And this will we do, if God permit. Hebrews 6:1-3

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, if they shall fall away, to renew them again unto **repentance**; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put Him to an open shame. Hebrews 4:4-6

The Lord swore and will not **repent**, You are a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec... Hebrews 7:21

For you know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of **repentance**, though he sought it carefully with tears. Hebrews 12:17

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to **repentance**. 2 Peter 3:9

Remember therefore from whence you are fallen, and **repent**, and do the first works; or else I will come unto you quickly, and will remove your candlestick out of his place, except you **repent**. Revelation 2:5

Repent; or else I will come unto you quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth. Revelation 2:16

Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and hold fast, and **repent**. If therefore you shall not watch, I will come on you as a thief, and you shall not know what hour I come upon you....As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and **repent**. Revelation 3:3, 19

The rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet **repented** not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: Neither **repented** they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts. Revelation 9:20-21

And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which had power over these plagues: and they **repented** not to give Him glory. And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, and blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and **repented** not of their deeds. Revelation 16:9-11

TURN TO AND TURN FROM

The men **turned** their faces from thence, and went toward Sodom: but Abraham stood yet before the LORD. Genesis 18:22

Tarry with him a few days, until your brother's fury **turn** away... Genesis 27:44

Turn you not unto idols, nor make to yourselves molten gods: I am the LORD your God... The soul that **turns** after such as have familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set My face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people. Leviticus 19:4, 20:6

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and you **turn** aside, and serve other gods, and worship them... Deuteronomy 11:16

Do I make this covenant... Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart **turns** away this day from the LORD [YEHOVAH] our God, to go and serve the gods of these nations... Deuteronomy 29:14, 18

But if your heart **turn** away, so that you will not hear, but shall be drawn away, and worship other gods, and serve them; I denounce unto you this day, that you shall surely perish... Deut 30:17-18

O Lord, what shall I say, when Israel **turns** their backs before their enemies! Joshua 7:8

Samuel said... Fear not: you have done all this wickedness: yet **turn** not aside from following the LORD, but serve the LORD with all your heart; **Turn** you not aside: for then should you go after vain things, which cannot profit nor deliver; for they are vain... Now therefore, I pray you, pardon my sin, and **turn** again with me, that I may worship the LORD. And Samuel said unto Saul, I will not return with you. 1 Samuel 12:20-21, 15:25-26

Keep the charge of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, and His commandments, and His judgments, and His testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do, and whithersoever you **turn** yourself... 1 Kings 2:3

O LORD God, **turn** not away the face of Your anointed, remember the mercies of David Your servant...When they in their trouble did **turn** unto the LORD God of Israel, and sought Him, He was found of them. 2 Chronicles 6:42, 15:4

For our fathers have trespassed, and done that which was evil in the eyes of the LORD our God, and have forsaken Him, and have **turned** away their faces from the habitation of the LORD, and turned their backs...Now it is in my heart to make a covenant with the LORD God of Israel, that His fierce wrath may **turn** away from us. 2 Chronicles 29:6, 10

Zedekiah...also rebelled against king Nebuchadnezzar, who had made him swear by God: but he stiffened his neck, and hardened his heart from **turning** unto the LORD God of Israel. 2 Chronicles 36:11, 13

Hear, O our God; for we are despised: and **turn** their reproach upon their own head, and give them for a prey in the land of captivity... Nehemiah 4:4

My brethren have dealt deceitfully as a brook, and as th stream of brooks they pass away...The paths of their way are **turned** aside; they go to nothing, and perish. Job 6:15, 18

God has delivered me to the ungodly, and **turned** me over into the hands of the wicked. Job 16:11

They **turn** the needy out of the way: the poor of the earth hide themselves together. Job 24:4

My harp also is **turned** to mourning, and my organ into the voice of them that weep. Job 30:31

He strikes them as wicked men in the open sight of others; Because they **turned** back from Him, and would not consider any of His ways: So that they cause the cry of the poor to come unto Him, and He hears the cry of the afflicted. Job 34:28

