## LOVINGKINDNESS

Show Your marvelous **lovingkindness**, O You who saves by Your right hand those who put their trust in You from those that rise up against them. Keep me as the apple of Your eye, hide me under the shadow of Your wings, From the wicked who oppress me, from my deadly enemies, who compass me about. Psalm 17:7-9

Remember, O LORD, Your tender mercies and Your **lovingkindnesses**; for they have been ever of old. Psalm 25:6

For Your **lovingkindness** is before mine eyes: and I have walked in Your truth. Psalm 26:3

How excellent is Your **lovingkindness**, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings... O continue Your **lovingkindness** unto them that know Thee; and Your righteousness to the upright in heart. Psalm 36:7, 10

I have not hid Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation: I have not concealed Your **lovingkindness** and Your truth from the great congregation. Withhold not Your tender mercies from me, O LORD: let Your **lovingkindness**, and Your truth continually preserve me. Ps 40:11

Yet the LORD will command His **lovingkindness** in the daytime, and in the night His song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life. Psalm 42:8

We have thought of Your **lovingkindness**, O God, in the midst of Your temple. Psalm 48:9

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your **lovingkindness**: according unto the multitude of Your tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Psalm 51:1

Because Your **lovingkindness** is better than life, my lips shall praise Thee. Psalm 63:3

Hear me, O LORD; for Your **lovingkindness** is good: turn unto me according to the multitude of Your tender mercies. Psalm 69:16

Shall Your **lovingkindness** be declared in the grave? Or Your faithfulness in destruction? Shall Your wonders be known in the dark? And Your righteousness in the land of forgetfulness? But unto You have I cried, O LORD: and in the morning shall my prayer prevent [anticipate] Thee. Psalm 88:11-13

Nevertheless My **lovingkindness** will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer My faithfulness to fail...Lord, where are Your former **lovingkindnesses**, which You sware unto David in Your truth? Psalm 89:33, 49

It is a good thing to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto Your name, O Most High: To shew forth Your **lovingkindness** in the morning, and Your faithfulness every night, upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound. Psalm 92:1-3

Bless the LORD, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases. Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with **lovingkindness** and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagles. Psalm 103:1-5

Yet sets He the poor on high from affliction, and makes him families like a flock. The righteous shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the **lovingkindness** of the LORD. Psalm 107:41-43

Quicken me after your **lovingkindness**; so shall I keep the testimony of Your mouth...Hear my voice according unto Your **lovingkindness**: O LORD, quicken me according to Your judgment...Consider how I love Your precepts: quicken me, O LORD, according to Your **lovingkindness**. Ps 119:88, 149, 159

I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your **lovingkindness** and for Your truth: for You have magnified Your word above all Your name. Psalm 138:2

Cause me to hear Your **lovingkindness** in the morning; for in Thee do I trust... Psalm 143:8

I will mention the **lovingkindnesses** of the LORD, and the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD has bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which He has bestowed on them according to His mercies, and according to the multitude of His **lovingkindnesses**. For He said, Surely they are My people, children that will not lie: so He was their Savior. In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them: in His **love** and in His pity he redeemed them; and He bare them, and carried them all the days of old. Isaiah 63:7-9

Thus says the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD which exercise **lovingkindness**, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, says the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23-24

For thus says the LORD, Enter not into the house of mourning, neither go to lament nor bemoan them: for I have taken away My peace from this people, says the LORD, even **lovingkindness** and mercies. Jeremiah 16:5

The LORD has appeared of old unto me, saying, Yes, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with **lovingkindness** have I drawn thee. Jeremiah 31:3

You show **lovingkindness** unto thousands, and recompense the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, is His name, Great in counsel, and mighty in work: for Your eyes are open upon all the ways of the sons of men: to give every one according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings... Jeremiah 32:18-19

I will betroth you unto Me for ever; yea, I will betroth you unto Me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in **lovingkindness**, and in mercies. Hosea 2:19

He said, Take now your son, your only son Isaac, whom you **love**, and get you into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell you of. Genesis 22:2

Isaac brought her into his mother Sarah's tent, and took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he **loved** her; and Isaac was comforted after his mother's death. Genesis 24:67

Isaac **loved** Esau, because he did eat of his venison: but Rebekah **loved** Jacob. Genesis 25:28

Make me savory meat, such as I **love**, and bring it to me, that I may eat; that my soul may bless you before I die...Go now to the flock, and fetch me from thence two good kids of the goats; and I will make them savory meat for your father, such as he **loves**...He went, and fetched, and brought them to his mother: and his mother made savory meat, such as his father **loved**. Genesis 27:4, 9,14

Jacob **loved** Rachel; and said, I will serve you seven years for Rachel your younger daughter...and Jacob served seven years for Rachel; and they seemed unto him but a few days, for the **love** he had to her...He went in also unto Rachel, and he **loved** also Rachel more than Leah, and served with him yet seven other years. Genesis 29:18, 20, 30

Leah conceived, and bare a son, and she called his name Reuben: for she said, Surely the LORD has looked upon my affliction; now therefore my husband will **love** me. Genesis 29:32

And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he **loved** the damsel, and spoke kindly unto the damsel. Genesis 34:3

Now Israel **loved** Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age; and he made him a coat of many colors. Genesis 37:3

And we said unto my lord, We have a father, an old man, and a child of his old age, a little one; and his brother is dead, and he alone is left of his mother, and his father **loves** him. Genesis 44:20

I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate Me; and showing mercy unto thousands of them that **love** Me, and keep My commandments. Exodus 20:5-6

If the servant shall plainly say, I **love** my master, my wife, and my children; I will not go out free. Then his master shall bring him unto the judges; he shall also bring him to the door, or unto the doorpost; and his master shall bore his ear through with an awl; and he shall serve him for ever. Exodus 21:5-6

You shall not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall **love** your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:18

But the stranger that dwells with you shall be unto you as one born among you, and you shall **love** him as yourself; for you were strangers in the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God. Leviticus 19:34

Because He **loved** your fathers, therefore He chose their seed after them, and brought you out in His sight with His mighty power out of Egypt...I the LORD your God am a jealous God...showing mercy unto thousands of them that **love** Me and keep My commandments... You shall **love** the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Deuteronomy 4:37; 5:9-10; 6:5

The LORD did not set His **love** upon you, nor choose you, because you were more in number than any people; for you were the fewest of all people: But because the LORD **loved** you, and because He would keep the oath which He had sworn unto your fathers, has the LORD brought you out with a mighty hand, and redeemed you out of the house of bondmen, from the hand of Pharaoh king of Egypt. Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that **love** Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations... He will **love** you, and bless you, and multiply you: He will also bless the fruit of your womb, and the fruit of your land, your corn, and your wine, and your oil, the increase of your kine, and the flocks of your sheep, in the land which He swore unto your fathers to give you. Deut 7:7-9, 13

And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, and to **love** Him, and to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, to keep his commandments of the LORD, and His statutes, which I command you this day for your good? Behold, the Heaven and the Heaven of Heavens is the LORD'S your God, the earth also, with all that therein is. Only the LORD had a delight in your fathers to **love** them, and He chose their seed after them, even you above all people, as it is this day...He does execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and **loves** the stranger, in giving him food and raiment. **Love** you therefore the stranger: for you were strangers... Deuteronomy 10:12-15, 18-19

Therefore you shall love the LORD your God, and keep His charge, and His statutes, and His judgments, and His commandments, always... And it shall come to pass, if you shall hearken diligently unto My commandments which I command you this day, to love the LORD your God, and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul, That I will give you the rain of your land in His due season, the first rain and the latter rain, that you may gather in your corn, and your wine, and your oil. And I will send grass in your fields for your cattle, that you may eat and be full. Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and you turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them...For if you shall diligently keep all these commandments which I command you, to do them, to love the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways, and to cleave unto Him; Then will the LORD drive out all these nations from before you, and you shall possess greater nations and mightier than yourselves. Deuteronomy 11:1, 13-16, 22-23

You shall not hearken unto the words of that prophet, or that dreamer of dreams: for the LORD your God proves you, to know whether you **love** the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. Deuteronomy 13:3

If he say unto **you**, I will not go away from you; because he **loves** you and your house, because he is well with you; Then you shall take an awl, and thrust it through his ear unto the door, and he shall be your servant or ever. And also unto your maidservant you shall do likewise. Deuteronomy 15:16-17

If you shall keep all these commandments to do them, which I command you this day, to **love** the LORD your God, and to walk ever in His ways; then shall you add three cities more for you, beside these three... Deuteronomy 19:9

Nevertheless the LORD your God would not hearken unto Balaam; but the LORD your God turned the curse into a blessing unto you, because the LORD your God **loved** you. Deut 23:5

The LORD your God will circumcise your heart, and the heart of your seed, to **love** the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, that you may live. Deuteronomy 30:6

In that I command you this day to **love** the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, to keep His commandments and His statutes and His judgments, that you may live and multiply: and the LORD your God shall bless you in the land whither you go to possess it...That you may **love** the LORD your God, and that you may obey His voice, and that you may cleave unto Him: for He is your life, and the length of your days: that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore unto your fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, to give them. Deuteronomy 30:16, 20

But take diligent heed to do the commandment and the law, which Moses the servant of the LORD charged you, to **love** the LORD your God, and to walk in all His ways, and to keep His commandments, and to cleave unto Him, and to serve Him with all your heart and with all your soul. Joshua 22:5

Take good heed therefore unto yourselves, that you **love** the LORD your God. Joshua 23:11

So let all Your enemies perish, O LORD: but let them that **love** Him be as the sun when he goes forth in his might. And the land had rest forty years. Judges 5:31

Samson's wife wept before him, and said, You do hate me, and **love** me not: you have put forth a riddle unto the children of my people, and have not told it me. And he said unto her, Behold, I have not told it my father nor my mother, and shall I tell it you? ..And it came to pass afterward, that he **loved** a woman in the valley of Sorek, whose name is Delilah. Judges 14:16; 16:4

She said unto him, How can you say, I **love** you, when your heart is not with me? You have mocked me these three times, and have not told me wherein your great strength lies. Judges 16:15

He shall be unto you a restorer of your life, and a nourisher of your old age: for your daughter in law, which **loves** you, who is better than seven sons, has born him. Ruth 4:15

Unto Hannah he gave a worthy portion; for he **loved** Hannah: but the LORD had shut up her womb. 1 Samuel 1:5

And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he **loved** him greatly; and he became his armorbearer. 1 Samuel 16:21

It came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan **loved** him as his own soul. Then Jonathan and David made a covenant, because he **loved** him as his own soul...And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he **loved** him: for he **loved** him as he **loved** his own soul. 1 Samuel 18:1, 3; 20:17

But all Israel and Judah **loved** David, because he went out and came in before them. 1 Samuel 18:16

Michal Saul's daughter **loved** David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him...and Saul commanded his servants, saying, Commune with David secretly, and say, Behold, the king has delight in you, and all his servants **love** you: now therefore be the king's son in law...and Saul saw and knew that the LORD was with David, and that Michal Saul's daughter **loved** him. 1 Samuel 18:20, 22, 28

And David lamented with this lamentation over Saul and over Jonathan his son...Saul and Jonathan were **lovely** and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions...I am distressed for you, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant have you been unto me: your **love** to me was wonderful, passing the love of women. 2 Samuel 1:18, 23, 26

David comforted Bath-sheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her; and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon: and the LORD **loved** him. 2 Samuel 12:24

He said unto him, Why are you, being the king's son, lean from day to day? Will you not tell me? And Amnon said unto him, I **love** Tamar, my brother Absalom's sister...Then Amnon hated her exceedingly; so that the hatred wherewith he hated her was greater than the **love** wherewith he had **loved** her. And Amnon said unto her, Arise, be gone. 2 Samuel 13:4, 15

Solomon **loved** the LORD, walking in the statutes of David his father: only he sacrificed and burnt incense in high places. 1 Kings 3:3

Hiram king of Tyre sent his servants unto Solomon; for he had heard that they had anointed him king in the room of his father: for Hiram was ever a **lover** of David. 1 Kings 5:1 (holy, brotherly love)

Blessed be the LORD your God, which delighted in you, to set you on the throne of Israel: because the LORD **loved** Israel for ever, therefore made He you a king, to do judgment and justice. 1 Kings 10:9

King Solomon **loved** many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, and Hittites; of the nations concerning which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, You shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: for surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in **love**. 1 Kings 11:1-2 (unholy)

Then Huram the king of Tyre answered in writing, which he sent to Solomon, Because the LORD has **loved** His people, He has made you king over them. 2 Chronicles 2:11

Blessed be the LORD your God, which delighted in you to set you on his throne, to be king for the LORD your God: because your God **loved** Israel, to establish them for ever, therefore made He you a king over them, to do judgment and justice. 2 Chr 9:8

Rehoboam **loved** Maachah the daughter of Absalom above all his wives and his concubines: (for he took eighteen wives, and threescore concubines; and begat twenty and eight sons, and threescore daughters.) 2 Chronicles 11:21

Jehu the son of Hanani the seer went out to meet him, and said to king Jehoshaphat, Should you help the ungodly, and **love** them that hate the LORD? Therefore is wrath upon you from before the LORD. 2 Chronicles 19:2

Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen also, and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he **loved** husbandry. 2 Chronicles 26:10

I beseech you, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keeps covenant and mercy for them that **love** Him and observe His commandments... Nehemiah 1:5

The king **loved** Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favor in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2:17

All my inward friends abhorred me: and they whom I **loved** are turned against me. Job 19:19

O you sons of men, how long will you turn My glory into shame? How long will you **love** vanity, and seek after leasing? Selah. Psalm 4:2

But let all those that put their trust in You rejoice: let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them: let them also that **love** Your name be joyful in You. Psalm 5:11

The LORD tries the righteous: but the wicked and him that **loves** violence his soul hates. Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: this shall be the portion of their cup. For the righteous LORD **loves** righteousness; His countenance beholds the upright. Psalm 11:5-7

I will love You, O LORD, my strength. Psalm 18:1

LORD, I have **loved** the habitation of Your house, and the place where Your honor dwells. Psalm 26:8

O **love** the LORD, all you His saints: for the LORD preserves the faithful, and plentifully rewards the proud doer. Psalm 31:23

For the word of the LORD is right; and all His works are done in truth. He **loves** righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD. Psalm 33:4-5

What man is he that desires life, and **loves** many days, that he may see good? Psalm 34:12

For the LORD **loves** judgment, and forsakes not His saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off. Psalm 37:28

My **lovers** and my friends stand aloof from my sore; and my kinsmen stand afar off. Psalm 38:11

Let all those that seek You rejoice and be glad in Thee: let such as **love** Your salvation say continually, The LORD be magnified. Psalm 40:16

You **love** righteousness, and hate wickedness: therefore God, Your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Psalm 45:7

He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom He **loved**. Selah. Psalm 47:4

You **love** evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah. You **love** all devouring words, O you deceitful tongue. Psalm 52:3-4

The seed also of His servants shall inherit it: and they that **love** His name shall dwell therein. Psalm 69:36

Let all those that seek You rejoice and be glad in Thee: and let such as **love** Your salvation say continually, Let God be magnified. Psalm 70:4

Moreover He refused the tabernacle of Joseph, and chose not the tribe of Ephraim: But chose the tribe of Judah, the mount Zion which He **loved**...The LORD **loves** the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob. Psalm 78:68; 87:2

