TRUTH

He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of **truth** and without iniquity, just and right is he. Deuteronomy 32:4

Only fear the LORD, and serve him in **truth** with all your heart: for consider how great things he hath done for you. 1 Samuel 12:24

LORD, who shall abide in thy tabernacle? Who shall dwell in thy holy hill? He that walketh uprightly, and worketh righteousness, and speaketh the truth in his heart. Psalm 15:1-2

Lead me in **thy truth**, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. Psalm 25:5

O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles. Psalm 43:3

Behold, thou desirest **truth** in the inward parts: and in the hidden part thou shalt make me to know wisdom. Psalm 51:6

For my mouth shall speak **truth**; and wickedness is an abomination to my lips. Proverbs 8:7

Buy the truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding. Proverbs 23:23

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and **truth**. John 1:14

Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, **the truth**, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. John 14:6

When he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. John 16:13

To them who by patient continuance in well-doing seek for glory and honour and immortality, eternal life: But unto them that are contentious, and do not obey **the truth**, but obey unrighteousness, indignation and wrath... Romans 2:7-8

Jesus Christ was a minister of the circumcision for **the truth of God**, to confirm the promises made unto the fathers: Romans 15:8

Let us keep the feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and **truth**. 1 Corinthians 5:8

... We have obtained an inheritance being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will: That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard **the word of truth**, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise... Ephesians 1:11-13

The fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth; Ephesians 5:9

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplace of righteousness... Ephesians 6:14

We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you...For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of **the truth** of the gospel; which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in **truth**... Colossians 1:3, 5-6

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work... With all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. ... But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 2:7, 10-14

I exhort therefore, that, first of all supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men...For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour; who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of **the truth**. 1 Timothy 2:1, 3-4

Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing **the word of truth**. 2 Timothy 2:15

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; and they shall turn away their ears from **the truth**, and shall be turned unto fables. 2 Timothy 4:3-4

Of his own will begat he us with **the word of truth**, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures. James 1:18

Brethren, if any of you do err from the truth, and one convert him; Let him know, that he which converteth the sinner from the error of his way, shall save a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins. James 5:19-20

For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of **the truth**, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins... Hebrews 10:26

Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, see that ye love one another with a pure heart fervently: 2 Peter 1:22

I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in **truth**. 3 John 1:4

The anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is **truth**, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. 1 John 2:27
