Adultery in heart

That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his **heart**. Matthew 5:28

Affected heart

Mine eye affecteth mine heart because of all the daughters of my city. La 3:51

All my heart,

I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my **heart**: and I will glorify thy name for evermore. Psalms 86:12

All thine heart, your, their, the, all that was in, all his heart

But if from thence thou shalt seek the LORD thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. Deuteronomy 4:29

And thou shalt love the LORD thy God with all thine **heart**, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. Deuteronomy 6:5

Let his **heart** be changed from man's, and let a beast's **heart** be given unto him; and let seven times pass over him. Daniel 4:16

He was driven from the sons of men; and his **heart** was made like the beasts... Daniel 5:21

Believe in heart

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine **heart** that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. Romans 10:9

For with the **heart** man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. Romans 10:10

Better in heart

Sorrow is better than laughter: for by the sadness of the countenance the **heart** is made better. Ecclesiastes 7:3

Bind them continually upon thine heart, and tie them about thy neck. Pro 6:21

The **heart** knoweth his own bitterness; and a stranger doth not intermeddle with his joy. Proverbs 14:10

They shall make themselves utterly bald for thee, and gird them with sackcloth, and they shall weep for thee with bitterness of **heart** and bitter wailing. Eze 27:31

Bless in his heart

Lest there should be among you...whose **heart** turneth away...If come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his **heart**, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst: The Lord will not spare him... Deuteronomy 29:18-20

Blindness of heart

Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their **heart**. Ephesians 4:18

Break mine heart

Then Paul answered, What mean ye to weep and to break mine **heart**? For I am ready not to be bound only, but also to die at Jerusalem, for the name of the Lord Jesus. Acts 21:13

Breastplate on heart

Thou shalt put in the breastplate of judgment the Urim and Thummim; and they shall be upon Aaron's **heart**, when he goeth in before the LORD: and Aaron shall bear the judgment of the children of Israel upon his **heart** before the LORD continually. Exodus 28:30

Broken in heart, brokenhearted

The LORD is nigh unto them that are of a broken **heart**; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. Psalm 34:18

Reproach hath broken my **heart**; and I am full of heaviness: and I looked for some to take pity, but there was none; and for comforters, but I found none. Psalm 69:20

Because that he remembered not to shew mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in **heart**. Psalm 109:16

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the **brokenhearted**, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. Isaiah 61:1

Mine **heart** within me is broken because of the prophets; all my bones shake; I am like a drunken man, and like a man whom wine hath overcome, because of the LORD, and because of the words of his holiness. Jeremiah 23:9

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the **brokenhearted**, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised... Luke 4:18

Brought down their heart

Therefore he brought down their **heart** with labour; they fell down, and there was none to help. Psalms 107:12

Burn in heart

They said one to another, Did not our **heart** burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures? Luke 24:32

C

Came (not) into heart

They have built the high places of Tophet, which is in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire; which I commanded them not, neither came it into my **heart**. Jeremiah 7:31

When he was full forty years old, it came into his **heart** to visit his brethren the children of Israel. Acts 7:23

Caul of their heart (breast enclosing the heart)

I will meet them as a bear that is bereaved of her whelps, and will rend the caul of their **heart**, and there will I devour them like a lion: the wild beast shall tear them. Hosea 13:8

Christ in heart

That Christ may dwell in your **hearts** by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God. Ephesians 3:17-19

Circumcised heart, circumcision

Circumcise therefore the foreskin of your **heart**, and be no more stiffnecked. Deuteronomy 10:16

And the LORD thy God will circumcise thine **heart**, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine **heart**, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest live. Deuteronomy 30:6

He is a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the **heart**, in the spirit, and not in the letter; whose praise is not of men, but of God. Romans 2:29

Comfort heart, hearts comforted

And I will fetch a morsel of bread, and comfort ye your **heart**; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said. Genesis 18:5

Comfort thine heart... I pray thee. Judges 19:5, 8

Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and that he might comfort your **hearts**. Ephesians 6:22

That their **hearts** might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgement of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ; Colossians 2:2

Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your **hearts**; Colossians 4:8

Comfort your **hearts**, and stablish you in every good word and work. 2 Thessalonians 2:17

Clean heart

Create in me a clean **heart**, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Psalm 51:10