**Lover** and friend have You put far from me, and mine acquaintance into darkness. Psalm 88:18

Because he has set his **love** upon Me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he has known My name. Psalm 91:14

You that **love** the LORD, hate evil: He preserves the souls of His saints; He delivers them out of the hand of the wicked. Psalm 97:10

The king's strength also **loves** judgment; You do establish equity, You execute judgment and righteousness in Jacob. Psalm 99:4

For my **love** they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer. And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my **love**. Psalm 109:4-5

As he **loved** cursing, so let it come unto him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him. Psalm 109:17

I **love** the LORD, because He has heard my voice and my supplications. Psalm 116:1

O how I **love** Your law! It is my meditation all the day...I hate vain thoughts: but Your law I do **love**. Psalm 119:97, 113

You put away all the wicked of the earth like dross: therefore I **love** Your testimonies...Therefore I **love** Your commandments above gold; yes, above fine gold. Psalm 119:119, 127

Look upon me, and be merciful unto me, as you used to do unto those that **love** Your name. Psalm 119:132

Your word is very pure: therefore Your servant **loves** it. Psalm 119:140

Consider how I **love** Your precepts: quicken me, O LORD, according to Your lovingkindness. Psalm 119:159

I hate and abhor lying: but Your law do I **love**...Great peace have they which **love** Your law: and nothing shall offend them. Psalm 119:163, 165

My soul has kept Your testimonies; and I **love** them exceedingly. Psalm 119:167

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that **love** Thee. Psalm 122:6

The LORD preserves all those who **love** Him: but all the wicked will He destroy. Psalm 145:20

The LORD opens the eyes of the blind: the LORD raises them that are bowed down: the LORD **loves** the righteous... Psalm 146:8

How long, you simple ones, will you **love** simplicity? And the scorners delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge? Proverbs 1:22

For whom the LORD **loves** He corrects; even as a father the son in whom he delights. Proverbs 3:12

Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of my mouth. Forsake her not, and she shall preserve you: **love** her, and she shall keep you. Proverbs 4:5-6

Let her be as the loving hind and pleasant roe; let her breasts satisfy you at all times; and be ravished always with her **love**. Proverbs 5:19 (holylove)

Come, let us take our fill of **love** until the morning: let us solace ourselves with **love**. Proverbs 7:18 (seduction - not holy love)

I wisdom dwell with prudence...The fear of the LORD is to hate evil: pride, and arrogancy, and the evil way, and the froward mouth, do I hate. Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom: I am understanding; I have strength...I **love** them that **love** me; and those that seek me early shall find me. Proverbs 8:12-14, 17

I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment: That I may cause those that **love** me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasure. Proverbs 8:20-21

He that sins against me wrongs his own soul: all they that hate me **love** death. Proverbs 8:36

Reprove not a scorner, lest he hate you: rebuke a wise man, and he will **love** you. Proverbs 9:8

Whoso **loves** instruction **loves** knowledge: but he that hates reproof is brutish. Proverbs 12:1

He that spares his rod hates his son: but he that **loves** him chastens him at times. Proverbs 13:24

The way of the wicked is an abomination unto the LORD: but He **loves** him that follows after righteousness. Proverbs 15:9

A scorner **loves** not one that reproves him: neither will he go unto the wise. Proverbs 15:12

Better is a dinner of herbs where **love** is, than a stalled ox and hatred therewith. Proverbs 15:17

Righteous lips are the delight of kings; and they **love** him that speaks right. Proverbs 16:13

He that covers a transgression seeks **love**; but he that repeats a matter separates very friends. Proverbs 17:9

A friend **loves** at all times, and a brother is born for adversity... He **loves** transgression that **loves** strife: and he that exalts his gate seeks destruction. Proverbs 17:17:17, 19

Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that **love** it shall eat the fruit thereof. Proverbs 18:21

He that gets wisdom **loves** his own soul: he that keep understanding shall find good. Proverbs 19:8

**Love** not sleep, lest you come to poverty; open your eyes, and you shall be satisfied with bread. Proverbs 20:13

He that **loves** pleasure shall be a poor man: he that **loves** wine and oil shall not be rich. Proverbs 21:17

A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and **loving** favor rather than silver and gold. Proverbs 22:1

He that **loves** pureness of heart, for the grace of his lips the king shall be his friend. Proverbs 22:11

Open rebuke is better than secret **love**. Proverbs 27:5

Whoso **loves** wisdom rejoices his father: but he that keeps company with harlots spends his substance. Proverbs 29:3

A time to **love**, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of peace. Ecclesiastes 3:8

He that **loves** silver shall not be satisfied with silver; nor he that **loves** abundance with increase: this is also vanity. Eccl 5:10

For all this I considered in my heart even to declare all this, that the righteous, and the wise, and their works, are in the hand of God: no man knows either **love** or hatred by all that is before them. Ecclesiastes 9:1

Also their **love**, and their hatred, and their envy, is now perished; neither have they any more a portion for ever in any thing that is done under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:6

Live joyfully with the wife whom you **love** all the days of the life of your vanity, which He has given you under the sun, all the days of your vanity: for that is your portion in this life, and in your labor which you take under the sun. Ecclesiastes 9:9

Let him kiss me with the kisses of his mouth: for your **love** is better than wine. Because of the savor of your good ointments your name is as ointment poured forth, therefore do the virgins **love** you. Draw me, we will run after you: the king has brought me into his chambers: we will be glad and rejoice in you, we will remember your **love** more than wine: the upright **love** you. Song of Solomon 1:2-4

Tell me, O you whom my soul **loves**, where you feed, where you make your flock to rest at noon: for why should I be as one that turns aside by the flocks of your companions? ... I have compared you, O my **love**, to a company of horses in Pharaoh's chariots... Behold, you are fair, my **love**; behold, you are fair; you have doves' eyes. Song of Solomon 1:7, 9, 15

As the lily among thorns, so is my **love** among the daughters... He brought me to his banqueting house, and his banner over me was **love**. Stay me with flagons, comfort me with apples: for I am sick of **love**... Song of Solomon 2:2, 4-5

I charge you, O you daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that you stir not up, nor awake my **love**, till he please...My beloved spoke, and said unto me, Rise up, my **love**, my fair one, and come away...The fig tree puts forth her green figs, and the vines with tender grape give a good smell. Arise, my **love**, my fair one, and come away. Song of Solomon 2:7, 10, 13

By night on my bed I sought him whom my soul **loves**: I sought him, but I found him not. I will rise now, and go about the city in the streets, and in the broad ways I will seek him whom my soul **loves**: I sought him, but I found him not. The watchmen that go about the city found me; to whom I said, Saw you him whom my soul **loves**? Song of Solomon 3:1-3

It was but a little that I passed from them, but I found him whom my soul **loves**: I held him, and would not let him go, until I had brought him into my mother's house, and into the chamber of her that conceived me...I charge you, O you daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that you stir not up, nor awake my **love**, till he please. Song of Solomon 3:4-5

He made the pillars thereof of silver, the bottom thereof of gold, the covering of it of purple, the midst thereof being paved with **love**, for the daughters of Jerusalem. Song of Solomon 3:10

Behold, you are fair, my **love**; behold, you are fair; you have doves' eyes within your locks: your hair is as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead...You are all fair, my **love**; there is no spot in you...How fair is your **love**, my sister, my spouse! How much better is your **love** than wine! And the smell of thine ointments than all spices. Song of Solomon 4:1, 7, 10

I sleep, but my heart wakes: it is the voice of my beloved that knocks, saying, Open to me, My sister, my **love**, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, and my locks with the drops of the night. Song of Solomon 5:2

I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, if you find my beloved, that you tell him, that I am sick of **love**...His mouth is most sweet: yes, he is altogether **lovely**. This is my **beloved**, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem. Song of Solomon 5:8, 16

You are beautiful, O my **love**, as Tirzah, comely as Jerusalem, terrible as an army with banners. Song of Solomon 6:4

How fair and how pleasant are you, O **love**, for delights! Song of Solomon 7:6

I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, that you stir not up, nor awake my **love**, until he please..Set me as a seal upon your heart, as a seal upon your arm: for **love** is strong as death; jealousy is cruel as the grave: the coals thereof are coals of fire, which has a most vehement flame. Many waters cannot quench **love**, neither can the floods drown it: if a man would give all the substance of his house for **love**, it would utterly be contemned. Song of Solomon 8:4, 6-7

Your princes are rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one **loves** gifts, and follows after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither does the cause of the widow come unto them. Isaiah 1:23

Behold, for peace I had great bitterness: but you have in **love** to my soul delivered it from the pit of corruption: for you have cast all my sins behind your back. Isaiah 38:17

All you, assemble yourselves, and hear; which among them has declared these thing? The LORD has **loved** him: He will do His pleasure on Babylon, and His arm shall be on the Chaldeans. Isaiah 48:14

Also the sons of the stranger, that join themselves to the LORD, to serve Him, and to **love** the name of the LORD, to be His servants, every one that keeps the sabbath from polluting it, and takes hold of My covenant; Even them will I bring to My holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of prayer... Isaiah 56:6-7

His watchmen are blind: they are all ignorant, they are all dumb dogs, they cannot bark; sleeping, lying down, **loving** to slumber. Isaiah 56:10

For I the LORD **love** judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Isaiah 61:8

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence saved them: in His **love** and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bare them, and carried them all the days of old. Isaiah 63:9

Rejoice you with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you that **love** her: rejoice for joy with her, all you that mourn for her... Isaiah 66:10

Cry in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, Thus says the LORD; I remember you, the kindness of your youth, the **love** of your espousals, when you went after me in the wilderness, in a land that was not sown. Jeremiah 2:2

Withhold your foot from being unshod, and your throat from thirst:but you said, there is no hope: no; for I have **loved** strangers, and after them will I go...Why trim you your way to seek **love?** Therefore have you also taught the wicked ones your ways. Jeremiah 2:25, 33

They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? Shall not that land be greatly polluted? But you have played the harlot with many **lover's** yet return again to Me, says the LORD. Jeremiah 3:1

When **you are** spoiled, what will you do? Though you clothe yourself with crimson, though you deck yourself with ornaments of gold, though you rent your face with painting, in vain shall you make yourself fair; your **lovers** will despise you, they will seek your life. Jeremiah 4:30

The prophets prophesy falsely, and the priests bear rule by their means; and My people **love** to have it so: and what will you do in the end thereof? Jeremiah 5:31

And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have **loved**, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshiped: they shall not be gathered, nor be buried; they shall be for dung upon the face of the earth. Jeremiah 8:2

Thus have they **loved** to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD does not accept them; He will now remember their iniquity, and visit their sins. Jeremiah 14:10

Go up to Lebanon, and cry; and lift up your voice in Bashan, and cry from the passages: for all your **lovers** are destroyed...The wind shall eat up all your pastors, and your **lovers** shall go into captivity: surely then shall you be ashamed and confounded for all your wickedness. Jeremiah 22:20, 22

All your **lovers** have forgotten you; they seek you not; for I have wounded you with the wound of an enemy, with the chastisement of a cruel one, for the multitude of your iniquity; because your sins were increased. Jeremiah 30:14

The LORD has appeared of old unto me, saying, Yes, I have **loved** you with an everlasting **love**: therefore with **lovingkindness** have I drawn you. Jeremiah 31:3

She weeps sore in the night, and her tears are on her cheeks: among all her **lovers** she has none to comfort her, all her friends have dealt treacherously with her, they are become her enemies... I called for my **lovers**, but they deceived me: my priests and mine elders gave up the ghost in the city, while they sought their meat to relieve their souls. Lamentations 1:2, 19

Now when I passed by you, and looked upon you, behold, your time was the time of **love**; and I spread My skirt over you, and covered your nakedness: yes, I swore unto you, and entered into a covenant with you, says the Lord GOD, and you became Mine... They give gifts to all whores: but you give your gifts to all your **lovers**, and hire them, that they may come unto you on every side for your whoredom...Because your filthiness was poured out, and your nakedness discovered through your whoredoms with your **lovers**, and with all the idols of your abominations, and by the blood of your children, which you did give to them; Behold, therefore I will gather all your **lovers**, with whom you have taken pleasure, and all them that you have **loved**, with all those that you have hated; I will even gather them round about against you, and will discover your nakedness unto them, that they may see all your nakedness. Ezekiel 16:8, 33, 36-37 (false love)

Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her **lovers**, on the Assyrians her neighbors...wherefore I have delivered her into the hand of her **lovers**, into the hand of the Assyrians, upon whom she doted...and when her sister Aholibah saw this, she was more corrupt in her inordinate **love** than she, and in her whoredoms more than her sister in her whoredoms. Ezekiel 23:5, 9, 11 (false love)

The Babylonians came to her into the bed of **love**, and they defiled her with their whoredom, and she was polluted with them, and her mind was alienated from them. Ezekiel 23:17

Therefore, O Aholibah, thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, I will raise up your **lovers** against you, from whom your mind is alienated, and I will bring them against you on every side... Ezekiel 23:22

They come unto you as the people come, and they sit before you as My people, and they hear your words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they show much **love**, but their heart goes after their covetousness. Lo, you are unto them as a very **lovely** song of one that has a pleasant voice, and can play well on an instrument: for they hear your words, but they do them not. Ezekiel 33:31-32

Now God had brought Daniel into favor and tender **love** with the prince of the eunuchs. Daniel 1:9

I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that **love** Him, and to them that keep His commandments; We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from your precepts and from your judgments:...to the Lord our God belong mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him; neither have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God... Daniel 9:4-5, 9-10

For their mother has played the harlot: she that conceived them has done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my **lovers**, that give me my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink. Hosea 2:5

..And she shall follow after her **lovers**, but she shall not overtake them; and she shall seek them, but shall not find them: then shall she say, I will go and return to my first husband; for then was it better with me than now...Now will I discover her lewdness in the sight of her **lovers**, and none shall deliver her out of Mine hand. Hosea 2:5, 7, 10

And I will destroy her vines and her fig trees, whereof she has said, These are my reward that my **lovers** have given me: and I will make them a forest, and the beasts of the field shall eat them. And I will visit upon her the days of Baalim, wherein she burned incense to them, and she decked herself with her earrings and her jewels, and she went after her **lovers**, and forgot Me, says the LORD. Hosea 2:12-13

Then said the LORD unto me, Go yet, **love** a woman beloved of her friend, yet an adulteress, according to the **love** of the LORD toward the children of Israel, who look to other gods, and love flagons of wine. Hosea 3:1

Their drink is sour: they have committed whoredom continually: her rulers with shame do **love**, Give you...For they are gone up to Assyria, a wild ass alone by himself: Ephraim has hired **lovers**. Hosea 4:18, 8:9

I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they **loved**...All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I hated them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of Mine house, I will **love** them no more; all their princes are revolters. Hosea 9:10, 15

Ephraim is as an heifer that is taught, and **loves** to tread out the corn; but I passed over upon her fair neck: I will make Ephraim to ride; Judah shall plow, and Jacob shall break his clods. Hosea 10:11

When Israel was a child, then I **loved** him, and called My son out of Egypt...I drew them with cords of a man, with bands of **love**: and I was to them as they that take off the yoke on their jaws, and I laid meat unto them. Hosea 11:1,4

