### **GRACE**

But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD. Genesis 6:8

Behold now, thy servant hath found **grace** in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy mercy, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die... Genesis 19:19

I have oxen, and asses, flocks, and menservants, and womenservants: and I have sent to tell my lord, that I may find **grace** in thy sight...And he said, What meanest thou by all this drove which I met? And he said, These are to find **grace** in the sight of my lord...And he lifted up his eyes, and saw the women and the children; and said, Who are those with thee? And he said, The children which God hath **graciously** given thy servant...And Jacob said, Nay, I pray thee, if now I have found grace in thy sight, then receive my present at my hand: for therefore I have seen thy face, as though I had seen the face of God, and thou wast pleased with me. Take, I pray thee, my blessing that is brought to thee; because God hath dealt **graciously** with me, and because I have enough. And he urged him, and he took it. Genesis 32:5, 8; 33:5, 10-11

Shechem said unto her father and unto her brethren, Let me find **grace** in your eyes, and what ye shall say unto me I will give. Genesis 34:11

Joseph found **grace** in his sight, and he served him: an dhe made him overseer over his house, and all that he had he put into his hand...and when the days of his mourning were past, Joseph spake unto the house of Pharaoh, saying, If now I have found **grace** in your eyes, speak, I pray you, in the ears of Pharaoh, saying...Now, therefore, let me go up, I pray thee, and bury my father... Genesis 39:4, 50:4-5

He lifted up his eyes, and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's son, and said, Is this your younger brother, of whom ye spake unto me? And he said, God be **gracious** unto thee, my son. Genesis 43:29

Thou hast saved our lives: let us find **grace** in the sight of my lord, and we will be Pharaoh's servants... As the time drew nigh that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found **grace** in thy sight, put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh, and deal kindly and truly with me; bury me not, I pray thee, in Egypt... Genesis 47:25, 29

For that is his covering only, it is his raiment for his skin: wherein shall he sleep? And it shall come to pass, when he crieth unto me, that I will hear; for I am gracious. Exodus 22:27

Moses said unto the LORD, See, thou sayest unto me, Bring up this people: and thou hast not let me know whom thou wilt send with me. Yet thou hast said, I know thee by name, and thou hast also found **grace** in my sight. Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found **grace** in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find **grace** in thy sight: and consider that this nation is thy people... Exodus 33:12-13

For wherein shall it be known here that I and thy people have found grace in thy sight? Is it not in that thou goest with us? So shall we be separated, I and thy people, from all the peolpe that are upon the face of the earth. And the LORD said unto Moses, I will do this thing also that thou hast spoken: for thou hast found grace in my sight, and I know thee by name...And he said, I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew mercy on whom I will shew mercy. Exodus 33:16-17, 19

And the LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and **gracious**, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth...And he said, If now I have found **grace** in thy sight, Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance. Exodus 34:6, 9

The LORD bless thee, and keep thee: The LORD make his face shine upon thee, and be **gracious** unto thee: The LORD lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace. Numbers 6:24-26

Wherefore, said they, if we have found **grace** in thy sight, let this land be given unto thy servants for a possession, and bring us not over Jordan. Numbers 32:5

He said unto him, If now I have found **grace** in thy sight, then shew me a sign that thou talkest with me. Judges 6:17

Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after him in whose sight I shall find **grace**. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter... Then she fell on her face, and bowed herself to the ground, and said utno him, Why have I found **grace** in thine eyes, that thou shouldest take knowledge of me, seeing I am a stranger? Ruth 2:2, 10

She said, Let thine handmaid find **grace** in thy sight. So the woman went her way, and did eat, and her counteance was no more sad. 1 Samuel 1:18

David sware moreover, and said, Thy father certainly knoweth that I have found **grace** in thine eyes; and he saith, Let not Jonathan know this, lest he be grieved: but truly as the LORD liveth, and as thy soul liveth, there is but a step between me and death...David said unto Achish, If I have now found grace in thine eyes, let them give me a place in some town in the country, that I may dwell there... 1 Samuel 20:3, 27:5

And he said, While the child was yet alive, I fasted and wept: for I said, Who can tell whether GOD will be **gracious** to me, that the child may live? 2 Samuel 12:22

Joab fell to the ground on his face, and bowed himself, and thanked the king: and Joab said, To day thy servant knoweth that I have found **grace** in thy sight, my lord, O king, in that the king hath fulfilled the request of his servant. 2 Samuel 14:22

Then said the king to Ziba, Behold, thine are all that pertained unto Mephibosheth. And Ziba said, I humbly beseech thee that I may find grace in thy sight, my lord, O king. 2 Samuel 16:4

The LORD was **gracious** unto them, and had compassion on them, and had respect unto them, because of his covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and would not destroy them, neither cast he them from his presence as yet. 2 Kings 13:23

For if ye turn again unto the LORD, your brethren and your children shall find compassion before them that lead them captive, so that they shall come again into this land: for the LORD your God is gracious and merciful, and will not turn away his face from you, if you return unto him. 2 Chronicles 30:9

Now for a little space **grace** hath been shewed from the LORD our God, to leave us a remnant to escape, and to give us a nail in his holy place, that our God may lighten our eyes, and give us a little reviving in our bondage. Ezra 9:8

They and our fathers dealt proudly, and hardened their necks, and hearkened not to thy commandments, And refused to obey, neither were they mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou art a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not... Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou art a gracious and merciful God. Nehemiah 9:16-17, 31

The king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained **grace** and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2:17

Then he is **gracious** unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom. Job 33:24

Thou art fairer than the children of men; grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever. Psalm 45:2

Hath God forgotten to be **gracious**? Hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? Selah. Psalms 77:9

For the LORD God is a sun and shield: the LORD will give **grace** and glory: no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. Psalm 84:11

But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth. Psalm 86:15

The LORD is merciful and **gracious**, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. Psalm 103:8

He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered: the LORD is gracious and full of compassion. Psalm 111:4

Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is **gracious**, and full of compassion, and righteous. Psalm 112:4

**Gracious** is the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God is merciful. Psalm 116:5

Remove from me the way of lying: and grant me thy law **graciously**. Psalm 119:29

The LORD is gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. Psalm 145:8

For they shall be an ornament of **grace** unto thy head, and chains about thy neck. Proverbs 1:9

Keep sound wisdom and discretion: So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck. Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble... Proverbs 3:21-23

The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just. Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth **grace** unto the lowly. Proverbs 3:33-34

Wisdom is the principle thing...she shall give to thine head an ornament of **grace**: a crown of glory shall she deliver to thee. Proverbs 4:7, 9

A gracious woman retaineth honour: and strong men retain riches. Proverbs 11:16

He that loveth pureness of heart, for the **grace** of his lips the king shall be his friend. Proverbs 22:11

The words of a wise man's mouth are **gracious**; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself. Ecclesiastes 10:12

Therefore will the LORD wait that he may be **gracious** unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him. For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very **gracious** unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee. Isaiah 30:18-19

O LORD, be **gracious** unto us; we have waited for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble. Isaiah 33:2

O inhabitant of Lebanon, that makest thy next in the cedars, how **gracious** shalt thou be when pangs come upon thee, the pain as of a woman in travail. Jeremiah 22:23

Thus saith the LORD, The people which were left of the sword found grace in the wilderness; even Israel, when I went to cause him to rest. Jeremiah 31:2

Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us **graciously**: so will we render the calves of our lips. Hosea 14:2

Rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he is **gracious** and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil. Joel 2:13

Hate the evil, and love the good, and establish judgment in the gate: it may be that the LORD God of hosts will be **gracious** unto the remnant of Joseph. Amos 5:15

He prayed unto the LORD, and said, I pray thee, O LORD, was not this my saying, when I was yet in my country? Therefore I fled before unto Tarshish: for I knew that thou art a **gracious** God, and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repentest thee of the evil. Jonah 4:2

Who art thou, O great mountain? Before Zerubbabel thou shalt become a plain: and he shall bring forth the headstone thereof with shoutings, crying, **Grace**, grace unto it. Zechariah 4:7

I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of **grace** and of supplications; and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son, and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for his firstborn. Zechariah 12:10

And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be **gracious** unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts. Malachi 1:9

#### GRACE IN NEW COVENANT

The child grew, and waxed strong in spirit, filled with wisdom: and the grace of God was upon him. Luke 2:40

And all bare him witness, and wondered at the **gracious** words which proceeded out of his mouth. And they said, Is not this Joseph's son? Luke 4:22

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of **grace** and truth...And of his fulness have all we received, and **grace for grace**. For the law was given by Moses, but **grace** and truth came by Jesus Christ. John 1:14, 16-17

With great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all. Acts 4:33

Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch. Who, when he came, and had seen the **grace** of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord. Acts 11:22-23

Now when the congregation was broken up, many of the Jews and religious proselytes followed Paul and Barnabas: who, speaking to them, persuaded them to continue in **the grace of God**. Acts 13:43

Long time therefore abode they speaking boldly in the Lord, which gave testimony unto the word of **his grace**, and granted signs and wonders to be done by their hands. When they had preached the word in Perga, they went down into Attalia: And thence sailed to Antioch, from whence they had be recommended to **the grace of God** for the work which they fulfilled...Acts 14:3, 25-26

Now therefore why tempt ye God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they. Acts 15:10-11

Paul chose Silas, and departed, being recommended by the brethren unto the grace of God. Acts 15:40

When he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had believed through **grace**... Acts 18:27

But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God...Brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified. Acts 20:24, 32

Paul, a servant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated unto the gospel of God. (Which he had promised afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures.) Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh: And declared to be the Son of God with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead: By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the faith among all nations, for his name. Among whom are ye also the called of Jesus Christ: to all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the ord Jesus Christ. Romans 1:1-7

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God. To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus. Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? Nay; but by the law of faith. Romans 3:23-27

Now to him that worketh is the reward not reckoned of **grace**, but of debt... Therefore it is of faith, that it might be by **grace**; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the faith of Abraham; who is the father of us all... Romans 4:4, 16

Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom also we have access by faith into this **grace** wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2

But not of the offence, so also is the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift of grace, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many. And not as it was by one that sinned, so is the gift: for the judgment was by one to condemnation, but the free gift is of many offenses utno justification. For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ...Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound: that as sin hath reigned unto death, even so might grace reign through righteousness unto eternal life by Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 5:15-17, 20-21

What shall we say then? ... Shall we continue in sin, that **grace** may abound? ... For sin shall not have dominion over you: for ye are not under the law, but under **grace**. What then? Shall we sin, because we are not under the law, but under **grace**? God forbid. Romans 6:1, 14-15

Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace. And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work. Romans 11:5-6

For I say, through the **grace** given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly thanhe ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith. For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office: So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another. Having then gifts differing according to the **grace** that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith... Romans 12:3-6

I myself also am persuaded of you, my brethren, that ye also are full of goodness, filled with all knowledge, able also to admonish one another. Nevertheless, brethren, I have written the more boldly unto you in some sort, as putting you in mind, because of **the grace** that is given to me of God... Romans 15:14-15

The God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. **The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ** be with you. Amen... **The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ** be with you all. Amen. Romans 16:20, 24

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. I thank my God always on your behalf, for the grace of God which is given you by Jesus Christ... 1 Corinthians 1:3-4

According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon. But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon. 1 Corinthians 3:10

For if I by **grace** be a partaker, why am I evil spoken of for that for which I give thanks? 1 Corinthians 10:30

But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me... The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. 1 Corinthians 15:10, 16:23

Grace be to you and peace from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ...For our rejoicing is this, the testimony of our conscience, that in simplicity and godly sincerity, not with fleshly wisdom, but by the grace of God, we have had our conversation in the world, and more abundantly to you-ward. 2 Corinthians 1:2, 12

For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant **grace** might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 4:15

We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that ye receive not the **grace** of God in vain. 2 Corinthians 6:1

Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the **grace** of God bestowed on the churches in Macedonia...Insomuch that we desired Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also finish in you the same **grace** also. 2 Corinthians 8:1, 6

Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that ye abound in **this grace** also. I speak not by commandment, but by occasion of the forwardness of others, and to prove the sincerity of your love. For ye know **the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ**, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich. 2 Corinthians 8:7-9

Not that only, but who was also chosen of the churches to travel with us with **this grace**, which is administered by us to the glory of the same Lord, and declaration of your ready mind... 2 Corinthians 8:19

God is able to make **all grace** abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work... They glorify God...by their prayer for you, which long after you for the exceeding **grace of God** in you. 2 Corinthians 9:8, 13-14

He said...My **grace** is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Ghost, be with you all. Amen. The second epistle to the Corinthians was written from Philippi, a city of Macedonia, by Titus and Lucas. 2 Corinthians 13:14

Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ...I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel...But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace, To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood... Galatians 1:3, 6, 15

When James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision. Galatians 2:9

I do not frustrate the **grace** of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain...Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from **grace**. Galatians 2:21, 5:4

Brethren, the **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. Unto the Galatians written from Rome. Galatians 6:18

Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ... To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace... Ephesians 1:2, 6-7

But God, who is rich in mercy, Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: that in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Ephesians 2:4-8

If ye have heard of the dispensation of the **grace** of God which is given me to you-ward... Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the **grace** of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power. Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this **grace** given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ... Ephesians 3:2, 7-8

Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister **grace** unto the hearers. Ephesians 4:29

Grace be with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen. Written from Rome unto the Ephesians by Tychicus. Ephesians 6:24

Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ... Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace... Philippians 1:2, 7,

The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. It was written to the Philippians from Rome by Epaphroditus. Philippians 4:3

To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colossae: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ... We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying alwaysfor you, since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love which ye have to all the saints, For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; Which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth... Colossians 1:2-6

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with **grace** in your hearts to the Lord. Colossians 3:16

Let your speech be alway with **grace**, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man... The salutation by the hand of me Paul. Remember my bonds. **Grace** be with you. Amen. Written from Rome to the Colossians by Tychicus and Onesimus. Colossians 4:6, 18

Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians which is in God the Father and in the Lord Jesus Christ; **Grace** be unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ... The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen. The first epistle unto the Thessalonians was written from Athens. 1 Thessalonians 1:1, 5:28

Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ... That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ... The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. The second epistle to the Thessalonians was written from Athens. 2 Thessalonians 1:2, 12, 3:18

Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which hath loved us, and hath given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, comfort your hearts, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen. The second epistle to the Thessalonians was written from Athens. 2 Thessalonians 3:18

To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: **Grace**, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord...The **grace** of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus...Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. **Grace** be with thee. Amen. The first to Timothy was written from Laodicea, which is the chiefest city of Phrygia Pacatiana. 1 Timothy 1:2, 14, 6:21

Be not thou...ashamed...but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God; who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began... 2 Timothy 1:8-9

The Lord Jesus Christ be with thy spirit. **Grace** be with you. Amen. The second epistle unto Timotheus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Ephesians, was written from Rome, when Paul was brought before Nero the second time. 2 Timothy 4:22

To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: **Grace**, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour...For **the grace of God** that bringeth salvation hath appeared to all men... Through Jesus Christ our Saviour; that being justified by his **grace**, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life...All that are with me salute thee. Greet them that love us in the faith. **Grace** be with you all. Amen. It was written to Titus, ordained the first bishop of the church of the Cretians, from Nicopolis of Macedonia. Titus 1:4, 2:11, 3:7, 15

Grace to you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. The **grace** of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit. Amen. Written from Rome to Philemon, by Onesimus, a servant. Philemon 1:3, 25

We see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the **grace** of God should taste death for every man. Hebrews 2:9

For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of **grace**, that we may obtain mercy, and find **grace** to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:15-16

He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? For we know him that hath said, Vengeance belongeth unto me, I will recompense, saith the Lord. And again, The Lord shall judge his people. It is a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the living God. Hebrews 10:28-31

Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fail of the **grace** of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled... Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have **grace**, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: for our God is a consuming fire. Hebrews 12:14-15, 28-29

Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the heart be established with **grace**; not with meats, which have not profited them that have been occupied therein... **Grace** be with you all. Amen. Written to the Hebrews from Italy by Timothy. Hebrews 13:9, 25

For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the **grace** of the fashion of it perisheth: so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways...But he giveth more **grace**. Wherefore he saith, God resisteth the proud, but giveth **grace** unto the humble. James 1:11, 4;6

Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied...Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls. Of which salvation the prophets have enquired and searched diligently, who prophesied of the grace that should come unto you: Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow. Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us, they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 1:2, 9-13

Wherefore, laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious. 1 Peter 2:1-3

Likewise, ye husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honour unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the **grace** of life; that your prayers be not hindered... 1 Peter 3:7

But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to another without grudging. As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold **grace** of God. 1 Peter 4:7-10

Ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth **grace** to the humble... ### **MERCY**

Behold now, thy servant hath found grace in thy sight, and thou hast magnified thy **mercy**, which thou hast shewed unto me in saving my life; and I cannot escape to the mountain, lest some evil take me, and I die: Genesis 19:19

He said, Blessed be the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his **mercy** and his truth: I being in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren. Genesis 24:27

The LORD was with Joseph, and shewed him **mercy**, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison. Genesis 39:21

God Almighty give you **mercy** before the man, that he may send away your other brother, and Bejamin. If I bereaved of my children, I am bereaved. Genesis 43:14

Thou in thy **mercy** hast led forth the people which thou hast redeemed: thou hast guided them in thy strength unto thy holy habitation. Exodus 15:13

Shewing **mercy** unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments. Exodus 20:6, also Deuteronomy 5:10

Thou shalt make a **mercy** seat of pure gold: two cubits and a half shall be the length thereof, and a cubit and a half the breadth thereof. And thou shalt make two cherubims of bold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the **mercy** seat...And thou shalt put the **mercy** seat above upon the ark; and in the ark thou shalt put the testimony that I shall give thee. And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the **mercy** seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel. Exodus 25:17-18, 21-22

Thou shalt put the **mercy** seat upon the ark of the testimony in the most holy place. Exodus 26:34

I will make all my goodness pass before thee, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before thee; and will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and will shew **mercy** on whom I will shew **mercy**. Exodus 33:19

Keeping **mercy** for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:7

The LORD said unto Moses, speak unto Aaron thy brother, that he come not at all times into the holy place within the vail before the mercy seat, which is upon the ark; that he die not: for I will appear in the cloud upon the mercy seat... And he shall put the incense upon the fire before the LORD, that the cloud of the incense may cover the mercy seat that is upon the testimony, that he die not: and he shall take of the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it with his finger upon the mercy seat eastward; and before the mercy seat shall he sprinkle of the blood with his finger seven times. Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that is for the people, and bring his blood within the vail, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat... Leviticus 16:2, 13-15

When Moses was gone into the tabernacle of the congregation to speak with him, then he heard the voice of one speaking unto him from off the mercy seat that was upon the art of testimony, from between the two cherubims: and he spake unto him. Numberbs 7:8-9

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great **mercy**, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy **mercy**, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. Numbers 14:18-19

When the LORD thy God shall deliver them before thee; thou shalt smite them, and utterly destroy them; thou shalt make no covenant with them, nor shew **mercy** unto them... Deuteronomy 7:2

Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and **mercy** with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations... Wherefore it shall come to pass, if ye hearken to these judgments, and keep, and do them, that the LORD thy God shall keep unto thee the covenant and the **mercy** which he sware unto thy fathers... Deuteronomy 7:9, 12

There shall cleave nought of the cursed thing to thine hand: that the LORD may turn from the fierceness of his anger, and shew thee **mercy**, and have compassion upon thee, and multiply thee, as he hath sworn unto thy fathers... Deuteronomy 13:17

The spies saw a man come forth out of the city, and they said unto him, Shew us, we pray thee, the entrance into the city, and we will shew thee mercy. Judges 1:24

But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee. 2 Samuel 7:15

Mercy and truth be with thee. 2 Samuel 15:20

He is the tower of salvation for his king: and sheweth **mercy** to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore. 2 Samuel 22:51

Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

He said, LORD God of Israel, there is no God like thee, in heaven above, or on earth beneath, who keepest covenant and **mercy** with thy servants that walk before thee with all their heart: 1 Kings 8:23, 2 Chronicles 6:14

O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good; for his **mercy** endureth for ever...And with them Heman and Jeduthun, and the rest that were chosen, who were expressed by name, to give thanks to the LORD, because his **mercy** endureth for ever... 1 Chronicles 16:34, 41

Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the **mercy** seat. 1 Chronicles 28:11

Solomon said unto God, Thou hast shewed great **mercy** unto David my father, and hast made me to reign in his stead. 2 Chronicles 1:8

It came to pass, as the trumpeters and singers were as one, to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the LORD; and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of musick, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his **mercy** endureth for ever: that then the house was filled with a cloud, even the house of the LORD... 2 Chronicles 5:13

When all the children of Israel saw how the fire came down, and the glory of the LORD upon the house, they bowed themselves with their faces to the ground upon the pavement, and worshipped, and praised the LORD, saying, For he is good; for his **mercy** endureth for ever...And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of musick of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his **mercy** endureth for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood. 2 Chronicles 7:3, 6

When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his **mercy** endureth for ever. 2 Chronicles 20:21

They sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his **mercy** endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid. Fzra 3:11

Blessed be the LORD God of our fathers, which hath put such a thing as this in the king's heart, to beautify the house of the LORD which is in Jerusalem: And hath extended **mercy** unto me before the king, and his counsellors, and before all the king's mighty princes. And I was strengthened as the hand of the LORD thy God was upon me, and I gathered together out of Israel chief men to go up with me. Ezra 7:27-28

We were bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of our God, and to repair the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah an din Jerusalem. Ezra 9:9

I beseech thee, O LORD God of heaven, the great and terrible God, that keepeth covenant and mercy for them that love him and observe his commandments...O Lord, I beseech thee, let now thine ear be attentive to the prayer of thy servant, and to the prayer of thy servants, who desire to fear thy name: and prosper, I pray thee, thy servant this day, and grant him mercy in the sight of this man. To him which led his people through the wilderness: for his **merc**y endureth for ever. To him which smote great kings: for his mercy endureth for ever: And slew famous kings: for his mercy endureth for ever: Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy endureth for ever: And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy endureth for ever: And gave their land for an heritage: for his **mercy** endureth for ever: Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his **mercy** endureth for ever. When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, and set them on fire: for it is a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have **mercy** on them, and he that formed them will shew them no favour. Isaiah 27:11

Therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have **mercy** upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him. Isaiah 30:18

I was wroth with my people, I have polluted mine inheritance, and given them into thine hand: thou didst shew them no **mercy**; upon the ancient hast thou very heavily laid thy yoke. Isaiah 47:6

They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath **mercy** on them shall lead them, even by the springs of water shall he guide them...Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O montains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have **mercy** upon his afflicted. Isaiah 49:10, 13

In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have **mercy** on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer. For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee. For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath **mercy** on thee. Isaiah 54:8-10

Let the wicked forake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have **mercy** upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon. Isaiah 55:7

The sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee. Isaiah 60:10

They shall lay hold on bow and spear; they are cruel, and have no **mercy**; their voice roareth like the sea; and they ride upon horses, set in array as men for war against thee, O daughter of Zion. Jeremiah 6:23

I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together, saith the LORD: I will not pity, nor spare, nor have **mercy**, but destroy them. Jeremiah 13:14

Afterward, saith the LORD, Iwill deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, and his servants, and the people, and such as are left in this city from the pestilence, from the sword, and from the famine, into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those that seek their life: and he shall smite them with the edge of the sword; he shall not spare them, neither have pity, nor have mercy. Is Ephraim my dear son? is he a pleasant child? for since I spake against him, I do earnestly remember him still: therefore my bowels are troubled for him; I will surely have **mercy** upon him, saith the LORD. Jer 31:20

Again there shall be heard in this place... The voice of joy, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride, the voice of them that shall say, Praise the LORD of Hosts: for the LORD is good; for his **mercy** endureth for ever: and of them that shall bring the sacrifice of praise into the house of the LORD. For I will cause to return the captivity of the land, as at the first, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 33:11

Thus saith the LORD; If my covenant be not with day and night, and if I have not appointed the ordinances of heaven and earth; Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, so that I will not take any of his seed to be rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have **mercy** on them. Jeremiah 33:25-26

I will shew **mercies** unto you, that he may have **mercy** upon you, and cause you to return to your own land. Jeremiah 42:12

They shall hold the bow and the land: they are cruel, and will not shew mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, every one put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon. Jeremiah 50:42

Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Now will I bring again the captivity of Jacob, and have **mercy** upon the whole house of Israel, and will be jealous for my holy name... Ezekiel 39:25

O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing **mercy** to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquility. Daniel 4:27

I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes: And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments; We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments... To the Lord our God belong mercies and forgivenessess... Daniel 9:4-5, 8

She conceived again, and bare a daughter. And God said unto him, call her name Lo-ruhamah: for I will no more have **mercy** upon the house of Israel; but I will utterly take them away. but I will have **mercy** upon the house of Judah, and will save them by the LORD their God, and will not save them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen. Hosea 1:6-7

I will not have **mercy** upon her children; for they be the children of whoredoms. Hosea 2:4

I will sow her unto me in the earth; and I will have **mercy** upon her that had not obtained **mercy**; and I will say to them which were not my people, Thou art my people; and they shall say, Thou art my God. Hosea 2:23

Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because there is no truth, nor **mercy**, nor knowledge of God in the land. Hosea 4:1

O LORD, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O LORD, revive thy work in the midst of the years, in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember **mercy**. Habakkuk 3:2

Then the angel of the LORD answered and said, O LORD of hosts, how long wilt thou not have **mercy** on Jerusalem and on the cities of Judah, against which thou hast had indignation these threescore and ten years? Zechariah 1:12

### MERCY IN THE NEW COVENANT

Blessed are the merciful: for they shall obtain mercy. Matthew 5:7

But go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have **mercy**, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance. Matthew 9:13

When Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, Thou Son of David, have mercy on us. Matthw 9:27

If ye had known what this meaneth, I will have **mercy**, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless. Matthew 12:7

Behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have **mercy** on me, O Lord, thou Son of David; my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil. Matthew 15:22

Lord, have **mercy** on my son: for he is lunatick, and sore vexed: for ofttimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water. Matthew 17:15

Behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have **mercy** on us, O Lord, thou Son of David. And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have **mercy** on us, O Lord, thou Son of David. Matthew 20:31

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, **mercy**, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Matthew 23:23

When he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out, and say, Jesus, thou Son of David, have **mercy** on me. And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, Thou Son of David, have **mercy** on me. Mark 10:47-48

His **mercy** is on them that fear him from generation to generation...He hath holpen his servant Israel, in remembrance of his **mercy**. Luke 1:50, 54

Her neighbours and her counsins heard how the Lord had shewed great mercy upon her; and they rejoiced with her. Luke 1:58

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, and hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David; As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began: That we should be saved from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; To perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember his holy covenant... Though the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us, to give light to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. Luke 1:68-72, 78-79

Which now of these thee, thinkest thou, was neighbour unto him that fell among the thieves? And he said, He that shewed **mercy** on him. then said Jesus unto him, Go, and do thou likewise. Luke 10:36-37

He cried and said, Father Abraham, have **mercy** on me, and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and cool my tongue; for I am tormented in this flame. Luke 16:24

They lifted up their voices, and said, Jesus, Master, have **mercy** on us. Luke 17:13

He cried, saying, Jesus, thou Son of David, have **mercy** on me. And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, Thou Son of David, have **mercy** on me. Luke 18:38-39

For he saith to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. So then it is not of him that willeth, nor of him that runneth, but of God that sheweth mercy... Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardeneth...that he might make known the riches of his glory on the vessels of mercy, which he had afore prepared unto glory, Romans 9:15-18, 23

For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy. For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all. Romans 11:30-32

Having then gifts differing according to the grace given to us...he that exhorteth, on exhortation: he that giveth, let him do it with simplicity; he that ruleth, with diligence; he that showeth **mercy**, with cheerfulness. Let love be without dissumulation. Romans 12:6, 8

That the Gentiles might glorify God for his **mercy**; as it is written, For this cause I will confess to thee among the Gentiles, and sing unto thy name. Romans 15:9

Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that hath obtained **mercy** of the Lord to be faithful. 1 Corinthians 7:25

Therefore seeing we have this ministry, as we have received **mercy**, we faint not. 2 Corinthians 4:1

And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and **mercy**, and upon the Israel of God. Galatians 6:16

God, who is rich in **mercy**, for his great love wherewith he loved us, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus: That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. Ephesians 2:4-7

For indeed he was sick nigh unto death: but God had **mercy** on him; and not on him only, but on me also, lest I should have sorrow upon sorrow. Philippians 2:27

Unto Timothy, my own son in the faith: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. 1 Timothy 1:2

I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief...Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might shew forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:12-13, 16

To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord... The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain: But, when he was in Rome, he sought me out very diligently, and found me. The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day: and in how many things he ministered unto me at Ephesus, thou knowest very well. 2 Timothy 1:2, 16-18

To Titus, mine own son after the common faith: Grace, **mercy**, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour. Titus 1:4

For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another. But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared, not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour...being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life. Titus 3:2-7

Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain **mercy**, and find grace to help in time of need. Hebrews 4:16

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. He that despised Moses' law died without **mercy** under two or three witnesses: Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? Hebrews 10:26-29

For he shall have judgment without **mercy**, that hath shewed no **mercy**; and **mercy** rejoiceth against judgment. James 2:13

The wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and easy to be intreated, full of **mercy** and good fruits, without partiality, and without hypocrisy. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace of them that make peace. James 3:17

Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender **mercy**. James 5:11

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant **mercy** hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you. 1 Peter 1:3-4

Ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained **mercy**, but now have obtained **mercy**. 1 Peter 2:5