God is good to Israel, even to such as are of a clean heart. Psalm 73:1

Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin? Proverbs 20:9

Cleansed heart

Verily I have cleansed my **heart** in vain, and washed my hands in innocency. Psalm 73:13

Commune with heart

Stand in awe, and sin not: commune with your own **heart** upon your bed, and be still. Selah. Psalm 4:4

I call to remembrance my song in the night: I commune with mine own **heart**: and my spirit made diligent search. Psalm77:6

I communed with mine own **heart**, saying, Lo, I am come to great estate, and have gotten more wisdom than all they that have been before in Jerusalem: yea, my heart had great experience of wisdom and knowledge. Ecclesiastes1:16

Conceived in heart

Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? And after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? Why hast thou conceived this thing in thine **hear**t? Thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God. Acts 5:4

Condemned heart, condemn us not

For if our **heart** condemn us, God is greater than our **heart**, and knoweth all things. Beloved, if our **heart** condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. 1 John 3:20-21

Consider in heart, considered, consider not

Know therefore this day, and consider it in thine **heart**, that the LORD he is God in heaven above, and upon the earth beneath: there is none else. Deut 4:39

Thou shalt also consider in thine **heart**, that, as a man chasteneth his son, so the LORD thy God chasteneth thee. Deuteronomy 8:5

For all this I considered in my **heart** even to declare all this, that the righteous, and the wise, and their works, are in the hand of God: no man knoweth either love or hatred by all that is before them. Ecclesiastes 9:1

And none considereth in his **heart**, neither is there knowledge nor understanding to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yea, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten it: and shall I make the residue thereof an abomination? Shall I fall down to the stock of a tree? Isaiah 44:19

They consider not in their **heart**s that I remember all their wickedness: now their own doings have beset them about; they are before my face. Hosea 7:2

Contrite heart

The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit: a broken and a contrite **heart**, O God, thou wilt not despise. Psalms 51:17

Counsel from heart, counsels of heart

Ointment and perfume rejoice the **heart**: so doth the sweetness of a man's friend by **hearty** counsel. Proverbs 27:9

Therefore judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to light the hidden things of darkness, and will make manifest the counsels of the **hearts**: and then shall every man have praise of God. 1 Corinthians 4:5

Covetousness in heart, goeth after covetousness

But thine eyes and thine **heart** are not but for thy covetousness, and for to shed innocent blood, and for oppression, and for violence, to do it. Jeremiah 22:17

They come unto thee as the people cometh, and they sit before thee as my people, and they hear thy words, but they will not do them: for with their mouth they shew much love, but their heart goeth after their covetousness. Ezekiel 33:31

Having eyes full of adultery, and that cannot cease from sin; beguiling unstable souls: an **heart** they have exercised with covetous practices; cursed children... 2 Peter 2:14

Cry, heart, cried, not cried

My **heart** shall cry out for Moab; his fugitives shall flee unto Zoar, an heifer of three years old: for by the mounting up of Luhith with weeping shall they go it up for in the way of Horonaim they shall raise up a cry of destruction. Isaiah 15:5

Their **heart** cried unto the Lord, O wall of the daughter of Zion, let tears run down like a river day and night: give thyself no rest; let not the apple of thine eye cease. Lamentations 2:18

They have not cried unto me with their **heart**, when they howled upon their beds: they assemble themselves for corn and wine, and they rebel against me. Ho 7:14

Cursed God in hearts

And it was so, when the days of their feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, and offered according to the number of them all: for Job said, It may be that my sons have sinned, and cursed God in their **hearts.** Thus did Job continually. Job 1:5

Cut to the heart

They were cut to the **heart**, and took counsel to slay them. Acts 5:33

When they heard these things, they were cut to the **heart**, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. Acts 7:54

D

Daystar arise in your hearts

We have also a more sure word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your **hearts**: 2 Peter 1:19

Deceit in heart, of heart, deceitful, deceive hearts

Deceit is in the **heart** of them that imagine evil: but to the counsellers of peace is joy. Proverbs 12:20

Then the LORD said unto me, The prophets prophesy lies in my name: I sent them not, neither have I commanded them, neither spake unto them: they prophesy unto you a false vision and divination, and a thing of nought, and the deceit of their **heart**. Jeremiah 14:14

The **heart** is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked: who can know it? Jeremiah 17:9

