FOUNTAINS, RIVERS, SPRINGS, STREAMS, AND WATERS

*Thou shalt make them drink of the **river** of thy pleasures. For with thee is the **fountain** of life: in thy light shall we see light. Psalm 36:8-9*

*There is **a river, the streams** whereof shall make glad the city of God, the holy place of the tabernacles of the most High. Psalm 46:4*

*Thou visitest the earth, and **waterest** it: thou greatly enrichest it with **the river of God**, which is full of **water**: Psalm 65:9*

*Bless ye God in the congregations, even the Lord, from the **fountain** of Israel. Psalm 68:26*

*His foundation is in the holy mountains...glorious things are spoken of thee, O city of God. Selah...of Zion it shall be said, This and that man was born in her: and the highest himself shall establish her. The LORD shall count, when he writeth up the people, that this man was born there. Selah...All my **springs** are in thee. Psalm 87:1-7*

*Drink **waters** out of thine own cistern, and running **waters** out of thine own well. Let thy **fountains** be dispersed abroad, and **rivers of waters** in the streets. Let them be only thine own, and not strangers' with thee. Let thy **fountain** be blessed: and rejoice with the wife of thy youth. Proverbs 5:15-18*

*The law of the wise is a **fountain** of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 13:14*

*The fear of the LORD is a **fountain** of life, to depart from the snares of death. Proverbs 14:27*

*The words of a man's mouth are as deep **waters**, and **the well-spring** of wisdom as **a flowing brook**. Proverbs 18:4*

*A righteous man falling down before the wicked is as a troubled **fountain**, and a corrupt **spring**. Proverbs 25:26*

*A garden inclosed is my sister, my spouse; a **spring** shut up, a **fountain** sealed...A **fountain** of gardens, a well of **living waters**, and **streams** from Lebanon. Song of Solomon 4:12, 15*

*Therefore with joy shall ye draw **water** out of the wells of salvation. Isaiah 12:3*

*A man shall be as an hiding place from the wind, and a covert from the tempest; **as rivers of water** in a dry place, as the shadow of a great rock in a weary land. Isaiah 32:2*

*There the glorious LORD will be unto us a place of broad **rivers and streams...***
Isaiah 33:21

*I will open **rivers** in high places, and **fountains** in the midst of the valleys: I will make the wilderness a pool of **water**, and the dry land **springs of water**.*
Isaiah 41:18

*For I will pour **water** upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring: and they shall spring up as among the grass, as willows by the water courses.*
Isaiah 44:3-4

*They shall not hunger nor thirst; neither shall the heat nor sun smite them: for he that hath mercy on them shall lead them, even by **the springs of water** shall he guide them.* Isaiah 49:9-10

*Ho, every one that thirsteth, come ye to the **waters**, and he that hath no money; come ye, buy, and eat; come, buy wine and milk without money and without price.* Isaiah 55:1

*The LORD shall guide thee continually, and satisfy thy soul in drought, and make fat thy bones: and thou shalt be like **a watered garden**, and like **a spring of water, whose waters fail not**.* Isaiah 58:11

*For my people have committed two evils; they have forsaken me **the fountain of living waters**, and hewed them out cisterns, broken cisterns, that can hold no **water**.* Jeremiah 2:13

*A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary. O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, and they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, **the fountain of living waters**.* Jeremiah 17:12-13

*They shall come with weeping, and with supplications will I lead them: I will cause them to walk by **the rivers of waters** in a straight way, wherein they shall not stumble: for I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my firstborn.*
Jeremiah 31:9

*It shall come to pass in that day, that the mountains shall drop down new wine, and the hills shall flow with milk, and all **the rivers** of Judah shall flow with **waters**, and a **fountain** shall come forth of the house of the LORD, and shall **water** the valley of Shittim.* Joel 3:18

*In that day there shall be a **fountain** opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.* Zechariah 13:1

*There cometh a woman of Samaria to draw water: Jesus saith unto her, give me to drink...Jesus answered and said unto her, If thou knewest the gift of God, and who it is that saith to thee, Give me to drink; thou wouldst have asked of him, and he would have given thee **living water**. The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that **living water**? Art thou greater than our father Jacob, which gave us the well, and drank thereof himself, and his children, and his cattle? Jesus answered and said unto her, Whosoever drinketh of this water shall thirst again: but whosoever drinketh of the **water** that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the **water** that I shall give him shall be in him a well of **water springing up into everlasting life**. The woman saith unto him, Sir, give me this **water**, that I thirst not... John 4:7-15*

*In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow **rivers of living water**. (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:37-39*

*Doth a **fountain** send forth at the same place sweet water and bitter? Can the fig tree, my brethren, bear olive berries? Either a vine, figs? So can no **fountain** both yield salt water and fresh. James 3:11-12*

*For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto **living fountains of waters**: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes. Revelation 7:17*

*He said unto me, It is done. I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the end. I will give unto him that is athirst of **the fountain of the water of life** freely. Revelation 21:6*

*And he shewed me a **pure river of water of life**, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb. In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of **the river**, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month; and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him. Revelation 22:1-3*