He is a merchant, the balances of deceit are in his hand: he **loves** to oppress. Hosea 12:7

I will heal their backsliding, I will **love** them freely: for Mine anger is turned away from him. Hosea 14:4

Hate the evil, and **love** the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:15

Heads of Jacob...Who hate the good, and **love** the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones... Micah 3:1-2

He has showed you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to do justly, and to **love** mercy, and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8

The LORD your God in the midst of you is mighty; He will save, He will rejoice over you with joy; he will rest in His **love**, He will joy over you with singing. Zephaniah 3:17

Let none of you imagine evil in your hearts against his neighbour; and **love** no false oath: for all these are things that I hate, says the LORD. Zechariah 8:17

Thus says the LORD of hosts; The fasts of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore **love** the truth and peace. Zechariah 8:19

I have loved you, says the LORD. Yet you say, Wherein have you **loved** us? Was not Esau Jacob's brother? says the LORD: yet I **loved** Jacob, and I hated Esau, and laid his mountains and his heritage waste for the dragons of the wilderness. Malachi 1:1-3

## LOVE IN THE NEW COVENANT

You have heard that it has been said, You shall **love** your neighbor, and hate your enemy. But I say unto you, **Love** your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; that you may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for He makes His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the just and on the unjust. For if you **love** them which **love** you, what reward have you? Do not even the publicans the same? Matthew 5:43-46

When you pray, you shall not be as the hypocrites are: for they **love** to pray standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, they have their reward. Matthew 6:5

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and **love** the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Matthew 6:24

He that **loves** father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me: and he that **loves** son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. And he that takes not his cross, and follows after Me, is not worthy of Me. Matthew 10:37

Honor your father and your mother: and, You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself. Matthew 19:19

Jesus said unto him, You shall **love** the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind... And the second is like unto it, You shall **love** your neighbour as yourself. Matthew 22:37, 39

All their works they do for to be seen of men: they make broad their phylacteries, and enlarge the borders of their garments, and **love** the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the markets, and to be called of men, Rabbi, Rabbi. But be not you called Rabbi: for one is your master, even Christ; and all you are brethren. And call no man your father upon the earth: for one is your Father, which is in Heaven. Matthew 23:5-9

And because iniquity shall abound, the **love** of many shall wax cold. Matthew 24:12

Then Jesus beholding him **loved** him, and said unto him, One thing you lack: go your way, sell whatsoever you have, and give to the poor, and you shall have treasure in Heaven: and come, take up the cross, and follow Me. Mark 10:21

You shall **love** the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself. There is no other commandment greater than these...to **love** Him with all the heart, and with all the understanding, and with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to **love** his neighbor as himself, is more than all whole burnt offerings and sacrifices. Mark 12:30-31, 33

For if you **love** them which **love** you, what thank have you? For sinners also **love** those that **love** them. Luke 6:32

For he **loves** our nation, and he has built us a synagogue. Luke 7:5

But I say unto you which hear, **Love** your enemies, do good to them which hate you, Bless them that curse you, and pray for them which despitefully use you. And unto him that smites you on the one cheek offer also the other; and him that takes away your cloak forbid not to take your coat also. Luke 6:27-29

Give to every man that asks of you; and of him that takes away your goods ask them not again. And as you would that men should do to you, do you also to them likewise. For if you **love** them which **love** you, what thanks have you? For sinners also **love** those that **love** them. And if you do good to them which do good to you, what thanks have you? For sinners also do ever the same. And if you lend to them of whom you hope to receive, what thanks have you? For sinners also lend to sinners, to receive as much again. But **love** your enemies, and do good, and lend hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and you shall be the children of the Highest; for He is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil. Luke 6:30-35

There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty. And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will **love** him most? Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, You have rightly judged...Wherefore I say unto you, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she **loved** much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same **loves** little. And he said unto her, Your sins are forgiven...And he said to the woman, Your faith has saved you; go in peace. Luke 7:41-43, 47-48, 50

A certain lawyer stood up, and tempted Him, saying, Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? He said unto him, What is written in the law? How do you read this? And he answering said, You shall **love** the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and thy neighbor as yourself. And He said unto him, You have answered right: this do, and you shall live. Luke 10:25-28

But woe unto you, Pharisees! For you tithe mint and rue and all manner of herbs, and pass over judgment and the **love** of God: these ought you to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Woe unto you, Pharisees! For you **love** the uppermost seats in the synagogues, and greetings in the markets. Luke 11:42-43

No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and **love** the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Luke 16:13

Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and **love** greetings in the markets... Luke 20:46

For God so **loved** the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved...And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men **loved** darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil...The Father **loves** the Son, and has given all things into His hand. He that believes on the Son has everlasting life: and he that believes not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him. John 3:16-17, 19, 35-36

The Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do: for what things soever He does, these also do the Son likewise. For the Father **loves** the Son, and shows Him all things that Himself does: and He will shew Him greater works than these, that you may marvel. John 5:19-20

But I know you, that you have not the **love** of God in you. John 5:42

I speak that which I have seen with My Father: and you do that which you have seen with your father. They answered and said unto Him, Abraham is our father. Jesus said unto them, If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham. But now you seek to kill Me, a man that has told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham. You do the deeds of your father. Then said they to Him, We are not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God. Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, you would **love** Me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of Myself, but He sent Me. John 8:41-42

Therefore does My Father **love** Me, because I lay down My life, that I might take it again. No man takes it from Me, but I lay it down of Myself. I have power to lay it down, and I have power to take it again. This commandment have I received of My Father. John 10:17-18

When Jesus heard that, He said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the Son of God might be glorified thereby... Jesus **loved** Martha, and her sister, and Lazarus... When Jesus therefore saw her weeping, and the Jews also weeping which came with her, He groaned in the spirit, and was troubled, And said, Where have you laid him? They said unto Him, Lord, come and see. Jesus wept. Then said the Jews, Behold how He **loved** him! John 11:4-5, 33-36

He that **loves** his life shall lose it; and he that hates his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal..Among the chief rulers also many believed on Him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue: For they **loved** the praise of men more than the praise of God. John 12:25, 42-43

Before the feast of the passover, when Jesus knew that His hour was come that He should depart out of this world unto the Father, having **loved** His own which were in the world, He **loved** them unto the end... Now there was leaning on Jesus' bosom one of His disciples, whom Jesus **loved**. Simon Peter therefore beckoned to him, that he should ask who it should be of whom He spoke. John 13:1, 23-24

A new commandment I give unto you, That you **love** one another, as I have **loved** you, that you also **love** one another. By this shall all men know that you are My disciples, if you have **love** one to another. John 13:34-35

If you love Me, keep My commandments. John 14:15

He that has My commandments, and keeps them, He it is that **loves** Me: and he that **loves** Me shall be **loved** of My Father, and I will **love** him, and will manifest Myself to him. Judas said unto Him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself unto us, and not unto the world? Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man **love** Me, he will keep My words: and My Father will **love** him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. He that **loves** Me not keeps not My sayings: and the word which you hear is not Mine, but the Father's which sent Me. John 14:21-24

You have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If you **loved** Me, you would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for My Father is greater than I... But that the world may know that I **love** the Father; and as the Father gave Me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence. John 14:28, 31

As the Father has **loved** Me, so have I **loved** you: continue you in My **love**. If you keep My commandments, you shall abide in My **love**; even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His **love**. John 15:9-10

This is My commandment, That you **love** one another, as I have **loved** you. Greater **love** has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. John 15:12-13

These things I command you, that you **love** one another. If the world hate you, you know that it hated Me before it hated you. If you were of the world, the world would **love** his own: but because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. John 15:17-19

The time comes, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall show you plainly of the Father. At that day you shall ask in My name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: For the Father Himself **loves** you, because you have **loved** Me, and have believed that I came out from God. John 16:25-27

That they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and you in Me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that you have sent Me, and have **loved** them, as you have loved Me. Father, I will that they also, whom You have given Me, be with Me where I am; that they may behold My glory, which you have given Me: for you **loved** Me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world has not known You: but I have known Thee, and these have known that You have sent Me. And I have declared unto them Your name, and will declare it: that the **love** wherewith You have **loved** Me may be in them, and I in them. John 17:22-26

Then she ran, and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus **loved**, and said unto them, They have taken away the Lord out of the sepulcre, and we know not where they have laid Him. John 20:2

Jesus said to Simon Peter, Simon, son of Jonas, do you **love** me more than these? He said unto Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I **love** You. He said unto him, Feed My lambs. He said to him again the second time, Simon, son of Jonas, do you **love** Me? He said unto Him, Yes, Lord; You know that I **love** Thee. He said unto him, Feed My sheep. He said unto him the third time, Simon, son of Jonas, do you **love** Me? Peter was grieved because He said unto him the third time, Do you **love** me? And he said unto Him, Lord, You know all things; you know that I **love** Thee. Jesus said unto him, Feed My sheep. John 21:15-17

Then Peter, turning about, saw the disciple whom Jesus **loved** following; which also leaned on His breast at supper, and said, Lord, who is he that is to betray you? Peter seeing him said to Jesus, Lord, and what shall this man do? Jesus said unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what is that to thee? You follow Me. John 21:20-22

...We glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation works patience; and patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope makes not ashamed; because **the love of God** is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us...For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. But God commended His **love** toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:3-5, 7-8

We know that all things work together for good to them that **love** God, to them who are the called according to His purpose. Romans 8:28

Who shall separate us from the **love** of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, For Your sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that **loved** us. For I am persuaded that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the **love** of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. Romans 8:35-39

Let **love** be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good. Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly **love**; in honor preferring one another...Owe no man any thing, but to **love** one another: for he that **loves** another has fulfilled the law. For this, You shall not commit adultery, You shall not kill, You shall not steal, You shall not bear false witness, You shall not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself. **Love** works no ill to his neighbor: therefore **love** is the fulfilling of the law. Romans 12:9-10, 13:8-10

I beseech you, brethren, for the Lord Jesus Christ's sake, and for the **love** of the Spirit, that you strive together with me in your prayers to God for me... Romans 15:30

But as it is written, Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God has prepared for them that **love** Him. But God has revealed them unto us by His Spirit: for the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. For what man knows the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? Even so the things of God knows no man, but the Spirit of God. 1 Corinthians 2:9-11

What will you do? Shall I come unto you with a rod, or in **love**, and in the spirit of meekness? 1 Corinthians 4:21

Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but charity edifies. And if any man think that he knows anything, he knows nothing yet as he ought to know. If any man **love** God, the same is known of Him. 1 Corinthians 8:1-3

If any man **love** not the Lord Jesus Christ, let him be Anathema Maranatha. The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. My **love** be with you all in Christ Jesus. 1 Corinthians 16:22-24

I wrote this same unto you, lest, when I came, I should have sorrow from them of whom I ought to rejoice; having confidence in you all, that my joy is the joy of you all. For out of much affliction and anguish of heart I wrote unto you with many tears; not that you should be grieved, but that you might know the **love** which I have more abundantly unto you. ... Wherefore I beseech you that you would confirm your **love** toward him. 2 Corinthians 2:3-4, 8

For the **love** of Christ constrains us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead... 2 Corinthians 5:14

Wherefore show you to them, and before the churches, the proof of your **love**, and of our boasting on your behalf. 2 Cor 8:24

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the **love** of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. 2 Corinthians 13:14

But in all these things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, in stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in watchings, in fasting by pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by **love** unfeigned. By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left. By honor and dishonor, by evil report, and good report: as deceivers, and yet true. 2 Corinthians 6:4-8

Therefore, as you abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your **love** to us, see that you abound in this grace also. I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your **love**... Wherefore show you to them, and before the churches, the proof of your **love**, and of our boasting on your behalf. 2 Corinthians 8:7-8, 24

But this I say, He which sows sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which sows bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Every man according as he purposes in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God **loves** a cheerful giver. 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

Wherefore? Because I **love** you not? God knows. But what I do, that I will do, that I may cut off occasion from them which desire occupation; that wherein they glory, they may be found even as we. 2 Corinthians 11:11-12

I will very gladly spend and be spent for you; though the more abundantly I **love** you, the less I be **loved**. 2 Corinthians 12:15

Finally, brethren, farewell, Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of **love** and peace shall be with you. 2 Corinthians 13:11

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who **loved** Me, and gave Himself for Me. Galatians 2:20

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision avails any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which works by **love**. Gal 5:5-6

For, brethren, you have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by **love** serve one another. For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself. Galatians 5:13-14

But the fruit of the Spirit is **love**, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: According as He has chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in **love**...Wherefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus, and **love** unto all the saints, cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in My prayers... Ephesians 1:3-4, 15-16

That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in **love**, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the **love** of Christ, which passes knowledge, that you might be filled with all the fullness of God. Ephesians 3:17-19

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in **love**...That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; but speaking the truth in **love**, may grow up into Him in all things, which is the head, even Christ: From whom the whole body fitly joined together and compacted by that which every joint supplies, according to the effectual working in the measure of every part, makes increase of the body unto the edifying of itself in **love**. Ephesians 4:1-2, 14-16

Be you therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in **love**, as Christ also has **loved** us, and has given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savor. Ephesians 5:1-2

For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church...Husbands, **love** your wives, even as Christ also **loved** the church, and gave Himself for it; That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, that He might present it to Himself a glorious church, nor having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. Ephesians 5:23, 25-27

So ought men to **love** their wives as their own bodies. He that **loves** his wife **loves** himself. For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as the Lord the church: For we are members of His body, of His flesh, and of His bones...Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so **love** his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. Ephesians 5:28-30, 33

Peace be to the brethren, and **love** with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Grace be with all them that **love** our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. Ephesians 6:23-24

And this I pray, that your **love** may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment... Philippians 1:9

The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds: But the other of **love**, knowing that I am set for the defense of the gospel. Philippians 1:16-17

If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of **love**, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, fulfill you my joy, that you be likeminded, having the same **love**, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 2:1-2

Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are **lovely**, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Philippians 4:8

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the **love** which you have to all the saints... Col 1:3-4

You also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ; who also declared unto us your **love** in the Spirit. Colossians 1:7-8

That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in **love**, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. Colossians 2:2-3

Husbands, **love** your wives, and be not bitter against them. Colossians 3:19

We give thanks to God always for you, making mention of you in our prayers; Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labor of **love**, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God. 1 Thessalonians 1:2-4

Now God Himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you. And the Lord make you to increase and abound in **love** one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you: To the end He may establish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints. 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13

As touching brotherly **love** you need not that I write unto you: for you yourselves are taught of God to **love** one another. 1 Thessalonians 4:9

For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and **love**; and for a helmet, the hope of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 5:7-8

We beseech you, brethren, to know them which labor among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; and to esteem them very highly in **love** for their work's sake. And be at peace among yourselves. 1 Thessalonians 5:13-14

For the mystery of iniquity does already work...And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of His mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of His coming...With all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the **love** of the truth, that they might be saved. 2 Thessalonians 2:7, 10

Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God, even our Father, which has **loved** us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

We have confidence in the Lord touching you, that you both do and will do the things which we command you. And the Lord direct your hearts into the **love** of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ. 2 Thessalonians 3:4-5

...Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and **love** which is in Christ Jesus. This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on Him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:12-16

For the **love** of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, **love**, patience, meekness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto you are also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses. 1 Timothy 6:10-12

