ENDURANCE

Let my lord, I pray you, pass over before his servant: and I will lead on softly, according as the cattle that go before me and so the children will be able to **endure**, until I come unto my lord unto Seir. Genesis 33:14

If you shall do this thing, and God command you so, then you shall be able to **endure**, and all this people shall also go to their place in peace. Exodus 18:23

O give thanks unto the LORD; for He is good; for His mercy **endures** for ever...Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because His mercy **endures** for ever...1 Chr 16:34, 41

When they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, and praised the LORD, saying, For He is good; for His mercy **endures** for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the cloud of the house of the LORD... 2 Chronicles 5:13

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshiped, and praised the LORD, saying, For He is good; for His mercy **endures** for ever....The Levites also with instruments of music of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because His mercy **endures** for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded the trumpets before them, and all Israel stood. 2 Chronicles 7:3, 6

When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for His mercy **endures** for ever. 2 Chronicles 20:21

They sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because He is good, for His mercy **endures** for ever toward Israel. And the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. Ezra 3:11 For how can I **endure** to see the evil that shall come unto my people? Or how can I **endure** to see the destruction of my kindred? Esther 8:6

He shall lean upon his house, but it shall not stand: he shall hold it fast, but it shall not **endure**. Job 8:15

If I have lifted up my hand against the fatherless, when I saw my help in the gate: Then let mine arm fall from my shoulder blade, and mine arm be broken from the bone. For destruction from God was a terror to me, and by reason of His highness I could not **endure**. Job 31:23

O you enemy, destructions are come to a perpetual end: and you have destroyed cities; their memorial is perished with them. But the LORD shall **endure** for ever: He has prepared His throne for judgment. And He shall judge the world in righteousness, He shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness. The LORD also will be a refuge for the oppressed, a refuge in times of trouble. And they that know Your name will put their trust in you: for You, LORD, have not forsaken them that seek You. Psalm 9:6-10

The fear of the LORD is clean, **enduring** for ever... Psalm 19:7

Sing unto the LORD, O you saints of His, and give thanks at the remembrance of His holiness. For His anger **endures** but a moment; in His favor is life: weeping may **endure** for a night, but joy comes in the morning. Psalm 30:4-5

Why boast yourself in mischief, O mighty man? The goodness of God **endures** continually. Psalm 52:1

He shall judge the poor of the people, He shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. They shall fear You as long as the sun and moon **endure**, throughout all generations...In His days shall the righteous flourish; and the abundance of peace so long as the moon **endures**. Psalm 72:4-5, 7

His name shall **endure** for ever: His name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in Him: all nations shall call Him blessed. Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only does wondrous things. Psalm 72:17

The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto Him; but their time should have **endured** for ever. Psalm 81:15

My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and My covenant shall stand fast with him. His seed also will I make to **endure** for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven...His seed shall **endure** for ever, and his throne as the sun before Me. Psalm 89:28-29, 36

And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for His mercy endures for ever: But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea; for His mercy endures for ever. To Him which led His people through the wilderness: for His mercy endures for ever. To Him which smote great kings: for His mercy endures for ever: And slew famous kings: for His mercy endures for ever: Sihon king of the Amorites: for His mercy endures for ever: And Og the king of Bashan: for His mercy endures for ever: And gave their land for an heritage: for His mercy endures for ever: Even an heritage unto Israel His servant: for His mercy endures for ever. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, says the LORD. Jeremiah 33:10-11

Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at your dishonest gain which you have made, and at your blood which has been in the midst of you. Can your heart **endure**, or can your hands be strong, in the days that I shall deal with you? I the LORD have spoken it, and will do it. Ezekiel 22:13-14

Be you therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves. But beware of men... And you shall be hated of all men for My name's sake: but he that **endures** to the end shall be saved. Matt 10:16, 22

And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many. And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold. But he that shall **endure** unto the end, the same shall be saved. Matthew 24:11-13

These are they likewise which are sown on stony ground; who, when they have heard the word, immediately receive it with gladness; And have no root in themselves, and so **endure** but for a time: afterward, when affliction or persecution arises for the word's sake, immediately they are offended. Mark 4:16-17

The brother shall betray the brother to death, and the father the son; and children shall rise up against their parents, and shall cause them to be put to death. And you shall be hated of all men for My name's sake: but he that shall **endure** unto the end, the same shall be saved. Mark 13:12-13

Labor not for the meat which perishes, but for that meat which **endures** unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for Him has God the Father sealed. John 6:27

What if God, willing to show His wrath, and to make His power known, **endured** with much longsuffering the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction... Romans 9:22

Though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profits me nothing. Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity vaunts not itself, is not puffed up, Does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil; Rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth. Bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, **endures** all things. 1 Corinthians 13:3-7

And whether we are afflicted, it is for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in **enduring** the same sufferings which we also suffer; or whether we are comforted, it is for your consolation and salvation. 2 Corinthians 1:6

So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you **endure**: Which is a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that you may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which you also suffer: Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you; And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction... 2 Thessalonians 1:4-9

Be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. And the things that you have heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. Therefore **endure** hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. No man that wars entangles himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please Him who has chosen him to be a soldier. And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully. 2 Timothy 2:3

Therefore I **endure** all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. It is a faithful saying: For if we are dead with Him, we shall also live with Him: If we suffer, we shall also reign with Him: if we deny Him, He also will deny us... 2 Timothy 2:10-12

You have fully known my...patience, persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I **endured**: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. 2 Timothy 3:11

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine. For the time will come when they will not **endure** sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. But you are to watch in all things, **endure** afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, make full proof of your ministry. 2 Timothy 4:2-5

Be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises...So, after he had patiently **endured**, he obtained the promise. Hebrews 6:12, 15

Vengeance belongs unto Me, I will recompense, says the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge His people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. But call to remembrance the former days, in which, after you were illuminated, you **endured** a great fight of afflictions...For you had compassion of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that you have in heaven a better and an **enduring** substance. Hebrews 10:30-32

By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he **endured**, as seeing Him who is invisible. Hebrews 11:27

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him **endured** the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. For consider Him that **endured** such contradiction of sinners against himself, lest you be wearied and faint in your minds. Hebrews 12:3

My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when you are rebuked of Him: For whom the Lord loves He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives. If you **endure** chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chastens not? Hebrews 12:5-7

For you are not come unto the mount that might be touched, and that burned with fire, nor unto blackness, and darkness, and tempest, and the sound of a trumpet, and the voice of words; which voice they that heard intreated that the word should not be spoken to them anymore: (For they could not **endure** that which was commanded, And if so much as a beast touch the mountain, it shall be stoned, or thrust through with a dart: and so terrible was the sight, that Moses said, I exceedingly fear and quake:) Hebrews 12:18-21

Blessed is the man that **endures** temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life... James 1:12

Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest you be condemned: behold, the judge stands before the door. Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of patience. Behold, we count them happy which **endure**. You have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. James 5:9-11

Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which lives and abides for ever. For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withers, and the flower thereof falls away: But the word of the Lord **endures** for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you. 1 Peter 1:23-25

Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward. For this is thankworthy, if a man for conscience toward God **endure** grief, suffering wrongfully. For what glory is it, if, when you are buffeted for your faults, you shall take it patiently? but if, when you do well, and suffer for it, you take it patiently, this is acceptable with God. 1 Peter 2:18-19

FORBEAR

If you see the ass of him that hates you lying under his burden, and would **forbear** to help him, you shall surely help with him. Exodus 23:5

But the man that is clean, and is not in a journey, and **forbears** to keep the Passover, even the same soul shall be cut off from among his people: because he brought not the offering of the LORD in his appointed season, that man shall bear his sin. Numbers 9:13

When you shall vow a vow unto the LORD your God, you shall not slack to pay it: for the LORD your God will surely require it of you; and it would be sin in you. But if you shall **forbear** to vow, it shall be no sin in you. Deuteronomy 23:22

Then David and his men, which were about six hundred, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped from Keilah; and he **forbare** to go forth. 1 Samuel 23:13

Then the king of Israel gathered the prophets together, about four hundred men, and said unto them, shall I go against Ramoth-gilead to battle, or shall I **forbear**? And they said, Go up; for the Lord shall deliver it into the hand of the king. 1 Kings 22:6

So he came to the king. And the king said unto him, Micaiah, shall we go against Ramoth-gilead to battle, or shall we **forbear**? And he answered him, Go, and prosper: for the LORD shall deliver it into the hand of the king...and he said, I saw all Israel scattered upon the hills, as sheep that have no shepherd. 1 Kings 22:15, 17 see also 2 Chronicles 18:5, 14

It came to pass, as he talked with him, that the king said unto him, Are you made of the king's counsel? **Forbear**; why should you be smitten? Then the prophet **forbare**, and said, I know that God has determined to destroy you, because you have done this, and have not hearkened unto my counsel. 2 Chronicles 25:16

FORBEARING

But he sent ambassadors to him, saying, What have I to do with you, thou king of Judah? I come not against you this day, but against the house wherewith I have war: for God commanded me to make haste: **forbear** you from meddling with God, who is with me, that He destroy you not. 2 Chronicles 35:21

Yet many years did you **forbear** them, and testified against them by Your spirit in the prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gave you them into the hands of the people of the lands. Nehemiah 9:30

Though I speak, my grief is not assuaged: and though I **forbear**, what am I eased? Job 16:6

If you **forbear** to deliver them that are drawn unto death, and those that are ready to be slain; If you say, Behold, we knew it not; does not He that ponders the heart consider it? And He that keeps your soul, does not He know it? And shall not He render to every man according to his works? Proverbs 24:11

By long **forbearing** is a prince persuaded, and a soft tongue breaks the bone. Proverbs 25:15

Then said I, I will not make mention of Him, nor speak any more in His name. But His word was in mine heart as a burning fire shut up in my bones, and I was weary with **forbearing**, and I could not stay. Jeremiah 20:9

Now, behold, I loose you this day from the chains which were upon your hand. If it seem good unto you to come with me into Babylon, come; and I will look well unto you: but if it seem ill unto you to come with me into Babylon, **forbear**: behold, all the land is before you: whither it see good and convenient for you to go, thither go. Jeremiah 40:4

But ten men were found among them that said unto Ishmael, Slay us not: for we have treasures in the field, of wheat, and of barley, and of oil, and of honey. So he **forbare**, and slew them not among their brethren. Jeremiah 41:8

And they, whether they will hear, or whether they will **forbear**, (for they are a rebellious house,) yet shall know that there has been a prophet among them...And you shall speak My words unto them, whether they will hear, or whether they will **forbear**: for they are most rebellious...Go, get you to them of the captivity, unto the children of your people, and speak unto them, and tell them, Thus says the Lord GOD; whether they will hear, or whether they will **forbear**. Ezekiel 2:5, 7, 3: 11

But when I speak with you, I will open your mouth, and you shall say unto them, Thus says the Lord GOD; He that hears, let him hear; and he that **forbears**, let him **forbear**: for they are a rebellious house. Ezekiel 3:27

Forbear to cry, make no mourning for the dead, bind the tire of your head upon you, and put on your shoes upon your feet, and cover not your lips, and eat not the break of men. So I spake unto the people in the morning: and at even my wife died; and I did in the morning as I was commanded. Ezekiel 24:17-18

I said unto them, If you think good, give me my price; and if not, **forbear**. So they weighed for my price thirty pieces of silver. Zechariah 11:12

Or despise you the riches of His goodness and **forbearance** and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? Romans 2:4

Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the **forbearance** of God. Romans 3:25

Have we not power to lead about a sister, a wife, as well as other apostles, and as the brethren of the Lord, and Cephas? Or I only and Barnabas, have not we power to **forbear** working? 1 Corinthians 9:6

For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but now I **forbear**, lest any man should think of me above that which he sees me to be, or that he hears of me. 2 Corinthians 12:6

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beesech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, **forbearing** one another in love; Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:2

You masters, do the same unto them, **forbearing** threatening: knowing that your Master also is in heaven; neither is there respect of persons with Him. Ephesians 6:9

