SWEET

The LORD smelled a **sweet** savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done. Genesis 8:21

He cried unto the LORD; and the LORD shewed him a tree, which when he had cast into the waters, the waters were made **sweet***… Exodus* 15:25

Oil for light, spices for anointing oil, and for sweet incense. Exodus 25:6

He made the holy anointing oil, and the pure incense of sweet spices, according to the work of the apothecary. Exodus 37:29

And he burnt **sweet** incense thereon; as the LORD commanded Moses. Exodus 40:27

The priests shall sprinkle the blood upon the altar of the LORD at the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and burn the fat for a **sweet** savour unto the LORD. Leviticus 17:6

They buried him in his own sepulchres, which he had made for himself in the city of David, and laid him in the bed which was filled with **sweet** odours and divers kinds of spices prepared by the apothecaries' art: and they made a very great burning for him. 2 Chronicles 16:14

Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the **sweet**, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for this day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10 Now when every maid's turn was come to go in to king Ahadureus, after that she had been twelve months, according to the manner of women, (for so were the days of their purifications accomplished, to wit, six months with oil of myrrh, and six months with **sweet** odours, and with other things for the purifying of the women;) Esthere 2:12
