How excellent is thy **lovingkindness**, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings. Psalm 36:7

O continue thy **lovingkindness** unto them that know thee; and thy righteousness to the upright in heart. Psalm 36:10

Withhold not thou thy tender mercies from me, O LORD: let thy lovingkindness, and thy truth continually preserve me. Psalm 40:11

Yet the LORD will command his **lovingkindness** in the daytime, and in the night his song shall be with me, and my prayer unto the God of my life. Psalm 42:8

Because thy **lovingkindness** is better than life, my lips shall praise thee. Psalm 63:3

Hear me, O LORD; for thy **lovingkindness** is good: turn unto me according to the multitude of thy tender mercies. Psalm 69:16

If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. Nevertheless my **lovingkindness** will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Psalm 89:31-33

Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Psalm 103:4

Whoso is wise, and will observe these things, even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. Psalm 107:43

Hear my voice according unto thy **lovingkindness**: O LORD, quicken me according to thy judgment. Psalm 119:149

Consider how I love thy precepts: quicken me, O LORD, according to thy lovingkindness. Psalm 119:159

I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth: for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. Psalm 138:2

Cause me to hear thy **lovingkindness** in the morning; for in thee do I trust: cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee. Psalm 143:8

I will mention the **lovingkindnesses** of the LORD, and the praises of the LORD, according to all that the LORD hath bestowed on us, and the great goodness toward the house of Israel, which he hath bestowed on them according to his mercies, and according to the multitude of his **lovingkindnesses**. For he said, Surely they are my people, children that will not lie: so he was their Saviour. In all their affliction he was afflicted, and the angel of his presence saved them: in **his love** and in his pity he redeemed them; and he bare them, and carried them all the days of old. Isaiah 63:7-9

But let him that glorieth glory in this, that he understandeth and knoweth me, that I am the LORD which exercise lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness, in the earth: for in these things I delight, saith the LORD. Jeremiah 9:24

The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, **I have loved thee with** an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee. Jeremiah 31:3

I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. Hosea 2:19

Master, which is the great commandment in the law? Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt **love** the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt **love** thy neighbour as thyself. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. Matthew 22:36-40

For God so **loved** the world that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. John 3:16-17

As the Father hath **loved** me, so have I **loved** you: continue ye in my **love**. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my **love**; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his **love**... John 15:9-10

This is my commandment, That ye **love** one another, as I have **loved** you. Greater **love** hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends. John 15:12-13

Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou **lovedst** me before the foundation of the world. O righteous Father, the world hath not known thee: but I have known thee, and these have known that thou hast sent me. And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare it: that the **love** wherewith thou hast **loved** me may be in them, and I in them. John 17:24-26

God, who is rich in mercy, for **his great love wherewith he loved us**, even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;) and hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus... Ephesians 2:4-5

Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; and walk in **love**, as Christ also hath **loved** us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour. Ephesians 5:1-2

Behold, what manner of **love** the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God... This is the message that ye heard from the beginning, that we should **love** one another... Hereby perceive we **the love of God**, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. 1 John 3:1, 11, 16

Beloved, let us **love** one another: for **love** is of God; and every one that **loveth** is born of God, and knoweth God. He that **loveth** not knoweth not God; for God is **love**. In this was manifested the **love** of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is **love**, not that we **loved** God, but that he **loved** us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4:7-10

There is no fear in **love**; but perfect **love** casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in **love**. We **love** him, because he first **loved** us. If a man say, I **love** God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that **loveth** not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he **love** God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, That he who **loveth** God **love** his brother also. 1 John 4:18-21