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; **Forbearing** one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Messiah forgave you, so also do you. Colossians 3:13

Wherefore when we could no longer **forbear**, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone; And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellow-laborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith: That no man should be moved by these afflictions; for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto, For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and you know. For this cause, when I could no longer **forbear**, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labor be in vain. 1 Thessalonians 3:1, 5

HOPE

Turn again, my daughters, go your way; for I am too old to have an husband. If I should say, I have **hope**, if I should have an husband also to night, and should also bear sons; Would you tarry for them till they were grown? Would you stay for them from having husbands? Nay, my daughters; for it grieves me much for your sakes that the hand of the LORD is gone out against me. And they lifted up their voice, and wept again: and Orpah kissed her mother-in-law; but Ruth clave unto her. Ruth 1:11-14

We have trespassed against our God, and have taken strange wives of the people of the land: yet now there is **hope** in Israel concerning this thing...Therefore make confession unto the LORD God of your fathers, and do His pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives. Ezra 10:2, 11

Now in the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews **hoped** to have power over them, (though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them;) Esther 9:1

So the poor has **hope**, and iniquity stops her mouth. Behold, happy is the man whom God corrects: therefore despise not the chastening of the Almighty. Job 5:16-17

What is my strength, that I should **hope**? and what is mine end, that I should prolong my life? Is my strength the strength of stones? or is my flesh of brass? Is not my help in me? and is wisdom driven quite from me? Job 6:11

The paths of their way are turned aside; they go to nothing, and perish. The troops of Tema looked, the companies of Sheba waited for them. They were confounded because they had **hoped**; they came thither, and were ashamed. Job 6:18-20

My days are swifter than a weaver's shuttle, and are spent without **hope**. O remember that my life is wind: mine eye shall no more see good. The eye of him that has seen me shall see me no more: your eyes are upon me, and I am not. Job 7:6-8

Can the rush grow up without mire? Can the flag grow without water? Whilst it is yet in his greenness, and not cut down, it withers before any other herb. So are the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's **hope** shall perish: whose **hope** shall be cut off, and whose trust shall be a spider's web. Job 8:11-14

You shall be secure, because there is **hope**; yes, you shall dig about yourself, and you shall take your rest in safety. Also you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid; yes, many shall make suit unto you. But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape, and their **hope** shall be as the giving up of the ghost. Job 11:18-20

For there is **hope** of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the tender branch thereof will not cease... Yet through the scent of water it will bud, and bring forth boughs like a plant. But man dies, and wastes away: yes, man gives up the ghost, and where is he? Job 14:7, 9-10

The waters wear the stones: you wash away the things which grow out of the dust of the earth; and you destroy the **hope** of man. You prevail for ever against him, and he passes: you change his countenance, and send him away. Job 14:19-20

I have said to corruption, You are my father: to the worm, You are my mother, and my sister. And where is now my **hope**? as for my **hope**, who shall see it? Job 17:14-15

He has fenced up my way that I cannot pass, and He has set darkness in my paths. He has stripped me of my glory, and taken the crown from my head. He has destroyed me on every side, and I am gone: and mine **hope** has he removed like a tree. Job 19:8-10

For what is the **hope** of the hypocrite, though he has gained, when God takes away his soul? Will God hear his cry when trouble comes upon him? Job 27:8-9

If I have made gold my **hope**, or have said to the fine gold, You are my confidence; If I rejoiced because my wealth was great, and because mine hand had gotten much...This also were an iniquity to be punished by the judge; for I should have denied the God that is above. Job 31:24-25, 28

Behold, the **hope** of him is in vain: shall not one be cast down even at the sight of him? Job 41:9

I have set the LORD always before me: because He is at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices: my flesh also shall rest in **hope**. Psalm 16:8-10

Our fathers trusted in You: they trusted, and You did deliver them. They cried unto You, and were delivered: they trusted in You, and were not confounded. But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. All they that see me laugh me to scorn: they shoot out the lip, they shake the head, saying, He trusted on the LORD that He would deliver him: let Him deliver him, seeing he delighted in Him. But You are He that took me out of the womb: you did make me **hope** when I was upon my mother's breasts. I was cast upon you from the womb: You are my God from my mother's belly. Blessed be the LORD: for He has shown me His marvelous kindness in a strong city. For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before Your eyes: nevertheless You heard the voice of my supplications when I cried unto You. O love the LORD, all you His saints: for the LORD preserves the faithful, and plentifully rewards the proud doer. Be of good courage, and He shall strengthen your heart, all you that **hope** in the LORD. Psalm 31:21-24

Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that **hope** in His mercy: To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in famine. Our soul waits for the LORD: He is our help and our shield. For our heart shall rejoice in Him, because we have trusted in His holy name. Let Your mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we **hope** in You. Psalm 33:18-22

In You, O LORD, do I **hope**: You will hear, O Lord my God...Lord, what wait I for? my **hope** is in You. Psalm 38:15, 39:7

Why are you cast down, O my soul? and why are you disquieted in me? **hope** in God... **Hope** in God: for I shall yet praise Him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God. Psalm 42: 5, 43:3-5

For You are my **hope**, O Lord GOD: You are my trust from my youth...I will **hope** continually, and will yet praise You more and more. Psalm 71:5, 14

He established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which He commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children: that the generation to come might know them, even the children which should be born; who should arise and declare them to their children: That they might set their **hope** in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments: and might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation that set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not steadfast with God. Psalm 78:5-8

Take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have **hoped** in Your judgments. Psalm 119:43

Remember the word unto Your servant, upon which You have caused me to **hope**. Psalm 119:49

Your hands have made me and fashioned me: give me understanding, that I may learn Your commandments. They that fear You will be glad when they see me; because I have **hoped** in Your word. Psalm 119:73-74

My soul faints for Your salvation: but I **hope** in Your word... Psalm 119:81

You are my hiding place and my shield: I **hope** in Your word... Psalm 119:114

Uphold me according unto Your word, that I may live: and let me not be ashamed of my **hope**... Psalm 119:116

I prevented the dawning of the morning, and cried: I **hoped** in Your word. Psalm 119:147

LORD, I have **hoped** for Your salvation, and done Your commandments. Psalm 119:166

I wait for the LORD, my soul does wait, and in His word do I **hope**...Let Israel **hope** in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with Him is plenteous redemption. And He shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. Psalm 130:5, 7-8

Let Israel **hope** in the LORD from henceforth and for ever. Psalm 131:3

Happy is he that has the God of Jacob for his help, whose **hope** is in the LORD his God: which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keeps truth for ever: Which executes judgment for the oppressed: which gives food to the hungry. The LORD looses the prisoners: The LORD opens the eyes of the blind: the LORD raises them that are bowed down: the LORD loves the righteous: The LORD preserves the strangers; he relieves the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked He turns upside down. The LORD shall reign forever, even your God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 146:5-10

The LORD takes pleasure in them that fear Him, in those that **hope** in His mercy. Psalm 147:11

The **hope** of the righteous shall be gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish. Proverbs 10:28

When a wicked man dies, his expectation shall perish: and the **hope** of unjust men perishes. Proverbs 11:7

Hope deferred makes the heart sick: but when the desire comes, it is a tree of life. Proverbs 13:12

The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the righteous has **hope** in his death. Proverbs 14:32

Chasten your son while there is **hope**, and let not your soul spare for his crying. Proverbs 19:18

See you a man wise in his own conceit? there is more **hope** of a fool than of him. Proverbs 26:12

See you a man that is hasty in his words? there is more **hope** of a fool than of him. Proverbs 29:20

For to him that is joined to all the living there is **hope**: for a living dog is better than a dead lion. Ecclesiastes 9:4

For the grave cannot praise you, death can not celebrate you: they that go down into the pit cannot **hope** for Your truth. Isaiah 38:18

You are wearied in the greatness of your way; yet said you not, There is no **hope**: you have found the life of your hand; therefore you were not grieved...For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners. Isaiah 57:10, 17-18

A wild ass...Withhold your foot from being unshod, and your throat from thirst: but you said, There is no **hope**: no; for I have loved strangers, and after them will I go. As the thief is ashamed when he is found, so is the house of Israel ashamed; they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets, Saying to a stock, You are my father; and to a stone, You have brought me forth: for they have turned their back unto Me, and not their face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise and save us.But where are your gods that you have made yourself? let them arise, if they can save you in the time of your trouble: for according to the number of your cities are your gods, O Judah. Jer 2:24-28

Truly in vain is salvation **hoped** for from the hills, [high places for idol sacrifices] and from the multitude of mountains: truly in the LORD our God is the salvation of Israel. Jeremiah 3:23

O LORD, though our iniquities testify against us, do you it for Your name's sake: for our backslidings are many; we have sinned against You. O **hope** of Israel, the savior thereof in time of trouble, why should You be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man that turns aside to tarry for a night? ... You are in the midst of us, and we are called by Your name; leave us not. Jeremiah 14:7-9

Blessed is the man that trusts in the LORD, and whose **hope** the LORD is. For He shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and that spreads out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat comes... Jeremiah 17:7

O LORD, the **hope** of Israel, all that forsake You shall be ashamed, and they that depart from Me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters. Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for You are my praise. Jeremiah 17:13-14

Be not a terror unto me; You are my **hope** in the day of evil. Let them be confounded that persecute me, but let not me be confounded: let them be dismayed, but let not me be dismayed: bring upon them the day of evil, and destroy them with double destruction. Jeremiah 17:17-18

Behold, I frame evil against you and devise a device against you: return you now every one from his evil way, and make your ways and your doings good. And they said, There is no **hope**: but we will walk after our own devices, and we will every one do the imagination of his evil heart. Therefore thus says the LORD [YEHOVAH]; Ask you now among the heathen, who has heard such things: the virgin of Israel has done a very horrible things. Jeremiah 18:11-13

And there is **hope** in your end, says the LORD, that your children shall come again to their own border. Jeremiah 31:17

In those days, and in that time, says the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God. They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant that shall not be forgotten. My people have been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their resting place. All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers. Jeremiah 50:4-7

They have seen vanity and lying divination, saying, The LORD says: and the LORD has not sent them: and they have made others to **hope** that they would confirm the word. Ezekiel 13:6

My strength and my **hope** is perished from the LORD: Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul has them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me. This I recall to my mind, therefore have I **hope**. It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is Thy faithfulness. The LORD is my portion, says my soul; therefore will I **hope** in Him. It is good that a man should both **hope** and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD. Lamentations 3:18-26

He puts His mouth in the dust; if so be there may be **hope**. He gives His cheek to him that smites Him: He is filled full of reproach. For the Lord will not cast off for ever: But though He cause grief, yet will He have compassion according to the multitude of His mercies. For He does not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men. To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth, To turn aside the right of a man before the face of the Most High, To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approves not. Lam 3:29

Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our **hope** is lost: we are cut off for our parts. Therefore prophesy and say unto them, Thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, O My people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. And you shall know that I am the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up out of your graves, and shall put My spirit in you, and you shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall you know that I the LORD have spoken it... Ezekiel 37:11-14

I will give her her vineyards from thence, and the valley of Achor for a door of **hope**... Hosea 2:15

The LORD also shall roar out of Zion, and utter His voice from Jerusalem; and the heavens and the earth shall shake: but the LORD will be the **hope** of His people, and the strength of the children of Israel. Joel 3:16

Turn you to the strong hold, you prisoners of **hope**: even to day do I declare that I will render double unto you... Zechariah 9:12

If you lend to them of whom you **hope** to receive, what thank have you? for sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again. Luke 6:34

When Herod saw Jesus, he was exceeding glad: for he was desirous to see Him of a long season, because he had heard many things of Him; and he **hoped** to have seen some miracle done by Him. Luke 23:8

For David speaks concerning Him, I forsaw the Lord always before my face, for He is on my right hand, that I should not be moved. Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in **hope**; Because you will not leave my soul in hell, neither will you suffer your Holy One to see corruption. You have made known to me the ways of life; you shall make me full of joy with Your countenance. Acts 2:25-28

