## RIGHTEOUS & RIGHTEOUSNESS

The LORD [YeHoVaH] said to Noah, Come you and all your house into the ark; for you have I seen **righteous** before Me in this generation. Genesis 7:1

He believed in the LORD [YeHoVaH]; and He counted it to him for **righteousness**. Genesis 15:6

Abraham drew near, and said, Will You also destroy the **righteous** with the wicked? Perhaps there are fifty **righteous** within the city: will You also destroy and not spare the place for the fifty **righteous** that are therein? That be far from you to do after this manner, to slay the **righteous** with the wicked: and that the **righteous** should be as the wicked, that be far from you: Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right? And the LORD [YeHoVaH] said, If I find in Sodom fifty **righteous** within the city, then I will spare all the place for their sakes....Peradventure there shall lack five of the fifty **righteous**: will you destroy all the city for lack of five? And He said, If I find there forty and five, I will not destroy it. Genesis 18:23-28

But Abimelech had not come near her: and he said, LORD, will You slay also a **righteous** nation? Genesis 20:4

So shall my **righteousness** answer for me in time to come, when it shall come for my hire before your face: every one that is not speckled and spotted among the goats, and brown among the sheep, that shall be counted stolen with me. Genesis 30:33

Judah acknowledged them, and said, She has been more **righteous** than I; because I gave her not to Shelah my son. And he knew her again no more. Genesis 38:26

Pharaoh sent, and called for Moses and Aaron, and said to them, I have sinned this time: the LORD is **righteous**, and I and my people are wicked. Exodus 9:27

Keep you far from a false matter; and the innocent and **righteous** slay you not: for I will not justify the wicked. And you shall take no gift: for the gift blinds the wise, and perverts the words of the **righteous**. Exodus 23:7-8

You shall do no unrighteousness in judgment: you shall not respect the person of the poor, nor honor the person of the mighty: but in **righteousness** shall you judge your neighbor. Levi 19:15

Who can count the dust of Jacob, and the number of the fourth part of Israel? Let me die the death of the **righteous**, and let my last end be like his! Numbers 23:10

And I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear the causes between your brothers, and judge **righteously** between every man and his brother, and the stranger that is with him. Deut 1:16

What nation is there so great, that has statutes and judgments so **righteous** as all this law, which I set before you this day?... The LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive...And it shall be our **righteousness**, if we observe to do all these commandments before the LORD our God, as He has commanded us. Deuteronomy 4:8, 6:25

Speak not in your heart, after that the LORD your God has cast them out from before you, saying, For my **righteousness** the LORD has brought me in to possess this land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD [YeHoVaH] does drive them out from before you. Not for your **righteousness**, or for the uprightness of your heart, do you go to possess their land: but for the wickedness of these nations the LORD your God does drive them out from before you, and that He may perform the word which the LORD swore to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. Understand therefore, that the LORD your God gives you not this good land to possess it for your **righteousness**; for you are a stiff necked people. Deuteronomy 9:4-6

You shall not wrest judgment; you shall not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift does blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the words of the **righteous**...In any case you shall deliver him the pledge again when the sun goes down, that he may sleep in his own raiment, and bless you: and it shall be **righteousness** to you before the LORD your God ...If there be a controversy between men, and they come to judgment, that the judges may judge them; then they shall justify the **righteous**, and condemn the wicked. Deut 16:19, 24:13, 25:1

They shall call the people to the mountain; there they shall offer sacrifices of **righteousness**: for they shall suck of the abundance of the seas, and of treasures hid in the sand. Deut 33:19

They that are delivered from the noise of archers in the places of drawing water, there shall they rehearse the **righteous** acts of the LORD, even the **righteous** acts toward the inhabitants of his villages in Israel: then shall the people of the LORD [YeHoVaH] go down to the gates. Judges 5:11

Now therefore stand still, that I may reason with you before the LORD of all the **righteous** acts of the LORD which He did to you and to your fathers. 1Samuel 12:7

He said to David, You are more **righteous** than I: for you have rewarded me good, whereas I have rewarded you evil... The LORD render to every man his **righteousness** and his faithfulness; for the LORD delivered you into my hand to day, but I would not stretch forth my hand against the LORD'S anointed. 1 Samuel 24:17, 26:23

How much more, when wicked men have slain a **righteous** person in his own house on his bed? Shall I not now require his blood of your hand, and take you away from the earth? 2 Samuel 4:11

The LORD rewarded me according to my **righteousness**: according to the cleanness of my hands has he recompensed me... Therefore the LORD has recompensed me according to my **righteousness**; according to my cleanness in His eye sight. 2 Samuel 22:21, 25

The LORD shall return his blood on his own head, who fell on two men more **righteous** and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing thereof, to wit, Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah. 1 Kings 2:32

Solomon said, You have showed to your servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before You in truth, and in **righteousness**, and in uprightness of heart with you; and You have kept for him this great kindness, that You have given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

If any man trespass against his neighbor, and an oath be laid upon him...Then hear You in heaven, and do, and judge Your servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way on his head; and justifying the **righteous**, to give him according to his **righteousness**. 1 Kings 8:31-32

Then hear from heaven, and do, and judge Your servants, by requiting the wicked, by recompensing his way on his own head; and by justifying the **righteous**, by giving him according to his **righteousness**. 2 Chronicles 6:23

Whereupon the princes of Israel and the king humbled themselves; and they said, The LORD is **righteous**. 2 Chron 12:6

O LORD [YeHoVaH] God of Israel, You are **righteous**: for we remain yet escaped, as it is this day: behold, we are before You in our trespasses: for we cannot stand before You because of this. Ezra 9:15

You are the LORD the God, who did choose Abram, and brought him out of Ur of the Chaldees, and gave him the name of Abraham; And found his heart faithful before You, and made a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Girgashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and have performed Your words; for You are **righteous**... So did You get Yourself a name... Nehemiah 9:7-8, 10

Remember, I pray you, who ever perished, being innocent? or where were the **righteous** cut off? Job 4:7

Return, I pray you, let it not be iniquity; yes, return again, my **righteousness** is in it. Job 6:29

If you were pure and upright; surely now He would awake for you, and make the habitation of your **righteousness** prosperous. Job 8:6

How much less shall I answer Him, and choose out my words to reason with Him? Whom, though I were **righteous**, yet would I not answer, but I would make supplication to my judge. If I had called, and He had answered me; yet would I not believe that He had hearkened unto my voice. Job 9:14-16

If I be wicked, woe to me; and if I be **righteous**, yet will I not lift up my head. I am full of confusion; therefore see You my affliction...Job 10:15

What is man, that he should be clean? and he which is born of a woman, that he should be **righteous**? Job 15:14

The **righteous** also shall hold on his way, and he that has clean hands shall be stronger and stronger. Job 17:9

Is it any pleasure to the Almighty, that you are **righteous**? or is it gain to Him, that you make your ways perfect? Job 22:3

The **righteous** see it, and are glad: and the innocent laugh them to scorn. Job 22:19

There the **righteous** might dispute with him; so should I be delivered for ever from my judge. Job 23:7

My **righteousness** I hold fast, and will not let it go: my heart shall not reproach me so long as I live. Job 27:6

I put on **righteousness**, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem. Job 29:14

So these three men ceased to answer Job, because he was **righteous** in his own eyes. Job 32:1

He shall pray to God, and He will be favorable to him: and he shall see His face with joy: for He will render to man his **righteousness**...For Job has said, I am **righteous**: and God has taken away my judgment. Job 33:26, 34:5

Do you think this to be right, that you said, My **righteousness** is more than God's? ...If you are **righteous**, what do you give Him? or what does He receive of your hand? Job 35:2, 7

Your wickedness may hurt a man as you are; and your **righteousness** may profit the son of man. Job 35:8

I will fetch my knowledge from afar, and will ascribe **righteousness** to my Maker...He withdraws not His eyes from the **righteous**: but with kings are they on the throne; yes, He does establish them for ever, and they are exalted. Job 36:3, 7

Will you also cancel My judgment? will you condemn Me, that you may be **righteous**? Job 40:8

Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the **righteous**. For the LORD knows the way of the **righteous**: but the way of the ungodly shall perish. Psalm 1:5-6

Hear me when I call, O God of my **righteousness**: You have enlarged me when I was in distress; have mercy on me, and hear my prayer. Psalm 4:1

Offer the sacrifices of **righteousness**, and put your trust in the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Psalm 4:5

Lead me, O LORD, in Your **righteousness** because of my enemies; make Your way straight before my face. Psalm 5:8

For You, LORD, will bless the **righteous**; with favor will You compass him as with a shield. Psalm 5:12

The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my **righteousness**, and according to my integrity that is in me. Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the just: for the **righteous** God tries the hearts and reins... God judges the **righteous**, and God is angry with the wicked every day...Psalm 7:8-9, 11

I will praise the LORD according to His **righteousness**: and will sing praise to the name of the LORD Most High. Psalm 7:17

He shall judge the world in **righteousness**, He shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness. Psalm 9:8

If the foundations be destroyed, what can the **righteous** do? Psalm 11:3

The LORD tries the **righteous**: but the wicked and him that loves violence His soul hates. Psalm 11:5

For the **righteous** LORD loves **righteousness**; His countenance does behold the upright. Psalm 11:7

There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the **righteous**. Psalm 14:5

LORD, who shall abide in Your tabernacle? Who shall dwell in Your holy hill? He that walks uprightly, and works **righteousness**, and speaks the truth in his heart. He that backbites not with his tongue, nor does evil to his neighbor, nor takes up a reproach against his neighbor. In whose eyes a vile person is contemned; but he honors them that fear the LORD. He that swears to his own hurt and changes not. He that puts not out his money to usury, nor takes reward against the innocent. He that does these things shall not be moved. Psalm 15:1-5

As for me, I will behold Your face in **righteousness**: I shall be satisfied, when I awake, with Your likeness. Psalm 17:15

The LORD [YeHoVaH] rewarded me according to my **righteousness**; according to the cleanness of my hands has He recompensed me...Therefore has the LORD recompensed me according to my **righteousness**, according to the cleanness of my hands in His eyesight. Psalm 18:20, 24

The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and **righteous** altogether. Psalm 19:9

They shall come, and shall declare His **righteousness** to a people that shall be born, that He has done this. Psalm 22:31

He restores my soul: He leads me in the paths of **righteousness** for His name's sake. Psalm 23:3

He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and **righteousness** from the God of his salvation. Psalm 24:5

In You, O LORD, do I put my trust; let me never be ashamed: deliver me in Your **righteousness**...Let the lying lips be put to silence; which speak grievous things proudly and contemptuously against the **righteous**. Psalm 31:1, 18

Be glad in the LORD, and rejoice, you **righteous**: and shout for joy, all you that are upright in heart...Rejoice in the LORD, O you **righteous**: for praise is comely for the upright... He loves **righteousness** and judgment... Psalm 32:11, 33:1, 5



The eyes of the LORD are on the **righteous**, and His ears are open to their cry. The face of the LORD is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. Ps 34:15-16

The **righteous** cry, and the LORD hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles...Many are the afflictions of the **righteous**: but the LORD delivers him out of them all. Psalm 34:17, 19

Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the **righteous** shall be desolate. Psalm 34:21

Judge me, O LORD [YeHoVaH] my God, according to Your **righteousness**; and let them not rejoice over me. Ps 35:24

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that favor my **righteous** cause: yes, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant. Psalm 35:27

And my tongue shall speak of Your **righteousness** and of Your praise all the day long. Psalm 35:28

Your **righteousness** is like the great mountains; Your judgments are a great deep: O LORD, You preserve man and beast... O continue Your loving kindness to them that know You; and Your **righteousness** to the upright in heart. Psalm 36:6, 10

Commit your way unto the LORD; trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass. And He shall bring forth your **righteousness** as the light, and your judgment as the noonday. Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him: fret not yourself because of him who prospers in his way, because of the man who brings wicked devices to pass. Psalm 37:5-7

A little that a **righteous** man has is better than the riches of many wicked. For the arms of the wicked shall be broken: but the LORD upholds the **righteous**...The wicked borrows, and pays not again: but the **righteous** shows mercy, and gives... I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the **righteous** forsaken, nor his seed begging bread... The **righteous** shall inherit the land, and dwell therein for ever. The mouth of the **righteous** speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of judgment. Psalm 37:16-17, 21, 25, 29-30

The wicked watches the **righteous**, and seeks to slay him... But the salvation of the **righteous** is of the LORD: He is their strength in the time of trouble. Psalm 37:32, 39

I have preached **righteousness** in the great congregation: see, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, You know. I have not hid Your **righteousness** within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation: I have not concealed Your loving kindness and Your truth from the great congregation. Ps 40:9-10

In Your majesty ride prosperously because of truth and meekness and **righteousness**; and Your right hand shall teach terrible things...You love **righteousness**, and hate wickedness: therefore God, your God, has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Psalm 45:4, 7

According to Your name, O God, so is Your praise to the ends of the earth: Your right hand is full of **righteousness**. Psalm 48:10

The heavens shall declare His **righteousness**: for God is judge Himself. Selah. Psalm 50:6

Deliver me from blood guiltiness, O God, you God of my salvation: and my tongue shall sing aloud of Your **righteousness**...Then shall You be pleased with the sacrifices of **righteousness**, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks on Your altar. Psalm 51:14, 19

You love evil more than good; and lying rather than to speak **righteousness**. Selah. Psalm 52:3

The **righteous** also shall see, and fear, and shall laugh at him...Psalm 52:6

Cast your burden on the LORD, and He shall sustain you: He shall never suffer the **righteous** to be moved. Psalm 55:22

Do you indeed speak **righteousness**, O congregation? do you judge uprightly, O you sons of men? ...The **righteous** shall rejoice when he sees the vengeance: he shall wash his feet in the blood of the wicked. So that a man shall say, Truly there is a reward for the **righteous**: truly He is a God that judges in the earth. Psalm 58:1, 10-11

The **righteous** shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in Him; and all the upright in heart shall glory. Psalm 64:10

By terrible things in **righteousness** will You answer us, O God of our salvation; who are the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off on the sea... Psalm 65:5

O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for You shall judge the people **righteously**, and govern the nations on earth. Selah. Psalm 67:4

But let the **righteous** be glad; let them rejoice before God: yes, let them exceedingly rejoice. Psalm 68:3

Add iniquity to their iniquity: and let them not come into Your **righteousness**. Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the **righteous**. Psalm 69:27-28

Deliver me in Your **righteousness**, and cause me to escape: incline Your ear to me, and save me. Psalm 71:2

My mouth shall show forth Your **righteousness** and Your salvation all the day; for I know not the numbers thereof. I will go in the strength of the Lord GOD: I will make mention of Your **righteousness**, even of Yours only...Your **righteousness** also, O God, is very high, who has done great things: O God, who is like unto You! Psalm 71:15-16, 19

My tongue also shall talk of Your **righteousness** all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought to shame, that seek my hurt. Psalm 71:24

Give the king Your judgments, O God, and Your **righteousness** to the king's son. He shall judge Your people with **righteousness**, and Your poor with judgment. The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by **righteousness**. Psalm 72:1-3

In His days shall the **righteous** flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endures. Psalm 72:7 [about Solomon but prophetically pointing to King Yeshua's reign]

All the horns of the wicked also will I cut off; but the horns of the **righteous** shall be exalted. Psalm 75:10

Mercy and truth are met together; **righteousness** and peace have kissed each other. Truth shall spring out of the earth; and **righteousness** shall look down from heaven. Psalm 85:10-11

Shall Your wonders be known in the dark? and Your **righteousness** in the land of forgetfulness? Psalm 88:12

In Your name shall they rejoice all the day: and in Your **righteousness** shall they be exalted. Psalm 89:16

The **righteous** shall flourish like the palm tree: he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. Psalm 92:12

But judgment shall return to **righteousness**: and all the upright in heart shall follow it. Psalm 94:15

They gather themselves together against the soul of the **righteous**, and condemn the innocent blood. Psalm 94:21

Say among the heathen that the LORD reigns: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: He shall judge the people **righteously**. Psalm 96:10

Let the field be joyful, and all that is there: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice before the LORD: for He comes, for He comes to judge the earth: He shall judge the world with **righteousness**, and the people with His truth. Psalm 96:12-13

Clouds and darkness are round about Him: **righteousness** and judgment are the habitation of His throne. Psalm 97:2

The heavens declare His **righteousness**, and all the people see His glory. Psalm 97:6

Light is sown for the **righteous**, and gladness for the upright in heart. Rejoice in the LORD, you **righteous**; and give thanks at the remembrance of His holiness. Psalm 97:11-12

The LORD has made known His salvation: His **righteousness** has He openly shown in the sight of the heathen. Psalm 98:2

Let the hills be joyful together before the LORD; for He comes to judge the earth: with **righteousness** shall He judge the world, and the people with equity. Psalm 98:8-9

The king's strength also loves judgment; You do establish equity,  
You execute judgment and **righteousness** in Jacob. Psalm 99:4

The LORD executes **righteousness** and judgment for  
all that are oppressed. Psalm 103:6

But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting  
on them that fear Him, and His **righteousness** to children's  
children... Psalm 103:17

Blessed are they that keep judgment, and he that does  
**righteousness** at all times. Psalm 106:3

Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment...And that was  
counted to him for **righteousness** to all generations for ever more.  
Psalm 106:30-31

The **righteous** shall see it, and rejoice: and all iniquity shall  
stop her mouth. Psalm 107:42

His work is honorable and glorious: and His **righteousness**  
endures for ever. Psalm 111:3

Wealth and riches shall be in His house: and His **righteousness**  
endures for ever. To the upright there rises light in the darkness:  
He is gracious, and full of compassion, and **righteous**.  
Psalm 112:3-4

Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the **righteous** shall be  
in everlasting remembrance...He has dispersed, he has given  
to the poor; his **righteousness** endures for ever; his horn shall be  
exalted with honor. Psalm 112:6, 9

Gracious is the LORD, and **righteous**; yes, our God is merciful.  
Psalm 116:5

The voice of rejoicing and salvation is in the tabernacles of  
the **righteous**: the right hand of the LORD does valiantly.  
Psalm 118:15

Open to me the gates of **righteousness**: I will go into them,  
and I will praise the LORD. This gate of the LORD [YeHoVaH],  
into which the **righteous** shall enter. Psalm 118:19-20

I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned Your **righteous** judgments. Psalm 119:7

Behold, I have longed after Your precepts: quicken me in Your **righteousness**. Psalm 119:40

At midnight I will rise to give thanks to You because of Your **righteous** judgments. Psalm 119:62

I have sworn, and I will perform it, that I will keep Your **righteous** judgments...My eyes fail for Your salvation, and for the word of Your **righteousness**. Psalm 119:106, 123

Your testimonies that You have commanded are **righteous** and very faithful...Your **righteousness** is an everlasting **righteousness**, and Your law is the truth. Psalm 119:138, 142

The **righteousness** of Your testimonies is everlasting: give me understanding, and I shall live...Your word is true from the beginning: and every one of Your **righteous** judgments endures for ever. Psalm 119:144, 160