O you sons of men, how long will you **turn** My glory into shame; how long will you love vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah. But know that the LORD has set apart him that is godly for Himself: the LORD will hear when I call unto Him. Psalm 4:2-3

God judges the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day. If he **turn** not, He will whet His sword; He has bent His bow, and made it ready...Psalm 7:11-12

When my enemies are **turned** back, they shall fall and perish at Your presence...The wicked shall be **turned** into hell, and all the nations that forget God. Psalm 9:3, 17

I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I **turn** again till they were consumed. I have wounded them that they were not able to rise: they are fallen under my feet. Psalm 18:37-38

All the ends of the world shall remember and **turn** unto the LORD: and all the kindreds of the nations shall worship before You. Psalm 22:27

Turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; for I am desolate and afflicted. Psalm 25:16

Blessed is that man that makes the LORD his trust, and respects not the proud, nor such as **turn** aside to lies. Psalm 40:4

You make us to **turn** back from the enemy: and they which hate us spoil for themselves. Psalm 44:10

When I cry unto You, then shall mine enemies **turn** back: this I know; for God is for me. Psalm 56:9

O GOD, You have cast us off, You have scattered us, You have been displeased; O **turn** Yourself to us again...Hear me, O LORD; for Your loving kindness is good: **turn** unto me according to the multitude of Your tender mercies. Ps 60:1, 69:16

Let them be **turned** back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha...The children of Ephraim, being armed, and carrying bows, **turned** back in the day of battle...Yes, they **turned** back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel...They...**turned** back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers: they were turned aside like a deceitful bow. Psalm 70:3, 78:9, 41, 57

Turn us again, O God, and cause Your face to shine; and we shall be saved...**Turn** us again... Psalm 80: 3, 19

I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for He will speak peace unto His people, and to His saints: but let them not **turn** again to folly. Psalm 85:8

Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause Your anger toward us to cease. Psalm 85:4

You **turn** man to destruction; and say, **Return**, you children of men. Psalm 90:3

I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that **turn** aside; it shall not cleave to me. Psalm 101:3

He **turned** their heart to hate His people, to deal subtilly with His servants. Psalm 105:25

Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken me in Your way...**Turn** away my reproach which I fear; for Your judgments are good. Psalm 119:37, 39

I thought on my ways, and **turned** my feet unto your testimonies... Let those that fear You **turn** unto me, and those that have known Your testimonies. Psalm 119:59, 79

As for such as **turn** aside unto their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them forth with the workers of iniquity: but peace shall be upon Israel. Psalm 125:5

Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south. Psalm 126:4

Let them all be confounded and **turned** back that hate Zion. Psalm 129:5

For Your servant David's sake **turn** not away the face of Your anointed. Psalm 132:10

The LORD preserves the strangers; He relieves the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked He **turns** upside down. Psalm 146:9

For the **turning** away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them. Proverbs 1:32

Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men. Avoid it, pass not by it, **turn** from it, and pass away...**Turn** not to the right hand nor to the left: remove your foot from evil. Proverbs 4:14-15, 27

Wisdom...cries upon the highest places of the city... Whoso is simple, let him **turn** in hither: as for him that wants understanding, she said to him, Come, eat of my bread, and drink of the wine which I have mingled. Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding. Proverbs 9:1, 3-16

A soft answer **turns** away wrath: but grievous words stir up anger. Proverbs 15:1

A gift is as a precious stone in the eyes of him that has it: whithersoever it **turns**, it prospers. Proverbs 17:8

The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water; He **turns** it whithersoever He will. Proverbs 21:1

Rejoice not when your enemy falls, and let not your heart be glad when he stumbles: Lest the LORD see it, and it displease Him, and He **turn** away His wrath from him...Debate your cause with your neighbor himself; and discover not a secret to another: Lest he that hears it put you to shame, and your infamy **turn** not away. Proverbs 24:17-18, 25:9-10

