SERVING GOD

Ye shall **serve** the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. Exodus 23:25

Thou shalt fear the LORD thy God, and **serve** him, and shalt swear by his name. Deuteronomy 6:13

Take heed to yourselves, that your heart be not deceived, and ye turn aside, and **serve** other gods, and worship them; Deuteronomy 30:17

Now therefore fear the LORD, and serve him in sincerity and in truth: and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the flood, and in Egypt; and serve ye the LORD. And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD... The people said unto Joshua, Nay; but we will serve the LORD... The LORD our God will we serve, and his voice will we obey... And Israel served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel. Joshua 24:14-31

If ye will fear the LORD, and serve him, and obey his voice, and not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then shall both ye and also the king that reigneth over you continue following the LORD your God... Serve the LORD with all your heart... Only fear the LORD, and serve him in truth with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you. 1 Samuel 12:14, 20, 24

They shall serve the LORD their God, and David... Jeremiah 30:9

Then Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word, and yielded their bodies, that they might not **serve** nor worship any god, except their own God. Daniel 3:28

She was a widow of about fourscore and four years, which departed not from the temple, but **served** God with fastings and prayers night and day. Luke 2:37

He that is gretest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve. Luke 22:26

If any man **serve** me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be: if any man **serve** me, him will my Father honour. John 12:26

For David, after he had **served** his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption: Acts 13:36

For God is my witness, whom I **serve** with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers; Romans 1:9

Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not **serve** sin. Romans 6:6

Now we are delivered from the law, that being dead wherein we were held; that we should **serve** in newness of spirit, and not in the oldness of the letter. Romans 7:6

For they that are such **serve** not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple. Romans 16:18

Whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men; Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ. Colossians 3:23-24

I thank God, whom I **serve** from my forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day; 2 Timothy 1:3

For if the blood of bulls and goats, and the ashes of an heifer sprinkling the unclean, sanctifieth to the purifying of the flesh: How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to **serve** the living God? Hebrews 9:13-14

Wherefore we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may **serve** God acceptably with reverence and godly fear: Hebrews 12:28

These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore are they before the throne of God, and **serve** him day and night in his temple: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. Revelation 7:14-15
