BAPTISM

Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be **baptized** of him. But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be **baptized** of thee, and cometh thou to me? And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him. And Jesus, when he was **baptized**, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him: Matthew 3:13-16

John did **baptize** in the wilderness, and preach the **baptism** of repentance for the remission of sins. And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all **baptized** of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins...And John...preached, saying, There cometh one mightier than I after me, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to stoop down and unloose. I indeed have **baptized** you with water: but he shall **baptize** you with the Holy Ghost. And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was **baptized** of John in Jordan. Mark 1:4-9

Jesus said unto them, Ye know what ye ask: can ye drink of the cup that I drink of? And be **baptized** with the **baptism** that I am **baptized** with? And they said unto him, We can. And Jesus said unto them, Ye shall indeed drink of the cup that I drink of; and with the **baptism** that I am **baptized** withal shall ye be **baptized**: Mark 10:38-39

He said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is **baptized** shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. Mark 16:15-18

The word of God came unto John the son of Zacharias in the wilderness. And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the **baptism** of repentance for the remission of sins... Then said he to the multitude that came forth to be **baptized** of him, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come? Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to ourfather... Luke 3:2-3, 7-8 Then came also publicans to be **baptized**, and said unto him, Master, what shall we do?...Now when all the people were **baptized**, it came to pass, that Jesus also being **baptized**, and praying, the heaven was opened, And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased. Luke 3:21-22

After these things came Jesus and his disciples into the land of Judaea; and there he tarried with them, and **baptized**...(Though Jesus himself **baptized** not, but his disciples,)... John 3:22-23, 4:2

For John truly **baptized** with water; but ye shall be **baptized** with the Holy Ghost not many days hence. Acts 1:5

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be **baptized** every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost... Then they that gladly received his word were **baptized**: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls. Acts 2:38, 41

When they believed Philip preaching the things concerning the kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were **baptized**, both men and women. Acts 8:12

As they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be **baptized**? ...And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip, and the eunuch; and he **baptized** him. Acts 8:36, 38

Immediately there fell from his eyes as it had been scales: and he received sight forthwith, and arose, and was baptized. Acts 9:18

Can any man forbid water, that these should not be **baptized**, which have received the Holy Ghost as well as we? And he commanded them to be **baptized** in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days. Acts 10:47-48

A certain woman named Lydia, a seller of purple, of the city of Thyatira, which worshipped God, heard us: whose heart the Lord opened, that she attended unto the things which were spoke of Paul. When she was **baptized**, and her household, she besought us, saying, If ye have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us. Acts 16:14-15 He took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was **baptized**, he and all his, straightway. Acts 16:33

Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized. Acts 18:8

Now why tarriest thou? Arise, and be **baptized**, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord. Acts 22:16

Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized** into Jesus Christ were **baptized** into his death? Therefore we are bured with him by **baptism** into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:3-4

Our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; And were all **baptized** unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea; 1 Corinthians 10:2

For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ. For by one Spirit are we all **baptized** into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:12-13

For as many of you as have been **baptized** into Christ have put on Christ. Galatians 3:26

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one faith, one **baptism**, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:4-6

Ye are complete in him, which is the head of all...Buried with him in **baptism**, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; Colossians 2:10, 12-14

In the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein...eight souls were saved by water. The like figure whereunto even **baptism** doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ. 1 Peter 3:21
