GOD'S PLEASURE

Balak said unto Balaam, Neither curse them at all, nor bless them at all. But Balaam answered and said unto Balak, Told not I you, saying, All that the LORD speaks, that I must do? And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will bring you unto another place: peradventure it will **please** God that you may curse me then from thence. Numbers 13:25-27

For the LORD will not forsake His people for His great name's sake: because it has **pleased** the LORD to make you His people. 1 Samuel 12:22

Now, O Lord GOD, You are that God, and Your words be true, and You have promised this goodness unto Your servant: Therefore now let it **please** You to bless the house of Your servant, that it may continue for ever before You: for You, O Lord GOD, have spoken it; and with Your blessing let the house of thy servant be blessed for ever. 2 Samuel 7:29

Give therefore Your servant an understanding heart to judge Your people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this Your so great a people? And the speech **pleased** the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing. 1 Kings 3:9-10

Now, LORD, You are God, and have promised this goodness unto Your servant: Now therefore let it **please** You to bless the house of Your servant, that it may be before You for ever: for You bless, O LORD, and it shall be blessed for ever. 1 Chronicles 17:26-27

I know also, my God, that You try the heart, and have **pleasure** in uprightness. 1 Chronicles 29:17

For You are not a God that has **pleasure** in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with You. Psalm 5:4

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favor my righteous cause: yes, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, who has **pleasure** in the prosperity of His servant. Psalm 35:27

They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of Your house; and You shalt make them drink of the river of Your **pleasures**. Psalm 36:8

Do good in Your good **pleasure** unto Zion: build Thou the walls of Jerusalem. Then shall You be **pleased** with the sacrifices of righteousness...Psalm 51:18-19

I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify Him with thanksgiving. This also shall **please** the LORD better than an ox or bullock that has horns and hoofs. The humble shall see this and be glad: and your heart shall live that seek God. Psalm 69:30-32

Bless you the LORD, all you His hosts; you ministers of His, that do His **pleasure**. Psalm 103:21

Whatsoever the LORD **pleased**, that did He in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places. Psalm 135:6

He delights not in the strength of the horse: He takes not **pleasure** in the legs of a man. The LORD take**s pleasure** in them that fear Him, in those that hope in His mercy. Psalm 147:10-11

For the LORD takes **pleasure** in His people: He will beautify the meek with salvation. Psalm 149:4

When a man's ways **please** the LORD, He makes even his enemies to be at peace with him. Proverbs 16:7

When you vow a vow unto God, defer not to pay it; for He hat no **pleasure** in fools: pay that which you have vowed. Eccl 5:4

I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart is snares and nets, and her hands as bands: whoso **pleases** God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be taken by her. Ecclesiastes 7:26

The LORD is well **pleased** for His righteousness; sake; He will magnify the law, and make it honorable. Isaiah 42:21

I am the LORD...that says of Cyrus, He is My shepherd, and shall perform all My **pleasure**: even saying to Jerusalem, You shall be built; and to the temple, Your foundation shall be laid. Isaiah 44:28

For I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like Me, Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My **pleasure**: Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executes My counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it. Isaiah 46:9-11

Yet it **pleased** the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief: when You shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the **pleasure** of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. Isaiah 53:10

For as the rain comes down, and the snow from the heaven, and returns not thither, but waters the earth, and makes it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: So shall My word be that goes forth out of My mouth: it shall not return unto Me void, but it shall accomplish that which I **please**, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. Isaiah 55:10-11

There shall be lamentation generally upon all the house-tops of Moab, and in the streets thereof: for I have broken Moab like a vessel wherein is no **pleasure**, says the LORD. Jeremiah 48:38

Have I any **pleasure** at all that the wicked should die? says the Lord GOD: and not that he should return from his ways, and live? ... For I have no **pleasure** in the death of him that dies, says the Lord GOD: wherefore turn yourselves, and live. Ezekiel 18:23, 32

O son of man, speak unto the house of Israel...Say unto them, As I live, says the Lord GOD, I have no **pleasure** in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn you, turn you from your evil ways; for why will you die, O house of Israel? Ezekiel 33:10-11

For they have sown the wind, and they shall reap the whirlwind: it has no stalk: the bud shall yield no meal: if so be it yield, the strangers shall swallow it up. Israel is swallowed up: now shall they be among the Gentiles as a vessel wherein is no **pleasure**. Hosea 8:7-8

Will the LORD be **pleased** with thousands of rams, or with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul? He has shown you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with Your God? Micah 6:7-8

Thus says the LORD of hosts: Consider your ways. Go up to the mountain, and bring wood, and build the house; and I will take **pleasure** in it, and I will be glorified, says the LORD. Haggai 1:7-8

If you offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? And if you offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? Offer it now unto Your governor; will he be pleased with you, or accept your person? Says the LORD of hosts. And now, I pray you, beseech God that He will be gracious unto us: this has been by your means; will He regard your persons? Says the LORD of hosts. Who is there even among you that would shut the doors for nought? Neither do you kindle fire on mine altar for nought. I have no **pleasure** in you, says the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hands. Malachi 1:8-10

Seek not you what you shall eat, or what you shall drink, neither be you of doubtful mind. For all these things do the nations of the world seek after: and your Father knows that you have need of these things. but rather seek you the Kingdom of God; and all these things shall be added unto you. Fear not, little flock; for it is your Father's good **pleasure** to give you the Kingdom. Luke 12:29-32

Then said Jesus...He that sent Me is with Me: the Father has not left Me alone; for I do always those things that **please** Him. John 8:28-29

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. The carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. So then they that are in the flesh cannot **please** God. Romans 8:6-8

Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it **pleased** God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe. 1 Corinthians 1:20-21

He that is unmarried cares for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may **please** the Lord: But he that is married cares for the things that are of the world, how he may **please** his wife. There is difference also between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman cares for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married cares for the things of the world, how she may **please** her husband. 1 Cor 7:32-34

God set the members every one of them in the body, as it has **pleased** Him...God gives it a body as it has **pleased** Him, and to every seed his own body. All flesh is not the same flesh: but there is one kind of flesh of men, another flesh of beasts, another of fishes, and another of birds. 1 Corinthians 12:18; 15:38-39

For do I now persuade men, or God? Or do I seek to **please** men? For if I yet **pleased** men, I should not be the servant of Christ... But when it **pleased** God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by His grace, to reveal His Son in me, that I might preach Him among the heathen...Galatians 1:10, 15

He has chosen us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love: Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] to Himself, according to the good **pleasure** of His will...Having made known unto us the mystery of His will, according to His good **pleasure** which He has purposed to Himself... Ephesians 1:5, 9

For it is God which works in you both to will and to do of His good **pleasure**. Philippians 2:13

Since the day we heard it, [we] do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you might walk worthy of the Lord unto all **pleasing**, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God...He is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things He might have the preeminence. For it **pleased** the Father that in Him should all fulness dwell; And, having made peace through the blood of His cross, by Him to reconcile all things unto Himself... Colossians 1:9-10, 18-20

For it is God which works in you both to will and to do of His good **pleasure**. Philippians 2:13

We were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as **pleasing** men, but God, which tries our hearts. 1 Thessalonians 2:4

For you, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for you also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they have of the Jesus: who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets and have persecuted us; and they **please** not God, and are contrary to all men. 1 Thessalonians 2:14-15

Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as you have received of us how you ought to walk and to **please** God, so you would abound more and more. 1 Thessalonians 4:1

We pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good **pleasure** of His goodness, and the work of faith with power: that the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thesss 1:11-12

No man that wars entangles himself with the affairs of this life; that he may **please** Him who has chosen him to be a soldier... 2 Timothy 2:4

When He came into the world, He said, Sacrifice and offering You would not have, but a body have You prepared Me: In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You have had no **pleasure**...Sacrifice and offering and burnt offerings and offering for sin You would not, neither had **pleasure** therein; which are offered by the law... Hebrews 10:5-6, 8

