GOD'S GLORY

The glory of the LORD abode upon mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it six days: and the seventh day he called unto Moses out of the midst of the cloud. And the sight of *the glory of the LORD* was like a devouring fire on the top of the mount in the eyes of the children of Israel. Exodus 24:17

Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and *the glory of the LORD* filled the tabernacle. And Moses was not able to enter into the tent of the congregation, because the cloud abode thereon, and *the glory of the LORD* filled the tabernacle. Exodus 40:34-35

Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now. And the LORD said, I have pardoned according to thy word: But as truly as I live, all the earth shall be filled with *the glory of the LORD*. Numbers 14:19-21

He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, and lifteth up the beggar from the dunghill, to set them among princes, and to make them inherit *the throne of glory*: for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them. 1 Samuel 2:8

Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and *the glory*, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. 1 Chronicles 29:11

Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting doors; and *the King of glory* shall come in. Who is this *King of glory*? The LORD of hosts, he is *the King of glory*. Selah. Psalm 24:9-10

O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; To see thy power and *thy glory*, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary. Psalm 63:1-2

His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed. Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things. And blessed be *his glorious name* for ever: and let the whole earth be filled with *his glory*; Amen, and Amen. All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall *glorify thy name*. For thou art great, and doest wondrous things: thou art God alone. Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth: unite my heart to fear thy name. I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart: and I will *glorify thy name* for evermore. Psalm 86:9-12

*The LORD is high above all nations, and **his glory** above all the heavens. Who is like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high, Who humbleth himself to behold the things that are in heaven, and in the earth! Psalm 113:4-6*

*They shall go into the holes of the rocks, and into the caves of the earth, for fear of the LORD, and for **the glory of his majesty**, when he ariseth to shake terribly the earth. Isaiah 2:19*

*In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also **the Lord sitting upon a throne**, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of **his glory**. Isaiah 6:1-3*

*In that day shall **the LORD of hosts be for a crown of glory**, and for a diadem of beauty unto the residue of his people, and for a spirit of judgment to him that sitteth in judgment, and for strength to them that turn the battle to the gate. Isaiah 28:5-6*

*Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain: And **the glory of the LORD** shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together: for the mouth of the LORD hath spoken it. Isaiah 40:4-5*

*Fear not: for I am with thee: I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; Even every one that is called by my name: for I have created him for **my glory**, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. Isaiah 43:5-7*

*Is not this the fast that I have chosen? To loose the bands of wickedness, to undo the heavy burdens, and to let the oppressed go free, and that ye break every yoke? Is it not to deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou bring the poor that are cast out to thy house? When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and that thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; **the glory of the LORD** shall be thy reward. Isaiah 58:6-8*

*For Zion's sake will I not hold my peace, and for Jerusalem's sake I will not rest, until the righteousness thereof go forth as brightness, and the salvation thereof as a lamp that burneth. And the Gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings **thy glory**: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the LORD shall name. Thou shalt also be **a crown of glory in the hand of the LORD**, and a royal diadem in the hand of thy God. Isaiah 62:2-3*

*The Son of man shall come in **the glory of his Father** with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works... When the Son of man shall come in **his glory**, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon **the throne of his glory**: Matthew 16:27, 24:31*

*His sisters sent unto him, saying, Lord, behold, he whom thou lovest is sick. When Jesus heard that, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for **the glory of God**, that the Son of God might be **glorified** thereby. John 11:4*

*This is life eternal, that they might know thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent. I have **glorified** thee on the earth: I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do. And now, O Father, **glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee** before the world was. John 17:3-5*

*Ye stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears, ye do always resist the Holy Ghost: as your fathers did, so do ye...when they heard these things, they were cut to the heart, and they gnashed on him with their teeth. He, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw **the glory of God**, and Jesus standing on the right hand of God. And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing at the right hand of God. Acts 7:51, 54-56*

*For if Abraham were justified by works, he hath whereof to **glory**; but not before God...He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving **glory to God**; and being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform. Romans 4:2, 20-21*

*For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all. O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been his counsellor?...For of him, and through him, and to him, are all things: **to whom be glory** for ever. Amen. Romans 11:33-36*

*He that **glorieth**, let him **glory in the Lord**. For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth. 2 Corinthians 10:17-18*