Grace be unto you, **mercy**, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. 2 John 1:3

## **MERCY AND TRUTH**

The LORD passed before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:6

# Mercy and truth be with thee. 2 Samuel 15:20

The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he teach his way. All the paths of the LORD are **mercy and truth** unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies. For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great. What man is he that feareth the LORD? Him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose. His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth. The secret of the LORD is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant. Psalm 25:9-14

I delight to do thy will, O my God; yea, thy law is within my heart. I have preached righteousness in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest. I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation. Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness and thy truth continually preserve me. Psalm 40:11

Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast. I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performeth all things for me. He shall send from heaven, and save me from the reproach of him that would swallow me up. Selah. God shall send forth his mercy and his truth. Psalm 57:1-3

My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise. Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake eartly. I will praise thee, O Lord, among the people: I will sing unto thee among the nations. For thy **mercy** is great unto the heavens, and thy **truth** unto the clouds. Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: let thy glory be above all the earth. Psalm 57:7-11

For thou, O God, hast heard my vows: thou hast given me the heritage of those that fear thy name. Thou wilt prolong the king's life: and his years as many generations. He shall abide before God for ever: O prepare mercy and truth, which may preserve him. So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows. Psalm 61:5-8

As forme, my prayer is unto thee, O LORD, in an acceptable time: O God, in the multitude of thy **mercy** hear me, in **the truth** of thy salvation. Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters. Let not the waterflood overflow me, neither let the deep swallow me up, and let not the pit shut her mouth upon me. Psalm 69:13-15

I will hear what God the LORD will speak: for he will speak peace unto his people, and to his saints: but let them not turn again to folly. Surely his salvation is nigh them that fear him; that glory may dwell in our land. Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Psalm 85:8-11

Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in **thy truth**: unite my heart to fear thy name. I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will glorify thy name for evermore. For great is thy **mercy** toward me; and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell. O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent men have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them. Thou hast a mighty arm: strong is thy hands, and high is thy right hand. Justice and judgment are the habitation of thy throne: **mercy and truth** shall go before thy face. Psalm 89:13-14

O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things: his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory. The LORD hath made known his salvation: his righteousness hath he openly shewed in the sight of the heathen. He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth: make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise. Psalm 98:1-4

Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. For the LORD is good; his **mercy** is everlasting; and his **truth** endureth to all generations. Psalm 100:1-5

O GOD, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory. Awake, psaltery and harp: I myself will awake early. I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people: and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations. For thy **mercy** is great above the heavens: and thy **truth** reacheth unto the clouds. Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens: and thy glory above all the earth... Psalm 108:1-5

Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for **thy mercy**, and for **thy truth's** sake. Wherefore should the heathen say, Where is now their God? But our God is in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased. Psalm 115:1-3

O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people. For his merciful kindness is great toward us; and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD. Psalm 117:2

My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments. For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee. Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart: So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man. Proverbs 3:1-4

The poor is hated even of his own neighbour: but the rich hath many friends. He that despiseth his neighbour sinneth: but he that hath mercy on the poor, happy is he. Do they not err that devise evil? But mercy and truth shall be to them that devise good. Proverbs 14:20-22

Every one that is proud in heart is an abomination to the LORD: though hand join in hand, he shall not be unpunished. By **mercy and truth** iniquity is purged: and by the fear of the LORD men depart from evil. When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him. Proverbs 16:5-7

In mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in truth in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness. Isaiah 16:5

### THE TRUTH

Blessed be the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his **truth**: I being in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren. Genesis 24:27

I am not worthy of the least of all the mercies, and of all the **truth**, which thou hast shewed unto thy servant; for with my staff I passed over this Jordan; and now I am become two bands. Genesis 32:10

Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether there be any **truth** in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye are spies. Genesis 42:16

Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens... Exodus 18:21

The LORD passed by before him, and proclaimed, The LORD, The LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth... Exodus 34:6

Then shalt thou enquire, and make search, and ask diligently; and, behold, if it be **truth**, and the thing certain, that such abomination is wrought among you... Deuteronomy 13:14

He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he. Deuteronomy 32:4

Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in **truth**: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flooe, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. Joshua 24:14

Only fear the LORD, and serve him in **truth** with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you. 1 Samuel 12:24

Now the LORD shew kindness and **truth** unto you: and I also will requite you this kindness, because ye have done this thing. 2 Samuel 2:6

Whereas thou camest but yesterday, should I this day make thee go up and down with us? Seeing I go whither I may, return thou, and take back thy brethren: mercy and **truth** be with thee. 2 Samuel 15:20

That the LORD may continue his word which he spake concerning me, saying, If thy children take heed to their way, to walk before me in **truth** with all their heart and with all their soul, there shall not fail thee (said he) a man on the throne of Israel. 1 Kings 2:4

Solomon said, Thou hast shewed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in **truth**, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as it is this day. 1 Kings 3:6

The woman said to Elijah, Now by this I know that thou art a man of God, and that the word of the LORD in thy mouth is **truth**. 1 Kings 17:24

I beseech thee, O LORD, remember now how I have walked before thee in **truth** and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore... Then said Hezekiah unto Isaia, Good is the word of the LORD which thou hast spoken. And he said, Is it not good, if peace and **truth** be in my days? 2 Kings 20:3, 19

The king said to him, How many times shall I adjure thee that thou say nothing but the **truth** to me in the name of the LORD? 2 Chronicle 18:15

Thus did Hezekiah throughout all Judah, and wrought that which was good and right and **truth** before the LORD his God. 2 Chronicles 31:20

He sent the letters unto all the Jews, to the hundred and twenty and seven provinces of the kingdom of Ahasuerus, with words of peace and **truth**... Esther 9:30

Iknow it is so of a truth: but how should man be just with God? Job 9:2

LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy holy hill? He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart. Psalm 15:1-2

Lead me in **thy truth**, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. Psalm 25:5

All the paths of the LORD are mercy and **truth** unto such as keep his covenant and his testimonies. Psalm 25:10

For thy lovingkindness is before mine eyes: and I have walked in thy **truth**. Psalm 26:3

What profit is there in my blood, when I go down to the pit? Shall the dust praise thee? Shall it declare thy **truth**? Psalm 30:9

Into thine hand I commit my spirit: thou hast redeemed me, O LORD God of truth. Psalm 31:5

For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in **truth**. Psalm 33:4

I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy **truth** from the great congregation. Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness and thy **truth** continually preserve me. Psalm 40:10-11

O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles. Psalm 43:3

He hath remembered his mercy and his **truth** toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. Psalm 98:3

For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his **truth** endureth to all generations. Psalm 100:5

In mine ears said the LORD of hosts, Of a **truth** many houses shall be desolate, even great and fair, without inhabitant. Isaiah 5:9

The remnant of Israel, and such as are escaped of the house of Jacob, shall no more again stay upon him that smote them; but shall stay upon the LORD, the Holy One of Israel, in **truth**. Isaiah 10:20

In mercy shall the throne be established: and he shall sit upon it in **truth** in the tabernacle of David, judging, and seeking judgment, and hasting righteousness. Isaiah 16:5

O LORD, thou art my God; I will exalt thee, I will praise thy name; for thou hast done wonderful things; thy counsels of old are faithfulness and truth. Isaiah 25:1

Open ye the gates, that the righteous nation which keepeth the **truth** may enter in. Isaiah 26:2

Remember now, OLORD, I beseech thee, how I have walked before thee in truth and with a perfect heart, and have done that which is good in thy sight. And Hezekiah wept sore. Isaiah 38:3

For the grave cannot praise thee, death can not celebrate thee: they that go down into the pit cannot hope for thy **truth**. The living, the living he shall praise thee, as I do this day: the father to the children shall make known thy **truth**. Isaiah 38:19

A bruised reed shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth. Isaiah 42:3

Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and shew us former things? Let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is **truth**. Isaiah 43:9

Hear ye this, O house of Jacob, which are called by the name of Israel, and are come forth out of the waters of Judah, which swear by the name of the LORD, and make mention of the God of Israel, but not in **truth**, nor in righteousness. Isaiah 48:1

None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for **truth**: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity... Judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for **truth** is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. Yea, **truth** faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey... Isaiah 59:4, 14-15

For the LORD love judgment, I hate robbery for burnt offering; and I will direct their work in **truth**, and I will make an everlasting covenant with them. Isaiah 61:8

He who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of **truth**; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of **truth**; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes. Isaiah 65:16

Thou shalt swear, The LORD liveth, in **truth**, in judgment, and in righteousness; and the nations shall bless themselves in him, and in him shall they glory. Jeremiah 4:2

Run ye to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if ye can find a man, if there be any that executeth judgment, that seeketh the **truth**; and I will pardon it. And though they say, The LORD liveth; surely they swear falsely. O LORD, are not thine eyes upon the **truth**? Thou hast stricken them, but they have not grieved; thou hast consumed them, but they have refused to receive correction: they have made their faces harder than a rock; they have refused to return. Jeremiah 5:1-3

Thou shalt say unto them, This is a nation that obeyeth not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receiveth correction: **truth** is perished, and is cut off from their mouth. Jeremiah 7:28

They bend their tongues like their bow for lies: but they are not valiant for the **truth** upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD. Take ye heed every one of his neighbor, and trust ye not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbor will walk with slanders. And they will deceive every one his neighbour, and will not speak the **truth**: they have taught their tongue to speak lies, and weary themselves to commit iniquity. Jeremiah 9:3-5

Know ye for certain, that if ye put me to death, ye shall surely bring innocent blood upon yourselves, and upon this city, and upon the inhabitants thereof: for of a **truth** the LORD hath sent me unto you to speak all these words in your ears. Jeremiah 26:15

Behold, I will bring it health and cure, and I will cure them, and will reveal unto them the abundance of peace and **truth**...and I will cleanse them from all their iniquity... Jeremiah 33:6, 8

The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a **truth** it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret. Daniel 2:47

Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works are **truth**, and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase. Daniel 4:37