Seven times a day do I praise You because of Your **righteous** judgments. Psalm 119:164

My tongue shall speak of Your word: for all Your commandments are **righteousness**. Psalm 119:172

For the rod of the wicked shall not rest on the lot of the **righteous**; lest the **righteous** put forth their hands to iniquity. Psalm 125:3

The LORD is **righteous**: He has cut asunder the cords of the wicked. Psalm 129:4

Let Your priests be clothed with **righteousness**; and let Your saints shout for joy. Psalm 132:9

Surely the **righteous** shall give thanks to Your name: the upright shall dwell in Your presence. Psalm 140:13

Let the **righteous** smite me; it shall be a kindness: and let him reprove me; it shall be an excellent oil, which shall not break my head: for yet my prayer also shall be in their calamities. Psalm 141:5

Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise Your name: the **righteous** shall compass me about; for You shall deal bountifully with me. Psalm 142:7

Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in Your faithfulness answer me, and in Your **righteousness**... Quicken me, O LORD, for Your name's sake: for Your **righteousness**' sake bring my soul out of trouble. Psalm 143:1, 11

They shall abundantly utter the memory of Your great goodness, and shall sing of Your **righteousness**...The LORD is **righteous** in all His ways, and holy in all His works...Psalm 145:7, 17

The LORD opens the eyes of the blind: the LORD raises them that are bowed down: the LORD loves the **righteous**... Psalm 146:8

My son, if you will receive my words, and hide my commandments with you; So that you incline your ear unto wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding... For the LORD [YeHoVaH] gives wisdom: out of His mouth comes knowledge and understanding. He lays up sound wisdom for the **righteous**: He is a buckler to them that walk uprightly... Then shall you understand **righteousness**, and judgment, and equity; yes, every good path. Proverbs 2:1-2, 6-7, 9

When wisdom enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto your soul; Discretion shall preserve you, understanding shall keep you...That you may walk in the way of good men, and keep the paths of the **righteous**. Proverbs 2:10-11, 20

For the fraudulent is abomination to the LORD: but His secret is with the **righteous**. Proverbs 3:32

All the words of my mouth are in **righteousness**; there is nothing fraudulent or perverse in them. Proverbs 8:8

I wisdom dwell with prudence...Riches and honor are with me; yes, durable riches and **righteousness**...I lead in the way of **righteousness**, in the middle of the paths of judgment: That I may cause those that love me to inherit substance; and I will fill their treasures. Proverbs 8:12, 18, 20



Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but **righteousness** delivers from death. The LORD will not suffer the soul of the **righteous** to famish: but He casts away the substance of the wicked. Proverbs 10:2-3

The mouth of a **righteous** man is a well of life: but violence covers the mouth of the wicked...The labor of the **righteous** tends to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin. Proverbs 10:11, 16

The lips of the **righteous** feed many: but fools die for want of wisdom. Proverbs 10:21

The fear of the wicked, it shall come on him: but the desire of the **righteous** shall be granted. As the whirlwind passes, so is the wicked no more: but the **righteous** is an everlasting foundation. Proverbs 10:24-25

The hope of the **righteous** shall be gladness: but the expectation of the wicked shall perish. The **righteous** shall never be removed: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth. Proverbs 10:28, 30

The lips of the **righteous** know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked speaks frowardness. Proverbs 10:32

Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but **righteousness** delivers from death. The **righteousness** of the perfect shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness. The **righteousness** of the upright shall deliver them: but transgressors shall be taken in their own naughtiness. Pro 11:4-6

The **righteous** is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked comes in his stead. When it goes well with the **righteous**, the city rejoices: and when the wicked perish, there is shouting. Proverbs 11:8, 10

The wicked works a deceitful work: but to him that sows **righteousness** shall be a sure reward. As **righteousness** tends to life: so he that pursues evil pursues it to his own death. Proverbs 11:18-19

Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the **righteous** shall be delivered. Proverbs 11:21



The desire of the **righteous** is only good: but the expectation of the wicked is wrath. Proverbs 11:23

He that trusts in his riches shall fall; but the **righteous** shall flourish as a branch. Proverbs 11:28

The fruit of the **righteous** is a tree of life; and he that wins souls is wise. Behold, the **righteous** shall be recompensed in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner. Proverbs 11:30-31

A man shall not be established by wickedness: but the root of the **righteous** shall not be moved...The thoughts of the **righteous** are right: but the counsels of the wicked are deceit. Proverbs 12:3, 5

The wicked are overthrown, and are not: but the house of the **righteous** shall stand. Proverbs 12:7

A **righteous** man regards the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked are cruel. Proverbs 12:10

The wicked desires the net of evil men: but the root of the **righteous** yields fruit. Proverbs 12:12

He that speaks truth shows forth **righteousness**: but a false witness deceit. Proverbs 12:17

The **righteous** is more excellent than his neighbor: but the way of the wicked seduces them. Proverbs 12:26

In the way of **righteousness** is life: and in the pathway thereof there is no death. Proverbs 12:28

A **righteous** man hates lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and comes to shame. The light of the **righteous** rejoices: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out...Evil pursues sinners: but to the **righteous** good shall be repaid. Proverbs 13:5, 9, 21

The **righteous** eats to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want. Proverbs 13:25

Fools make a mock at sin: but among the **righteous** there is favor. Proverbs 14:9

The evil bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the **righteous**. Proverbs 14:19

The wicked is driven away in his wickedness: but the **righteous** has hope in his death. Proverbs 14:32

In the house of the **righteous** is much treasure: but in the revenues of the wicked is trouble. Proverbs 15:6

The way of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but He loves him that follows after **righteousness**. Proverbs 15:9

The way of the slothful man is as an hedge of thorns: but the way of the **righteous** is made plain. Proverbs 15:19

The heart of the **righteous** studies to answer: but the mouth of the wicked pours out evil things. The LORD is far from the wicked: but He hears the prayer of the **righteous**. Pro 15:28-29

Better is a little with **righteousness** than great revenues without right. Proverbs 16:8

It is an abomination to kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by **righteousness**. Proverbs 16:12

The hoary head is a crown of glory, if it be found in the way of **righteousness**. Proverbs 16:31

It is not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the **righteous** in judgment. Proverbs 18:5

The name of the LORD [YeHoVaH] is a strong tower: the **righteous** runs into it, and is safe. Proverbs 18:10

The **righteous** man wisely considers the house of the wicked: but God overthrows the wicked for their wickedness... The wicked shall be a ransom for the **righteous**, and the transgressor for the upright. Proverbs 21:12, 18

He that follows after **righteousness** and mercy finds life, **righteousness**, and honor. Proverbs 21:21

He covets greedily all the day long: but the **righteous** gives and spares not. Proverbs 21:26

The father of the **righteous** shall greatly rejoice: and he that begets a wise child shall have joy of him. Proverbs 23:24

Lay not wait, O wicked man, against the dwelling of the **righteous**; spoil not his resting place: Proverbs 24:15

He that says to the wicked, You are **righteous**; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him: But to them that rebuke him shall be delight, and a good blessing shall come upon them. Proverbs 24:24-25

Take away the wicked from before the king, and his throne shall be established in **righteousness**. Proverbs 25:5

A **righteous** man falling down before the wicked is as a troubled fountain, and a corrupt spring. Proverbs 25:26

The wicked flee when no man pursues: but the **righteous** are bold as a lion. Proverbs 28:1

Whoever causes the **righteous** to go astray in an evil way, he shall fall himself into his own pit: but the upright shall have good things in possession. Proverbs 28:10

When **righteous** men do rejoice, there is great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden. Proverbs 28:12

When the wicked rise, men hide themselves: but when they perish, the **righteous** increase. Proverbs 28:28

When the **righteous** are in authority, the people rejoice: but when the wicked bears rule, the people mourn. Proverbs 29:2

In the transgression of an evil man there is a snare: but the **righteous** does sing and rejoice. Proverbs 29:6

The **righteous** considers the cause of the poor: but the wicked regards not to know it. Proverbs 29:7

When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increases: but the **righteous** shall see their fall. Proverbs 29:16

Open your mouth, judge **righteously**, and plead the cause of the poor and needy. Proverbs 31:9

And moreover I saw under the sun the place of judgment, that wickedness was there; and the place of **righteousness**, that iniquity was there. I said in my heart, God shall judge the **righteous** and the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every work. Ecclesiastes 3:16-17

All things have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a just man that perishes in his **righteousness**, and there is a wicked man that prolongs his life in his wickedness. Be not **righteous** over much; neither make yourself over wise: why should you destroy yourself? Ecclesiastes 7:15-16

There is a vanity which is done on the earth; that there be just men, to whom it happens according to the work of the wicked; again, there be wicked men, to whom it happens according to the work of the **righteous**: I said that this also is vanity. Ecclesiastes 8:14

For all this I considered in my heart even to declare all this, that the **righteous**, and the wise, and their works, are in the hand of God: no man knows either love or hatred by all that is before them. All things come alike to all: there is one event to the **righteous**, and to the wicked; to the good and to the clean, and to the unclean; to him that sacrifices, and to him that sacrifices not: as is the good, so is the sinner; and he that swears, as he that fears an oath. Ecclesiastes 9:1-2

How is the faithful city become an harlot! it was full of judgment; **righteousness** lodged in it; but now murderers. Isaiah 1:21

I will restore your judges as at the first, and your counsellors as at the beginning: afterward you shall be called, The city of **righteousness**, the faithful city. Zion shall be redeemed with judgment, and her converts with **righteousness**. Isaiah 1:26-27

Say you to the **righteous**, that it shall be well with him: for they shall eat the fruit of their doings. Isaiah 3:10

For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah His pleasant plant: and He looked for judgment, but behold oppression; for **righteousness**, but behold a cry. Isaiah 5:7

But the LORD of hosts shall be exalted in judgment, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in **righteousness**...Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink: Which justify the wicked for reward, and take away the **righteousness** of the **righteous** from him! Isaiah 5:16, 22-23

For though Your people Israel be as the sand of the sea, yet a remnant of them shall return: the consumption decreed shall overflow with **righteousness**. Isaiah 10:22

But with **righteousness** shall He judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and He shall smite the earth: with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked. And **righteousness** shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdle of His reins. Isaiah 11:4-5

And in mercy shall the throne be established: and He shall sit on it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hastening **righteousness**. Isaiah 16:5

From the uttermost part of the earth have we heard songs, even glory to the **righteous**. But I said, My leanness, my leanness, woe to me! the treacherous dealers have dealt treacherously; yes, the treacherous dealers have dealt very treacherously. Isaiah 24:16

Open you the gates, that the **righteous** nation which keeps the truth may enter in. Isaiah 26:2

With my soul have I desired You in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek You early: for when Your judgments are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn **righteousness**. Isaiah 26:9

Let favor be shown to the wicked, yet will he not learn **righteousness**: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD. Isaiah 26:10

Judgment also will I lay to the line, and **righteousness** to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. Isaiah 28:17

Behold, a king shall reign in **righteousness**, and princes shall rule in judgment. Isaiah 32:1

Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and **righteousness** remain in the fruitful field. And the work of **righteousness** shall be peace; and the effect of **righteousness** quietness and assurance for ever. Isaiah 32:16-17

The LORD is exalted; for He dwells on high: He has filled Zion with judgment and **righteousness**. Isaiah 33:5

Who shall dwell with everlasting burnings? He that walks **righteously**, and speaks uprightly; he that despises the gain of oppressions, that shakes his hands from holding of bribes, that stops his ears from hearing of blood, and shuts his eyes from seeing evil... Isaiah 33:14b-15

Who raised up the **righteous** man from the east, called him to His foot, gave the nations before Him, and made Him rule over kings? He gave them as the dust to His sword, and as driven stubble to His bow. Isaiah 41:2

Fear not; for I am with you: be not dismayed; for I am your God: I will strengthen you; yes, I will help you; yes, I will uphold you with the right hand of My **righteousness**. Isaiah 41:10

Who has declared from the beginning, that we may know? and beforetime, that we may say, He is **righteous**? yes, there is none that shows, yes, there is none that declares, yes, there is none that hears Your words. Isaiah 41:26

I the LORD have called you in **righteousness**, and will hold Your hand, and will keep You, and give you for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles... Isaiah 42:6

The LORD is well pleased for His **righteousness'** sake; He will magnify the law, and make it honorable. Isaiah 42:21

Drop down, you heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down **righteousness**: let the earth open, and let them bring forth salvation, and let **righteousness** spring up together; I the LORD [YeHoVaH] have created it. Isaiah 45:8

I have raised Him up in **righteousness**, and I will direct all His ways: He shall build My city, and He shall let go My captives, not for price nor reward, says the LORD of hosts. Isaiah 45:13

I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I said not to the seed of Jacob, Seek Me in vain: I the LORD speak **righteousness**, I declare things that are right. Isaiah 45:19

I have sworn by Myself, the word is gone out of My mouth in **righteousness**, and shall not return, That to Me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear. Surely, shall one say, in the LORD have I **righteousness** and strength: even to Him shall men come; and all that are incensed against Him shall be ashamed. Isaiah 45:23-24

Listen to Me, you stouthearted, that are far from **righteousness**: I bring near My **righteousness**; it shall not be far off, and My salvation shall not tarry: and I will place salvation in Zion for Israel My glory. Isaiah 46:12-13

Listen to me, you that follow after **righteousness**, you that seek the LORD: look to the rock from where you are hewn, and to the hole of the pit from where you are digged. Isaiah 51:1

Hear you this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, but not in truth, nor in **righteousness**...O that you had listened to My commandments! then had your peace been as a river, and your **righteousness** as the waves of the sea... Isaiah 48:1, 18

My **righteousness** is near; My salvation is gone forth, and My arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait on Me, and on My arm shall they trust. Lift up your eyes to the heavens, and look on the earth beneath: for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, and the earth shall wax old like a garment, and they that dwell therein shall die in like manner: but My salvation shall be for ever, and My **righteousness** shall not be abolished. Listen to Me, you that know **righteousness**, the people in whose heart is My law; fear you not the reproach of men, neither be you afraid of their revilings. For the moth shall eat them up like a garment, and the worm shall eat them like wool: but My **righteousness** shall be for ever, and My salvation from generation to generation. Isaiah 51:5-8



He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My **righteous** servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities. Isaiah 53:11

In **righteousness** shall you be established: you shall be far from oppression; for you shall not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near you....No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their **righteousness** is of Me, said the LORD. Isaiah 54:14, 17

Thus said the LORD, Keep you judgment, and do justice: for My salvation is near to come, and My **righteousness** to be revealed. Isaiah 56:1

The **righteous** perishes, and no man lays it to heart: and merciful men are taken away, none considering that the **righteous** is taken away from the evil to come...Isaiah 57:1

I will declare your **righteousness**, and your works; for they shall not profit you. Isaiah 57: 12

Yet they seek Me daily, and delight to know My ways, as a nation that did **righteousness**, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of Me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God. Isaiah 58:2

Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness...Then shall your light break forth as the morning, and your health shall spring forth speedily: and your **righteousness** shall go before you; the glory of the LORD [YeHoVaH] shall be your rear guard. Isaiah 58:6, 8

And He saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore His arm brought salvation to Him; and His **righteousness**, it sustained Him. For He put on **righteousness** as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation on His head; and He put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak. Isaiah 59:16-17



For brass I will bring gold, and for iron I will bring silver, and for wood brass, and for stones iron: I will also make your officers peace, and your exactors **righteousness**... Your people also shall be all **righteous**: they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of My planting, the work of My hands, that I may be glorified. Isaiah 60:17, 21

To appoint to them that mourn in Zion, to give to them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of **righteousness**, the planting of the LORD, that He might be glorified. Isaiah 61:3

I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of **righteousness**, as a bridegroom decks himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels. For as the earth brings forth her bud, and as the garden causes the things that are sown in it to spring forth; so the Lord GOD will cause **righteousness** and praise to spring forth before all the nations. Isaiah 61:10-11

For Zion's sake will I not hold My peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the **righteousness** thereof go forth as brightness, and the salvation thereof as a lamp that burns. And the Gentiles shall see your **righteousness**, and all kings your glory: and you shall be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name. Isaiah 62:1-2

Who is this that comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this that is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength? I that speak in **righteousness**, mighty to save. Isaiah 63:1

You meet him that rejoices and works **righteousness**, those that remember You in Your ways: behold, You are wroth; for we have sinned: in those is continuance, and we shall be saved. But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our **righteousnesses** are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. Isaiah 64:5-6

And you shall swear, The LORD lives, in truth, in judgment, and in **righteousness**; and the nations shall bless themselves in Him, and in Him shall they glory. Jeremiah 4:2

But let him that glories glory in this, that He understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD which exercise loving kindness, judgment, and **righteousness**, in the earth: for in these things I delight, says the LORD. Jeremiah 9:24

But, O LORD of hosts, that judge **righteously**, that tries the reins and the heart, let me see Your vengeance on them: for to You have I revealed my cause. Jeremiah 11:20

But, O LORD of hosts, that tries the **righteous**, and sees the reins and the heart, let me see Your vengeance on them: for to You have I opened my cause. Jeremiah 20:12

Thus said the LORD; Execute judgment and **righteousness**, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place. Jeremiah 22:3

Behold, the days come, said the LORD, that I will raise to David a **righteous** Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth. In His days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, **THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS**. Jeremiah 23:5-6

In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of **righteousness** to grow up to David; and He shall execute judgment and **righteousness** in the land. Jeremiah 33:15

In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this is the name with which she shall be called, **The LORD our righteousness**. Jeremiah 33:16

The LORD has brought forth our **righteousness**: come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD our God. Jeremiah 51:10

The LORD is **righteous**; for I have rebelled against His commandment: hear, I pray you, all people, and behold My sorrow: My virgins and My young men are gone into captivity. Lamentations 1:18

Again, When a **righteous** man does turn from his **righteousness**, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumbling-block before him, he shall die: because you have not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his **righteousness** which he has done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at your hand. Nevertheless if you warn the **righteous** man, that the **righteous** sin not, and he does not sin, he shall surely live, because he is warned; also you have delivered your soul. Ezekiel 3:20-21

With lies you have made the heart of the **righteous** sad, whom I have not made sad; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life... Ezekiel 13:22

Though these three men, Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, they should deliver but their own souls by their **righteousness**, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 14:14

Though Noah, Daniel, and Job were in it, as I live, says the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls by their **righteousness**. Ezekiel 14:20

You also, which have judged your sisters, bear your own shame for your sins that you have committed more abominable than they: they are more **righteous** than you: yes, be you confounded also, and bear your shame, in that you have justified your sisters. Ezekiel 16:52

The soul that sins, it shall die. The son shall not bear the iniquity of the father, neither shall the father bear the iniquity of the son: the **righteousness** of the **righteous** shall be on him, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be on him...All his transgressions that he has committed, they shall not be mentioned to him: in his **righteousness** that he has done he shall live. Ezekiel 18:20, 22

