## BREAD

In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat **bread**, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return. Genesis 3:19

Melchizedek king of Salem brought forth **bread** and wine: and he was the priest of the most high God. Genesis 14:18

And the seven years of dearth began to come, according as Joseph had said: and the dearth was in all lands; but in all the land of Egypt there was **bread**...When all the land of Egypt was famished, the people cried to Pharaoh for **bread**: and Pharaoh said unto all the Egyptians, Go unto Joseph; what he saith to you, do. Genesis 41:54-55

Joseph nourished his father, and his brethren, and all his father's household, with **bread**, according to their families. And there was no **bread** in all the land; for the famine was very sore, so that the land of Egypt and all the land of Canaan fainted by reason of the famine. Genesis 47:12-13

Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened **bread** be eaten...Seven days thou shalt eat unleavened **bread**, and in the seventh day shall be a feast to the LORD. Exodus 13:3, 6

The children of Israel said unto them, Would to God we had died by the hand of the LORD in the land of Egypt, when we sat by the flesh pots, and when we did eat **bread** to the full; for ye have brought us forth into this wilderness, to kill this whole assembly with hunger. Then said the LORD unto Moses, Behold, I will rain **bread from heaven** for you; and the people shall go out and gather a certain rate every day, that I may prove them, whether they will walk in my law, or no...And Moses said, This shall be, when the LORD shall give you in the evening flesh to eat, and in the morning **bread** to the full; for that the LORD heareth your murmurings which ye murmur against him: and what are we? Your murmurings are not against us, but against the LORD. Exodus 16:3-4, 8

When the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, It is manna: for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the **bread** which the LORD hath given you to eat. Exodus 16:15

They shall be holy unto their God, and not profane the name of their God: for the offerings of the LORD made by fire, and **the bread of their God**, they do offer: therefore they shall be holy...Thou shalt sanctify him therefore; for he offereth **the bread of thy God**: he shall be holy unto thee: for I the LORD, which sanctify you, am holy. Leviticus 21:6, 8

He humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by **bread** only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live. Deuteronomy 8:3

The ravens brought him **bread** and flesh in the morning, and **bread** and flesh in the evening; and he drank of the brook. 1 Kings 17:6

Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD'S prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with **bread** and water? 1 Kings 18:13

I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging **bread**. Psalm 37:25

Behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can he give **bread** also? Can he provide flesh for his people? Psalm 78:20

I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with **bread**. *Psalm* 132:15

Love not sleep, lest thou come to poverty; open thine eyes, and thou shalt be satisfied with **bread**. Proverbs 20:13

*He that hath a bountiful eye shall be blessed; for he giveth of his bread to the poor. Proverbs 22:9* 

If thine enemy be hungry, give him **bread** to eat; and if he be thirsty, give him water to drink: Proverbs 25:21

Cast thy **bread** upon the waters: for thou shalt find it after many days. Give a portion to seven, and also to eight; for thou knowest not what evil shall be upon the earth. Ecclesiastes 11:1-2

He shall dwell on high: his place of defence shall be the munitions of rocks: **bread** shall be given him; his waters shall be sure. Isaiah 33:16

Is not this the fast that I have chosen?...Is it not to deal thy **bread** to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? Isaiah 58:7

When the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made **bread**. But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by **bread** alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God. Matthew 4:3-4

Give us this day our daily bread. Matthew 6:11

Jesus said unto them, **I** am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst...He that believeth on me hath everlasting life. I am that bread of life...This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die. I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world...Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you. Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life...This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever... John 6:35, 47-48, 50-51, 53-54, 58

As soon then as they were come to land, they saw a fire of coals there, and fish laid thereon, and **bread**...Jesus then cometh, and taketh **bread**, and giveth them, and fish likewise. John 21:9, 13

They continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of **bread**, and in prayers...And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking **bread** from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart. Acts 2:42, 46

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The **bread** which we break is it not the communion of the body of Christ? For we being many are one **bread**, and one body: for we are all partakers of that one **bread**. 1 Corinthians 10:17