I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the **truth** of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things... Then I would know the **truth** of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth were of iron, and his nails of brass; which devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet... Daniel 7:16, 19

And I saw in a vision...An host was given him against the daily sacrifice by reason of transgression, and it cast down the **truth** to the ground; and it practised, and prospered. Daniel 8:2, 12

As it is written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us; yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand thy **truth**. Daniel 9:13

I will shew thee that which is noted in the scripture of **truth**: and there is none that holdeth with me in these things, but Michael your prince. Daniel 10:21

Now will I shew thee the **truth**. Behold, there shall stand up ye three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than they all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia. Daniel 11:2

Hear the word of the LORD, ye children of Israel: for the LORD hath a controversy with the inhabitants of the land, because thereis no **truth**, nor mercy, nor knowledge of God in the land. Hosea 4:1

Thou wilt perform the **truth** to Jacob, and the mercy to Abraham, which thou hast sworn unto our fathers from the days of old. Micah 7:20

Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of **truth**; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain. Zechariah 8:3

I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be my people, and I will be their God, in **truth** and in righteousness... These are the things that ye shall do; Speak ye every man the **truth** to his neighbour; execute the judgment of **truth** and peace in your gates... Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth, and the fast of the seventh, and the fast of the tenth, shall be to the house of Judah joy and gladness, and cheerful feasts; therefore love the **truth** and peace. Zechariah 8:8, 16, 19

The law of **truth** was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity. Malachi 2:6

#### TRUTH IN THE NEW COVENANT

They that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a **truth** thou art the Son of God. Matthew 14:33

He answered and said, It is not meet to take the children's bread, and to cast it to dogs. She said, **Truth**, Lord: yet the dogs eat of the crumbs which fall from their masters' table. Matthew 15:26-27

They sent out unto him their disciples with the Herodians, saying, Master, we know that thou art **true**, and teachest the way of God in **truth**, neither carest thou for any man: for thou regardest not the person of men. Matthew 22:16

The woman fearing and trembling, knowing what was done in her, came and fell down before him, and told him all the **truth**. Mark 5:33

The scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the **truth**: for there is one God; and there is none other but he... Mark 12:32

I tell you of a **truth**, many widows were in Israel in the days of Elias, when the heaven was shut up three years and six months, when great famine was throughout all the land... Luke 4:25

But I tell you of a **truth**, there be some standing here, which shall not taste of death, till they see the kingdom of God. Luke 9:27

Blessed is that servant, whom his lord when he cometh shall find so doing. Of a **truth** I say unto you, that he will make him ruler over all that he hath. Luke 12:44

He said, Of a **truth** I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all... Luke 21:3

After a little while another saw him, and said, Thou art also of them. And Peter said, Man, I am not. About the space of one hour after another confidently affirmed, saying, Of a **truth** this fellow also was with him: for he is a Galilaean. Luke 22:58-59

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth...For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. John 1:14, 17

Every one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. He that doeth **truth** cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. John 3:20-21

The hour cometh, and now is, when the **true** worshippers shall worship the Father in spirit and in **truth**: for the Father seeketh such to worship him. God is a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship him in spirit and in **truth**. John 4:23-24

Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth. John 5:33

Ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:32

Now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the **truth**, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham... Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in **the truth**, because there is no **truth** in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. And because I tell you the **truth**, ye believe me not. Which of you convinceth me of sin? And if I say th **truth**, why do ye not believe me? John 8:40, 44-46

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, **the truth**, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14:6

If ye love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of **truth**; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. John 14:15-17

When the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of **truth**, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me... John 15:26

I tell you the **truth**; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. When he, **the Spirit of truth**, is come, he will guide you into all **truth**: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. John 16:7, 13

Sanctify them through thy **truth**: thy word is **truth**...for their sakes I sanctify myself, that they also might be sanctified through the **truth**. John 17:17, 19

Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end was I born, and for this cause came I into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice. Pilate saith unto him, What is truth? And he had said this, he went out again unto the Jews, and saith unto them, I find in him no fault at all. John 18:37-38

For of a **truth** against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, for to do whatsoever they hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. Acts 4:27-28

Peter opened his mouth, and said, Of a **truth** I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him. Acts 10:34-35

He said, I am not made, most noble Festus; but speak forth the words of truth and soberness. Acts 26:25

The wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who hold the truth in unrighteousness...who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen. Romans 1:18, 25

We are sure that the judgment of God is according to **truth** against them which commit such things. Romans 2:2

To them who by patient continuance in well-doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey **the truth**, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath... Romans 2:7-8

Thou art...an instructor of the foolish, a teacher of babes, which hast the form of knowledge and of the **truth** in the law. Thou therefore which teachest another, teachest thou not thyself?... Romans 2:20-21

Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for **the truth** of God, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers: Romans 15:8

Let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and **truth**. 1 Corinthians 5:8

Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the **truth**... 1 Corinthians 13:4-6

But if all prophesy, and there come in one that believeth not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he judged of all: And thus are the secrets of his heart made manifest; and so falling down on his face he will worship God, and report that God is in you of a truth. 1 Corinthians 14:24-25

Therefore, seeing we have this ministry, as we have received mercy, we faint not; But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the **truth** commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God. 2 Corinthians 4:1-2

But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses, In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labors, in watchings, in fastings; By pureness, by knowledge, by long-suffering, by kindness, by the Holy Ghost, by love unfeigned. By the word of **truth**, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left, By honor and dishonor, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and yet **true**; As unknown, and yet well known; as dying, and, behold, we live; as chastened, and not killed; As sorrowful, yet always rejoicing; as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, and yet possessing all things. 2 Corinthians 6:4-8

For if I have boasted any thing to him of you, I am not ashamed; but as we spake all things to you in truth, even so our boasting, which I made before Titus, is found a **truth**. 2 Corinthians 7:14

As the **truth** of Christ is in me, no man shall stop me of this boasting in the regions of Achaia. 2 Corinthians 11:10

For though I would desire to glory, I shall not be a fool; for I will say the truth: but now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he seeth me to be, or that he heareth of me. 2 Corinthians 12:6

Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates. For we can do nothing against the **truth**, but for the **truth**. 2 Corinthians 13:7-8

But neither Titus, who was with me, being a Greek, was compelled to be circumcised: And that because of false brethren unawares brought in who came in privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage: To whom we gave place by subjection, no, not for an hour; that the **truth** of the gospel might continue with you. Galatians 2:3-5

The other Jews dissembled likewise with him; insomuch that Barnabas also was carried away with their dissimulation. But when I saw that they walked not uprightly according to the **truth** of the gospel, I said unto Peter before them all, If thou, being a Jew, livest after the manner of Gentiles, and not as do the Jews, why compellest thou the Gentiles to live as do the Jews? Galatians 2:13-14

O foolish Galatians, who hath bewitched you, that ye should not obey the **truth**, before whose eyes Jesus Christ hath been evidently set forth, crucified among you? Galatians 3:1

Am I therefore become your enemy, because I tell you the **truth**? Galatians 4:16

Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the **truth**? Galatians 5:7

We should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of **truth**, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise... Ephesians 1:12-13

... That we henceforth be no more children, tossed to and fro, and carried about with every wind of doctrine, by the sleight of men, and cunning craftiness, whereby they lie in wait to deceive; But speaking the **truth** in love, may grow up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ... Ephesians 4:14-15

But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the **truth** is in Jesus... Ephesians 4:20-21

That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. Wherefore putting away lying, Speak every man truth with his neighbour; for we are members one of another. Ephesians 4:22-25

The fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth; Ephesians 5:9

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplace of righteousness... Ephesians 6:14

The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerly, supposing to add affliction to my bonds: But the other of love, knowing that I am set for the defense of the gospel. What then? Notwithstanding, every way, whether in pretence, or in **truth**, Christ is preached; and I therein do rejoice, yea, and will rejoice. Philippians 1:16-18

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you... For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the **truth** of the gospel; which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in **truth**: Colossians 1:3, 5-6

For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in **truth**, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work... With all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the **truth**, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the **truth**, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. ... But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the **truth**: Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 2:7, 10-14

I exhort therefore, that, first of all supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men... For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth... Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity. 1 Timothy 2:2:1, 3-4, 7

These things write I unto thee, hoping to come unto thee shortly: But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of **the truth**. 1 Timothy 3:14-15

Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth. 1 Timothy 4:1-3

He is proud, knowing nothing, but doting about questions and strifes of words, whereof cometh envy, strife, railings, evil surmisings, Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of **the truth**, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself. But godliness with contentment is great gain. 1 Timothy 6:4-6

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing **the word of truth**. But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenneus and Philetus; Who concerning **the truth** have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some. 2 Timothy 2:15-18

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of **the truth**; And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:24-26

Of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts, Ever learning, and never able to come to the knowledge of **the truth**. Now as Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist **the truth**. 2 Timothy 3:6-8

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from **the truth**, and shall be turned unto fables. 2 Timothy 4:3-4

Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of **the truth** which is after godliness; In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began... Titus 1:1-2

This witness is **true**. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith; not giving heed to Jewish fables, and commandments of men, that turn from **the truth**. Titus 1:13-14

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of **the truth**, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, But a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries. Hebrews 10:26-27

Of his own will begat he us with **the word of truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures. James 1:18

Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom. But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your hearts, glory not, and lie not against the truth. James 3:13-14

Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way, shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins. James 5:19-20

Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in **the present** truth. 2 Peter 1:12

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently... 2 Peter 1:21-22

Many follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. 2 Peter 2:2

If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not **the truth**: But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin. If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and **the truth** is not in us. 1 John 1:6-8

He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him...I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth. Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son... But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. 1 John 2:4, 21-22, 27

My little children, let us not love in words, neither in tongue; but in deed and in **truth**. And hereby we know that we are of **the truth**, and shall assure our hearts before him. 1 John 3:18-19

We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; he that is not of God heareth not us. Hereby know we **the spirit of truth**, and the spirit of error... This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is **truth**. 1 John 4:6, 5:6

