FORGIVENESS

Be merciful, O LORD, unto thy people Israel, whom thou hast redeemed, and lay not innocent blood unto thy people of Israel's charge. And the blood shall be **forgiven** them. Deuteronomy 21:8

When ye stand praying, **forgive**, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may **forgive** you your trespasses. But if ye do not **forgive**, neither will your Father which is in heaven **forgive** your trespasses. Mark 11:25-26

When he saw their faith, he said unto him, Man, thy sins are forgiven thee. Luke 5:20

Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: **forgive**, and ye shall be **forgiven**: Luke 6:37

I say unto thee, Her sins, which are many, are **forgiven**; for she loved much: but to whom little is **forgiven**, the same loveth little. And he said unto her, Thy sins are **forgiven**. Luke 7:47-48
