GOD'S PROMISES

The LORD God of your fathers make you a thousand times so many more as ye are, and bless you, as he hath **promised** you! Deuteronomy 1:11

The LORD hath avouched thee this day to be his peculiar people, as he hath **promised** thee, and that thou shouldest keep all his commandments; Deuteronomy 26:18

Their children also multiplieds thou as the stars of heaven, and broughtest them into the land, concerning which thou hadst **promised** to their fathers, that they should go in to possess it. Nehemiah 9:23

Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will perform that good thing which I have **promised** unto the house of Israel and to the house of Judah. Jeremiah 33:14

And now, O Lord GOD, thou art that God, and thy words be true, and thou hast **promised** this goodness unto thy servant: 2 Samuel 7:28

He remembered his holy promise, and Abraham his servant. Psalm 105:42

Behold, I send the **promise** of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high. Luke 24:49

Being assembled together with them, commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the **promise** of the Father, which, saith he, ye have heard of me. Acts 1:4

Therefore being by the right hand of God exalted, and having received of the Father the **promise** of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear...for the **promise** is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call. Acts 2:33, 39

Of this man's seed hath God according to his **promise** raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus: Acts 13:23

...(Which he had **promised** afore by his prophets in the holy scriptures,) concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh; and declared to be the Son of God... Romans 1:2-3

That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the **promise** of the Spirit through faith. Galatians 3:14

The scripture hath concluded all under sin, that the **promise** by faith of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. Galatians 3:22

If ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the **promise**. Galatians 3:29

He who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by **promise**...now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of **promise**. Galatians 4:23, 28

That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of **promise**, which is the earnest of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, unto the praise of his glory. Ephesians 1:12-14

For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them. Wherefore remember, that ye being in time past Gentiles in the flesh...that at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world: but now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ...for through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father. Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellow-citizens with the saints, and of the household of God. Ephesians 2:10-13, 18-19

The Gentiles should be fellow-heirs, and of the same body and partakers of his **promise** in Christ by the gospel...to the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God, according to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord: Ephesians 3:6, 10-11

For bodily exercise profiteth little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having **promise** of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. 1 Timothy 4:8

...Acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness; In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, **promised** before the world began; Titus 1:1b-2

Let us therefore fear, lest, a **promise** being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it...the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it. Hebrews 4:1-2

That ye be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the **promises**. For when God made **promise** to Abraham, because he could swear by no greater, he sware by himself, saying, Surely blessing I will bless thee, and multiplying I will multiply thee. Hebrews 6:13

And so, after he had patiently endured, he obtained the **promise**. For men verily swear by the greater: and an oath for confirmation is to them an end of all strife. Wherein God, willing more abundantly to shew unto the heirs of **promise** the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: that by two immutable things in which it was impossible for God to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us: Hebrews 6:15-18

For this cause he is mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions that were made under the first testament, they which are called might receive the **promise** of eternal inheritance. Hebrews 9:15

Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that **promised**...for ye have need of patience, that after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the **promise**. Hebrews 10:23, 36

By faith he sojourned in the land of **promise**, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same **promise**. For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker is God. Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had **promised**. Hebrews 11:9-11

See that ye refuse not him that speaketh. For if they escaped not who refused him that spake on earth, much more shall not we escape, if we turn away from him that speaketh from heaven: Whose voice then shook the earth: but now he hath **promised**, saying, Yet once more I shake not the earth only, but also heaven. Hebrews 12:25-26

Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath **promised** to them that love him. James 1:12

Hearken, my beloved brethren, Hath not God chosen the poor of this world rich in faith, and heirs of the kingdom which he hath **promised** to them that love him? James 2:5

The Lord is not slack concerning his **promise**, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance. Nevertheless we, according to his **promise**, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. 2 Peter 3:13

This is the promise that he hath **promised** us, even eternal life. 1 John 2:25
