BELIEF

Abram said, Behold, to me you have given no seed: and, lo, one born in my house is mine heir. And, behold, the word of the LORD [YeHoVaH] came unto him, saying, This shall not be your heir; but he that shall come forth out of your own bowels shall be your heir. He brought him forth abroad, and said, Look now toward heaven, and tell the stars, if you be able to number them: and He said unto him, So shall your seed be. And he **believed** in the LORD; and He counted it to him for righteousness. Genesis 15:5-6

Joseph is yet alive, and he is governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he **believed** them not. Genesis 45:26

Moses answered and said, But, behold, they will not **believe** me, nor hearken unto my voice: for they will say, The LORD has not appeared unto you...and the LORD said unto Moses, Put forth your hand, and take it by the tail. And he put forth his hand, and caught it, and it became a rod in his hand: That they may **believe** that the LORD God of their fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared unto you. Exodus 4:1, 4-5

It shall come to pass, if they will not **believe** you, neither hearken to the voice of the first sign, that they will **believe** the voice of the latter sign. And it shall come to pass, if they will not **believe** also these two signs, neither hearken unto your voice, that you shall take of the water of the river, and pour it upon the dry land: and the water which you take out of the river shall become blood upon the dry land...The people **believed**: and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel, and that He had looked upon their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshiped ...And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and **believed** the LORD, and His servant Moses. Exodus 4:8-9, 31; 14:31

The LORD said unto Moses, Lo, I come unto you in a thick cloud, that the people may hear when I speak with you, and **believe** you for ever. And Moses told the words of the people unto YeHoVaH. Exodus 19:9

How long will this people provoke Me? And how long will it be ere they **believe** Me, for all the signs which I have shown among them? Numbers 14:11

The LORD [YeHoVaH] spoke unto Moses and Aaron, Because you **believed** Me not, to sanctify Me in the eyes of the children of Israel, therefore you shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them. Numbers 20:12

Yet in this thing you did not **believe** the LORD your God, Who went in the way before you, to search you out a place to pitch your tents in, in fire by night, to shew you by what way you should go, and in a cloud by day. And the LORD heard the voice of your words, and was wroth, and swore, saying, Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I swore to give unto your fathers. Deuteronomy 1:32

Likewise when the LORD sent you from Kadesh-barnea, saying, Go up and possess the land which I have given you; then you rebelled against the commandment of the LORD your God, and you **believed** Him not, nor hearkened to His voice. Deuteronomy 9:23

Achish **believed** David, saying, He has made his people Israel utterly to abhor him; therefore he shall be my servant for ever. 1 Samuel 27:12

When the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the LORD [YeHoVaH], she came to prove him with hard questions...and Solomon told her all her questions: there was not any thing hid from the king, which he told her not...Howbeit I **believed** not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and, behold, the half was not told me: your wisdom and prosperity exceeds the fame which I heard. 1 Kings 10:1, 3, 7

Notwithstanding they would not hear, but hardened their necks, like to the neck of their fathers, that did not **believe** in the LORD their God. 2 Kings 17:14

I **believed** not their words, until I came, and my eyes had seen it: and, behold, the one half of the greatness of your wisdom was not told me: for you exceed the fame that I heard. 2 Chronicles 9:6

They rose early in the morning, and went forth into the wilderness of Tekoa: and as they went forth, Jehoshaphat stood and said, Hear me, O Judah, and you inhabitants of Jerusalem; **Believe** in the LORD your God [YeHoVaH], so shall you be established; **believe** His prophets, so shall you prosper. 2 Chronicles 20:20

Now therefore let not Hezekiah deceive you, nor persuade you on this manner, neither yet **believe** him: for no god of any nation or kingdom was able to deliver His people out of my hand, and out of the hand of my fathers: how much less shall your God deliver you out of my hand? 2 Chronicles 32:15

If I had called, and he had answered me; yet would I not **believe** that He had hearkened unto My voice. Job 9:16

Will you **believe** him, that he will bring home your seed, and gather it into your barns? Job 39:12

I had fainted, unless I had **believed** to see the goodness of the LORD [YeHoVaH] in the land of the living. Psalm 27:13

Therefore the LORD heard this, and was wroth: so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel; Because they **believed** not in God, and trusted not in His salvation... Psalm 78:21-22

For all this they sinned still, and **believed** not for His wondrous works. Therefore their days did He consume in vanity, and their years in trouble. When He slew them, then they sought Him: and they returned and inquired early after God. Psalm 78:32-34

Then **believed** they His words; they sang His praise... Psalm 106:12

Yes, they despised the pleasant land, they **believed** not His word; but murmured in their tents, and hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Psalm 106:24-25

I **believed**, therefore have I spoken: I was greatly afflicted... Psalms 116:10

Teach me good judgment and knowledge: for I have **believed**
Your commandments. Psalm 119:66

The simple **believe** every word: but the prudent man looks well
to his going. Proverbs 14:15

Burning lips and a wicked heart are like a potsherd covered with
silver dross. He that hates dissembles with his lips, and lays up
deceit within him; When he speaks fair, **believe** him not: for there
are seven abominations in his heart. Proverbs 26:23-25

Therefore thus says the Lord GOD [YeHoVaH], Behold, I lay
in Zion for a foundation a stone, a tried stone, a precious
corner stone, a sure foundation: he that **believes** shall not
make haste. Isaiah 28:16

You are My witnesses, says the LORD, and My servant whom I
have chosen: that you may know and **believe** Me, and understand
that I am He: before Me there was no God formed, neither shall
there be after Me. Isaiah 43:10

Who has **believed** our report? And to whom is the arm of the
LORD revealed? For He shall grow up before Him as a tender
plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form nor
comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that
we should desire Him. He was despised and rejected of men;
a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it
were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him
not. Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet
we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised
for our iniquities... Isaiah 53:1-5

For even your brethren, and the house of your father,
even they have dealt treacherously with you; yes, they have called
a multitude after you: **believe** them not, though they speak
fair words unto you. Jeremiah 12:6

And said unto him, Do you certainly know that Baalis the king of
the Ammonites has sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay
you? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam **believed** them not.
Jeremiah 40:14

Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he **believed** in his God. Daniel 6:23

The kings of the earth, and all the inhabitants of the world, would not have **believed** that the adversary and the enemy should have entered into the gates of Jerusalem. Lamentations 4:12

The people of Nineveh **believed** God, and proclaimed a fast, and put on sackcloth, from the greatest of them even to the least of them. Jonah 3:5

Behold you among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvelously: for I will work a work in your days, which you will not **believe**, though it be told you. Habakkuk 1:5

BELIEVE & BELIEF IN THE NEW COVENANT

Speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed. For I am a man under authority, having soldiers under me: and I say to this man, Go, and he goes; and to another, Come, and he comes; and to my servant, Do this, and he does it...And Jesus [Yeshua] said unto the centurion, Go your way; and as you have **believed**, so be it done unto you. And his servant was healed in the selfsame hour. Matthew 8:8-9, 13

When He was come into the house, the blind men came to Him: and Jesus [Yeshua] said unto them, Do you **believe** that I am able to do this? They said unto Him, Yes, Lord. Matthew 9:28

But whoever shall offend one of these little ones which **believe** in Me, it were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and that he were drowned in the depth of the sea. Mt 18:6

Jesus [Yeshua] answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If you have faith, and doubt not, you shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if you shall say unto this mountain, Be removed, and be cast into the sea; it shall be done. And all things, whatever you shall ask in prayer, **believing**, you shall receive. Matthew 21:21-22

The baptism of John, where was it from? From heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say unto us, Why did you not then **believe** Him?...For John came unto you in the way of righteousness, and you **believed** him not; but the publicans and the harlots **believed** him: and you, when you had seen it, repented not afterward, that you might **believe** him. Matthew 21:25, 32

Then if any man shall say unto you, Lo, here is Christ [the Messiah], or there; **believe** it not...Wherefore if they shall say unto you, Behold, he is in the desert; go not forth: behold, he is in the secret chambers; **believe** it not. Matthew 24:23, 26

...The chief priests mocking Him, with the scribes and elders, said, He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will **believe** Him. Matthew 27:42

After that John was put in prison, Jesus [Yeshua] came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom of God, And saying, The time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand: repent you, and **believe** the gospel. Mark 1:15

As soon as Jesus [Yeshua] heard the word that was spoken, He said unto the ruler of the synagogue, Be not afraid, only **believe**. Mark 5:36

Jesus [Yeshua] said unto him, If you can **believe**, all things are possible to him that **believes**. And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I **believe**; help my unbelief. Mark 9:23-24

Whoever shall offend one of these little ones that **believe** in Me, it is better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he were cast into the sea. Mark 9:42

I say unto you, That whoever shall say unto this mountain, Be removed, and be cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall **believe** that those things which He said shall come to pass; he shall have whatever he says. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, **believe** that you receive them, and you shall have them. Mark 11:23-24

There come to Him the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders, And say unto him, By what authority do you these things? ...Jesus [Yeshua] answered and said unto them, I will also ask of you one question, and answer Me, and I will tell you by what authority I do these things. The baptism of John, was it from heaven, or of men? Answer Me...They reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then did you not **believe** him? But if we shall say, Of men; they feared the people: for all men counted John, that he was a prophet indeed. Mark 11:31-32

Then if any man shall say to you, Lo, here is Christ [the Messiah]; or, lo, he is there; **believe** him not... Mark 13:21

Let Christ [Messiah] the King of Israel descend now from the cross, that we may see and **believe**. And they that were crucified with Him reviled Him. Mark 15:32

And they, when they had heard that He was alive, and had been seen of her, **believed** not...And they went and told it unto the residue; neither **believed** they them. Mark 16:13

Afterward He appeared unto the eleven as they sat at meat, and upbraided them with their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they **believed** not them which had seen him after He was risen. And He said unto them, Go you into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that **believes** and is baptized shall be saved; but he that **believes** not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that **believe**; In My name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues... Mark 16:14-17

Forasmuch as man have taken in hand to set forth in order a declaration of those things which are most surely **believed** among us. Even as they delivered them unto us, which from the beginning were eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word; It seemed good to me also, having had perfect understanding of all things from the very first, to write unto you... Luke 1:1-3

And, behold, you shall be dumb, and not able to speak, until the day that these things shall be performed, because you **believed** not my words, which shall be fulfilled in their season. Luke 1:20

Those by the way side are they that hear; then comes the devil, and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should **believe** and be saved. They on the rock are they, which, when they hear, receive the word with joy; and these have no root, which for while **believe**, and in time of temptation fall away. Luke 8:12-13

But when Jesus [Yeshua] heard it, He answered him, saying, Fear not: **believe** only, and she shall be made whole. Luke 8:50

They reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; He will say, Why then **believed** you him not? Luke 20:5

Are you the Christ [the Messiah]? Tell us. And He said unto them, If I tell you, you will not **believe**... Luke 22:67

They remembered His words, and returned from the sepulcher, and told all these things unto the eleven, and to all the rest... And their words seemed to them as idle tales, and they **believed** them not... Then He said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to **believe** all that the prophets have spoken... Luke 24:8-11, 25

While they yet **believed** not for joy, and wondered, He said unto them, Have you here any meat? Luke 24:41

There was a man sent from God, whose name was John, The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through Him might **believe**. John 1:6-7

But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that **believe** on His name: Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. John 1:12-13

Jesus [Yeshua] answered and said unto him, Because I said unto you, I saw you under the fig tree, **believe** you? You shall see greater things than these. John 1:50

This beginning of miracles did Jesus [Yeshua] in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth His glory; and His disciples **believed** on Him. John 2:11