Now the just shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, My soul shall have no **pleasure** in him. But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the saving of the soul. Hebrews 10:38-39

By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he **pleased** God. Hebrews 11:5

But without faith it is impossible to **please** Him: for he that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name. But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well **pleased**. Hebrews 13:15-16

Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are **pleasing** in His sight. 1 John 3:21-22

The four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship Him that lives for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for Thou hast created all things, and for Thy **pleasure** they are and were created. Revelation 4:10-11

PRAYER, PETITION, & SUPPLICATION

God said unto him in a dream, Yes, I know that you did this in the integrity of your heart; for I also withheld you from sinning against Me: therefore I suffered you not to touch her. Now therefore restore the man his wife; for he is a prophet, and he shall **pray** for you, and you shall live: and if you restore her not, know you that you shall surely die, you, and all that are yours...So Abraham **prayed** unto God: and God healed Abimelech, and his wife, and his maidservants; and they bare children. For the LORD had fast closed up all the wombs of the house of Abimelech, because of Sarah Abraham's wife. Genesis 20:6-7, 17-18

SONG OF PRAISE BY MOSES

Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the Lord, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the Lord, for He has triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider has He thrown into the sea. The Lord is my strength and song, and He is become my salvation: He is my God, and I will prepare Him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt Him. The Lord is a man of war; the Lord is His name. Pharaoh's chariots and his host has He cast into the sea: his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea. The depths have covered them: they sank into the bottom as a stone. Thy right hand, O Lord, is become glorious in power; Thy right hand, O Lord, has dashed in pieces the enemy. And in the greatness of Your excellency You have overthrown them that rose up against Thee: You sent forth Your wrath, which consumed them as stubble. And with the blast of Your nostrils the waters were gathered together, the floods stood upright as an heap, and the depths were congealed in the heart of the sea. The enemy said, I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil: my lust shall be satisfied upon them; I will draw my sword, my hand shall destroy them. You did blow with Your wind, the sea covered them: they sank as lead in the mighty waters. Who is like unto You, O Lord, among the gods? Who is like Thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, doing wonders? You stretched out Your right hand, the earth swallowed them. You in Your mercy have led forth the people which You have redeemed... Exodus 15:1-13a

You have guided them in Your strength unto Your holy habitation. The people shall hear, and be afraid: sorrow shall take hold on the inhabitants of Palestina. Then the dukes of Edom shall be amazed; the mighty men of Moab, trembling shall take hold upon them; all the inhabitants of Canaan shall melt away. Fear and dread shall fall upon them; by the greatness of Your arm they shall be as still as a stone; till Your people pass over, O Lord, till the people pass over, which You have purchased. You shall bring them in, and plant them in the mountain of Your inheritance, in the place, O Lord, which You have made for Yourself to dwell in, in the Sanctuary, O Lord, which Your hands have established. The Lord shall reign for ever and ever. For the horse of Pharaoh went in with his chariots and with his horsemen into the sea, and the Lord brought again the waters of the sea upon them; but the children of Israel went on dry land in the midst of the sea. Exodus 15:13b-19

Yet now, if you will forgive their sin; and if not, blot me, I **pray** You, out of Your book which You have written. Exodus 32:32

PRAYERS OF MOSES AND OF THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL

And Moses said unto the Lord, See, You say unto me, Bring up this people: and You have not let me know whom you will send with me. Yet You have said, I know you by name, and you have also found grace in My sight. Now therefore, I pray Thee, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know Thee, that I may find grace in Your sight: and consider that this nation is Your people. And He said, My presence shall go with you, and I will give you rest. And he said unto Him, If Your presence go not with me, carry us not up from here. For wherein shall it be known here that I and Thy people have found grace in Your sight? Is it not in that You go with us? So shall we be separated, I and Thy people, from all the people that are upon the face of the earth. And the Lord said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that You have spoken: for You have found grace in My sight, and I know you by name. Exodus 33:12-17

And he said, I beseech thee, Show me your glory. And He said, I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the Lord before you; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy. And He said, You can not see My face: for there shall no man see me, and live. And the Lord said, Behold, there is a place by Me, and you shall stand upon a rock: And it shall come to pass, while my glory passes by, that I will put you in a cleft of the rock, and will cover you with My hand while I pass by: And I will take away Mine hand, and you shall see My back parts: but My face shall not be seen. Exodus 33:18-23

If now I have found grace in Your sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I **pray** You, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for Your inheritance. Exodus 34:9

If they shall **confess** their iniquity, and the iniquity of their fathers, with their trespass which they trespassed against Me, and that also they have walked contrary unto Me; and that I also have walked contrary unto them, and have brought them into the land of their enemies; if then their uncircumcised hearts be humbled, and they then accept of the punishment of their iniquity: Then will I remember My covenant with Jacob, and also My covenant with Isaac, and also My covenant with Abraham will I remember; and I will remember the land. Leviticus 26:40-42

The people cried unto Moses; and when Moses **prayed** unto the LORD [YEHOVAH], the fire was quenched...The people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; **pray** unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses **prayed** for the people. Numbers 11:2, 21:7

THE HEAVENLY FATHER'S PRAYER

O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear me, and keep all my commandments always, that it might be well with them, and with their children for ever! Deuteronomy 5:29

The LORD was very angry with Aaron to have destroyed him: and I **prayed** for Aaron also the same time...I **prayed** therefore unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, destroy not Your people and Your inheritance, which You have redeemed through Your greatness. Deuteronomy 9:20, 26

Gideon said unto God, Let not Your anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I **pray** You, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew. Judges 6:39

Now therefore beware, I **pray** you, and drink not wine nor strong drink, and eat not any unclean thing... Judges 13:4

Samson called unto the LORD, and said, O Lord GOD, remember me, I **pray** You, and strengthen me, I **pray** You, only this once, O God, that I may be at once avenged of the Philistines for my two eyes. Judges 16:28

She was in bitterness of soul, and **prayed** unto the LORD, and wept sore...It came to pass, as she continued **praying** before the LORD, that Eli marked her mouth... Then Eli answered and said, Go in peace: and the God of Israel grant you your petition that you have asked of Him. 1 Samuel 1:10-12, 17

She said, Oh my lord...I am the woman that stood by you here, **praying** unto the LORD. For this child I **prayed**; and the LORD has given me my **petition** which I asked of Him: therefore also have I lent him to the LORD; as long as he lives he shall be lent to the LORD. And he worshiped the LORD there. 1 Samuel 1:26-28

And Hannah **prayed**, and said, My heart rejoices in the LORD, my horn is exalted in the LORD: my mouth is enlarged over mine enemies; because I rejoice in Your salvation. There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside You: neither is there any rock like our God. Talk no more so exceeding proudly; let not arrogancy come out of your mouth: for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by Him actions are weighed. The bows of the mighty men are broken, and they that stumbled are girded with strength. They that were full have hired out themselves for bread; and they that were hungry ceased: so that the barren has born seven; and she that has many children is waxed feeble...

