PERFECT

HIS WAY IS PERFECT

When Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou **perfect**. And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly. Genesis 17:1-2

When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations... Thou shalt be **perfect** with the LORD thy God. Deuteronomy 18:9, 13

For by thee I have run through a troop: by my God have I leaped over a wall. As for God, his way is **perfect**; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him. For who is God, save the LORD? And who is a rock, save our God? God is my strength and power: and he maketh my way **perfect**. 2 Samuel 22:30-33

Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with **perfect** heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy. 1 Chronicles 29:9

For the eyes of the LORD run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of them whose heart is **perfect** toward him. 2 Chronicles 16:9

And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the LORD, faithfully, and with a **perfect** heart. 2 Chronicles 19:9

The law of the LORD is **perfect**, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. Psalm 19:7

Mark the **perfect** man, and behold the upright: for the end of that man is peace. Psalm 37:37

I will behave myself wisely in a **perfect** way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a **perfect** heart...Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a **perfect** way, he shall serve me. Psalm 101:2, 4

The LORD will **perfect** that which concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, endureth for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands. Psalm 138:8

The righteousness of the **perfect** shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness. Proverbs 11:5

Be ye therefore **perfect**, even as your Father which is in heaven is **perfect**. Matthew 5:48

Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be **perfect**, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me. Matthew 19:21

The disciple is not above his master: but every one that is **perfect** shall be as his master. Luke 6:40

That which fell among thorns are they, which, when they have heard, go forth, and are choked with cares and riches and pleasures of this life, and bring no fruit to **perfection**. Luke 8:14

And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one; I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made **perfect** in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me. John 17:22-23

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and **perfect**, will of God. Romans 12:2

Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and that there be no divisions among you; but that ye be **perfectly** joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment. 1 Corinthians 1:10

Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, **perfecting** holiness in the fear of God. 2 Corinthians 7:1

He said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made **perfect** in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me. 2 Corinthians 12:9

I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest... For we are glad, when we are weak, and ye are strong; and this also we wish, even your **perfection**. Therefore I write these things being absent, lest being present I should use sharpness, according to the power which the Lord hath given me to edification, and not to destruction. Finally, brethren, farewell. Be **perfect**, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you. 2 Corinthians 13:7, 9-11

Are ye so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are ye now made **perfect** by the flesh? Galatians 3:3

Christ in you, the hope of glory: Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man **perfect** in Christ Jesus: Colossians 1:27-28

Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith... 1 Thessalonians 3:10

All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: that the man of God may be **perfect**, throughly furnished unto all good works. 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; and being made **perfect**, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him. Hebrews 5:7-9

Leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto **perfection**; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God... Hebrews 6:1

Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you **perfect** in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well-pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen. Hebrews 13:20-21

Let patience have her **perfect** work, that ye may be **perfect** and entire, wanting nothing. James 1:4

If any man offend not in word, the same is a perfect man... James 3:2

The God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, **perfect**, stablish, strengthen, settle you. 1 Peter 5:10

In this was manifested the love of God toward us, because that God sent his only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through him. Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we ought also to love one another.