I am a Pharisee, the son of a Pharisee: of the **hope** and resurrection of the dead I am called in question. Acts 23:6

This I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets: and have **hope** toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and unjust. And herein do I exercise myself to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and toward men...Acts 24:14-16

He **hoped** also that money should have been given him of Paul, that he might loose him... Acts 24:26

My manner of life from my youth, which was at the first among mine own nation at Jerusalem, know all the Jews; Which knew me from the beginning...And now I stand and am judged for the **hope** of the promise made of God unto our fathers: Unto which promise our twelve tribes, instantly serving God day and night, **hope** to come, For which **hope's** sake, king Agrippa, I am accused of the Jews. Why should it be thought a thing incredible with you, that God should raise the dead? Acts 26:6-8

When neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, all **hope** that we should be saved was then taken away. Acts 27:20

For this cause therefore have I called for you, to see you, and to speak with you: because that for the **hope** of Israel I am bound with this chain. Acts 28:20

As it is written, I have made you a father of many nations...who against **hope** believed in **hope**, that he might become the father of many nations, according to that which was spoken... Romans 4:17-18

Being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulation also: knowing that tribulation works patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: and hope makes not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. For when we were vet without strength, in due time Christ [Messiah] died for the ungodly. For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some ould dare to die. But God commended His love toward us, in that, while we were vet sinners. Christ died for us. Much more then, being justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. Romans 5:1-10

For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of Him who has subjected the same in **hope**, Because the creature itself also shall be delivered from the bondage of corruption into the glorious liberty of the children of God. For we know that the whole creation groans and travails in pain together until now. And not only they, but ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body. For we are saved by **hope**: but **hope** that is seen is not **hope**: for what a man sees, why does he yet **hope** for? But if we **hope** for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. Romans 8:20-25

Be kindly affectioned one to another...Rejoicing in **hope**; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. Romans 12:10, 12-13

For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through patience and comfort of the scriptures might have **hope**. Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:4-6

Now the God of **hope** fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in **hope**, through the power of the Holy Ghost. Romans 15:13

He that plows should plow in **hope**; and that he that threshes in **hope** should be partaker of his **hope**. 1 Corinthians 9:10

Charity...rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, **hopes** all things, endures all things...Now abides faith, **hope**, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:6-7, 13

If Christ be not raised, your faith is vain; you are yet in your sins. Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished. If in this life only we have **hope** in Christ, we are of all men most miserable. But now is Christ risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept. For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead. 1 Corinthians 15:19

Seeing then that we have such **hope**, we use great plainness of speech...2 Corinthians 3:12

For to their power, I bear record, yes, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves; Praying us with much entreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. And this they did, not as we **hoped**, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God. 2 Corinthians 8:3-5

Not boasting of things without our measure, that is, of other men's labors; but having **hope**, when your faith is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly, To preach the gospel in the regions beyond you, and not to boast in another man's line of things made ready to our hand. But he that glories, let him glory in the Lord. 2 Corinthians 10:15-17

Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; you are fallen from grace. For we through the Spirit wait for the **hope** of righteousness by faith. Galatians 5:4-5

That the...Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him: The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the **hope** of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints... Ephesians 1:16-18

...In time past Gentiles in the flesh...that at that time you were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no **hope**, and without God in the world... Ephesians 2:11-12

...Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you are called in one **hope** of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:3-6

For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your prayer, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, According to my earnest expectation and my **hope**, that in nothing I shall be ashamed, but that with all boldness, as always, so now also Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by life, or by death. Philippians 1:19-20

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you...For the **hope** which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof you heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel... Colossians 1:3, 5

Yet now has He reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in His sight: If you continue in the faith grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the **hope** of the gospel, which you have heard, and which was preached to every creature... Col 1:21-23

To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the **hope** of glory... Colossians 1:27

Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labor of love, and patience of **hope** in our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], in the sight of God and our Father; Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God...For what is our **hope**, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? Are not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming? 1 Thessalonians 1:3, 2:19

I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that you sorrow not, even as others which have no **hope**...But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the **hope** of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 4:13, 5:8

Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good **hope** through grace, Comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Savior, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our **hope**; Unto Timothy... 1 Timothy 1:1

Paul...According to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness...In **hope** of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began... Titus 1:1-2

We should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world; Looking for that blessed **hope**, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ... Titus 2:12-13

According to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior; that being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the **hope** of eternal life. Titus 3:5-7

Christ as a son over His own house; whose house we are, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the **hope** firm unto the end...We desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of **hope** unto the end: That you be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises. Hebrews 3:6, 6:11-12

God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of promise the immutability of His counsel, confirmed it by an oath: That by two immutable things, in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the **hope** set before us: which **hope** we have as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast, and which enters into that within the veil; whither the forerunner is for us entered, Hebrews 6:17-20

It is yet far more evident: for that after the similitude of Melchisedec there arises another priest, Who is made, not after the law of a carnal commandment, but after the power of an endless life. For He testifies, You are a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec...For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better **hope** did; by the which we draw nigh unto God. Hebrews 7:15-19

Now faith is the substance of things **hoped** for, the evidence of things not seen. Hebrews 11:1

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again unto a lively **hope** by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fades not away, reserved in heaven for you...Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and **hope** to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; as obedient children...For you...who by Him do believe in God, that raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; that your faith and **hope** might be in God. 1 Peter 1:3-4, 13. 20-21

Sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asks you a reason of the **hope** that is in you with meekness and fear: 1 Peter 3:15

Behold, what manner of love the Father has bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God...Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it does not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when He shall appear, we shall be like Him; for we shall see Him as he is. And every man that has this **hope** purifies Himself, even as He is pure. 1 John 3:1-3

HUMILITY

Moses and Aaron came in unto Pharaoh, and said unto him, Thus says the LORD God of the Hebrews, How long will you refuse to **humble** yourself before Me? Let My people go, that they may serve Me. Exodus 10:3

...And that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be **humbled**, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember My covenant with Jacob... Leviticus 26:41-42

You shall remember all the way which the LORD your God led you these forty years in the wilderness, to **humble** you, and to prove you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments, or not. And He **humbled** you, and suffered you to hunger, and fed you with manna, which you knew not, neither did your fathers know; that He might make you know that man does not live by bread only, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of the LORD...Who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers knew not, that He might **humble** you, and that He might prove you, to do you good at your latter end... Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 16

Do you see how Ahab **humbles** himself before Me? Because he **humbles** himself before Me, I will not bring the evil in his days: but in his son's days will I bring the evil upon his house. 1 Kings 21:29

Because your heart was tender, and you have **humbled** yourself before the LORD, when you heard what I spoke against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and have rent your clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard you, says the LORD. 2 Kings 22:19

If My people, which are called by My name, shall **humble** themselves, and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king **humbled** themselves; and they said, The LORD is righteous. When the LORD saw that they **humbled** themselves, the word of the LORD came to Shemaiah, saying, They have **humbled** themselves; therefore I will not destroy them, but I will grant them some deliverance; and My wrath shall not be poured out upon Jerusalem by the hand of Shishak...And when he **humbled** himself, the wrath of the LORD turned from him, that he would not destroy him altogether...2 Chronicles 12:6-7, 12

Nevertheless divers of Asher and Manasseh and of Zebulun **humbled** themselves, and came to Jerusalem. 2 Chronicles 30:11

Hezekiah rendered not again according to the benefit done unto him; for his heart was lifted up...Notwithstanding Hezekiah **humbled** himself for the pride of his heart, both he and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, so that the wrath of the LORD came not upon them in the days of Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 32:25-26

When he was in affliction, he sought the LORD his God, and **humbled** himself greatly before the God of his fathers... 2 Chronicles 33:12

Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and...His prayer also, and how God was intreated of him, and all his sin, and his trespass, and the places where he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was **humbled**: behold, they are written among the sayings of the seers. 2 Chronicles 33:18-19

Amon...did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD, as did Manasseh his father: for Amon sacrificed unto all the carved images which Manasseh his father had made, and served them; and **humbled** not himself before the LORD, as Manasseh his father had **humbled** himself; but Amon trespassed more and more. And his servants conspired against him, and slew him in his own house. 2 Chronicles 33:21-24

Because your heart was tender, and you did **humble** yourself before God, when you heard His words against this place, and against the inhabitants of it, and **humbled** yourself before Me, and did rend your clothes, and weep before Me; I have even heard you also, says the LORD. 2 Chronicles 34:27

Zedekiah...did that which was evil in the sight of the LORD his God, and **humbled** not himself before Jeremiah the prophet speaking from the mouth of the LORD. 2 Chronicles 36:11-12

When men are cast down, then you shall say, There is lifting up; and He shall save the **humble** person. Job 22:29

Sing praises to the LORD, which dwells in Zion: declare among the people His doings. When He makes inquisition for blood, He remembers them: He forgets not the cry of the **humble**. Psalm 9:11-12

He crouches, and [falsely] **humbles** himself, that the poor may fall by his strong ones. He has said in his heart, God has forgotten: He hides His face; He will never see it. Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up Your hands: forget not the **humble**...LORD, You have heard the desire of the **humble**: You will prepare their heart, You will cause your ear to hear: to judge the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress. Psalm 10:10-12, 17-18

My soul shall make her boast in the LORD: the **humble** shall hear of this, and be glad...But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth: I **humbled** my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom. Psalms 34:2, 35:13

I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving...The **humble** shall hear this, and be glad: and your heart shall live that seek God. Psalms 69:30, 32

The LORD is high above all nations, and His glory above the heavens. Who is like unto the LORD our God, who dwells on high, Who **humbles** Himself to behold the things that are in heaven, and in earth! Psalm 113:4-6

You are snared with the words of your mouth, you are taken with the words of your mouth. Do this now, my son, and deliver yourself, when you are come into the hand of your friend; go, **humble** yourself, and make sure your friend. Give not sleep to your eyes, nor slumber to your eyelids. Proverbs 6:2-4

The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom; and before honor is **humility**. Proverbs 15:33

Better it is to be of an **humble** spirit with the lowly, than to divide the spoil with the proud. Proverbs 16:19

Before destruction the heart of man is haughty, and before honor is **humility**. Proverbs 18:12

By **humility** and the fear of the LORD are riches, and honor, and life. Proverbs 22:4

A man's pride shall bring him low: but honor shall uphold the **humble** in spirit. Proverbs 29:23

Their land also is full of idols; they worship the work of their own hands, that which their own fingers have made. And the mean man bows down, and the great man **humbles** himself [to an idol]: therefore forgive them not...The lofty looks of man shall be **humbled**, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day...The mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty men shall be **humbled**, and the eyes of the lofty shall be **humbled**... Isaiah 2:8-9, 11, 5:15

Behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, shall lop the bough with terror: and the high ones of stature shall be hewn down, and the haughty shall be **humbled**. Isaiah 10:33

For thus says the high and lofty One that inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy; I dwell in the high and holy place, with him also that is of a contrite and **humble** spirit, to revive the spirit of the **humble**, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones. For I will not contend for ever, neither will I be always wroth: for the spirit should fail before Me, and the souls which I have made. For the iniquity of his covetousness was I wroth, and smote him: I hid Me, and was wroth, and he went on frowardly in the way of his heart. I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore comforts unto him and to his mourners. Isaiah 57:15-18

Say unto the king and to the queen, **Humble** yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, even the crown of your glory. Jeremiah 13:18

They are not **humbled** even unto this day, neither have they feared, nor walked in My law, nor in My statutes...Jeremiah 44:10

And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD: Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. My soul has them still in remembrance, and is **humbled** in me. This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning: great is your faithfulness, Lamentations 3:18-23

O king, the Most High God gave Nebuchadnezzar your father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honor...But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him: And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts...And you his son, O Belshazzar, have not **humbled** your heart, though you knew all this... Daniel 5:18-22

Jesus called a little child unto Him, and set him in the midst of them, And said, Truly I say unto you, Except you be converted, and become as little children, you shall not enter into the Kingdom of heaven. Whosoever shall **humble** himself as this little child, the same is greatest in the Kingdom of heaven. Matthew 18:2-4