The LORD kills, and makes alive: he brings down to the grave, and brings up. The LORD makes poor, and makes rich: he brings low, and lifts up. He raises up the poor out of the dust, and lifts up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit the throne of glory: for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and He has set the world upon them. He will keep the feet of His saints, and the wicked shall be silent in darkness; for by strength shall no man prevail. The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of Heaven shall He thunder upon them: the LORD shall judge the ends of the earth; and He shall give strength unto His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed. 1 Samuel 2:1-10

Samuel said, Gather all Israel to Mizpeh, and I will **pray** for you unto the LORD...The thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel **prayed** unto the LORD. 1 Samuel 7:5, 8:6

All the people said unto Samuel, **Pray** for your servants unto the LORD [YEHOVAH] your God, that we die not: for we have added unto all our sins this evil, to ask us a king...Moreover as for me, God forbid that I should sin against the LORD in ceasing to **pray** for you: but I will teach you the good and the right way... 1 Samuel 12:19-23

Therefore said I, The Philistines will come down now upon me to Gilgal, and I have not made **supplication** unto the LORD: I forced myself therefore, and offered a burnt offering. 1 Samuel 13:12

Now therefore, I **pray** you, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD. 1 Samuel 15:25

David spake unto the LORD when he saw the angel that smote the people, and said, Lo, I have sinned, and I have done wickedly: but these sheep, what have they done? Let Your hand, I **pray** You, be against me, and against my father's house. 2 Samuel 24:17

Now, O God of Israel, let Your word, I **pray** you, be verified, which You spake unto Your servant David my father. Will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain You; how much less this house that I have built? Yet have You respect unto the **prayer** of Your servant, and to his **supplication**, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and to the **prayer**, which Your servant **prays** before Thee today: That Your eyes may be open toward this house night and day, even toward the place of which You have said, My name shall be there: that You may hearken unto the **prayer** which Your servant shall make toward this place. And hearken You to the **supplication** of Your servant, and of Your people Israel, when they shall **pray** toward this place: and hear You in heaven Your dwelling place: and when You hear forgive. 1 Kings 8:26-30

When Your people Israel be smitten down before the enemy, because they have sinned against You, and shall turn again to You, and confess Your name, and pray, and make supplication unto You in this house: Then hear You in heaven, and forgive the sin of Your people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which You gave unto their fathers. When heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against You; if they pray toward this place, and confess Your name, and turn from their sin, when You afflict them: Then hear You in heaven, and forgive the sin of Your servants, and of Your people Israel, that You teach them the good way wherein they should walk, and give rain upon Your land, which You have given to Your people for an inheritance. If there be in the land famine, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, or if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness there be; What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all Your people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house: then hear You in heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive... Concerning a stranger..when he shall come and pray toward this house: Hear You in Heaven Your dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calls to You for

...If they sin against You, (for there is no man that sins not,) and You be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near; Yet if they shall think of themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and repent, and make supplication unto You in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness: and so return unto You with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captive, and pray unto You toward their land, which You gave unto their fathers, the city which You have chosen, and Your house which I have built for Your name: Then hear You their prayer and their supplication in heaven Your dwelling place, and maintain their cause, and forgive Your people that have sinned against You, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against You, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them: For they are Your people, and Your inheritance, which You brought forth out of Egypt, from the midst of the furnace of iron: that Your eyes may be open unto the **supplication** of Your servant, and unto the **supplication** of Your people Israel, to hearken unto them in all that they call for unto You. 1 Kings 8:33-52

When Solomon had made an end of **praying** all this **prayer** and **supplication** unto the LORD, he arose from before the altar of the LORD [YEHOVAH], from kneeling on his knees with his hands spread up to heaven. And he stood, and blessed all the congregation of Israel with a loud voice...Let these my words, wherewith I have made **supplication** before the LORD, be nigh unto the LORD [YEHOVAH] our God day and night, that He maintain the cause of His servant, and the cause of His people Israel at all times, as the matter shall require: That all the people of the earth may know that the LORD is God, and that there is none else. 1 Kings 8:54-55, 59-60

The LORD said unto him, I have heard your **prayer** and your **supplication**, that you have made before Me: I have hallowed this house, which you have built, to put My name there for ever; and Mine eyes and Mine heart shall be there perpetually. 1 Kings 9:3

The king answered and said unto the man of God, Entreat now the face of the LORD your God, and **pray** for me, that my hand may be restored me again. And the man of God besought the LORD, and the king's hand was restored him again, and became as it was before. 1 Kings 13:6

He stretched himself upon the child three times, and cried unto the LORD, and said, O LORD my God, I pray You, let this child's soul come into him again. 1 Kings 17:21

Jehoshaphat said unto the king of Israel, Enquire, I **pray** you, at the word of the LORD [YEHOVAH] to day. 1 Kings 22:5

He went in therefore, and shut the door upon them twain, and **prayed** unto the LORD. 2 Kings 4:33

When they came down to him, Elisha **prayed** unto the LORD, and said, Smite this people, I **pray** You, with blindness. And he smote them with blindness according to the word of Elisha. 2 Kings 6:18

It may be the LORD thy God will hear all the words of Rabshakeh, whom the king of Assyria his master has sent to reproach the living God; and will reprove the words which the LORD your God has heard: wherefore lift up your **prayer** for the remnant that are left. 2 Kings 19:4

Hezekiah **prayed** before the LORD, and said, O LORD God of Israel, which dwells between the cherubim...2 Kings 19:15

You are the God, even You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth; You have made heaven and earth. Now therefore, O LORD our God, I **beseech** You, save us out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You are the LORD God, even You only. Then Isaiah the son of Amoz sent to Hezekiah, saying, Thus says the LORD God of Israel, That which you have **prayed** to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria I have heard. 2 Kings 19:15, 19-20

He turned his face to the wall, and **prayed** unto the LORD, saying, I **beseech** You, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before You in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in Your sight. And Hezekiah wept sore. 2 Kings 20:2-3

Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, thus says the LORD, the God of David your father, I have heard your **prayer**, I have seen your tears: behold, I will heal you: on the third day you shall go up unto the house of the LORD. 2 Kings 20:5

You, O my God, have told Your servant that You will build him an house: therefore Your servant has found in his heart to **pray** before You. 1 Chronicles 17:25

Have respect therefore to the **prayer** of Your servant, and to his supplication, O LORD my God, to hearken unto the cry and the prayer which Your servant prays before You: That Your eyes may be open upon this house day and night, upon the place whereof You have said that You would put Your name there; to hearken unto the prayer which Your servant prays toward this place. Hearken therefore unto the supplications of Your servant, and of Your people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear You from Your dwelling place, even from heaven; and when You hear, forgive. If Your people Israel be put to the worse before the enemy, because they have sinned against You; and shall return and confess Your name, and pray and make supplication before You in this house; then hear You from the heavens, and forgive the sin of Your people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which You gave to them and to their fathers. When the heaven is shut up, and there is no rain, because they have sinned against You; yet if they pray toward this place, and confess Your name, and turn from their sin, when You do afflict them: then hear You from Heaven, and forgive the sin of Your servants, and of Your people Israel, when You have taught them the good way, wherein they should walk; and send rain upon the land, which You have given unto Your people for an inheritance. 2 Chronicles 6:19-21,24-27

If there be dearth in the land, if there be pestilence, if there be blasting, or mildew, locusts, or caterpillars; if their enemies besiege them in the cities of their land; whatsoever sore or whatsoever sickness there be: Then what **prayer** or what **supplication** soever shall be made of any man, or of all Your people Israel, when every one shall know his own sore and his own grief, and shall spread forth his hands in this house..

Then hear You from Heaven Your dwelling place, and forgive, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart You know; (for only You know the hearts of the children of men:) That they may fear You, to walk in Your ways, so long as they live in the land which You gave unto our fathers. 2 Chr 6:28-31

Moreover concerning the stranger, which is not of your people Israel, but is come from a far country for thy great name's sake, and Your mighty hand, and Your stretched out arm; if they come and pray in this house; Then hear You from the heavens, even from Your dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger called to You for; that all people of the earth may know Your name, and fear You, as do Your people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by Your name. If Your people go out to war against their enemies by the way that You shall send them, and they pray unto You toward this city which You have chosen, and the house which I have built for Your name; Then hear You from the heavens their prayer and their supplication, and maintain their cause....Yet if they think of themselves in the land whither they are carried captive, and turn and pray unto You in the land of their captivity, saying, We have sinned, we have done amiss, and have dealt wickedly; If they return to You with all their heart and with all their soul in the land of their captivity, whither they have carried them captives, and pray toward their land, which You gave unto their fathers, and toward the city which You have chosen, and toward the house which I have built for Your name: Then hear You from the heavens, even from Your dwelling place, their prayer and their supplications, and maintain their cause, and forgive Your people which have sinned against You. Now, my God, let I beseech You, Your eyes be open, and let Your ears be attentive unto the **prayer** that is made in this place. 2 Chronicles 6:32-40