The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I love in the truth; and not I only, but also all they that have known the truth; For the truth's sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever. Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father. 2 John 1:1-4

The elder unto the wellbeloved Gaius, whom I love in the truth. For I rejoiced greatly, when the brethren came and testified of the truth that is in thee, even as thou walkest in the truth. I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth. We therefore ought to receive such, that we might be fellowhelpers to the truth. Demetrius hath good report of all men, and of the truth itself; yea, and we also bear record; and ye know that our record is true. 3 John 1:1, 3-4, 8, 12

## **FAVOUR**

My Lord, if now I have found **favour** in thy sight, pass not away, I pray thee, from thy servant: Genesis 18:3

Leah was tender eyed; but Rachel was beautiful and well **favoured**. Genesis 29:17

Laban said unto him, I pray thee, if I have found **favour** in thine eyes, tarry: for I have learned by experience that the LORD hath blessed me for thy sake. Genesis 30:27

He left all that he had in Joseph's hand; and he knew not ought he had, save the bread which he did eat. And Joseph was a goodly person, and well **favoured**. Genesis 39:6

The LORD was with Joseph, and shewed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison. Genesis 39:21

Behold, there came up out of the river seven well favoured kine and fatfleshed; and they fed in a meadow. And, behold, seven other kine came up after them out of the river, ill favoured and leanfleshed; and stood by the other kine upon the brink of the river. And the ill favoured and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well favoured and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke...And the seven thin and ill favoured kine that came up after them are seven years; and the seven empty ears blasted with the east wine shall be seven years of famine. Genesis 41:2-4, 27

I will give this people **favour** in the sight of the Egyptians: and it shall come to pass, that, when ye go, ye shall not go empty: Exodus 3:21

The LORD gave the people **favou**r in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses was very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people. Exodus 11:3

The LORD gave the people **favour** in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them such things as they required. And they spoiled the Egyptians. Exodus 12:36

Moses said unto the LORD, Wherefore hast thou afflicted thy servant? and wherefore have I not found **favour** in thy sight, that thou layest the burden of all this people upon me? Numbers 11:11

If thou deal thus with me, kill me, I pray thee, out of hand, if I have found favour in thy sight; and let me not see my wretchedness. Numbers 11:15

Of Naphtali he said, O Naphtali, satisfied with **favour**, and full with the blessing of the LORD: possess thou the west and the south. Deuteronomy 33:23

For it was of the LORD to harden their hearts, that they should come against Israel in battle, that he might destroy them utterly, and that they might have no **favour**, but that he might destroy them, as the LORD commanded Moses. Joshua 11:20

It shall be, when their fathers or their brethren come unto us to complain, that we will say unto them, Be **favourable** unto them for our sakes: because we reserved not to each man his wife in the war: for ye did not give unto them at this time, that ye should be guilty. Judges 21:22

Let me find **favour** in thy sight, my lord; for that thou hast comforted me, and for that thou hast spoken friendly unto thine handmaid, though I be not like unto one of thine handmaidens. Ruth 2:13

The child Samuel grew on, and was in **favour** both with the LORD, and also with men. 1 Samuel 2:26

Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight. 1 Samuel 16:22

He said, Let me go, I pray thee; for our family hath a sacrifice in the city; and my brother, he hath commanded me to be there: and now, if I have found **favour** in thine eyes, let me get away, I pray thee, and see my brethren. Therefore he cometh not unto the king's table. 1 Samuel 20:29

Ask thy young men, and they will shew thee. Wherefore let the young men find **favour** in thine eyes: for we come in a good day: give, I pray thee, whatsoever cometh to thine hand unto thy servants, and to thy son David. 1 Samuel 25:8

Then Achish called David, and said unto him, Surely, as the LORD liveth, thou hast been upright, and thy going out and thy coming in with me in the hosts is good in my sight: for I have not found evil in thee since the day of thy coming unto me unto this day: nevertheless the lords favour thee not. 1 Samuel 29:6

The king said unto Zadok, Carry back the ark of God into the city: if I shall find **favour** in the eyes of the LORD, he will bring me again, and shew me both it, and his habitation: 2 Samuel 15:25

One of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that **favoureth** Joab, and he that is for David, let him go after Joab. 2 Samuel 20:11

Hadad found great **favour** in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen. 1 Kings 11:19

I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found **favour** in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it. Nehemiah 2:5

When the turn of Esther, the daughter of Abihail the uncle of Mordecai, who had taken her for his daughter, was come to go in unto the king, she required nothing but what Hegai the king's chamberlain, the keeper of the women, appointed. And Esther obtained **favour** in the sight of all them that looked upon her. Esther 2:15

The king loved Esther above all the women, and she obtained grace and favour in his sight more than all the virgins; so that he set the royal crown upon her head, and made her queen instead of Vashti. Esther 2:17

It was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, that she obtained **favour** in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre that was in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre...If I have found **favour** in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said. Esther 5:2, 8

Then Esther the queen answered, and said, If I have found **favour** in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request... If it please the king, and if I have found **favour** in his sight, and the thing seem right before the king, and I be pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which are in all the king's provinces: Esther 7:3, 8:5

Thou hast granted me life and **favour**, and thy visitation hath preserved my spirit. Job 10:12

He shall pray unto God, and he will be **favourable** unto him: and he shall see his face with joy: for he will render unto man his righteousness. Job 33:26

For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; with **favour** wilt thou compass him as with a shield. Psalm 5:12

For his anger endureth but a moment; in his **favour** is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning. And in my prosperity I said, I shall never be moved. LORD, by thy **favour** thou hast made my mountain to stand strong: thou didst hide thy face, and I was troubled. Psalm 30:5-7

Let them shout for joy, and be glad, that **favour** my righteous cause: yea, let them say continually, Let the LORD be magnified, which hath pleasure in the prosperity of his servant. Psalm 35:27

By this I know that thou **favourest** me, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me. Psalm 41:11

For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a **favour** unto them. Psalm 44:3

The daughter of Tyre shall be there with a gift; even the rich among the people shall intreat thy **favour**. Psalm 45:12

Will the Lord cast off for ever? and will he be **favourable** no more? Psalm 77:7

LORD, thou hast been **favourable** unto thy land: thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob. Psalm 85:1

For thou art the glory of their strength: and in thy **favour** our horn shall be exalted. Psalm 89:17

Thou shalt arise, and have mercy upon Zion: for the time to **favour** her, yea, the set time, is come. For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and **favour** the dust thererof. Psalm 102:13-14

Remember me, O LORD, with the **favour** that thou bearest unto thy people: O visit me with thy salvation... Psalm 106:4

Let there be none to extend mercy unto him: neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children. Psalm 109:12

A good man sheweth **favour**, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion. Psalm 112:5

I intreated thy **favour** with my whole heart: be merciful unto me according to thy word. Psalm 119:58

My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments: For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee. Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart. So shalt thou find **favour** and good understanding in the sight of God and man. Proverbs 3:1-4

Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not. Blessed is the man that heareth me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. For whoso findeth me findeth life, and shall obtain **favour** of the LORD. Proverbs 8:33-35

He that diligently seeketh good procureth **favour**: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him. Proverbs 11:27

A good man obtaineth **favour** of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn. Proverbs 12:2

Good understanding giveth **favour**: but the way of the transgressors is hard. Proverbs 13:15

Fools make a mock at sin: but among the righteous there is **favour**. Proverbs 14:9

The king's **favour** is toward a wise servant: but his wrath is against him that causeth shame. Proverbs 14:35

In the light of the king's countenance is life; and his **favour** is as a cloud of the latter rain. Proverbs 16:15

Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth **favour** of the LORD. Proverbs 18:22

Many will intreat the **favour** of the prince: and every man is a friend to him that giveth gifts. Proverbs 19:6

The king's wrath is as the roaring of a lion; but his **favour** is as dew upon the grass. Proverbs 19:12

The soul of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbour findeth no **favour** in his eyes. Proverbs 21:10

A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving **favour** rather than silver and gold. Proverbs 22:1

He that rebuketh a man afterwards shall find more **favour** than he that flattereth with the tongue. Proverbs 28:23

Many seek the ruler's **favour**; but every man's judgment cometh from the LORD. Proverbs 29:26

**Favour** is deceitful, and beauty is vain: but a woman that feareth the LORD, she shall be praised. Proverbs 31:30

I returned, and saw under the sun, that the race is not to the swift, nor the battle to the strong, neither yet bread to the wise, nor yet riches to men of understanding, nor yet **favour** to men of skill; but time and chance happeneth to them all. Ecclesiastes 9:11

Let **favour** be shewed to the wicked, yet will he not learn righteousness: in the land of uprightness will he deal unjustly, and will not behold the majesty of the LORD. Isaiah 26:10

When the boughs thereof are withered, they shall be broken off: the women come, and set them on fire: for it is a people of no understanding: therefore he that made them will not have mercy on them, and he that formed them will shew them no **favour**. Isaiah 27:11

The sons of strangers shall build up thy walls, and their kings shall minister unto thee: for in my wrath I smote thee, but in my favour have I had mercy on thee. Isaiah 60:10

Therefore will I cast you out of this land into a land that ye know not, neither ye nor your fathers; and there shall ye serve other gods day and night; where I will not shew you **favour**. Jeremiah 16:18

The anger of the LORD hath divided them; he will no more regard them: they respected not the persons of the priests, they **favoured** not the elders. Lamentations 4:16

The king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring certain of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes; Children in whom was no blemish, but **wellfavoured**, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as had ability in them to stand in the king's palace...Daniel 1:3-4

Now God had brought Daniel into **favour** and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs. Daniel 1:9

The angel came in unto her, and said, Hail, thou that art highly **favoured**, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women. And when she saw him, she was troubled at his saying, and cast in her mind what manner of salutaion this should be. And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found **favour** with God. Luke 1:28-30

Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in **favour** with God and man. Luke 2:52

They, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart. Praising God, and having **favour** with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved. Acts 2:46-47