Be not called Rabbi: for one is your Master, even Christ; and all you are brethren. And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in heaven. Neither be you called masters: for one is your Master, even Christ. But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant. And whosoever shall exalt himself shall be abased; and he that shall **humble** himself shall be exalted. Matthew 23:8-12

When you are invited by any man to a wedding, do not sit down in the highest room; unless a more honorable man than you be invited of him; And he that invited you and him come and say to you, Give this man place; and you begin with shame to take the lowest room. But when you are invited, go and sit down in the lowest room; that when he that invited you comes, he may say unto you, Friend, go up higher: then shall you have worship in the presence of them that sit at the meal with you. For whosoever exalts himself shall be abased; and he that **humbles** himself shall be exalted. Luke 14:8-11

Two men went up to the temple to pray...The Pharisee stood and prayed this way with himself, God, I thank You, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: for every one that exalts himself shall be abased; and he that **humbles** himself shall be exalted. Luke 18:10-14

You know, from the first day that I came into Asia, after what manner I have been with you at all seasons, Serving the Lord with all **humility** of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews: And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shown you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house. Acts 20:18-20

For I fear...lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults: And lest, when I come again, my God will **humble** me among you, and that I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not repented of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed. 2 Corinthians 12:20-21

Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God: But made Himself of no reputation, and took upon Him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men: And being found in fashion as a man, He **humbled** himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross. Wherefore God also has highly exalted Him, and given Him a name which is above every name... Philippians 2:5-9

Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary **humility** and worshiping of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, and not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increases with the increase of God. Colossians 2:18-19

Wherefore if you be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are you subject to ordinances, (Touch not; taste not; handle not; Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men? Which things have indeed a show of wisdom in will worship, and **humility**, and neglecting of the body; not in any honor to the satisfying of the flesh. Colossians 2:20-23

Do you think that the scripture says in vain, The spirit that dwells in us lusts to envy? But He gives more grace. Wherefore He says, God resists the proud, but gives grace to the **humble**...Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. **Humble** yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up. James 4:5-6, 8-10

You younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yes, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with **humility**: for God resists the proud, and gives grace to the **humble**. **Humble** yourselves therefore under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time. 1 Peter 5:5-6

LONGSUFFERING

The LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, **longsuffering**, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:6

The LORD is **longsuffering**, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Numbers 14:17-23

O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set You before them. But you, O Lord, are a God full of compassion, and gracious, **longsuffering**, and plentiful in mercy and truth. O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give your strength unto your servant, and save the son of your handmaid. Psalm 86:14-17

O LORD, You know: remember me, and visit me, and revenge me of my persecutors; take me not away in Your **longsuffering**: know that for Your sake I have suffered rebuke. Your words were found, and I did eat them; and Your word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart...Jeremiah 15:15-16a

And think this, O man, that judges them which do such things, and does the same, that you shall escape the judgment of God? Or do you despise the riches of His goodness and forbearance and **longsuffering**; not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? Romans 2:3-4

What if God willing to show His wrath, and to make His power known, endured with much **longsuffering** the vessels of wrath fitted to destruction: And that He might make known the riches of His glory on the vessels of mercy, which He had afore prepared unto glory. Romans 9:22-23

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in watchings, in fastings; by pureness, by knowledge, by **longsuffering**, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, by honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet true; As unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed; as sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:4-7

Now the works of the flesh are manifest...they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, **longsuffering**, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:19, 21-24

Walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with **longsuffering**, forbearing one another in love; endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3

We also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might according to His glorious power, unto all patience and **longsuffering** with joyfulness...Colossians 1:9-11

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, **longsuffering**; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do you. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. Colossians 3:12-14

For this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show forth all **longsuffering**, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on Him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:16

Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all **longsuffering** and doctrine. 2 Timothy 4:2

Quickened by the Spirit...[Yeshua] went and preached unto the spirits in prison...which sometime were disobedient, when once the **longsuffering** of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is eight souls were saved by water. 1 Peter 3:19-20

The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some men count slackness; but is **longsuffering** to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance... And account that the **longsuffering** of our Lord is salvation... 2 Peter 3:9

LOWLINESS

The stranger that is within you shall get up above you very high; and you shall come down very **low**. Deuteronomy 28:43

And it came to pass, when he saw her, that he rent his clothes, and said, Alas, my daughter! You have brought me very **low**, and you are one of them that trouble me: for I have opened my mouth unto the LORD, and I cannot go back. Judges 11:35

The LORD makes poor, and makes rich: he brings **low**, and lifts up. 1 Samuel 2:7

For the LORD brought Judah **low** because of Ahaz king of Israel; for he made Judah naked, and transgressed sore against the LORD. 2 Chronicles 28:19

Who gives rain upon the earth, and sends waters upon the fields. To set up on high those that are **low**; that those which mourn may be exalted to safety. Job 5:10-11

His sons come to honor, and he knows it not; and they are brought **low**, but he perceives it not of them. Job 14:21

They are exalted for a little while, but are gone and brought **low**; they are taken out of the way as all other, and cut off as the tops of the ears of corn...Look on every one that is proud, and bring him **low**; and tread down the wicked in their place. Job 24:24, 40:12

Hear this, all you people; give ear, all you inhabitants of the world. Both **low** and high, rich and poor, together... Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, when the iniquity of my heels shall compass me about? They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; None of them can be any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him: (For the redemption of their soul is precious, and it ceases for ever:) Psalm 49:1-2, 5-8

Trust in Him at all times; you people, pour out your heart before Him: God is a refuge for us. Selah. Surely men of **low** degree are vanity, and men of high degree are a lie: to be laid in the balance, they are altogether lighter than vanity. Psalm 62:9

O remember not against us former iniquities: let Your tender mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very **low**. Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of Your name: and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for Your name's sake. Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is their God? Let Him be known among the heathen in our sight by the revenging of the blood of Your servants which is shed. Psalm 79:8-10

Many times did He deliver them; but they provoked Him with their counsel, and were brought **low** for their iniquity. Nevertheless He regarded their affliction, when He heard their cry: And He remembered for them His covenant, and repented according to the multitude of His mercies. He made them also to be pitied of all those that carried them captive. Psalm 106:43-46

He blesses them also, so that they are multiplied greatly...Again, they are minished and brought **low** through oppression, affliction, and sorrow...Yet sets He the poor on high from affliction, and makes him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. Psalm 107:38-43

The LORD preserves the simple: I was brought **low**, and He helped me. Return unto your rest, O my soul; for the LORD has dealt bountifully with you. Psalm 116:6-7

O give thanks unto the LORD; for He is good...Who remembered us in our **low** estate: for His mercy endures for ever: and has redeemed us from our enemies: for His mercy endures for ever. Psalm 136:1, 23-24

Though the LORD be high, yet has He respect unto the **lowly**: but the proud He knows afar off. Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me: You shall stretch forth Your hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and Your right hand shall save me. Psalm 138:6-7

I said, You are my refuge and my portion in the land of the living. Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very **low**: deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I. Psalm 142:5-6

The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but He blesses the habitation of the just. Surely He scorns the scorners: but He gives grace to the **lowly**. The wise shall inherit glory: but shame shall be the promotion of fools. Proverbs 3:33-35

When pride comes, then comes shame: but with the **lowly** is wisdom. The integrity of the upright shall guide them: but the perverseness of transgressors shall destroy them... The highway of the upright is to depart from evil: he that keeps his way preserves his soul. Pride goes before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall. Better it is to be of an humble spirit with the **lowly**, than to divide the spoil with the proud. He that handles a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusts in the LORD, happy is he. Proverbs 11:2-3, 16:17-20

There is an evil which I have seen under the sun, as an error which proceeds from the ruler: Folly is set in great dignity, and the rich sit in **low** place. Ecclesiastes 10:6-7

In the day when the keepers of the house shall tremble, and the strong men shall bow themselves, and the grinders cease because they are few, and those that look out of the windows be darkened, and the doors be shut in the streets, when the sound of the grinding is **low**, and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird, and all the daughters of music shall be brought **low**; also when they shall be afraid of that which is high, and fears shall be in the way... Ecclesiastes 12:3-5

Enter into the rock, and hide in the dust, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of His majesty. The lofty looks of man shall be humbled, and the haughtiness of men shall be bowed down, and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. For the day of the LORD of hosts shall be upon every one that is proud and lofty, and upon every one that is lifted up; and he shall be brought **low**... And the loftiness of man shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be made **low**: and the LORD alone shall be exalted in that day. And the idols He shall utterly abolish. And they shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for the glory of His majesty, when He arises to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:10-12, 17-19

Behold, the day of the LORD comes, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine. And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity; and I will cause the arrogancy of the proud to cease, and will lay **low** the haughtiness of the terrible. Isaiah 13:9-11

For you have been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat ... the branch of the terrible ones shall be brought **low**... and He shall spread forth His hands in the midst of them, as he that swims spreads forth his hands to swim: and He shall bring down their pride together with the spoils of their hands. And the fortress of the high fort of your walls shall He bring down, lay **low**, and bring to the ground, even to the dust. Isaiah 25:4, 11-12

For He brings down them that dwell on high; the lofty city, He lays it **low**; He lays it **low**, even to the ground; He brings it even to the dust. The foot shall tread it down, even the feet of the poor, and the steps of the needy. The way of the just is uprightness: you, most upright, do weigh the path of the just. Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O LORD, have we waited for you; the desire of our soul is to Your name, and to the remembrance of You. Isaiah 26:5-8

And you shall be brought down, and shall speak out of the ground, and your speech shall be **low** out of the dust, and your voice shall be, as of one that has a familiar spirit, out of the ground, and your speech shall whisper out of the dust. Isaiah 29:4

Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. And My people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places; When it shall hail, coming down on the forest; and the city shall be **low** in a **low** place. Isaiah 32:16-19

The voice of him that cries in the wilderness, Prepare you the way of the LORD, make straight in the desert a highway for our God. Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made **low**: and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: and the glory of the LORD shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD has spoken it. Isaiah 40:3-5

Mine eye runs down with rivers of water for the destruction of the daughter of my people. Mine eye trickles down, and ceases not, without any intermission, till the LORD look down, and behold from heaven. Mine eye affects mine heart because of all the daughters of my city. Mine enemies chased me sore, like a bird, without cause. They have cut off my life in the dungeon, and cast a stone upon me. Waters flowed over mine head; then I said, I am cut off. I called upon Your name, O LORD, out of the **low** dungeon. You have heard my voice: hide not Your ear at my breathing, at my cry. You drew near in the day that I called upon You: You said, Fear not. Lamentations 3:55-57

It...became a spreading vine of **low** stature, whose branches turned toward him, and the roots thereof were under him: so it became a vine, and brought forth branches, and shot forth sprigs...And all the trees of the field shall know that I the LORD have brought down the high tree, have exalted the **low** tree, have dried up the green tree, and have made the dry tree to flourish: I the LORD have spoken and have done it. Ezekiel 17:6, 24

Thus says the Lord GOD; Remove the diadem, and take off the crown: this shall not be the same: exalt him that is **low**, and abase him that is high. I will overturn, overturn, overturn, it: and it shall be no more, until He come whose right it is; and I will give it Him. Ezekiel 21:25-27

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes unto you: He is just, and having salvation; **lowly**, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off: and He shall speak peace unto the heathen...Zechariah 9:9-10

Come unto Me, all you that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am meek and **lowly** in heart; and you shall find rest unto your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light. Matthew 12:28-31

And Mary said, My soul does magnify the Lord, And my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. For He has regarded the **low** estate of His handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed. For He that is mighty has done to me great things; and holy is His name. Luke 1:46-49

As it is written in the book of the words of Esaias the prophet, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare you the way of the Lord, make His paths straight. Every valley shall be filled, and every mountain and hill shall be brought **low**; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough ways shall be made smooth; And all flesh shall see the salvation of God. Luke 3:4-6

Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not high things, but condescend to men of **low** estate. Romans 12:16