Now when Solomon had made an end of **praying**, the fire came down from heaven, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the LORD filled the house. 2 Chronicles 7:1-2

The LORD appeared to Solomon by night, and said unto him, I have heard your **prayer**, and have chosen this place for Myself for an house of sacrifice. If I shut up heaven that there be no more rain, or if I command the locusts to devour the land, or if I send pestilence among My people; If My people, which are called by My name, shall humble themselves, and **pray**, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land. Now Mine eyes shall be open, and Mine ears attentive unto the **prayer** that is made in this place. 2 Chronicles 7:12-15

For a multitude of the people, even many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah **prayed** for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one...Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD [YEHOVAH]: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings, and making **confession** to the LORD God of their fathers...Then the priests the Levites arose and blessed the people: and their voice was heard, and their **prayer** came up to His holy dwelling place, even unto heaven. 2 Chronicles 30:18, 22, 27

In those days Hezekiah was sick to the death, and **prayed** unto the LORD: and He spake unto him, and He gave him a sign. 2 Chronicles 32:24

When he was in affliction, he besought the LORD his God, and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers. And **prayed** unto Him: and He was entreated of him, and heard his **supplication**, and brought him again to Jerusalem into his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the LORD [YEHOVAH] He was God...Now the rest of the acts of Manasseh, and his **prayer** unto his God, and the words of the seers that spake to him in the name of the LORD God of Israel, behold, they are written in the book of the kings of Israel. His **prayer** also, and how God was entreated of him, and all his sins, and his trespass, and the places wherein he built high places, and set up groves and graven images, before he was humbled: behold, they are written among the sayings of Manasseh. 2 Chronicles 33:12-13, 18-19

Let it be given them day by day without fail: That they may offer sacrifices of sweet savors unto the God of Heaven, and **pray** for the life of the king, and of his sons... Ezra 6:9-10

Now when Ezra had **prayed**, and when he had **confessed**, weeping and casting himself down before the house of God, there assembled unto him out of Israel a very great congregation of men and women and children: for the people wept very sore... Now therefore make **confession** unto the LORD God of your fathers, and do His pleasure: and separate yourselves from the people of the land, and from the strange wives. Ezra 10:1, 11

It came to pass, when I heard these words, that I sat down and wept, and mourned certain days, and fasted, and prayed before the God of Heaven. And said, I beseech Thee, O LORD God of Heaven, the great and terrible God, that keeps covenant and mercy for them that love Him and observe His commandments: Let Your ear now be attentive, and Your eyes open, that You may hear the prayer of Your servant, which I pray before You now, day and night, for the children of Israel Your servants, and confess the sins of the children of Israel, which we have sinned against You: both I and My father's house have sinned. We have dealt very corruptly against Thee, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the judgments, which You commanded Your servant Moses. Remember, I beseech Thee, the word that You commanded Your servant Moses, saying, If you transgress, I will scatter you abroad among the nations: But if you turn unto Me, and keep My commandments, and do them; though there were of you cast out unto the uttermost part of the Heaven, yet will I gather them from thence, and will bring them unto the place that I have chosen to set My name there. Now these are Thy servants and Thy people, whom Thou hast redeemed by Thy great power, and by Thy strong hand. O Lord, I beseech You, let now Your ear be attentive to the prayer of Your servant, and to the prayer of Your servants, who desire to fear Your name: and prosper, I pray You, Your servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. For I was the king's cupbearer. Nehemiah 1:4-11

Then the king said unto me, For what do you make request? So I **prayed** to the God of Heaven. Nehemiah 2:4

Hear, O our God; for we are despised: and turn their reproach upon their own head, and give them for a prey in the land of captivity: And cover not their iniquity, and let not their sin be blotted out from before Thee: for they have provoked to anger before the builders...Nevertheless we made our **prayer** unto our God, and set a watch against them day and night, because of them. Nehemiah 4:4-5, 9

My God, think Thou upon Tobiah and Sanballat according to these their works, and on the prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of the prophets, that would have put me in fear. Nehemiah 6:14

And Ezra opened the book in the sight of all the people; (for he was above all the people;) and when he opened it, all the people stood up: And Ezra blessed the LORD, the great God. And all the people answered, Amen, Amen, with lifting up their hands; and they bowed their heads, and worshiped the LORD with their faces to the ground. Nehemiah 8:5-6

The seed of Israel separated themselves from all strangers, and stood and **confessed** their sins, and the iniquities of their fathers. And they stood up in their place, and read in the book of the law of the LORD their God one fourth part of the day; and another fourth part they **confessed**, and worshiped the LORD their God. Nehemiah 9:2-3

Then the Levites...said, Stand up and bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be Thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise. Thou, even Thou, are LORD alone; You have made Heaven, the Heaven of Heavens, with all their host, the earth, and all things that are therein, the seas, and all that is therein, and You preserve them all: and the host of Heaven worship You... Nehemiah 9:5-6

Thou art the LORD the God, who did choose Abram, and brought him forth out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gave him the name of Abraham; And found his heart faithful before Thee, and made a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and have performed Your words, for You are righteous... Nehemiah 9:7-8

And did see the affliction of our fathers in Egypt, and heard their cry by the Red sea; And showed signs and wonders upon Pharaoh. and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for You knew that they dealt proudly against them. So did You get Thee a name, as it is this day. And You did divide the sea before them, so that they went through the midst of the sea on the dry land; and their persecutors You threw into the deeps, as a stone into the mighty waters. Moreover You led them in the day by a cloudy pillar; and in the night by a pillar of fire to give them light in the way wherein they should go. You came down also upon mount Sinai, and spoke with them from Heaven, and gave them right judgments, and true laws, good statutes and commandments: And made known unto them Your holy sabbath, and commanded them precepts, statutes, and laws, by the hand of Moses Your servants: And gave them bread from Heaven for their hunger, and brought forth water for them out of the rock for their thirst, and promised them that they should go in to possess the land which You had sworn to give them. But they and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to Your commandments, and refused to obey, neither were mindful of Your wonders that You did among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but You are a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsook them not. Yes, when they had made them a molten calf, and said, This is your God that brought you up out of Egypt, and had wrought great provocations; Yet You in Your manifold mercies forsook them not in the wilderness: the pillar of the cloud departed not from them by day, to lead them in the way; neither the pillar of fire by night, to show them light, and the way wherein they should go. You gave also Your good spirit to instruct them, and withheld not Your manna from their mouth, and gave them water for their thirst. Yes, forty years did You sustain them in the wilderness, so that they lacked nothing; their clothes waxed not old, and their feet swelled not. Moreover You gave them kingdoms and nations, and did divide them into corners: so they possessed the land of Sihon, and the land of the king of Heshbon. and the land of Og king of Bashan. Nehemiah 9:9-22

Their children also multiplied You as the stars of the heaven, and brought them into the land, concerning which You had promised to their fathers, that they should go in to possess it. So the children went in and possessed the land, and You subdued before them the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, and gave them into their hands, with their kings, and the people of the land that they might do with them as they would. And they took strong cities, and a fat land, and possessed houses full of all goods, wells digged, vineyards, and oliveyards, and fruit trees in abundance: so they did eat, and were filled, and became fat, and delighted themselves in Your great goodness. Nevertheless they were disobedient, and rebelled against You, and cast Your law behind their backs, and slew Your prophets which testified against them to turn them to You, and they wrought great provocations. Therefore You delivered them into the land of their enemies, who vexed them: and in the times of their trouble, when they cried unto Thee, You heard them from Heaven; and according to Your manifold mercies You gave them saviors, who saved them out of the hand of their enemies. But after they had rest, they did evil again before You: therefore left Thou them in the hand of their enemies. so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto You, You heard them from Heaven, and many times did You deliver them according to Your mercies; and testified against them, that You might bring them again unto Your law; yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto Your commandments, but sinned against Your judgments, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear. Yet many years did You forbear them, and testified against them by Your spirit in Your prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gave You them into the hand of the people of the lands. Nevertheless for Your great mercies sake You did not utterly consume them. nor forsake them; for Thou art a gracious and merciful God. Now therefore, our God, the great, the mighty, and the terrible God, who keeps covenant and mercy, let not all the trouble seem little before Thee, that has come upon us, on our kings, on our princes, and on our priests, and on our prophets, and on our fathers, and on all Your people, since the time of the kings of Asyria unto this day. Nehemiah 9:23-32

