## THE WAY OF THE JUST

Noah was a **just** man and perfect in his generations... Genesis 6:9

Judges and officers shalt thou make thee in all thy gates, which the LORD thy God giveth thee, through thy tribes: and they shall judge the people with **just** judgment... That which is altogether **just** shalt thou follow, that thou mayest live, and inherit the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. Deut 16:18, 20

Thou shalt have a perfect and **just** weight, a perfect and **just** measure shalt thou have: that thy days may be lengthened in the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee. Deuteronomy 25:15

He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment; a God of truth and without iniquity, **just** and right is he. Deuteronomy 32:4

Shall mortal man be more **just** than God? Shall a man be more pure than his maker? ... Behold, in this thou art not **just**: I will answer thee, that God is greater than man. Job 4:17, 33:12

Shall even he that hateth right govern? And wilt thou condemn him that is most just? Job 34:17

Oh let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end; but establish the **just**: for the righteous God trieth the hearts and reins. Psalm 7:9

The wicked plotted against the **just**, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth. Psalm 37:12

The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the **just**. Proverbs 3:33

The path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day. Proverbs 4:18

Give instruction to a wise man, and he will be yet wiser: teach a **just** man, and he will increase in learning. Proverbs 9:9

The tongue of the **just** is as choice silver; the heart of the wicked is little worth. Proverbs 10:20

The wicked is snared by the transgression of his lips: but the **just** shall come out of trouble. Proverbs 12:13

A good man leaveth an inheritance to his children's children: and the wealth of the sinner is laid up for the **just**. Proverbs 13:22

It is a joy to the **just** to do judgment: but destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity. Proverbs 21:15

For a **just** man falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief. Proverbs 24:16

The way of the just is uprightness: thou, most upright, dost weigh the path of the just. Isaiah 26:7

Who hath declared this from ancient time... Have not I the LORD? And there is no God else beside me; a **just** God and a Saviour; there is none beside me. Isaiah 45:21

Who is wise, and he shall understand these things? Prudent, and he shall know them? For the ways of the LORD are right, and the **just** shall walk in them: but the transgressors shall fall therein. Hosea 14:9

Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the **just** shall live by his faith. Habakkuk 2:4

The **just** LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame. Zephaniah 3:5

Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is **just**, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. Zechariah 9:9

Herod feared John, knowing that he was a **just** man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly. Mk 6:20

He shall go before him in the spirit and power of Elias, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the **just**; to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. Luke 1:17

I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is **just**; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me. John 5:30

Cornelius the centurion, a **just** man, and one that feareth God, and of good report among all the nation of the Jews, was warned from God by an holy angel to send for thee into his house, and to hear words of thee. Acts 10:22

One Ananias, a devout man according to the law...said unto me, Brother Saul, receive thy sight. And the same hour I looked up upon him. And he said, The God of our fathers hath chosen thee, that thou shouldest know his will, and see that **Just** One, and shouldest hear the voice of his mouth. Acts 22:12-14

...As many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law; (For not the hearers of the law are **just** before God, but the doers of the law shall be **justified**. When the Gentiles, which have not the law, do by nature the things contained in the law, these, having not the law, are a law unto themselves: which shew the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and their thoughts the mean while accusing or else excusing one another;) Romans 2:12-15

The law is holy, and the commandment holy, and **just**, and good...the law is spiritual: but I am carnal, sold under sin. Romans 7:12, 14

That no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The **just** shall live by faith. Galatians 3:11

Whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are **just**, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things. Philippians 4:8

Masters, give unto your servants that which is **just** and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven. Colossians 4:1

A bishop must be blameless, as the steward of God; not selfwilled, not soon angry, not given to wine, no striker, not given to filthy lucre; but a lover of hospitality, a lover of good men, sober, **just**, holy, temperate; holding fast the faithful word as he hath been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine...to exhort... Titus 1:7-9

Now the **just** shall live by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:38

Ye are come unto mount Sion, and unto the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to an innumerable company of angels, to the general assembly and church of the firstborn, which are written in heaven, and to God the Judge of all, and to the spirits of **just** men made perfect, and to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling... Hebrews 12:22-24

Christ also hath once suffered for sins, the **just** for the unjust, that he might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh, but quickened by the Spirit. 1 Peter 3:18

If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and **just** to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:8-9

They sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty; **just** and true are thy ways, thou King of saints. Revelation 15:3