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all **lowliness** and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:1-6

If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil you my joy, that you be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in **lowliness** of mind let each esteem other better than themselves. Look not every man on his own things, but every man also on the things of others. Philippians 2:1-4

Let the brother of **low** degree rejoice in that he is exalted: but the rich, in that he is made **low**: because as the flower of the grass he shall pass away. James 1:9-10

MEEKNESS

(Now the man Moses was very **meek**, above all the men which were upon the face of the earth.) Numbers 12:3

The **meek** shall eat and be satisfied: they shall praise the LORD that seek Him: your heart shall live for ever. Psalm 22:26

The **meek** will He guide in judgment: and the **meek** will He teach His way. Psalm 25:9

But the **meek** shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace. Psalm 37:11

Gird Thy sword upon Your thigh, O most mighty, with Your glory and Your majesty. And in Your majesty ride prosperously because of truth and **meekness** and righteousness; and Your right hand shall teach You terrible things. Psalm 45:4

You, even You, are to be feared: and who may stand in Your sight when once You are angry? You did cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still, when God arose to judgment, to save all the **meek** of the earth. Selah. Psalm 76:7-9

The LORD lifts up the **meek**: He casts the wicked down to the ground. Psalm 147:6

For the LORD takes pleasure in His people: He will beautify the **meek** with salvation. Psalm 149:4

But with righteousness shall He judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the **meek** of the earth: and He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked. Isaiah 11:4

The **meek** also shall increase their joy in the LORD, and the poor among men shall rejoice in the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 29:19

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me; because the LORD has anointed Me to preach good tidings unto the **meek**; He has sent Me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; to proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God... Isaiah 61:1-2

For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they sold the righteous for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes; That pant after the dust of the earth on the head of the poor, and turn aside the way of the **meek**: and a man and his father will go in unto the same maid, to profane My holy name... Amos 2:6-7

Seek you the LORD, all you **meek** of the earth, which have wrought His judgment; seek righteousness, seek **meekness**: it may be you shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger. Zeph 2:3

Blessed are the **meek**: for they shall inherit the earth. Matthew 5:5

Take My yoke upon you, and learn of Me; for I am **meek** and lowly in heart: and you shall find rest unto your souls. Mt 11:29

Tell the daughter of Sion, Behold, your King comes unto you, **meek**, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. Matthew 21:5

What will you? Shall I come unto you with a rod, or in love, and in the spirit of **meekness**? 1 Corinthians 4:21

Now I Paul myself beseech you by the **meekness** and gentleness of Christ, who in presence am base among you, but being absent am bold toward you... 2 Corinthians 10:1

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, **meekness**, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:23

Brethren, if a man be overtaken in a fault, you which are spiritual, restore such an one in the spirit of **meekness**; considering yourself, lest you also be tempted. Galatians 6:1

...Walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all lowliness and **meekness**, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:1-3

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, **meekness**, longsuffering; forbearing one another, and forgiving one another... Col 3:12-13

They that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. But you, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. 1 Timothy 6:10-11

In **meekness** instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:25-26

Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work. To speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, showing all **meekness** unto all men. For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. Titus 3:1-3

Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with **meekness** the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. James 1:21

Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him shew out of a good conversation his works with **meekness** of wisdom. James 3:13

Likewise, you wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives; while they observe your chaste conversation coupled with fear. Whose adorning let it not be that outward adorning of plaiting the hair, and of wearing of gold, or of putting on of apparel; But let it be the hidden man of the heart, in that which is not corruptible, even the ornament of a **meek** and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price... But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and be ready always to give an answer to every man that asks you a reason of the hope that is in you with **meekness** and fear: Having a good conscience; that, whereas they speak evil of you, as of evildoers, they may be ashamed that falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ. 1 Peter 3:1-4, 15-16

OBEY

Now therefore, my son, **obey** my voice according to that which I command you. Genesis 27:8

And his mother said unto him, Upon me be your curse, my son: only **obey** my voice, and go fetch me them. Genesis 27:13

Now therefore, my son, **obey** my voice; and arise, you flee to Laban my brother to Haran... Genesis 27:43

In your seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because you have **obeyed** My voice...Because that Abraham **obeyed** My voice, and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws. Genesis 22:18, 26:5

Jacob **obeyed** his father and his mother, and was gone to Padan-aram. Genesis 28:7

And Pharaoh said, Who is the LORD, that I should **obey** His voice to let Israel go? I know not the LORD, neither will I let Israel go. Exodus 5:2

Now therefore, if you will **obey** My voice indeed, and keep My covenant, then you shall be a peculiar treasure unto Me above all people: for all the earth is Mine. Exodus 19:5

Behold, I send an Angel before you, to keep you in the way, and to bring you into the place which I have prepared. Beware of him, and **obey** his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for My name is in him...if you shall indeed **obey** his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto your enemies, and an adversary unto your adversaries. Ex 23:20-22

He took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD has said will we do, and be **obedient**. And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the Covenant, which the LORD has made with you concerning all these words. Exodus 24:7-8

You shall put some of your honor upon him, that all the congregation of the children of Israel may be **obedient**. Numbers 27:20

If...you shall seek the LORD your God, you shall find Him, if you seek Him with all your heart and with all your soul. When you are in tribulation, and all these things are come upon you, even in the latter days, if you turn to the LORD your God, and shall be **obedient** unto His voice; (For the LORD your God is a merciful God;) He will not forsake you, neither destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore unto them. Deu 4:29-31

As the nations which the LORD destroys before your face, so shall you perish; because you would not be **obedient** unto the voice of the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 8:20

Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse; A blessing, if you **obey** the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day: And a curse, if you will not **obey** the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which you have not known. Deuteronomy 11:26-28

You shall walk after the LORD your God, and fear Him, and keep His commandments, and **obey** His voice, and you shall serve Him, and cleave unto Him. Deuteronomy 13:4

If a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not **obey** the voice of his father, or the voice of his mother, and that, when they have chastened him, will not hearken unto them: Then shall his father and his mother lay hold on him, and bring him out unto the elders of his city, and unto the gate of his place; and they shall say unto the elders of his city, This our son is stubborn and rebellious, he will not **obey** our voice; he is a glutton, and a drunkard. And all the men of his city shall stone him with stones, that he die: so shall you put evil away from among you; and all Israel shall hear, and fear. Deuteronomy 21:18-21

You shall therefore **obey** the voice of the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God, and do His commandments and His statutes, which I command you this day. Deuteronomy 27:10

You shall be left few in number, whereas you were as the stars of heaven for multitude; because you would not **obey** the voice of the LORD your God. Deuteronomy 28:62

And shall return unto the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God, and shall **obey** His voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul... Deuteronomy 30:2

The LORD your God will put all these curses upon your enemies, and on them that hate you, which persecuted you. And you shall return and **obey** the voice of the LORD, and do all His commandments which I command you this day. Deut 30:7-8

That you may love the LORD your God, and that you may **obey** His voice, and that you may cleave unto Him: for He is your life, and the length of your days: that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. Deuteronomy 30:20

The children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people that were men of war, which came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD: unto whom the LORD swore that He would not show them the land, which the LORD swore unto their fathers that He would give us, a land that flows with milk and honey. Joshua 5:6

You have kept all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, and have **obeyed** My voice in all that I commanded you... Joshua 22:2

The people said unto Joshua, The LORD our God will we serve, and His voice will we **obey**. Joshua 24:24

You shall make no league with the inhabitants of this land; you shall throw down their altars: but you have not **obeyed** My voice: why have you done this? ... Yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, **obeying** the commandments of the LORD; but they did not so. Judges 2:2, 17

I said unto you, I am the LORD your God; fear not the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you dwell: but you have not **obeyed** My voice. Judges 6:10

Nevertheless the people refused to **obey** the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us...If you will fear the LORD, and serve Him, and **obey** His voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both you and also the king that reigns over you continue following the LORD your God: But if you will not **obey** the voice of the LORD, but rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall the hand of the LORD be against you, as it was against your fathers. 1 Samuel 8:19, 12:14-15

Wherefore then did you not **obey** the voice of the LORD, but did fly upon the spoil, and did evil in the sight of the LORD? And Saul said unto Samuel, Yes, I have **obeyed** the voice of the LORD, and have gone the way which the LORD sent me, and have brought Agag the king of Amalek, and have utterly destroyed the Amalekites...Samuel said, Has the LORD as great delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, as in **obeying** the voice of the LORD? Behold, to **obey** is better than sacrifice, and to hearken than the fat of rams... Saul said unto Samuel, I have sinned: for I have transgressed the commandment of the LORD, and Your words: because I feared the people, and **obeyed** their voice. 1 Samuel 15:19-20, 22, 24

Because you **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD, nor executed His fierce wrath upon Amalek, therefore has the LORD done this thing unto you this day...The woman came unto Saul, and saw that he was sore troubled, and said unto him, Behold, your handmaid has **obeyed** your voice, and I have put my life in my hand, and have hearkened unto your words which you spake unto me. 1 Samuel 28:18, 21 (She obeyed Saul to do evil)

Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be **obedient** unto me. 2 Samuel 22:45

...Because they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD their God, but transgressed His covenant, and all that Moses the servant of the LORD commanded, and would not hear them, nor do them. 2 Kings 18:12

And they **obeyed** the words of the LORD, and returned from going against Jeroboam. 2 Chronicles 11:4

Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David his father, and prospered; and all Israel **obeyed** him. 1 Chronicles 29:23

Then said he unto him, Because you have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD [YEHOVAH], behold, as soon as you are departed from me, a lion shall slay you. And as soon as he was departed from him, a lion found him, and slew him. 1 Kings 20:36

But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Your commandments, And refused to **obey**, neither were mindful of Your wonders that You did among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but You are a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsook them not. Nehemiah 9:17

If they **obey** and serve Him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures. But if they **obey** not, they shall perish by the sword, and they shall die without knowledge. Job 36:11-12

As soon as they hear of me, they shall **obey** me: the strangers shall submit themselves unto me. Psalm 18:44

How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof; And have not **obeyed** the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me! Proverbs 5:12-13

As an earring of gold, and an ornament of fine gold, so is a wise reprover upon an **obedient** ear...The eye that mocks at his father, and despises to **obey** his mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it. Proverbs 25:12; 30:17

If you be willing and **obedient**, you shall eat the good of the land: but if you refuse and rebel, you shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the LORD has spoken it. Isaiah 1:19-20

They shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall **obey** them. Isaiah 11:14

Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? Did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? For they would not walk in His ways, neither were they **obedient** unto His law. Isaiah 42:24

Who is among you that fears the LORD, that **obeys** the voice of His servant, that walks in darkness, and has no light? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Is 50:10

Only acknowledge your iniquity, that you have transgressed against the LORD your God, and have scattered your ways to the strangers under every green tree, and you have not **obeyed** My voice, says the LORD...We lie down in our shame, and our confusion covers us: for we have sinned against the LORD our God, we and our fathers, from our youth even unto this day, and have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD our God. Jer 3:13, 25

But this thing commanded I them, saying, **Obey** My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people: and walk you in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you...Therefore you shall speak all these words unto them; but they will not hearken to you: you shall also call unto them; but they will not answer you. But you shall say unto them, this is a nation that **obeys** not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receives correction: truth is perished, and is cut off from their mouth. Jeremiah 7:23, 27-28

The LORD says, Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not **obeyed** My voice, neither walked therein; But have walked after the imagination of their own heart, and after Baalim, which their fathers taught them: Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will feed them, even this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. Jeremiah 9:13-15

Say you unto them, Thus says the LORD God of Israel; Cursed be the man that **obeys** not the words of this covenant. Which I commanded your fathers in the day that I brought them forth out of the land of Egypt, from the iron furnace, saying, **Obey** My voice, and do them, according to all which I command you: so shall you be My people, and I will be your God..Jer 11:3-4

For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day that I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, even unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, **obey** My voice Yet they **obeyed** not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not. Jeremiah 11:7-8

But if they will not **obey**, I will utterly pluck up and destroy that nation, says the LORD. Jeremiah 12:17