Howbeit You are just in all that is brought upon us; for Thou hast done right, but we have done wickedly. Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept Thy law, nor hearkened unto Thy commandments and Thy testimonies, wherewith Thou did testify against them. For they have not served Thee in their kingdom, and in Thy great goodness that You gave them, and in the large and fat land which You gave before them, neither turned they from their wicked works. Behold, we are servants this day, and for the land that You gave unto our fathers to eat the fruit thereof and the good thereof, behold, we are servants in it: And it yields much increase unto the kings whom You have set over us because of our sins; also they have dominion over our bodies, and over our cattle, at their pleasure, and we are in great distress. And because of all this we make a sure covenant, and write it; and our princes, Levites, and priests, seal unto it. Nehemiah 9:33-38

Mattaniah the son of Micha, the son of Zabdi, the son of Asaph, was the principal to begin the thanksgiving in **prayer**: and Bakbukiah the second among his brethren, and Abda the son of Shammua... Nehemiah 11:17

The chief of the Levites...with their brethren over against them, to praise and to **give thanks**, according to the commandment of David the man of God...And at the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with thanksgivings, and with singing, with cymbals, psalteries, and with harps...And the priests and the Levites purified themselves, and purified the people, and the gates, and the wall. Nehemiah 12:24-30

So stood the two companies of them that **gave thanks** in the house of God, and I, and the half of the rulers with me...Also that day they offered great sacrifices, and rejoiced: for God ad made them rejoice with grat joy: the wives also and the children rejoiced: so that the joy of Jerusalem was heard even afar off. Nehemiah 12:40, 43

Then contended I with the rulers, and said, Why is the house of God forsaken? And I gathered them together, and set them in their place...Remember me, O my God, concerning this, and wipe not out my good deeds that I have done for the house of my God, and for the offices thereof...And I commanded the Levites that they should cleanse themselves, and that thye should come and keep the gates, to sanctify the sabbath day. Remember me, O my God, concerning this also, and spare me according to the greatness of Your mercy...then I cleansed them from all strangers, and appointed the wards of the priests and the Levites, every one in his business; And for the wood offering, at times appointed, and for the firstfruits. Remember me, O my God, for good. Nehemiah 13:11, 14, 22b, 30-31

Mordecai... gave him the copy of the writing of the decree that was given at Shushan to destroy them, to shew it unto Esther, and to declare it unto her, and to charge her that she should go in unto the king, to make **supplication** unto him, and to make request before him for her people. Esther 4:7-8

My soul is weary of my life; I will leave my complaint upon myself; I will speak in the bitterness of my soul. I will say unto God, Do not condemn me; show me wherefore You contend with me. Is it good unto You that You should oppress, that You should despise the work of Your hands, and shine upon the counsel of the wicked? Have You eyes of flesh? Or see You as man sees? Are Your days as the days of man? Are Your years as man's days, That You inquire after my iniquity, and search after my sin? You know that I am not wicked; and there is none that can deliver out of Your hand. Your hands have made me and fashioned me together round about, yet You do destroy me. Job 10:1-8+

My face is foul with weeping, and on my eyelids is the shadow of death; Not for any injustice in mine hands: also my **prayer** is pure. Job 16:16-17

You shall make your **prayer** unto Him, and He shall hear you, and you shall pay your vows. You shall also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto you: and the light shall shine upon your ways. Job 22:27-28

He shall **pray** unto God, and He will be favorable unto him: and He shall see his face with joy: for He will render unto man his righteousness. Job 33:26

Therefore take unto you now seven bullocks and seven rams, and go to My servant Job, and offer up for yourselves a burnt offering; and My servant Job shall **pray** for you: for him will I accept: lest I deal with you after your folly, in that you have not spoken of Me the thing which is right, like My servant Job...And the LORD turned the captivity of Job, when he prayed for his friends: also the LORD gave Job twice as much as he had before. Job 42:8, 10

Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: You have enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my **prayer**. Psalm 4:1

Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto You will I **pray**. My voice shall you hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my **prayer** unto You, and will look up. Psalm 5:2-3

Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; for the LORD has heard the voice of **my weeping**. The LORD has heard my **supplication**; the LORD ill receive my **prayer**. Psalm 6:-9

Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goes not out of feigned lips. Psalm 17:1

We will rejoice in Your salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfil all your **petitions**. Psalm 20:5

Hear the voice of my **supplications**, when I cry unto You, when I lift up my hands toward Your holy oracle...Blessed be the LORD, because He has heard the voice of my **supplications**. Ps 28:2, 6

I cried to You, O LORD; and unto the LORD I made **supplication**... Psalm 30:8

For I said in my haste, I am cut off from before Your eyes: nevertheless You heard the voice of my **supplications** when I cried unto You. Psalm 31:22

I acknowledged my sin unto You, and my iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will **confess** my transgressions unto the LORD; and You forgave me the iniquity of my sin. Selah. For this shall every one that is godly **pray** unto You in a time when You may be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto Him. Psalm 32:5-6

But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my **prayer** returned into mine own bosom. Psalm 35:13

Hear my **prayer**, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not Your peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with You, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. Psalm 39:12

Yet the LORD will command His lovingkindness in the daytime, and in the night His song shall be with me, and my **prayer** unto the God of my life. Psalm 42:8

PRAISE & PRAYER OF DAVID Have mercy upon me, O God, according to Your lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of Your tender mercies blot out my transgressions. Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me. Against Thee, Thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight: that You might be justified when You speak, and be clear when You judge. Behold, I was shaped in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me. Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts; and in the hidden part You shall make me to know wisdom. Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Make me to hear joy and gladness; that the bones which You have broken may rejoice. Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from Your presence; and take not Your holy spirit from me. Restore unto me the joy of Your salvation; and uphold me with Your free spirit. Then will I teach transgressors Your ways; and sinners shall be converted unto Thee. Deliver me from blood guiltiness, O God, Thou God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness. O Lord, open my lips; and my mouth shall shew forth Your praise.

For You desire not sacrifice; else would I give it; You delight not in burnt offering. The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite heart, O God, You will not despise. Do good in Your good pleasure unto Zion: build Thou the walls of Jerusalem. Then shall You be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon Your altar. Psalm 51

As for me, I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me. Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I **pray**, and cry aloud: and He shall hear my voice. Psalm 55:16-17

Preserve my soul; for I am holy: O my God, save Your servant that trusts in You...For You, Lord are good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee. Give ear, O LORD, unto my **prayer**; and attend to the voice of my supplications. In the day of my trouble I will call upon You: for You will answer me. Psalm 86:1-2, 4-7

Hear my **prayer**, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth. Ps 54:2

Give ear to my **prayer**, O God; and hid not Yourself from my supplication...Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I **pray**, and cry aloud: and He shall hear my voice. Psalm 55:1, 17

Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. Psalm 61:1

O God, Thou art my God; early will I seek Thee: my soul thirsts for Thee, my flesh longs for Thee...To see Your power and Your glory, so as I have seen You in the sanctuary. Because Your lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise Your. Psalm 63: 1-3

But as for me, my **prayer** is unto You, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of Your mercy hear me, in the truth of Your salvation. Psalm 69:13

Hear my voice, O God, in my **prayer**: preserve my life from fear of the enemy. Psalm 64:1

O You that hears **prayer**, unto You shall all flesh come. Psalm 65:2

Come and hear, all you that fear God, and I will declare what He has done for my soul. I **cried** unto Him with my mouth, and He was extolled with my tongue. If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear me: But verily God has heard me: He has attended to the voice of my **prayer**. Blessed be God, which has not turned away my **prayer**, nor His mercy from me. Psalm 66:16-20