But when the **righteous** turns away from his **righteousness**, and commits iniquity, and does according to all the abominations that the wicked man does, shall he live? All his **righteousness** that he has done shall not be mentioned: in his trespass that he has trespassed, and in his sin that he has sinned, in them shall he die. Yet you say, The way of the Lord is not equal. Hear now, O house of Israel; Is not My way equal? are not your ways unequal? When a **righteous** man turns away from his **righteousness**, and commits iniquity, and dies in them; for his iniquity that he has done shall he die. Ezekiel 18:24-26

And say to the land of Israel, Thus said the LORD; Behold, I am against you, and will draw forth My sword out of his sheath, and will cut off from you the **righteous** and the wicked. Seeing then that I will cut off from you the **righteous** and the wicked, therefore shall My sword go forth out of His sheath against all flesh from the south to the north...Ezekiel 21:3-4

The **righteous** men, they shall judge them after the manner of adulteresses, and after the manner of women that shed blood; because they are adulteresses, and blood is in their hands. Ezekiel 23:45

Therefore, you son of man, say to the children of your people, The **righteousness** of the **righteous** shall not deliver him in the day of his transgression: as for the wickedness of the wicked, he shall not fall thereby in the day that he turns from his wickedness; neither shall the **righteous** be able to live for his **righteousness** in the day that he sins. When I shall say to the **righteous**, that he shall surely live; if he trust to his own **righteousness**, and commit iniquity, all his **righteousnesses** shall not be remembered; but for his iniquity that he has committed, he shall die for it. Ezekiel 33:12-13

When the **righteous** turns from his **righteousness**, and commits iniquity, he shall even die thereby. Ezekiel 33:18

Why, O king, let my counsel be acceptable to you, and break off your sins by **righteousness**, and your iniquities by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of your tranquility. Daniel 4:27

O LORD, **righteousness** belongs to you, but to us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to all Israel, that are near, and that are far off, through all the countries where you have driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against you. Daniel 9:7

Therefore has the LORD watched on the evil, and brought it on us: for the LORD our God is **righteous** in all His works which He does: for we obeyed not His voice. Daniel 9:14

O LORD, according to all Your **righteousness**, I beseech You, let Your anger and Your fury be turned away from Your city Jerusalem, Your holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and Your people are become a reproach to all that are about us. Daniel 9:16

O my God, incline your ear, and hear; open your eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name: for we do not present our supplications before you for our **righteousnesses**, but for Your great mercies. Daniel 9:18

Seventy weeks are determined on Your people and on Your holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting **righteousness**, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy. Daniel 9:24

And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to **righteousness** as the stars for ever and ever. Daniel 12:3

I will betroth you to Me for ever; yes, I will betroth you to Me in **righteousness**, and in judgment, and in loving kindness, and in mercies. Hosea 2:19

Sow to yourselves in **righteousness**, reap in mercy; break up your fallow ground: for it is time to seek the LORD, till He come and rain **righteousness** on you. Hosea 10:12

Thus said the LORD; For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not turn away the punishment thereof; because they sold the **righteous** for silver, and the poor for a pair of shoes... Amos 2:6

You who turn judgment to wormwood, and leave off **righteousness** in the earth, Seek Him that made the seven stars... Amos 5:7-8

But let judgment run down as waters, and **righteousness** as a mighty stream. Amos 5:24

Shall horses run on the rock? will one plow there with oxen? for you have turned judgment into gall, and the fruit of **righteousness** into hemlock... Amos 6:12

O My people, remember now what Balak king of Moab consulted, and what Balaam the son of Beor answered him from Shittim to Gilgal; that you may know the **righteousness** of the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Micah 6:5

I will bear the indignation of the LORD, because I have sinned against Him, until He plead my cause, and execute judgment for me: He will bring me forth to the light, and I shall behold His **righteousness**. Micah 7:9

Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment does never go forth: for the wicked does compass about the **righteous**; therefore wrong judgment proceeds. Habakkuk 1:4

You are of purer eyes than to behold evil, and can not look on iniquity: why do You look on them that deal treacherously, and hold Your tongue when the wicked devours the man that is more **righteous** than he? Habakkuk 1:13 Habakkuk's thoughts

Seek you the LORD, all you meek of the earth, which have worked His judgment; seek **righteousness**, seek meekness: it may be you shall be hid in the day of the LORD's anger. Zephaniah 2:3

And I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the middle of Jerusalem: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, in truth and in **righteousness**. Zechariah 8:8

And He shall sit as a refiner and purifier of silver: and He shall purify the sons of Levi, and purge them as gold and silver, that they may offer to the LORD an offering in **righteousness**. Malachi 3:3

Then shall you return, and discern between the **righteous** and the wicked, between him that serves God and him that serves Him not. Malachi 3:18

But to you that fear My name shall the Sun of **righteousness** arise with healing in His wings; and you shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall. Malachi 4:2

## RIGHTEOUSNESS IN THE NEW COVENANT

John forbade Him, saying, I have need to be baptized of You, and You come to me? And Jesus answering said to him, Let it be so now: for it is right for us to do this to fulfill all **righteousness**. Then he agreed with Him. Matthew 3:14-15

Blessed are they which do hunger and thirst after **righteousness**: for they shall be filled...Blessed are they which are persecuted for **righteousness'** sake: for theirs is the Kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:6, 10

For I say to you, That except your **righteousness** shall exceed the **righteousness** of the scribes and Pharisees, you shall in no case enter into the Kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:20

But seek you first the Kingdom of God, and His **righteousness**; and all these things shall be added to you. Matthew 6:33

But go you and learn what that means, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the **righteous**, but sinners to repentance. Matthew 9:13

He that receives a prophet in the name of a prophet shall receive a prophet's reward; and he that receives a **righteous** man in the name of a **righteous** man shall receive a **righteous** man's reward. Matthew 10:41

Truly I say to you, That many prophets and **righteous** men have desired to see those things which you see, and have not seen them; and to hear those things which you hear, and have not heard them. Matthew 13:17

Then shall the **righteous** shine forth as the sun in the Kingdom of their Father. Who has ears to hear, let him hear. Matthew 13:43



For John came to you in the way of **righteousness**, and you believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and you, when you had seen it, repented not afterward, that you might believe him. Matthew 21:32

Even so you also outwardly appear **righteous** to men, but within you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity. Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because you build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchers of the **righteous**... Matthew 23:28-29

That on you may come all the **righteous** blood shed on the earth, from the blood of **righteous** Abel to the blood of Zacharias son of Barachias, whom you slew between the temple and the altar... Then shall the **righteous** answer Him, saying, Lord, when saw we You an hungered, and fed You? or thirsty, and gave You drink? Matthew 25:35, 37

And these shall go away into everlasting punishment: but the **righteous** into life eternal. Matthew 25:46

When Jesus heard it, He said to them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the **righteous**, but sinners to repentance. Mark 2:17

They were both **righteous** before God, walking in all the commandments and ordinances of the Lord blameless. Luke 1:6

That He would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear, in holiness and **righteousness** before Him, all the days of our life. Luke 1:74-75

I came not to call the **righteous**, but sinners to repentance. Luke 5:32

And He spoke this parable to certain which trusted in themselves that they were **righteous**, and despised others... Luke 18:9

Now when the centurion saw what was done, he glorified God, saying, Certainly this was a **righteous** man. Luke 23:47



Judge not according to the appearance, but judge **righteous** judgment. John 7:24

If I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of **righteousness**, and of judgment: Of sin, because they believe not on Me; Of **righteousness**, because I go to My Father, and you see Me no more; of judgment, because the prince of this world is judged. John 16:7-11

O **righteous** Father, the world has not known You: but I have known You, and these have known that You have sent Me. John 17:25

But in every nation he that fears Him, and works **righteousness**, is accepted with Him. Acts 10:35

...And said, O full of all subtlety and all mischief, you child of the devil, you enemy of all **righteousness**, will you not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord? Acts 13:10

He has appointed a day, in the which He will judge the world in **righteousness** by that man whom He has ordained; whereof He has given assurance to all men, in that He has raised Him from the dead. Acts 17:31

And as he reasoned of **righteousness**, temperance, and judgment to come, Felix trembled... Acts 24:25

For therein is the **righteousness** of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith. Romans 1:17

But after your hardness and impenitent heart treasure up to yourself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the **righteous** judgment of God... Romans 2:5

Therefore if the uncircumcision keep the **righteousness** of the law, shall not his uncircumcision be counted for circumcision? Romans 2:26

But if our unrighteousness commend the **righteousness** of God, what shall we say? Is God unrighteous who takes vengeance? (I speak as a man) Romans 3:5

As it is written, There is none **righteous**, no, not one... But now the **righteousness** of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; Even the **righteousness** of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] to all and on all them that believe: for there is no difference... Romans 3:10, 22

Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His **righteousness** for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time His **righteousness**: that He might be just, and the justifier of Him which believes in Jesus. Romans 3:25-26

For what said the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him for **righteousness**...But to him that works not, but believes on Him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted for **righteousness**. Even as David also describes the blessedness of the man, to whom God imputes **righteousness** without works... Romans 4:3, 5-6

Comes this blessedness then on the circumcision only, or on the uncircumcision also? for we say that faith was reckoned to Abraham for **righteousness**. Romans 4:9

And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the **righteousness** of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that **righteousness** might be imputed to them also... Romans 4:11

For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the **righteousness** of faith...He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God; And being fully persuaded that, what He had promised, He was able also to perform. And therefore it was imputed to him for **righteousness**. Romans 4:13, 20-22

For scarcely for a **righteous** man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die. Romans 5:7

For if by one man's offense death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of **righteousness** shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) Therefore as by the offense of one judgment came on all men to condemnation; even so by the **righteousness** of one the free gift came on all men to justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made **righteous**. Romans 5:17-19

That as sin has reigned to death, even so might grace reign through **righteousness** to eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 5:21

Neither yield you your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin: but yield yourselves to God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of **righteousness** to God. Romans 6:13

Know you not, that to whom you yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey; whether of sin to death, or of obedience to **righteousness**? But God be thanked, that you were the servants of sin, but you have obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine which was delivered you. Being then made free from sin, you became the servants of **righteousness**. Romans 6:16-18

I speak after the manner of men because of the infirmity of your flesh: for as you have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to **righteousness** unto holiness. For when you were the servants of sin, you were free from **righteousness**. Romans 6:19-20

That the **righteousness** of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. Romans 8:4

And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of **righteousness**. Romans 8:10

For He will finish the work, and cut it short in **righteousness**: because a short work will the Lord make on the earth... What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after **righteousness**, have attained to **righteousness**, even the righteousness which is of faith. But Israel, which followed after the law of **righteousness**, has not attained to the law of **righteousness**. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. Romans 9:28, 30-32

For they being ignorant of God's **righteousness**, and going about to establish their own **righteousness**, have not submitted themselves to the **righteousness** of God. For Christ [Messiah] is the end of the law for **righteousness** to every one that believes. Romans 10:3-4

For Moses describes the **righteousness** which is of the law, That the man which does those things shall live by them. But the **righteousness** which is of faith speaks on this wise, Say not in your heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down from above:) or, Who shall descend into the deep? (that is, to bring up Christ from the dead.)...For with the heart man believes to **righteousness**; and with the mouth confession is made to salvation. Romans 10:5-7, 10

For the Kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but **righteousness**, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. Romans 14:17

But of him are you in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua], who of God is made to us wisdom, and **righteousness**, and sanctification, and redemption... 1 Corinthians 1:30

Awake to **righteousness**, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame. 1 Corinthians 15:34

For if the ministration of condemnation be glory, much more does the ministration of **righteousness** exceed in glory. 2 Corinthians 3:9

For He has made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the **righteousness** of God in Him. 2 Cor 5:21

In all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God... By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of **righteousness** on the right hand and on the left... 2 Cor 6:4, 7

Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has **righteousness** with unrighteousness? and what communion has light with darkness? 2 Corinthians 6:14

(As it is written, He has dispersed abroad; He has given to the poor: His **righteousness** remains for ever. Now He that ministers seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your **righteousness**;) 2 Corinthians 9:9-10

Therefore it is no great thing if His ministers also be transformed as the ministers of **righteousness**; whose end shall be according to their works. 2 Corinthians 11:15

I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if **righteousness** come by the law, then Christ [Messiah] is dead in vain. Galatians 2:21

Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for **righteousness**. Galatians 3:6

Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly **righteousness** should have been by the law. Galatians 3:21

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of **righteousness** by faith. Galatians 5:5

Put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that you put on the new man, which after God is created in **righteousness** and true holiness. Ephesians 4:22-24

(For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and **righteousness** and truth;) Ephesians 5:9

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of **righteousness**... Ephesians 6:14

That you may approve things that are excellent; that you may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ; Being filled with the fruits of **righteousness**, which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God. Philippians 1:10-11

Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the **righteousness** which is in the law, blameless. Philippians 3:6

And be found in Him, not having my own **righteousness**, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the **righteousness** which is of God by faith: That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being made conformable unto His death; If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead. Philippians 3:9-11

Which is a manifest token of the **righteous** judgment of God, that you may be counted worthy of the Kingdom of God, for which you also suffer: Seeing it is a **righteous** thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you... 2 Thessalonians 1:5-6

The law is good, if a man know how to use it lawfully; Knowing this, that the law is not made for a **righteous man**, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, For whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons... 1 Timothy 1:8-10

But you, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after **righteousness**, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. 1 Timothy 6:11

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow **righteousness**, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 2:22

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in **righteousness**... 2 Timothy 3:16

Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of **righteousness**, which the Lord, the **righteous** judge, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but to all them also that love His appearing. 2 Timothy 4:8

Teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, **righteously**, and godly, in this present world... Titus 2:12

Not by works of **righteousness** which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost... Titus 3:5

But to the Son He said, Your throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a scepter of **righteousness** is the scepter of Your Kingdom. You have loved **righteousness**, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even Your God has anointed you with the oil of gladness above your fellows. Hebrews 1:8-9

For every one that uses milk is unskillful in the word of **righteousness**: for he is a babe. Hebrews 5:13

To whom also Abraham gave a tenth part of all; first being by interpretation King of **righteousness**, and after that also King of Salem, which is, King of peace... Hebrews 7:2

By faith Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was **righteous**, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaks. Hebrews 11:4

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the **righteousness** which is by faith. Hebrews 11:7

...Who through faith subdued kingdoms, worked **righteousness**, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions. Hebrews 11:33

Now no chastening for the present seems to be joyous, but grievous: nevertheless afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of **righteousness** to them which are exercised thereby. Hebrews 12:11



For the wrath of man works not the **righteousness** of God.  
James 1:20

The scripture was fulfilled which said, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed to him for **righteousness**: and he was called the Friend of God. James 2:23

The fruit of **righteousness** is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:18

Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that you may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a **righteous** man avails much. James 5:16

Who, when He was reviled, reviled not again; when He suffered, He threatened not; but committed Himself to Him that judges **righteously**: Who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live to **righteousness**: by whose stripes you were healed. 1 Peter 2:23-24

For the eyes of the Lord are over the **righteous**, and His ears are open to their prayers: but the face of the Lord is against them that do evil...But and if you suffer for **righteousness'** sake, happy are you: and be not afraid of their terror, neither be troubled... 1 Peter 3:12, 14

And if the **righteous** scarcely be saved, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? 1 Peter 4:18

Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the **righteousness** of God and our Savior Jesus Christ...2 Peter 1:1

...And spared not the old world, but saved Noah the eighth person, a preacher of **righteousness**, bringing in the flood on the world of the ungodly... 2 Peter 2:5

(For that **righteous** man dwelling among them, in seeing and hearing, vexed his **righteous** soul from day to day with their unlawful deeds;) 2 Peter 2:8

For it had been better for them not to have known the way of **righteousness**, than, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. 2 Peter 2:21



Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwells **righteousness**. 2 Peter 3:13

My little children, these things write I to you, that you sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] the **righteous**... 1 John 2:1

If you know that He is **righteous**, you know that every one that does **righteousness** is born of Him. 1 John 2:29

Little children, let no man deceive you: He that does **righteousness** is **righteous**, even as He is **righteous**. 1 John 3:7

In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: whoever does not **righteousness** is not of God, neither he that loves not his brother. 1 John 3:10

Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And why slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's **righteous**. 1 John 3:12

And I heard the angel of the waters say, You are **righteous**, O Lord, which is, and was, and shall be, because You have judged thus. Revelation 16:5

And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and **righteous** are Your judgments. Rev 16:7

For true and **righteous** are His judgments: for He has judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and has avenged the blood of His servants at her hand. Rev 19:2

And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the **righteousness** of saints. Revelation 19:8

And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in **righteousness** He does judge and make war. Revelation 19:11

He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is **righteous**, let him be **righteous** still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still. Revelation 22:11

## UNRIGHTEOUSNESS

You shall not raise a false report: put not your hand with the wicked to be an **unrighteous** witness. Exodus 23:1

You shall do no **unrighteousness** in judgment: you shall not respect the person of the poor, nor honor the person of the mighty: but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbor... You shall do no **unrighteousness** in judgment, in mete yard, in weight, or in measure. Leviticus 19:15, 35

Let my enemy be as the wicked, and he that rises up against me as the **unrighteous**. Job 27:7

Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, out of the hand of the **unrighteous** and cruel man. Psalms 71:4

To shew that the LORD is upright: He is my rock, and there is no **unrighteousness** in Him. Psalms 92:15

Woe unto them that decree **unrighteous** decrees, and write grievousness which they have prescribed... Isaiah 10:1

Let the wicked forsake his way, and the **unrighteous** man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and He will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for He will abundantly pardon. Isaiah 55:7

Woe unto him that builds his house by **unrighteousness**, and his chambers by wrong; that uses his neighbor's service without wages, and gives him not for his work... Jeremiah 22:13

And I say unto you, Make to yourselves friends of the mammon of **unrighteousness**; that, when you fail, they may receive you into everlasting habitations... If therefore you have not been faithful in the **unrighteous** mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? Luke 16:9-11

He that speaks of himself seeks his own glory: but he that seeks His glory that sent Him, the same is true, and no **unrighteousness** is in Him. John 7:18

Unto them that are contentious, and do not obey the truth, but obey **unrighteousness**, indignation and wrath, tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that does evil... Ro 2:8-9

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and **unrighteousness** of men, who hold the truth in **unrighteousness**...being filled with all **unrighteousness**, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity... Romans 1:18, 29

But if our **unrighteousness** commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God **unrighteous** who takes vengeance? (I speak as a man) Romans 3:5

Neither yield **you** your members as instruments of **unrighteousness** unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God....What shall we say then? Is there **unrighteousness** with God? God forbid. Romans 6:13; 9:14

Know you not that the **unrighteous** shall not inherit the Kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind... 1 Corinthians 6:9

Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with **unrighteousness**? And what communion has light with darkness? 2 Cor 6:14

And with all deceivableness of **unrighteousness** in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved...That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in **unrighteousness**. 2 Thess 2;10, 12

For God is not **unrighteous** to forget your work and labor of love, which you have showed toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister...For I will be merciful to their **unrighteousness**, and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more. Hebrews 6:10, 8:12