Stir up the gift of God, which is in you by the putting on of my hands. For God has not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of **love**, and of a sound mind...Hold fast the form of sound words, which you have heard of me, in faith and **love** which is in Christ Jesus. That good thing which was committed unto you keep by the Holy Ghost which dwells in us. 2 Tim 1:6-7, 13-14

For men shall be **lovers** of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy... 2 Timothy 3:2

I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the faith: Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them also that **love** His appearing...For Demas has forsaken me, having **loved** this present world, and is departed unto Thessalonica; Crescens to Galatia, Titus unto Dalmatia. 2 Timothy 4:7-8, 10

For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; but a **lover** of hospitality, a **lover** of good men, sober, just, holy, temperate; holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. Titus 1:7-9

The aged women likewise, that they be in behavior as becomes holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; that they may teach the young women to be sober, to **love** their husbands, to **love** their children, to be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. Titus 2:3-5

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and **love** of God our Savior toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior; that being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:3-7

All that are with me salute you. Greet them that **love** us in the faith. Grace be with you all. Amen. Titus 3:15

I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers, Hearing of your **love** and faith, which you have toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all saints; that the communication of your faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus. For we have great joy and consolation in your **love**, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by you, brother. Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin you that which is convenient, yet for **love's** sake I rather beseech you, being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ. Philemon 1:4-9

Of the angels He said, Who makes His angels spirits, and His ministers a flame of fire. But unto the Son He said, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom. You have **loved** righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even your God, has anointed You with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Hebrews 1:7-9

For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labor of **love**, which you have showed toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister. And we desire that every one of you do show the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end. Hebrews 6:10-11

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for He is faithful that promised;) and let us consider one another to provoke unto **love** and to good works... Hebrews 10:23-24

My son, despise not the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when you are rebuked of Him: For whom the Lord **loves** He chastens, and scourges every son whom He receives. If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons... Hebrews 12:5-7

Let brotherly **love** continue. Be not forgetful to entertain strangers:for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. Hebrews 13:1-2

Blessed is the man that endures temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that **love** Him. James 1:12

Hearken, my beloved brethren, Has not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the Kingdom which He has promised to them that **love** Him? But you have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the judgment seats? Do not they blaspheme that worthy name by the which you are called? If you fulfill the royal law according to the scripture, You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself, you do well: But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. James 2:5-9

That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: whom having not seen, you **love**; in whom, though now you see Him not, yet believing, you rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:7-9

Seeing you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned **love** of the brethren, see that you **love** one another with a pure heart fervently; being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which lives and abides for ever. 1 Peter 1:22-23

Honor all men. **Love** the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king...Finally, be all of one mind, having compassion one of another, **love** as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that you are called to this, that you should inherit a blessing. For he that will **love** life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: Let him avoid evil, and do good; let him seek peace, and ensue it. 1 Peter 2:17; 3:8-11

Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an heart they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children: Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the way of Balaam the son of Bosor, who **loved** the wages of unrighteousness... 2 Peter 2:14-15

He that says, I know Him, and keeps not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoso keeps His word, in Him verily is the **love** of God perfected... He that **loves** his brother abides in the light, and there is no occasion of stumbling in him. But he that hates his brother is in darkness, and walks in darkness, and knows not whither he goes, because that darkness has blinded his eyes...**Love** not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man **love** the world, the **love** of the Father is not in him. 1 John 2:4-5, 9-11, 15

Behold, what manner of **love** the Father has given unto us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knows us not, because it knew Him not...In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whoever does not righteousness is not of God, neither he that **loves** not his brother. For this is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should **love** one another...1 John 3:1, 10-11

We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we **love** the brethren. He that **loves** not his brother abides in death. Whoever hates his brother is a murderer: and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him. Hereby perceive we the **love** of God, because He laid down His life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has this world's good, and sees his brother have need, and shuts up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwells the **love** of God in him? My little children, let us not **love** in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth...And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. And, this is His commandment, That we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and **love** one another, as He gave us commandment. 1 John 3:14-23

**Beloved**, let us **love** one another: for **love** is of God; and every one that **loves** is born of God, and knows God. He that **loves** not knows not God; for God is **love**. In this was manifested the **love** of God toward us, because that God sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. Herein is **love**, not that we **loved** God, but that He **loved** us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4:7-10

Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we ought also to **love** one another. No man has seen God at any time. If we **love** one another, God dwells in us, and His **love** is perfected in us. Hereby know we that we dwell in Him, and He in us, because He has given us of His Spirit...And we have known and believed the **love** that God has to us. God is **love**; and he that dwells in **love** dwells in God, and God in him. Herein is our **love** made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as He is, so are we in this world...There is no fear in **love**; but perfect **love** casts out fear; because fear has torment. He that fears is not made perfect in **love**. We **love** Him, because He first **loved** us. If a man say, I **love** God, and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he that **loves** not his brother whom he has seen, how can he **love** God whom he has not seen? And this commandment have we from Him, that he who **loves** God **love** his brother also. 1 John 4:11-21

Whosoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that **loves** Him that begat **loves** Him also that is begotten of Him. By this we know that we **love** the children of God, when we **love** God, and keep His commandments. For this is the **love** of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous. 1 John 5:1-3

The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I **love** in the truth; and not I only, but also all they that have known the truth. For the truth's sake, which dwells in us, and shall be with us for ever. Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and **love**. I rejoiced greatly that I found of your children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father... And now I beseech you, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto you, but that which we had from the beginning, that we **love** one another. And this is **love**, that we walk after His commandments...as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it. 2 John 1:4-6

**Beloved** Gaius, whom I **love** in the truth...**Beloved**, I wish above all things that you may prosper and be in health, even as your soul prospers...I wrote unto the church: but Diotrephes, who **loves** to have the preeminence among them, receives us not. 3 Jn 1:1-2, 9

Mercy unto you, and peace, and **love**, be multiplied. Jude 1:2

**Beloved**, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, keep yourselves in the **love** of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have compassion, making a difference: And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. Jude 1:20-23

Unto Him that **loved** us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests unto God and His Father; to Him be glory and dominion for ever and ever. Amen. Revelation 1:5-6

I know your works, and your labor, and your patience, and how you can not bear them which are evil: and you have tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and have found them liars. And have borne, and have patience for My name's sake have labored, and have not fainted. Nevertheless I have somewhat against you, because you have left your first **love**. Revelation 2:4

Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have **loved** you. Because you have kept the word of My patience, I also will keep you from the hour of temptation, which shall come upon all the world, to try them that dwell upon the earth. Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which you have, that no man take your crown...As many as I **love**, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. Revelation 3:9-11, 19

Now is come salvation, and strength, and the Kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they **loved** not their lives unto the death. Revelation 12:10-11

For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whoever **loves** and makes a lie. Revelation 22:15

### LOVE ONE ANOTHER COMMANDS

You shall not avenge, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but you shall love your neighbor as yourself: Leviticus 19:18

You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. And these words, which I command you this day, shall be in your heart: and you shall teach them diligently unto your children...and the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as it is at this day. And it shall be our righteousness, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as He commanded us. Deuteronomy 6:5-7, 24-25

**Love you therefore the stranger**: for you were strangers in the land of Egypt. Deuteronomy 10:19

**For my love** they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer. And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my **love**. Psalm 109:4-5

You have heard that it has been said, You shall love your neighbor, and hate your enemy. But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; that you may be the children of your Father which is in heaven... Matthew 5:43-45

Jesus said... You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Matthew 22:37-40

Jesus answered him, The first of all the commandments is, Hear, O Israel; The Lord our God is one Lord: And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all you strength: this is the first commandment. And the second is like, namely this, You shall love your neighbor as yourself. There is none other commandment greater than these. Mark 12:29-31

But **love you your enemies**, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and you shall be the children of the Highest: for He is kind unto the unthankful and to the evil. Luke 6:32-35

A new commandment I give unto you, That you **love one another**; as I have loved you, that you also **love one another**. By this shall all men know that you are My disciples, if you have **love one to another**. John 13:34-35

If you keep My commandments, you shall abide in My **love**; even as I have kept My Father's commandments, and abide in His **love**... This is My commandment, That you **love one another, as I have loved you**. Greater **love** has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends...These things I command you, that you **love one another**. John 15:10-13, 17

Let love be without dissimulation. Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good. **Be kindly affectioned one to another with brotherly love**...If there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, **You shall love your neighbor as yourself**. **Love** works no ill to his neighbor: therefore **love** is the fulfilling of the law. Romans 13:9, 9-10

Be you therefore followers of God, as dear children; and **walk in love**, as Christ [Messiah] also has loved us... Ephesians 5:1-2

If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any **comfort of love**, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil you my joy, that you be like-minded, **having the same love**, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 2:1-2

The LORD make you to increase and abound in **love one toward another**, and toward all men, even as we do toward you... As touching **brotherly love** you need not that I write unto you: for you yourselves are taught of God to **love one another**. 1 Thessalonians 3:12; 4:9

Comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also you do... Know them which labor among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you; and to **esteem them very highly in love** for their work's sake. And be at peace among yourselves. 1 Thessalonians 5:11-13

For we have great joy and consolation in **your love**, because the bowels of the saints are refreshed by you brother. Philemon 1:7

**Let brotherly love continue**. Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. Hebrews 13:1

If you fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, **You shall love your neighbor as yourself**, you do well... James 2:8

Seeing you have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto **unfeigned love of the brethren**, see that you **love one another** with a pure heart fervently...Honor all men. **Love the brotherhood**. Fear God. Honor the king... 1 Peter 1:22, 2:17

This is the message that you heard from the beginning, that we should **love one another**...Hereby perceive we the **love** of God, because He laid down His life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren...This is His commandment, That we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and **love one another**, as He gave us commandment. 1 John 3:11, 16, 23

Beloved, **let us love one another**: for **love** is of God; and every one that **loves** is born of God, and knows God. He that **loves** not knows not God; for God is **love**...Herein is **love**, not that we loved God, but that He **loved** us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so **loved** us, we ought also to **love one another**. No man has seen God at any time. If we **love one another**, God dwells in us, and His **love** is perfected in us...If a man say, I **love** God, and hates his brother, he is a liar: for he that **loves** not his brother whom he has seen, how can he **love** God whom he has not seen? And this commandment have we from Him, That **he who loves God love his brother also**. 1 John 4:7-8, 10-12, 20-21

Whosoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loves Him that begat loves him also that is begotten of Him. By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep His commandments. For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments... 1 John 5:1-3

Not as though I wrote a new commandment to you, but that which we had from the beginning, that we **love one another**. And **this is love, that we walk after His commandments**. This is the commandment...you should walk in it. 2 John 1:5-6-7

### **CHARITY**

If your brother be grieved with your meat, now you do not walk **charitably**. Destroy not him with your meat, for whom Christ died. Romans 14:15

Now as touching things offered unto idols, we know that we all have knowledge. Knowledge puffs up, but **charity** edifies. 1 Corinthians 8:1

Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, and have not **charity**, I am become as sounding brass, or a tinkling cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. And though I give all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, and have not charity, it profits me nothing. Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity vaunts not itself, is not puffed up, does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil; rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. Charity never fails: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away. For we know in part, and we prophesy in part. But when that which is perfect is come, then that which is in part shall be done away. When I was a child, I spoke as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things. For now we see through a glass, darkly; but then face to face: now I know in part; but then shall I know even as also I am known. And now abides faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13

Follow after **charity**, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather to prophesy...Let all your things be done with **charity**. 1 Corinthians 14:1, 16:13-14

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind... Above all these things put on **charity**, which is the bond of perfectness. Col 3:12-14

Now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your faith and **charity**, and that you have good remembrance of us always...1 Thessalonians 3:6

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith grows exceedingly, and the **charity** of every one of you all toward each other abounds... 2 Thessalonians 1:3

Now the end of the commandment is **charity** out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of faith unfeigned... 1 Timothy 1:5

Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression. Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in faith and **charity** and holiness with sobriety. 1 Timothy 2:14-15

Let no man despise your youth; but be an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in **charity**, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honor, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work. Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, **charity**, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 2:22

But you have fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, faith, longsuffering, **charity**, patience, persecutions, afflictions... What persecutions I endured: but out of them all the Lord delivered me. 2 Timothy 3:10-11

But speak the things which become sound doctrine: That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in faith, in **charity**, in patience. the aged women likewise, that they be behavior as becomes holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things; that they may teach the younger women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children, to be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed. Young men likewise exhort to be sober minded. In all things showing yourself a pattern of good works...Titus 2:1-7

But the end of all things is at hand: be you therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent **charity** among yourselves: for **charity** shall cover the multitude of sins. 1 Peter 4:7-8

Greet one another with a kiss of **charity**. Peace be with you all that are in Christ Jesus. Amen. 1 Peter 5:14

Besides this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness **charity**. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that you shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacks these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if you do these things, you shall never fall: For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting Kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 1:5-11

Beloved, you do faithfully whatever you do to the brethren, and to strangers; which have borne witness of your **charity** before the church: whom if you bring forward on their journey after a godly sort, you shall do well. 3 John 1:5-6

Woe unto them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core. These are spots in your feasts of **charity**, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withers, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots... Jude 1:11-12

I know your works, and **charity**, and service, and faith, and your patience, and your works; and the last to be more than the first. Revelation 2:19

#### **CHERISH**

Now king David was old and stricken in years; and they covered him with clothes, but he got no heat. Wherefore his servants said unto him, Let there be sought for my lord the king a young virgin: and let her stand before the king, and let her **cherish** him, and let her lie in your bosom, that my lord the king may get heat. So they sought for a fair damsel throughout all the coasts of Israel, and found Abishag a Shunammite, and brought her to the king. And the damsel was very fair, and **cherished** the king, and ministered to him: but the king knew her not. 1 Kings 1:2-4

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ [the Messiah] loved the church, and gave Himself for it; That He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word, that He might present it to Himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish. So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loves his wife loves himself. For no man every yet hated his own flesh; but nourishes and **cherishes** it, even as the Lord the church: For we are members of His body, of His flesh, and of His bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ [the Messiah] and the church. Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. Ephesians 5:25-33

For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile: But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which tries our hearts. For neither at any time used we flattering words, as you know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God is witness: Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor yet of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ. But we were gentle among you, even as a nurse **cherishes** her children. So being affectionately desirous of you, we were willing to have imparted unto you, not the gospel of God only, but also our own souls, because you were dear unto us. 1 Thessalonians 2:3-8

#### **COMFORT**

Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son: And he called his name Noah, saying, This same shall **comfort** us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD has cursed. Genesis 5:28-29

I will fetch a morsel of bread, and **comfort** your hearts; after that you shall pass on for therefore are you come to your servant. And they said, so do, as you have said. Genesis 18:5

These words of Esau her elder son were told to Rebekah: and she sent and called Jacob her younger son, and said unto him, Behold, your brother Esau, as touching you, does **comfort** himself, purposing to kill you. Genesis 27:42

Jacob rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his loins, and mourned for his son many days. And all his sons and all his daughters rose up to **comfort** him; but he refused to be **comforted**; and he said, For I will go down into the grave unto my son mourning. Thus his father wept for him. Genesis 37:34-35

It came to pass on the fourth day, when they arose early in the morning, that he rose up to depart: and the damsel's father said unto his son in law, **Comfort** your heart with a morsel of bread, and afterward go your way...And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, **Comfort** your heart, I pray you. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them. Judges 19:5, 8