When...He was risen from the dead, His disciples remembered that He had said this unto them; and they **believed** the scripture, and the word which Jesus [Yeshua] had said. John 2:22

Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, in the feast day, many **believed** in His name, when they saw the miracles which He did. John 2:23

If I have told you earthly things, and you **believe** not, how shall you **believe**, if I tell you of heavenly things? And no man has ascended up to heaven, but He that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven...As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whoever **believes** in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever **believes** in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life. For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved. He that **believes** on Him is not condemned: but he that **believes** not is condemned already, because he has not **believed** in the name of the only begotten Son of God. John 3:13-18

He that **believes** on the Son has everlasting life: and he that **believes** not on the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abides on him. John 3:36

Jesus said unto her, Woman, **believe** Me, the hour comes, when you shall neither in this mountain, nor yet at Jerusalem, worship the Father ...Many of the Samaritans of that city **believed** on Him for the saying of the woman, which testified, He told me all that ever I did...And many more **believed** because of His own word. And said unto the woman, Now we **believe**, not because of your saying: for we have heard Him ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Savior of the world. John 4:21, 39, 41-42

There was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto Him, and besought Him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death. Then said Jesus unto him, Except you see signs and wonders, you will not **believe**. The nobleman said unto Him, Sir, come down ere my child die. Jesus said unto him, Go your way; your son lives. And the man **believed** the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way...So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Your son lives: and himself **believed**, and his whole house. John 4:46-50-53

Truly, truly, I say unto you, He that hears My word, and **believes** on Him that sent Me, has everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. John 5:24

And you have not His word abiding in you: for whom He has sent, Him you **believe** not. John 5:38

How can you **believe**, which receive honor one of another, and seek not the honor that comes from God only? Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father: there is one that accuses you, even Moses, in whom you trust. For had you **believed** Moses, you would have **believed** Me: for he wrote of Me. But if you **believe** not his writings, how shall you **believe** My words? John 5:44-47

This is the work of God, that you **believe** on Him whom He has sent. They said therefore unto Him, What sign show you then, that we may see, and **believe** You? What do you work? ...Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that comes to Me shall never hunger; and he that **believes** on Me shall never thirst. But I said unto you, That you also have seen Me, and **believe** not. John 6:29-30, 35-36

And this is the will of Him that sent Me, that every one which sees the Son, and **believes** on Him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise Him up at the last day...Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that **believes** on Me has everlasting life. John 6:40, 47

But there are some of you that **believe** not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that **believed** not, and who should betray Him...Then Simon Peter answered Him, Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. And we **believe** and are sure that You are that Christ, the Son of the living God. John 6:64, 68-69

His brethren therefore said unto Him, Depart hence, and go into Judaea, that Your disciples also may see the works that You do... For neither did His brethren **believe** in Him. John 7:3, 5

Many of the people **believed** on Him, and said, When Christ [Messiah] comes, will He do more miracles than these which this man has done? John 7:31

He that **believes** on Me, as the scripture has said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that **believe** on Him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.) John 7:38-39

Then answered them the Pharisees, Are you also deceived? Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees **believed** on Him? Jn 7:47-48

And He said unto them, You are from beneath; I am from above; you are of this world; I am not of this world. I said therefore unto you, that you shall die in your sins: for if you **believe** not that I am He, you shall die in your sins. John 8:23-24

Then said Jesus unto them, When you have lifted up the Son of man, then shall you know that I am He, and that I do nothing of Myself; but as My Father has taught Me, I speak these things. And He that sent Me is with Me: the Father has not left Me alone; for I do always those things that please Him. As He spake these words, many **believed** on Him. Then said Jesus to those Jews which **believed** on Him, If you continue in My word, then are you My disciples indeed; and you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. John 8:28-32

Because I tell you the truth, you **believe** Me not. Which of you convinces Me of sin? And if I say the truth, why do you not **believe** Me? He that is of God hears God's words: you therefore hear them not, because you are not of God. John 8:45-47

But the Jews did not **believe** concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight...Do you **believe** on the Son of God? He answered and said, Who is He, Lord, that I might **believe** on Him? ...And he said, Lord, I **believe**. And he worshiped Him. John 9:18, 35-36, 38

I told you, and you **believed** not: the works that I do in My Father's name, they bear witness of Me. But you **believe** not, because you are not of My sheep, as I said unto you...If I do not the works of My Father, **believe** Me not. But if I do, though you **believe** not Me, **believe** the works: that you may know, and **believe**, that the Father is in Me, and I in Him. Jn 10:25-26, 37-38

Therefore they sought again to take Him: but He escaped out of their hand, and went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there He abode. And many resorted unto Him, and said, John did no miracle; but all things that John spake of this man were true. And many **believed** on Him there. John 10:42

I am glad for your sakes that I was not there, to the intent you may **believe**; nevertheless let us go unto him. John 11:15

Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that **believes** in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: Whoever lives and **believes** in Me shall never die. Do you **believe** this? She said unto Him, Yes, Lord: I **believe** that you are the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world. Jn 11:25-27

Some of them said, Could not this man, which opened the eyes of the blind, have caused that even this man should not have died? ...Jesus [Yeshua] said unto her, Said I not unto you, that, if you would **believe**, you should see the glory of God? Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up His eyes, and said, Father, I thank You that You have heard Me. And I knew that You hear Me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may **believe** that You have sent Me... John 11:37, 40-42

He cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus [Yeshua] said unto them, Loose him, and let him go. Then many of the Jews which came to Mary, and had seen the things which Jesus [Yeshua] did, **believed** on Him. John 11:43-45

If we let Him thus alone, all men will **believe** on Him: and the Romans shall come and take away both our place and nation. John 11:48

Because that by reason of Him many of the Jews went away, and **believed** on Jesus [Yeshua]. John 12:11

While you have light, **believe** in the light, that you may be the children of light. John 12:36

These things spake Jesus [Yeshua], and departed, and did hide Himself from them. But though He had done so many miracles before them, yet they **believed** not on Him. That the saying of Esaias the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke, Lord, who has **believed** our report? And to whom has the arm of the Lord been revealed? Therefore they could not **believe**, because that Esaias said again, He has blinded their eyes, and hardened their heart; that they should not see with their eyes, nor understand with their heart, and be converted, and I should heal them. These things said Esaias, when he saw His glory, and spake of Him. John 12:37-41

Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many **believed** on Him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue...Jesus cried and said, He that **believes** on Me, **believes** not on Me, but on Him that sent Me... I am come a light into the world, that whoever **believes** on Me should not abide in darkness. And if any man hear My words, and **believe** not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to save the world. John 12:42-47

Now I tell you before it come, that, when it is come to pass, you may **believe** that I am He. John 13:19

Let not your heart be troubled: you **believe** in God, **believe** also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. John 14:1-2

Believe you not that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak unto you I speak not of Myself: but the Father that dwells in Me, He does the works. **Believe** Me that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me: or else **believe** Me for the very works' sake. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that **believes** on Me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto My Father. John 14:10-12

You have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If you loved Me, you would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for My Father is greater than I. And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, that you might **believe**. John 14:28-29

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send Him unto you. And when He is come, He will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: Of sin, because they **believe** not on Me... John 16:7-9

For the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have **believed** that I came out from God. John 16:27

Now are we sure that you know all things, and need not that any man should ask you: by this we **believe** that You came forth from God. Jesus answered them, Do you now **believe**? John 16:30-31

For I have given unto them the words which You gave Me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from You, and they have **believed** that You did send me. I pray for them: I pray not for the world, but for them which You have given Me; for they are Yours. And all mine are Yours, and Yours are mine; and I am glorified in them. John 17:8-10

Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall **believe** on Me through their word; That they all may be one; as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, that they also may be one in Us; that the world may **believe** that You have sent Me. John 17:20-21

He that saw it bare record, and his record is true: and he knows that he says true, that you might **believe**. John 19:35

Then went in also that other disciple, which came first to the sepulcher, and he saw, and **believed**. John 20:8

The other disciples therefore said unto him, We have seen the Lord. But he said unto them, Except I shall see in His hands the print of the nails, and put my finger into the print of the nails, and thrust my hand into His side, I will not **believe**... Then said He to Thomas, Reach hither your finger, and behold My hands; and reach hither your hand, and thrust it into My side: and be not faithless, but **believing**. And Thomas answered and said unto Him, My Lord and my God. Jesus said unto Him, Thomas, because you have seen Me, you have **believed**: blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have **believed**. John 20:25, 27-29

Many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of His disciples, which are not written in this book: But these are written, that you might **believe** that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that **believing** you might have life through His name. John 20:30-31

All that **believed** were together, and had all things common... Acts 2:44

Howbeit many of them which heard the word **believed**; and the number of the men was about five thousand. Acts 4:4

And the multitude of them that **believed** were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things in common. Acts 4:32

And by the hands of the apostles were many signs and wonders wrought among the people; (and they were all with one accord in Solomon's porch. And of the rest dared no man join himself to them: but the people magnified them. And **believers** were the more added to the Lord, multitudes both of men and women.) Acts 5:14

But when they **believed** Philip preaching the things concerning the Kingdom of God, and the name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized, both men and women. Then Simon himself **believed** also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done. Acts 8:12-13

As they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what does hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If you **believe** with all your heart, you may. And he answered and said, I **believe** that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. Acts 8:36-37

When Saul was come to Jerusalem he assayed to join himself to the disciples: but they were all afraid of him, and **believed** not that he was a disciple. Acts 9:26

It was known throughout all Joppa; and many **believed** in the Lord. Acts 9:42

Him God raised up the third day, and showed Him openly... To Him give all the prophets witness, that through His name whoever **believes** in Him shall receive remission of sins. While Peter yet spoke these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word. And they of the circumcision which **believed** were astonished, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Ghost. Acts 10:40, 43-45

Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as He did unto us, who **believed** on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God? When they heard these things, they held their peace, and glorified God, saying, Then has God also to the Gentiles granted repentance unto life...And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number **believed**, and turned unto the Lord. Acts 11:17-18, 21

Then the deputy, when he saw what was done, **believed**, being astonished at the doctrine of the Lord. Acts 13:12

By Him all that **believe** are justified from all things, from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses. Acts 13:39

Beware therefore, lest that come upon you, which is spoken of in the prophets; Behold, you despisers, and wonder, and perish: for I work a work in your days, a work which you shall in no wise **believe**, though a man declare it unto you. Acts 13:40-41

When the Jews saw the multitudes, they were filled with envy, and spake against those things which were spoken by Paul, contradicting and blaspheming. Then Paul and Barnabas waxed bold, and said, It was necessary that the word of God should first have been spoken to you: but seeing you put it from you, and judge yourselves unworthy of everlasting life, lo, we turn to the Gentiles. For so has the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set you to be a light of the Gentiles, that you should be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life **believed**. Acts 13:45-48

It came to pass in Iconium, that they went both together into the synagogue of the Jews, and so spoke, that a great multitude both of the Jews and also of the Greeks **believed**... And when they had ordained them elders in every church, and had prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord, on whom they **believed**. Acts 14:1, 23

But there rose up certain of the sect of the Pharisees which **believed**, saying, That it was needful to circumcise them, and to command them to keep the law of Moses. And the apostles and elders came together for to consider of this matter. When there had been much disputing, Peter rose up, and said unto them, Men and brethren, you know how that a good while ago God made choice among us, that the Gentiles by my mouth should hear the word of the gospel, and **believe**. And God, which knows the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as He did unto us; and put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith. Now therefore why tempt you God, to put a yoke upon the neck of the disciples, which neither our fathers nor we were able to bear? But we **believe** that through the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ we shall be saved, even as they. Acts 15:11

Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and **believed**; but his father was a Greek... Acts 16:1

Sirs, what must I do to be saved? And they said, **Believe** on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be saved, and your house. And they spoke unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. And he took them the same hour of the night, and washed their stripes; and was baptized, he and all his, straightway. And when he had brought them into his house, he set meat before them, and rejoiced, **believing** in God with all his house. Acts 16:31-34

And some of them **believed**, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few. But the Jews which **believed** not, moved with envy, took unto them certain lewd fellows of the baser sort, and gathered a company, and set all the city on an uproar, and assaulted the house of Jason, and sought to bring them out to the people. Acts 17:4-5

These were more noble than those in Thessalonica, in that they received the word with all readiness of mind, and searched the scriptures daily, whether those things were so. Therefore many of them **believed**; also of honorable women which were Greeks, and of men, not a few....Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and **believed**: among the which was Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them. Acts 17:11-12, 34

He departed thence, and entered into a certain man's house, named Justus, one that worshipped God, whose house joined hard to the synagogue. And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, **believed** on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing **believed**, and were baptized. Acts 18:7-8

And when he was disposed to pass into Achaia, the brethren wrote, exhorting the disciples to receive him: who, when he was come, helped them much which had **believed** through grace... Acts 18:27

Have you received the Holy Ghost since you **believed**? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there be any Holy Ghost. And he said unto them, Unto what then were you baptized? And they said, Unto John's baptism. Then said Paul, John verily baptized with the baptism of repentance, saying unto the people, that they should **believe** on Him which should come after him, that is, on Christ Jesus. Acts 19:2-4

But when divers were hardened, and **believed** not, but spoke evil of that way before the multitude, he departed from them, and separated the disciples, disputing daily in the school of one Tyrannus. Acts 19:9

Many that **believed** came, and confessed, and showed their deeds. Acts 19:18

And when they heard it, they glorified the Lord, and said unto him, You see, brother, how many thousands of Jews there are which **believe**; and they are all zealous of the law... As touching the Gentiles which **believe**, we have written and concluded that they observe no such thing, save only that they keep themselves from things offered to idols, and from blood, and from strangled, and from fornication. Acts 21:20, 25

And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that **believed** on You... Acts 22:19

This I confess unto you, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, **believing** all things which are written in the law and in the prophets: Acts 24:14

King Agrippa, Do you **believe** the prophets? I know that you **believe**. Then Agrippa said unto Paul, Almost you persuade me to be a Christian. Acts 26:27-28

I perceive that this voyage will be with hurt and much damage...Nevertheless the centurion **believed** the master and the owner of the ship, more than those things which were spoken by Paul....Wherefore, sirs, be of good cheer: for I **believe** God, that it shall be even as it was told me. Acts 27:11, 25

And some **believed** the things which were spoken, and some **believed** not. Acts 28:24

For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that **believes**; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. Romans 1:16

For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by His grace through redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through faith in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; To declare, I say, at this time His righteousness: that He might be just, and the justifier of him which **believes** in Jesus [Yeshua]. Romans 3:23-26

For what says the scripture? Abraham **believed** God, and it was counted unto him for righteousness. Now to him that works is the reward not reckoned of grace, but of debt. But to him that works not, but **believes** on Him that justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness. Romans 4:3-5

And he received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the faith which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that **believe**, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also... Romans 4:11

(As it is written, I have made you a father of many nations,) before Him whom he **believed**, even God, who quickens the dead, and calls those things which be not as though they were. Who against hope **believed** in hope, that he might become the father of many nations; according to that which was spoken, So shall your seed be. Romans 4:17-18

Now if we be dead with Christ, we **believe** that we shall also live with Him; Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dies no more; death has no more dominion over Him. For in that He died, He died unto sin once; but in that He lives, He lives unto God. Romans 6:8-10

Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by faith, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone. As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever **believes** on Him shall not be ashamed. Ro 9:31-33

For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God. For Christ [Messiah] is the end of the law for righteousness to every one that **believes**... Romans 10:3-4

That if you shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall **believe** in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shall be saved. For with the heart man **believes** unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture says, Whoever **believes** on Him shall not be ashamed. Romans 10:9-11

How then shall they call on Him in whom they have not **believed**? And how shall they **believe** in Him of whom they have not heard? And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach, except they be sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things! But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Esaias said, Lord, who has **believed** our report? Romans 10:14-16

For as you in times past have not **believed** God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief: Even so have these also now not **believed**, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy. Romans 11:30-31

And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we **believed**. Romans 13:11

For one **believes** that he may eat all things: another, who is weak, eats herbs. Let not him that eats despise him that eats not; and let not him which eats not judge him that eats: for God has received him. Romans 14:2-3

The God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in **believing**, that you may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost...That I may be delivered from them that do not **believe** in Judaea; and that my service which I have for Jerusalem may be accepted of the saints... Romans 15:13, 31

For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that **believe**. 1 Corinthians 1:21

Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom you **believed**, even as the Lord gave to every man? 1 Cor 3:5

To the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother has a wife that **believes** not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away. And the woman which has an husband that **believes** not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him. 1 Corinthians 7:12-13

If any of them that **believe** not bid you to a feast, and you be disposed to go; whatsoever is set before you, eat, asking no question for conscience sake. 1 Corinthians 10:27

For first of all, when you come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions among you; and I partly **believe** it. 1 Corinthians 11:18

Charity...Bears all things, **believes** all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 1 Corinthians 13:4, 7

Wherefore tongues are for a sign, not to them that **believe**, but to them that **believe** not: but prophesying serves not for them that **believe** not, but for them which **believe**. If therefore the whole church be come together into one place, and all speak with tongues, and there come in those that are unlearned, or unbelievers, will they not say that you are mad? But if all prophesy, and there come in one that **believes** not, or one unlearned, he is convinced of all, he is judged of all... 1 Corinthians 14:22--24

Brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also you have received, and wherein you stand; By which also you are saved, if you keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless you have **believed** in vain. Therefore whether it were I or they, so we preach, and so you **believed**. 1 Cor 15:1-2, 11

...In whom the god of this world has blinded the minds of them which **believe** not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them. 2 Cor 4:4

We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I **believed**, and therefore have I spoken; we also **believe**, and therefore speak; Knowing that He which raised up the Lord Jesus [Yeshua] shall raise up us also by Jesus, and shall present us with you. 2 Corinthians 4:13-14

Be not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship has righteousness with unrighteousness? And what communion has light with darkness? And what concord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has he that **believes** with an infidel? 2 Corinthians 6:14-15

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], even we have **believed** in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ [the Messiah], and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Galatians 2:16

Even as Abraham **believed** God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness...But the scripture has concluded all under sin, that the promise by faith of Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] might be given to them that **believe**. Galatians 3:6, 22

In whom you also trusted, after that you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that you **believed**, you were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise. Ephesians 1:13

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, and what the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints. And what is the exceeding greatness of His power to usward who **believe**, according to the working of His mighty power... Ephesians 1:18-19

For unto you it is given in the behalf of Christ, not only to **believe** on Him, but also to suffer for His sake... Philippians 1:29

So that you were examples to all that **believe** in Macedonia and Achaia. 1 Thessalonians 1:7

You are witnesses, and God also, how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that **believe**... 1 Thessalonians 2:10

For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when you received the word of God which you heard of us, you received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually works also in you that **believe**. 1 Thessalonians 2:13

For if we **believe** that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring Him. 1 Thessalonians 4:14

To you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord... When He shall come to be glorified in His saints, and to be admired in all them that **believe** (because our testimony among you was **believed**) in that day. 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10

And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should **believe** a lie: That they all might be damned who **believed** not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 2 Thessalonians 2:11

But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God has from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and **belief** of the truth... 2 Thessalonians 2:12-13

Howbeit for this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter **believe** on Him to life everlasting. 1 Timothy 1:16

Without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, **believed** on in the world, received up into glory. 1 Timothy 3:16

Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils. Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God has created to be received with thanksgiving of them which **believe** and know the truth. 1 Timothy 4:1-3

For therefore we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, who is the Savior of all men, specially of those that **believe**....Let no man despise your youth; but you be an example of the **believers**, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:10, 12

If any man or woman that **believes** have widows, let them relieve them, and let not the church be charged; that it may relieve them that are widows indeed. 1 Timothy 5:16

Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honor, that the name of God and His doctrine be not blasphemed. And they that have **believing** masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are faithful and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort. 1 Timothy 6:1-2

For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have **believed**, and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day. If we **believe** not, yet He abides faithful: He cannot deny Himself. 2 Timothy 2:12-13

This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that you affirm constantly, that they which have **believed** in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. Titus 3:8

To whom swore He that they should not enter into His rest, but to them that **believed** not? Hebrews 3:18

For we which have **believed** do enter into rest, as He said, As I have sworn in My wrath, if they shall enter into My rest: although the works were finished from the foundation of the world. Hebrews 4:3

But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that **believe** to the saving of the soul. Hebrews 10:39

But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that comes to God must **believe** that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Hebrews 11:6

By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that **believed** not, when she had received the spies with peace. Hebrews 11:31

You **believe** that there is one God; you do well: the demons also **believe**, and tremble. But will you know, O vain man, that faith without works is dead? James 2:19-20

The scripture was fulfilled which says, Abraham **believed** God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. James 2:23

That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, you love; in whom, though now you see Him not, yet **believing**, you rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory... 1 Peter 1:7-8

But was manifest in these last times for you, Who by Him do **believe** in God, that raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:21

Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that **believes** on Him shall not be confounded. Unto you therefore which **believe** He is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner... 1 Peter 2:6-7

This is His commandment, That we should **believe** on the name of His Son Jesus Christ, and love one another, as He gave us commandment. 1 John 3:23

Beloved, **believe** not every spirit, but try the spirits whether they are of God: because many false prophets are gone out into the world...And we have known and **believed** the love that God has to us. God is love; and he that dwells in love dwells in God, and God in him. 1 John 4:1, 16

Whoever **believes** that Jesus is the Christ [Yeshua is the Messiah] is born of God: and every one that loves Him that begat loves him also that is begotten of Him....Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that **believes** that Jesus is the Son of God? 1 John 5:1, 5

He that **believes** on the Son of God has the witness in himself: he that **believes** not God has made Him a liar; because he **believes** not the record that God gave of His Son. And this is the record, that God has given to us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He that has the Son has life; and he that has not the Son of God has not life. These things have I written unto you that **believe** on the name of the Son of God; that you may know that you have eternal life, and that you may **believe** on the name of the Son of God. 1 John 5:10-13

I will therefore put you in remembrance, though you once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that **believed** not. Jude 1:5

FAITH

My servant Moses is not so, who is **faithful** in all mine house. With him will I speak mouth to mouth, even apparently, and not in dark speeches; and the similitude of the LORD shall he behold: wherefore then were you not afraid to speak against My servant Moses? Numbers 12:7-8

Know therefore that the LORD your God, He is God, the **faithful** God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love Him and keep His commandments to a thousand generations... Deuteronomy 7:9

And He said, I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end shall be: for they are a very froward generation, children in whom is no **faith**. Deuteronomy 32:20

I will raise Me up a **faithful** priest, that shall do according to that which is in Mine heart and in My mind: and I will build him a sure house; and he shall walk before Mine anointed for ever. 1 Samuel 2:35

Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who is so **faithful** among all your servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goes at your bidding, and is honorable in your house? 1 Samuel 22:14