How long shall this be in the **heart** of the prophets that prophesy lies? Yea, they are prophets of the deceit of their own **heart**. Jeremiah 23:26

For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the **hearts** of the simple. Romans 16:18

Deceived heart

Take heed to yourselves, that your **heart** be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and serve other gods, and worship them; And then the LORD's wrath be kindled against you, and he shut up the heaven, that there be no rain, and that the land yield not her fruit; and lest ye perish quickly from off the good land which the LORD giveth you. Deuteronomy 11:16-17

He feedeth on ashes: a deceived **heart** hath turned him aside, that he cannot deliver his soul, nor say, Is there not a lie in my right hand? Isaiah 44:20

If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own **heart**, this man's religion is vain. James 1:26

Decreed in heart

Nevertheless he that standeth stedfast in his **heart**, having no necessity, but hath power over his own will, and hath so decreed in his **heart** that he will keep his virgin, doeth well. 1 Corinthians 7:37

Deep heart (in sin)

They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward thought of every one of them, and the **heart**, is deep. Psalm 64:6

Defiled by things in heart

Those things which proceed out of the mouth come forth from the **heart**; and they defile a man. Matthew 15:18

Desire of heart, desires

For the wicked boasteth of his **heart's** desire, and blesseth the covetous, whom the LORD abhorreth. Psalms 10:3

Thou hast given him his **heart's** desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah. Psalm 21:2

Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the **desires** of thine heart. Psalm 37:4

Desolate heart

Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my **heart** within me is desolate. Psalm 143:4

Despair in heart

Therefore I went about to cause my **heart** to despair of all the labour which I took under the sun. Ecclesiastes 2:20

Despised him in her heart, despiteful

As the ark of the LORD came into the city of David, Michal Saul's daughter looked through a window, and saw king David leaping and dancing before the LORD; and she despised him in her **heart**. 2 Samuel 6:16

Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because the Philistines have dealt by revenge, and have taken vengeance with a despiteful **heart**, to destroy it for the old hatred; Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold I will stretch out mine hand upon the Philistines...Ezekiel 25:15

Despised reproof in heart

How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof... Proverbs 5:12

Destroy the heart

Surely oppression maketh a wise man mad; and a gift destroyeth the **heart**. Ecclesiastes 7:7

Devil putting in heart

Supper being ended, the devil having now put into the **heart** of Judas Iscariot, Simon's son, to betray him; John 13:2

Direct your hearts

And the Lord direct your **hearts** into the love of God, and into the patient waiting for Christ. 2 Thessalonians 3:5

Dissembled in hearts (put on appearance, concealed facts, pretense)

For ye dissembled in your **hearts**, when ye sent me unto the LORD your God, saying, pray for us unto the LORD our God; and according unto all that the LORD our God shall say, so declare unto us, and we will do it. Jeremiah 47:20

Divided heart

Their **heart** is divided; now shall they be found faulty: he shall break down their altars, he shall spoil their images. Hosea 10:2

Devising wicked in heart

An **heart** that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief... Proverbs 6:18

Disquietude of heart

I am feeble and sore broken: I have roared by reason of the disquietude of my heart. Psalm 38:8

Double heart

Of Zebulun, such as went forth to battle, expert in war, with all instruments of war, fifty thousand, which could keep rank: they were not of double **heart**. 1 Chronicles 12:33

They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double **heart** do they speak. Psalm 12:2

Doubt in heart

For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his **heart**, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Mark 11:23

Dove without heart

Ephraim also is like a silly dove without **heart**: they call to Egypt, they go to Assyria. Hosea 7:11

Doing the will of God from the heart

Not with eyeservice, as men pleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the **heart**... Ephesians 6:6

Do with all thine heart

This day the LORD thy God hath commanded thee to do these statutes and judgment: thou shalt therefore keep and do them with all thine **heart**, and with all thy soul. Deuteronomy 26:16

Earnest care in heart

But thanks be to God, which put the same earnest care into the **heart** of Titus for you. 2 Corinthians 8:16

Engaged heart

Their nobles shall be of themselves, and their governor shall proceed from the midst of them; and I will draw near, and he shall approach unto me: for who is this that engaged his **heart** to approach unto me? saith the LORD. Jer 30:21

Enlarge heart, enlarged

I will run the way of thy commandments, when thou shalt enlarge my **heart**. Psalm 119:32