Then said David, I will shew kindness to Hanun the son of Nahash, as his father showed kindness unto me. And David sent to **comfort** him by the hand of his servants for his father. And David's servants came into the land of the children of Ammon. And the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun their lord, Do you think that David does honor your father, that he has sent **comforters** to you? Has not David rather sent his servants to you, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it? 2 Samuel 10:2-3

Then your handmaid said, The word of my lord the king shall now be **comfortable**: for as an angel of God, so is my lord the king to discern good and bad: therefore the LORD your God will be with you. 2 Samuel 14:17

Joab came into the house to the king, and said...I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased you well. Now therefore arise, go forth, and speak **comfortably** unto your servants: for I swear by the LORD, if you go not forth, there will not tarry one with you this night: and that will be worse unto you than all the evil that befell thee from your youth until now. Then the king arose, and sat in the gate. And they told unto all the people, saying, Behold, the king does sit in the gate. And all the people came before the king: for Israel had fled every man to his tent. 2 Samuel 19:5-8

Ephraim their father mourned many days, and his brethren came to **comfort** him. 1 Chronicles 7:22

Hezekiah spoke **comfortably** to all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings, and making confession to the LORD God of their fathers. 2 Chronicles 30:22

He set captains of war over the people, and gathered them together to him in the street of the gate of the city, and spoke **comfortably** to them, saying, Be strong and courageous, be not afraid nor dismayed for the king of Assyria, nor for all the multitude that is with him: for there be more with us than with him: With him is an arm of flesh; but with us is the LORD our God to help us, and to fight our battles. And the people rested themselves upon the words of Hezekiah king of Judah. 2 Chronicles 32:6-8

When Job's three friends, heard of all that was come upon him, they came every one from his own place...for they had made an appointment together to come to mourn with him and to **comfort** him. Job 2:11

Oh that I might have my request; and that God would grant me the thing that I long for... Then should I yet have **comfort**; yes, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare: for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One. Job 6:10

When I say, My bed shall **comfort** me, my couch shall ease my complaint; Then you scare me with dreams, and terrify me through visions: So that my soul chooses strangling, and death rather than my life. Job 7:13-14

If I say, I will forget my complaint, I will leave off my heaviness, and **comfort** myself...Are not my days few? Cease then, and let me alone, that I may take **comfort** a little. Job 9:27, 10:20

I have heard many such things: miserable **comforters** are you all. Job 16:2

How then **comfort** you me in vain, seeing in your answers there remains falsehood? Job 21:34

I chose out their way, and sat chief, and dwelt as a king in the army, as one that **comforts** the mourners. Job 29:25

Yes, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for you are with me; Your rod and Your staff they comfort me. Psalm 23:4

Reproach has broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, but there was none; and for **comforters**, but I found none. They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. Ps 69:20-21

You, who has shown me great and sore troubles, shall quicken me again, and shall bring me up again from the depths of the earth. You shall increase my greatness, and **comfort** me on every side. Psalm 71:20-21

When I said, My foot slips; Your mercy, O LORD, held me up. In the multitude of my thoughts within me Your comforts delight my soul...They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. But the LORD is my defense; and my God is the rock of my refuge. Psalm 94:18-19, 21-22

Remember the word to Your servant, upon which You have caused me to hope. This is my **comfort** in my affliction: for Your word has quickened me...I know, O LORD, that Your judgments are right, and that You in faithfulness have afflicted me. Let, I pray thee, Your merciful kindness be for my **comfort**, according to Your word unto Your servant...My soul faints for Your salvation: but I hope in Your word. Mine eyes fail for Your word, saying, When will You **comfort** me? Psalm 119:49-50; 75-76, 81-82

So I returned, and considered all the oppressions that are done under the sun: and behold the tears of such as were oppressed, and they had no **comforter**; and on the side of their oppressors there was power; but they had no **comforter**. Ecclesiastes 4:1

Stay me with flagons, **comfort** me with apples: for I am sick of love. Song of Solomon 2:5

Therefore said I, Look away from me; I will weep bitterly, labor not to **comfort** me, because of the spoiling of the daughter of my people. For it is a day of trouble, and of treading down, and of perplexity by the Lord GOD of hosts in the valley of vision, breaking down the walls, and of crying to the mountains. Isaiah 22:4-5

**Comfort** you, **comfort** you My people, says your God. Speak you **comfortably** to Jerusalem, and cry to her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she has received of the LORD'S hand double for all her sins. Isaiah 40:1-2

For the LORD shall comfort Zion: He will comfort all her waste places; and He will make her wilderness like Eden, and her desert like the garden of the LORD; joy and gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, and the voice of melody...I, even I, am He that comforts you: who are you, that you should be afraid of a man that shall die, and of the son of man which shall be made as grass; And forget the LORD your Maker, that has stretched forth the heavens, and laid the foundations of the earth; and has feared continually every day because of the fury of the oppressor, as if he were ready to destroy? And where is the fury of the oppressor?...There is none to guide her among all the sons whom she has brought forth; neither is there any that takes her by the hands of all the sons that she has brought up. These two things are come unto you; who shall be sorry for you? Desolation, and destruction, and the famine, and the sword: by whom shall I comfort you? Isaiah 51:3, 12-13, 18-19

Are you not children of transgression...Among the smooth stones of the stream is your portion; they, they are your lot: even to them have you poured a drink offering, you have offered a meat offering. Should I receive **comfort** in these? Isaiah 57:4, 6

I have seen his ways, and will heal him: I will lead him also, and restore **comforts** unto him and to his mourners. Isaiah 57:18

The spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD has anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He has sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to **comfort** all that mourn; To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called tress of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified. Isaiah 61:1-3

As one whom his mother **comforts**, so will I **comfort** you; and you shall be **comforted** in Jerusalem. Isaiah 66:13

When I would **comfort** myself against sorrow, my heart is faint in me. Jeremiah 8:18

Neither shall men tear themselves for them in mourning, to **comfort** them for the dead; neither shall men give them the cup of consolation to drink for their father or for their mother...Then shall the virgin rejoice in the dance, both young men and old together: for I will turn their mourning into joy, and will **comfort** them, and make them rejoice from their sorrow. Jer 16:7, 31:13

How does the city sit solitary, that was full of people! How is she become as a widow! She that was great among the nations, and princess among the provinces, how is she become tributary! She weeps sore in the night, and her tears are on her cheeks: among all her lovers she has none to **comfort** her: all her friends have dealt treacherously with her, they are become her enemies... Her filthiness is in her skirts; she remembers not her last end; therefore she came down wonderfully: she had no **comforter**. O LORD, behold my affliction: for the enemy has magnified himself...For these things I weep; mine eye, mine eye runs down with water, because the **comforter** that should relieve my soul is far from me: my children are desolate, because the enemy prevailed... Lamentations 1:1-2, 9, 16

Zion spreads forth her hands, and there is none to **comfort** her: the LORD has commanded concerning Jacob, that his adversaries should be round about him: Jerusalem is as a menstruous woman among them...They have heard that I sigh: there is none to **comfort** me... Lamentations 1:17, 21

What thing shall I take to witness for you? What thing shall I liken to you, O daughter of Jerusalem? What shall I equal to you, that I may **comfort** you, O virgin daughter of Zion? For your breach is great like the sea: who can heal you? Lamentations 2:13

They shall **comfort** you, when you see their ways and their doings: and you shall know that I have not done without cause all that I have done in it, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 14:23

That you may bear your own shame, and may be confounded in all that you have done, in that you are a **comfort** unto them. Ezekiel 16:54

Therefore, behold, I will allure her, and bring her into the wilderness, and speak **comfortably** unto her. Hosea 2:14

It shall come to pass, that all they that look upon thee shall flee from you, and say, Nineveh is laid waste: who will bemoan her? Whence shall I seek **comforters** for you? Nahum 3:7

The LORD answered the angel that talked with me with good words and **comfortable** words...Cry yet, saying, thus says the LORD of hosts; My cities through prosperity shall yet be spread abroad; and the LORD shall yet **comfort** Zion, and shall yet choose Jerusalem. Zechariah 1:13, 17

For the idols have spoken vanity, and the diviners have seen a lie, and have told false dreams; they **comfort** in vain: therefore they went their way as a flock, they were troubled, because there was no shepherd. Zechariah 10:2

Jesus turned Him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good **comfort**; your faith has made you whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. Matthew 9:22

Jesus stood still, and commanded him to be called. And they call the blind man, saying unto him, Be of good **comfort**, rise; He calls you. Mark 10:49

Many of the Jews came to Martha and Mary, to **comfort** them concerning their brother. John 11:19

I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another **Comforter**, that He may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it sees Him not, neither knows Him: but you know Him; for He dwells with you, and shall be in you. John 14:16-17

I will not leave you **comfortless**: I will come to you...But the **Comforter**, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in My name, He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatever I have said unto you. John 14:18, 26

But when the **Comforter** is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceeds from the Father, He shall testify of Me... John 15:26

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the **Comforter** will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. John 16:7

Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the **comfort** of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied. Acts 9:31

For whatever things were written afore time were written for our learning, that we through patience and **comfort** of the scriptures might have hope. Romans 15:4

For he that speaks in an unknown tongue speaks not unto men, but unto God: for no man understands him; howbeit in the spirit he speaks mysteries. But he that prophesies speaks unto men to edification, and exhortation, and comfort. 1 Corinthians 14:2-3

Blessed be God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies, and the God of all **comfort**; Who **comforts** us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to **comfort** them which are in any trouble, by the **comfort** wherewith we ourselves are **comforted** of God. 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

Sufficient to such a man is this punishment...So that contrariwise you ought rather to forgive him, and **comfort** him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. 2 Corinthians 2:6-7

I speak not this to condemn you: for I have said before, that you are in our hearts to die and live with you. Great is my boldness of speech toward you, great is my glorying of you: I am filled with **comfort**, I am exceeding joyful in all our tribulation... Nevertheless God, that **comfort** those that are cast down, **comforted** us by the coming of Titus; And not by his coming only, but by the consolation wherewith he was **comforted** in you, when he told us your earnest desire, your mourning, your fervent mind toward me; so that I rejoiced the more. 2 Corinthians 7:3-4, 6-7

Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good **comfort**, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you. 2 Corinthians 13:11

...I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak. But that you also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things: Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that you might know our affairs, and that he might **comfort** your hearts. Ephesians 6:20-22

If there be therefore any consolation in Christ, if any **comfort** of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any bowels and mercies, Fulfil you my joy, that you be like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Philippians 2:1-2

But I trust in the Lord Jesus to send Timotheus shortly unto you, that I also may be of good **comfort**, when I know your state. Philippians 2:19

All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, who is a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellow-servant in the Lord: Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and **comfort** your hearts; With Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is one of you. They shall make known unto you all things which are done here. Aristarchus my fellow-prisoner salutes you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, (touching whom you received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;) And Jesus, who is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only are my fellowworkers unto the Kingdom of God, which have been a **comfort** unto me. Colossians 4:7-11

When we could no long forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone; And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellow-laborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to **comfort** you concerning your faith: That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto. 1 Thessalonians 3:1-3

For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the arch-angel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first: Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. Wherefore **comfort** one another with these words. 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18

For God has not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with Him. Wherefore **comfort** yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also you do. 1 Thessalonians 5:9-11

Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, **comfort** the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all men. 1 Thessalonians 5:14

Now our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, **comfort** your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

### **COMPASSION**

The daughter of Pharaoh came down to wash herself at the river...and when she saw the ark among the flags, she sent her maid to fetch it. And when she had opened it, she saw the child: and, behold, the babe wept. And she had **compassion** on him, and said, This is one of the Hebrews' children. Exodus 2:5-6

There shall cleave nothing of the cursed thing to your hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of His anger, and show you mercy, and have **compassion** upon you, and multiply you, as He has sworn unto your fathers; When you shall hearken to the voice of the LORD your God, to keep all His commandments which I command you this day, to do that which is right in the eyes of the LORD your God. Deut 13:17-18

...And shall return unto the LORD your God, and shall obey His voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul; That then the LORD your God will turn your captivity, and have **compassion** upon you, and will return and gather you from all the nations, whither the LORD your God has scattered you. Deut 30:2-3

Now therefore, O king, come down according to all the desire of your soul to come down; and our part shall be to deliver him into the king's hand. And Saul said, Blessed be you of the LORD; for you have **compassion** on me. 1 Samuel 23:20-21

If they shall...repent, and make supplication to You in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness; And so return unto You with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto Thee toward their land, which You gave unto their fathers, the city which You have chosen, and the house which I have built for Thy name: Then hear their prayer and their supplication in heaven Your dwelling place, and maintain their cause, And forgive Your people that have sinned against Thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against Thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion upon them... 1 Kings 8:47-50

The LORD was gracious unto them, and had **compassion** on them, and had respect unto them, because of His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast He them from His presence as yet. 2 Kings 13:23

For if you turn again unto the LORD, your brethren and your children shall find **compassion** before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the LORD your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn away His face from you, if you return to Him. 2 Chronicles 30:9

The LORD God of their fathers sent to them by His messengers, rising up at times, and sending; because He had **compassion** on His people, and on His dwelling place. But they mocked the messengers of God, and despised His words, and misused His prophets, until the wrath of the LORD arose against His people, till there was no remedy. Therefore He brought upon them the king of the Chaldees, who slew their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, and had no **compassion** upon the young man or maiden, old man, or him that stooped for age: He gave them all into his hand. 2 Chronicles 36:15-17

But He, being full of **compassion**, forgave their iniquity, and destroyed them not: yes, many a time turned He His anger away, and did not stir up all His wrath. Psalm 78:38

O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set you before them. But You, O Lord, are a God full of **compassion**, and gracious, longsuffering, and plentiful in mercy and truth. O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give Your strength unto Your servant, and save the son of Your handmaid. Show me a token for good; that they which hate me may see it, and be ashamed: because You, LORD, have helped me, and comforted me. Psalm 86:14-17

He has made His wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is gracious and full of **compassion**. Psalm 111:4

Blessed is the man that fears the LORD, that delights greatly in His commandments...Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endures forever. Unto the upright there arises light in the darkness: He is gracious, and full of **compassion**, and righteous. Psalm 112:4

They shall abundantly utter the memory of Your great goodness, and shall sing of Your righteousness. The LORD is gracious, and full of **compassion**; slow to anger, and of great mercy. Psalm 145:7-8

Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have **compassion** on the son of her womb? Yes, they may forget, yet will I not forget you. Isaiah 49:15

It shall come to pass, after that I have plucked them out I will return, and have **compassion** on them, and will bring them again, every man to his heritage, and every man to his land. Jeremiah 12:15

It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because His **compassions** fail not. They are new every morning: great is Your faithfulness...But though He cause grief, yet will He have **compassion** according to the multitude of His mercies. For He does not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men. Lamentations 3:22-23, 32-33

No eye pitied you, to do any of these unto you, to have **compassion** upon you; but you were cast out in the open field, to the loathing of your person, in the day that you were born. Ezekiel 16:5

Who is a God like unto Thee, that pardons iniquity, and passes by the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He retains not His anger for ever, because He delights in mercy. He will turn again, He will have **compassion** upon us; He will subdue our iniquities; and you will cast all their sins into the depths of the sea. Micah 7:18-19