The LORD render to every man his righteousness and his **faithfulness**: for the LORD delivered you into my hand to day, but I would not stretch forth mine hand against the LORD'S anointed. 1 Samuel 26:23

I am one of them that are peaceable and **faithful** in Israel: you seek to destroy a city and a mother in Israel: why will you swallow up the inheritance of the LORD? 2 Samuel 20:19

Moreover they reckoned not with the men, into whose hand they delivered the money to be bestowed on workmen: for they dealt **faithfully**. 2 Kings 12:15

Howbeit there was no reckoning made with them of the money that was delivered into their hand, because they dealt **faithfully**. 2 Kings 22:7

And he charged them, saying, Thus shall you do in the fear of the LORD, **faithfully**, and with a perfect heart. 2 Chronicles 19:9

And brought in the offerings and the tithes and the dedicated things **faithfully**: over which Cononiah the Levite was ruler, and Shimei his brother was the next. 2 Chronicles 31:12

The men did the work **faithfully**: and the overseers of them were Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of Kohathites, to set it forward; and other of the Levites, all that could skill[fully play] instruments of music. 2 Chronicles 34:12

I gave my brother Hanani, and Hananiah the ruler of the palace, charge over Jerusalem: for he was a **faithful** man, and feared God above many. Nehemiah 7:2

And found his heart **faithful** before you and made a covenant with him to give the land of the Canaanites, the Hittites, the Amorites, and the Perizzites, and the Jebusites, and the Gergashites, to give it, I say, to his seed, and has performed Your words; for You are righteous. Nehemiah 9:8

I made treasurers over the treasures, Shelemiah the priest, and Zadok the scribe, and of the Levites, Pedaiah: and next to them was Hanan the son of Zaccur, the son of Mattaniah: for they were counted **faithful**, and their office was to distribute unto their brethren. Nehemiah 13:13

For there is no **faithfulness** in their mouth; their inward part is very wickedness; their throat is an open sepulcher; they flatter with their tongue. Psalm 5:9

Help, LORD; for the godly man ceases; for the **faithful** fail from among the children of men. Psalm 12:1

I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known Your **faithfulness** to all generations. For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever: Your **faithfulness** shall You establish in the very heavens... Psalm 89:1-2

O love the LORD, all you His saints: for the LORD preserves the **faithful**, and plentifully rewards the proud doer. Psalm 31:23

Your mercy, O LORD, is in the heavens; and Your **faithfulness** reaches unto the clouds. Psalm 36:5

I have not hid Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your **faithfulness** and Your salvation: I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth from the great congregation. Psalm 40:10

Shall Your lovingkindness be declared in the grave? Or Your **faithfulness** in destruction? Psalm 88:11

The heavens shall praise Your wonders, O LORD: Your **faithfulness** also in the congregation of the saints... But My **faithfulness** and My mercy shall be with him: and in My name shall his horn be exalted... My lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer My **faithfulness** to fail... It shall be established for ever as the moon, and as a **faithful** witness in heaven. Selah. Psalm 89:5, 8, 24, 33, 37

My eyes shall be upon the **faithful** of the land, that they may dwell with Me: he that walks in a perfect way, he shall serve Me. Psalm 101:6

I know, O LORD, that Your judgments are right, and that you in **faithfulness** have afflicted me...All your commandments are **faithful**: they persecute me wrongfully; You help me...Your **faithfulness** is unto all generations: You have established the earth, and it abides...Your testimonies that you have commanded are righteous and very **faithful**. Psalms 119:75, 86, 90, 138

Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in Your **faithfulness** answer me, and in Your righteousness. Psalm 143:1

A talebearer reveals secrets: but he that is of a **faithful** spirit conceals the matter. Proverbs 11:13

A wicked messenger falls into mischief: but a **faithful** ambassador is health. Proverbs 13:17

A **faithful** witness will not lie: but a false witness will utter lies. Proverbs 14:5

Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: but a **faithful** man who can find? Proverbs 20:6

As the cold of snow in the time of harvest, so is a **faithful** messenger to them that send him: for he refreshes the soul of his master. Proverbs 25:13

Faithful are the wounds of a friend; but the kisses of an enemy are deceitful. Proverbs 27:6

A **faithful** man shall abound with blessings: but he that makes haste to be rich shall not be innocent. Proverbs 28:20

The king that **faithfully** judges the poor, his throne shall be established for ever. Proverbs 29:14

How is the **faithful** city become an harlot? It was full of judgment; righteousness lodged in it; but now murderers...And I will restore your judges as at the first, and your counselors as at the beginning: afterward you shall be called, The city of righteousness, the **faithful** city. Isaiah 1:21, 26

I took unto me **faithful** witnesses to record, Uriah the priest, and Zechariah the son of Jeberechiah. Isaiah 8:2

Righteousness shall be the girdle of His loins, and **faithfulness** the girdle of His reins. Isaiah 11:5

O LORD, You are my God; I will exalt You, I will praise Your name; for You have done wonderful things; Your counsels of old are **faithfulness** and truth. For You have made of a city an heap; of a defenced city a ruin: a palace of strangers to be no city; it shall never be built. Therefore shall the strong people glorify You, the city of the terrible nations shall fear You. For You have been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress... Isaiah 25:1-3

Thus says the LORD, the Redeemer of Israel, and His Holy One, to him whom man despises, to him whom the nation abhors, to a servant of rulers, Kings shall see and arise, princes also shall worship, because of the LORD that is **faithful**, and the Holy One of Israel, and He shall choose you. Isaiah 49:7

The prophet that has a dream, let him tell a dream; and he that has My word, let him speak My word **faithfully**. What is the chaff to the wheat? says the LORD. Jeremiah 23:28

Then they said to Jeremiah, The LORD be a true and **faithful** witness between us, if we do not even according to all things for the which the LORD your God shall send you to us. Jeremiah 42:5

It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. They are new every morning; great is Your **faithfulness**. Lamentations 3:22-23

Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he was **faithful**, neither was there any error or fault found in him. Daniel 6:4

Ephraim compasses Me about with lies, and the house of Israel with deceit: but Judah yet rules with God, and is **faithful** with the saints. Hosea 11:12

I will even betroth you unto Me in **faithfulness**: and you shall know the LORD. Hosea 2:20

Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his **faith**. Habakkuk 2:4

FAITH IN THE NEW COVENANT

Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, shall He not much more clothe you, O you of little **faith**? Matthew 6:30

When Jesus [Yeshua] heard it, He marveled, and said to them that followed, Truly I say unto you, I have not found so great **faith**, no, not in Israel. Matthew 8:10

And He said unto them, Why are you fearful, O you of little **faith**? Then He arose, and rebuked the winds and the sea; and there was a great calm. Matthew 8:26

Behold, they brought to Him a man sick of the palsy, lying on a bed: and Jesus seeing their **faith** said unto the sick of the palsy; Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you. Matthew 9:2

But Jesus turned him about, and when He saw her, He said, Daughter, be of good comfort; your **faith** has made you whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. Matthew 9:22

Then touched He their eyes, saying, According to your **faith** be it unto you. Matthew 9:29

And immediately Jesus [Yeshua] stretched forth His hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O you of little **faith**, wherefore did you doubt? Matthew 14:31

Then Jesus answered and said unto her, O woman, great is your **faith**: be it unto you even as you will. And her daughter was made whole from that very hour. Matthew 15:28

When Jesus perceived, He said unto them, O you of little **faith**, why reason you among yourselves, because you have brought no bread? Matthew 16:8

O **faithless** and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him hither to Me. Mt 17:17

Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If you have **faith** as a grain of mustard seed, you shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Mt 17:20

Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If you have **faith**, and doubt now, you shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if you shall say unto this mountain, Be removed, and be cast into the sea; it shall be done. Matt 21:21

Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law, judgment, mercy, and **faith**: these ought you to have done, and not to leave the other undone. Matthew 23:23

Who then is a **faithful** and wise servant, whom his lord has made ruler over his household, to give them meat in due season? ...His lord said unto him, Well done, you good and **faithful** servant: you have been **faithful** over a few things, I will make you ruler over many things: you enter into the joy of your lord...His lord said unto him, Well done, good and **faithful** servant; you have been **faithful** over a few things, I will make you over many things: you enter into the joy of your lord. Matt 24:45, 25:21, 23

When Jesus saw their **faith**, He said unto the sick of the palsy, Son, your sins be forgiven you. Mark 2:5

And He said unto them, Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no **faith**? Mark 4:40

And He said unto her, Daughter, your **faith** has made you whole; go in peace, and be whole of your plague. Mark 5:34

He answered him, and said, O **faithless** generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I suffer you? Bring him hither to Me. Mark 9:19

Jesus said unto him, Go your way; your **faith** has made you whole. And immediately he received his sight, and followed Jesus [Yeshua] in the way. Mark 10:52

Jesus answering said unto them, Have **faith** in God. Mark 11:22

They went upon the housetop, and let him down through the tiling with his couch into the midst before Jesus. And when He saw their **faith**, He said unto him, Man, your sins are forgiven you. Luke 5:19-20

When Jesus heard these things, He marvelled at him, and turned him about, and said unto the people that followed him, I say unto you, I have not found so **great faith**, no, not in Israel. Luke 7:9

He said to the woman, your **faith** has saved you; go in peace. Luke 7:50

Where is your **faith**? And they being afraid wondered, saying one to another, What manner of man is this! For He commands even the winds and water, and they obey Him. Luke 8:25

He said unto her, Daughter, be of good comfort: your **faith** has made you whole; go in peace. Luke 8:48

Jesus answering said, O **faithless** and perverse generation, how long shall I be with you, and suffer you? Bring your son hither. Luke 9:41

If then God so clothe the grass, which is today in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more will He clothe you, O you of little **faith**? Luke 12:28

The Lord said, Who then is that **faithful** and wise steward, whom his lord shall make ruler over his household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? Luke 12:42

He that is **faithful** in that which is least is **faithful** also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much. If therefore you have not been **faithful** in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? And if you have not been **faithful** in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own? Luke 16:10-12

And the apostles said unto the Lord, Increase our **faith**. And the Lord said, If you had **faith** as a grain of mustard seed, you might say unto this sycamine tree, Be plucked up by the root, and Be planted in the sea; and it should obey you. Luke 17:5-6

He said...Arise, go your way: your **faith** has made you whole. Luke 17:19

I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man comes, shall He find **faith** on the earth? Luke 18:8

Jesus [Yeshua] said unto him, Receive your sight: your **faith** has saved you. Luke 18:42

He said unto him, Well, you good servant: because you have been **faithful** in a very little, you have authority over ten cities. Luke 19:17

But I have prayed for you, that your **faith** fail not: and when **you are** converted, strengthen your brethren. Luke 22:32

Then said he to Thomas, Reach hither your finger, and behold My hands; and reach hither your hand, and thrust it into My side: and be not **faithless**, but believing. John 20:27

His name through **faith** in His name has made this man strong, whom you see and know: yes, the **faith** which is by Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all. Acts 3:16

The saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of **faith** and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch...The word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the **faith**. And Stephen, full of **faith** and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people. Acts 6:5, 7-8

For he was a good man, and full of the Holy Ghost and of **faith**: and much people was added unto the Lord. Acts 11:24

But Elymas the sorcerer (for so is his name by interpretation) withstood them, seeking to turn away the deputy from the **faith**. Acts 13:8

The same heard Paul speak: who steadfastly beholding him, and perceiving that he had **faith** to be healed...When they... had gathered the church together, they rehearsed all that God had done with them, and how He had opened the door of **faith** unto the Gentiles. Acts 14:9, 27

...And put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by **faith**. Acts 15:9