O ye Corinthians, our mouth is open unto you, our **heart** is enlarged. 2 Corinthians 6:11

Entereth not into the heart, entered into

Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; Because it entereth not into his **heart**, but into his belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats? Mark 7:19

But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the **heart** of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. 1 Corinthians 2:9

Envy in heart

Let not thine **heart** envy sinners: but be thou in the fear of the LORD all the day long. Proverbs 23:17

But if ye have bitter envying and strife in your **hearts**, glory not, and lie not against the truth. James 3:14

Err in heart

Forty years long was I grieved with this generation, and said, It is a people that do err in their **heart**, and they have not known my ways: Psalm 95:10

Wherefore I was grieved with that generation, and said, They do alway err in their **heart**; and they have not known my ways. Hebrews 3:10

Established heart

His **heart** is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies. Psalm 112:8

Be not carried about with divers and strange doctrines. For it is a good thing that the **heart** be established with grace; not with meats, whch have not profited them that have been occupied therein. Hebrews 13:9

Evil heart

Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil **heart** of unbelief, in departing from the living God. Hebrews 3:12

This is an evil among all things that are done under the son, that there is one event unto all: yea, also the **heart** of the sons of men is full of evil, and madness is in their **heart** while they live, and after that they go to the dead. Eccl 9:3

Exalted heart

According to their pasture, so were they filled; they were filled, and their **heart** was exalted; therefore have they forgotten me. Hosea 13:6

Failed heart, faileth, failing

For innumerable evils have compassed me about: mine iniquities have taken hold upon me, so that I am not able to look up; they are more than the hairs of mine head: therefore my **heart** faileth me. Psalm 40:12

My flesh and my **heart** faileth: but God is the strength of my **heart**, and my portion forever. Psalm 73:26

Men's **hearts** failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. Luke 21:26

Faint of heart, fainthearted, faintness in their hearts

And upon them that are left alive of you I will send a faintness in their **hearts** in the lands of their enemies; and the sound of a shaken leaf shall chase them; and they shall flee, as fleeing from a sword; and they shall fall when none pursueth. Leviticus 26:36

And shall say unto them, Hear, O Israel, ye approach this day unto battle against your enemies; let not your **hearts** faint, fear not, and do not tremble, neither be ye terrified because of them; Deuteronomy 20:3

What man is there that is fearful and fainthearted? Let him go and return unto his house, lest his brethren's heart faint as well as his heart. Deuteronomy 20:8

Why should ye be stricken any more? Ye will revolt more and more: the whole head is sick, and the whole heart faint. Isaiah 1:5

Say unto him, Take heed, and be quiet; fear not, neither be **fainthearted** for the two tails of these smoking firebrands, for the fierce anger of Rezin with Syria, and of the son of Remaliah. Isaiah 7:4

When I would comfort myself against sorrow, my **heart** is faint in me. Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people... Jeremiah 8:18-19

Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are **fainthearted**; there is sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet. Jeremiah 49:23

Heart of mighty men, woman in her pangs

Kerioth is taken, and the strong holds are surprised, and the mighty men's **hearts** in Moab at that day shall be as the **heart** of a woman in her pangs. Jer 48:41

The heaven for height, and the earth for depth, and the **heart** of kings is unsearchable. Proverbs 25:3

For oftentimes also thine own **heart** knoweth that thou thyself likewise hast cursed others. Ecclesiastes 7:22

And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your **hearts**: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God. Luke 16:15

And they prayed, and said, Thou, Lord, which knowest the **hearts** of all men, shew whether of these two thou hast chosen. Acts 1:24

Lift heart

Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD. Let us lift up our heart with our hands unto God in the heavens. We have transgressed and have rebelled: thou hast not pardoned. There are gathered unto him vain men, the children of Belial, and have strengthened themselves against Rehoboam the son of Solomon, when Rehoboam was young and **tenderhearted**, and could not withstand them. 2 Chronicles 13:7

Be ye kind one to another, **tenderhearted**, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. Ephesians 4:32

Terror, meditated in heart

He shall turn the **heart** of the fathers to the children, and the **heart** of the children to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. Malachi 4:6

And he shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the **hearts** of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17

To whom our fathers would not obey, but thrust him from them, and in their hearts turned back again into Egypt... Acts 7:39