Thus speaks the LORD of hosts, saying, Execute true judgment, and show mercy and **compassions** every man to his brother... Zechariah 7:9

But when he saw the multitudes, He was moved with **compassion** on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Matthew 9:36

Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and was moved with **compassion** toward them, and He healed their sick. Matthew 14:14

Then Jesus called His disciples unto Him, and said, I have **compassion** on the multitude, because they have stayed with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way. Matthew 15:32

Then the lord of that servant was moved with **compassion**, and loosed him, and forgave him the debt...Should not you also have had **compassion** on your fellow servant, even as I had pity on you? Matthew 18:27-33

Jesus had **compassion** on them, and touched their eyes: and immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him. Matthew 20:24

Jesus, moved with **compassion**, put forth His hand, and touched him, and said unto him, I will; be clean. Mark 1:41

Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but said unto him, Go home to your friends, and tell them how great things the Lord has done for you, and has had **compassion** on you. Mark 5:19

And Jesus, when He came out, saw much people, and was moved with **compassion** toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and He began to teach them many things. Mark 6:34

I have **compassion** on the multitude, because they have now been with Me three days, and have nothing to eat... Mark 8:2

When He saw him, straightway the spirit tare him, and he fell on the ground, and wallowed foaming. And he asked his father, How long is it again since this came unto him? And he said, Of a child. And ofttimes it has cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if You can do any thing, have **compassion** on us, and help us. Mark 9:20-22

When the Lord saw her, He had **compassion** on her, and said unto her, Weep not. Luke 7:13

Jesus answering said, A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, which stripped him of his raiment, and wounded him, and departed, leaving him half dead...A certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was: and when he saw him...had **compassion** on him...Luke 10:30-33

When he had spent all, there arose a mighty famine in that land; and he began to be in want...And he arose, and came to his father. But when he was yet a great way off, his father saw him, and had **compassion**, and ran, and fell on his neck, and kissed him... For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost, and is found. And they began to make merry. Luke 15:14, 20, 24

For He said to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have **compassion** on whom I will have **compassion**. Romans 9:15

For every high priest taken from among men is ordained for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins: Who can have **compassion** on the ignorant, and on them that are out of the way; for that he himself also is **compassed** with infirmity. Hebrews 5:1-2

For you had **compassion** of me in my bonds, and took joyfully the spoiling of your goods, knowing in yourselves that you have in Heaven a better and an enduring substance. Hebrews 10:34

Finally, be you all of one mind, having **compassion** one of another, love as brethren, be pitiful, be courteous: Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that you are called unto this, that you should inherit a blessing...For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open to their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. 1 Peter 3:8-9, 12

But whoso has this world's good, and sees his brother have need, and shuts up his bowels of **compassion** from him, how dwells the love of God in him? My little children, let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in deed and in truth. 1 John 3:17-18

You, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. And of some have **compassion**, making a difference. Jude 1:20-22

# **GENTLENESS**

The king commanded Joab and Abishai and Ittai, saying, Deal **gently** for my sake with the young man, even with Absalom. And all the people heard when the king gave all the captains charge concerning Absalom. 2 Samuel 18:5

You have also given me the shield of Your salvation: and Your **gentleness** has made me great. 2 Samuel 22:36

You have also given me the shield of Your salvation: and Your right hand has held me up, and Your **gentleness** has made me great. Psalm 18:35

He shall feed His flock like a shepherd: He shall gather the lambs with His arm, and carry them in His bosom, and shall **gently** lead those that are with young. Isaiah 40:11

Now I Paul myself beseech you by the meekness and **gentleness** of Christ, who in presence am base among you, but being absent am bold toward you... 2 Corinthians 10:1

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, **gentleness**, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. Galatians 5:22-23

For our exhortation was not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile: but as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, who tries our hearts. For neither at any time used we flattering words, as you know, or a cloak of covetousness; God is witness: Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor yet of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ. But we were **gentle** among you, even as a nurse cherishes her children: so being affectionately desirous of you, we were willing to have imparted to you, not the gospel of God only, but also our own souls, because you were dear to us. 1 Thessalonians 2:3-8

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be **gentle** unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:24-26

Put them in mind to be subject to principalities and powers, to obey magistrates, to be ready to every good work, to speak evil of no man, to be no brawlers, but **gentle**, showing all meekness unto all men. Titus 3:1-2

But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, **gentle**, and easy to be intreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. James 3:17

Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and **gentle**, but also to the froward. 1 Peter 2:18

# **KINDNESS**

And it came to pass, when God caused me [Abraham] to wander from my father's house, that I said unto her, This is your **kindness** which you shall show unto me; at every place where we shall come, say of me, He is my brother. Genesis 20:13

And it came to pass at that time, that Abimelech and Phichol the chief captain of his host spake unto Abraham, saying, God is with thee in all that you do: Now therefore swear unto me here by God that you will not deal falsely with me, nor with my son, nor with my son's son: but according to the **kindness** that I have done unto you, you shall do unto me, and to the land wherein you have sojourned. Genesis 21:22-23

He said, O LORD God of my master Abraham, I pray thee, send me good speed this day, and shew **kindness** unto my master Abraham. Behold, I stand here by the well of water; and the daughters of the men of the city come out to draw water: And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down your pitcher, I pray you, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give your camels drink also: let the same be she that you have appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that you have shown **kindness** unto my master...And now if you will deal **kindly** and truly with my master, tell me: and if not, tell me, that I may turn to the right hand, or to the left. Gen 24:12-14, 49

And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spoke **kindly** unto the damsel. Genesis 34:3

But think on me when it shall be well with you, and show **kindness**, I pray you, unto me, and make mention of me unto Pharaoh, and bring me out of this house... Genesis 40:14

And the time drew near that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found grace in your sight, put, I pray thee, your hand under my thigh, and deal **kindly** and truly with me; bury me not, I pray thee, in Egypt...And he said, I will do as you have said. Genesis 47:29-30

Fear not: I will nourish you, and your little ones. And he comforted them, and spoke **kindly** unto them. Genesis 50:21

Now therefore, I pray you, swear unto me by the LORD, since I have shown you kindness, that you will also show **kindness** unto my father's house, and give me a true token: And that you will save alive my father, and my mother, and my brethren, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death. And the men answered her, Our life for yours, if you utter not this our business. And it shall be, when the LORD has given us the land, that we will deal **kindly** and truly with thee. Joshua 2:12-14

The children of Israel remembered not the LORD their God, who had delivered them out of the hands of all their enemies on every side: Neither showed they **kindness** to the house of Jerubbaal, namely, Gideon, according to all the goodness which he had shown unto Israel. Judges 8:34-35

Naomi said unto her two daughters in law, Go, return each to her mother's house; the LORD deal **kindly** with you, as you have dealt with the dead, and with me...And Naomi said unto her daughter in law, Blessed be he of the LORD, who has not left off his **kindness** to the living and to the dead. And Naomi said unto her, The man is near of kin unto us, one of our next kinsmen...And he said, Blessed are you of the LORD, my daughter: for you have shown more **kindness** in the latter end than at the beginning, inasmuch as you followed not young men, whether poor or rich. Ruth 1:8; 2:20, 3:10

And Saul said unto the Kenites, Go, depart, get you down from among the Amalekites, lest I destroy you with them: for you showed **kindness** to all the children of Israel, when they came up out of Egypt. So the Kenites departed from among the Amalekites. 1 Samuel 15:6

Therefore you shall deal **kindly** with your servant; for you have brought your servant into a covenant of the LORD with you: notwithstanding, if there be in me iniquity, slay me yourself; for why should you bring me to your father?... You shall not only while yet I live show me the **kindness** of the LORD, that I die not: but also you shall not cut off your **kindness** from my house for ever: no, not when the LORD has cut off the enemies of David every one from the face of the earth. 1 Samuel 20:8, 14-15

David sent messengers unto the men of Jabesh-gilead, and said unto them, Blessed are you of the LORD, that you have shown this **kindness** unto your lord, even unto Saul, and have buried him. And now the LORD show **kindness** and truth unto you: and I also will requite you this **kindness**, because you have done this thing. 2 Samuel 2:5-6

Then was Abner very wroth for the words of Ish-bosheth, and said, Am I a dog's head, which against Judah do show **kindness** this day unto the house of Saul your father, to his brethren, and to his friends, and have not delivered you into the hand of David, that you charge me to day with a fault concerning this woman? 2 Samuel 3:8

And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him **kindness** for Jonathan's sake? And there was of the house of Saul a servant whose name was Ziba...And the king said, Is there not yet any of the house of Saul, that I may show the **kindness** of God to him? And Ziba said unto the king, Jonathan has yet a son, which is lame on his feet...And David said unto him, Fear not: for I will surely shew you **kindness** for Jonathan your father's sake, and restore to you all the land of Saul your father, and you shall eat bread at my table continually...Then said David, I will show **kindness** unto Hanun the son of Nahash, as his father showed **kindness** unto me. 2 Samuel 9:1-3, 7, 10:2

And Absalom said to Hushai, Is this your **kindness** to your friend? Why did you not go with your friend? 2 Samuel 16:17

Do therefore according to your wisdom, and let not his hoar head go down to the grave in peace. But show **kindness** unto the sons of Barzillai the Gileadite, and let them be of those that eat at your table: for so they came to me when I fled because of Absalom your brother. 1 Kings 2:6-7

Solomon said, You have shown unto Your servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before You in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with You; and You have kept for him this great **kindness**, that You have given him a son to sit on His throne, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

...Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign lifted up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison; And he spoke **kindly** to him, and set his throne above the throne of the kings that were with him in Babylon; And changed his prison garments: and he did eat bread continually before him all the days of his life. And his allowance was a continual allowance given him of the king, a daily rate for every day, all the days of his life. 2 Kings 25:27-30

Thus Joash the king remembered not the **kindness** which Jehoiada his father had done to him, but slew his son. And when he died, he said, The LORD look upon it, and require it. 2 Chronicles 24:22

They and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Your commandments, And refused to obey, neither were mindful of Your wonders that You did among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but you are a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great **kindness**, and forsook them not. Nehemiah 9:16-17

And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained **kindness** of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, who were meet to be given her, out of the king's house... Esther 2:9

Blessed be the LORD: for He has shown me His marvelous **kindness** in a strong city. Psalm 31:21

O praise the LORD, all you nations: praise Him, all you people. For His merciful **kindness** is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endures for ever. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 117

Let, I pray you, Your merciful **kindness** be for my comfort, according to Your word unto Your servant...Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a **kindness**: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for my prayer also shall be in their calamities. Psalm 119:76; 141:5

The desire of a man is his **kindness**: and a poor man is better than aliar. Proverbs 19:22

Who can find a virtuous woman?...She opens her mouth with wisdom; and in her tongue is the law of **kindness**. Pro 31:10, 26

In a little wrath I hid my face from you for a moment; but with everlasting **kindness** will I have mercy on you, says the LORD your Redeemer. For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but My **kindness** shall not depart from you, neither shall the covenant of My peace be removed, says the LORD that has mercy on you. O you afflicted, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay your stones with fair colors, and lay your foundations with sapphires. And I will make your windows of agates, and your gates of carbuncles, and all your borders of pleasant stones. Isaiah 54:8-12

Go and cry in the ears of Jerusalem, saying, thus says the LORD; I remember you, the **kindness** of your youth, and love of your espousals, when you went after me in the wilderness... Jer 2:2

Rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great **kindness**, and repents Him of the evil. Joel 2:13

Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that you are a gracious God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great **kindness**, and repents of the evil. Jonah 4:2

The barbarous people showed us no little **kindness**: for they kindled a fire, and received us every one, because of the present rain, and because of the cold. Acts 28:2

Be **kindly** affectioned one to another with brotherly love; in honor preferring one another. Romans 12:10

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in watchings, in fastings; By pureness, by knowledge, by longsuffering, by **kindness**, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned, by the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness... 2 Corinthians 6:4-7

But God, who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, Even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace you are saved;) And has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His **kindness** toward us through Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:4-6

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, **kindness**, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering; Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do you. And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also you are called in one body; and be you thankful. Colossians 3:12-15

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the **kindness** and love of God our Savior toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior; That being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:3-7

Besides this, giving all diligence, add to your faith virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly **kindness**; and to brotherly **kindness** charity. For if these things be in you, and abound, they make you that you shall neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. But he that lacks these things is blind, and cannot see afar off, and has forgotten that he was purged from his old sins. Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if you do these things, you shall never fall... 2 Peter 1:5-10

### **PEACE**

You shall go to your fathers in **peace**; you shall be buried in a good old age. Genesis 15:15

And the man wondering at her held his **peace**, to wit [know] whether the LORD had made his journey prosperous or not. Genesis 24:21

Let there be now an oath betwixt [between] us, even betwixt us and you, and let us make a covenant with you; that you will do us no hurt, as we have not touched you, and as we have done unto you nothing but good, and have sent you away in **peace**: you are now the blessed of the LORD. And he made them a feast, and they did eat and drink. And they rose up betimes in the morning, and swore one to another: and Isaac sent them away, and they departed from him in **peace**. Genesis 26:28-31

And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on, So that I come again to my father's house in **peace**; then shall the LORD be my God...Genesis 28:20-21

Jacob heard that he had defiled Dinah his daughter: now his sons were with his cattle in the field: and Jacob held his **peace** until they were come. Genesis 34:5

Pharaoh said unto Joseph, I have dreamed a dream, and there is none that can interpret it: and I have heard say of you, that you can understand a dream to interpret it. And Joseph answered Pharaoh, saying, It is not in me: God shall give Pharaoh an answer of **peace**. Genesis 41:15-16

He said, **Peace** be to you, fear not: your God, and the God of your father, has given you treasure in your sacks: Genesis 43:23

He said, God forbid that I should do so: but the man in whose hand the cup is found, he shall be my servant; and as for you, get you up in **peace** unto your father. Genesis 44:17

Moses went and returned to Jethro...Let me go, I pray you, and return unto my brethren which are in Egypt, and see whether they be yet alive. And Jethro said to Moses, Go in **peace**. Exodus 4:18

Fear you not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which He will show to you to-day: for the Egyptians whom you have seen to-day, you shall see them again no more for ever. The LORD shall fight for you, and you shall hold your **peace**. Exodus 14:13-14

Every small matter they shall judge: so shall it be easier for yourself, and they shall bear the burden with you. If you shall do this thing, and God command you so, then you shall be able to endure, and all this people shall also go to their place in **peace**. Exodus 18:22-23

Then Moses said unto Aaron, This is it that the LORD spoke, saying, I will be sanctified in them that come nigh Me, and before all the people I will be glorified. And Aaron held his **peace**. Leviticus 10:3

And I will give **peace** in the land, and you shall lie down, and none shall make you afraid: and I will rid evil beasts out of the land, neither shall the sword go through your land. Levi 26:6

The LORD bless you, and keep you: The LORD make His face shine upon you, and be gracious unto you: The LORD lift up His countenance upon you, and give you **peace**. And they shall put My name upon the children of Israel; and I will bless them. Numbers 6:24-27

Phinehas, the son of Eleazar, the son of Aaron the priest, has turned My wrath away from the children of Israel, while he was zealous for My sake among them, that I consumed not the children of Israel in My jealousy. Wherefore say, Behold, I give unto him My covenant of **peace**: and he shall have it, and his seed after him, even the covenant of an everlasting priesthood; because he was zealous for his God... Numbers 25:11-13