So were the churches established in the **faith**, and increased in number daily. Acts 16:5

When she was baptized, and her household, she besought us, saying, If you have judged me to be **faithful** to the Lord, come into my house, and abide there. And she constrained us. Acts 16:15

Testifying both to the Jews, and also to the Greeks, repentance toward God, and **faith** toward our Lord Jesus Christ. Acts 20:21

After certain days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, which was a Jewess, he sent for Paul, and heard him concerning the **faith** in Christ [the Messiah]. Acts 24:24

...To make you a minister and a witness...To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by **faith** that is in me. Acts 26:17-18

By whom we have received grace and apostleship, for obedience to the **faith** among all nations, for His name: Among whom are you also the called of Jesus Christ [the Messiah]... Romans 1:5-6

I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your **faith** is spoken of throughout the whole world...That is, that I may be comforted together with you by the mutual **faith** both of you and me. Romans 1:8, 12

For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from **faith to faith**: as it is written, The just shall live by **faith**. Romans 1:17

For what if some did not believe? Shall their unbelief make the **faith** of God without effect? Romans 3:3

Even the righteousness of God which is by **faith** of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; Being justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: Whom God has set forth to be a propitiation through **faith** in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God... Romans 3:22-25

Where is boasting then? It is excluded. By what law? Of works? No: but by the law of **faith**. Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by **faith** without the deeds of the law. Romans 3:27-28

Seeing it is one God, which shall justify the circumcision by **faith**, and uncircumcision through **faith**. Do we then make void the law through **faith**? God forbid: yes, we establish the law. Romans 3:30-31

But to him that works not, but believes on Him that justifies the ungodly, his **faith** is counted for righteousness. Romans 4:5

Comes this blessedness then upon the circumcision only, or upon the uncircumcision also? For we say that **faith** was reckoned to Abraham for righteousness. Romans 4:9

He received the sign of circumcision, a seal of the righteousness of the **faith** which he had yet being uncircumcised: that he might be the father of all them that believe, though they be not circumcised; that righteousness might be imputed unto them also... Romans 4:11

The father of circumcision to them who are not of the circumcision only, but who also walk in the steps of that **faith** of our father Abraham, which he had being yet uncircumcised. For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, was not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of **faith**. For if they which are of the law be heirs, **faith** is made void, and the promise made of none effect: Because the law works wrath: for where no law is, there is no transgression. Therefore it is of **faith**, that it might be by grace; to the end the promise might be sure to all the seed; not to that only which is of the law, but to that also which is of the **faith** of Abraham; who is the father of us all... Romans 4:12-16

Being not weak in **faith**, he considered not his own body now dead, when he was about an hundred years old, neither yet the deadness of Sara's womb: He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in **faith**, giving glory to God... Romans 4:19-20

Therefore being justified by **faith**, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: By whom also we have access by **faith** into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Romans 5:1-2

What shall we say then? That the Gentiles, which followed not after righteousness, have attained to righteousness, even the righteousness which is of **faith**. But Israel, which followed after the law of righteousness, has not attained to the law of righteousness. Wherefore? Because they sought it not by **faith**, but as it were by the works of the law. For they stumbled at that stumblingstone... Romans 9:30-32

But the righteousness which is of **faith** speaks on this wise, Say not in your heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (That is, to bring Christ down from above:) Or, who shall descend into the deep? (That is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.) But what says it? The word is nigh you, even in your mouth, and in your heart: that is, the word of **faith**, which we preach... Romans 10:6-8

So then **faith** comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. Romans 10:17

You will say then, The branches were broken off, that I might be grafted in. Well; because of unbelief they were broken off, and you stand by **faith**. Be not highminded, but fear... Romans 11:19-20

For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God has dealt to every man the measure of **faith**. Romans 12:3

Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether prophecy, let us prophesy according to the proportion of **faith**; Romans 12:6

Him that is weak in **faith** receive you, but not to doubtful disputations. Romans 14:1

Do you have **faith**? Have it to yourself before God. Happy is he that condemns not himself in that thing which he allows. And he that doubts is damned if he eat, because he eats not of **faith**: for whatsoever is not of faith is sin. Romans 14:22-23

...But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of **faith**... Romans 16:26

God is **faithful**, by whom you were called unto the fellowship of His Son Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah] our Lord. 1 Corinthians 1:9

My speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom, but in demonstration of the Spirit and power. That your **faith** should not stand in the wisdom of men, but in the power of God. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

Moreover it is required in stewards, that a man be found **faithful**. 1 Corinthians 4:2

For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and **faithful** in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church. 1 Corinthians 4:17

Now concerning virgins I have no commandment of the Lord: yet I give my judgment, as one that has obtained mercy of the Lord to be **faithful**. 1 Corinthians 7:25

There has no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is **faithful**, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that you are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it. 1 Corinthians 10:13

To another **faith** by the same Spirit; to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit. 1 Corinthians 12:9

Though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries, and all knowledge; and though I have all **faith**, so that I could remove mountains, and have not charity, I am nothing. 1 Corinthians 13:2

And now abides **faith**, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. 1 Corinthians 13:13

If Christ is not risen, then is our preaching vain, and your **faith** is also vain...And if Christ has not been raised, your **faith** is vain; you are yet in your sins. 1 Corinthians 15:14, 17

Watch you, stand fast in the **faith**, quit you like men, be strong. 1 Corinthians 16:13

Not for that we have dominion over your **faith**, but are helpers of your joy: for by **faith** you stand. 2 Corinthians 1:24

We having the same spirit of **faith**, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak... 2 Corinthians 4:13

Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, while we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: (For we walk by **faith**, not by sight:) 2 Corinthians 5:6-7

Therefore, as you abound in every thing, in **faith**, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that you abound in this grace also. 2 Corinthians 8:7

Not boasting of things without our measure, that is, of other men's labors; but having hope, when your **faith** is increased, that we shall be enlarged by you according to our rule abundantly... 2 Corinthians 10:15

Examine yourselves, whether you be in the **faith**; prove your own selves. Know you not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except you be reprobate? 2 Corinthians 13:5

But they had heard only, That he which persecuted us in times past now preaches the **faith** which once he destroyed. Galatians 1:23

Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], that we might be justified by the **faith** of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified. Galatians 2:16

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the **faith** of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave Himself for me. Galatians 2:20

O foolish Galatians, who has bewitched you, that you should not obey the truth, before whose eyes Jesus Christ has been evidently set forth, crucified among you? This only would I learn of you, Received you the Spirit by the works of the law, or by the hearing of **faith**? Are you so foolish? Having begun in the Spirit, are you now made perfect by the flesh? Have you suffered so many things in vain? If it be yet in vain. He therefore that ministers to you the Spirit, and works miracles among you, does he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of **faith**? Even as Abraham believed God, and it was accounted to him for righteousness. Know you therefore that they which are of **faith**, the same are the children of Abraham. And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through **faith**, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In you shall all nations be blessed. So then they which be of **faith** are blessed with **faithful** Abraham. Gal 3:1-9

But that no man is justified by the law in the sight of God, it is evident: for, The just shall live by **faith**. And the law is not of **faith**: but, The man that does them shall live in them. Christ [Messiah] has redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangs on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through **faith**. Galatians 3:11-15

But the scripture has concluded all under sin, that the promise by **faith** of Jesus Christ might be given to them that believe. But before **faith** came, we were kept under the law, shut up unto the **faith** which should afterwards be revealed. Wherefore the law was our schoolmaster to bring us unto Christ, that we might be justified by **faith**. But after that **faith** is come, we are no longer under a schoolmaster. For you are all the children of God by **faith** in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]. Galatians 3:22-26

For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by **faith**. For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision avails any thing, nor uncircumcision; but **faith** which works by love. Galatians 5:5

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, **faith**, meekness, temperance... Galatians 5:22-23

As we have therefore opportunity, let us do good unto all men, especially unto them who are of the household of **faith**. Galatians 6:10

Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the **faithful** in Christ Jesus...Wherefore I also, after I heard of your **faith** in the Lord Jesus, and love unto all the saints, Cease not to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers. Ephesians 1:1, 15-16

For by grace are you saved through **faith**; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God...In whom we have boldness and access with confidence by the **faith** of Him. Ephesians 2:8, 3:12

That Christ may dwell in your hearts by **faith**; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; and to know the love of Christ, which passes knowledge, that you might be filled with all the fulness of God. Ephesians 3:17-19

There is one body, and one Spirit, even as you are called in one hope of your calling; One Lord, one **faith**, one baptism, One God and Father of all, who is above all, and through all, and in you all. Ephesians 4:5-6

Till we all come in the unity of the **faith**, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ... Ephesians 4:13

Above all, taking the shield of **faith**, wherewith you shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. Ephesians 6:16

But that he also may know my affairs, and how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and **faithful** minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things... Ephesians 6:2

Peace be to the brethren, and love with **faith**, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. Ephesians 6:23

Having this confidence, I know that I shall abide and continue with you all for your furtherance and joy of **faith**; Philippians 1:25

Only let your conversation be as it becomes the gospel of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the **faith** of the gospel... Philippians 1:27

Yes, and if I be offered upon the sacrifice and service of your **faith**, I joy, and rejoice with you all. Philippians 2:17

And be found in Him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the **faith** of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by **faith**... Philippians 3:9

To the saints and **faithful** brethren in Christ which are at Colossae: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], praying always for you, since we heard of your **faith** in Christ Jesus, and of the love which you have to all the saints... Colossians 1:2-4

As you also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a **faithful** minister of Christ... Colossians 1:7

If you continue in the **faith** grounded and settled, and be not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which you have heard, and which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister... Colossians 1:23

For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the steadfastness of your **faith** in Christ [the Messiah]. Colossians 2:5

Rooted and built up in Him, and established in the **faith**, as you have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. Colossians 2:7

Buried with Him in baptism, wherein also you are risen with Him through the **faith** of the operation of God, who has raised Him from the dead. Colossians 2:12

All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, who is a beloved brother, and a **faithful** minister and fellowservant in the Lord: Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts; with Onesimus, a **faithful** and beloved brother, who is one of you. They shall make known unto you all things which are done here. Colossians 4:7-9

Remembering without ceasing your work of **faith**, and labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father...For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your **faith** to God-ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing. 1 Thessalonians 1:3, 8

Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone; And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlaborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your **faith**: That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto. For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and you know. For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your **faith**, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labor be in vain. 1 Thessalonians 3:1-5

But now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your **faith** and charity, and that you have good remembrance of us always, desiring greatly to see us, as we also to see you: Therefore, brethren, we were comforted over you in all our affliction and distress by your **faith**... 1 Thessalonians 3:6-7

For what thanks can we render to God again for you, for all the joy wherewith we joy for your sakes before our God; Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your **faith**? 1 Thessalonians 3:9-10

Let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of **faith** and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation. 1 Thessalonians 5:8

Faithful is He who calls you, who also will do it. 1 Thess 5:24

We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your **faith** grows exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other abounds; So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and **faith** in all your persecutions and tribulations that you endure. 2 Thessalonians 1:3-4

Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness, and the work of **faith** with power: That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Thessalonians 1:11-12

Pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have free course, and be glorified, even as it is with you; And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all men have not **faith**. But the Lord is **faithful**, who shall establish you, and keep you from evil. 2 Thessalonians 3:1-3

Unto Timothy, my own son in the **faith**: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord. As I besought you to abide still at Ephesus, when I went into Macedonia, that you might charge some that they teach no other doctrine, neither give heed to fables and endless genealogies, which minister questions, rather than godly edifying which is in **faith**: so do. Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and of a good conscience, and of **faith** unfeigned... 1 Tim 1:2-5

