## WAITING ON THE LORD

Ihave waited for thy salvation, OLORD. Genesis 49:18

Yea, let none that **wait** on thee be ashamed: let them be ashamed which transgress without cause...Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I **wait** all the day. Psalm 25:3, 5

Let integrity and uprightness preserve me; for I wait on thee. Psalm 25:21

Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD. Psalm 27:14

Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield. Psalm 33:20

Rest in the LORD, and **wait** patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass... For evil doers shall be cut off: but those that **wait** upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth... **Wait** on the LORD, and keep his way, and he shall exalt thee to inherit the land: when the wicked are cut off, thou shalt see it. Psalm 37:7, 9, 34

Now, Lord, what wait I for? My hope is in thee. Psalm 39:7

I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry. Psalm 40:1

I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done it: and I will **wait** on thy name; for it is good before thy saints. Psalm 52:9

Because of his strength will I wait upon thee: for God is my defence. Psalm 59:9

Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him cometh my salvation... My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him. Psalm 62:1, 5

I am weary of my crying: my throat is dried: mine eyes fail while I wait for my God...Let not them that wait on thee, O Lord GOD of hosts, be ashamed for my sake: Psalm 69:3, 6

They soon forgat his works; they waited not for his counsel. Psalm 106:13

Behold, as the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress; so our eyes **wait** upon the LORD our God, until that he hath mercy upon us. Psalm 123:2

I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope. My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: Isay, more than they that watch for the morning. Psalm 130:5-6

The eyes of all **wait** upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. Psalm 145:15

Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but **wait** on the LORD, and he shall save thee. Proverbs 20:22

In the way of thy judgments, O LORD, have we waited for thee; the desire of our soul is to thy name, and to the remembrance of thee. Isaiah 26:8

Therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you: for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him. Isaiah 30:18

O LORD, be gracious unto us; we have **waited** for thee: be thou their arm every morning, our salvation also in the time of trouble. Isaiah 33:2

Surely the isles shall **wait** for me, and the ships of Tarshish first, to bring thy sons from far, their silver and their gold with them, unto the name of the LORD thy God, and to the Holy One of Israel, because he hath glorified thee. Isaiah 60:9

For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that **waiteth** for him. Isaiah 64:4

The LORD is good unto them that **wait** for him, to the soul that seeketh him. It is good that a man should both hope and quietly **wait** for the salvation of the LORD. Lamentations 3:25-26

Turn thou to thy God: keep mercy and judgment, and wait on thy God continually. Hosea 12:6

I will look unto the LORD; I will **wait** for the God of my salvation: my God will hearme. Micah 7:7

For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, **wait** for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry. Habakkuk 2:3

Therefore **wait** ye upon me, saith the LORD, until the day that I rise up to the prey: for my determination is to gather the nations, that I may assemble the kingdoms, to pour upon them mine indignation, even all my fierce anger: for all the earth shall be devoured with the fire of my jealousy. Zephaniah 3:8

Behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, **waiting** for the consolation of Israel: and the Holy Ghost was upon him. Luke 2:25

It came to pass, that, when Jesus was returned, the people gladly received him: for they were all **waiting** for him. Luke 8:40

Let your loins be girded about, and your lights burning; And ye yourselves like unto men that **wait** for their lord, when he will return from the wedding; that when he cometh and knocketh, they may open unto him immediately. Luke 12:35-36

The whole creation groaneth and travaileth...Ourselves also, which have the firstfruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, to wit, the redemption of our body...If we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it. Romans 8:22-25