But as for me, my **prayer** is unto You, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of Your mercy hear me, in the truth of Your salvation. Psalm 69:13

He shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: **prayer** also shall be made for him continually; and daily shall He be praised. Psalm 72:15

O LORD God of hosts, how long will You be angry against the **prayer** of Your people? You feed them with the bread of tears; and give them tears to drink in great measure. Psalm 80: 4-5

They go from strength to strength, every one of them in Zion appears before God. O LORD God of hosts, hear my **prayer**: give ear, O God of Jacob. Selah. Psalm 84:7-8

Give ear, O LORD, unto my **prayer**; and attend to the voice of my supplications. In the day of my trouble I will call upon You: for You will answer me. Psalm 86:6

Unto You have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my **prayer** prevent You. Psalm 88:13

Hear my **prayer**, O LORD, and let my cry come unto You...He will regard the **prayer** of the destitute, and not despise their **prayer**. Psalm 102:1, 17

Our fathers understood not Your wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of Your mercies; but provoked Him at the sea, even at the Red sea. Nevertheless He saved them for His name's sake, that He might make His mighty power to be known. He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was dried up: so that He led them through the depths, as through the wilderness. And He saved them from the hand of him that hated them. and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. And the waters covered their enemies: there was not one of them left. Then believed they His words; they sang His praise. They soon forgot His works; they waited not for His counsel: But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, and tempted God...Save us, O Lord our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto Thy holy name, and to triumph in Thy praise. Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting: and let all the people say, Amen. Praise you the Lord. Psalm 106:7-14, 47-48

O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory...I will praise You, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto You among the nations. For Your mercy is great above the Heavens: and thy glory above all the earth; That Your beloved may be delivered: save with Your right hand, and answer me. Psalm 108:1, 3-6

For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto **prayer**...When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his **prayer** become sin. Psalm 109:4, 7

I love the LORD, because He has heard my voice and my supplications. Because He has inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon him as long as I live...Gracious is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful...What shall I render unto the LORD for all His benefits toward me? I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD. I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all His people... I will offer to Thee **the sacrifice of thanksgiving**, and will call upon the name of the LORD... Psalm 116:1-2, 5, 12-17

I know, O LORD, that Your judgments are right, and that You in faithfulness have afflicted me. Let, I **pray** You, Your merciful kindness be for my comfort, according to Your word unto Your servant. Psalm 119:75-76

Let my **supplication** come before You: deliver me according to Your word. Psalm 119:170

Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love You. Psalm 122:6

Lord, hear my voice: let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my **supplications**. Psalm 130:2

We will go into His tabernacles: **we will worship** at His footstool. Arise, O LORD, into Your rest; and the ark of Your strength. Let Your priests be clothed with righteousness; and let Your saints shout for joy. Psalm 132:8-9

I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication. I poured out my complaint before Him; I showed before Him my trouble. When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then You knew my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me. I looked on my right hand, and beheld, but there was no man that would know me: refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul. I cried unto Thee, O LORD: I said, Thou art my refuge and my portion in the land of the living. Psalm 142:1-5

I said unto the LORD, You are my God: hear the voice of my **supplications**, OLORD [YEHOVAH]. Psalm 140:6

Let my **prayer** be set forth before You as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice...Let the righteous smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my **prayer** also shall be in their calamities. Psalm 141:2, 5

I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my **supplication**. Psalm 142:1

Hear my **prayer**, O LORD, give ear to my **supplications**: in Your faithfulness answer me, and in Your righteousness. Psalm 143:1

The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the **prayer** of the upright is His delight...The LORD is far from the wicked: but He hears the **prayer** of the righteous. Proverbs 15:8, 29

He that turns away his ear from hearing the law, even his **prayer** shall be an abomination...He that covers his sins shall not prosper: but whoso confesses and forsakes them shall have mercy. Proverbs 28:9, 13

It shall come to pass, when it is seen that Moab is weary on the high place, that he shall come to his sanctuary to **pray**; but he shall not prevail. Isaiah 16:12

LORD, in trouble have they visited You, they poured out a **prayer** when Your chastening was upon them. Like as a woman with child, that draws near the time of her delivery, is in pain, and cries out in her pangs; so have we been in Your sight, O LORD. Isaiah 26:16-17

Hezekiah went up unto the house of the LORD, and spread it before the LORD. And Hezekiah **prayed** unto the LORD, saying, O LORD of hosts, God of Israel, that dwells between the cherubim, You are the God, even You alone, of all the kingdoms of the earth: You have made heaven and earth. Incline Your ear, O LORD, and hear; open Your eyes, O LORD, and see... Isaiah 36:14-17

Isaiah the son of Amoz sent unto Hezekiah, saying, thus says the LORD God of Israel, Whereas you have **prayed** to me against Sennacherib king of Assyria: This is the word which the LORD has spoken concerning him ...Against whom have you exalted your voice, and lifted up your eyes on high? Even against the Holy One of Israel. Isaiah 37:21-23

They shall make **supplication** unto you, saying, Surely God is in you; and there is none else, there is no God. Isaiah 45:14

Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, you that are escaped of the nations: they have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven image, and **pray** unto a god that cannot save. Isaiah 45:20

Them I will bring to my holy mountain, and make them joyful in My house of **prayer**: their burnt offerings and their sacrifices shall be accepted upon Mine altar; for Mine house shall be called an house of **prayer** for all people. Isaiah 56:7

A voice was heard upon the high places, weeping and **supplications** of the children of Israel: for they have perverted their way, and they have forgotten the LORD their God. Jer 3:21

Pray not you for this people, neither lift up cry nor **prayer** for them, neither make **intercession** to me: for I will not hear you. Jer 7:16

Therefore **pray** not you for this people, neither lift up a cry or **prayer** for them: for I will not hear them in the time that they cry unto Me for their trouble...Then said the LORD unto me, **Pray** not for this people for their good. Jeremiah 11:14, 14:11

Enquire, I **pray** you, of the LORD for us; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon makes war against us; if so be that the LORD will deal with us according to all His wondrous works, that He may go up from us. Jer 21:2

Seek the peace of the city whither I have caused you to be carried away captives, and **pray** unto the LORD for it: for in the peace thereof shall you have peace. Jeremiah 29:7

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end. Then shall you call upon Me, and you shall go and **pray** unto Me, and I will hearken unto you. And you shall seek Me, and find me, when you shall search for me with all your heart. And I will be found of you, says the LORD...Jer 29:11-13

They shall come with weeping, and with **supplications** will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by the rivers of waters in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is My firstborn. Jeremiah 31:9

When I had delivered the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch ...I **prayed** unto the LORD, saying, Ah Lord GOD! Behold, You have made the heaven and the earth by Your great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for You: You show lovingkindness unto thousands, and recompense the iniquity of the fathers into the bosom of their children after them: the Great, the Mighty God, the LORD of hosts, is His name. Great in counsel, and mighty in work: for Your eyes are open upon all the ways of the sons of men: to give everyone according to his ways, and according to the fruit of his doings. Jer 32:16-19

Zedekiah the king sent...to the prophet Jeremiah, saying, **Pray** now unto the LORD our God for us...Therefore hear now, I pray you, O my lord the king: let my **supplication**, I pray you, be accepted before you; that you cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there...Then you shall say unto them, I presented my **supplication** before the king, that he would not cause me to return to Jonathan's house, to die there. Jeremiah 38:37:3, 20, 26

All the captains of the forces...and all the people from the least even unto the greatest, came near, and said unto Jeremiah the prophet, Let, we beseech You, our **supplication** be accepted before You, and **pray** for us unto the LORD your God, even for all this remnant; (for we are left but a few of many. As Your eyes do behold us:) That the LORD your God may show us the way wherein we may walk, and the thing that we may do. Then Jeremiah the prophet said unto them, I have heard you: behold, I will **pray** unto the LORD your God according to your words...