And shall receive the reward of **unrighteousness**, as they that count it pleasure to riot in the day time....which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray...who loved the wages of **unrighteousness**... 2 Peter 2:15

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all **unrighteousness**...All **unrighteousness** is sin: and there is a sin not unto death. 1 John 1:9; 5:17

## JUSTICE AND JUDGMENT

These are the generations of Noah: Noah was a **just** man and perfect in his generations, and Noah walked with God. Gen 6:9

Also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I **judge**: and afterward shall they come out with great substance. Genesis 15:14

Sarai said unto Abram, My wrong be upon you: I have given my maid into your bosom; and when she saw that she had conceived, I was despised in her eyes: the **LORD judge** between me and thee. Genesis 16:5

For I know him, that he will command his children and his household after him, and they shall keep the way of the **LORD**, to do **justice** and **judgment**; that the **LORD** may bring upon Abraham that which He has spoken of him. Genesis 18:19

That be far from You to do after this manner, to slay the righteous with the wicked: and that the righteous should be as the wicked, that be far from You: Shall not the **Judge** of all the earth do right? Genesis 18:25

They said, Stand back. And they said again, This one fellow came in to sojourn, and he will needs be a **judge**: now will we deal worse with you, than with them. And they pressed sore upon the man, even Lot, and came near to break the door. Genesis 19:9

Rachel said, God has **judged** me, and has also heard my voice, and has given me a son: therefore called she his name Dan. Genesis 30:6

Whereas you have searched all my stuff, what have you found of all your household stuff? Set it here before my brethren and your brethren, that they may **judge** between us both. Genesis 31:37

The God of Abraham, and the God of Nahor, the God of their father, **judge** betwixt us. And Jacob sware by the fear of his father Isaac. Genesis 31:53

Dan shall **judge** his people, as one of the tribes of Israel. Genesis 49:16

He said, Who made **you** a prince and a **judge** over us? Intend you to kill me, as you killed the Egyptian? And Moses feared, and said, Surely this thing is known. Exodus 2:14

They said unto them, The LORD look upon you, and **judge**; because you have made our savior to be abhorred in the eyes of Pharaoh, and in the eyes of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to slay us. Exodus 5:21

Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great **judgments**... Exodus 6:6

But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay My hand upon Egypt, and bring forth My armies, and My people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great **judgments**. Exodus 7:4

For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute **judgment**: I am the LORD [YeHoVaH] . Exodus 12:12

It came to pass on the morrow, that Moses sat to **judge** the people: and the people stood by Moses from the morning unto the evening...When they have a matter, they come unto me; and I **judge** between one and another, and I do make them know the statutes of God, and His laws...Let them **judge** the people at all seasons: and it shall be, that every great matter they shall bring unto you, but every small matter they shall **judge**: so shall it be easier for yourself, and they shall bear the burden with you...They **judged** the people at all seasons: the hard causes they brought unto Moses, but every small matter they **judged** themselves. Exodus 18:13, 16, 22, 26

Now these are the **judgments** which you shall set before them... Then his master shall bring him unto the **judges**; he shall also bring him to the door, or unto the door post; and his master shall bore his ear through with an awl; and he shall serve him for ever... Exodus 21:1

If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart from her, and yet no mischief follow; he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the **judges** determine...If an ox gore a man or a woman, that they die: then the ox shall be surely stoned, and his flesh shall not be eaten; but the owner of the ox shall be quit...Whether he have gored a son, or have gored a daughter, according to this **judgment** shall it be done unto him. Exodus 21: 6, 28, 31

If the thief be not found, then the master of the house shall be brought unto the **judges**, to see whether he have put his hand unto his neighbor's goods. For all manner of trespass, whether it be for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, or for any manner of lost thing, which another challenges to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the **judges**; and whom the **judges** shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbor. Exodus 22:8-9

You shall not follow a multitude to do evil; neither shall you speak in a cause to decline after many to wrest **judgment**... You shall not wrest the **judgment** of your poor in his cause. Keep far from a false matter; and the innocent and righteous slay you not: for I will not **justify** the wicked. Exodus 23:2, 6-7

Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the **judgments**: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD has said will we do. Exodus 24:3

You shall make the breastplate of **judgment** with cunning work; after the work of the ephod you shall make it; of gold, of blue, and of purple, and of scarlet, and of fine twined linen, shall you make it...Exodus 28: 15

And Aaron shall bear the names of the children of Israel in the breastplate of **judgment** upon his heart, when he goes in unto the holy place, for a memorial before the LORD continually. And you shall put in the breastplate of **judgment** the Urim and Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's heart, when he goes in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the **judgment** of the children of Israel upon his heart before the LORD continually. Exodus 28:29-30

You shall do My **judgments**, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I am the LORD your God. You shall therefore keep My statutes, and My **judgments**: which if a man do, he shall live in them: I am the LORD... You shall therefore keep My statutes and My **judgments**, and shall not commit any of these abominations; neither any of your own nation, nor any stranger that sojourns among you...Leviticus 18:4-5, 26

You shall do no unrighteousness in **judgment**: you shall not respect the person of the poor, nor honor the person of the mighty: but in righteousness shall you judge your neighbor... Leviticus 19:15

You shall do no unrighteousness in **judgment**, in meteyard, in weight, or in measure. **Just** balances, **just** weights, a **just** ephah, and a **just** hin, shall you have: I am the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt. Therefore shall you observe all My statutes, and all My **judgments**, and do them; and you shall dwell in the land in safety. Leviticus 19:35-37

You shall therefore keep all My statutes, and all My **judgments**, and do them: that the land, whither I bring you to dwell therein, spue you not out. Leviticus 20:22

Wherefore you shall do My statutes, and keep My **judgments**, and do them; and you shall dwell in the land in safety. Levi 25:18

...If you shall despise My statutes, or if your soul abhor My **judgments**, so that you will not do all My commandments, but that you break My covenant: I also will do this unto you; I will even appoint over you terror, consumption, and the burning ague, that shall consume the eyes, and cause sorrow of heart: and you shall sow your seed in vain, for your enemies shall eat it. And I will set My face against you, and you shall be slain before your enemies: they that hate you shall reign over you; and you shall flee when none pursues...The land also shall be left of them, and shall enjoy her sabbaths, while she lies desolate without them: and the shall accept of the punishment of their iniquity: because, even because they despised My **judgments**, and because their soul abhorred My statutes...These are the statutes and **judgments** and laws, which the LORD made between him and the children of Israel in Mount Sinai by the hand of Moses. Lev 26:15-17, 43, 48



Moses said unto the **judges** of Israel, Slay you every one his men that were joined unto Baal-peor. Numbers 25:5

If his father have no brethren, then you shall give his inheritance unto his kinsman that is next to him of his family, and he shall possess it: and it shall be unto the children of Israel a statute of **judgment**, as the LORD commanded Moses. Numbers 27:11

And the LORD said unto Moses, Take you Joshua the son of Nun, a man in whom is the spirit, and lay your hand upon him...And he shall stand before Eleazar the priest, who shall ask counsel for him after the **judgment** of Urim before the LORD: at his word shall they go out, and at his word they shall come in, both he, and all the children of Israel with him, even all the congregation. Numbers 27:18, 21

For the Egyptians buried all their firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD [YeHoVaH] executed **judgments**. Numbers 33:4

They shall be unto you cities for refuge from the avenger; that the manslayer die not, until he stand before the congregation in **judgment**...Then the congregation shall **judge** between the slayer and the revenger of blood according to these **judgments**...So these things shall be for a statute of **judgment** unto you throughout your generations in all your dwellings. Numbers 35:12, 24, 29

These are the commandments and the **judgments**, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel... Numbers 38:13

I charged your judges at that time, saying, Hear the causes between your brethren, and **judge** righteously between every man and his brother, and the stranger that is with him. You shall not respect persons in **judgment**; but you shall hear the small as well as the great; you shall not be afraid of the face of man; for the **judgment** is God's: and the cause that is too hard for you, bring it unto me, and I will hear it. **Judges** and officers shall you make for yourself in all your gates, which the LORD your God gives you, throughout your tribes: and they shall **judge** the people with **just judgment**. Deuteronomy 1:16-18

Now therefore hearken, O Israel, unto the statutes and unto the **judgments**, which I teach you, for to do them, that you may live, and go in and possess the land which the LORD God of your fathers gives you... Deuteronomy 4:1

Behold, I have taught you statutes and judgments, even as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should do so in the land whither you go to possess it...And what nation is there so great, that has statutes and **judgments** so righteous as all this law, which I set before you this day? ...And the LORD commanded me at that time to teach you statutes and **judgments**, that you might do them in the land whither you go over to possess it...These are the testimonies, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which Moses spoke unto the children of Israel, after they came out of Egypt... Deuteronomy 4:5, 8, 14, 45

And Moses called all Israel, and said unto them, Hear, O Israel, the statutes and **judgments** which I speak in your ears this day, that you may learn them, and keep, and do them...But as for you, stand you here by me, and I will speak unto you all the commandments, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which you shall teach them, that they may do them in the land which I give them to possess it. Deuteronomy 5:1, 31

Now these are the commandments, the statutes, and the **judgments**, which the LORD your God commanded to teach you, that you might do them in the land whither you go to possess it...And when your son asks you in time to come, saying, What mean the testimonies, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which the LORD our God has commanded you? Then you shall say... Deuteronomy 6:1, 20-21

You shall therefore keep the commandments, and the statutes, and the **judgments**, which I commanded you this day, to do them. Wherefore it shall come to pass, if you hearken to these **judgments**, and keep, and do them, that the LORD your God shall keep unto you the covenant and the mercy which He swore unto your fathers. Deuteronomy 7:11-12

Beware that you forget not the LORD your God, in not keeping His commandments, and His **judgments**, and His statutes, which I command you this day... Deuteronomy 8:11

He does execute the **judgment** of the fatherless and widow, and loves the stranger, in giving him food and raiment... Deuteronomy 10:18

Therefore you shall love the LORD your God, and keep His charge, and His statutes, and His **judgments**, and His commandments, always...You shall observe to do all the statutes and **judgments** which I set before you this day...These are the statutes and **judgments**, which you shall observe to do in the land, which the LORD God of your fathers gives you to possess it, all the days that you live upon the earth. Deut 11:1, 32, 12:1

**Judges** and officers shall you make you in all your gates, which the LORD your God gives you, throughout your tribes: and they shall **judge** the people with **just judgment**. You shall not wrest **judgment**; you shall not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift blinds the eyes of the wise, and perverts the words of the righteous. That which is altogether **just** shall you follow, that you may live, and inherit the land which the LORD [YeHoVaH] your God gives you. Deuteronomy 16:18-20

If there arise a matter too hard for you in **judgment**, between blood and blood, between plea and plea, and between stroke and stroke, being matters of controversy within your gates: then shall you arise, and get up into the place which the LORD your God shall choose; And you shall come unto the priests the Levites, and unto the **judge** that shall be in those days, and enquire; and they shall show you the sentence of **judgment**. And you shall do according to the sentence of the law which they shall teach you, and according to the **judgment** which they shall tell you, you shall do: you shall not decline from the sentence which they shall show you, to the right hand, nor to the left. And the man that will do presumptuously, and will not hearken unto the priest that stands to minister there before the LORD your God, or unto the **judge**, even that man shall die: and you shall put away the evil from Israel. Deuteronomy 17:8-12

I command you this day to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments and His statutes and His **judgments**, that you may live and multiply: and the LORD your God shall bless you in the land....Deut 30:16

He is the Rock, His work is perfect: for all His ways are **judgment**: a God of truth and without iniquity, **just** and right is He. Deuteronomy 32:4

For their rock is not as our Rock, even our enemies themselves being **judges**. Deuteronomy 32:31

For the LORD shall **judge** His people, and repent Himself for His servants, when He sees that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left. Deuteronomy 32:36

If I whet my glittering sword, and My hand take hold on **judgment**; I will render vengeance to Mine enemies, and will reward them that hate Me. Deuteronomy 32:41

They shall teach Jacob your **judgments**, and Israel Your law: they shall put incense before You, and whole burnt sacrifice upon Your altar. Deuteronomy 33:10

If a false witness rise up against any man to testify against him that which is wrong; Then both the men, between whom the controversy is, shall stand before the LORD [YeHoVaH], before the priests and the **judges**, which shall be in those days; And the **judges** shall make diligent inquisition: and, behold, if the witness be a false witness, and has testified falsely against his brother; Then shall you do unto him, as he had thought to have done unto his brother: so shall you put the evil away from among you. And those which remain shall hear, and fear, and shall henceforth commit no more any such evil among you. And your eye shall not pity; but life shall go for life, eye for eye, tooth for tooth, hand for hand, foot for foot. Deut 19:17-21

If one be found in the land which the LORD your God gives you to possess it, lying in the field, and it be not known who has slain him: Then your elders and your **judges** shall come forth, and they shall measure to the cities which are round about him that is slain...And all the elders of that city...Shall answer and say, Our hands have not shed this blood, neither have our eyes seen it. Deuteronomy 21:1-2, 6-7

You shall not pervert the **judgment** of the stranger, nor of the fatherless; nor take a widow's raiment to pledge... Deut 24:17

If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto **judgment**, that the **judges** may **judge** them; then they shall **justify** the righteous, and condemn the wicked. And it shall be, if the wicked man be worthy to be beaten, that the **judge** shall cause him to lie down, and to be beaten before his face, according to his fault, by a certain number. Deuteronomy 25:1-2

You shall have a perfect and **just** weight, a perfect and **just** measure shall you have: that your days may be lengthened in the land which the LORD your God gives you. Deut 25:15

This day the LORD your God has commanded you to do these statutes and **judgments**: you shall therefore keep and do them with all your heart, and with all your soul. You have avouched the LORD this day to be your God, and to walk in His ways, and to keep His statutes, and His commandments, and His **judgments**, and to hearken unto His voice. Deut 26:16-17

Cursed be he that perverts the **judgment** of the stranger, fatherless, and widow. And all the people shall say, Amen. Deut 27:19

He provided the first part for himself, because there, in a portion of the lawgiver, was he seated; and he came with the heads of the people, he executed the **justice of the LORD, and his judgments** with Israel. Deuteronomy 33:21

All Israel, and their elders, and officers, and their **judges**, stood on this side the ark and on that side before the priests the Levites, which bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD, as well the stranger, as he that was born among them; half of them over against Mount Gerizim, and half of them over against Mount Ebal; as Moses the servant of the LORD had commanded before, that they should bless the people of Israel. Joshua 8:33

He shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for **judgment**, and until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days: then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house, unto the city from where he fled. Joshua 20:6

Joshua called for all Israel, and for their elders, and for their heads, and for their **judges**, and for their officers, and said unto them, I am old and stricken in age... Joshua 23:2

Nevertheless the LORD raised up **judges**, which delivered them out of the hand of those that spoiled them. And they would not hearken unto their **judges**, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; but they did not so. When the LORD raised them up **judges**, then the LORD was with the **judge**, and delivered them out of the hand of their enemies all the days of the **judge**: for it repented the LORD because of their groanings by reason of them that oppressed them and vexed them. And it came to pass, when the **judge** was dead, that they returned, and corrupted themselves more than their fathers, in following other gods to serve them, and to bow down unto them, they ceased not from their own doings, nor from their stubborn way. Judges 2:16-19

The Spirit of the LORD came upon him, and he **judged** Israel, and went out to war: and the LORD delivered Chushan-rishathaim king of Mesopotamia into his hand; and his hand prevailed against Chushan-rishathaim. Judges 3:10

Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, **judged** Israel at that time. She dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Beth-el in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for **judgment**. Judges 4:4-5

Speak, you that ride on white asses, you that sit in **judgment**, and walk by the way. Judges 5:10

Wherefore I have not sinned against you, but you do me wrong to war against me: the LORD the **Judge** be **judge** this day between the children of Israel and the children of Ammon. Judges 11:27

Samson...He **judged** Israel in the days of the Philistines twenty years. Judges 15:20

It came to pass in the days when the **judges** ruled, that there was a famine in the land. And a certain man of Beth-lehem-judah went to sojourn in the country of Moab, he, and his wife, and his two sons. Ruth 1:1



The adversaries of the LORD shall be broken to pieces; out of heaven shall he thunder upon them: the LORD shall **judge** the ends of the earth; and He shall give strength unto His king, and exalt the horn of His anointed. 1 Samuel 2:10

If one man sin against another, the **judge** shall **judge** him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall intreat for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them. 1 Samuel 2:25

For I have told him that I will **judge** his house for ever for the iniquity which he knows; because his sons made themselves vile, and he restrained them not. 1 Samuel 3:13

It came to pass, when he made mention of the ark of God, that he fell off the seat backward by the side of the gate, and his neck brake, and he died: for he was an old man, and heavy. And he **judged** Israel forty years. 1 Samuel 4:18

They gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured it out before the LORD, and fasted on that day, and said there, We have sinned against the LORD. And Samuel **judged** the children of Israel in Mizpeh...Samuel **judged** Israel all the days of his life. He went from year to year in circuit to Beth-el, and Gilgal, and Mizpeh, and **judged** Israel in all those places. And his return was to Ramah; for there was his house; and there he **judged** Israel; and there he built an altar unto the LORD [YeHoVaH]. 1 Samuel 7:6, 15-17

It came to pass, when Samuel was old, that he made his sons **judges** over Israel. Now the name of his firstborn was Joel; and the name of his second, Abiah; they were **judges** in Beer-sheba. His sons walked not in his ways, but turned aside after lucre, and took bribes, and perverted **judgment**. Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah, And said unto him, Behold, you are old, and your sons walk not in your ways: now make us a king to **judge** us like all the nations. But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to **judge** us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD... That we also may be like all the nations; and that our king may **judge** us, and go out before us, and fight our battles. 1 Sam 8:1-6,



As since the time that I commanded **judges** to be over my people Israel, and have caused you to rest from all your enemies. Also the LORD tells you that He will make you an house. 2 Sam 7:11

Absalom said moreover, Oh that I were made **judge** in the land, that every man which has any suit or cause might come unto me, and I would do him **justice**! ...And on this manner did Absalom to all Israel that came to the king for **judgment**: so Absalom stole the hearts of the men of Israel. 2 Samuel 15:4, 6

David reigned over all Israel; and David executed **judgment** and **justice** unto all his people. 2 Samuel 8:15

For all His **judgments** were before me: and as for His statutes, I did not depart from them. 2 Samuel 22:23

The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that rules over men must be **just**, ruling in the fear of God. 2 Sam 23:3

Keep the charge of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, to keep His statutes, and His commandments, and His **judgments**, and His testimonies, as it is written in the law of Moses, that you may prosper in all that you do, and whithersoever you turn yourself. 1 Kings 2:3

Give therefore your servant an understanding heart to **judge** Your people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge so great a people? 1 Kings 3:9

God said unto him, Because you have asked this thing, and have not asked for yourself long life; neither have asked riches for yourself, nor have asked the life of your enemies; but have asked for yourself understanding to discern **judgment**; Behold, I have done according to your words... 1 Kings 3:11-12

All Israel heard of the **judgment** which the king had judged; and they feared the king: for they saw that the wisdom of God was in him, to do **judgments**. 1 Kings 3:28