As the door **turns** upon his hinges, so does the slothful upon his bed. Proverbs 26:14

Scornful men bring a city into a snare: but wise men **turn** away wrath. Proverbs 29:8

The wind goes toward the south, and **turns** about unto the north; it whirls about continually, and the wind **returns** again according to his circuits. Ecclesiastes 1:6

I will **turn** My hand upon you, and purely purge away your dross, and take away all your tin... Isaiah 1:25

For the people **turn** not unto him that smite them, neither do they seek the LORD of hosts...**Turn** you unto Him from whom the children of Israel have deeply revolted. Isaiah 9:13; 31:6

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off: that make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproves in the gate, and **turn** aside the just for a thing of nought. Isaiah 29:20-21

This is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the LORD: Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophecy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits: Get you out of the way, **turn** aside out of the path, cause the Holy One of Israel to cease from before us. Isaiah 30:9-11

Though the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not your teachers be removed into a corner any more, but your eyes shall see your teachers: And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, This is the way, walk you in it, when you **turn** to the right hand, and when you **turn** to the left. Isaiah 30:20-21

Thus says the LORD, Your redeemer, and He that formed you from the womb, I am the LORD that makes all things, that stretches forth the heavens alone; that spreads abroad the earth by Myself; That frustrates the tokens of the liars, and makes diviners mad; that **turns** wise men backward, and makes their knowledge foolish... Isaiah 44:24-25

The Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that **turn** from transgression in Jacob, says the LORD. Isaiah 59:20

They hearkened not, nor inclined their ear to **turn** from their wickedness, to burn no incense unto other gods. Jeremiah 44:5

I have surely heard Ephraim bemoaning himself thus; You have chastised me, and I was chastised, as a bullock unaccustomed to the yoke; You **turn** me, and I shall be **turned**; for You are the LORD my God...Set you up waymarks, make you high heaps: set your heart toward the highway, even the way which you went: **turn** again, O virgin of Israel, **turn** again to these your cities. Jeremiah 31:18, 21

Jerusalem has grievously sinned; therefore she is removed: all that honored her despise her, because they have seen her nakedness: yes, she sighs, and **turns** backward. Lamentations 1:8

Surely against me is he **turned**; He **turns** His hand against me all the day. Lamentations 3:3

For the Lord will not cast off for ever: For though He cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of His mercies. For He does not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men. To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth, To **turn** aside the right of a man before the face of the most High, To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approves not. Lamentations 3:32-35

Let us search and try our ways, and **turn** again to the LORD. Lamentations 3:40

Our inheritance is **turned** to strangers, our houses to aliens... **Turn** us unto You, O LORD, and we shall be **turned**; renew our days as of old. Lamentations 5:2, 21

My face will I **turn** also from them, and they shall pollute My secret place: for the robbers shall enter into it, and defile it. Ezekiel 7:22

Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord GOD; Repent, and turn yourselves from your idols; and **turn** away your faces from all your abominations. Ezekiel 14:6

When a righteous man **turns** away from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, and dies in them; for his iniquity that he has done shall he die. Again, when the wicked man **turns** away from his wickedness that he has committed, and does that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive. Because he considers, and **turns** away from all his transgressions that he has committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die...For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dies, says the Lord GOD: wherefore **turn** yourselves, and live. Ezekiel 18:26-28, 32

Nevertheless, if you warn the wicked of his way to **turn** from it; if he do not **turn** from his way, he shall die in his iniquity; but you have delivered your soul... Ezekiel 33:9

Say unto them, As I live, says the Lord GOD, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked **turn** from his way and live: **turn** you, turn you from your evil ways; for why will you die, O house of Israel? Therefore, you son of man, say unto the children of your people, The righteousness of the righteous shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he **turns** from his wickedness; neither shall the righteous be able to live for his righteousness in the day that he sins... Ezekiel 33:11-12

When the righteous **turns** from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, he shall even die thereby. But if the wicked **turn** from his wickedness, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall live thereby. Ezekiel 33:18-19

