HOLINESS

WORSHIP THE LORD IN THE BEAUTY OF HOLINESS

*When he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should **praise the beauty of holiness**, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever. And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir...and they were smitten. 2 Chronicles 20:21-22*

*Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come before him: **worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness**. Psalm 29:2*

*Sing unto the LORD, O ye saints of his, and give thanks at the remembrance of **his holiness**. For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning... Thou hast turned for me my mourning into dancing: thou hast put off my sackcloth, and girded me with gladness; to the end that my glory may sing praise to thee, and not be silent. O LORD my God, I will give thanks unto thee for ever. Psalm 30:4-5, 11-12*

*God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of **his holiness**. Psalm 47:8*

*Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, in the mountain of **his holiness**...According to thy name, O God, so is thy praise unto the ends of the earth: thy right hand is full of righteousness. Psalm 48:1, 10*

*My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. Once have I sworn by **my holiness** that I will not lie unto David. His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me. It shall be established for ever as the moon, and as a faithful witness in heaven. Selah. Psalm 89:34-37*

*Thy testimonies are very sure: **holiness** becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever. Psalm 93:5*

*O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day. Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people. For the LORD is great, and **greatly to be praised**: he is to be feared above all gods. For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens. Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary. Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength. Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts. **O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness**: fear before him, all the earth. Psalm 96:1-9*

*The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice...the heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his glory...Light is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart. Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of **his holiness**. Psalm 97:1, 6, 11-12*

*Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, **in the beauties of holiness** from the womb of the morning; thou hast the dew of thy youth. The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. Psalm 110:3-4*

*The LORD hath sworn by his right hand, and by the arm of his strength, Surely I will no more give thy corn to be meat for thine enemies: and the sons of the stranger shall not drink thy wine, for the which thou hast laboured: but they that have gathered it shall eat it, and **praise the LORD**; and they that have brought it together shall drink it in the courts of **my holiness**. Isaiah 62:8-9*

*Upon mount Zion shall be deliverance, and there shall be **holiness**; and the house of Jacob shall possess their possessions. Obadiah 1:17*

*Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people, and hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David...that he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve him without fear, in **holiness** and righteousness before him, all the days of our life. Luke 1:68-69, 74-75*

*For as ye have yielded your members servants to uncleanness and to iniquity unto iniquity; even so now yield your members servants to righteousness unto **holiness**. For when ye were the servants of sin, ye were free from righteousness. What fruit had ye then in those things whereof ye are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto **holiness**, and the end everlasting life. Romans 6:19-22*

*Put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and be renewed in the spirit of your mind; and...Put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and **true holiness**. Ephesians 4:23-24*

*God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you. And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all men, even as we do toward you: to the end that he may stablish your hearts unblameable **in holiness** before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints. 1 Thessalonians 3:12-13*

WORSHIP THE HOLY ONE WITH HOLINESS HE DIED FOR

Wherefore, **holy brethren**, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house. For this man was counted worthy of much more glory than Moses, inasmuch as he who hath builded the house hath more honour than the house. For every house is builded by some man; but he that built all things is God. And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after; but Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end. Hebrews 3:1-6

For such an high priest became us, who is **holy**, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners, and made higher than the heavens; who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself. Hebrews 6:26-27

The Holy Ghost this signifying, that **the way into the holiest** of all was not yet made manifest, while as the first tabernacle was yet standing...Christ being come an high priest of good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is to say, not of this building; neither by the blood of goats and calves, but by his own blood he entered in once into the **holy place**, having obtained eternal redemption for us...If the blood of bulls and goats...sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God? Hebrews 9:8, 11-14

For Christ is not entered into **the holy places** made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: nor yet that he should offer himself often, as the high priest entereth into **the holy place** every year with the blood of others...but now once...hath he appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of himself... Hebrews 9:24-26

We have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and live? For they verily for a few days chastened us after their own pleasure; but he for our profit, that we might be partakers of **his holiness**. Hebrews 12:9-10

Make straight paths for your feet, lest that which is lame be turned out of the way; but let it rather be healed. Follow peace with all men, and **holiness**, without which no man shall see the Lord: Hebrews 12:13-14
