## LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS

Moses stretched forth his hand toward heaven; and there was a thick darkness in all the land of Egypt three days: They saw not one another, neither rose any from his place for three days: but all the children of Israel had **light** in their dwellings. Exodus 10:22-23

The angel of God, which went before the camp of Israel, removed and went behind them; and the pillar of the cloud went from before their face, and stood behind them: and it came between the camp of the Egyptians and the camp of Israel; and it was a cloud and darkness to them, but it gave **light** by night to these: so that the one came not near the other all the night. Exodus 14:19-20

For thou art my lamp, O LORD: and the LORD will **lighten** my darkness. 2 Samuel 22:29

Oh that I were as in the months past, as in the days when God preserved me; When his candle shined upon my head, and when by **his light** I walked through darkness... Job 29:2-3

For thou wilt **lighten** my candle: the LORD my God will **enlighten** my darkness. Psalm 18:28

Unto the upright there ariseth **light** in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. Psalm 112:4

Then I saw that wisdom excelleth folly, as far as **light** excelleth darkness Ecclesiastes 2:13

The people that walked in darkness have seen **a great light**: they that dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon them hath **the light** shined. Isaiah 9:2

I will bring the blind by a way that they knew not; I will lead them in paths that they have not known: I will make darkness **light** before them, and crooked things straight. These things will I do unto them, and not forsake them. Isaiah 42:16

Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no **light**? Let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. Isaiah 50:10

If thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and satisfy the afflicted soul; then shall thy **light** rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday: And the LORD shall guide thee continually... Isaiah 58:10-11

For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: but the LORD shall arise upon thee, and **his glory** shall be seen upon thee. Isaiah 60:2

He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and **the light** dwelleth with him. Daniel 2:22

The people which sat in darkness saw **great light**; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death **light** is sprung up. Matthew 4:16

Through the tender mercy of our God; whereby the dayspring from on high hath visited us, to give **light** to them that sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the way of peace. Luke 1:78-79

**The light** of the body is the eye: therefore when thine eye is single, thy whole body also is full of **light**; but when thine eye is evil, thy body also is full of darkness. Take heed therefore that **the light** which is in thee be not darkness. Luke 11:34-35

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...In him was life; and the life was **the light** of men. And **the light** shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not. John 1:1,4-5

This is the condemnation, that **light** is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than **light**, because their deeds were evil. For every one that doeth evil hateth **the light**, neither cometh to **the light**, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to **the light**, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God. John 3:19-21

Then spake Jesus... saying, I am **the light** of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have **the light** of life... Ye are from beneath; I am from above...I am not of this world. John 8:12, 23

Then said Jesus... Yet a little while is **the light** with you. Walk while ye have **the light**, lest darkness come upon you: for he that walketh in darkness knoweth not whither he goeth. While ye have **light**, believe in **the light**, that ye may be **the children of light**. I am come **a light** into the world, that whosoever believeth on me should not abide in darkness. John 12:35-36, 46

... Unto whom now I send thee, To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to **light**, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me. Acts 26:17-18

The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on **the armour of light**. Romans 13:12

Judge nothing before the time, until the Lord come, who both will bring to **light** the hidden things of darkness... 1 Corinthians 4:5

For God, who commanded **the light** to shine out of darkness, hath shined in our hearts, to give **the light** of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. 2 Corinthians 4:6

For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye **light** in the Lord: walk as **children of light**...And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove them. Ephesians 5:8, 11

Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in **light**: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: Colossians 1:12-13

Ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all **the children of light**, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness. 1 Thessalonians 5:4-5

Ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous **light**: 1 Peter 2:9

This then is the message which we have heard of him, and declare unto you, that **God is light**, and in him is no darkness at all. If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth: But if we walk in **the light**, as he is in **the light**, we have fellowship one with another... I John 1:5-7

Darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. 1 John 2:8-9