...and it shall come to pass, that whatsoever thing the LORD shall answer you, I will declare it unto you...It came to pass after ten days, that the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah...and said unto them, Thus says the LORD, the God of Israel, unto whom you sent me to present your **supplication** before him; If you will still abide in this land, then will I build you, and not pull you down, and I will plant you, and not pluck you up: for I repent me of the evil that I have done unto you. For you dissembled in your hearts, when you sent me unto the LORD your God, saying, **Pray** for us unto the LORD our God; and according unto all that the LORD our God shall say, so declare unto us, and we will do it. Jeremiah 42:1-4, 7-10, 20

When I cry and shout, He shuts out my **prayer**... You have covered yourself with a cloud, that our **prayer** should not pass through. Lamentations 3:8, 44

All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counselors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man for thirty days, save of you, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions...When Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and **prayed**, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime. Then these men assembled, and found Daniel praying and making **supplication** before his God. Daniel 6:7, 10-11

I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by **prayer** and **supplications**, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: And I **prayed** unto the LORD my God, and made my **confession**, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love Him, and to them that keep His commandments; We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and from Your judgments...As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our **prayer** before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand Your truth. Therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision...

Therefore has the LORD watched upon the evil, and brought it upon us; for the LORD our God is righteous in all His works which He does: for we obeyed not His voice...Now therefore, O our God, hear the **prayer** of Your servant, and his **supplications**, and cause Your face to shine upon Your sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake. O my God, incline Your ear, and hear; open Your eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name: for we do not present our **supplications** before You for our righteousnesses, but for Your great mercies. O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive; O Lord, hearken and do; defer not, for Your own sake, O my God: for Your city and Your people are called by Your name. And while I was speaking, and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God; Yes, while I was speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation. And he informed me, and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now come forth to give you skill and understanding. At the beginning of your supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to shew you; for you are greatly beloved: Daniel 9:3-5, 13-14, 17-23

Yes, he had power over the angel, and prevailed: he wept, and made **supplication** unto him: he found him in Bethel, and there he spake with us... Hosea 12:4

Then Jonah **prayed** unto the LORD his God out of the fish's belly, and said, I cried by reason of my affliction unto the LORD, and He heard me; out of the belly of hell cried I, and You heard my voice. For You had cast me into the deep, in the midst of the seas... When my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my **prayer** came in unto You, into Your holy temple. They that observe lying vanities forsake their own mercy. But I will sacrifice unto You with the voice of thanksgiving; I will pay that that I have vowed. Salvation is of the LORD. And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the dry land. Jonah 2:2-10

A **prayer** of Habakkuk the prophet upon Shigionoth. O LORD, I have heard Your speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive Your work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy... Habakkuk 3:1-2

Thus says the LORD of hosts; It shall yet come to pass, that there shall come people, and the inhabitants of many cities: and the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, Let us go speedily to **pray** before the LORD, and to seek the LORD of hosts: I will go also. Yea, many people and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to **pray** before the LORD. Zechariah 8:20-22

I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of **supplications**: and they shall look upon Me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for Him, as one mourns for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:10

Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan, and were baptized of him in Jordan, **confessing** their sins. Matthew 3:5-6

I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and **pray** for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you... Matthew 5:44

When you **pray**, you shall not be as the hypocrites are: for they love to **pray** standing in the synagogues and in the corners of the streets, that they may be seen of men. Verily I say unto you, They have their reward. Matthew 6:5

When you **pray**, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking... After this manner therefore **pray** you: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Matthew 6:7, 9

Pray you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He will send forth laborers into His harvest. Matthew 9:38

When He had sent the multitudes away, He went up into a mountain apart to **pray**: and when the evening was come, He was there alone. Matthew 14:23

Howbeit this kind goes not out but by **prayer** and fasting. Matthew 17:21

Then were there brought unto Him little children, that He should put His hands on them, and **pray**: and the disciples rebuked them. Matthew 19:13

It is written, My house shall be called the house of **prayer**: but you have made it a den of thieves. Matthew 21:13

And all things, whatsoever you shall ask in **prayer**, believing, you shall receive. Matthew 21:22

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense make long **prayer**: therefore you shall receive the greater damnation. Matthew 23:14

Pray you that your flight be not in winter, neither on the sabbath day... Matthew 24:20

Then came Jesus with them unto a place called Gethsemane, and said unto the disciples, Sit you here, while I go and pray yonder... He went a little further, and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, O My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from Me: nevertheless not as I will, but as You will. And He came unto the disciples, and found them asleep, and said unto Peter, What, could you not watch with Me one hour? Watch and pray, that you enter not into temptation: the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak. He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, O My Father, if this cup may not pass away from Me, except I drink it, Your will be done. And He came and found them asleep again: for their eyes were heavy. And He left them, and went away again, and prayed the third time, saying the same words. Matthew 26:36, 39-44

Think you that I cannot now **pray** to My Father, and He shall presently give Me more than twelve legions of angels? Matt 26:53

There went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, **confessing** their sins. Mark 1:5

In the morning, rising up a great while before day, He went out, and departed into a solitary place, and there **prayed**. Mark 1:35

...And besought Him greatly, saying, My little daughter lies at the point of death: I **pray** You, come and lay Your hands on her, that she may be healed; and she shall live. Mark 5:23

When He had sent them away, He departed into a mountain to pray. Mark 6:46

He said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by **prayer** and fasting. Mark 9:29

Is it not written, My house shall be called of all nations the house of **prayer**? But you have made it a den of thieves. Mark 11:17

Therefore I say unto you, What things soever you desire, when you **pray**, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them. And when you stand **praying**, forgive, if you have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. Mark 11:24-25

Pray you that your flight be not in the winter... Take you heed, watch and **pray**: for you know not when the time is. Mk 13:18, 33

He said to His disciples, Sit you here, while I shall **pray**...and He went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and **prayed** that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from Him. Mark 14:32, 35

Watch you and **pray**, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit truly is ready, but the flesh is weak. And again He went away, and **prayed**, and spake the same words. Mark 14:38-39

The whole multitude of the people were **praying** without at the time of incense...The angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias; for your **prayer** is heard; and your wife Elisabeth shall bear you a son, and you shall call his name John. Luke 1:10, 13

Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus [Yeshua] also being baptized, and **praying**, the heaven was opened... Luke 3:21

He withdrew himself into the wilderness, and **prayed**. Luke 5:16

It came to pass in those days, that He went out into a mountain to **pray**, and continued all night in **prayer** to God. Luke 6:12

Bless them that curse you, and **pray** for them which despitefully use you. Luke 6:28

It came to pass, as He was alone **praying**, His disciples were with Him: and He asked them, saying, Whom say the people that I am? Luke 9:18

It came to pass about an eight days after these sayings, He took Peter and John and James, and went up into a mountain to **pray**. And as He **prayed**, the fashion of His countenance was altered, and His raiment was white and glistering. Luke 9:28-29

Therefore said He unto them, The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few: **pray** you therefore the Lord of the harvest, that He would send forth laborers into His harvest. Luke 10:2

It came to pass, that, as He was **praying** in a certain place, when He ceased, one of His disciples said unto Him, Lord, teach us to **pray**, as John also taught his disciples. Luke 11:1

When you **pray**, say, Our Father which are in heaven, Hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done, as in heaven, so in earth. Luke 11:2

He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to **pray**, and not to faint...Two men went up into the temple to **pray**; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and **prayed** thus with himself, God, I thank you, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. Luke 18:1, 10-11

It is written, My house is the house of **prayer**: but you have made it a den of thieves. Luke 19:46

Watch you therefore, and **pray** always, that you may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. Luke 21:36

But I have **prayed** for you, that your faith fail not: and when you are converted, strengthen your brethren... When He was at the place, He said unto them, **Pray** that you enter not into temptation. And He was withdrawn from them about a stone's cast, and kneeled down, and **prayed**, Saying, Father, if You be willing, remove this cup from Me: nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done. And there appeared an angel unto Him from heaven, strengthening Him. And being in an agony He **prayed** more earnestly: and His sweat was as it were great drops of blood falling down to the ground. And when He rose up from prayer, and was come to His disciples, He found them sleeping for sorrow, And said unto them, Why sleep you? Rise and **pray**, lest you enter into temptation. Luke 22:32, 40-46

His disciples prayed Him, saying, Master, eat. John 4:31

I will **pray** the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you for ever. John 14:16

At that day you shall ask in My name: and I say not unto you, that I will **pray** the Father for you... John 16:26

JESUS HIGH PRIESTLY PRAYER

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee: As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him. And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. I have glorified thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. And now, O Father, glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was. manifested thy name unto the men which thou gavest me out of the world: thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word. Now they have known that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee. For I have given unto them the words which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which thou hast given me; for they are thine. And all mine are thine, and thine are mine; and I am glorified in them. And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are. While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name; those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled. And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves. I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth. As thou hast sent me into the world, even so have I also sent them into the world. And for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the truth. Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word...