If a woman also vow a vow unto the LORD... and her father hear her vow... and her father shall hold his **peace** at her: then all her vows shall stand...and if she had at all an husband, when she vowed, or uttered aught out of her lips, wherewith she bound her soul; and her husband heard it, and held his **peace** at her in the day that he heard it: then her vows shall stand, and her bonds wherewith she bound her soul shall stand... Numbers 30:3-4, 6-7

If she vowed in her husbands' house, or bound her soul by a bond with an oath; and her husband heard it, and held his **peace** at her, and disallowed her not: then all her vows shall stand, and every bond wherewith she bound her soul shall stand...But if her husband altogether hold his **peace** at her from day to day; then he establishes all her vows, or all her bonds, which are upon her: he confirms them, because he held his **peace** at her in the day that he heard them. Numbers 30:10-11, 13-14

I sent messengers out of the wilderness of Kedemoth unto Sihon king of Heshbon with words of **peace**, saying, Let me pass through your land... Deuteronomy 2:26-27

When you come nigh unto a city to fight against it, then proclaim **peace** unto it. And it shall be, if it make you answer of **peace**, and open unto you, then it shall be, that all the people that is found therein shall be tributaries unto you, and they shall serve you. And if it will make no **peace** with you, but will make war against you, then you shall besiege it... Deuteronomy 20:10-12

An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter the congregation of the LORD because they met you not with bread and with water in the way, when you came forth out of Egypt...The LORD your God would not hearken unto Balaam; but the LORD your God turned the curse into a blessing unto you, because the LORD your God loved you. You shall not seek their **peace** nor their prosperity all your days forever. Deut 23:3-6

And it shall come to pass, when he hears the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have **peace**, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst: the LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. Deuteronomy 29:19-20

Then Joshua built an altar unto the LORD God of Israel in mount Ebal, As Moses the servant of the LORD commanded the children of Israel...an altar of whole stones...and offered thereon burnt offerings unto the LORD, and sacrificed **peace** offerings. Joshua 8:30-31

The men took of their victuals, and asked not counsel at the mouth of the LORD. And Joshua made **peace** with them, and made a league with them, to let them live: and the princes of the congregation swore unto them. Joshua 9:14-15

It came to pass, when Adoni-zedek king of Jerusalem had heard how Joshua had taken Ai, and had utterly destroyed it; as he had done to Jericho and her king, so he had done to Ai and her king; and how the inhabitants of Gibeon had made **peace** with Israel, and were among them; that they feared greatly...Adonizedec king of Jerusalem sent...saying, Come up unto me, and help me, that we may smite Gibeon: for it has made **peace** with Joshua and with the children of Israel. Joshua 10:1-4

All the people returned to the camp to Joshua at Makkedah in **peace**: none moved his tongue against any of the children of Israel. Joshua 10:21

There was not a city that made **peace** with the children of Israel, save the Hivites the inhabitants of Gibeon: all other they took battle. Joshua 11:19

Howbeit Sisera fled away on his feet to the tent of Jael the wife of Heber the Kenite: for there was **peace** between Jabin the king of Hazor and the house of Heber the Kenite. Judges 4:17

When Gideon perceived that he was an angel of the LORD, Gideon said, Alas, O Lord GOD! For because I have seen an angel of the LORD face to face. And the LORD said unto him, **Peace** be unto you, fear not: you shall not die. Judges 6:22-23

Gideon...spake also unto the men of Penuel, saying, When I come again in **peace**, I will break down this tower. Judges 8:9

Then it shall be, that whatsoever comes forth of the doors of my house to meet me, when I return in **peace** from the children of Ammon, shall surely be the LORD'S, and I will offer it up for a burnt offering. Judges 11:31

Behold, I will send a lad, saying, go, find out the arrows. If I expressly say unto the lad, Behold, the arrows are on this side of you, take them; then come you: for there is **peace** to you, and no hurt; as the LORD lives. 1 Samuel 20:21

Jonathan said to David, Go in **peace**, for a smuch as we have sworn both of us in the name of the LORD, saying, be between me and thee, and between my seed and your seed for ever. And he arose and departed: and Jonathan went into the city. 1 Samuel 20:42

Abner said unto David, I will arise and go, and will gather all Israel unto my lord the king, that they may make a league with you, and that you may reign over all that your heart desires. And David sent Abner away; and he went in **peace**...They told Joab, saying, Abner the son of Ner came to the king, and he has sent him away, and he is gone in **peace**. 2 Samuel 3:21, 23

They brought in the ark of the LORD, and set it in His place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and **peace** offerings before the LORD. And as soon as David had made an end of offering burnt offerings and **peace** offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD of hosts. 2 Samuel 6:17-18

And the Syrians fled before Israel; and David slew the men of seven hundred chariots of the Syrians, and forty thousand horsemen, and smote Shobach the captain of their host, who died there. And when all the kings that were servants to Hadarezer saw that they were smitten before Israel, they made **peace** with Israel, and served them. So the Syrians feared to help the children of Ammon any more. 2 Samuel 10:18-19

David built there an altar unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings and **peace** offerings. So the LORD was intreated for the land, and the plague was stayed from Israel. 2 Samuel 24:25

You know also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, and what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel...whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in **peace**, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that was about his loins, and in his shoes that were on his feet..Do therefore according to your wisdom, and let not his hoar head go down to the grave in **peace**...Their blood shall return upon the head of Joab, and upon the head of his seed for ever: but upon David, and upon his seed, and upon his house, and upon His throne, shall there be **peace** for ever from the LORD. 1 Kings 2:5-6, 33

Solomon awoke, and, behold, it was a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered **peace** offerings, and made a feast to all his servants. 1 Kings 3:15

Solomon offered a sacrifice of **peace** offerings which he offered unto the LORD, two and twenty thousand oxen, and an hundred and twenty thousand sheep. So the king and all the children of Israel dedicated the house of the LORD. 1 Kings 8:63

Three times in a year did Solomon offer burnt offerings and **peace** offerings upon the altar which he built unto the LORD, and he burnt incense upon the altar that was before the LORD. So he finished the house. 1 Kings 9:25

Behold, I will gather you to your fathers, and you shall be gathered to your grave in **peace**, neither shall your eyes see all the evil that I will bring upon this place, and upon the inhabitants of the same. 2 Chronicles 34:28

Then sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and to Shimshai the scribe, and to the rest of their companions that dwell in Samaria, and unto the rest beyond the river, **Peace**, and at such a time. Ezra 4:17

Artaxerxes, king of kings, unto Ezra the priest, a scribe of the law of the God of Heaven, perfect **peace**, and at such a time. Ezra 7:12

For Mordecai the Jew was next unto king Ahasuerus, and great among the Jews, and accepted of the multitude of his brethren, seeking the wealth of his people, and speaking **peace** to all his seed. Esther 10:3

I will both lay me down in **peace**, and sleep: for You, LORD, only make me dwell in safety. Psalm 4:8

If I have rewarded evil unto him that was at **peace** with me; (yes, I have delivered him that without cause is mine enemy:) Let the enemy persecute my soul, and take it; yes, let him tread down my life upon the earth, and lay my honor in the dust. Selah. ... Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak **peace** to their neighbors, but mischief is in their hearts. Psalm 7:4-5; 28:3

The LORD will give strength unto His people; the LORD will bless His people with **peace**. Psalm 29:11

Depart from evil, and do good; seek **peace**, and pursue it. Psalm 34:14

For they speak not **peace**: but they devise deceitful matters against them that are quiet in the land. Psalm 35:20

But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of **peace**. Psalm 37:11

Mark the perfect man, and behold the upright: for the end of that man is **peace**. Psalm 37:37

I was dumb with silence, I held my **peace**, even from good; and my sorrow was stirred. Psalm 39:2

Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not Your **peac**e at my tears: for I am a stranger with You, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. Psalm 39:12

He has delivered my soul in **peace** from the battle that was against me: for there were many with me...He has put forth his hands against such that be at **peace** with him: he has broken his covenant. Psalm 55:18, 20

The mountains shall bring **peace** to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness...In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of **peace** so long as the moon endures. Psalm 72:3, 7

Keep not silence, O God; hold not Your **peace**, and be not still, O God. Psalm 83:1

I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for He will speak **peac**e unto His people, and to His saints: but let them not turn again to folly. Surely His salvation is nigh them that fear Him; that glory may dwell in our land. Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and **peace** have kissed each other. Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Yes, the LORD shall give that which is good; and our land shall yield her increase. Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set us in the way of His steps. Psalm 85:8-13

Hold not your **peace**, O God of my praise; For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue. They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause. For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer. Psalm 109:1-4

Great **peace** have they which love Your law: and nothing shall offend them. Psalm 119:165

My soul has long dwelt with him that hates **peace**. I am for **peace**: but when I speak, they are for war. Psalm 120:6-7

I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD. Our feet shall stand within your gates, O Jerusalem. Jerusalem is built as a city that is compact together...Pray for the **peace** of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love you. **Peace** be within your walls, and prosperity within your palaces. For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, **Peace** be within you. Psalm 122:1-3, 6-8

As for such as turn aside unto their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them forth with the workers of iniquity: but **peace** shall be upon Israel. Psalm 125:5

Yes, you shall see your children's children, and **peace** upon Israel. Psalm 128:6

He makes **peace** in your borders, and fills you with the finest of the wheat. He sends forth His commandment upon earth: His word runs very swiftly. Psalm 147:14-15

My son, forget not my law; but let your heart keep my commandments; For length of days, and long life, and **peace**, shall they add to you...Happy is the man that finds wisdom, and the man that gets understanding...Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are **peace**. Proverbs 3:1-2, 13, 17

He that is void of wisdom despises his neighbor: but a man of understanding holds his **peace**. Proverbs 11:12

Deceit is in the heart of them that imagine evil: but to the counselors of **peace** is joy. Proverbs 12:20

When a man's ways please the LORD, he makes even his enemies to be at **peace** with him. Proverbs 16:7

Even a fool, when he holds his **peace**, is counted wise: and he that shuts his lips is esteemed a man of understanding. Proverbs 17:28

To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven...A time to love, and a time to hate; a time of war, and a time of **peace**. Ecclesiastes 3:1, 8

For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of **Peace**. Of the increase of His government and **peace** there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, an upon His kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:6-7

You will keep him in perfect **peace**, whose mind is stayed on You: because he trusts in You...LORD, You will ordain **peace** for us: for you also have wrought all our works in us. Isaiah 26:3, 12

Let him take hold of My strength, that he may make **peace** with Me; and he shall make **peace** with Me. Isaiah 27:5

The work of righteousness shall be **peace**; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. Isaiah 32:17

O that you had hearkened to My commandments! Then had your **peace** been as a river, and your righteousness as the waves of the sea... Isaiah 48:18

There is no **peace**, says the LORD, unto the wicked. Isaiah 48:22

How beautiful upon the mountains are the feet of him that brings good tidings, that publishes **peace**; that brings good tidings of good, that publishes salvation; that says unto Zion, Your God reigns! Isaiah 52:7

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our **peace** was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53:5

For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but My kindness shall not depart from you, neither shall the covenant of My **peace** be removed, says the LORD that has mercy on you...All your children shall be taught of the LORD; and great shall be the **peace** of your children. Isaiah 54:10, 13

For you shall go out with joy, and be led forth with **peace**: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands. Isaiah 55:12

He shall enter into **peace**: they shall rest in their beds, each one walking in his uprightness. Isaiah 57:2

I create the fruit of the lips; **Peace**, **peace** to him that is far off, and to him that is near, says the LORD; and I will heal him. Isaiah 57:19

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of **peace**, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Jeremiah 29:11

I will make with them a covenant of **peace**, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods. Ezekiel 34:25

My covenant was with him of life and **peace**; and I gave them to him for the fear wherewith he feared me, and was afraid before My name. The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with Me in **peace** and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. Malachi 2:5-6

Blessed are the **peacemakers**: for they shall be called the children of God. Matthew 5:9

And if the house be worthy, let your **peace** come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your **peace** return to you. Matthew 10:13

Think not that I am come to send **peace** on earth: I came not to send **peace**, but a sword. Matthew 10:34

And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their **peace**: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David. Matthew 20:31

But Jesus held His **peace**. And the high priest answered and said unto Him, I adjure Thee by the living God, that You tell us whether You are the Christ, the Son of God. Matthew 26:63

And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold your **peace**, and come out of him. Mark 1:25

And He arose, and rebuked the wind, and said unto the sea, **Peace**, be still. And the wind ceased, and there was a great calm. Mark 4:39

And He said unto her, Daughter, your faith has made you whole; go in **peace**, and be whole of your plague. Mark 5:34

Salt is good; but if the salt have lost his saltness, wherewith will you season it? Have salt in yourselves, and have **peace** one with another. Mark 9:50

But He held His **peace**, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked Him, and said unto Him, Are You the Christ, the Son of the Blessed? Mark 14:61

To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of **peace**. Luke 1:79

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth **peace**, good will toward men. Luke 2:14

Lord, not let Your servant depart in **peace**, according to Your word... Luke 2:29

And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold your **peace**, and come out of him. And when the demon had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not. Luke 4:35

And He said to the woman, Your faith has saved you; go in **peace**. Luke 7:50

And He said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: your faith has made you whole; go in **peace**. Luke 8:48

And into whatsoever house you enter, first say, **Peace** be to this house. And if the Son of **peace** be there, your **peace** shall rest upon it: if not, it shall turn to you again. Luke 10:5-6

When a strong man armed keeps his palace, his goods are in **peace**: But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he takes from him all his armor wherein he trusted, and divides his spoils. Luke 11:21-22

Suppose you that I am come to give **peace** on earth? I tell you, Nay; but rather division. Luke 12:51

Jesus answering spoke unto the lawyers and Pharisees, saying, Is it lawful to heal on the sabbath day? And they held there **peace**. And he took him, and healed him, and let him go; Luke 14:3-4

That as He was near Jericho, a certain blind man sat by the way side begging...and he cried, saying, Jesus, son of David, have mercy on me...They which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his **peace**: but he cried so much the more, son of David, have mercy on me. Luke 18:34-39

When He came nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen; Saying, Blessed be the King that comes in the name of the Lord: **peace** in Heaven, and glory in the highest. And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto Him, Master, rebuke Your disciples. And He answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their **peace**, the stones would immediately cry out. And when He was come near, He behold the city, and wept over it, Saying, If you had known, even you, at least in this your day, the things which belong unto your **peace**! But now they are hid from your eyes. Luke 19:37-42

They could not take hold of His words before the people: and they marveled at His answer, and held their **peace**. Luke 20:26

As they thus spoke, Jesus Himself stood in the midst of them, and said unto them, **Peace** be unto you. Luke 24:36

**Peace** I leave with you, My **peace** I give unto you: not as the world gives, give I unto you Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. John 14:27

These things have I spoken unto you, that in me you might have **peace**. In the world you shall have tribulation but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world. John 16:33

Then the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and said unto them, **Peace** be unto you. Then said Jesus to them again, **Peace** be unto you: as My Father has sent Me, even so send I you... After eight days again His disciples were within, and Thomas with them: then came Jesus, the doors being shut, and stood in the midst, and said, **Peace** be unto you. John 20:19-20-26