For, behold, I am for you, and I will **turn** unto you, and you shall be tilled and sown... Ezekiel 36:9

They that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that **turn** many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever. Daniel 12:3

They will not frame their doings to **turn** unto their God: for the spirit of whoredoms is in the midst of them, and they have not known the LORD. Hosea 5:4

Turn you to your God: keep mercy and judgment, and wait on your God continually. Hosea 12:6

Therefore also now, says the LORD, **turn** you even to Me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning. Joel 2:12

You who **turn** judgment to wormwood, and leave off righteousness in the earth, Seek Him that made the seven stars and Orion, and **turns** the shadow of death into the morning, and makes the day dark with night: that calls for the waters of the sea, and pours them out upon the face of the earth: The LORD is His name... Amos 5:7-8

Who can tell if God will **turn** and repent, and turn away from His fierce anger, that we perish not? Jonah 3:8

For then will I **turn** to the people a pure language, that they may all call upon the name of the LORD, to serve Him with one consent. Zephaniah 3:9

Therefore say you unto them, Thus says the LORD of hosts; **turn** you unto Me, says the LORD of hosts, and I will **turn** unto you, says the LORD of hosts...I will sow them among the people: and they shall remember Me in far countries; and they shall live with their children, and **turn** again. Zechariah 1:3; 10:9

He shall **turn** the heart of the fathers to the children, and the heart of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. Malachi 4:6

TURN TO AND TURN FROM IN THE NEW COVENANT

You have heard that it has been said, An eye for an eye, and a tooth for a tooth: But I say unto you, That you resist not evil: but whosoever shall smite you on your right cheek, **turn** to him the other also...Give to him that asks you, and from him that would borrow of you **turn** not you away. Matthew 5:38-39, 42

Many of the children of Israel shall he **turn** to the Lord their God. And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to **turn** the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:16-17

And into whatsoever house you enter, first say, Peace be to this house. And if the son of peace be there, your peace shall rest upon it: if not, it shall **turn** to you again. Luke 10:5-6

Take heed to yourselves: If your brother trespass against you, rebuke him; and if he repent, forgive him. And if he trespass against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day **turn** again to you, saying, I repent; you shall forgive him. Luke 17:4

Before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for My name's sake. And it shall **turn** to you for a testimony. Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what you shall answer: For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. Luke 21:12-15

Unto You first God, having raised up His Son Jesus, sent Him to bless you, in **turning** away every one of you from his iniquities. Acts 3:26

All that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw Him, and **turned** to the Lord...And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and **turned** unto the Lord. Acts 9:35, 11:21

But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to **turn** away the deputy from the faith. Acts 13:8

I would not, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own conceits, that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be saved: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall **turn** away ungodliness from Jacob. Romans 11:25-26

Even unto this day, when Moses is read, the veil is upon their heart. Nevertheless, when it shall **turn** to the Lord, the veil shall be taken away. 2 Corinthians 3:15-16

But now after that you have known God, or rather are known of God, how **turn** you again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto you desire again to be in bondage? Galatians 4:9

For I know that this shall **turn** to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ... Philippians 1:19

I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house, give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully. For some are already **turned** aside after Satan. 1 Timothy 5:14-15

Men shall be lovers of their own selves...Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such **turn** away. 2 Timothy 3:2, 5

They shall **turn** away their ears from the truth, and shall be **turned** unto fables. 2 Timothy 4:4

Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith; Not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that **turn** from the truth. Titus 1:13-14

But you are come unto mount Zion...to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant...See that you refuse not Him that speaks. For if they escaped not who refused him that spoke on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we **turn** away from Him that speaks from heaven...Hebrews 12:24-25

Every good and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of **turning**. James 1:17

Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may obey us; and we **turn** about their whole body. Behold also the ships, which though they be so great, and are driven of fierce winds, yet are they **turned** about with a very small helm, whither soever the governor lists. James 3:3-4

There are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, **turning** the grace of God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ [Adon Yeshua the Messiah]. Jude 1:4