But they **obeyed** not, neither inclined their ear, but made their neck stiff, that they might not hear, nor receive instruction. Jeremiah 17:23

Concerning a nation...If it do evil in My sight, that it **obey** not My voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them. Jeremiah 18:10

I spoke unto you in your prosperity; but you said, I will not hear. This has been your manner from your youth, that you **obeyed** not My voice. Jeremiah 22:21

Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and **obey** the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will repent him of the evil that He has pronounced against you. Jeremiah 26:13

And they came in, and possessed it; but they **obeyed** not Your voice, neither walked in Your law; they have done nothing of all that You commanded them to do: therefore you have caused all this evil to come upon them... Jeremiah 32:23

Now when all the princes, and all the people, which had entered into the covenant, heard that every one should let his manservant, and every one his maidservant, go free, that none should serve themselves of them any more, then they **obeyed**, and let them go. Jeremiah 34:10

Thus have we **obeyed** the voice of Jonadab the son of Rechab our father in all that he has charged us, to drink no wine all our days, we, our wives, our sons, nor our daughters...But we have dwelt in tents, and have **obeyed**, and done according to all that Jonadab our father commanded us. Jeremiah 35:8, 10

And Jeremiah said unto the house of the Rechabites, Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Because you have **obeyed** the commandment of Jonadab your father, and kept all his precepts, and done according unto all that he has commanded you: Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Jonadab the son of Rechab shall not want a man to stand before me for ever. Jeremiah 35:10, 18-19

Will you not receive instruction to hearken to My words? says the LORD. The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but **obey** their father's commandment: nothwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but you hearkened not unto Me. Jeremiah 35:13-14

But Jeremiah said, They shall not deliver you. **Obey**, I beseech you, the voice of the LORD, which I speak unto you: so it shall be well unto you, and your soul shall live. Jeremiah 38:20

Now the LORD has brought it, and done according as He has said: because you have sinned against the LORD, and have not **obeyed** His voice, therefore this thing is come upon you. Jeremiah 40:3

Whether it be good, or whether it be evil, we will **obey** the voice of the LORD our God, to whom we send you; that it may be well with us, when we **obey** the voice of the LORD our God...But if you say, We will not dwell in this land, neither **obey** the voice of the LORD your God, Saying, No; but we will go into the land of Egypt, where we shall see no war...it shall come to pass, that the sword, which you feared shall overtake you... Jer 42:6, 13-15

And now I have this day declared it to you; but you have not **obeyed** he voice of the LORD your God, nor any thing for the which He has sent me unto you. Jeremiah 42:21

So Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces, and all the people, **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD, to dwell in the land of Judah...So they came into the land of Egypt: for they **obeyed** not the voice of the LORD: thus came they even to Tahpanhes. Jeremiah 43:4, 7

Because you have burned incense, and because you have sinned against the LORD, and have not **obeyed** the voice of the LORD, nor walked in His law, nor in His statutes, nor in His testimonies, therefore this evil is happened unto you, as at this day. Jeremiah 44:23

And the Kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the Kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the Most High, whose Kingdom is an everlasting Kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and **obey** Him. Daniel 7:27

Neither have we **obeyed** the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in His laws, which He set before us by His servants the prophets. Yes, all Israel have transgressed Your law, even by departing, that they might not **obey** Your voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that is written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against Him. Daniel 9:10-11

Therefore has the LORD watched upon the evil, and brought it upon us: for the LORD our God is righteous in all His works which He does: for we **obeyed** not His voice. Daniel 9:14

She **obeyed** not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God. Zephaniah 3:2

And they that are far off shall come and build in the temple of the LORD, and you shall know that the LORD of hosts has sent me unto you. And this shall come to pass, if you will diligently **obey** the voice of the LORD your God. Zechariah 6:15

Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, **obeyed** the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the LORD. Haggai 1:12

But the men marvelled, saying, What manner of man is this, that even the winds and the sea **obey** Him? Matthew 8:27

They were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? What new doctrine is this? For with authority commands He even the unclean spirits, and they do **obey** Him...They feared exceedingly, and said one to another, What manner of man is this, that even the wind and the sea **obey** Him? Mark 1:27, 4:41

He said unto them, Where is your faith? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this? For He commands even the winds and the water, and they **obey** Him...The Lord said, If you had faith as a grain of mustard seed, you might say unto this sycamine tree, Be you plucked up by the root, and be you planted in the sea; and it should **obey** you. Luke 8:25, 17:6

Peter and the other apostles answered and said, We ought to **obey** God rather than men. The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom you slew and hanged on a tree. Him has God exalted with His right hand to be a Prince and a Savior, for to give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. And we are His witnesses of these things; and so is also the Holy Ghost, whom God has given to them that **obey** Him...For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as **obeyed** him, were scattered, and brought to nought. After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, even as many as **obeyed** him, were dispersed. Acts 5:29-32, 36-37

And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of priests were **obedient** to the faith. Acts 6:7

This is he, that was in the church in the wilderness with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sinai, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us: To whom our fathers would not **obey**, but thrust him from them, and in their hearts turned back again into Egypt, Saying unto Aaron, Make us gods... Acts 7:38-40

Concerning His Son Jesus Christ...By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for **obedience** to the faith among all nations, for His name: Among whom are you also the called of Jesus Christ...Unto them that are contentious, and do not **obey** the truth, but **obey** unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile... Romans 1:3, 5-6; 2:8-9

For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ [Messiah] has not wrought by me, to make the Gentiles **obedient**, by word and deed, For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the **obedience** of one shall many be made righteous. Romans 5:18-19

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that you should **obey** it in the lusts thereof...Know you not, that to whom you yield yourselves servants to **obey**, his servants you are to whom you **obey**; whether of sin unto death, or of **obedience** unto righteousness? But God be thanked, that you were the servants of sin, but you have **obeyed** from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Romans 6:12, 16-17

How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! But they have not all **obeyed** the gospel. For Esaias said, Lord, who has believed our report? Romans 10:15-16

For your **obedience** is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil...Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began, But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the **obedience** of faith: To God only wise, be glory through Jesus Christ for ever. Amen. Romans 16:19, 25-27

Let your women keep silence in the churches: for it is not permitted unto them to speak; but they are commanded to be under **obedience**, as also says the law. 1 Corinthians 14:34

For to this end also did I write, that I might know the proof of you, whether you be **obedient** in all things. 2 Corinthians 2:9

And his inward affection is more abundant toward you, while he remembers the **obedience** of you all, how with fear and trembling you received him. 2 Corinthians 7:15

Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the **obedience** of Christ; And having in a readiness to revenge all disobedience, when your **obedience** is fulfilled. 2 Corinthians 10:5-6

O foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, that you should not **obey** the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ has been evidently set forth, crucified among you? Galatians 3:1

You did run well; who did hinder you that you should not **obey** the truth? Galatians 5:7

Children, **obey** your parents in the Lord: for this is right...Servants, be **obedient** to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; Ephesians 6:1, 5

And being found in fashion as a man, He humbled Himself, and became **obedient** unto death, even the death of the cross...Wherefore, my beloved, as you have always **obeyed**, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. Philippians 2:8, 12

Children, **obey** your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord...Servants, **obey** in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God... Colossians 3:20, 22

You who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that **obey** not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of His power... 2 Thessalomians 1:7-9

If any man **obey** not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed. 2 Thessalonians 3:14

The aged women...may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, **obedient** to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed...Exhort servants to be **obedient** unto their own masters, and to please them well in all things, not answering again; Not purloining, but showing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God... Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to **obey** magistrates, to be ready to every good work, to speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but gentle, showing all meekness unto all men. Titus 2:3-5, 9-10; 3:1-2

Having confidence in thy **obedience** I wrote unto you, knowing that you will also do more than I say. Philemon 1:21

Though He were a Son, yet learned He **obedience** by the things which He suffered; And being made perfect, He became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that **obey** Him... Hebrews 5:8-10

By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, **obeyed**; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. Hebrews 11:8

Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves; for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief: for that is unprofitable for you. Hebrews 13:17

Behold, we put bits in the horses' mouths, that they may **obey** us; and we turn about their whole body. James 3:3

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto **obedience** and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied...As **obedient** children, not fashioning yourselves according to the former lusts in your ignorance: But as He which has called you is holy, so be you holy... 1 Peter 1:2, 14-16

Seeing you have purified your souls in **obeying** the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that you love one another with a pure heart fervently: Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which lives and abides for ever. 1 Peter 1:22-23

Likewise, you wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any **obey** not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives... 1 Peter 3:1

For the time is come that judgment must begin at the house of God; and if it first begin at us, what shall the end be of them that **obey** not the gospel of God? And if the righteous scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to Him in well doing, as unto a faithful Creator. 1 Peter 4:17-19

DISOBEDIENCE

Thus says the LORD, Forasmuch as you have **disobeyed** the mouth of the LORD, and have not kept the commandment which the LORD your God commanded you, But came back, and have eaten bread and drunk water in the place of the which the LORD did say to you, Eat no bread, and drink no water; your carcase shall not come unto the sepulcher of your fathers...When the prophet that brought him back from the way heard thereof, he said, It is the man of God, who was **disobedient** unto the word of the LORD: therefore the LORD has delivered him unto the lion, which has torn him, and slain him, according to the word of the LORD, which He spake unto him. 1 Kings 13:20-21, 26

Nevertheless they were **disobedient**, and rebelled against you, and cast your law behind their backs, and slew your prophets which testified against them to turn them to you, and they wrought great provocations. Nehemiah 9:26

He shall go before Him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the **disobedien**t to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17

Whereupon, O king Agrippa, I was not **disobedient** unto the heavenly vision... Acts 26:19

As they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient; Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, **disobedient** to parents, without understanding, covenant breakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful: Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28-32

For as by one man's **disobedience** many were made sinners, so by the **obedience** of one shall many be made righteous...Esaias is very bold, and said, I was found of them that sought Me not; I was made manifest unto them that asked not after Me. But to Israel He said, All day long I have stretched forth my hands unto a **disobedient** and gainsaying people. Romans 5:19; 10:20-21

For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war after the flesh: (For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal, but mighty through God to the pulling down of strong holds;) Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the **obedience** of Christ; and having in a readiness to revenge all **disobedience**, when your **obedience** is fulfilled. 2 Cor 10:3-6

Wherein in time past you walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now works in the children of **disobedience**: Ephesians 2:2

Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things comes the wrath of God upon the children of **disobedience**. Ephesians 5:6

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth: fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: For which things' sake the wrath of God comes on the children of **disobedience**... Colossians 3:5-6

Knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and **disobedient**, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine: According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my trust. 1 Timothy 1:9-11

This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, **disobedient** to parents, unthankful, unholy, without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce despisers of those that are good, traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God; having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: from such turn away. 2 Timothy 3:1-5

Unto the pure all things are pure: but unto them that are defiled and unbelieving is nothing pure; but even their mind and conscience is defiled. They profess that they know God; but in works they deny Him, being abominable, and **disobedient**, and unto every good work reprobate...For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, **disobedient**, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. Titus 1:15-16; 3:3

For if the word spoken by angels was steadfast, and every transgression and **disobedience** received a just recompense of reward; How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard Him; God also bearing them witness, both with signs and wonders, and with divers miracles, and gifts of the Holy Ghost, according to His own will? Hebrews 2:2-4

Unto you therefore which believe He is precious: but unto them which be **disobedient**, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, and a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being **disobedient**: whereunto also they were appointed. 1 Peter 2:7-8

For Christ also has once suffered for sins, the just for the unjust, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit: by which also He went and preached unto the spirits in prison; Which sometime were **disobedient**, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were saved by water. 1 Peter 3:18-20

PATIENCE

Rest in the LORD, and wait **patiently** for Him: fret not yourself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass. Psalm 37:7

I waited **patiently** for the LORD; and He inclined unto me, and heard my cry. Psalm 40:1

Better is the end of a thing than the beginning thereof: and the **patient** in spirit is better than the proud in spirit. Eccl 7:8-9