Concerning this house which you are building, if you will walk in My statutes, and execute My **judgments**, and keep all My commandments to walk in them; then will I perform My word with you, which I spoke unto David your father... 1 Kings 6:12

Then he made a porch for the throne where he might **judge**, even the porch of **judgment**: and it was covered with cedar from one side of the floor to the other. 1 Kings 7:7

If any man trespass against his neighbor, and an oath be laid upon him to cause him to swear, and the oath come before Your altar in this house: Then hear in heaven, and do, and **judge** Your servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and **justifying** the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness. 1 Kings 8:31-32

The LORD our God be with us, as He was with our fathers: let Him not leave us, nor forsake us: That He may incline our hearts unto Him, to walk in all His ways, and to keep His commandments, and His statutes, and His **judgments**, which He commanded our fathers. 1 Kings 8:57-58

If you walk before Me, as David your father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded you, and will keep My statutes and My **judgments**: Then I will establish the throne of your kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David your father, saying, there shall not fail you a man upon the throne of Israel. 1 Kings 9:4-5

Blessed be the LORD your God, which delighted in you, to set you on the throne of Israel: because the LORD loved Israel for ever, therefore He made you king, to do **judgment** and **justice**. 1 Kings 10:9

Because they have forsaken Me, and have worshiped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in My ways, to do that which is right in My eyes, and to keep My statutes and My **judgments**, as did David his father... I will take the kingdom out of his son's hand... 1 Kings 11:33, 35

The LORD smote the king, so that he was a leper unto the day of his death... And Jotham the king's son was over the house, **judging** the people of the land. 2 Kings 15:5

Surely there was not held such a passover from the days of the **judges** that **judged** Israel... 2 Kings 23:22

Remember His marvelous works that He has done, His wonders, and the **judgments** of His mouth; O you seed of Israel His servant, you children of Jacob, His chosen ones. He is the LORD our God; His **judgments** are in all the earth. 1 Chronicles 16:12-14

Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof: let the fields rejoice, and all that is therein. Then shall the trees of the wood sing out at the presence of the LORD, because He comes to **judge** the earth. 1 Chronicles 16:33

Wheresoever I have walked with all Israel, spake I a word to any of the **judges** of Israel, whom I commanded to feed My people, saying, Why have you not built me a house of cedars...And since the time that I commanded **judges** to be over My people Israel. Moreover I will subdue all your enemies. Furthermore I tell you that the LORD will build you an house. 1 Chronicles 17:6, 10

Then shall you prosper, if you take heed to fulfil the statutes and **judgments** which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed. 1 Chronicles 22:13

Now the Levites were numbered from the age of thirty years and upward: and their number by their polls, man by man, was thirty and eight thousand. Of which, twenty and four thousand were to set forward the work of the house of the LORD; and six thousand were officers and **judges**...Of the Isharites, Chenaniah and his sons were for the outward business over Israel, for officers and **judges**. 1 Chronicles 23:3-5, 26:29

Moreover I will establish his kingdom for ever, if he be constant to do My commandments and My **judgments**, as at this day. 1 Chronicles 28:7

Then Solomon spoke unto all Israel, to the captains of thousands and of hundreds, and to the **judges**, and to every governor in all Israel, the chief of the fathers. 2 Chronicles 1:2

Give me now wisdom and knowledge, that I may go out and come in before this people: for who can **judge** this Your people, that is so great? And God said to Solomon, Because this was in your heart, and you have not asked riches, wealth, or honor, nor the life of your enemies, neither yet have asked long life; but have asked wisdom and knowledge for yourself, that you may **judge** My people, over whom I have made you king. 2 Chronicles 1:11

If a man sin against his neighbor, and an oath be laid upon him to make him swear, and the oath come before your altar in this house; Then hear from heaven, and do, and **judge** Your servants, by requiting the wicked, by recompensing his way upon his own head; and by **justifying** the righteous, by giving him according to his righteousness. 2 Chronicles 6:22-23

As for you, if you will walk before Me, as David your father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded you, and shall observe My statutes and My **judgments**; Then will I stablish the throne of your kingdom, according as I have covenanted with David your father, saying, There shall not fail you a man to be ruler in Israel. 2 Chronicles 7:17

He set **judges** in the land throughout all the fenced cities of Judah, city by city, And said to the **judges**, Take heed what you do: for you **judge** not for man, but for the LORD, who is with you in the **judgment**. Wherefore now let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take heed and do it: for there is no iniquity with the LORD our God, nor respect of persons, nor taking of gifts. 2 Chr 19:5-6

Moreover in Jerusalem did Jehoshaphat set of the Levites, and of the priests, and of the chief of the fathers of Israel, for the **judgment** of the LORD, and for controversies, when they returned to Jerusalem. And he charged them, saying, Thus shall you do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a perfect heart. What cause soever shall come to you of your brethren that dwell in their cities, between blood and blood, between law and commandment, statutes and **judgments**, you shall even warn them that they trespass not against the LORD, and so wrath come upon you, and upon your brethren: this do, and you shall not trespass. 2 Chronicles 19:8-10

If, when evil comes upon us, as the sword, **judgment**, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in Your presence, (for Your name is in this house,) and cry unto You in our affliction, then You will hear and help. 2 Chronicles 20:9

O our God, will You not **judge** them? For we have no might against this great company that comes against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon You. 2 Chronicles 20:12

It came to pass, that, when Jehu was executing **judgment** upon the house of Ahab, and found the princes of Judah, and the sons of the brethren of Ahaziah, that ministered to Ahaziah, he slew them. 2 Chronicles 22:8

For the army of the Syrians came with a small company of men, and the LORD delivered a very great host into their hand, because they had forsaken the LORD God of their fathers. So they executed **judgment** against Joash. 2 Chronicles 24:24

Uzziah the king was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house, being a leper; for he was cut off from the house of the LORD: and Jotham his son was over the king's house, **judging** the people of the land. 2 Chronicles 26:21

For Ezra had prepared his heart to seek the law of the LORD, and to do it, and to teach in Israel statutes and **judgments**...And you, Ezra, after the wisdom of your God, that is in your hand, set magistrates and **judges**, which may **judge** all the people that are beyond the river, all such as know the laws of God; and teach them that know them not. Whosoever will not do the law of your God, and the law of the king, let **judgment** be executed speedily upon him, whether it be unto death, or to banishment, or to confiscation of goods, or to imprisonment. Ezra 7:10, 25-26

Let now our rulers of all the congregation stand, and let all them which have taken strange wives in our cities come at appointed times, and with them the elders of every city, and the **judges** thereof, until the fierce wrath of our God for this matter be turned from us. Ezra 10:14

We have dealt very corruptly against you, and have not kept the commandments, nor the statutes, nor the **judgments**, which You commanded Your servant Moses. Nehemiah 1:7

You came down also upon mount Sinai, and spoke with them from heaven, and gave them right **judgments**, and true laws, good statutes and commandments...And testified against them, that You might bring them again unto Your law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto Your commandments, but sinned against Your **judgments**, (which if a man do, he shall live in them;) and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear. Nehemiah 9:13, 29

Howbeit you are **just** in all that is brought upon us; for you have done right, but we have done wickedly: Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept your law, nor hearkened unto Your commandments and Your testimonies, wherewith You did testify against them. Nehemiah 9:33-34

They clave to their brethren, their nobles, and entered into a curse, and into an oath, to walk in God's law, which was given by Moses the servant of God, and to observe and do all the commandments of the LORD our Lord, and His **judgments** and His statutes... Nehemiah 10:29

Then the king said to the wise men, which knew the times, (for so was the king's manner toward all that knew law and **judgment**... What shall we do...? Esther 1:13, 14

Shall mortal man be more **just** than God? shall a man be more pure than his maker?...Does God pervert **judgment**? Or does the Almighty pervert **justice**? Job 4:17, 8:3

Whom, though I were righteous, yet would I not answer, but I would make supplication to my **judge**. Job 9:15

If I **justify** myself, my own mouth shall condemn me: if I say, I am perfect, it shall also prove me perverse. Job 9:20

The earth is given into the hand of the wicked: he covers the faces of the **judges** thereof; if not, where, and who is he? Job 9:24

Should not the multitude of words be answered? And should a man full of talk be **justified**? Job 11:2

He leads counselors away spoiled, and makes the **judges** fools. Job 12:17

Behold now, I have ordered my cause; I know that I shall be **justified**. Job 13:18

Be you afraid of the sword: for wrath brings the punishments of the sword, that you may know there is a **judgment**. Job 19:29

Shall any teach God knowledge? Seeing He **judges** those that are high? Job 21:22

And you say, How does God know? Can He **judge** through the dark cloud? Job 22:13

There the righteous might dispute with Him; so should I be delivered for ever from my **judge**. Job 23:7

How then can man be **justified** with God? Or how can he be clean that is born of a woman? Job 25:4

God forbid that I should **justify** you: till I die I will not remove my integrity from me. Job 27:5

I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my **judgment** was as a robe and a diadem. Job 29:14

For this is an heinous crime; yes, it is an iniquity to be punished by the **judges**. Job 31:11

This also was an iniquity to be punished by the **judge**: for I should have denied the God that is above. Job 31:28

Then was kindled the wrath of Elihu the son of Barachel the Buzite, of the kindred of Ram: against Job was his wrath kindled, because he **justified** himself rather than God... Great men are not always wise: neither do the aged understand **judgment**. Job 32:2, 9

If you have any thing to say, answer me: speak, for I desire to **justify** you. Job 33:32

Yes, surely God will not do wickedly, neither will the Almighty pervert **judgment**... For He will not lay upon man more than right; that he should enter into **judgment** with God. Job 34:12, 23

Although you say you shall not see Him, yet **judgment** is before Him; therefore trust you in Him. Job 35:14



But you have fulfilled the **judgment** of the wicked: **judgment and justice** take hold on you...For by them **judges** He the people; He gives meat in abundance. Job 36:17, 31

Touching the Almighty, we cannot find Him out: He is excellent in power, and **in judgment**, and in plenty of **justice**: He will not afflict. Job 37:23

Will you also disannul my **judgment**? Will you condemn Me, that you may be righteous? Job 40:8

Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the **judgment**, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. Psalm 1:5

Be wise now therefore, O you kings: be instructed, you **judges** of the earth. Psalm 2:10

Arise, O LORD, in Your anger, lift up Yourself because of the rage of my enemies: awake for me to the **judgment** that You have commanded...The LORD shall **judge** the people: **judge** me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity that is in me. Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the **just**: for the righteous God tries the hearts and reins...God **judges** the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day. Psalm 7:6, 8-9, 11

For You have maintained my right and my cause; You sat in the throne **judging** right...The LORD shall endure for ever: He has prepared His throne for **judgment**. And He shall **judge** the world in righteousness, He shall minister **judgment** to the people in uprightness...The LORD is known by the **judgment** which He executes the wicked is snared in the work of His own hands. Higgaion. Selah. Psalm 9:4, 7-8

Arise, O LORD; let not man prevail: let the heathen be **judged** in Your sight. Psalm 9:19

His ways are always grievous; Your **judgments** are far above out of His sight: as for all His enemies, He puffs at them. Psalm 10:5

To **judge** the fatherless and the oppressed, that the man of the earth may no more oppress. Psalm 10:18

For all His **judgments** were before me, and I did not put away His statutes from me. Psalm 18:22

The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the **judgments** of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. Psalm 19:9

The meek will He guide in **judgment**: and the meek will He teach His way. Psalm 25:9

**Judge** me, O LORD; for I have walked in my integrity: I have also trusted in the LORD; therefore I shall not slide. Psalm 28:1

The king that faithfully **judges** the poor, His throne shall be established for ever. Proverbs 29:14

He loves righteousness and **judgment**: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD. Psalm 33:5

**Judge** me, O LORD my God, according to Your righteousness; and let them not rejoice over me...Your righteousness is like the great mountains; Your **judgments** are a great deep: O LORD, You preserve man and beast. Psalm 35:24, 36:6

He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your **judgment** as the noonday...The wicked plots against the **just**, and gnashes upon him with his teeth...For the LORD loves **judgment**, and forsakes not His saints; they are preserved for ever: but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off... The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, and his tongue talks of **judgment**...The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is **judged**. Psalm 37:6, 12, 28, 30, 33

**Judge** me, O God, and plead my cause against an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man. Psalm 43:1

Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of Your **judgments**. Psalm 48:11

He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that He may **judge** His people. Gather My saints together unto Me; those that have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice. And the heavens shall declare His righteousness: for God is **judge** Himself. Selah. Psalm 50:4-6

Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight: that You might be **justified** when You speak, and be clear when You **judge**. Psalm 51:4

Save me, O God, by Your name, and **judge** me by Your strength. Psalm 54:1

Do you indeed speak righteousness, O congregation? Do you **judge** uprightly, O you sons of men? The righteous shall rejoice when he sees the vengeance: he shall wash his feet in the blood of the wicked. So that a man shall say, Verily there is a reward for the righteous: verily He is a God that **judges** in the earth. Psalm 58:1, 10-11

O let the nations be glad and sing for joy: for You shall **judge** the people righteously, and govern the nations upon the earth. Selah...A father of the fatherless, and a **judge** of the widows, is God in His holy habitation. Psalm 67:4, 68:5

Give the king Your **judgments**, O God, and Your righteousness unto the king's son. He shall **judge** Your people with righteousness, and Your poor with **judgment**. The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness. He shall **judge** the poor of the people, He shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. Psalm 72:1-4

When I shall receive the congregation I will **judge** uprightly... But God is the **judge**: He puts down one, and sets up another. Psalm 75:2, 7

You did cause **judgment** to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still, When God arose to **judgment**, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah. Psalm 76:8-9

God stands in the congregation of the mighty; He **judges** among the gods. How long will You **judge** unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah. Defend the poor and fatherless: do **justice** to the afflicted and needy...Arise, O God, **judge** the earth: for You shall inherit all nations. Psalm 82:1-3

**Justice and judgment** are the habitation of Your throne: mercy and truth shall go before Your face. Psalm 89:14

If his children forsake My law, and walk not in My **judgment**;  
If they break My statutes, and keep not My commandments;  
Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity  
with stripes. Psalm 89:30-32

Lift up Yourself, You **judge** of the earth: render a reward  
to the proud...But **judgment** shall return unto righteousness:  
and all the upright in heart shall follow it. Psalm 94:2, 15

O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before Him,  
all the earth. Say among the heathen that the LORD reigns:  
the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved:  
He shall **judge** the people righteously. Let the heavens rejoice,  
and let the earth be glad; let the seas roar, and the fulness thereof.  
Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees  
of the wood rejoice. Before the LORD: for He comes, for He  
comes to **judge** the earth: He shall **judge** the world  
with righteousness, and the people with His truth. Psalm 96:9-13

Clouds and darkness are round about Him: righteousness  
and **judgment** are the habitation of His throne. Psalm 97:2

Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced  
because of Your **judgments**, O LORD. Psalm 97:8

Let the floods clap their hands: let the hills be joyful together  
before the LORD; for He comes to **judge** the earth:  
with righteousness shall He **judge** the world, and the people  
with equity. Psalm 98:8-9

The king's strength also loves **judgment**; You do establish equity,  
You execute **judgment** and righteousness in Jacob. Psalm 99:4

I will sing of mercy and **judgment**: unto You, O LORD,  
will I sing. Psalm 101:1

The LORD executes righteousness and **judgment**  
for all that are oppressed. Psalm 103:6

Remember His marvelous works that He has done; His wonders,  
and the **judgments** of His mouth; O you seed of Abraham  
His servant, you children of Jacob His chosen. He is the LORD  
our God: His **judgments** are in all the earth. Psalm 105:5-7

Then stood up Phinehas, and executed **judgment**: and so the plague was stayed. Psalm 106:30

When he shall be **judged**, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin. Psalm 109:7

He shall **judge** among the heathen, He shall fill the places with the dead bodies; He shall wound the heads over many countries. Psalm 110:6

The works of His hands are verity and **judgment**; all His commandments are sure. Psalm 111:7

I will praise You with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned Your righteous **judgments**... With my lips have I declared all the **judgments** of Your mouth... My soul breaks for the longing that it has unto Your **judgments** at all times... I have chosen the way of truth: Your **judgments** have I laid before me... Turn away my reproach which I fear: for Your **judgments** are good... Take not the word of truth utterly out of my mouth; for I have hoped in Your **judgments**... I remembered Your **judgments** of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself... At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto You because of Your righteous **judgments**... Teach me good **judgment** and knowledge: for I have believed Your commandments... I know, O LORD, that Your **judgments** are right, and that You in faithfulness have afflicted me... How many are the days of Your servant? When will You execute **judgment** on them that persecute me? Psalm 119:7, 13, 20, 30, 39, 43, 52, 62, 66, 75, 84

I have not departed from Your **judgments**: for You have taught me... I have sworn, and I will perform it, that I will keep Your righteous **judgments**... Accept, I beseech You, the freewill offerings of my mouth, O LORD, and teach me Your **judgments**... My flesh trembles for fear of You; and I am afraid of Your **judgments**. I have done **judgment and justice**: leave me not to mine oppressors. Psalm 119:102, 106, 108, 120-121

Righteous are You, O LORD, and upright are Your **judgments**... Hear my voice according unto Your lovingkindness: O LORD, quicken me according to Your **judgment**... Psalm 119:137, 149

Great are Your tender mercies, O LORD: quicken me according to Your **judgments**...Your word is true from the beginning: and every one of Your righteous **judgments** endures for ever... Psalm 119:156, 160

Seven times a day do I praise You because of Your righteous **judgments**...Let my soul live, and it shall praise You; and let Your **judgments** help me. Psalm 119:164, 175

For there are set thrones of **judgment**, the thrones of the house of David. Psalm 122:5

For the LORD will **judge** His people, and He will repent Himself concerning His servants. Psalm 135:14

When their **judges** are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear My words; for they are sweet. Psalm 141:6

Enter not into **judgment** with Your servant: for in Your sight shall no man living be **justified**. Psalm 143:2

Happy is the man that has the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God: Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein is: which keeps truth for ever: Which executes **judgment** for the oppressed: which gives food to the hungry. The LORD looses the prisoners: The LORD opens the eyes of the blind: the LORD raises them that are bowed down: the LORD loves the righteous: the LORD preserves the strangers; He relieves the fatherless and widow: but the way of the wicked He turns upside down. Psalm 146:5-9

He shows His word unto Jacob, His statutes and His **judgments** unto Israel. He has not dealt so with any nation: and as for His **judgments**, they have not known them. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 147:19-20

Praise the LORD...Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all **judges** of the earth: Both young men, and maidens; old men, and children: Let them praise the name of the LORD: for His name alone is excellent; His glory is above the earth and heaven. Psalm 148:7, 11-13

Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds. Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edge sword in their hand; To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people: To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron: To execute upon them the **judgment** written: this honor have all His saints. Praise you the LORD. Psalm 149:5-9

The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel: To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; To receive the instruction of wisdom, **justice, and judgment**, and equity; To give subtilty to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. Proverbs 1:1-4