The word which God sent unto the children of Israel, preaching **peace** by Jesus Christ: (He is Lord of all:) Acts 10:36

When they heard these things, they held their **peace**, and glorified God, saying, Then has God granted repentance unto life unto the Gentiles. Acts 11:18

He beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their **peace**, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of prison. And he said, Go show these things unto James, and to the brethren. And he departed... Acts 12:17

Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired **peace**... Acts 12:20

After they had held their **peace**, James answered, saying, Men and brethren, hearken unto me...After they had tarried there a space, they were let go in **peace** from the brethren unto the apostles. Acts 15:13, 33

They keeper of the prison told this saying to Paul, The magistrates have sent to let you go: now therefore depart, and go in **peace**. Acts 16:36

Then spoke the Lord to Paul in the night by a vision, Be not afraid, but speak, and hold not your **peace**: For I am with you, and no man shall set on you to hurt you: for I have much people in this city. Acts 18:9-10

To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and **peace** from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ. Romans 1:7

To them who by patient continuance in well-doing seek for glory and honor and immortality, eternal life...But glory, honor, and **peace**, to every man that works good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile. Romans 2:7, 10

...Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness: Their feet are swift to shed blood: Destruction and misery are in their ways: And the way of **peace** have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes. Romans 3:14-18

Therefore being justified by faith, we have **peace** with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2

To be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and **peace**. Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. Romans 8:6-7

How shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of **peace**, and bring glad tidings of good things! Romans 10:15

Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men. If it be possible, as much as lies in you, live **peaceably** with all men. Romans 12:17-18

For the Kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and **peace**, and joy in the Holy Ghost...Let us therefore follow after the things which make for **peace**, and things wherewith one may edify another. Romans 14:17, 19

Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and **peace** in believing, that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Spirit...Now the God of **peace** be with you all. Amen... And the God of **peace** shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. Romans 15:13, 33; 16:20

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]. 1 Corinthians 1:3

If the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God has called us to **peace**. 1 Corinthians 7:15

If any thing be revealed to another that sits by, let the first hold his **peace**...For God is not the author of confusion, but of **peace**, as in all churches of the saints. 1 Corinthians 14:30, 33

Let no man therefore despise him: but conduct him forth in **peace**, that he may come unto me: for I look for him with the brethren. 1 Corinthians 16:11

Grace be to you and **peace** from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]...Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in **peace**; and the God of love and peace shall be with you. 2 Corinthians 13:2, 11

Grace be to you and **peace** from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]. Galatians 1:3

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, **peace**, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance. Galatians 5:22-23a

But God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world. For in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua] neither circumcision avails any thing, nor uncircumcision, but a new creature. And as many as walk according to this rule, **peace** be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God. Galatians 6:14-16

Grace be to you, and **peace**, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...Now in Messiah Yeshua you who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Messiah. For He is our **peace**, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of partition between us; Having abolished in His flesh the enmity, even the law of commandments contained in ordinances; for to make in Himself of twain one new man, so making **peace**... Ephesians 1:2; 2:13-14

That He might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby: And came and preached **peace** to you that were afar off, and to them that were nigh. For through Him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father... I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called, with all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; Endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of **peace**. Ephesians 2:16-18, 4:1-3

Grace be unto you, and **peace**, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. And the **peace** of God, which passes all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus [Yeshua the Messiah]. Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Those things, which you have both learned, and received, and heard, and seen in me, do: and the God of **peace** shall be with you. Philippians 1:2; 4:6-9

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ... For it pleased the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell; And, having made **peace** through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself; by Him, I say, whether they be things in earth, or things in heaven. Col 1:2, 19-20

Above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness. And let the **peace** of God rule in your hearts, to the which also you are called in one body... Colossians 3:14-15

...Grace be unto you, and **peace**, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ...But of the times and the seasons, brethren, you have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, **Peace** and safety; then sudden destruction comes upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3

Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. The very God of **peace** sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ 1 Thess 5:19-23

Grace unto you, and **peace**, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ...Now the Lord of **peace** Himself give you **peace** always by all means. The Lord be with you all. 2 Thess 1:2, 3:16

Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and **peace**, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord...I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and **peaceable** life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 1Timothy 1:2, 2:1-4

To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and **peace**, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord...Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, **peace**, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 1:2, 2:22

To Titus...Grace, mercy and **peace**, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior. Titus 1:4

Grace to you, and **peace**, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Philemon 1:3

For this Melchisedec, king of Salem [peace], priest of the Most High God, who met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings, and blessed him; To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all, first being by interpretation King of righteousness, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of **peace**... Hebrews 7:1-2

By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with **peace**. Hebrews 11:31

No chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yields the **peaceable** fruit of righteousness unto them which put it into practice. Hebrews 12:11

Follow **peace** with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord...Now the God of **peace**, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you perfect in every good work to do His will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 12:14; 13:20-21

If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food, and one of you say unto them, Depart in **peace**, be you warmed and filled; nothwithstanding you give them not those things which are needful to the body; what does it profit? Even so faith, if it has not works, is dead, being alone...The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then **peaceable**, gentle, and easy to be entreated, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in **peace** of them that make **peace**. James 2:14-17; 3:17-18

Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to the strangers scattered throughout Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bthynia, Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and **peace**, be multiplied. 1 Peter 1:1-2

For he that will love life, and see good days, let him refrain his tongue from evil, and his lips that they speak no guile: let him eschew [avoid] evil, and do good; let him seek **peace**, and ensue [follow] it. For the eyes of the Lord are over the righteous, and His ears are open unto their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil. 1 Peter 3:10-12

Greet you one another with a kiss of charity. **Peace** be with you all that are in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]. Amen. 1 Peter 5:14

Grace and **peace** be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, according as His divine power has given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him that has called us to glory and virtue... 2 Peter 1:2-3

We, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwells righteousness. Wherefore, beloved, seeing that you look for such things, be diligent that you may be found of Him in **peace**, without spot, and blameless. 2 Peter 3:13-14

Grace be with you, mercy, and **peace**, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. 2 John 1:3

But I trust I shall shortly see you, and we shall speak face to face. **Peace** be to you. Our friends salute you. Greet the friends by name. 3 John 1:14

Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. Jude 1:2

John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and **peace**, from Him which is, and which was, and which is to come; and from the seven Spirits which are before His throne. Revelation 1:4

And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take **peace** from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword. Revelation 6:4

## **SWEET**

The LORD smelled a **sweet** savor; and the LORD said in His heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done. Genesis 8:21

He cried unto the LORD; and the LORD showed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made **sweet**... Exodus 15:25

Oil for light, spices for anointing oil, and for **sweet** incense... He made the holy anointing oil, and the pure incense of **sweet** spices, according to the work of the apothecary. Exodus 25:6; 37:29

And he burnt **sweet** incense thereon; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:27

The priests shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a **sweet** savor to the LORD. Leviticus 17:6

And for a drink offering you shall offer the third part of an hin of wine, for a **sweet** savor to the LORD. Numbers 15:7

Now these be the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man who was raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the **sweet** psalmist of Israel, said... 2 Samuel 23:1

Behold, I build an house to the name of the LORD my God, to dedicate it to Him, and to burn before Him **sweet** incense, and for the continual showbread, and for the burnt offerings morning and evening, on the sabbaths, and on the new moons, and on the solemn feasts of the LORD our God. This is an ordinance for ever to Israel. 2 Chronicles 2:4

They buried him in his own sepulchers, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with **sweet** odors and divers kinds of spices prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him. 2 Chronicles 16:14

Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the **sweet**, and send portions to them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be you sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10

Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahasuerus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with **sweet** odors, and with other things for the purifying of the women...) Esther 2:12

Can thou bind the **sweet** influences of Pleiades, or loose the bands of Orion? Job 38:31

More to be desired are they than gold, yes, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. Psalm 19:10

We took **sweet** counsel together, and walked unto the house of God in company. Psalm 55:14

My meditation of Him shall be **sweet**: I will be glad in the LORD. Psalm 104:34

How **sweet** are Your words unto my taste! ye**s**, **sweeter** than honey to my mouth! Psalm 119:103

When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear My words; for they are **sweet**. Psalm 141:6

When you lie down, you shall not be afraid: yes, you shall lie down, and your sleep shall be **sweet**. Proverbs 3:24

The desire accomplished is **sweet** to the soul: but it is abomination to fools to depart from evil. Proverbs 13:19

The wise in heart shall be called prudent: and the **sweetness** of the lips increases learning. Proverbs 16:21

Pleasant words are as an honeycomb, **sweet** to the soul, and health to the bones. Proverbs 16:24

My son, eat honey, because it is good; and the honeycomb, which is **sweet** to your taste... Proverbs 24:13

The full soul loathes an honeycomb; but to the hungry soul every bitter thing is **sweet**. Proverbs 27:7

Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so does the **sweetness** of a man's friend by hearty counsel. Proverbs 27:9

The sleep of a laboring man is **sweet**, whether he eat little or much: but the abundance of the rich will not suffer him to sleep. Ecclesiastes 5:12

Truly the light is **sweet**, and a pleasant thing it is for the eyes to behold the sun... Ecclesiastes 11:7

His mouth is most **sweet**: yes, he is altogether lovely. This is my beloved, and this is my friend, O daughters of Jerusalem. Song of Solomon 5:16

Woe to them that call evil good, and good evil; that put darkness for light, and light for darkness; that put bitter for **sweet**, and **sweet** for bitter! Isaiah 5:20

My sleep was sweet unto me. Jeremiah 31:26

I will accept you with your **sweet** savor, when I bring you out from the people, and gather you out of the countries wherein you have been scattered; and I will be sanctified in you before the heathen. Ezekiel 20:41

Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that the plowman shall overtake the reaper, and the treader of grapes him that sows seed; and the mountains shall drop **sweet** wine, and all the hills shall melt. Amos 9:13

When the sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the mother of James, and Salome, had bought **sweet** spices, that they might come and anoint him. Mark 16:1

For we are unto God a **sweet** savor of Christ, in them that are saved... 2 Corinthians 2:15

Walk in love, as Christ also has loved us, and has given Himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a **sweetsmelling savour**. Ephesians 5:2

But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things which were sent from you, an odor of a **sweet** smell, a sacrifice acceptable, well pleasing to God. Philippians 4:18

Does a fountain send forth at the same place **sweet** water and bitter? James 3:11

I went unto the angel, and said unto him, Give me the little book. And he said unto me, Take it, and eat it up; and it shall make your belly bitter, but it shall be in thy mouth **sweet** as honey. Revelation 10:9

## TENDER

Leah was **tender** eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well favored. Genesis 29:17

He said unto him, My lord knows that the children are **tender**, and the flocks and herds with young are with me: and if men should overdrive them one day, all the flock will die. Genesis 33:13

So that the man that is **tender** among you, and very delicate, his eye shall be evil toward his brother, and toward the wife of his bosom, and toward the remnant of his children, which he shall leave: So that he will not give to any of them of the flesh of his children whom he shall eat: because he has nothing left him in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith your enemies shall distress you in all thy gates. The **tender** and delicate woman among you, which would not adventure to set the sole of her foot upon the ground for delicateness and tenderness, her eye shall be evil toward the husband of her bosom, and toward her son, and toward her daughter, And toward her young one that come out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear; for she shall eat them for want of all things secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith your enemy shall distress thee in the gates. If you will not observe to do all the words of this law that are written in this book...Deuteronomy 28:54-58

My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distill as the dew, as the small rain upon the **tender** herb, and as the showers upon the grass... Deuteronomy 32:2

He shall be as the light of the morning, when the sun rises, even a morning without clouds; as the **tender** grass springing out of the earth by clear shining after rain. 2 Samuel 23:4

Because your heart was **tender**, and you have humbled yourself before the LORD, when you heard what I spoke against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and have rent your clothes, and wept before me; I also have heard you, says the LORD. 2 Kings 22:19

David said, Solomon my son is young and **tender**, and the house that is to be built for the LORD must be exceeding magnificent, of fame and of glory throughout all countries... 1 Chronicles 22:5

Furthermore David the king said to all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God has chosen, is yet young and **tender**, and the work is great: for the palace is not for man, but for the LORD God. 1 Chronicles 29:1

There are gathered to him vain men, the children of Belial, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and **tenderhearted**, and could not withstand them. 2 Chronicles 13:7

Because your heart was **tender**, and you did humble yourself before God, when you heard His words against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, and humbled yourself before Me, and did rend your clothes, and weep before me; I have even heard you also, says the LORD. 2 Chronicles 34:27

For there is hope of a tree, if it be cut down, that it will sprout again, and that the **tender** branch thereof will not cease. Job 14:7

Remember, O LORD, Your **tender** mercies and Your lovingkindnesses; for they have been ever of old. Psalm 25:6

Withhold not Your **tender** mercies from me, O LORD: let Your lovingkindness and Your truth continually preserve me. Psalm 40:11

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness: according to the multitude of Your **tender** mercies. Psalm 69:16

Has God forgotten to be gracious? Has He in anger shut up His **tender** mercies? Selah. Psalm 77:9

O remember not against us former iniquities; let Your **tender** mercies speedily prevent us: for we are brought very low. Psalm 79:8

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless His holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all your diseases; who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with lovingkindness and **tender** mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's...Like as a father pities his children, so the LORD pities them that fear Him. For He knows our frame; He remembers that we are dust. Psalm 103:1-5, 13-14

Let Your **tender** mercies come unto me, that I may live: for Your law is my delight. Psalm 119:77

Great are Your **tender** mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to Your judgments. Psalm 119:156

The LORD is good to all: and His **tender** mercies are over all His works. Psalm 145:9

For I was my father's son, **tender** and only beloved in the sight of my mother. Proverbs 4:3

A righteous man regards the life of his beast: but the **tender** mercies of the wicked are cruel. Proverbs 12:10

The fig tree puts forth her green figs, and the vines with the **tender** grape give a good smell. Arise, my love, my fair one, and come away. O my dove, that are in the clefts of the rock, in the secret places of the stairs, let me see your countenance, let me hear your voice; for sweet is your voice, and your countenance is comely. Take us the foxes, the little foxes, that spoil the vines: for our vines have **tender** grapes. My beloved is mine, and I am his: he feeds among the lilies. Until the day break, and the shadows flee away, turn, my beloved, and be like a roe or a young hart upon the mountains of Bether. Song of Solomon 2:13-17

Come down, and sit in the dust, O virgin daughter of Babylon, sit on the ground: there is no throne, O daughter of the Chaldeans: for you shall no more be called **tender** and delicate. Isaiah 47:1

For he shall grow up before him as a **tender** plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him. Isaiah 53:2

Thus says the Lord GOD; I will also take of the highest branch of the high cedar, and will set it; I will crop off from the top of his young twigs a **tender** one, and will plant it upon an high mountain and eminent... Ezekiel 17:22

Now God had brought Daniel into favor and **tender** love with the prince of the eunuchs. Daniel 1:9

Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When his branch is yet **tender**, and puts forth leaves, you know that summer is nigh... Matthew 24:32

You, child, shall be called the prophet of the Highest: for you shall go before the face of the Lord to prepare His ways; To give knowledge of salvation unto His people by the remission of their sins, Through the **tender** mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high has visited us, To give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. Luke 1:76-79

And be you kind one to another, **tenderhearted**, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake has forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

Behold, we count them happy which endure. You have heard of the patience of Job and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of **tender** mercy. James 5:11
