THANKFULNESS

When ye will offer a sacrifice of *thanksgiving* unto the LORD, offer it at your own will. Leviticus 22:29

Therefore I will give **thanks** unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and I will sing praises unto thy name. 2 Samuel 22:50

Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. 1 Chronicles 16:8

At the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem they sought the Levites out of all their places, to bring them to Jerusalem, to keep the dedication with gladness, both with **thanksgivings**, and with singing, and with cymbals, psalteries, and with harps...For in the days of David and Asaph of old there were chief of the singers, and songs of praise and **thanksgiving** unto God. Nehemiah 12:27, 46

I will give thee **thanks** *in the great congregation: I will praise thee among much people. Psalm 35:18*

Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High: Psalm 50:14

I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with *thanksgiving*. Psalm 69:30

Unto thee, O God, do we give **thanks**, unto thee do we give **thanks**: for that thy name is near thy wondrous works declare. Psalm 75:1

It is a good thing to give **thanks** unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High: to shew forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night, upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound. For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through the works of thy hands. Psalm 92:1-4

Let us come before his presence with **thanksgiving**, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. Psalm 95:2

Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. Psalm 97:12

Enter into his gates with **thanksgiving**, and into his courts with praise: be **thankful** unto him, and bless his name. Psalm 100:4

I will offer to thee the sacrifice of *thanksgiving*, and will call upon the name of the LORD. Psalm 107:22

At midnight I will rise to give **thanks** unto thee because of thy righteous judgments. Psalm 119:62

O give **thanks** unto the LORD; for he is good: for his mercy endureth forever. O give **thanks** unto the God of gods: for his mercy endureth for ever. O give **thanks** to the Lord of lords: for his mercy endureth for ever...O give **thanks** unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever. Psalm 136:1-3,26

I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, and the right of the poor. Surely the righteous shall give **thanks** unto thy name: the upright shall dwell in thy presence. Psalm 140:12-13

Thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. 1 Corinthians 15:57

Now **thanks** be unto God, which always causeth us to triumph in Christ, and maketh manifest the savour of his knowledge by us in every place. 2 Corinthians 2:14

We also believe, and therefore speak; knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you. For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the **thanksgiving** of many redound to the glory of God. 2 Corinthians 4:15

Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us **thanksgiving** to God...**Thanks** be unto God for his unspeakable gift. 2 Corinthians 9:10-11,15

But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of **thanks**. Ephesians 5:3-4

Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with *thanksgiving* let your requests be made known unto God. Philippians 4:6

As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with **thanksgiving**. Colossians 2:6-7

We give **thanks** to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you, remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father; knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God. 1 Thessalonians 1:2-3 Let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye **thankful**. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving **thanks** to God and the Father by him. Colossians 3:15-17

Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving; Colossians 4:2

Rejoice evermore. Pray without ceasing. In every thing give **thanks**: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you. Quench not the Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. Prove all things; hold fast that which is good. Abstain from all appearance of evil. And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24

We are bound to give **thanks** alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14

By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of our lips giving **thanks** to his name. Hebrews 13:15

When those beasts give glory and honour and **thanks** to him that sat on the throne, who liveth for ever and ever, the four and twenty elders fall down before him that sat on the throne, and worship him that liveth for ever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying, Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created. Revelation 4:9-11

Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and **thanksgiving**, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen. Revelation 7:12