The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but He blesses the habitation of the **just**. Proverbs 3:33

The path of the **just** is as the shining light, that shines more and more unto the perfect day. Proverbs 4:18

Wisdom...By me kings reign, and princes decree **justice**. By me princes rule, and nobles, even all the **judges** of the earth. Proverbs 8:15-16

Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a **just** man, and he will increase in learning. Proverbs 9:9

Blessings are upon the head of the **just**: but violence covers the mouth of the wicked. The memory of the **just** is blessed: but the name of the wicked shall rot...The tongue of the **just** is as choice silver: the heart of the wicked is little worth... The mouth of the **just** brings forth wisdom: but the froward tongue shall be cut out. Proverbs 10:31

A false balance is abomination to the LORD: but a **just** weight is His delight. Proverbs 11:1

An hypocrite with his mouth destroys his neighbor: but through knowledge shall the **just** be delivered. Proverbs 11:9

The wicked is snared by the transgression of the lips: but the **just** shall come out of trouble...There shall no evil happen to the **just**: but the wicked shall be filled with mischief. Proverbs 12:21



A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the **just**. Proverbs 13:22

A **just** weight and balance are of the LORD'S: all the weights of the bag are His work. Proverbs 16:11

He that **justifies** the wicked, and he that condemns the **just**, even they both are abomination to the LORD. Proverbs 17:15

Also to punish the **just** is not good, nor to strike princes for equity. Proverbs 17:26

It is not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the righteous in **judgment**. Proverbs 18:5

He that is first in his own cause seems **just**; but his neighbor comes and searches him. Proverbs 18:17

An ungodly witness scorns **judgment**: and the mouth of the wicked devours iniquity. **Judgments** are prepared for scorners, and stripes for the back of fools. Proverbs 19:28-29

The **just** man walks in his integrity: his children are blessed after him. Proverbs 20:7

To do **justice and judgment** is more acceptable to the LORD than sacrifice...It is joy to the **just** to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 21:3, 15

For a **just** man falls seven times, and rises up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief...These things also belong to the wise. It is not good to have respect of persons in **judgment**. Proverbs 24:16, 23

They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them. Evil men understand not **judgment**: but they that seek the LORD understand all things. Pro 28:4-5

The blood thirsty hate the upright: but the **just** seek his soul... An unjust man is an abomination to the **just**: and he that is upright in the way is abomination to the wicked. Proverbs 29:10, 27

Open your mouth, **judge** righteously, and plead the cause of the poor and needy. Proverbs 31:9

I said in my heart, God shall **judge** the righteous and the wicked: for there is a time there for every purpose and for every work. Ecclesiastes 3:17

If you see the oppression of the poor, and violent perverting of **judgment and justice** in a province, marvel not at the matter: for He that is higher than the highest regards; and there be higher than they. Ecclesiastes 5:8

All things have I seen in the days of my vanity: there is a **just** man that perishes in his righteousness, and there is a wicked man that prolongs his life in his wickedness...For there is not a **just** man upon earth, that does good, and sins not. Ecclesiastes 7:15, 20

There is a vanity which is done upon the earth; that there be **just** men, unto whom it happens according to the work of the wicked; again, there be wicked men, to whom it happens according to the work of the righteous: I said that this also is vanity. Eccl 8:14

Rejoice, O young man, in your youth; and let your heart cheer you in the days of your youth, and walk in the ways of your heart, and in the sight of your eyes: but know you, that for all these things God will bring you into **judgment**...For God shall bring every work into **judgment**, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil. Ecclesiastes 11:9, 12:14

Learn to do well; seek **judgment**, relieve the oppressed, **judge** the fatherless, plead for the widow...How is the faithful city become an harlot! It was full of **judgment**; righteousness lodged in it; but now murderers. Your silver is become dross, your wine mixed with water: Your princes are rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loves gifts, and follows after rewards: they **judge** not the fatherless, neither does the cause of the widow come unto them...And I will restore your **judges** as at the first, and your counselors as at the beginning: afterward you shall be called, The city of righteousness, the faithful city. Zion shall be redeemed with **judgment**, and her converts with righteousness. Isaiah 1:17, 21-23, 26-27

Behold...the LORD of hosts, takes away from Jerusalem ...The mighty man, and the man of war, the **judge**, and the prophet, and the prudent, and the ancient. Isaiah 3:1-2

The LORD stands up to plead, and stands to judge the people. The LORD will enter into **judgment** with the ancients of His people, and the princes thereof: for you have eaten up the vineyard; the spoil of the poor is in your houses...It shall come to pass that he that is left in Zion, and he that remains in Jerusalem shall be called holy, even every one that is written among the living in Jerusalem: When the Lord shall have washed away the filth of the daughters of Zion, and shall have purged the blood of Jerusalem from the midst thereof by the spirit of **judgment**, and by the spirit of burning. Isaiah 3:13-14, 4:4

Now, O inhabitants of Jerusalem, and men of Judah, **judge**, I pray you, between Me and My vineyard...I will lay it waste: it shall not be pruned, nor dug; but there shall come up briers and thorns: I will also command the clouds that they rain no rain upon it. For the vineyard of the LORD of hosts is the house of Israel, and the men of Judah His pleasant plant: and He looked for **judgment**, but behold oppression; for righteousness, but behold a cry. Isaiah 5:3, 6-7

The mean man shall be brought down, and the mighty man shall be humbled, and the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled: But the LORD of hosts shall be exalted in **judgment**, and God that is holy shall be sanctified in righteousness. Isaiah 5:15-16

Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink: which **justify** the wicked for reward, and take away the righteousness of the righteous from him! Isaiah 5:23

Of the increase of His government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon His kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with **judgment** and with **justice** from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this. Isaiah 9:7

Woe unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, and that write grievousness which they have prescribed; To turn aside the needy from **judgment**, and to take away the right from the poor of My people, that widows may be their prey, and that they may rob the fatherless! Isaiah 10:2

There shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of His roots: And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD; And shall make Him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and He shall not **judge** after the sight of His eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of His ears: But with righteousness shall He **judge** the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth, and with the breath of His lips shall He slay the wicked. And righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and faithfulness the girdles of His reins. Isaiah 5:1-5

Take counsel, execute **judgment**; make your shadow as the night in the midst of the noonday; hide the outcasts; bewray not him that wanders. Let outcasts dwell with you, Moab; you be a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceases, the oppressors are consumed out of the land. And in mercy shall the throne be established: and He shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, **judging**, and seeking **judgment**, and hasting righteousness. Isaiah 16:3-5

The way of the **just** is uprightness: You, most upright, do weigh the path of the **just**. Yes, in the way of Your **judgments**, O LORD, have we waited for You; the desire of our soul is to Your name, and to the remembrance of You. With my soul have I desired You in the night; yes, with my spirit within me will I seek You early: for when Your **judgments** are in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness. Isaiah 26:7-9

In that day shall the LORD of hosts be for a crown of glory, and for a diadem of beauty, unto the residue of His people, And for a spirit of **judgment** to him that sits in **judgment**, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate. But they also have erred through wine, and through strong drink are out of the way; the priest and the prophet have erred through strong drink, they are swallowed up of wine, they are out of the way through strong drink; they err in vision, they stumble in **judgment** ...**Judgment** also will I lay to the line, and righteousness to the plummet: and the hail shall sweep away the refuge of lies, and the waters shall overflow the hiding place. Isaiah 28:5-7

For the terrible one is brought to nought, and the scorner is consumed, and all that watch for iniquity are cut off: That make a man an offender for a word, and lay a snare for him that reproveth in the gate, and turn aside the **just** for a thing of nought. Isaiah 29:20-21

Therefore will the LORD wait, that He may be gracious unto you, and therefore will He be exalted, that He may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of **judgment**: blessed are all they that wait for Him. Isaiah 30:18

Behold, a king shall reign in righteousness, and princes shall rule in **judgment**. And a man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; as rivers of water in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. Isaiah 32:1-2

Until the spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest. Then **judgment** shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness quietness and assurance for ever. Isaiah 32:15-17

The LORD is exalted; for He dwells on high: He has filled Zion with **judgment** and righteousness. Isaiah 33:5

For the LORD [YeHoVaH] is our **judge**, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; He will save us. Isaiah 33:22

For My sword shall be bathed in heaven; behold, it shall come down upon Idumea, and upon the people of My curse, to **judgment**. Isaiah 34:5

With whom took He counsel, and who instructed Him, and taught Him in the path of **judgment**, and taught Him knowledge, and showed to Him the way of understanding? Isaiah 40:14

It is He that sits upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretches out the heavens as a curtain, and spreads them out as a tent to dwell in: that brings the princes to nothing; He makes the **judges** of the earth as vanity. Isaiah 40:22-23

Why do you say, O Jacob, and speak, O Israel, My way is hid from the LORD, and My **judgment** is passed over from my God? Isaiah 40:27

Keep silence before Me, O islands; and let the people renew their strength: let them come near; then let them speak: let us come near together to **judgment**. Isaiah 41:1

Behold, My servant, whom I uphold; My elect, in whom My soul delights; I have put My spirit upon Him: He shall bring forth **judgment** to the Gentiles. A bruised reed shall He not break, and the smoking flax shall He not quench: He shall bring forth **judgment** unto truth. He shall not fail nor be discouraged, till He have set **judgment** in the earth: and the isles shall wait for His law. Isaiah 42:1-4

Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? Let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be **justified**: or let them hear, and say, It is truth... Put Me in remembrance: let us plead together: declare you, that you may be **justified**. Isaiah 43:9, 26

Tell you, and bring them near; yes, let them take counsel together: who has declared this from ancient time? Who has told it from that time? Have not I the LORD? And there is no God else beside Me; a **just** God and a Savior, there is none beside Me... In the LORD shall all the seed of Israel be **justified**, and shall glory. Isaiah 45:21, 25

Then I said, I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nought, and in vain: yet surely my **judgment** is with the LORD, and my work with my God. Isaiah 49:4

He is near that **justifies** me; who will contend with me? Let us stand together: who is mine adversary? Let him come near to me. Isaiah 50:8

Hearken unto Me, My people; and give ear unto Me, O My nation: for a law shall proceed from Me, and I will make My **judgment** to rest for a light of the people. My righteousness is near; My salvation is gone forth, and My arms shall **judge** the people... Isaiah 51:4-5



He was taken from prison and from **judgment**: and who shall declare His generation? For He was cut off out of the land of the living; for the transgression of My people was He stricken... He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant **justify** many; for He shall bear their iniquities. Isaiah 53:8, 11

No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in **judgment** you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of Me, says the LORD. Isaiah 54:17

Thus says the LORD, Keep you **judgment, and do justice**: for My salvation is near to come, and My righteousness to be revealed. Isaiah 56:1

Yet they seek Me daily, and delight to know My ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of Me the ordinances of **justice**; they take delight in approaching to God. Isaiah 58:2

None calls for **justice**, nor any pleads for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. They hatch cockatrice's eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eats of their eggs dies, and that which is crushed breaks out into a viper. Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works are works of iniquity, and the act of violence is in their hands. Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood; their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths. Isaiah 59:4-7

The way of peace they know not; and there is no **judgment** in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goes therein shall not know peace. Therefore is **judgment** far from us, neither does **justice** overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness. We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men. We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for **judgment**, but there is none; for salvation, but it is far off from us. Isaiah 59:8-11



For our transgressions are multiplied before You, and our sins testify against us; for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them; In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. And **judgment** is turned away backward, and **justice** stands afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. Yes, truth fails; and he that departs from evil makes himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no **judgment**. Isaiah 59:12-15

For I the LORD love **judgment**, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in truth, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Isaiah 61:8

I will utter My **judgments** against them touching all their wickedness, who have forsaken Me, and have burned incense unto other gods, and worshiped the works of their own hands. Jeremiah 1:16

And the LORD said unto Me, The backsliding Israel has **justified** herself more than treacherous Judah. Jeremiah 3:11

Run to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if you can find a man, if there be any that executes **judgment**, that seeks the truth; and I will pardon it. And though they say, The LORD lives; surely they swear falsely. O LORD, are not Your eyes upon the truth? You have stricken them, but they have not grieved; You have consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return. Therefore I said, Surely these are poor; they are foolish: for they know not the way of the LORD, nor the **judgment** of their God. I will get me unto the great men, and will speak unto them; for they have known the way of the LORD, and the **judgment** of their God: but these have altogether broken the yoke, and burst the bonds. Jeremiah 5:1-5

They are waxen fat, they shine: yes, they overpass the deeds of the wicked: they judge not the cause, the cause of the fatherless, yet they prosper; and the right of the needy do they not **judge**. Jeremiah 5:28

For if you thoroughly amend your ways and your doings; if you thoroughly execute **judgment** between a man and his neighbor; If you oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither walk after other gods to your hurt: Then will I cause you to dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers, for ever and ever. Jeremiah 7:5-7

Yes, the stork in the heaven knows her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but My people know not the **judgment** of the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Jeremiah 8:7

Thus says the LORD, Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, neither let the mighty man glory in his might, let not the rich man glory in his riches: But let him that glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, **judgment**, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, says the LORD. Jeremiah 9:23-24

O LORD [YeHoVaH], correct me, but with **judgment**; not in Your anger, lest you bring me to nothing. Jeremiah 10:24

But, O LORD of hosts, that **judge** righteously, that tries the reins and the heart, let me see Your vengeance on them: for unto You have I revealed my cause. Jeremiah 11:20

Righteous are you, O LORD, when I plead with You: yet let me talk with You of Your **judgments**...Jeremiah 12:1

O house of David, thus says the LORD; Execute **judgment** in the morning, and deliver him that is spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest My fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench it, because of the evil of your doings. Jeremiah 21:12

Thus says the LORD; Execute you **judgment** and righteousness, and deliver the spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor: and do no wrong, do no violence to the stranger, the fatherless, nor the widow, neither shed innocent blood in this place... Shall you reign, because you enclose yourself in cedar? Did not your father eat and drink, and do **judgment** and **justice**, and then it was well with him? He **judged** the cause of the poor and needy; then it was well with him: was not this to know Me? says the LORD. Jeremiah 22:3,15-16

Behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute the **judgment** and **justice** in the earth. Jeremiah 23:5

Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; As yet they shall use this speech in the land of Judah and in the cities thereof, when I shall bring again their captivity; The LORD bless you, O habitation of **justice**, and mountain of holiness. Jer 31:23

In those days, and at that time, will I cause the Branch of righteousness to grow up unto David; and He shall execute **judgment** and righteousness in the land. Jeremiah 33:15

The Chaldeans' army pursued after them, and overtook Zedekiah in the plains of Jericho: and when they had taken him, they brought him up to Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon to Riblah in the land of Hamath, where he gave **judgment** upon him. Jeremiah 39:5

For thus says the LORD; Behold, they whose **judgment** was not to drink of the cup have assuredly drunken; and are you he that shall altogether go unpunished? You shall not go unpunished, but you shall surely drink of it. Jeremiah 49:12

All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of **justice**, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers. Jeremiah 50:7

We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her **judgment** reaches unto heaven, and is lifted up even to the skies. Jer 51:9

Therefore, behold, the days come, that I will do **judgment** upon the graven images of Babylon: and her whole land shall be confounded, and all her slain shall fall in the midst of her ...Wherefore, behold, the days come, says the LORD, that I will do **judgment** upon her graven images: and through all her land the wounded shall groan. Jeremiah 51:47, 52

O LORD, You have seen my wrong: You **judge** my cause... Lamentations 3:59

For the sins of her prophets, and the iniquities of her priests, that have shed the blood of the **just** in the midst of her, They have wandered as blind men in the streets, they have polluted themselves with blood, so that men could not touch their garments. Lamentations 4:13-14

She has changed My **judgments** into wickedness more than the nations, and My statutes more than the countries that are round about her: for they have refused My **judgments** and My statutes, they have not walked in them. Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Because you multiplied more than the nations that are round about you, and have not walked in My statutes, neither have kept My **judgments**, neither have done according to the **judgments** of the nations that are round about you; Therefore thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, am against you, and will execute **judgments** in the midst of you in the sight of the nations. Ezekiel 5:6-8

Therefore the fathers shall eat the sons in the midst of you, and the sons shall eat their fathers; and I will execute **judgments** in you, and the whole remnant of you will I scatter into all the winds... So it shall be a reproach and a taunt, an instruction and an astonishment unto the nations that are round about you, when I shall execute **judgments** in you in anger and in fury and in furious rebukes. I the LORD have spoken it. Ezekiel 5:10, 15

Now is the end come upon you, and I will send My anger upon you, and will **judge** you according to your ways, and will recompense upon you all your abominations. Ezekiel 7:3

Now will I shortly pour out My fury upon you, and accomplish My anger upon you: and I will **judge** you according to your ways, and will recompense you for all your abominations. Ezekiel 7:8

The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I **judge** them; and they shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 7:27

I will bring you out of the midst thereof, and deliver you into the hands of strangers, and will execute **judgments** among you. You shall fall by the sword; I will **judge** you in the border of Israel; and you shall know that I am the LORD. This city shall not be your caldron, neither shall you be the flesh in the midst thereof; but I will **judge** you in the border of Israel. And you shall know that I am the LORD: for you have not walked in My statutes, neither executed My **judgments**, but have done after the manners of the heathen that are round about you. Ezekiel 11:9-12

Though Noah, Daniel, and Job, were in it, as I live, says the Lord GOD, they shall deliver neither son nor daughter; they shall but deliver their own souls by their righteousness. For thus says the Lord GOD; How much more when I send My four sore **judgments** upon Jerusalem, the sword, and the famine, and the noisome beast, and the pestilence, to cut off from it man and beast? Ezekiel 14:20-21

I will **judge** you, as women that break wedlock and shed blood are **judged**; and I will give you blood in fury and jealousy... Ezekiel 16:38

Behold, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy. And they were haughty, and committed abomination before Me; therefore I took them away as I saw good. Neither has Samaria committed half of your sins; but you have multiplied your abominations more than they, and have justified your sisters in all your abominations which you have done. You also, who have judged your sisters, bear your own shame for your sins that you have committed more abominable than they: they are more righteous than you: yes, be you confounded also, and bear your shame, in that you have **justified** your sisters. Ezekiel 16:49-52

They shall burn your houses with fire, and execute **judgments** upon you in the sight of many women: and I will cause you to cease from playing the harlot, and you also shall give no hire any more. Ezekiel 16:41

But if a man be **just**, and do that which is lawful and right... He that has not given forth upon usury, neither has taken any increase, that has withdrawn his hand from iniquity, has executed true **judgment** between man and man. Has walked in My statutes, and has kept My **judgments**, to deal truly; he is **just**, he shall surely live, says the Lord GOD. Eze 18:5, 8-9

If he beget a son, that sees all his father's sins which he has done, and considers, and does not such like... That has taken off his hand from the poor, that has not received usury nor increase, has executed My **judgments**, has walked in My statutes; he shall not die for the iniquity of his father, he shall surely live. Eze 18:14, 17

Therefore I will **judge** you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, says the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Ezekiel 18:30