I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has enabled me, for that He counted me **faithful**, putting me into the ministry; Who was before a blasphemer, and a persecutor, and injurious: but I obtained mercy, because I did it ignorantly in unbelief. And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with **faith** and love which is in Christ Jesus. This is a **faithful** saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief. 1 Timothy 1:12-15

Holding **faith**, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning **faith** have made shipwreck... 1 Tim 1:19

Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in **faith** and verity. 1 Timothy 2:7

Notwithstanding she shall be saved in childbearing, if they continue in **faith** and charity and holiness with sobriety. 1 Timothy 2:15

Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre; holding the mystery of the **faith** in a pure conscience...Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, **faithful** in all things...For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the **faith** which is in Christ Jesus. 1 Timothy 3:8-9, 11, 13

Now the Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the **faith**, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils... 1 Timothy 4:1

If you put the brethren in remembrance of these things, you shall be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of **faith** and of good doctrine, whereunto you have attained. 1 Timothy 4:6

For bodily exercise profits little: but godliness is profitable unto all things, having promise of the life that now is, and of that which is to come. This is a **faithful** saying and worthy of all acceptation. 1 Timothy 4:8-9

Let no man despise your youth; but you be an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in **faith**, in purity. 1 Timothy 4:12

If any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he has denied the **faith**, and is worse than an infidel. 1 Timothy 5:8

But the younger widows refuse: for when they have begun to wax wanton against Christ, they will marry. Having damnation, because they have cast off their first **faith**. 1 Timothy 5:11-12

They that have believing masters, let them not despise them, because they are brethren; but rather do them service, because they are **faithful** and beloved, partakers of the benefit. These things teach and exhort. 1 Timothy 6:2

For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the **faith**, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows. But you, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, **faith**, love, patience, meekness. Fight the good fight of **faith**, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto you are also called, and have professed a good profession before many witnesses. 1 Timothy 6:10-12

O Timothy, keep that which is committed to your trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called: Which some professing have erred concerning the **faith**. Grace be with you. Amen. 1 Timothy 6:21

When I call to remembrance the unfeigned **faith** that is in you, which dwelt first in your grandmother Lois, and your mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in you also...Hold fast the form of sound words, which you have heard of me, in **faith** and love which is in Christ Jesus [the Messiah Yeshua]. 2 Timothy 1:5, 13

The things that you have heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit you to **faithful** men, who shall be able to teach others also. 2 Timothy 2:2

It is a **faithful** saying: For if we be dead with Him, we shall also live with Him: If we suffer, we shall also reign with Him: if we deny Him, He also will deny us: If we believe not, yet He abides **faithful**: He cannot deny Himself. 2 Tim 2:11-13

Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the **faith** of some. 2 Timothy 2:18

Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, **faith**, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. 2 Timothy 2:22

As Jannes and Jambres withstood Moses, so do these also resist the truth: men of corrupt minds, reprobate concerning the **faith**...But you have fully known my doctrine, manner of life, purpose, **faith**, longsuffering, charity, patience... 2 Tim 3:8, 10

From a child you have known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through **faith** which is in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]. 2 Timothy 3:15

I have fought a good fight, I have finished my course, I have kept the **faith**... 2 Timothy 4:7

Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the **faith** of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness...To Titus, mine own son after the common **faith**: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior. Titus 1:1, 4

If any be blameless, the husband of one wife, having **faithful** children not accused of riot or unruly...Holding fast the **faithful** word as he has been taught, that he may be able by sound doctrine both to exhort and to convince the gainsayers. Titus 1:6, 9

For there are many unruly and vain talkers and deceivers, specially they of the circumcision: Whose mouths must be stopped, who subvert whole houses, teaching things which they ought not, for filthy lucre's sake...This witness is true. Wherefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the **faith**... Titus 1:10-11, 13

But you speak the things which become sound doctrine: That the aged men be sober, grave, temperate, sound in **faith**, in charity, in patience. Titus 2:2

This is a **faithful** saying, and these things I will that you affirm constantly, that they which have believed in God might be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable unto men. Titus 3:8

All that are with me salute you. Greet them that love us in the **faith**. Grace be with you all. Amen. Titus 3:15

I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers, Hearing of your love and **faith**, which you have toward the Lord Jesus, and toward all saints; That the communication of your **faith** may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus [Messiah Yeshua]. Phil 1:4-6

Wherefore in all things it behoved Him to be made like unto His brethren, that He might be a merciful and **faithful** high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people. Hebrews 2:17

Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession, Christ Jesus; Who was **faithful** to Him that appointed Him, as also Moses was **faithful** in all his house. Hebrews 3:1-2

Moses verily was **faithful** in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after... Hebrews 3:5

For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with **faith** in them that heard it. Hebrews 4:2

Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of **faith** toward God. Hebrews 6:1

...That you be not slothful, but followers of them who through **faith** and patience inherit the promises. Hebrews 6:12

Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of **faith**, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the profession of our **faith** without wavering; (for He is **faithful** that promised;) Hebrews 10:22-23

Now the just shall live by **faith**: but if any man draw back, my soul shall have no pleasure in him. Hebrews 10:38

Now **faith** is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report. Through **faith** we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which did appear. Hebrews 11:1-3

By **faith** Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaks. Hebrews 11:4

By **faith** Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God. But without **faith** it is impossible to please Him: for he that comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of them that diligently seek Him. Hebrews 11:5-6

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by **faith**. By **faith** Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went. By **faith** he sojourned in the land of promise, as in a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise: Hebrews 11:7-9

Through **faith** also Sarah herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him **faithful** who had promised...These all died in **faith**, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of them, and embraced them, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. Hebrews 11:11, 13

By **faith** Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten son... Hebrews 11:17

By **faith** Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come. By **faith** Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshiped, leaning upon the top of the staff. By **faith** Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones. Hebrews 11:20-22

By **faith** Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw he was a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment. By **faith** Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter...By **faith** he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing Him who is invisible. Hebrews 11:23-27

Through **faith** he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them. By **faith** they passed through the Red sea as by dry land: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned. Hebrews 11:28-29

By **faith** the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days. By **faith** the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace...Who through **faith** subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions...And these all, having obtained a good report through **faith**, received not the promise... Hebrews 11:30-32

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our **faith**; who for the joy that was set before Him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at the right hand of the throne of God. Hebrews 12:2

Remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose **faith** follow, considering the end of their conversation. Hebrews 13:7

Knowing this, that the trying of your **faith** works patience... But let him ask in **faith**, nothing wavering. For he that wavers is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed. James 1:3, 6

My brethren, have not the **faith** of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Lord of glory, with respect of persons...Hearken, my beloved brethren, has not God chosen the poor of this world rich in **faith**, and heirs of the Kingdom which He has promised to them that love Him? James 2:1, 5

What does it profit, my brethren, though a man say he has **faith**, and have not works? Can **faith** save him? James 2:14

Even so **faith**, if it has not works, is dead, being alone. Yes, a man may say, You have **faith**, and I have works: show me your **faith** without your works, and I will show you my **faith** by my works. You believe that there is one God; you do well: the devils also believe, and tremble. But will you know, O vain man, that **faith** without works is dead? Was not Abraham our father justified by works, when he had offered Isaac his son upon the altar? Do you see how **faith** wrought with his works, and by works was **faith** made perfect? James 2:17-22

And the scripture was fulfilled which says, Abraham believed God, and it was imputed unto him for righteousness: and he was called the Friend of God. You see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by **faith** only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way? For as the body without the spirit is dead, so **faith** without works is dead also. James 2:23-26

The prayer of **faith** shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. James 5:15

Who are kept by the power of God through **faith** unto salvation ready to be revealed in the last time. 1 Peter 1:5

That the trial of your **faith**, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honor and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ: Whom having not seen, you love; in whom, though now you see Him not, yet believing, you rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory. Receiving the end of your **faith**, even the salvation of your souls. 1 Peter 1:7-9

Who by Him do believe in God, that raised Him up from the dead, and gave Him glory; that your **faith** and hope might be in God. 1 Peter 1:21

Wherefore let them that suffer according to the will of God commit the keeping of their souls to Him in well doing, as unto a **faithful** Creator. 1 Peter 4:19

Whom resist steadfast in the **faith**, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world. 1 Peter 5:9

By Silvanus, a **faithful** brother unto you, as I suppose, I have written briefly, exhorting, and testifying that this is the true grace of God wherein you stand. 1 Peter 5:12

Beside this, giving all diligence, add to your **faith** virtue; and to virtue knowledge; and to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness; and to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity. 2 Peter 1:5-8

If we confess our sins, He is **faithful** and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9

For whatsoever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our **faith**. 1 John 5:4

Beloved, you do **faithfully** whatsoever you do to the brethren, and to strangers which have borne witness of your charity before the church. 3 John 1:5-6

Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of the common salvation, it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that you should earnestly contend for the **faith** which was once delivered unto the saints. Jude 1:3

But you, beloved, building up yourselves on your most holy **faith**, praying in the Holy Ghost, Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life. Jude 1:20-21

And from Jesus Christ, who is the **faithful** witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the prince of the kings of the earth. Unto Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood. Revelation 1:5

Fear none of those things which you shall suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that you may be tried; and you shall have tribulation ten days: you be **faithful** unto death, and I will give you a crown of life. Revelation 2:10

I know your works, and where you dwell, even where Satan's seat is: and you hold fast My name, and have not denied My faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was My **faithful** martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwells... Revelation 2:13

I know your works, and charity, and service, and **faith**, and your patience, and your works; and the last to be more than the first. Revelation 2:19

Unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things says the Amen, the **faithful** and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God... Revelation 3:14

It was given unto him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all kindreds, and tongues, and nations. And all that dwell upon the earth shall worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world. If any man have an ear, let him hear. He that leads into captivity shall go into captivity: he that kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the **faith** of the saints. Revelation 13:6-10

The smoke of their torment ascends up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receive the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the **faith** of Jesus. And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them. Revelation 14:11-13

These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him are called, and chosen, and **faithful**. Revelation 17:14

The LORD has made known His **salvation**: His righteousness has He openly shown in the sight of the heathen. He has remembered His mercy and His truth toward the house of Israel: all the ends of the earth have seen the **salvation** of our God. Psalm 98:2-3

Remember me, O LORD, with the favor that You bear unto Your people: O visit me with Your **salvation**... Psalm 106:4

I will take the cup of **salvation**, and call upon the name of the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Psalm 116:13

The LORD is my strength and my song, and is become my **salvation**...The voice of rejoicing and **salvation** is in the tabernacles of the righteous: the right hand of the LORD does valiantly. Psalm 118:14-15

Thus the LORD **saved** Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore. Exodus 14:30

If you go to war in your land against the enemy that oppresses you, then you shall blow an alarm with the trumpets; and you shall be remembered before the LORD your God, and you shall be **saved** from your enemies. Numbers 10:9

The ass saw me, and turned from me these three times: unless she had turned from me, surely now also I had slain you, and **saved** her alive. Numbers 22:33

Moses said unto them, Have you **saved** all the women alive? Numbers 31:15

You shall grope at noonday, as the blind gropes in darkness, and you shall not prosper in your ways: and you shall be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall **save** you. Deuteronomy 28:29

Happy are you, O Israel: who is like unto you, O people **saved** by the LORD, the shield of your help, and who is the sword of your excellency! And your enemies shall be found liars unto you, and you shall tread upon their high places. Deuteronomy 33:29