That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one. And that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them. John 17

I **pray** not that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil...Neither **pray** I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on Me through their word... John 17:15, 20

These all continued with one accord in **prayer** and **supplication**, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus, and with His brethren. Acts 1:14

They **prayed**, and said, You, Lord, which know the hearts of all men, shew whether of these two You have chosen... Acts 1:24

Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of **prayer**, being the ninth hour. Acts 3:1

When they had **prayed**, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. Acts 4:31

We will give ourselves continually to **prayer**, and to the ministry of the word. The saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose...Whom they set before the apostles: and when they had **prayed**, they laid their hands on them. Acts 6:4-6

Who, when they were come down, **prayed** for them, that they might receive the Holy Ghost... Acts 8:15

Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and **pray** God, if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you...Then answered Simon, and said, **Pray** you to the Lord for me, that none of these things which you have spoken come upon me. Acts 8:22, 24

The Lord said unto him, Arise, and go into the street which is called Straight, and enquire in the house of Judas for one called Saul, of Tarsus: for, behold, he **prays**... Acts 9:11

Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and **prayed**; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up. Acts 9:40

Cornelius...A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and **prayed** to God alway. Acts 10:2

On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to **pray** about the sixth hour. Acts 10:9

Cornelius said, Four days ago I was fasting until this hour; and at the ninth hour I **prayed** in my house, and, behold, a man stood before me in bright clothing, and said, Cornelius, **your prayer** is heard, and your alms are had in remembrance in the sight of God. Acts 10:30-31

I was in the city of Joppa **praying**: and in a trance I saw a vision, A certain vessel descend, as it had been a great sheet, let down from heaven by four corners; and it came even to me... Acts 11:5

Peter therefore was kept in prison: but **prayer** was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him. Acts 12:5

When he had considered the thing, he came to the house of Mary the mother of John, whose surname was Mark; where many were gathered together **praying**. Acts 12:12

When they had fasted and **prayed**, and laid their hands on them, they sent them away. Acts 13:3

When they had ordained them elders in every church, and had **prayed** with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they believed. Acts 14:23

A vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and **prayed** him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us. Acts 16:9

And on the sabbath we went out of the city by a river side, where **prayer** was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither. Acts 16:13

It came to pass, as we went to **prayer**, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying... Acts 16:16

At midnight Paul and Silas **prayed**, and sang praises unto God; and the prisoners heard them. Acts 16:25

When he had thus spoken, he kneeled down, and **prayed** with them all. Acts 20:36

When we had accomplished those days, we departed and went out way; and they all brought us on our way, with wives and children, till we were out of the city: and we kneeled down on the shore, and **prayed**. Acts 21:5

It came to pass, that, when I was come again to Jerusalem, even while I **prayed** in the temple, I was in a trance... Acts 22:17

It came to pass, that the father of Publius lay sick of a fever and of a bloody flux: to whom Paul entered in, and **prayed**, and laid his hands on him, and healed him. Acts 28:8

Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities: for we know not what we should **pray** for as we ought: but the Spirit itself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. Romans 8:26

Brethren, my heart's desire and **prayer** to God for Israel is, that they might be saved. Romans 10:1

Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in **prayer**... Romans 12:12

Defraud you not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that you may give yourselves to fasting and **prayer**; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency. 1 Corinthians 7:5

Every man **praying** or prophesying, having his head covered, dishonours his head. Every woman that **prays** or prophesies with her head uncovered dishonours her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven...Judge in yourselves: is it comely that a woman **pray** unto God uncovered? 1 Corinthians 11:4-5, 13

Wherefore let him that speaks in an unknown tongue **pray** that he may interpret. For if I **pray** in an unknown tongue, my spirit **prays**, but my understanding is unfruitful. What is it then? I will **pray** with the spirit, and I will **pray** with the understanding also: I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also. 1 Corinthians 14:13-15

You also helping together by **prayer** for us, that for the gift bestowed upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf. 2 Corinthians 1:11

...**Praying** us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints. 2 Corinthians 8:4

...And by their **prayer** for you, which long after you for the exceeding grace of God in you. 2 Corinthians 9:14

Now I **pray** to God that you do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that you should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates. 2 Corinthians 13:7

Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: **Praying** always with all **prayer** and **supplication** in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and **supplication** for all saints... Ephesians 6:18

Always in every **prayer** of mine for you all making request with joy... Philippians 1:4

And this I **pray**, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment...For I know that this shall turn to my salvation through your **prayer**, and the supply of the Spirit of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]... Philippians 1:9, 19

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by **prayer** and **supplication** with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. Philippians 4:6

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], **praying** always for you... Colossians 1:3

For this cause we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to **pray** for you, and to desire that you might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding... Colossians 1:9

Continue in **prayer**, and watch in the same with thanksgiving; Withal **praying** also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ [Messiah], for which I am also in bonds... Col4:2-3

... Night and day **praying** exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith... 1 Thes 3:10

Pray without ceasing...The very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I **pray** God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is He that calls you, who also will do it. Brethren, **pray** for us. 1 Thessalonians 5:17, 23-25

Wherefore also we **pray** always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of His goodness, and the work of faith with power... 2 Thess 1:11

Finally, brethren, **pray** for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you... 2 Thessalonians 3:1

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, **supplications**, **prayers**, **intercessions**, and **giving of thanks**, be made for all men; For kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. 1 Timothy 2:1-2

I will therefore that men **pray** every where, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting. 1 Timothy 2:8

Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God has created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth. For every creature of God is good, and nothing to e refused, if it be received with thanksgiving: For it is sanctified by the word of God and **prayer**. 1 Timothy 4:5

At my first answer no man stood with me, but all men forsook me: I **pray** God that it may not be laid to their charge. 2 Timothy 4:16

Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusts in God, and continues in **supplications** and prayers night and day. 1 Timothy 5:5

Who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up **prayers and supplications** with strong crying and tears unto Him that was able to save Him from death, and was heard in that He feared... Hebrews 5:7

Pray for us: for we trust we have a good conscience, in all things willing to live honestly. Hebrews 13:18

PRAYER FROM PAUL

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20, 21

Is any among you afflicted? Let him **pray**. Is any merry? Let him sing psalms. Is any sick among you? Let him call for the elders of the church; and let them **pray** over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the **prayer** of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess your faults one to another, and **pray** one for another, that you may be healed. The effectual fervent **prayer** of a righteous man avails much. James 5:13-16

Elias was a man subject to like passions as we are, and he **prayed** earnestly that it might not rain: and it rained not on the earth by the space of three years and six months. And he **prayed** again, and the heaven gave rain, and the earth brought forth her fruit. James 5:17-18

But the end of all things is at hand: be you therefore sober, and watch unto **prayer**. 1 Peter 4:7

If we **confess** our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleans us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us. 1 John 1:9-10

This is the confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His will, He hears us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the **petitions** that we desired of Him. 1 John 5:14-15