Will you **judge** them, son of man, will you **judge** them? Cause them to know the abominations of their fathers... Eze 20:4

I gave them My statutes, and showed them My **judgments**, which if a man do, he shall even live in them. Moreover also I gave them My sabbaths, to be a sign between Me and them, that they might know that I am the LORD that sanctify them. But the house of Israel rebelled against Me in the wilderness: they walked not in My statutes, and they despised My **judgments**, which if a man do, he shall even live in them; and My sabbaths they greatly polluted: then I said, I would pour out My fury upon them in the wilderness, to consume them. Ezekiel 20:11-13

Because they despised My **judgments**, and walked not in My statutes, but polluted My sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols. Nevertheless My eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness. But I said unto their children in the wilderness, Walk you not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their **judgments**, nor defile yourselves with their idols: I am the LORD your God; walk in My statutes, and keep My judgments, and do them; And hallow My sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between Me and you, that you may know that I am the LORD your God. Ezekiel 20:16-20



Notwithstanding the children rebelled against Me: they walked not in My statutes, neither kept My **judgments** to do them, which if a man do, he shall even live in them; they polluted My sabbaths: then I said, I would pour out My fury upon them to accomplish My anger against them in the wilderness. Nevertheless I withdrew Mine hand, and wrought for My name's sake, that it should not be polluted in the sight of the heathen, in whose sight I brought them forth. I lifted up Mine hand unto them also in the wilderness, that I would scatter them among the heathen, and disperse them through the countries. Because they had not executed My **judgments**, but had despised My statutes, and had polluted My sabbaths, and their eyes were after their fathers' idols. Wherefore I gave them also statutes that were not good, and **judgments** whereby they should not live; And I polluted them in their own gifts, in that they caused to pass through the fire all that open the womb, that I might make them desolate, to the end that they might know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 20:21-26

Shall I cause it to return into his sheath? I will **judge** you in the place where you were created, in the land of your nativity. Ezekiel 21:30

Now, you son of man, will you judge, will you **judge** the blood city? Yes, you shall shew her all the abominations. Ezekiel 22:2

Aholah...I have delivered her into the hand of her lovers, into the hand of the Assyrians, upon whom she doted. These discovered her nakedness: they took her sons and her daughters, and slew her with the sword: and she became famous among women; for they had executed **judgment** upon her. Ezekiel 23:9-10

They shall come against you with chariots, wagons, and wheels, and with an assembly of people, which shall set against you buckler and shield and helmet round about: and I will set **judgment** before them, and they shall judge you according to their **judgments**...The LORD said moreover unto me; Son of man, will you **judge** Aholah and Aholibah? Yes, declare unto them their abominations...The righteous men, they shall **judge** them after the manner of adulteresses, and after the manner of women that shed blood; because they are adulteresses, and blood is in their hands. Ezekiel 23:24, 36, 45



I the LORD have spoken it: it shall come to pass, and I will do it; I will not go back, neither will I spare, neither will I repent; according to your ways, and according to your doings, shall they **judge** you, says the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 24:14

I will execute **judgments** upon Moab; and they shall know that I am the LORD...Thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against you, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of you: and they shall know that I am the LORD, when I shall have executed **judgments** in her, and shall be sanctified in her. For I will send into her pestilence, and blood into her streets; and the wounded shall be **judged** in the midst of her by the sword upon her on every side; and they shall know that I am the LORD...And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yes, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed **judgments** upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I am the LORD their God...I will make Pathros desolate, and will set fire in Zoan, and will execute **judgments** in No...Thus will I execute **judgments** in Egypt: and they shall know that I am the LORD. Ezekiel 25:11, 28:22-23, 26,30:14, 19

When the righteous turns from his righteousness, and commits iniquity, he shall even die thereby. But if the wicked turn from his wickedness, and do that which is lawful and right, he shall live thereby. Yet you say, The way of the Lord is not equal. O you house of Israel, I will **judge** you every one after his ways. Ezekiel 33:18-20

I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with **judgment**. And as for you, O my flock, thus says the Lord GOD; Behold, I **judge** between cattle and cattle, between the rams and the he goats. Seems it a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but you must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? And to have drunk of the deep waters, but you must foul the residue with your feet? And as for my flock, they eat that which you have trodden with your feet; and they drink that which you have fouled with your feet. Ezekiel 34:16-20

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD unto them; Behold, I, even I, will **judge** between the fat cattle and between the lean cattle. Because you have thrust with side and with shoulder, and pushed all the diseased with your horns, till you have scattered them abroad; Therefore will I save My flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will **judge** between cattle and cattle. Eze 34:20-22

Therefore, as I live, says the Lord GOD, I will even do according to your anger, and according to your envy which you have used out of your hatred against them; and I will make Myself known among them, when I have **judged** you. Ezekiel 35:11

I scattered them among the heathen, and they were dispersed through the countries: according to their way and according to their doings I **judged** them. Ezekiel 36:19

A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put My spirit within you, and cause you to walk in My statutes, and you shall keep My **judgments**, and do them. And you shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers; and you shall be My people, and I will be your God. Ezekiel 36:26-28

David My servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in My **judgments**, and observe My statutes, and do them. Ezekiel 37:24

I will set My glory among the heathen, and all the heathen shall see My **judgment** that I have executed, and My hand that I have laid upon them. Ezekiel 39:21

In controversy they shall stand in **judgment**; and they shall **judge** it according to My **judgments**: and they shall keep My laws and My statutes in all Mine assemblies; and they shall hallow My sabbaths. Ezekiel 44:24

Thus says the Lord GOD; Let it suffice you, O princes of Israel: remove violence and spoil, and execute **judgment** and **justice**, take away your exactions from My people, says the Lord GOD. You shall have **just** balances, and a **just** ephah, and a **just** bath. Ezekiel 45:9-10

Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the **judges**, the treasurers, the counselors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up. Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the **judges**, the treasurers, the counselors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up. Daniel 3:2-3

Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honor the King of heaven, all whose works are truth, and His ways **judgment**: and those that walk in pride He is able to abase. Daniel 4:37

A fiery stream issued and came forth from before Him: thousand thousands ministered unto Him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him: the **judgment** was set, and the books were opened...Until the Ancient of days came, and **judgment** was given to the saints of the Most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the Kingdom... Dan 7:10, 22

But the **judgment** shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy it unto the end. Daniel 7:26

We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and from Your **judgments**: Neither have we hearkened unto Your servants the prophets, which spoke in Your name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land...We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from Your precepts and Your **judgments**...Daniel 8:5-6; 9:5

And He has confirmed His words, which He spoke against us, and against our **judges** that **judged** us, by bringing upon us a great evil: for under the whole heaven has not been done as has been done upon Jerusalem. Daniel 9:12

I will betroth you unto Me for ever; yes, I will betroth you unto Me in righteousness, and in **judgment**, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. I will even betroth you unto Me in faithfulness: and you shall know the LORD. Hosea 2:19-20

Hear you this, O priests; and hearken, you house of Israel; and give ear, O house of the king; for **judgment** is toward you, because you have been a snare on Mizpah, and a net spread upon Tabor...Ephraim is oppressed and broken in **judgment**, because he willingly walked after the commandment. Hosea 5:1, 11

Therefore have I hewed them by the prophets; I have slain them by the words of My mouth: and your **judgments** are as the light that goes forth. Hosea 6:5

They are all hot as an oven, and have devoured their **judges**; all their kings are fallen: there is none among them that calls unto me. Hosea 7:7

They have spoken words, swearing falsely in making a covenant: thus **judgment** springs up as hemlock in the furrows of the field. Hosea 10:4

Therefore turn you to your God: keep mercy and **judgment**, and wait on your God continually...Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the **just** shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein. Hosea 12:6, 14:9

I will be your king: where is any other that may save you in all your cities? And your **judges** of whom you said, Give me a king and princes? Hosea 13:10

Let the heathen be wakened, and come up to the valley of Jehoshaphat: for there will I sit to **judge** all the heathen round about. Joel 3:12

I will cut off the **judge** from the midst thereof, and will slay all the princes thereof with him, says the LORD. Amos 2:3

You who turn **judgment** to wormwood, and leave off righteousness in the earth...For I know your manifold transgressions and your mighty sins; they afflict the **just**, they take a bribe, and they turn aside the poor in the gate from their right...Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish **judgment** in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be gracious unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:7, 12, 15

I hate, I despise your feast days, and I will not smell in your solemn assemblies. Though you offer Me burnt offerings and your meat offerings, I will not accept them: neither will I regard the peace offerings of your fat beasts. Take you away from Me the noise of your songs; for I will not hear the melody of your viols. But let **judgment** run down as waters, and righteousness as a mighty stream. Amos 5:21-24

Shall horses run upon the rock? Will one plow there with oxen? For you have turned **judgment** into gall, and the fruit of righteousness into hemlock... Amos 6:12

And I said, Hear, I pray you, O heads of Jacob, and you princes of the house of Israel; Is it not for you to know **judgment**? Who hate the good, and love the evil; who pluck off their skin from off them, and their flesh from off their bones; Who also eat the flesh of My people, and flay their skin from off them; and they break their bones, and chop them in pieces, as for the pot, and as flesh within the caldron. Then shall they cry unto the LORD, but He will not hear them: He will even hide His face from them at that time, as they have behaved themselves ill in their doings. Micah 3:1-4

Truly I am full of power by the spirit of the LORD, and of judgment, and of might, to declare unto Jacob his transgression, and to Israel his sin. Hear this, I pray you, you heads of the house of Jacob, and princes of the house of Israel, that abhor **judgment**, and pervert all equity. They build up Zion with blood, and Jerusalem with iniquity. The heads thereof **judge** for reward, and the priests thereof teach for hire, and the prophets thereof divine for money; yet will they lean upon the LORD, and say, Is not the LORD among us? None evil can come upon us. Micah 3:8-11

He shall **judge** among many people, and rebuke strong nations afar off; and they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning hooks: nation shall not lift up a sword against nation, neither shall they learn war any more... Gather yourself in troops, O daughter of troops: he has laid siege against us: they shall smite the **judge** of Israel with a rod upon the cheek... That they may do evil with both hands earnestly, the prince asks, and the **judge** asks for a reward; and the great man, he utters his mischievous desire: so they wrap it up. Micah 4:3, 5:1; 7:3

Therefore the law is slacked, and **judgment** does never go forth: for the wicked does compass about the righteous; therefore wrong **judgment** proceeds...They are terrible and dreadful: their **judgment** and their dignity shall proceed of themselves. Habakkuk 1:4,7

Are you not from everlasting, O LORD my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die. O LORD, you have ordained them for **judgment**; and, O mighty God, You have established them for correction. ...Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the **just** shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 1:12, 2:4

Seek you the LORD, all you meek of the earth, which have wrought His **judgment**; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be you shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger. Zeph 2:3

Woe to her that is filthy and polluted, to the oppressed city! She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God. Her princes within her are roaring lions; her **judges** are evening wolves; they gnaw not the bones till the morrow. Her prophets are light and treacherous persons: her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done violence to the law. The **just** LORD is in the midst thereof; He will not do iniquity: every morning does He bring His **judgment** to light, He fails not; but the unjust knows no shame...Thus says the LORD of hosts; If you will walk in My ways, and if you will keep My charge, then you shall also **judge** My house, and shall also keep My courts, and I will give you places to walk among these that stand by...The LORD has taken away your **judgments**, He has cast out your enemy: the king of Israel, even the LORD, is in the midst of you: you shall not see evil any more. Zephaniah 3:1-5, 15

Execute true **judgment**, and shew mercy and compassions every man to his brother...These are the things that you shall do; speak you every man the truth to his neighbor; execute the **judgment** of truth and peace in your gates... Zechariah 7:9, 8:16

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, your King comes unto you: He is **just**, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. Zechariah 9:9



You have wearied the LORD with your words, Yet you say, Wherein have we wearied Him? When you say, Every one that does evil is good in the sight of the LORD, and He delights in them; or, Where is the God of **judgment**? Malachi 2:17

I will come near to you in **judgment**; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers, and against the adulterers, and against false swearers, and against those that oppress the hireling in his wages, and widow, and the fatherless, and that turn aside the stranger from his right, and fear not Me, says the LORD of hosts. Mal 3:5

Remember you the law of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in Horeb for all Israel, with the statutes and **judgments**. Malachi 4:4

## JUSTICE AND JUDGMENT IN THE NEW COVENANT

Then Joseph her husband, being a **just** man, and not willing to make her a public example, thought to put her away privily. Matthew 1:19

You have heard that it was said by them of old time, You shall not kill; and whoever shall kill shall be in danger of the **judgment**: But I say unto you, That whoever is angry with his brother without a cause shall be in danger of the **judgment**: and whoever shall say to his brother, Raca, shall be in danger of the council: but whosoever shall say, You fool, shall be in danger of hell fire ...Agree with your adversary quickly, while you are in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver you to the **judge**, and the **judge** deliver you to the officer, and you be cast into prison. Matthew 5:21-22, 25

I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; That you may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for He makes His sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the **just** and on the unjust. Matthew 5:44-45

**Judge** not, that you be not **judged**. For with what **judgment** you **judge**, you shall be **judged**: and with the measure you use as a standard, it shall be measured to you again. Matthew 7:1-2



As you go, preach, saying, The Kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely you have received, freely give...Into whatever city or town you shall enter, inquire who in it is worthy; and there abide till you go thence. And when you come into an house, salute it. And if the house be worthy, let your peace come upon it: but if it be not worthy, let your peace return to you. And whoever shall not receive you, nor hear your words, when you depart out of that house or city, shake off the dust of your feet... Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of **judgment**, than for that city. Matthew 10:7-8, 11-15

The Son of man came eating and drinking, and they say, Behold a man gluttonous, and a wine bibber, a friend of publicans and sinners. But wisdom is **justified** of her children. Then began He to upbraid the cities wherein most of His mighty works were done, because they repented not: Woe unto you, Chorazin! If the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have repented long ago in sackcloth and ashes. But I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Tyre and Sidon at the day of **judgment**, than for you. And you, Capernaum, which are exalted unto heaven, shall be brought down to hell: for if the mighty works, which have been done in you, had been done in Sodom, it would have remained until this day. But I say unto you, That it shall be more tolerable for the land of Sodom in the day of **judgment**, than for you. Mt 11:19-24

Behold My servant, whom I have chosen; My beloved, in whom My soul is well pleased: I will put My spirit upon Him, and He shall shew **judgment** to the Gentiles. He shall not strive, nor cry; neither shall any man hear His voice in the streets. A bruised reed shall He not break, and smoking flax shall He not quench, till He send forth **judgment** unto victory. And in His name shall the Gentiles trust. Matthew 12:18-21

That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of **judgment**. For by your words you shall be **justified**, and by your words you shall be condemned...Matthew 12:36-37

The men of Nineveh shall rise in **judgment** with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here. The queen of the south shall rise up in the **judgment** with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon is here. Matthew 12: 41-42

So shall it be at the end of the world: the angels shall come forth, and sever the wicked from among the **just**, And shall cast them into the furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth. Matthew 13:49-50

And Jesus said unto them, Verily I say unto you, That you which have followed Me, in the regeneration when the Son of man shall sit in the throne of His glory, you also shall sit upon twelve thrones, **judging** the twelve tribes of Israel. Matt 19:28

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, **judgment**, mercy, and faith: these ought you to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Matthew 23:23

When he was set down on the **judgment** seat, his wife sent unto him, saying, Have nothing to do with that **just** man: for I have suffered many things this day in a dream because of Him... When Pilate saw that he could prevail nothing, but that rather a tumult was made, he took water, and washed his hands before the multitude, saying, I am innocent of the blood of this **just** person: see you to it. Matthew 27:19, 24

Whoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you, It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of **judgment**, than for that city. Mark 6:11

For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a **just** man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly. Mark 6:20

He shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the **just**; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17

There was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was **just** and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. Lk 2:25

**Judge** not, and you shall not be **judged**: condemn not, and you shall not be condemned: forgive, and you shall be forgiven... Luke 6:37

All the people that heard Him, and the publicans, **justified** God, being baptized with the baptism of John...John the Baptist came neither eating bread nor drinking wine; and you say, He has a devil. The Son of man is come eating and drinking; and you say, Behold a gluttonous man, and a wine bibber, a friend of publicans and sinners... wisdom is **justified** of her children. Lk 7:29, 33-35

There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty. And when they had nothing to pay, he frankly forgave them both. Tell me therefore, which of them will love him most? Simon answered and said, I suppose that he, to whom he forgave most. And he said unto him, You have rightly **judged**. Luke 7:41-43

Be he, willing to **justify** himself, said unto Jesus, And who is my neighbor? Luke 10:29

If I by Beelzebub cast out devils, by whom do your sons cast them out? Therefore they shall be your **judges**. Luke 11:19

One of the company said unto Him, Master, speak to my brother, that he divide the inheritance with me. And He said unto him, Man, who made me a **judge** or a divider over you? You hypocrites, you can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that you do not discern this time? Yes, and why even of yourselves **judge** you not what is right? When you go with your adversary to the magistrate, as you are in the way, give diligence that you may be delivered from him; lest he take you to the **judge**, and the **judge** deliver you to the officer, and the officer cast you into prison. Luke 12:13-14, 56-58

When you make a feast, call the poor, the maimed, the lame, the blind: And you shall be blessed; for they cannot recompense you: for you shall be recompensed at the resurrection of the **just**. Luke 14:13-14

I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repents, more than over ninety and nine **just** persons, who need no repentance. Luke 15:7

No servant can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. And the Pharisees also, who were covetous, heard all these things: and they derided Him. He said unto them, You are they which **justify** yourselves before men; but God knows your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God. Luke 16:13-15

He spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint; Saying, there was in a city a **judge**, which feared not God, neither regarded man: And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, Though I fear not God, nor regard man; Yet because this widow troubles me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust **judge** said. Luke 18:1-6

He spoke this parable unto certain who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a publican. The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, God, I thank You, that I am not as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this publican. I fast twice in the week, I give tithes of all that I possess. And the publican, standing afar off, would not lift up so much as his eyes unto heaven, but smote upon his breast, saying, God be merciful to me a sinner. I tell you, this man went down to his house **justified** rather than the other: for every one that exalts himself shall be abased; and he that humbles himself shall be exalted. Luke 18:9-14

He said unto him, Out of your own mouth will I **judge** you, you wicked servant. You knew that I was an austere man, taking up that I laid not down, and reaping that I did not sow: Wherefore then gave not you my money into the bank, that at my coming I might have required my own with usury? Luke 19:22-23

They watched Him, and sent forth spies, which should feign themselves **just** men, that they might take hold of His words, that so they might deliver Him unto the power and authority of the governor. Luke 20:20

I appoint unto you a Kingdom, as My Father has appointed unto Me; That you may eat and drink at My table in My Kingdom, and sit on thrones **judging** the twelve tribes of Israel. Luke 22:29-30

Behold, there was a man named Joseph, a counselor; and he was a good man, and a **just**...This man went unto Pilate, and begged the body of Jesus [Yeshua]. Luke 23:50, 52