The servant therefore fell down, and worshiped him, saying, Lord, have **patience** with me, and I will pay you all...His fellow servant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have **patience** with me, and I will pay you all. Matthew 18:26, 29

They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for a while believe, and in time of temptation fall away. That which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to perfection. But that on the good ground are they, which in an honest and good heart, having heard the word, keep it, and bring forth fruit with **patience**. Luke 8:13-15

And you shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kin folk, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. And you shall be hated of all men for My name's sake. But there shall not an hair of your head perish. In your **patience** possess you your souls. Luke 21:19

I think myself happy, king Agrippa, because I shall answer for myself this day before you touching all the things whereof I am accused of the Jews: Especially because I know you to be expert in all customs and questions which are among the Jews: wherefore I beseech you to hear me **patiently**. Acts 26:2-3

To them who by **patient** continuance in well doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil...

but glory, honor, and peace, to every man that works good... Romans 2:7-10

But we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation works **patience**; and **patience**, experience; and experience, hope: and hope makes not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:3-5

For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man sees, why does he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with **patience** wait for it. Romans 8:24-25

Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honor preferring one another; Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope; **patient** in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer; distributing to the necessity of saints; given to hospitality. Romans 12:10-13

For whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning, that we through **patience** and comfort of the scriptures might have hope. Now the God of **patience** and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That you may with one mind and one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 15:4-6

Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed: But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much **patience**, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses... 2 Corinthians 6:3-4

Truly the signs of an apostle were wrought among you in all **patience**, in signs, and wonders, and mighty deeds. 2 Corinthians 12:12

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; That you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; Strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, unto all **patience** and longsuffering with joyfulness; Giving thanks unto the Father... Colossians 1:9-12

We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers; Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labor of love, and **patience** of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father... 1 Thessalonians 1:3

Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be **patient** toward all men. See that none render evil for evil unto any man; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all men. 1 Thessalonians 5:14-15

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith grows exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other abounds; So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your **patience** and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure... 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4

But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep you from evil. And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that you both do and will do the things which we command you. And the Lord direct your hearts into the love of God, and into the **patient** waiting for Christ. 2 Thessalonians 3:3-5

A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality, apt to teach; not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but **patient**, not a brawler, not covetous; one that rules well his own house, having his children in subjection with all gravity; (For if a man know not how to rule his own house, how shall he take care of the church of God?) not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil. 1 Timothy 3:2-6

For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, **patience**, meekness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto you are also called, and have professed a good profession before many witnesses. 1 Timothy 6:10-12

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, **patient**, in meekness instructing those who oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance... You have fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, charity, **patience**, persecutions, afflictions, which came unto me at Antioch, at Iconium, at Lystra; what persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. Yes, and all that will live godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. 2 Timothy 2:24-25, 3:10-12

But speak the things which become sound doctrine: That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in charity, in patience. Titus 2:2

And we desire that every one of you do show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end: that you be not slothful but followers of them who through faith and **patience** inherit the promises. For when God made promise to Abraham, because He could swear by no greater, He swore by Himself, Saying, Surely blessing I will bless you, and multiplying I will multiply you. And so, after he had **patiently** endured, he obtained the promise. Hebrews 6:11-15

Cast not away therefore your confidence, which has great recompense of reward. For you have need of **patience**, that, after you have done the will of God, you might receive the promise. For yet a little while, and He that shall come will come, and will not tarry. Hebrews 10:35-37

Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which does so easily beset us, and let us run with **patience** the race that is set before us, looking unto Jesus [Yeshua] the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:1-2

My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into divers temptations; Knowing this, that the trying of your faith works **patience**. But let **patience** have her perfect work, that you may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing. James 1:2-4

Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waits for the precious fruit of the earth, and has long **patience** for it, until he receive the early and latter rain. Be you also **patient**; stablish your hearts: for the coming of the Lord draws nigh. Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest you be condemned: behold, the judge stands before the door. James 5:7-9

Take, my brethren, the prophets, who have spoken in the name of the Lord, for an example of suffering affliction, and of **patience**. Behold, we count them happy which endure. You have heard of the **patience** of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy. James 5:10-11

For what glory is it, if, when you be buffeted for your faults, you shall take it patiently? But if, when you do well, and suffer for it, you take it **patiently**, this is acceptable with God. For even hereunto were you called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in His mouth: Who, when He was reviled, reviled not again; when He suffered, He threatened not; but committed Himself to Him that judges righteously... 1 Peter 2:20-23

Giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity...

...For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that you shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacks these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if you do these things, you shall never fall: For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting Kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though you know them, and be established in the present truth. 2 Peter 1:5-12

I John, who also am your brother, and companion in tribulation, and in the kingdom and **patience** of Jesus Christ, was in the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ. Revelations 1:9

I know your works, and your labor, and your **patience**, and how you can not bear them which are evil: and you have tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and have found them liars: and have borne, and have **patience**, and for my name's sake have labored, and have not fainted. Revelation 2:2-3

I know your works, and charity, and service, and faith, and your **patience**, and your works; and the last to be more than the first. Nothwithstanding I have a few things against you... Rev 2:19-20

Because you have kept the word of My **patience**, I also will keep you from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Revelation 3:10

If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leads into captivity shall go into captivity: he that kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the **patience** and the faith of the saints. Revelation 13:9-10

Here is the **patience** of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them. Revelation 14:12-13

REVERENCE

You shall keep My sabbaths, and **reverence** My sanctuary: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:30 and Leviticus 26:2

When Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did **reverence**. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold your servant! 2 Samuel 9:6

Bath-sheba bowed with her face to the earth, and did **reverence** to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever. 1 Kings 1:31

All the king's servants, that were in the king's gate, bowed, and **reverenced** Haman...But Mordecai bowed not, nor did him **reverence**...And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him **reverence**, then was Haman full of wrath. Esther 3:2, 5

God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in **reverence** of all them that are about Him. Psalm 89:7

He sent redemption unto His people: He has commanded His covenant for ever: holy and **reverend** is His name. Psalm 111:9

Last of all he sent unto them his son, saying, They will **reverence** my son. Matthew 21:37

Having yet therefore one son, his well beloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will **reverence** my son. Mark 12:6

Then said the lord...What shall I do? I will send my beloved son: it may be they will **reverence** him when they see him. Luke 20:13

Let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she **reverence** her husband. Ephesians 5:33

Furthermore we have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them **reverence**: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? Hebrews 12:9

Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with **reverence** and godly fear... Hebrews 12:28

STRENGTH

When you till the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto you her **strength**; a fugitive and a vagabond shall you be in the earth. Genesis 4:12

One told Jacob, and said, Behold, your son Joseph comes unto you: and Israel **strengthened** himself, and sat upon the bed... Reuben, you are my firstborn, my might, and the beginning of my **strength**, the excellency of dignity, and the excellency of power... Genesis 48:2; 49:3

God brought them out of Egypt; He has as it were the **strength** of an unicorn. Numbers 23:22

Charge Joshua, and encourage him, and **strengthen** him: for he shall go over before this people, and he shall cause them to inherit the land which you shall see. Deuteronomy 3:28

Your shoes shall be iron and brass; and as thy days, so shall your **strength** be. Deuteronomy 33:25

But as for the cities that stood still in their **strength**, Israel burned none of them, save Hazor only; that did Joshua burn. Joshua 11:13

As yet I am strong this day as I was in the day that Moses sent me: as my strength was then, even so is my **strength** now, for war, both to go out, and to come in. Joshua 14:11

The children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD: and the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD. Judges 3:12

You shall hear what they say; and afterward shall your hands be strengthened to go down unto the host. Then went he down with Phurah his servant unto the outside of the armed men that were in the host. Judges 7:11

Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, remember me, I pray thee, and **strengthen** me, I pray thee, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes. Judges 16:28

The bows of the mighty men are broken, and they that stumbled are girded with **strength**...He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by **strength** shall no man prevail. 1 Samuel 2:4, 9

Also the **Strength** of Israel will not lie nor repent: for he is not a man, that he should repent. 1 Samuel 15:29

And Jonathan Saul's son arose, and went to David into the wood, and **strengthened** his hand in God. 1 Samuel 23:16

Therefore now let your hands be **strengthened**, and be ye valiant: for your master Saul is dead, and also the house of Judah have anointed me king over them. 2 Samuel 2:7

God is my **strength** and power: and He makes my way perfect. ...For You have girded me with **strength** to battle: them that rose up against me have You subdued under me. 2 Samuel 22:33, 40

He arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the **strength** of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God. 1 Kings 19:8

And the prophet came to the king of Israel, and said unto him, Go, **strengthen** yourself, and mark, and see what you do: for at the return of the year the king of Syria will come up against you. 1 Kings 20:22

These also are the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who **strengthened** themselves with him in his kingdom, and with all Israel, to make him king, according to the word of the LORD concerning Israel. 1 Chronicles 11:10

Seek the LORD and His **strength**, seek His face continually. 1 Chronicles 16:11

Glory and honor are in His presence; **strength** and gladness are in His place. Give unto the LORD, you kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and **strength**. 1 Chronicles 16:27-28

All these of the sons of Obed-edom: they and their sons and their brethren, able men for **strength** for the service, were threescore and two of Obed-edom. 1 Chronicles 26:8

Solomon the son of David was **strengthened** in his kingdom, and the LORD his God was with him, and magnified him exceedingly. 2 Chronicles 1:1

So they **strengthened** the kingdom of Judah, and made Rehoboam the son of Solomon strong, three years: for three years they walked in the way of David and Solomon...When Rehoboam had established the kingdom, and had **strengthened** himself, he forsook the law of the LORD, and all Israel with him. 2 Chronicles 11:17, 12:1

There are gathered unto him vain men, the children of Belial, and have **strengthened** themselves against Rehoboarm the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and tenderhearted, and could not withstand them. 2 Chronicles 13:7

Neither did Jeroboam recover **strength** again in the days of Abijah: and the LORD struck him, and he died. 2 Chr 13:20

Now when Jehoram was risen up to the kingdom of his father, he **strengthened** himself, and slew all his brethren with the sword, and divers also of the princes of Israel. 2 Chronicles 21:4

In the seventh year Jehoiada **strengthened** himself, and took the captains of hundreds... into covenant with him. 2 Chronicles 23:1

So the workmen wrought, and the work was perfected by them, and they set the house of God in his state, and **strengthened** it. 2 Chronicles 24:13

Amaziah **strengthened** himself, and led forth his people, and went to the valley of salt, and smote of the children of Seir tenthousand. 2 Chronicles 25:11

The Ammonites gave gifts to Uzziah: and his name spread abroad even to the entering in of Egypt; for he **strengthened** himself exceedingly. 2 Chronicles 26:8

And Tilgath-pilneser king of Assyria came unto him, and distressed him, but **strengthened** him not. 2 Chronicles 28:20

He **strengthened** himself, and built up all the wall that was broken, and raised it up to the towers, and another wall without, and repaired Millo in the city of David... 2 Chronicles 32:5

All they that were about them **strengthened** their hands with vessels of silver, with gold, with goods, and with beasts, and with precious things, beside all that was willingly offered. Ezra 1:6

The children of Israel, which were come again out of captivity, and all such as had separated themselves unto them from the filthiness of the heathen of the land, to seek the LORD God of Israel, did eat, And kept the feast of unleavened bread seven days with joy: for the LORD had made them joyful, and turned the heart of the king of Assyria unto them, to **strengthen** their hands in the work of the house of God, the God of Israel. Ezra 6:21-22

Blesssed be the LORD God of our fathers, which hath put such a thing as this in the king's heart, to beautify the house of the LORD which is in Jerusalem: And hath extended mercy unto me before the king, and his counselors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was **strengthened** as the hand of the LORD my God was upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chie f men to go up with me. Ezra 7:27-28

Then I told them of the hand of my God which was good upon me; as also the king's words that he had spoken unto me. And they said, Let us rise up and build. So they **strengthened** their hands for this good work. Nehemiah 2:18

