THE ROCK

He is **the Rock**, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he. Deuteronomy 32:4

But Jeshurun waxed fat, and kicked: thou art waxen fat, thou art grown thick, thou art covered with fatness; then he forsook God which made him, and lightly esteemed **the Rock** of his salvation. Deuteronomy 32:15

Of **the Rock** that begat thee thou art unmindful, and hast forgotten God that formed thee. Deuteronomy 32:18

How should one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, except **their Rock** had sold them, and the LORD had shut them up? For their rock is not as **our Rock**, even our enemies themselves being judges. Deuteronomy 32:30-31

There is none holy as the LORD: for there is none beside thee: neither is there **any rock** like our God. The God of **my rock**; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou saved me from violence. 1 Samuel 2:2-3

And David spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day that the LORD had delivered him out of the hand of Saul...He said, The LORD is **my rock**, and my fortress, and my deliverer... 2 Samuel 22:1-2

For who is God, save the LORD? And who is **a rock**, save our God? ... The LORD liveth; and blessed be **my rock**; and exalted be the God of **the rock** of my salvation. 2 Samuel 22:32, 47

The God of Israel said, **the Rock** of Israel spake to me, He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God. 2 Samuel 23:3

The LORD is **my rock**, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, and my high tower. Psalm 18:2

For who is God save the LORD? Or who is **a rock** save our God? ... The LORD liveth; and blessed be **my rock**; and let the God of my salvation be exalted. Psalm 18:31, 46

For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon **a rock**. Psalm 27:5

*Unto thee will I cry, O LORD **my rock**; be not silent to me: lest, if thou be silent to me, I become like them that go down into the pit. Psalm 28:1*

*For thou art **my rock** and my fortress; therefore for thy name's sake lead me, and guide me. Psalm 31:3*

*He brought me up also out of an horrible pit, out of the miry clay, and set my feet upon **a rock**, and established my goings. Psalm 40:2*

*I will say unto God **my rock**, Why hast thou forgotten me? Why go I mourning because of the oppression of the enemy? Psalm 42:9*

*From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to **the rock** that is higher than I. Psalm 61:2*

*He only is **my rock** and my salvation: he is my defence; I shall not be moved. In God is my salvation and my glory: **the rock** of my strength, and my refuge, is in God. Psalm 62:6-7*

*Be thou my strong habitation, whereunto I may continually resort: thou hast given commandment to save me; for thou art **my rock** and my fortress. Psalm 71:3*

*They remembered that God was **their rock**, and the high God their redeemer. Psalm 78:35*

*He shall cry unto me, Thou art my father, my God, and **the rock** of my salvation. Psalm 89:26*

*They shall be fat and flourishing; To shew that the LORD is upright: he is **my rock**, and there is no unrighteousness in him. Psalm 92:14-15*

*The LORD is my defence; and my God is **the rock** of my refuge. Psalm 94: 22*

*O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to **the rock** of our salvation. Psalm 95:1*

*Because thou hast forgotten the God of thy salvation, and hast not been mindful of **the rock** of thy strength, therefore shalt thou plant pleasant plants, and shalt set it with strange slips...Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto **the rock** from whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged. Isaiah 17:10, 51:1*

*Whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a **rock**. And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a **rock**. And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it. Matthew 7:24-27*

*Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God. And Jesus answered and said unto him, Blessed art thou, Simon Barjona: for flesh and blood hath not revealed it unto thee, but my Father which is in heaven. And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon **this rock** I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it... Matthew 16:16-18 (rock = revelation of who Christ is)*

*He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a **rock**: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a **rock**. But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great. Luke 6:48-49*

*But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, hath not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that **stumblingstone**; As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a **stumblingstone** and **rock** of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed. Romans 9:31-33*

*And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of **that spiritual Rock** that followed them: and **that Rock was Christ**. 1 Corinthians 10:4*

*Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Sion a chief corner **stone**, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, **the stone** which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner, And a **stone** of stumbling, and a **rock** of offence, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed. 1 Peter 2:6-8*