For the Father **judges** no man, but has committed all judgment unto the Son...And has given Him authority to execute **judgment** also, because He is the Son of man. John 5:22, 27

I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and My **judgment** is **just**; because I seek not My own will, but the will of the Father who has sent Me. John 5:30

**Judge** not according to the appearance, but **judge** righteous **judgment**. John 7:24

Does our law **judge** any man, before it hear him, and know what he does? John 7:51

You **judge** after the flesh; I **judge** no man. And yet if I **judge**, My **judgment** is true: for I am not alone, but I and the Father that sent Me. John 8:15-16

I have many things to say and to **judge** of you: but He that sent Me is true; and I speak to the world those things which I have heard of Him. John 8:26

I seek not Mine own glory: there is one that seeks and **judges**. John 8:50

Jesus [Yeshua] said, For **judgment** I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind. John 9:39

Now is the **judgment** of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. John 12:31

If any man hear My words, and believe not, I **judge** him not: for I came not to **judge** the world, but to save the world. He that rejects Me, and receives not My words, has one that **judges** him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall **judge** him in the last day. John 12:47-48

It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. When He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of **judgment**: Of sin, because they believe not on Me; Of righteousness, because I go to My Father, and you see Me no more; Of **judgment**, because the prince of this world is judged. John 16:7-11

Then led they Jesus [Yeshua] from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the **judgment** hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover...Then said Pilate unto them, Take you Him, and **judge** Him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death...Then Pilate entered into the **judgment** hall again, and called Jesus, and said unto Him, Are you the King of the Jews? John 18:28, 31-33

When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he was the more afraid; and went again into the **judgment** hall, and said unto Jesus [Yeshua], Whence are you? But Jesus gave him no answer... When Pilate therefore heard that saying, he brought Jesus forth, and sat down in the **judgment** seat in a place that is called the Pavement, but in the Hebrew, Gabbatha. John 19:8-9, 13

But you denied the Holy One and **the Just**, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you... Acts 3:14

Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of God to hearken unto you more than unto God you **judge**. Acts 4:19

The nation to whom they shall be in bondage will I **judge**, said God: and after that shall they come forth, and serve Me in this place. Acts 7:7

But he that did his neighbor wrong thrust him away, saying, Who made you a ruler and a **judge** over us? Acts 7:27

This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made you a ruler and a **judge**? The same did God sent to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush. Acts 7:35

Which of the prophets have not your fathers persecuted? And they have slain them which showed before of the coming of **the Just One**; of whom you have been now the betrayers and murderers... Acts 7:52

In His humiliation His **judgment** was taken away: and who shall declare His generation? For His life is taken from the earth. Acts 8:33

They said, Cornelius the centurion, a **just** man, and one that fears God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for you into his house, and to hear words of you. Acts 10:22

He commanded us to preach unto the people, and to testify that it is He which was ordained of God to be the **Judge** of quick and dead. Acts 10:42

After that He gave unto them **judges** about the space of four hundred and fifty years, until Samuel the prophet. Acts 13:20

Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the forgiveness of sins: By Him all that believe are **justified** from all things; from which you could not be **justified** by the law of Moses. Acts 13:38-39

Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing you put it from you, and **judge** yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles. Acts 13:46



When she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If you have **judged** me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us. Acts 16:15

Because He has appointed a day, in the which He will **judge** the world in righteousness by that man whom He has ordained; whereof He has given assurance unto all men, in that He has raised Him from the dead. Acts 17:31

When Gallio was the deputy of Achaia, the Jews made insurrection with one accord against Paul, and brought Him to the **judgment** seat...But if it be a question of words and names, and of your law, look you to it; for I will be no **judge** of such matters. And he drove them from the **judgment** seat. Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat him before the **judgment** seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things. Acts 18:12, 15-17

He said, The God of our fathers has chosen you, that you should know His will, and see that **Just One**, and should hear the voice of His mouth. Acts 22:14

Then said Paul unto him, God shall smite you, you whited wall: for you sit to **judge** me after the law, and command me to be smitten contrary to the law? Acts 23:3

I will hear you, said he, when your accusers are also come. And he commanded him to be kept in Herod's **judgment** hall. Acts 23:35

For we have found this man...a ringleader of the sect of the Nazarenes: Who also has gone about to profane the temple: whom we took, and would have **judged** according to our law... Then Paul, after the governor had beckoned unto him to speak, answered, Forasmuch as I know that you have been of many years a **judge** unto this nation, I do the more cheerfully answer for myself...I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets: And have hope toward God, which they themselves also allow, that there shall be a resurrection of the dead, both of the **just** and unjust. Acts 24:5-6, 10, 14-15

As he reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and **judgment** to come, Felix trembled, and answered, Go your way for this time; when I have a convenient season, I will call for you. Acts 24:25

When he had tarried among them more than ten days, he went down unto Caesarea; and the next day sitting on the **judgment** seat commanded Paul to be brought...But Festus, willing to do the Jews a pleasure, answered Paul, and said, Will you go up to Jerusalem, and there be **judged** of these things before me? Then said Paul, I stand at Caesar's **judgment** seat, where I ought to be **judged**; to the Jews have I done no wrong, as you know very well...About whom, when I was at Jerusalem, the chief priests and the elders of the Jews informed me, desiring to have **judgment** against him...Therefore, when they came here without any delay on the morrow I sat on the **judgment** seat, and commanded the man to be brought forth... And because I doubted of such manner of questions, I asked him whether he would go to Jerusalem, and there be **judged** of these matters. Acts 25:6, 9-10, 15, 17, 20

Now I stand and am **judged** for the hope of the promise made of God unto our fathers... Acts 26:6

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation...For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The **just** shall live by faith. Romans 1:16-17

Even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind...Who knowing the **judgment** of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them. Romans 1:28, 32

Therefore you are inexcusable, O man, whosoever you are that **judges**: for wherein you **judged** another, you condemn yourself; for you that **judge** do the same things. But we are sure that the **judgment** of God is according to truth against them which commit such things. And think you this, O man, that **judges** them which do such things, and do the same, that you shall escape the **judgment** of God? Romans 2:1-3

Or do you despise the riches of His goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance? But after your hardness and impenitent heart treasure up to yourself wrath against the day of wrath and revelation of the righteous **judgment** of God; In the day when God shall **judge** the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel. Romans 2:4-6

For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be **judged** by the law; (For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be **justified**... Romans 2:12-13

Shall not the uncircumcision which is by nature, if it fulfil the law, **judge** you, who by the letter and circumcision do transgress the law? For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither is that circumcision, which is outward in the flesh: But he is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. Romans 2:27

God forbid: yes, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, that you might be **justified** in your sayings, and might overcome when you are **judged**. But if our unrighteousness commend the righteousness of God, what shall we say? Is God unrighteous who takes vengeance? (I speak as a man) God forbid; for then how shall God **judge** the world? For if the truth of God has more abounded through my lie unto His glory; why yet am I also judged as a sinner? And not rather, (as we be slanderously reported, and as some affirm that we say,) Let us do evil, that good may come? Whose damnation is **just**. Romans 3:4-8

Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be **justified** in His sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin...Being **justified** freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be **just**, and the **justifier** of him which believe in Jesus. Romans 3:20, 24-26

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay: but by the law of faith. Therefore we conclude that a man is **justified** by faith without the deeds of the law. Is He the God of the Jews only? Is He not also of the Gentiles? Yes, of the Gentiles also: Seeing it is one God, which shall **justify** the circumcision by faith, and uncircumcision through faith. Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yes, we establish the law. Romans 3:27-31

What shall we say then that Abraham our father, as pertaining to the flesh, has found? For if Abraham were **justified** by works, he has whereof to glory, but not before God. For what says the scripture? Abraham believed God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness. Now to him that works is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. But to him that works not, but believes on Him that **justifies** the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Even as David also described the blessedness of the man, unto whom God imputed righteousness without works, Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin. Comes this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? For we say that faith was reckoned for Abraham for righteousness... Now it was not written for his sake alone, that it was imputed to him; But for us also, to whom it shall be imputed, if we believe on Him that raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead; who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our **justification**. Romans 4:1-9, 23-25

Therefore being **justified** by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah]. By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation works patience; And patience, experience; and experience, hope: And hope makes not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us. Romans 5:1-5

Not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the **judgment** was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offences unto justification. Romans 5:15-16

(...For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.) Therefore as by the offence of one **judgment** came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life. For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous. Romans 5:17-19

Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and **just**, and good. Romans 7:12

And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to His purpose. For whom He did foreknow, He also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of His Son, that He might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom He did predestinate, them He also called: and whom He called, them He also **justified**: and whom He **justified**, them He also glorified. What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us? He that spared not His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifies. Romans 8:28-33

O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God? How unsearchable are His **judgments**, and His ways past finding out. Romans 11:33

Let not him that eats despise him that eats not; and let not him which eats not **judge** him that eats: for God has received him. Who are you that **judges** another man's servant? To his own master he stands or falls. Yes, he shall be holden up: for God is able to make him stand. Romans 14:3-4

Why do you **judge** your brother? Or why do you set at nought your brother? For we shall all stand before the **judgment** seat of Christ [the Messiah]. Romans 14:10

Let us not therefore **judge** one another any more: but **judge** this rather, that no man put a stumbling block or an occasion to fall in his brother's way. Romans 14:13

Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], that you all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that you be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same **judgment**. 1 Corinthians 1:10

But he that is spiritual **judges** all things, yet he himself is **judged** of no man. 1 Corinthians 2:15

But with me it is a very small thing that I should be **judged** of you, or of man's **judgment**: yes, I **judge** not mine own self. For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby **justified**: but he that **judges** me is the Lord. For I know nothing by myself; yet am I not hereby justified: but he that **judges** me is the Lord. Therefore **judge** nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the hearts: and then shall every man have praise of God. 1 Corinthians 4:3-5

For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have **judged** already, as though I were present, concerning him that has so done this deed... 1 Corinthians 5:3

Now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such an one no not to eat. For what have I to do to **judge** them also that are without? Do not you **judge** them that are within? But them that are without God **judges**. Therefore put away from among yourselves that wicked person. 1 Corinthians 5:11-13

Do you not know that the saints shall **judge** the world? And if the world shall be judged by you, are you unworthy to judge the smallest matters? Know you not that we shall **judge** angels? If then you have **judgments** of things pertaining to this life, set them to **judge** who are least esteemed in the church. I speak to your shame, Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? No, not one that shall be able to **judge** between his brethren? ...Know you not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? ...And such were some of you: but you are washed, but you are sanctified, but you are **justified** in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. 1 Cor 6:2-5, 9, 11



Concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my **judgment**: as one that has obtained mercy of the Lord to be faithful...But she is happier if she so abide, after my **judgment**: and I think also that I have the Spirit of God. 1 Corinthians 7:25, 40

I speak as to wise men; **judge** you what I say...Conscience, I say, not your own, but of the other: for why is my liberty **judged** of another man's conscience? 1 Corinthians 10:15, 29

**Judge** in yourselves; is it comely that a woman pray unto God uncovered?...For if we would **judge** ourselves, we should not be **judged**. But when we are **judged**, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world. 1 Corinthians 11:13, 31-32

But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believes not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is **judged** of all.. .Let the prophets speak two or three, and let the other **judge**. 1 Corinthians 14:24, 29

For we must all appear before the **judgment** seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he has done, whether it be good or bad. Knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are made manifest unto God; and I trust also are made manifest in your conscience. For we commend not ourselves again unto you, but give you occasion to glory on our behalf, that you may have somewhat to answer them which glory in appearance, and not in heart. For whether we be beside ourselves, it is to God: or whether we be sober, it is for your cause. For the love of Christ [the Messiah] constrains us; because we thus **judge**, that if one died for all, then were all dead: And that He died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves... 2 Corinthians 5:10-15



Knowing that a man is not **justified** by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be **justified** by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be **justified**. But if, while we seek to be **justified** by Christ, we ourselves also are found sinners, is therefore Christ [Messiah] the minister of sin? God forbid. Galatians 2:16-17

And the scripture, foreseeing that God would **justify** the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In you shall all nations be blessed. So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham. For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, Cursed is every one that continues not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them. That no man is **justified** by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The **just** shall live by faith...Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be **justified** by faith. Galatians 3:8-11, 24

Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are **justified** by the law; you are fallen from grace. For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision avails any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which works by love. You did run well; who did hinder you that you should not obey the faith?.. I have confidence in you through the Lord, that you will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubles you shall bear his **judgment**, whosoever he be. Galatians 5:4-7, 10

This I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all **judgment**; That you may approve things that are excellent; that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ. Philippians 1:9-10

Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are **just**, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Philippians 4:8

Let no man therefore **judge** you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath days: Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body is of Christ [the Messiah]. Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he has not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind, And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands, having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increases with the increase of God. Colossians 2:16-19

Masters, give unto your servants that which is **just** and equal; knowing that you also have a Master in heaven. Colossians 4:1

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith grows exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other abounds; So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure: Which is a manifest token of the righteous **judgment** of God, that you may be counted worthy of the Kingdom of God, for which you also suffer: Seeing it is a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulations to them that trouble you... 2 Thessalonians 1:3-6

Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, **justified** in the spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. 1 Timothy 3:16

Some men's sins are open before hand, going before to **judgment**; and some men they follow after. Likewise also the good works of some are manifest beforehand; and they that are otherwise cannot be hid. 1 Timothy 5:24-25

I charge you therefore before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall **judge** the quick and the dead at His appearing and His Kingdom... Henceforth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord, the righteous **judge**, shall give me at that day: and not to me only, but unto all them that love His appearing. 2 Timothy 4:1, 8

For a bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; but a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, **just**, holy, temperate; Holding fast the faithful word as he has been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. Titus 1:7-9

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He saved us...That being **justified** by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:5, 7

Therefore we ought to give the more earnest heed to the things which we have heard, lest at any time we should let them slip. For if the word spoken by angels was stedfast, and every transgression and disobedience received a **just** recompense of reward; How shall we escape, if we neglect so great salvation; which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed unto us by them that heard Him... Hebrews 2:1-3

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God, Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal **judgment**. Hebrews 6:1-2

Now once in the end of the world has He appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the **judgment**: So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many... Hebrews 9:26-28

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remains no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of **judgment** and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries...For we know Him that has said, Vengeance belongs unto Me, I will recompense, says the Lord. And again, The Lord shall **judge** His people...Now the **just** shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, My soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:26-27, 30, 38

Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she **judged** Him faithful who had promised. Hebrews 11:11

But you are come unto mount Zion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, To the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the **Judge** of all, and to the spirits of **just** men made perfect, And to Jesus [Yeshua] the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaks better things than that of Abel. See that you refuse not Him that speaks. For if they escaped not who refused Him that spoke on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from Him that speaks from heaven... Hebrews 12:22-25

Marriage is honorable in all, and the bed undefiled: but whoremongers and adulterers God will **judge**. Hebrews 13:4

My brethren, have not the faith of our Lord Jesus Christ, with respect of persons. For if there come unto your assembly a man with a gold ring, in goodly apparel, and there come in also a poor man in vile raiment; And you have respect to him that wears the gay clothing, and say unto him, You sit here in a good place; and say to the poor, You stand there, or sit here under my footstool: Are you not then partial in yourselves, and are become **judges** of evil thoughts? Hearken, my beloved brethren, Has not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which He has promised to them that love Him? But you have despised the poor. Do not rich men oppress you, and draw you before the **judgment** seats? Do not they blaspheme that worthy name by the which you are called? If you fulfil the royal law according to the scripture, You shall love your neighbor as yourself, you do well: But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all. For He that said, do not commit adultery, said also, do not kill. Now if you commit no adultery, yet if you kill, you have become a transgressor of the law. So speak you, and so do, as they that shall be **judged** by the law of liberty. For He shall have **judgment** without mercy, that has shown no mercy; and mercy rejoices against **judgment**. James 2:1-13

Was not Abraham our father **justified** by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? See how faith wrought with his works, and by works was faith made perfect? And the scripture was fulfilled which said, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. You see then how that by works a man is **justified**, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot **justified** by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so faith without works is dead also. James 2:21-26

Speak not evil of another, brethren. He that speaks evil of his brother, and **judges** his brother, speaks evil of the law, and **judges** the law: but if you **judge** the law, you are not a doer of the law, but a **judge**. There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy: who are you that **judges** another? James 4:11-12

You have condemned and killed the **just**; and he does not resist you. James 5:6

Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest you be condemned: behold, the **judge** stands before the door. James 5:9

If you call on the Father, who without respect of persons **judges** according to every man's work, pass the time of your sojourning here in fear... 1 Peter 1:17

They think it strange that you run not with them to the same excess of riot, speaking evil of you: Who shall give account to Him that is ready to **judge** the quick and the dead. For for this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be **judged** according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit. 1 Peter 4:4-6

...The Lord knows how to deliver the godly out of temptations, and to reserve the unjust unto the day of **judgment** to be punished. But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise governments. Presumptuous are they, self-willed... 2 Peter 2:9-10

For this they are willingly ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of **judgment** and perdition of ungodly men. 2 Peter 3:6-7

If we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ His Son cleanses us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, He is faithful and **just** to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and His word is not in us. 1 John 1:7-10

We have known and believed the love that God has to us. God is love; and he that dwells in God, and God in him. Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of **judgment**: because as He is, so are we in this world. There is no fear in love; but perfect love casts out fear: because fear has torment. He that fears is not made perfect in love. 1 John 4:16-18

The angels which kept not their first estate, but left their own habitation, He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness unto the **judgment** of the great day...Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord comes with ten thousands of His saints, To execute **judgment** upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him. Jude 1:6, 14-15

When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: They cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, do you not **judge** and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? Revelations 6:9-10

The nations were angry, and Your wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be **judged**, and that You should give reward unto your servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear Your name, small and great; and should destroy them which destroy the earth. Revelation 11:18

I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to Him; for the hour of His **judgment** is come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. Revelation 14:6-7

They sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; **just** and true are Your ways, you King of saints. Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You only are holy: for all nations shall come and worship before You; for Your **judgments** are made manifest. Revelation 15:3-4

I heard the angel of the waters say, You are righteous, O Lord, which is, and was, and shall be, because You have **judged** thus. For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and You have given them blood to drink; for they are worthy. I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your **judgments**. Revelation 16:5-7

There came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither, I will shew unto you the **judgment** of the great whore that sits upon many waters: With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication...Revelation 17: 1-2



Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who **judges** her. The kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her, shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning, standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour is your **judgment** come. Revelation 18:8-10

I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honor, and power, unto the Lord our God: For true and righteous are His **judgments**: for He has **judged** the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and has avenged the blood of His servants at her hand. Revelation 19:1-2

I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness does He **judge** and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns...and His name is called The Word of God. Revelation 19:11-12

I saw thrones, and they sat upon them, and **judgment** was given unto them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus [Yeshua], and for the word of God, and which had not worshiped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark upon their foreheads, or in their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ [the Messiah] a thousand years...I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were **judged** out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were **judged** every man according to their works. Revelation 20:4, 13
