LIVE

Ye shall do my judgments, and keep mine ordinances, to walk therein: I am the LORD your God. Ye shall therefore keep my statutes, and my judgments: which if a man do, he shall **live** in them: I am the LORD. Leviticus 18:4-5

The LORD thy God will circumcise thine heart, and the heart of thy seed, to love the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, that thou mayest *live*. Deuteronomy 30:6

I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you **life** and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose **life**, that both thou and thy seed may **live**: That thou mayest love the LORD thy God, and that thou mayest obey his voice, and that thou mayest cleave unto him: for he is thy **life**, and the length of thy days... Deuteronomy 30:19-20

They are a nation void of counsel, neither is there any understanding in them. O that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end!...See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make **alive**; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand. For I lift up my hand to heaven, and say, I **live** for ever. Deuteronomy 32:28-29, 39-40

I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving... The humble shall see this, and be glad: and your heart shall **live** that seek God. Psalm 69:30, 32

I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD. Psalm 118:17

The righteousness of thy testimonies is everlasting: give me understanding, and I shall live. Psalm 119:144

He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live. Proverbs 4:4

Forsake the foolish, and live; and go in the way of understanding. Proverbs 9:6

O Lord, by these things men **live**, and in all these things is the **life** of my spirit: so wilt thou recover me, and make me to **live**. Isaiah 38:16

Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall **live**; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David. Isaiah 55:3

Seek good, and not evil, that ye may *live*: and so the LORD, the God of hosts, shall be with you, as ye have spoken. Amos 5:15

Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not **live** by bread alone, but by every word of God. Luke 4:4

He is not a God of the dead, but of the living: for all live unto him. Luke 20:38

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the **life**: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he **live**: And whosoever **liveth** and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this? John 11:25-26

Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I **live**, ye shall **live** also. At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. John 14:19-20

For in him we **live**, and move, and have our being; as certain also of your own poets have said, For we are also his offspring. Acts 17:28

Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also **live** with him: Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him. For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he **liveth**, he **liveth** unto God. Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but **alive** unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord. Romans 6:8-11

Brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to **live** after the flesh. For if ye **live** after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall **live**. Romans 8:12-13

For none of us **liveth** to himself, and no man dieth to himself. For whether we **live**, we **live** unto the Lord; and whether we die, we die unto the Lord: whether we **live** therefore, or die, we are the Lord's. For to this end Christ both died, and rose, and revived, that he might be Lord both of the dead and **living**. Romans 14:7-9

We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed; always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the **life** also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. For we which **live** are alway delivered unto death for Jesus' sake, that the **life** also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body. 2 Corinthians 4:8-11

For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead: and that he died for all, that they which **live** should not henceforth **live** unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. 2 Corinthians 5:14-15

For though he was crucified through weakness, yet he **liveth** by the power of God. For we also are weak in him, but we shall **live** with him by the power of God toward you. 2 Corinthians 13:4

They that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we *live* in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Galatians 5:24-25

Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest **live** long on the earth. Ephesians 6:1-3

Christ shall be magnified in my body, whether it be by **life**, or by death. For to me to **live** is Christ, and to die is gain. Philippians 1:20-21

For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ, Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should **live** together with him. 1 Thessalonians 5:9-10

It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also **live** with him: 2 Timothy 2:11

Yea, and all that will **live** godly in Christ Jesus shall suffer persecution. 2 Timothy 3:12

Now the just shall **live** by faith: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:38

We have had fathers of our flesh which corrected us, and we gave them reverence: shall we not much rather be in subjection unto the Father of spirits, and *live*? Hebrews 12:9

Because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps: Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth: Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should **live** unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. 1 Peter 2:21-24

For this cause was the gospel preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but **live** according to God in the spirit. But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer. 1 Peter 4:6-7

In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might **live** through him. 1 John 4:8-10