And Judah said, The **strength** of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and there is much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall. Nehemiah 4:10

For they all made us afraid, saying, Their hands shall be weakened from the work, that it be not done. Now therefore, O God, **strengthen** my hands. Nehemiah 6:9

The joy of the LORD is your **strength**. Nehemiah 8:10

Behold, you have instructed many, and you have **strengthened** the weak hands. Your words have upholden him that was falling, and you have **strengthened** the feeble knees. Job 4:3-4

With Him is wisdom and **strength**, He has counsel and understanding...With Him is **strength** and wisdom: the deceived and the deceiver are His. Job 12:13, 16

He pours contempt upon princes, and weakenes the **strength** of the mighty. Job 12:21

I would **strengthen** you with my mouth, and the moving of my lips should assuage your grief. Job 16:5

His **strength** shall be hungerbitten, and destruction shall be ready at his side. It shall devour the **strength** of his skin: even the firstborn of death shall devour his **strength**. Job 18:12-13

One dies in his full **strength**, being wholly at ease and quiet. Job 21:23

Behold, God is mighty, and despises not any: He is mighty in **strength** and wisdom. Job 36:5

The sting of death is sin; and the **strength** of sin is the law. 1 Corinthians 15:56

They that make them are like unto them: so is every one that **trusts** in them. O Israel, **trust** you in the LORD: He is their hope and their shield. O house of Aaron, **trust** in the LORD: He is their help and their shield. You that fear the LORD, **trust** in the LORD: He is their help and their shield. Psalm 115:8-11

It is better to **trust** in the LORD than to put confidence in man. It is better to **trust** in the LORD than to put confidence in princes. Psalm 118:8-9

So shall I have wherewith to answer him that reproaches me: for I **trust** in Your word. Psalm 119:42

They that **trust** in the LORD shall be as mount Zion, which cannot be removed, but abides for ever. Psalm 125:1

But my eyes are unto you, O GOD the Lord: in You is my **trust**; leave not my soul destitute. Cause me to hear Your lovingkindness in the morning; for in You do I **trust**; cause me to know the way wherein I should walk... Psalm 141:8; 143:8

Blessed be the LORD [YEHOVAH] my strength, which teaches my hands to war, and my fingers to fight: My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and He in whom I **trust**; who subdues my people under me. Psalm 144:1-2

Put not your **trust** in princes, nor in the son of man, in whom there is no help. Psalm 146:3

Trust in the LORD with all your heart; and lean not unto your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths. Proverbs 3:5-6

He that **trusts** in his riches shall fall: but the righteous shall flourish as a branch. Proverbs 11:28

He that handles a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso **trusts** in the LORD [YEHOVAH], happy is he. Proverbs 16:20

Bow down your ear, and hear the words of the wise, and apply your heart unto my knowledge. For it is a pleasant thing if you keep them within you; they shall withal be fitted in your lips. That your **trust** may be in the LORD, I have made known to you this day, even to you. Proverbs 22:17-19

He that is of a proud heart stirs up strife: but he that puts his **trust** in the LORD shall be made fat. (happy) He that **trusts** in his own heart is a fool: but whoso walks wisely, he shall be delivered... The fear of man brings a snare: but whoso puts his **trust** in the LORD shall be safe. Proverbs 28:25-26; 29:25

Every word of God is pure: He is a shield unto them that put their **trust** in Him. Proverbs 30:5

The heart of her husband does safely **trust** in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil. Proverbs 31:11

Behold, God is my salvation; I will **trus**t, and not be afraid: for the LORD YEHOVAH is my strength and my song; He also is become my salvation. Isaiah 12:2

The LORD has founded Zion, and the poor of His people shall **trust** in it. Isaiah 14:32

You will keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on You: because he **trusts** in You. **Trust** you in the LORD for ever: for in the LORD YEHOVAH is everlasting strength... Isaiah 26:3-4

Woe to the rebellious children, says the LORD, that take counsel, but not of Me; and that cover with a covering, but not of My spirit, that they may add sin to sin: That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at My mouth; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to **trust** in the shadow of Egypt! Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your shame, and the **trust** in the shadow of Egypt your confusion...Wherefore thus says the Holy One of Israel, Because you despise this word, and **trust** in oppression and perverseness, and stay thereon: Therefore this iniquity shall be to you as a breach ready to fall, swelling out in a high wall, whose breaking comes suddenly at an instant. Isaiah 30:1-3, 12-13

Woe to them that go down to Egypt for help; and stay on horses, and **trust** in chariots, because they are many; and in horsemen, because they are very strong; but they look not unto the Holy One of Israel, neither seek the LORD [YEHOVAH]! Isaiah 31:1

They shall be turned back, they shall be greatly ashamed, that **trust** in graven images, that say to the molten images, You are our gods...For you **trusted** in your wickedness: you have said, None sees me. Your wisdom and your knowledge, it has perverted you; and you have said in your heart, I am, and none else beside me. Isaiah 42:17; 47:10

Who is among you that fears the LORD, that obeys the voice of His servant, that walks in darkness, and has no light? Let him **trust** in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God... My righteousness is near; my salvation is gone forth, and mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, and on mine arm shall they **trust**. Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look upon the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish... And the earth wax old...but My salvation shall be for ever, and My righteousness shall not be abolished. Isaiah 50:10; 51:5-6

He that puts his **trust** in Me shall possess the land, and shall inherit My holy mountain... Isaiah 57:13

None calls for justice, nor any pleads for truth: they **trust** in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. Isaiah 59:4

They shall eat up your harvest, and your bread, which your sons and your daughters should eat: they shall eat up your flocks and your herds: they shall eat up your vines and your fig trees: they shall impoverish your fenced cities, wherein you **trusted**, with the sword. Jeremiah 5:17

Trust you not in lying words, saying. The temple of the LORD, The temple of the LORD, The temple of the LORD, are these. For if you throughly amend your ways and your doings; if you throughly execute judgment between a man and his neighbor; If you oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt: Then will I cause you to dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers, for ever and ever. Behold, you trust in lying words, that cannot profit. Will you steal, murder, and commit adultery, and swear falsely, and burn incense unto Baal, and walk after other gods whom you know not; And come and stand before Me in this house, which is called by My name, and say, We are delivered to do all these abominations? ... Therefore will I do unto this house, which is called by My name, wherein you trust, and unto the place which I gave to you and to your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh. Jeremiah 7:4-10, 14

If you have run with the footmen, and they have wearied you, then how can you contend with horses? And if in the land of peace, wherein you **trusted**, they wearied you, then how will you do in the swelling of Jordan? Jeremiah 12:5

This is your lot, the portion of your measure from Me, says the LORD; because you have forgotten Me, and **trusted** in falsehood. Jeremiah 13:25

Thus says the LORD; Cursed be the man that **trusts** in man, and makes flesh his arm, and whose heart departs from the LORD... Blessed is the man that **trusts** in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is. Jeremiah 17:5-7

Thus says the LORD concerning Shemaiah the Nehelamite; Because that Shemaiah has prophesied unto you, and I sent him not, and he caused you to **trust** in a lie...Behold, I will punish Shemaiah the Nehelamite, and his seed: he shall not have a man to dwell among this people... Jeremiah 29:31-32

For I will surely deliver you, and you shall not fall by the sword, but your life shall be for a prey unto you: because you have put your **trust** in Me, says the LORD. Jeremiah 39:18

For because you have **trusted** in your works and in your treasures, you shall also be taken: and Chemosh shall go forth into captivity with his priests and his princes together. Jeremiah 48:7

Wherefore glory you in the valleys, your flowing valley, O backsliding daughter? That **trusted** in her treasures, saying, Who shall come unto Me? Jeremiah 49:4

Leave your fatherless children, I will preserve them alive; and let your widows **trust** in Me. Jeremiah 49:11

When I shall say to the righteous, that he shall surely live; if he **trust** to his own righteousness, and commit iniquity, all his righteousnesses shall not be remembered; but for his iniquity that he has committed, he shall die for it. Ezekiel 33:13

Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abed-nego, who has sent his angel, and delivered his servants that **trusted** in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God. Daniel 3:28

You have plowed wickedness, you have reaped iniquity; you have eaten the fruit of lies: because you did **trust** in your way, in the multitude of your mighty men. Hosea 10:13

Woe to them that are at ease in Zion, and **trust** in the mountain of Samaria, which are named chief of the nations, to whom the house of Israel came! Amos 6:1

The LORD is good, a strong hold in the day of trouble; and He knows them that **trust** in Him. But with an overrunning flood He will make an utter end of the place thereof... Nahum 1:7-8

What profits the graven image that the maker thereof has graven it; the molten image, and a teacher of lies, that the maker of his work **trusts** therein, to make dumb idols? Habakkuk 2:18

She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she **trusted** not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God. Zephaniah 3:2

I will also leave in the midst of you an afflicted and poor people, and they shall **trust** in the name of the LORD. Zephaniah 3:12

Behold My servant, whom I have chosen; My beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased: I will put My spirit upon him, and he shall shew judgment to the Gentiles...And in His name shall the Gentiles **trust**. Matthew 12:18, 21

He **trusted** in God; let Him deliver him now, if He will have him: for He said, I am the Son of God. Matthew 27:43

But Jesus [Yeshua] answered again, and said unto them, Children, how hard is it for them that **trust** in riches to enter into the Kingdom of God! Mark 10:24

When a strong man armed keeps his palace, his goods are in peace: But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he takes from him all his armor wherein he **trusted**, and divides his spoils. Luke 11:21-22

He spake this parable unto certain which **trusted** in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others... Luke 18:9

They said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people...we **trusted** that it had been He which should have redeemed Israel... Luke 24:19, 21

Esaias said, There shall be a root of Jesse, and He that shall rise to reign over the Gentiles; in Him shall the Gentiles **trust**. Romans 15:12

Whensoever I take my journey into Spain, I will come to you: for I **trust** to see you in my journey...For I will not see you now by the way; but I **trust** to tarry a while with you, if the Lord permit. Romans 15:24; 1 Corinthians 16:7

But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not **trust** in ourselves, but in God which raises the dead: Who delivered us from so great a death, and does deliver: in whom we **trust** that He will yet deliver us...For we write none other things unto you, than what you read or acknowledge; and I **trust** you shall acknowledge even to the end... 2 Corinthians 1:9-10, 13

You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read of all men: Forasmuch as you are manifestly declared to be the epistle of Christ ministered by us, written not with ink, but with the Spirit of the living God; not in tables of stone, but in fleshy tables of the heart. And such **trust** have we through Christ to God-ward: Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God... 2 Corinthians 3:2-5

Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I **trust** also are made manifest in your consciences. 2 Corinthians 5:11

Do you look on things after the outward appearance? If any man **trust** to himself that he is Christ's [the Messiah's], let him of himself think this again, that, as he is Christ's, even so are we Christ's. 2 Corinthians 10:7

I **trust** that you shall know that we are not reprobates. 2 Corinthians 13:6

That we should be to the praise of His glory, who first **trusted** in Christ. In whom you also **trusted**, after that you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation... Ephesians 1:12-13

But I **trust** in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good comfort, when I know your state...But I **trust** in the LORD that I also myself shall come shortly. Philippians 2:19, 24

Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinks that he has whereof he might **trust** in the flesh, I more... Philippians 3:4

But as we were allowed of God to be put in **trust** with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which tries the hearts. 1 Thessalonians 2:4

We know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully...According to the glorious gospel of the blessed God, which was committed to my **trust**. 1 Timothy 1:11

For therefore we both labor and suffer reproach, because we **trus**t in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, specially of those that believe. 1 Timothy 4:10

Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, **trusts** in God, and continues in supplications and prayers night and day. 1 Timothy 5:5

Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor **trust** in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy. That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life. O Timothy, keep that which is committed to your **trust**, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with you. Amen. 1 Tim 6:17-21

I **trust** that through your prayers I shall be given to you. Phile 1:22

...I will declare Your name unto my brethren, in the midst of the church will I sing praise unto You. And again, I will put my **trust** in Him. Hebrews 2:12-13