I pray you, swear unto me by the LORD, since I have showed you kindness, that you will also show kindness unto my father's house, and give me a true token: and that you will **save** alive my father, and my mother, and my brethren, and my sisters, and all that they have, and deliver our lives from death. Joshua **saved** Rahab the harlot alive, and her father's household, and all that she had; and she dwelled in Israel even unto this day; because she hid the messengers, which Joshua sent to spy out Jericho. Joshua 6:25

The LORD God of gods, the LORD God of gods, He knows, and Israel He shall know; if it be in rebellion, or if in transgression against the LORD, (**save** us not this day,) That we have built us an altar to turn from following the LORD...let the LORD [YeHoVaH] Himself require it... Joshua 22:22-23

The LORD said unto Gideon, The people that are with you are too many for Me to give the Midianites into their hands, lest Israel vaunt themselves against Me, saying, my own hand has saved me...By the three hundred men that lapped will I **save** you, and deliver the Midianites into your hand: and let all the other people go every man unto his place... Judges 7:2, 7

He said, They were my brethren, even the sons of my mother: as the LORD lives, if you had **saved** them alive, I would not slay you. Judges 8:19

Benjamin came again at that time; and they gave them wives which they had **saved** alive of the women of Jabesh-gilead: and yet so they sufficed them not. Judges 21:14

When the people were come into the camp, the elders of Israel said, Wherefore has the LORD smitten us to day before the Philistines? Let us fetch the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of Shiloh unto us, that, when it comes among us, it may **save** us out of the hand of our enemies. 1 Samuel 4:3

The children of Israel said to Samuel, Cease not to cry unto the LORD our God for us, that he will **save** us out of the hand of the Philistines...But the children of Belial said, How shall this man **save** us? And they despised him... 1 Samuel 7:8, 10:27

To morrow about this time I will send you a man out of the land of Benjamin, and you shall anoint him to be captain over My people Israel, that he may **save** My people out of the hand of the Philistines: for I have looked upon My people, because their cry is come unto Me. 1 Samuel 9:16

You have this day rejected your God, who Himself **saved** you out of all your adversities and your tribulations; and you have said unto Him, Nay, but set a king over us. Now therefore present yourselves before the LORD by your tribes, and by your thousands. 1 Samuel 10:19

So the LORD **saved** Israel that day: and the battle passed over unto Beth-aven. 1 Samuel 14:23

For, as the LORD lives, which **saves** Israel, though it be in Jonathan my son, he shall surely die. But there was not a man among all the people that answered him. 1 Samuel 14:39

All this assembly shall know that the LORD **saved** not with sword and spear: for the battle is the LORD'S, and He will give you into our hands. 1 Samuel 17:47

So David and his men went to Keilah, and fought with the Philistines, and brought away their cattle, and smote them with a great slaughter. So David **saved** the inhabitants of Keilah. 1 Samuel 23:5

Jonathan said to the young man that bare his armor, Come, and let us go over unto the garrison of these uncircumcised: it may be that the LORD will work for us: for there is no restraint to the LORD to **save** by many or by few. 1 Samuel 14:6

The LORD has spoken of David, saying, By the hand of My servant David I will **save** My people Israel out of the hand of the Philistines, and out of the hand of all their enemies. 2 Samuel 3:18

David **saved** neither man nor woman alive, to bring tidings to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so will be his manner all the while he dwells in the country of the Philistines. 1 Samuel 27:11

The God of my rock; in Him will I trust: He is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my savior; You **save** me from violence. I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised; so shall I be **saved** from my enemies. 2 Samuel 22:3-4

The afflicted people You will **save**: but Your eyes are upon the haughty, that You may bring them down...They looked, but there was none to **save**; even unto the LORD, but He answered them not. 2 Samuel 22:42

Come, let me, I pray you, give counsel, that you may **save** your own life, and the life of your son Solomon. 1 Kings 1:12

O LORD our God, I beseech you, **save** us out of his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You are the LORD God, even You only...For I will defend this city, to **save** it, for My own sake, and for My servant David's sake. 2 Kings 19:19, 34

They set themselves in the midst of that parcel, and delivered it, and slew the Philistines; and the LORD **saved** them by a great deliverance. 1 Chronicles 11:14

He **saves** the poor from the sword, from their mouth, and from the hand of the mighty. Job 5:15

When men are cast down, then you shall say, There is lifting up; and He shall **save** the humble person. Job 22:29

How have you helped him that is without power? How **save** you the arm that has no strength? Job 26:2

Arise, O LORD; **save** me, O my God: for You have smitten all my enemies upon the cheek bone; you have broken the teeth of the ungodly. Psalm 3:7

Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh **save** me for Your mercies' sake. Psalm 6:4

Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and He **saves** them out of their distresses. Psalm 107:19

Be exalted, O God, above the heavens: and Your glory above all the earth; That Your beloved may be delivered: save with Your right hand, and answer me. Psalm 108:5-6

Help me, O LORD my God: O **save** me according to Your mercy...For He shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to **save** him from those that condemn his soul. Psalm 109:26, 31

Save now, I beseech You, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech You, send now prosperity. Psalm 118:25

I am Yours, **save** me; for I have sought your precepts...I cried unto you; **save** me, and I shall keep your testimonies. Psalm 119:94, 146

Though I walk in the midst of trouble, You will revive me: You shall stretch forth Your hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Your right hand shall **save** me. Psalm 138:7

He will fulfil the desire of them that fear Him: He also will hear their cry, and will **save** them. Psalm 145:19

Say not you, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and He shall **save** you. Proverbs 20:22

Whoso walks uprightly shall be **saved**: but he that is perverse in his ways shall fall at once. Proverbs 28:18

It shall be said in that day, Lo, this is our God; we have waited for Him, and He will **save** us: this is the LORD; we have waited for Him, we will be glad and rejoice in His **salvation**. Isaiah 25:9

Thus says the Lord GOD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall you be **saved**; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and you would not. Isaiah 30:15

For the LORD is our judge, the LORD is our lawgiver, the LORD is our king; He will **save** us. Isaiah 33:22

Say to them that are of a fearful heart, Be strong, fear not: behold, Your God will come with vengeance, even God with a recompense; He will come and **save** you. Isaiah 35:4

Now therefore, O LORD our God, **save** us from his hand, that all the kingdoms of the earth may know that You are the LORD [YeHoVaH], even You only. Isaiah 37:20

For I will defend this city to **save** it for My own sake, and for My servant David's sake. Isaiah 37:35

The LORD was ready to **save** me: therefore we will sing my songs to the stringed instruments all the days of our life in the house of the LORD. Isaiah 38:20

I have declared, and have **saved**, and I have shown, when there was no strange god among you: therefore you are My witnesses, says the LORD, that I am God. Isaiah 43:12

Israel shall be **saved** in the LORD with an everlasting **salvation**: you shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end... Assemble yourselves and come; draw near together, you that are escaped of the nations: they have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven image, and pray unto a god that cannot **save**... Look unto Me, and be **saved**, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. Isaiah 45:17-22

They bear him upon the shoulder, they carry him, and set him in his place, and he stands; from his place shall he not remove: yes, one shall cry unto him, yet can he not answer, nor **save** him out of his trouble. Isaiah 46:7

You are wearied in the multitude of your counsels, Let now the astrologers, the stargazers, the monthly prognosticators, stand up, and **save** you from these things that shall come upon you...Thus shall they be unto you with whom you have labored, even your merchants, from your youth: they shall wander every one to his quarter; none shall **save** you. Isaiah 47:13, 15

Thus says the LORD, Even the captives of the mighty shall be taken away, and the prey of the terrible shall be delivered: for I will contend with him that contends with you, and I will **save** your children. Isaiah 49:25

Behold, the LORD'S hand is not shortened, that it cannot **save**; neither His ear heavy, that it cannot hear... Isaiah 59:1

Who is this that comes from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? This that is glorious in His apparel, traveling in the greatness of His strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to **save**. Isaiah 63:1

In all their affliction He was afflicted, and the angel of His presence **saved** them: in His love and in His pity He redeemed them; and He bare them, and carried them all the days of old. Isaiah 63:9

You meet him that rejoices and works righteousness, those that remember You in Your ways: behold, You are wroth; for we have sinned: in those is continuance, and we shall be **saved**. Isaiah 64:5

As the thief is ashamed when he is found, so is the house of Israel ashamed; they, their kings, their princes, and their priests, and their prophets, Saying to a stock, you are my father; and to a stone, you have brought me forth: for they have turned their back unto Me, and not their face: but in the time of their trouble they will say, Arise, and **save** us. But where are your gods that you have made yourself? Let them arise, if they can **save** you in the time of trouble: for according to the number of your cities are your gods, O Judah. Jeremiah 2:26-28

O Jerusalem, wash your heart from wickedness, that you may be **saved**. How long shall your vain thoughts lodge within you? Jeremiah 4:14

The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not **saved**.
Jeremiah 8:20

Then shall the cities of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem go, and cry unto the gods unto whom they offer incense: but they shall not **save** them at all in the time of their trouble.
Jeremiah 11:12

Why should you be as a man astonished, as a mighty man that cannot **save**? Yet You, O LORD, are in the midst of us, and we are called by Your name; leave us not. Jeremiah 14:9

I will make you unto this people a fenced brasen wall: and they shall fight against you, but they shall not prevail against you: for I am with you to **save** you and to deliver you, says the LORD.
Jeremiah 15:20

Heal me, O LORD [YeHoVaH], and I shall be healed; **save** me, and I shall be **saved**: for You are my praise. Jeremiah 17:14

In his days Judah shall be **saved**, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this is His name whereby He shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS. Jeremiah 23:6

Fear not, O my servant Jacob, says the LORD; neither be dismayed, O Israel: for, lo, I will **save** you from afar, and your seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and shall be in rest, and be quiet, and none shall make him afraid. For I am with you, says the LORD, to **save** you: though I make a full end of all nations whither I have scattered you, yet will I not make a full end of you: but I will correct you in measure, and will not leave you altogether unpunished. Jeremiah 30:10-11

Thus says the LORD [YeHoVaH]; Sing with gladness for Jacob, and shout among the chief of the nations: publish you, praise you, and say, O LORD, **save** Your people, the remnant of Israel.
Jeremiah 31:7

Be not afraid of the king of Babylon, of whom you are afraid; be not afraid of him, says the LORD: for I am with you to **save** you, and to deliver you from his hand. Jeremiah 42:11

But fear not you, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will **save** you from afar off, and your seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid. Jeremiah 46:27

Flee, **save** your lives, and be like the heath in the wilderness. Jeremiah 48:6

As for us, our eyes as yet failed for our vain help: in our watching we have watched for a nation that could not **save** us. Lamentations 4:17

When I say unto the wicked, You shall surely die; and you give him not warning, nor speak to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to **save** his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at your hands. Ezekiel 3:18

Woe to the women that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will you hunt the souls of My people, and will you **save** the souls alive that come unto you? And will you pollute Me among My people for handfuls of barley and for pieces of bread, to slay the souls that should not die, and to **save** the souls alive that should not live, by your lying to My people that hear your lies? Ezekiel 13:18-19

Again, when the wicked man turns away from his wickedness that he has committed, and does that which is lawful and right, he shall **save** his soul alive. Ezekiel 18:27

Therefore will I **save** My flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle. Ezekiel 34:22

I will also **save** you from all your uncleannesses: and I will call for the corn, and will increase it, and lay no famine upon you. Ezekiel 36:29

Neither shall they defile themselves any more with their idols, nor with their detestable things, nor with any of their transgressions: but I will **save** them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and will cleanse them: so shall they be My people, and I will be their God. Ezekiel 37:23