The patriarchs, moved with envy, sold Joseph into Egypt: but God was with him, and delivered him out of all his afflictions, and gave him **favour** and wisdom in the sight of Pharaoh king of Egypt; and he made him governor over Egypt and all his house. Acts 7:9-10

Then the high priest and the chief of the Jews informed him against Paul, and besought him. And desired **favour** against him, that he would send for him to Jerusalem, laying wait in the way to kill him. Acts 25:2-3

## **FORGIVENESS**

So shall ye say unto Joseph, **Forgive**, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sins; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him. Genesis 50:17

Now therefore **forgive**, I pray thee, my sin only this once, and intreat the LORD your God, that he may take away from me this death only. Exodus 10:17

Yet now, if thou wilt **forgive** their sin; and if not, blot me, I pray thee, out of thy book which thou hast written. Exodus 32:32

Keeping mercy for thousand, **forgiving** iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear the guilty; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth generation. Exodus 34:7

And he shall do with the bullock as he did with the bullock for a sin offering, so shall he do with this: and the priest shall make an atonement for them, and it shall be **forgiven** them. Leviticus 4:20

And he shall burn all his fat upon the altar, as the fat of the sacrifice of peace offerings: and the priest shall make an atonement for him as concerning his sin, and it shall be forgiven him. Levitcus 4:26

And he shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat is taken away from off the sacrifice of peace offerings; and the priest shall burn it upon the altar for a sweet savour unto the LORD; and the priest shall make an atonement for him, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 4:31

And he shall take away all the fat thereof, as the fat of the lamb is taken away from the sacrifice of the peace offerings; and the priest shall burn them upon the altar, according to the offerings made by fire unto the LORD: and the priest shall make an atonement for his sin that he hath committed, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 4:35

And he shall offer the second for a burnt offering, according to the manner: and the priest shall make an atonement for him for his sin which he hath sinned, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 5:10

And the priest shall make an atonement for him as touching his sin that he hath sinned in one of these, and it shall be **forgiven** him: and the remnant shall be the priest's as a meat offering. Leviticus 5:13

And he shall make amends for the harm that he hath done in the holy thing, and shall add the fifth part thereto, and give it unto the priest; and the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 5:16

And he shall bring a ram without blemish out of the flock, with thy estimation, for a trespass offering, unto the priest: and the priest shall make an atonement for him concerning his ignorance wherein he erred and wist it not, and it shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 5:18

And the priest shall make an atonement for him before the LORD: and it shall be **forgiven** him for any thing of all that he hath done in trespassing therein. Leviticus 6:7

And the priest shall make an atonement for him with the ram of the trespass offering before the LORD for his sin which he hath done; and the sin which he hath done shall be **forgiven** him. Leviticus 19:22

The LORD is longsuffering, and of great mercy, **forgiving** iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation. Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast **forgiven** this people, from Egypt even until now. Numbers 14:18-19

And the priest shall make an atonement for all the congregation of the children of Israel, and it shall be **forgiven** them; for it is ignorance: and they shall bring their offering, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD, and their sin offering before the LORD, for their ignorance: Numbers 15:25

And it shall be **forgiven** all the congregation of the children of Israel, and the stranger that sojourneth among them; seeing all the people were in ignorance. Numbers 15:26

And the priest shall make an atonement for the soul that sinneth ignorantly, when he sinneth by ignorance before the LORD, to make an atonement for him; and it shall be **forgiven** him. Numbers 15:28

But if her father disallow her in the day that he heareth; not any of her vows, or of her bonds wherewith she hath bound her soul, shall stand: and the LORD shall **forgive** her, because her father disallowed her....But if her husband disallowed her on the day that he heard it; then he shall make her vow which she vowed, and that which she uttered with her lips, wherewith she bound her soul, of none effect; and the LORD shall **forgive** her. Numbers 30:5, 8

But if her husband hath utterly made them void on the day he heard them; then whatsoever proceeded out of her lips concerning her vows, or concerning the bond of her soul, shall not stand: her husband hath made them void; and the LORD shall **forgive** her. Numbers 30:12

Be merciful, O LORD, unto thy people Israel, whom thou hast redeemed, and lay not innocent blood unto thy people of Israel's charge. And the blood shall be **forgiven** them. Deuteronomy 21:8

And Joshua said unto the people, Ye cannot serve the LORD: for he is an holy God; he is a jealous God; he will not **forgive** your transgressions nor your sins. Joshua 24:19

I pray thee, **forgive** the trespass of thine handmaid: for the LORD will certainly make my lord a sure house; because my lord fighteth the battles of the LORD, and evil hath not been found in thee all thy days. 1 Samuel 25:28

And hearken thou to the supplication of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, when they shall pray toward this place: and hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place: and when thou hearest, **forgive**. 1 Kings 8:30

Then hear thou in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest unto their fathers. 1 Kings 8:34

Then hear thou in heaven, and **forgive** the sin of thy servants, and of thy people Israel, that thou teach them the good way wherein they should walk, and give rain upon thy land, which thou hast given to thy people for an inheritance. 1 Kings 8:36

Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, even thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;) 1 Kings 8:39

And forgive thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive, that they may have compassion on them: 1 Kings 8:50

Hearken therefore unto the supplications of thy servant, and of thy people Israel, which they shall make toward this place: hear thou from thy dwelling place, even from heaven; and when thou hearest, **forgive**. 2 Chronicles 6:21

Then hear thou from the heavens, and **forgive** the sin of thy people Israel, and bring them again unto the land which thou gavest to them and to their fathers. 2 Chr onicles 6:25

Then hear thou from heaven, and **forgive** the sin of thy servants, and of thy people Israel, when thou hast taught them the good way, wherein they should walk; and send rain upon thy land, which thou hast given unto thy people for an inheritance. 2 Chronicles 6:27

Then hear thou from heaven thy dwelling place, and **forgive**, and render unto every man according unto all his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou only knowest the hearts of the children of men:) 2 Chronicles 6:30

If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will **forgive** their sin, and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14

Look upon mine affliction and my pain; and forgive all my sins. Psalm 25:18

Blessed is he whose transgression is **forgiven**, whose sin is covered. Psalm 32:1

Thou hast forgiven the iniquity of thy people, thou hast covered all their sin. Selah. Psalm 85:2

For thou, Lord, art good, and ready to **forgive**; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee. Psalm 86:5

Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; Psalm 103:3

But there is **forgiveness** with thee, that thou mayest be feared. Psalm 130:4

And the mean man boweth down, and the great man humbleth himself; therefore forgive them not. Isaiah 2:9

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity. Isaiah 33:24

Yet, LORD, thou knowest all their counsel against me to slay me: **forgive** not their iniquity, neither blot out their sin from thy sight, but let them be overthrown before thee; deal thus with them in the time of thine anger. Jeremiah 18:23

And they shall teach no more every man his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, Know the LORD: for they shall all know me, from the least of them unto the greatest of them, saith the LORD: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more. Jeremiah 31:34

It may be that the house of Judah will hear all the evil which I purpose to do unto them; that they may return every man from his evil way; that I may **forgive** their iniquity and their sin. Jeremiah 36:3

To the Lord our God belong mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him; Daniel 9:9

O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive; O Lord, hearken and do; defer not, for thine own sake, O my God: for thy city and thy people are called by thy name. Daniel 9:19

And it came to pass, that when they had made an end of eating the grass of the land, then I said, O Lord GOD, **forgive**, I beseech thee: by whom shall Jacob arise? For he is small. Amos 7:2

## FORGIVENESS IN NEW COVENANT

And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. Matthew 6:12

For if ye **forgive** men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: Matthew 6:15

And, behold, they brought to him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their faith said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be **forgiven** thee. Matthew 9:2

For whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be **forgiven** thee; or to say, Arise, and walk? Matthew 9:5

But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to **forgive** sins, (then saith he to the sick of the palsy,) Arise, take up thy bed, and go unto thine house. Matthew 9:6

Wherefore I say unto you, All manner of sin and blasphemy shall be forgiven unto men: but the blasphemy against the Holy Ghost shall not be forgiven unto men. Matthew 12:31

And whosoever speaketh a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be **forgiven** him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come. Matthew 12:32

Then came Peter to him, and said, Lord, how oft shall my brother sin against me, and I forgive him? Till seven times? Matthew 18:21

So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses. Matthew 18:35

When Jesus saw their faith, he said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, thy sins be forgiven thee. Mark 2:5

Why doth this man thus speak blasphemies? Who can **forgive** sins but God only? Mark 2:7

Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, Thy sins be **forgiven** thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk? But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,) Mark 2:9-10

Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be **forgiven** unto the sons of men, and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never **forgiveness**, but is in danger of eternal damnation: Mark 3:28-29

That seeing they may see, and not perceive; and hearing they may hear, and not understand; lest at any time they should be converted, and their sins should be **forgiven** them. Mark 4:12

And when ye stand praying, **forgive**, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not **forgive**, neither will your Father which is in heaven **forgive** your trespasses. Mark 11:25-26

And when he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are **forgiven** thee. And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can **forgive** sins, but God alone? Luke 5:20-21

Whether is easier, to say, Thy sins be **forgiven** thee; or to say, Rise up and walk? But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power upon earth to **forgive** sins, (he said unto the sick of the palsy,) I say unto thee, Arise, and take up thy couch, and go into thine house. Luke 5:23-24

Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: **forgive**, and ye shall be forgiven: Luke 6:37

Wherefore I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are forgiven; for she loved much: but to whom little is forgiven, the same loveth little. And he said unto her, Thy sins are forgiven. And they that sat at meat with him began to say within themselves, Who is this that forgiveth sins also? Luke 7:47-49

And forgive us our sins; for we also forgive every one that is indebted to us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil. Luke 11:4

And whosoever shall speak a word against the Son of man, it shall be forgiven him: but unto him that blasphemeth against the Holy Ghost it shall not be forgiven. Luke 12:10

Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repent, **forgive** him. Luke 17:3

And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt **forgive** him. Luke 17:4

Then said Jesus, Father, **forgive** them; for they know not what they do. And they parted his raiment, and cast lots. Luke 23:34

Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give repentance to Israel, and **forgiveness** of sins. Acts 5:31

Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgive thee. Acts 8:22

Be it known unto you therefore, men and brethren, that through this man is preached unto you the **forgiveness** of sins: Acts 13:38

To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive **forgiveness** of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me. Acts 26:18

Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are **forgiven**, and whose sins are covered. Romans 4:7

So that contrariwise ye ought rather to **forgive** him, and comfort him, lest perhaps such a one should be swallowed up with overmuch sorrow. 2 Cointhians 2:7

To whom ye forgive any thing, I **forgive** also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I **forgave** it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ... 2 Corinthians 2:10

For what is it wherein ye were inferior to other churches, except it be that I myself was not burdensome to you? **Forgive** me this wrong. 2 Corinthians 12:13

In whom we have redemption through his blood, the **forgiveness** of sins, according to the riches of his grace; Ephesians 1:7

And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, **forgiving** one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the **forgiveness** of sins: Colossians 1:14

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having **forgiven** you all trespasses; Colossians 2:13

And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be **forgiven** him. James 5:15

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to **forgive** us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

I write unto you, little children, because your sins are **forgive**n you for his name's sake. 1 John 2:12

## REPENT

God is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man that he should **repent**: hath he said, and shall he not do it? Or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good? Numbers 23:19

For the LORD shall judge his people, and **repent** himself for his servants, when he seeth that their power is gone, and there is none shut up, or left. Deuteronomy 32:36

The Strength of Israel will not lie nor **repent**: for he is not a man, that he should repent. 1 Samuel 15:29

If they shall bethink themselves in the land whither they were carried captives, and **repent**, and make supplication unto thee in the land of them that carried them captives, saying, We have sinned, and have done perversely, we have committed wickedness; And so return unto thee with all their heart, and with all their soul, in the land of their enemies, which led them away captives, and pray unto thee toward their land, which thou gavest unto their fathers, the city which thou hast chosen, and the house which I have built for thy name: Then hear thou their prayer and their supplication in heaven thy dwelling place, and maintain their cause, and forgive thy people that have sinned against thee, and all their transgressions wherein they have transgressed against thee, and give them compassion before them who carried them captive... 1 Kings 8:47-50

I abhor myself, and repent in dust and ashes. Job 42:6

The LORD hath sworn, and will not **repent**, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. Psalm 110:4

For this shall the earth mourn, and the heavens above be black: because I have spoken it, I have purposed it, and will not **repent**, neither will I turn back from it. Jeremiah 4:28

No man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? Every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle...If that nation, against whom I have pronounced, turn from their evil, I will repent of the evil that I thought to do unto them. And at what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom, to build and to plant it; If it do evil in my sight, that it obey not my voice, then I will repent of the good, wherewith I said I would benefit them. Jeremiah 8:6, 18:8-10

Let that man be as the cities which the LORD overthrew, and **repented** not: and let him hear the cry in the morning, and the shouting at noontide; Because he slew me not from the womb... Jeremiah 20:16-17

If so be they will hearken, and turn every man from his evil way, that I may **repent** me of the evil, which I purpose to do unto them because of the evil of their doings... Therefore now amend your ways and your doings, and obey the voice of the LORD your God; and the LORD will **repent** him of the evil that he hath pronounced against you. Jeremiah 26:3, 13

Surely after that I was turned, I **repented**; and after that I was instructed, I smote upon my thigh: I was ashamed, yea, even confounded, because I did bear the reproach of my youth. Jeremiah 31:19

If ye will still abide in this land, then will I build you, and not pull you down, and I will plant you, and not pluck you up: for I repent me of the evil that I have done unto you. Jeremiah 42:10

Therefore say unto the house of Israel, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Repent**, and turn yourselves from your idols; and turn away your faces from all your abominations. Ezekiel 14:6

I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways, saith the Lord GOD. **Repent**, and turn yourselves from all your transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. Ezekiel 18:30

I the LORD have spoken it: it shall come to pass, and I will do it, I will not go back, neither will I spare, neither will I repent; according to thy ways, and according to thy doings, shall they judge thee, saith the Lord GOD. Ezekiel 24:14

I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes. Hosea 13:14

Who knoweth if he will return and **repent**, and leave a blessing behind him; even a meat offering and a drink offering unto the LORD your God? Joel 2:14

Who can tell if God will turn and **repent**, and turn away from his fierce anger, that we perish not? Jonah 3:9

## REPENTANCE IN NEW COVENANT

John...Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand...Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance...I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire. Matthew 3:2, 8, 11

From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, **Repent**: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. Matthew 4:17

Go ye and learn what that meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice: for I am not come to call the righteous, but sinners to **repentance**. Matthew 9:13

Then began he to upbraid the cities wherein most of his mighty works were done, because they **repented** not: Woe unto thee, Chorazin! Woe unto thee, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works, which were done in you, had been done in Tyre and Sidon, they would have **repented** long ago in sackcloth and ashes. Matthew 11:20-21

The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they **repented** at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here. Matthew 12:41

But what think ye? A certain man had two sons; and he came to the first and said, Son, go work to-day in my vineyard. He answered and said, I will not: but afterward he **repented**, and went. And he came to the second, and said likewise. And he answered and said, I go, sir: and went not. Whether of them twain did the will of his father? They say unto him, the first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you. For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and ye believed him not: but the publicans and the harlots believed him: and ye, when ye had seen it, repented not afterward, taht ye might believe him. Matthew 21:28-32

Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, **repented** himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, I have sinned in that I have betrayed the innocent blood. And they said, What is that to us? See thou to that. And he cast down the pieces of silver in the temple, and departed, and went and hanged himself. Matthew 26:3-5

John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of **repentance** for the remission of sins... After that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God, and saying, The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand: **repent** ye, and believe the gospel. Mark 1:4, 14-15

When Jesus heard it, he saith unto them, They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick, I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to **repentance**. Mark 2:17

They went out, and preached that men should repent. Mark 6:12

He came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance for the remission of sins... Luke 3:3

Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of **repentance**, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. Luke 3:8

I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance. Luke 5:32

Woe unto thee, Chorazin! Woe unto thee, Bethsaida! For if the mighty works had been done in Tyre and Sidon, which have been done in you, they had a great while ago **repented**, sitting in sackcloth and ashes. Luke 10:13

There were present at that season some that told him of the Galilaeans, whose blood Pilate had mingled with their sacrifices. And Jesus answering said unto them, Suppose ye that these Galileans were sinners above all the Galileans, because they suffered such things? I tell you, Nay; but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem? I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish. Luke 13:1-5

I say unto you, that likewise joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that **repenteth**, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no **repentance**...I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that **repenteth**. Luke 15:7, 10

Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he **repent**, forgive him. And if he trespass against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I **repent**; thou shalt forgive him. Luke 17:3-4

Abraham said unto him, They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear them. And he said, Nay, father Abraham: but if one went unto them from the dead, they will **repent**. And he said unto him, If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. Luke 16:29-31

Jesus...said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behoved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: and that **repentance** and remission of sins should be preached in his name among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. And ye are witnesses of these things. Luke 24:46-48

Peter said unto them, **Repent**, and be baptized everyone of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:38

**Repent** ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord; Acts 3:19

The God of our fathers raised up Jesus, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree. Him hath God exalted with his right hand to be a Prince and a Saviour, for to give **repentance** to Israel, and forgiveness of sins. Acts 5:30-31

**Repent** therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. Acts 8:22

When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then hath God also to the Gentiles granted **repentance** unto life. Acts 11:18

Of this man's seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus: When John had first preached before his coming the baptism of **repentance** to all the people of Israel. Acts 13:23-24

The times of this ignorance God winked at; but now commandeth all men every where to **repent**: because he hath appointed a day, in the which he will judge the world in righteousness by that man whom he hath ordained; whereof he hath given assurance unto all men, in that he hath raised him from the dead. Acts 17:30-31

Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should believe on him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. Acts 19:4

Paul...serving the Lord with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews...I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have shewed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house, testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, **repentance** toward God, and faith toward our Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:19-21

O king Agrippa, I was not disobedient unto the heavenly vision: But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and then to the Gentiles, that they should **repent** and turn to God, and do works meet for **repentance**. Acts 26:19-20

Despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance? Romans 2:4

For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance. Romans 11:29

For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent: for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though it were but for a season. Now I rejoice, nto that ye were made sorry, but that ye sorrowed to repentance: for ye were made sorry after a godly manner, that ye might receive damage by us in nothing. For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death. 2 Corinthians 7:8-10

For I fear...lest there be debates, envyings, wraths, strifes, backbitings, whisperings, swellings, tumults: and lest, when I come again, my God will humble me among you, and that I shall bewail many which have sinned already, and have not **repented** of the uncleanness and fornication and lasciviousness which they have committed. 2 Corinthians 12:20-21

The servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, in meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them **repentance** to the acknowledging of the truth; and that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. 2 Timothy 2:24-26

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of **repentance** from dead works, and of faith toward God, of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and of eternal judgment. And this will we do, if God permit. Hebrews 6:1-3

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come, if they shall fall away, to renew them again unto **repentance**; seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame. Hebrews 4:4-6

The Lord sware and will not **repent**, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchisedec... Hebrews 7:21

For ye know how that afterward, when he would have inherited the blessing, he was rejected: for he found no place of **repentance**, though he sought it carefully with tears. Hebrews 12:17

The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to **repentance**. 2 Peter 3:9

Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and **repent**, and do the first works; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place, except thou **repent**. Revelation 2:5

**Repent**; or else I will come unto thee quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth. Revelation 2:16

I gave her space to **repent** of her fornication; and she **repented** not. Behold, I will cast her into a bed, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, except they **repent** of their deeds. Revelation 2:21-22

Remember therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast, and **repent**. If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I come upon thee....As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and **repent**. Revelation 3:3, 19

The rest of the men which had not killed by these plagues yet **repented** not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: Neither **repented** they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts. Revelation 9:20-21

And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they **repented** not to give him glory. And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, and blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds. Revelation 16:9-11