I will have mercy upon the house of Judah, and will **save** them by the LORD their God, and will not **save** them by bow, nor by sword, nor by battle, by horses, nor by horsemen. Hosea 1:7

I will be your king: where is any other that may **save** you in all your cities? And your judges of whom you said, Give me a king and princes? Hosea 13:10

Asshur shall not **save** us; we will not ride upon horses; neither will we say any more to the work of our hands, you are our gods: for in you the fatherless find mercy. Hosea 14:3

O LORD, how long shall I cry, and You will not hear! Even cry out unto You of violence, and You will not **save**! Habakkuk 1:2

The LORD your God in the midst of you is mighty; He will **save**, He will rejoice over you with joy; he will rest in His love, He will joy over you with singing. Zephaniah 3:17

Behold, at that time I will undo all that afflict you: and I will **save** her that halts, and gather her that was driven out; and I will get them praise and fame in every land where they have been put to shame. At that time will I bring you again, even in the time that I gather you: for I will make you a name and a praise among all people of the earth, when I turn back your captivity before your eyes, says the LORD [YeHoVaH]. Zephaniah 3:19

Thus says the LORD of hosts; Behold, I will **save** My people from the east country, and from the west country; and I will bring them, and they shall dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, in truth and in righteousness. Zechariah 8:7-8

It shall come to pass, that as you were a curse among the heathen, O house of Judah, and house of Israel; so will I **save** you, and you shall be a blessing: fear not, but let your hands be strong. Zechariah 8:13

The LORD their God shall **save** them in that day as the flock of His people: for they shall be as the stones of a crown, lifted up as an ensign upon His land. For how great is His goodness, and how great is His beauty! Zechariah 9:16-17a

I will strengthen the house of Judah, and I will **save** the house of Joseph, and I will bring them again to place them; for I have mercy upon them: and they shall be as though I had not cast them off: for I am the LORD their God, and will hear them. Zechariah 10:6

The LORD also shall **save** the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify themselves against Judah. Zechariah 12:7

She shall bring forth a son, and you shall call His name JESUS [Yeshua]: for He shall **save** His people from their sins. Matt 1:21

His disciples came to Him, and awoke Him, saying, Lord, **save** us: we perish. Matthew 8:25

You shall be hated of all men for My name's sake: but he that endures to the end shall be **saved**. Matthew 10:22

When he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, **save** me. Matthew 14:30

For whosoever will **save** his life shall lose it: and whosoever will lose his life for My sake shall find it. Matthew 16:25

The Son of man is come to **save** that which was lost. Mt 18:11

Then said Jesus [Yeshua] unto His disciples, Verily I say unto you, That a rich man shall hardly enter into the kingdom of heaven... When His disciples heard it, they were exceedingly amazed, saying, Who then can be **saved**? But Jesus [Yeshua] beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible. Matthew 19:23, 25-26

He that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be **saved**... Except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be **saved**: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened. Matthew 24:13, 22

You that destroyed the temple, and build it in three days, **save** Yourself. If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross...He **saved** others; Himself He cannot **save**. If He be the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him. Matthew 27:40, 42

He said unto them, Is it lawful to do good on the sabbath days, or to do evil? To **save** life, or to kill? Mark 3:4a

He suffered no man to follow Him, **save** Peter, and James, and John the brother of James. Mark 5:37

Whoever will **save** his life shall lose it; but whosoever shall lose his life for My sake and the gospel's, the same shall **save** it. Mark 8:35

They were astonished out of measure, saying among themselves, Who then can be **saved**? Mark 10:26

You shall be hated of all men for My name's sake: but he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be **saved**. Mark 13:13

Save Yourself, and come down from the cross...Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He **saved** others; Himself He cannot **save**. Mark 15:30-31

He that believes and is baptized shall be **saved**; but he that believes not shall be damned. Mark 16:16

Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for He has visited and redeemed His people, and has raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of His servant David; As He spake by the mouth of His holy prophets, which have been since the world began: that we should be **saved** from our enemies, and from the hand of all that hate us; to perform the mercy promised to our fathers, and to remember His holy covenant; The oath which He sware to our father Abraham, That he would grant unto us, that we being delivered out of the hand of our enemies might serve Him without fear, In holiness and righteousness before Him, all the days of our life. Luke 1:68-75

Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? To **save** life, or to destroy it? Luke 6:9

He said...Your faith has **saved** you; go in peace. Luke 7:50

Those by the way side are they that hear; then comes the devil, and takes away the word out of their hearts, lest they should believe and be **saved**. Luke 8:12

For the Son of man is not come to destroy men's lives, but to **save** them. And they went to another village. Luke 9:56

Then said one unto Him, Lord, are there few that be **saved**? And He said unto them, Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able. Luke 13:23-24

Whosoever shall seek to **save** his life shall lose it; and whosoever shall lose his life shall preserve it. Luke 17:33

Jesus said unto him, Receive your sight: your faith has **saved** you. Luke 18:42

For the Son of man is come to seek and to **save** that which was lost. Luke 19:10

The people stood beholding. And the rulers also with them derided Him, saying, He **saved** others; let Him **save** Himself, if He be Christ, the chosen of God...If You be the king of the Jews, **save** Yourself...One of the malefactors which were hanged railed on Him, saying, If You are Christ [Messiah], **save** Yourself and us. Luke 23:35, 37, 39

For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be **saved**. John 3:17

I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that you might be **saved**. John 5:34

I am the door: by Me if any man enter in, he shall be **saved**, and shall go in and out, and find pasture. John 10:9

Now is My soul troubled; and what shall I say? Father, **save** Me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour. John 12:27

If any man hear My words, and believe not, I judge him not: for I came not to judge the world, but to **save** the world. Jn 12:47

It shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be **saved**...The Lord added to the church daily such as should be **saved**. Acts 2:21, 47

With many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, **Save** yourselves from this untoward generation. Acts 2:40

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be **saved**. Acts 4:12

Call for Simon, whose surname is Peter; Who shall tell you words, whereby you and all your house shall be **saved**. Acts 11:13b-14

Certain men which came down from Judaea taught the brethren, and said, Except you be circumcised after the manner of Moses, you cannot be **saved**...But we believe that through the grace of the Lord Jesus [Yeshua] Christ we shall be **saved**... Acts 15:1, 15

Then he called for a light, and sprang in, and came trembling, and fell down before Paul and Silas, And brought them out, and said, Sirs, what must I do to be **saved**? And they said, Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be **saved**, and your house. And they spoke unto him the word of the Lord, and to all that were in his house. Acts 16:29-31

When neither sun nor stars in many days appeared, and no small tempest lay on us, all hope that we should be **saved** was then taken away...Paul said to the centurion and to the soldiers, Except these abide in the ship, you cannot be **saved**... The centurion, willing to **save** Paul, kept them from their purpose; and commanded that they which could swim should cast themselves first into the sea, and get to land... Acts 27:20, 31, 43

But God commended His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ [the Messiah] died for us. Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be **saved** from wrath through Him. For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of His Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be **saved** by His life. Romans 5:8-10

For we are **saved** by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man sees, why does he yet hope for? Romans 8:24

Esaias also cried concerning Israel, Though the number of the children of Israel be as the sand of the sea, a remnant shall be **saved**... Romans 9:27

Brethren, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is, that they might be **saved**... That if you shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you shall be **saved**... For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be **saved**... Romans 10:1, 9, 13,

For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I magnify my office: If by any means I may provoke to emulation them which are my flesh, and might **save** some of them... Romans 11:14

For I would not, brethren, that you should be ignorant of this mystery, lest you should be wise in your own conceits; that blindness in part is happened to Israel, until the fulness of the Gentiles be come in. And so all Israel shall be **saved**: as it is written, There shall come out of Zion the Deliverer, and shall turn away ungodliness from Jacob... Romans 11:25-26

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are **saved** it is the power of God... For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to **save** them that believe. 1 Corinthians 1:13, 21

If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be **saved**; yet so as by fire. 1 Corinthians 3:15

To deliver such an one to Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be **saved** in the day of the Lord Jesus [Yeshua]. 1 Corinthians 5:5

For what know you, O wife, whether you shall **save** your husband? Or how know you, O man whether you shall **save** your wife? 1 Corinthians 7:16

To the weak became I as weak, that I might gain the weak: I am made all things to all men, that I might by all means **save** some. 1 Corinthians 9:22

Give none offense, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God: Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking my own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be **saved**. 1 Corinthians 10:32-33

Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also you have received, and wherein you stand; By which also you are **saved**, if you keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. 1 Corinthians 15:1-2

For we are unto God a sweet savor of Christ [Messiah], in them that are **saved**, and in them that perish: To the one we are the savor of death unto death; and to the other the savor of life unto life. And who is sufficient for these things? 2 Corinthians 2:15-16

But God forbid that I should glory, **save** [except] in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ [Yeshua the Messiah], by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world. Galatians 6:14

But God, who is rich in mercy, for His great love wherewith He loved us, Even when we were dead in sins, has quickened us together with Christ, (by grace you are **saved**;) And has raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus; That in the ages to come He might shew the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus. For by grace are you **saved** through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of works, lest any man should boast. Ephesians 2:5-8

You also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they have of the Jews: Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men: Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be **saved**, to fill up their sins alway: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost. 1 Thessalonians 2:14-16

With all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be **saved**. For this cause God shall send...delusion. 2 Thessalonians 2:10-11

The grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus. This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus [Yeshua] came into the world to **save** sinners; of whom I am chief. 1 Timothy 1:14-15

I exhort therefore, that, first of all, supplications, prayers, intercessions, and giving of thanks, be made for all men; for kings, and for all that are in authority; that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior; Who will have all men to be **saved**, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth. 1 Timothy 2:1-4

For Adam was first formed, then Eve. Adam was not deceived, but the woman being deceived was in the transgression. Notwithstanding she shall be **saved** in childbearing, if they continue in faith and charity and holiness with sobriety. 1 Timothy 2:14-15

Take heed unto yourself, and unto the doctrine; continue in them: for in doing this you shall both **save** yourself, and them that hear you. 1 Timothy 4:16

Be not therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord... Who has **saved** us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who has abolished death, and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel... 2 Timothy 1:8-10

But after that the kindness and love of God our Savior toward man appeared, Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to His mercy He **saved** us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost; Which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior... Titus 3:4-6

Who in the days of His flesh, when He had offered up prayers and supplications with strong crying and tears unto Him that was able to **save** Him from death, and was heard in that He feared... Hebrews 5:7

Wherefore He is able also to **save** them to the uttermost that come unto God by Him, seeing He ever lives to make intercession for them. Hebrews 7:25

But we are not of them who draw back unto perdition; but of them that believe to the **saving** of the soul. Hebrews 10:39

By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the **saving** of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith. Hebrews 11:7

Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to **save** your souls. James 1:21

There is one lawgiver, who is able to **save** and to destroy: who are you that judges another? James 4:12

The prayer of faith shall **save** the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him... Let him know, that he which converts the sinner from the error of his way shall **save** a soul from death, and shall hide a multitude of sins. James 5:15, 20

...Which sometime were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of God waited in the days of Noah, while the ark was a preparing, wherein few, that is, eight souls were **saved** by water. The like figure whereunto even baptism does also now **save** us...by the resurrection of Jesus Christ... 1 Peter 3:20-21

And if the righteous scarcely be **saved**, where shall the ungodly and the sinner appear? 1 Peter 4:18

I will therefore put you in remembrance, though you once knew this, how that the Lord, having **saved** the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed them that believed not... Others **save** with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh. Jude 1:5, 23

And the nations of them which are **saved** shall walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth do bring their glory and honor into it. Revelations 21:24
